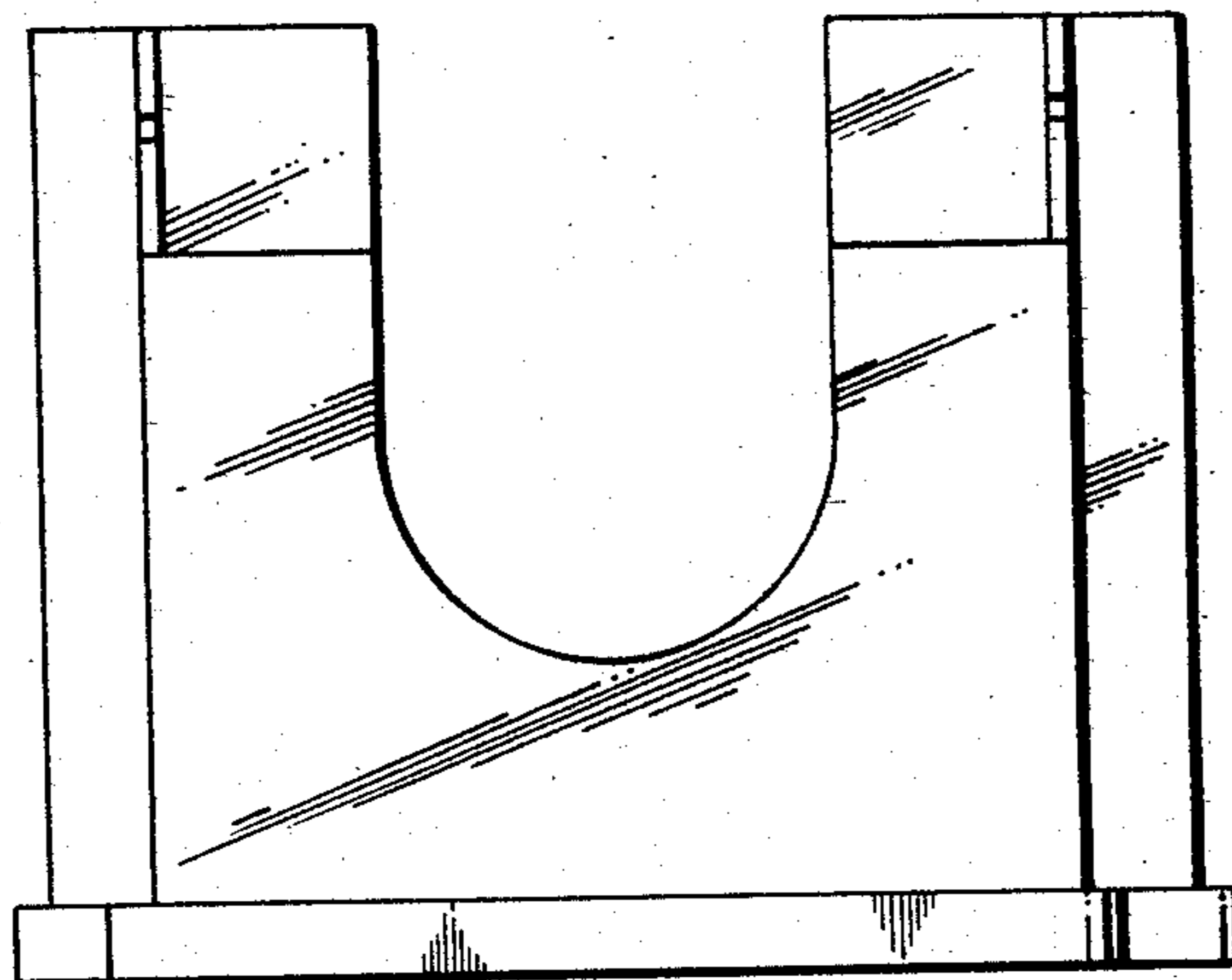
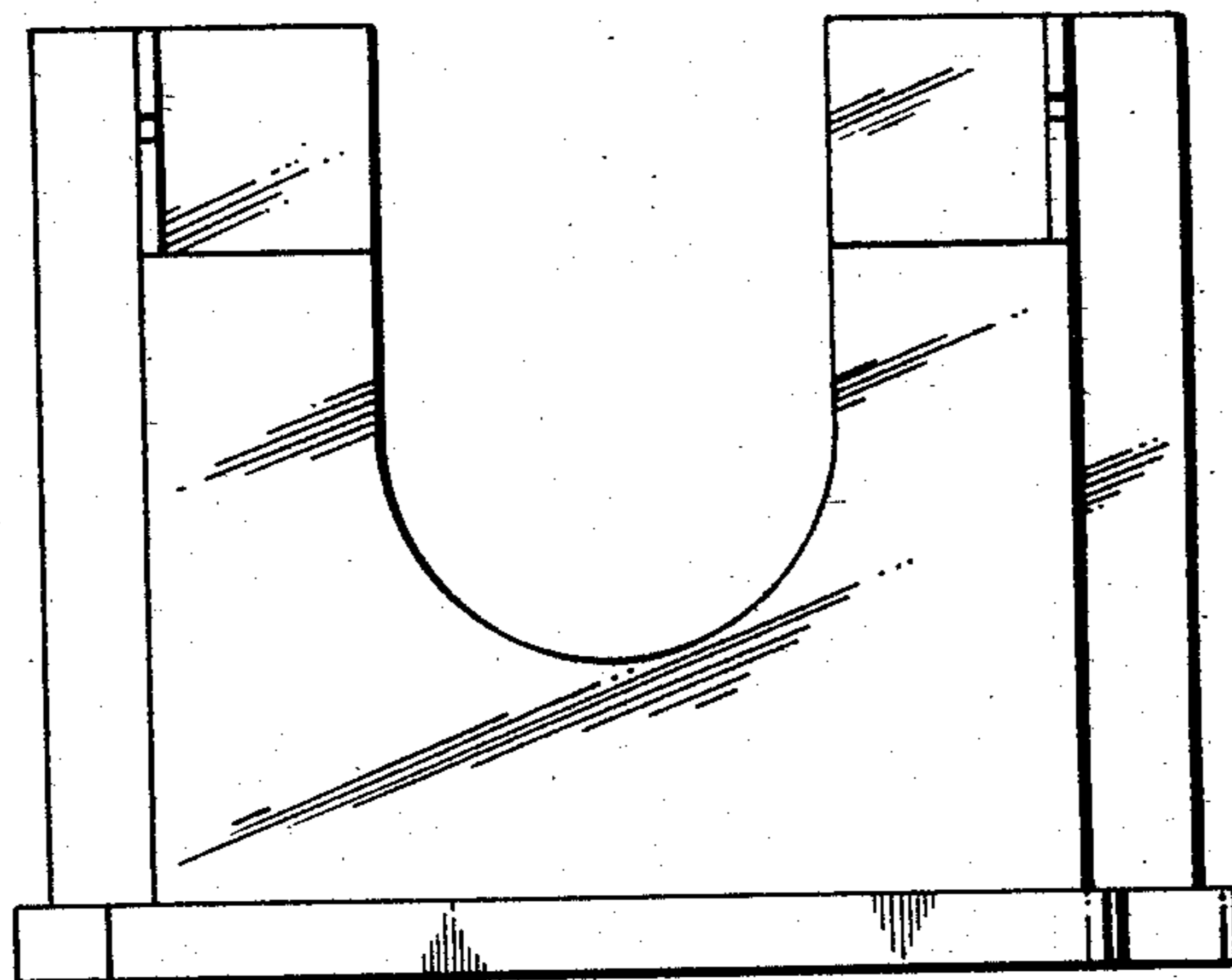
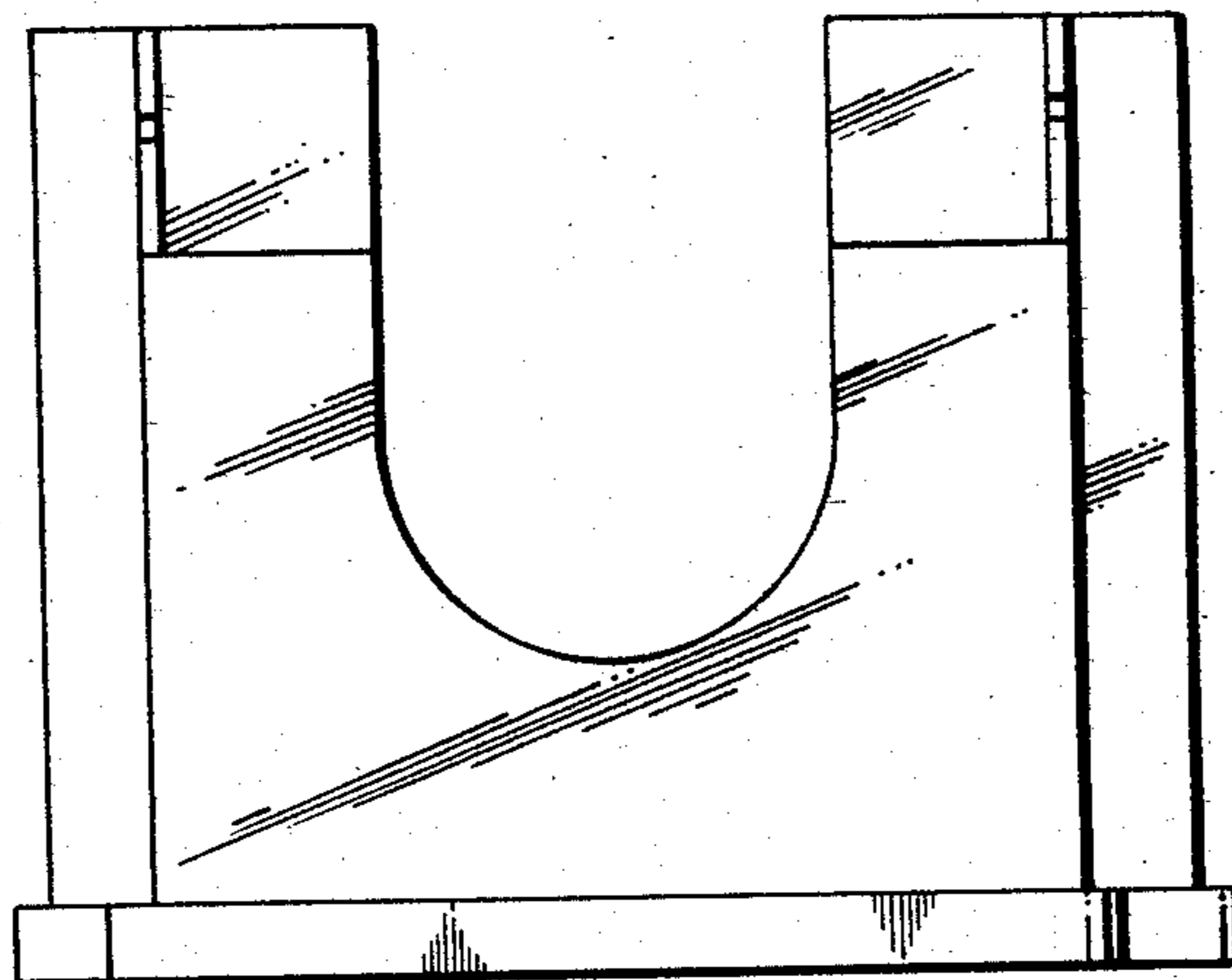
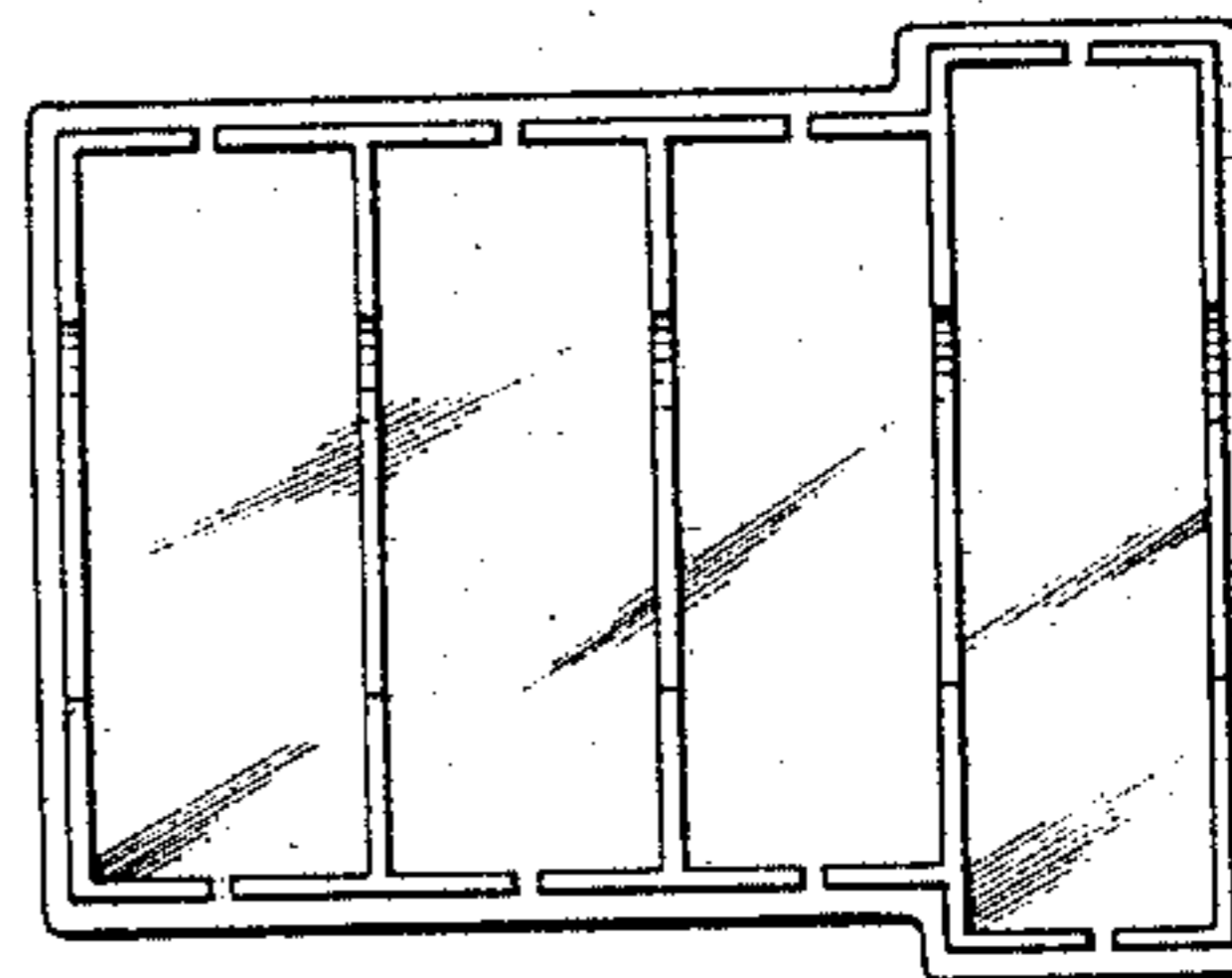
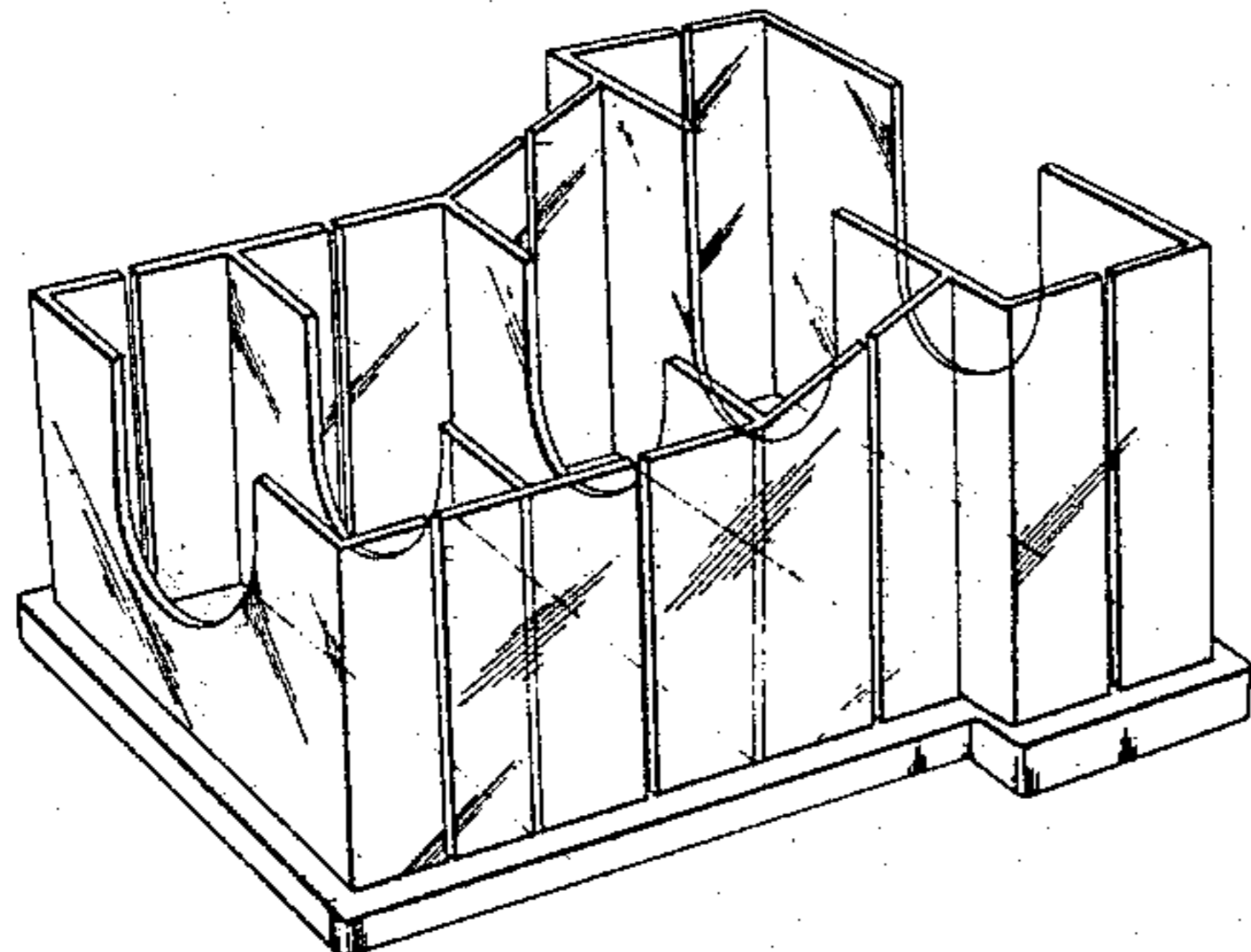

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bagel slicing jig, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a bagel slicing jig showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view of FIG. 1.



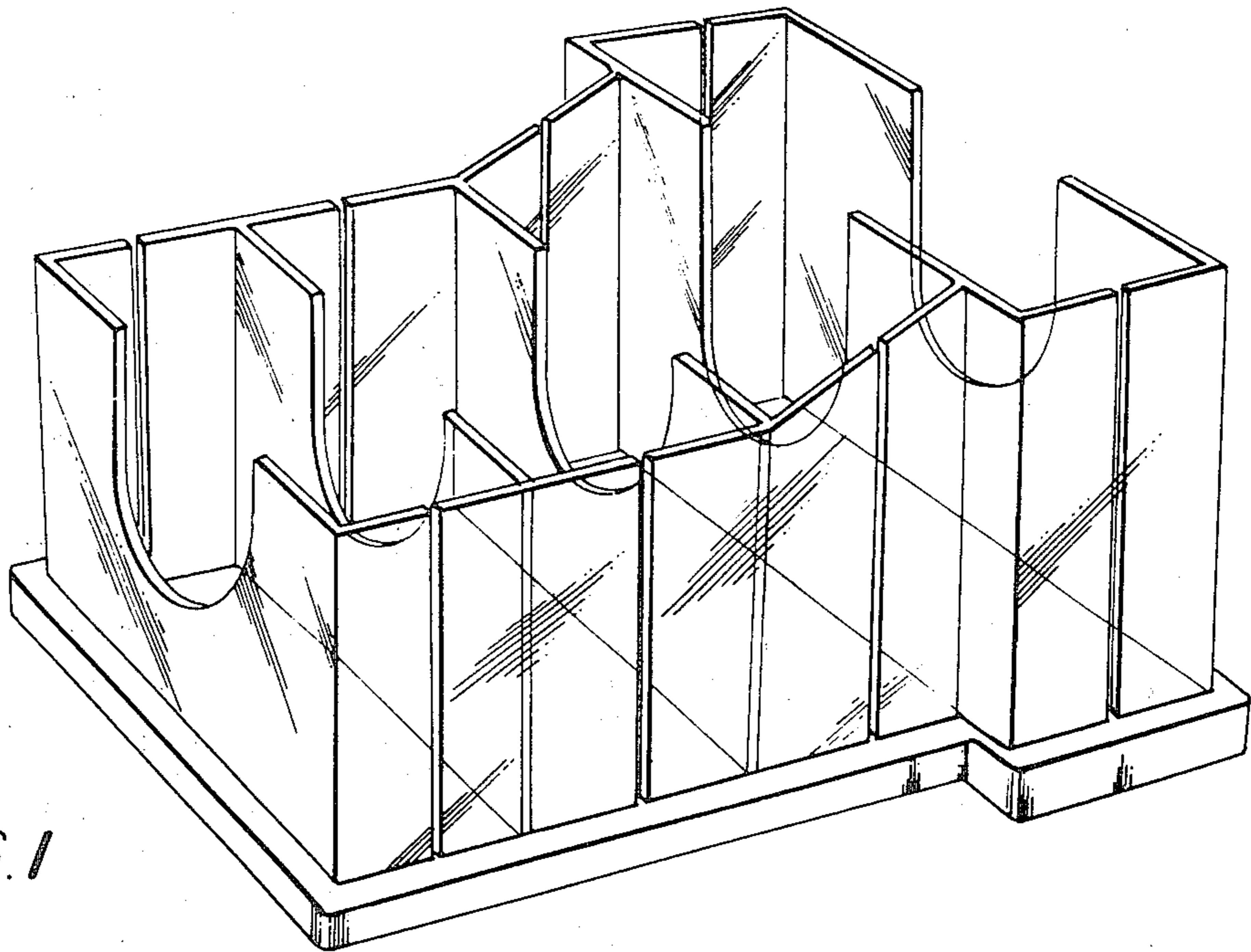

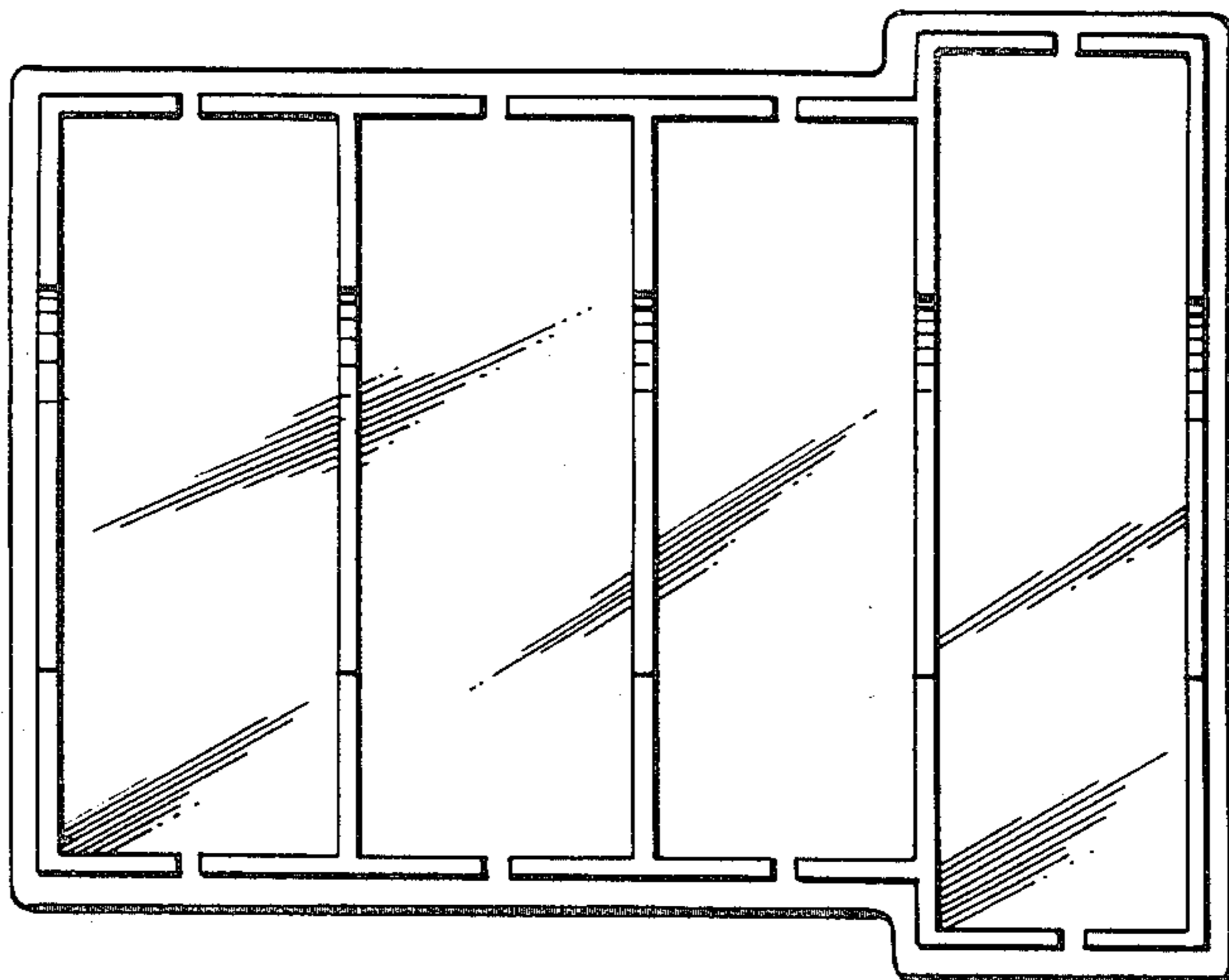

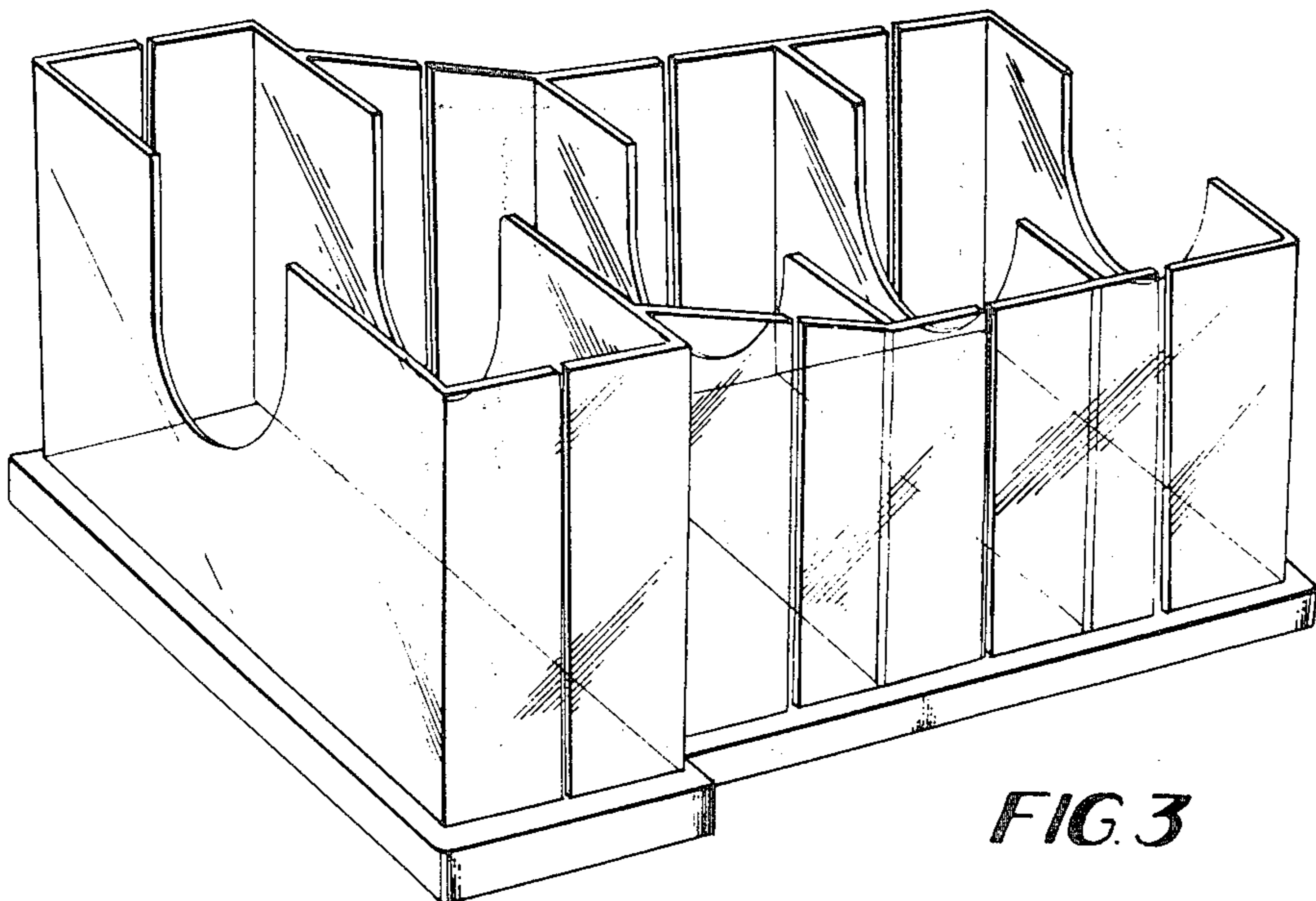

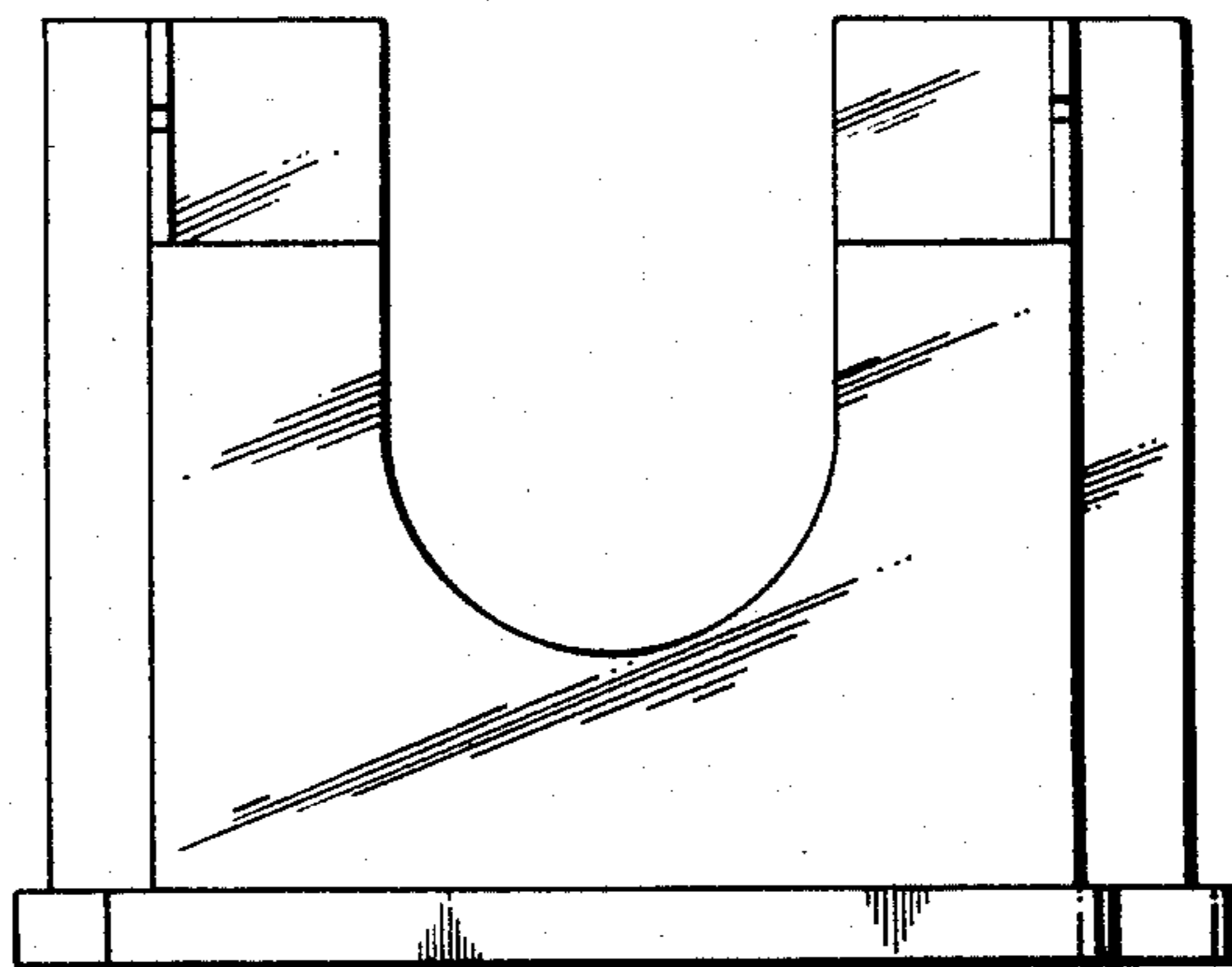

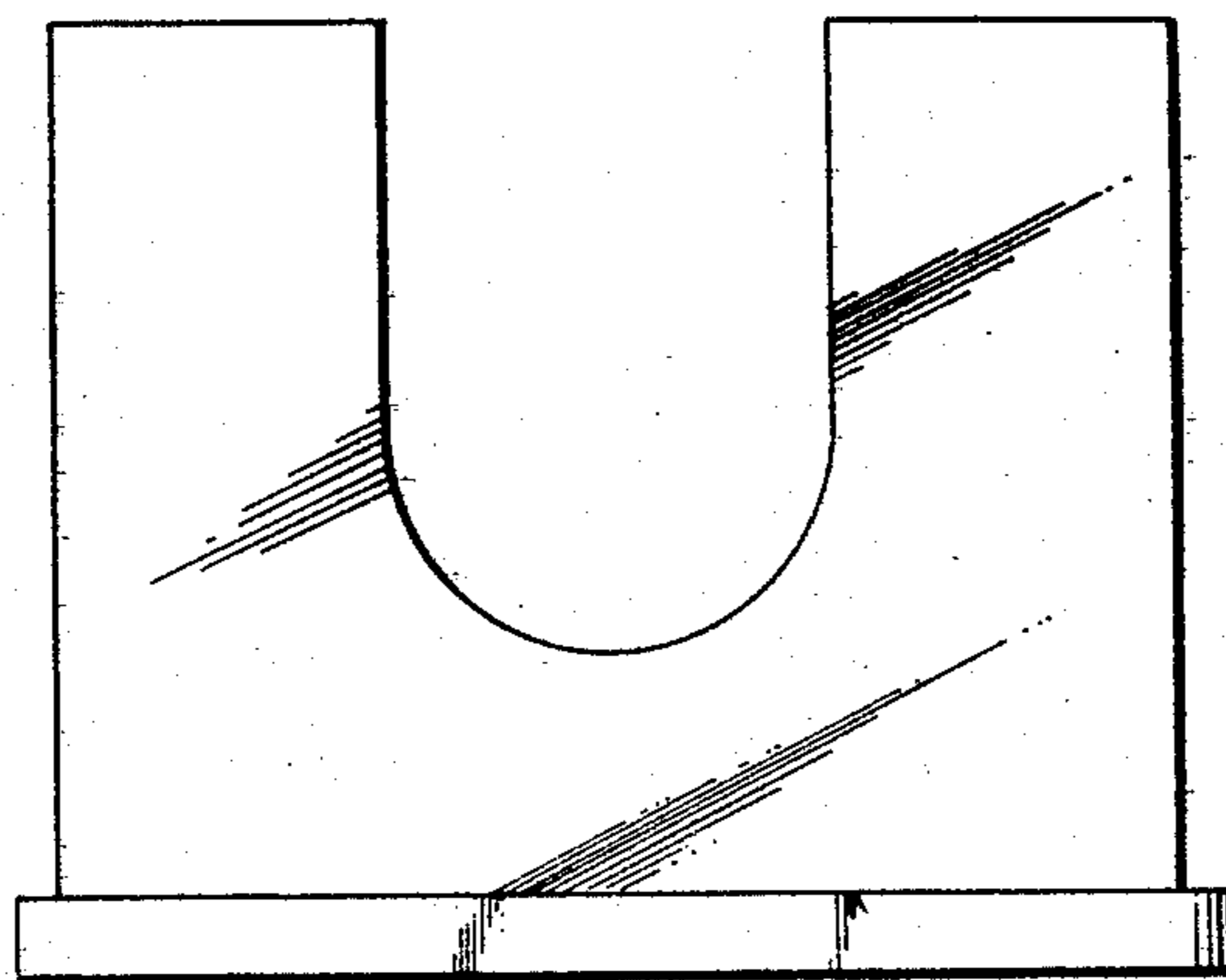
