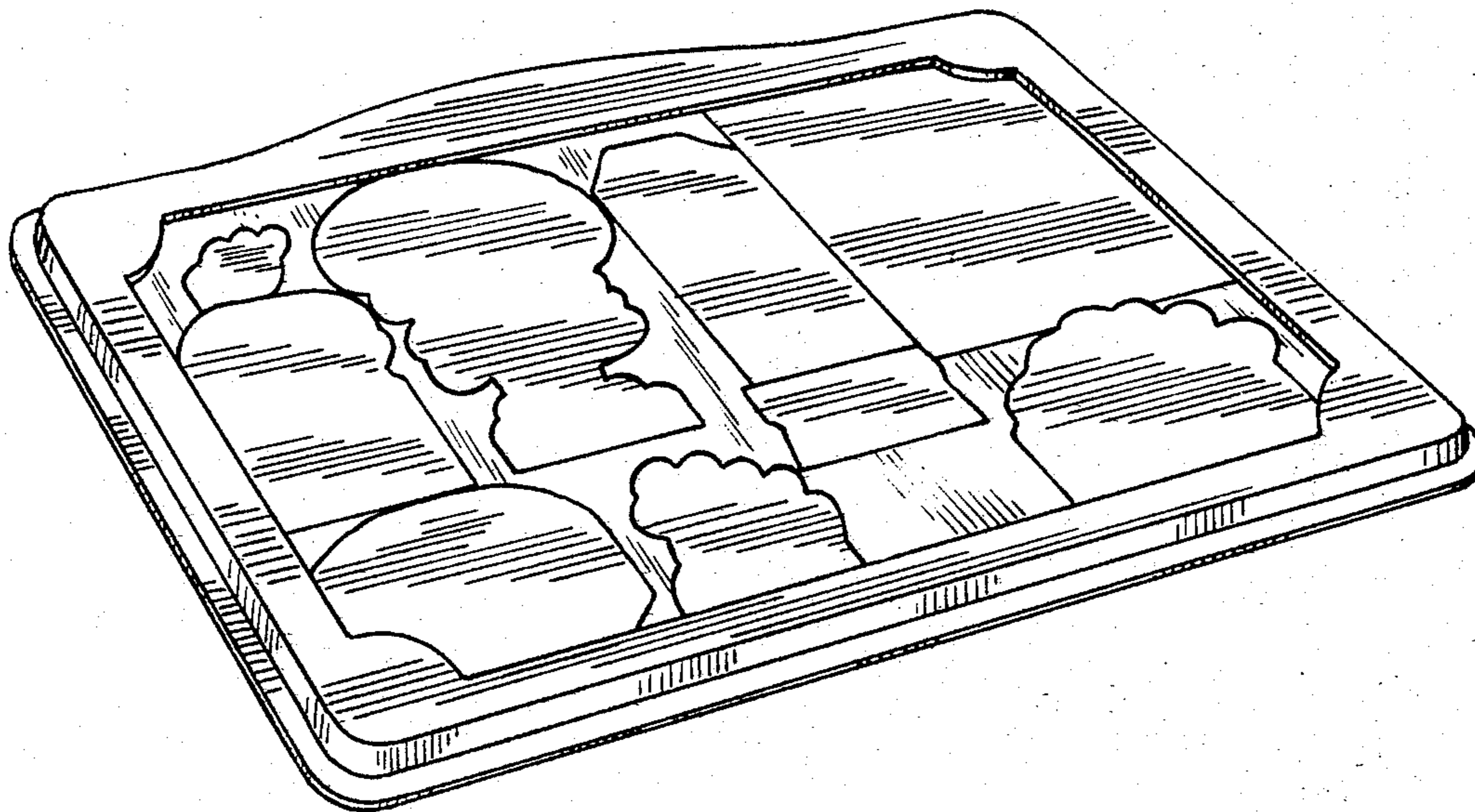

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined puzzle and tray, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined puzzle and tray, showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 1, but showing the tray as holding some of the puzzle pieces in a vertical position;
 FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the tray member with the puzzle pieces removed;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof.



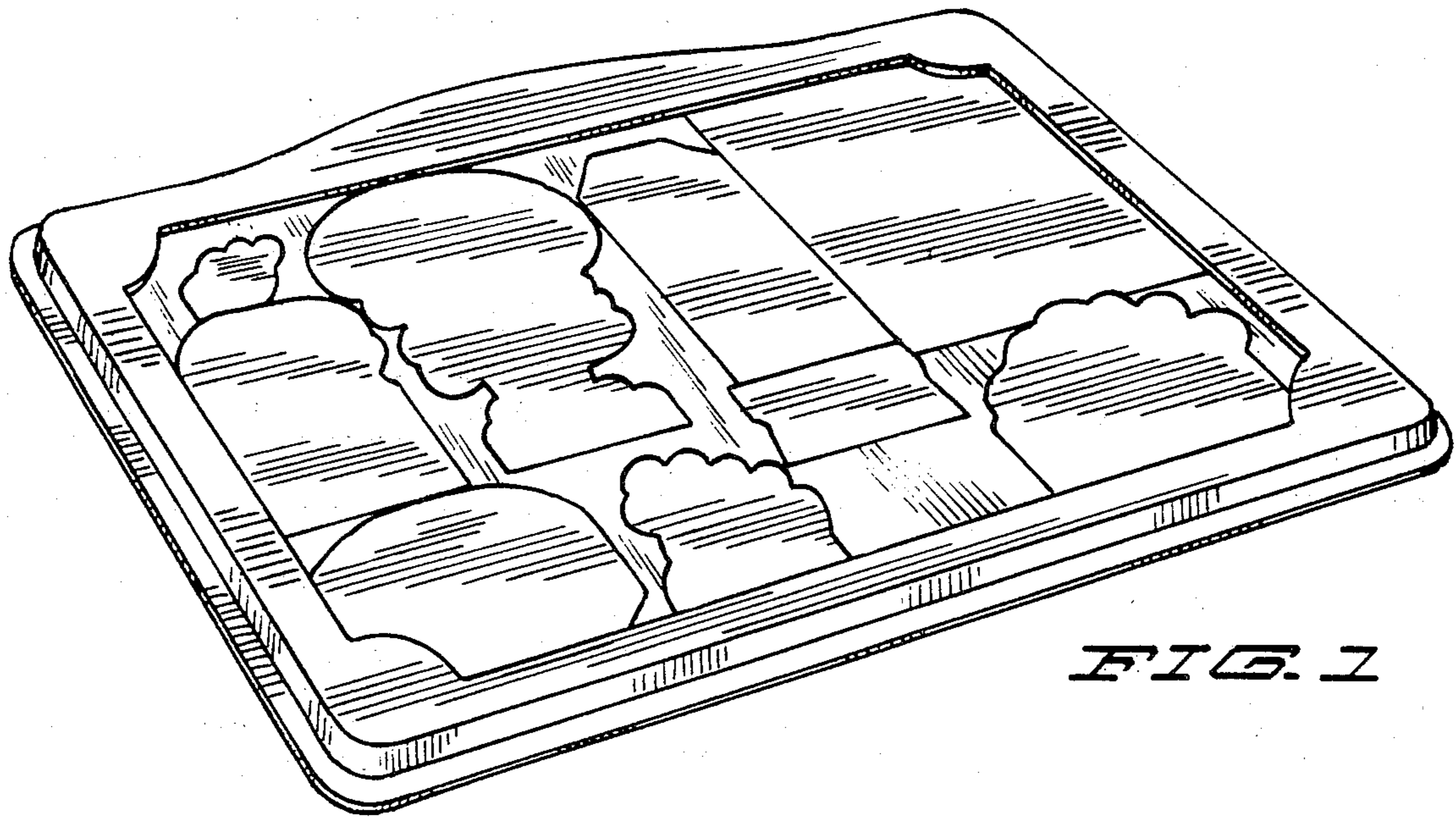

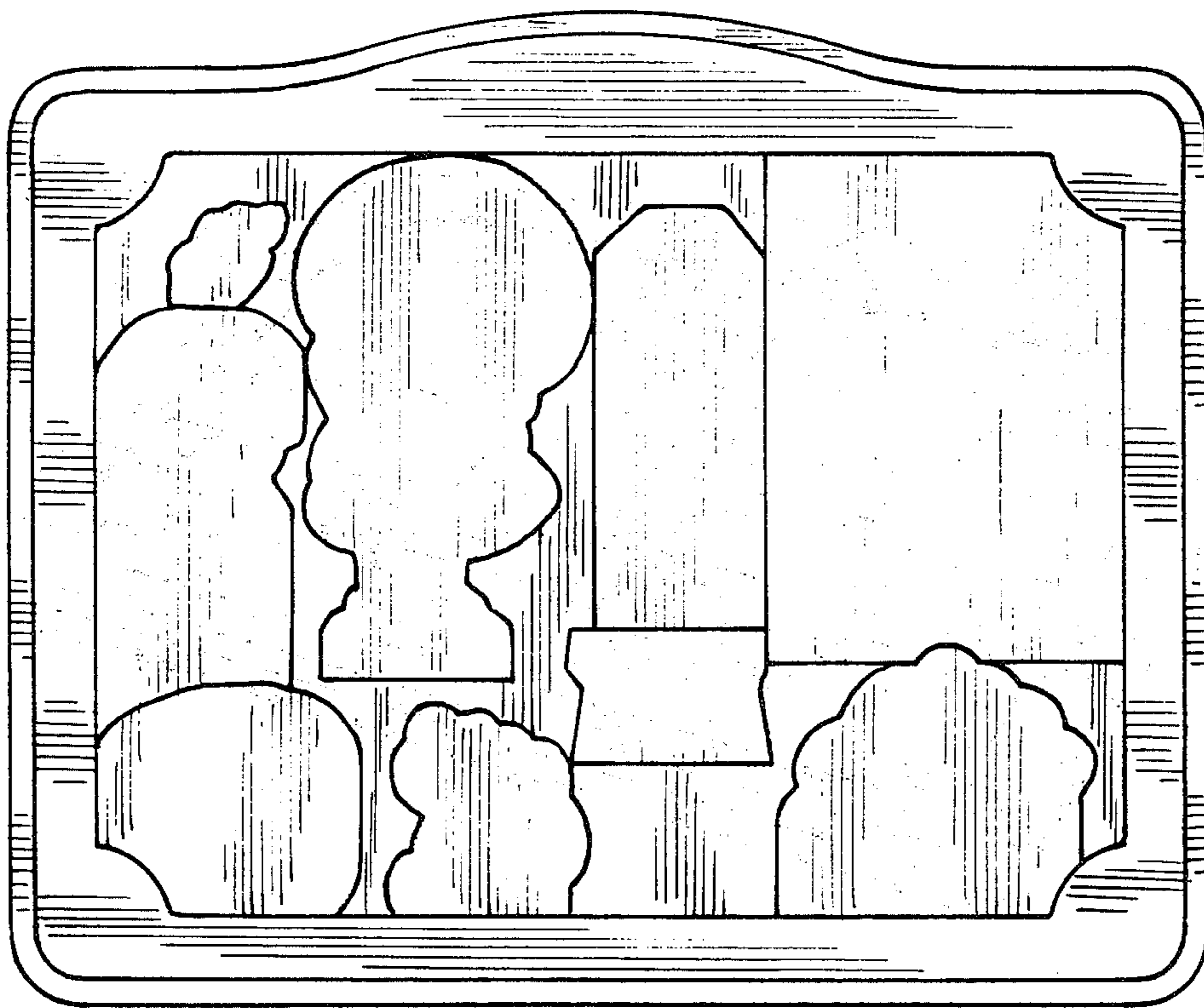
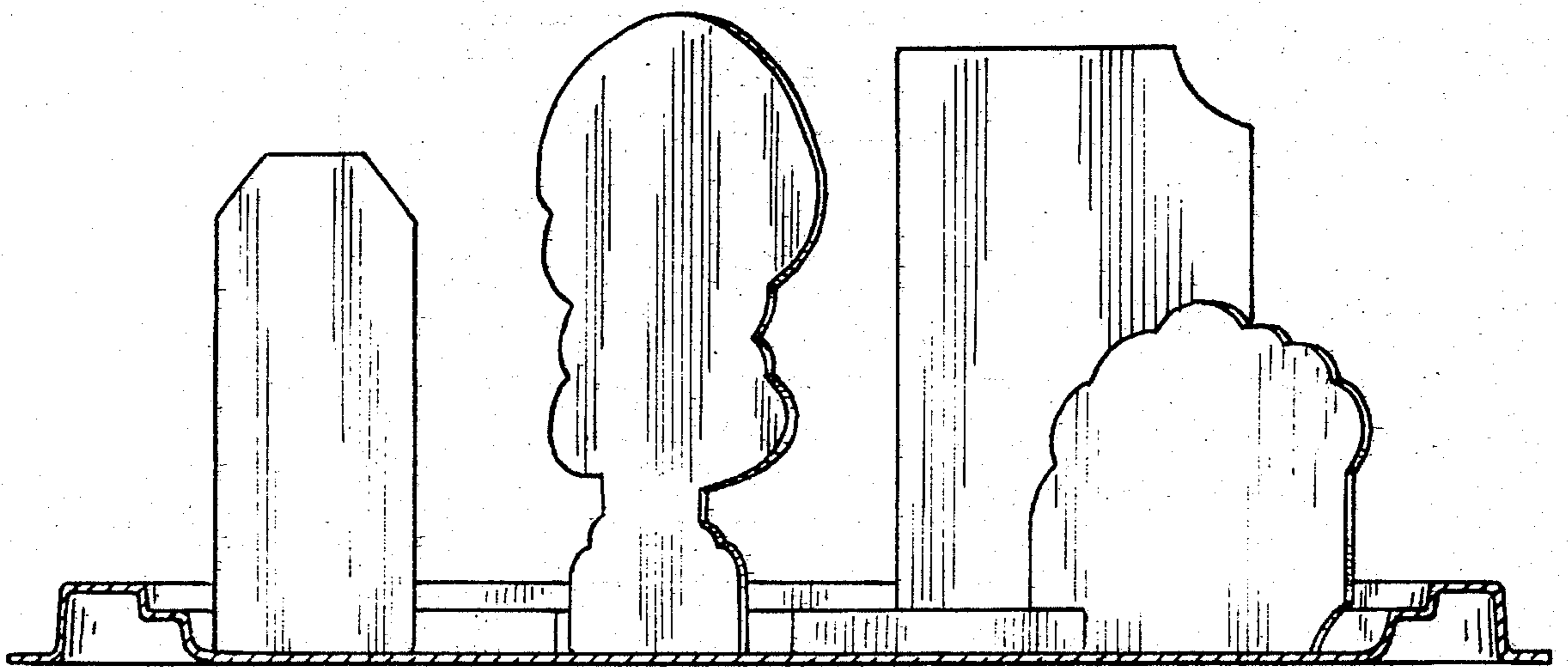
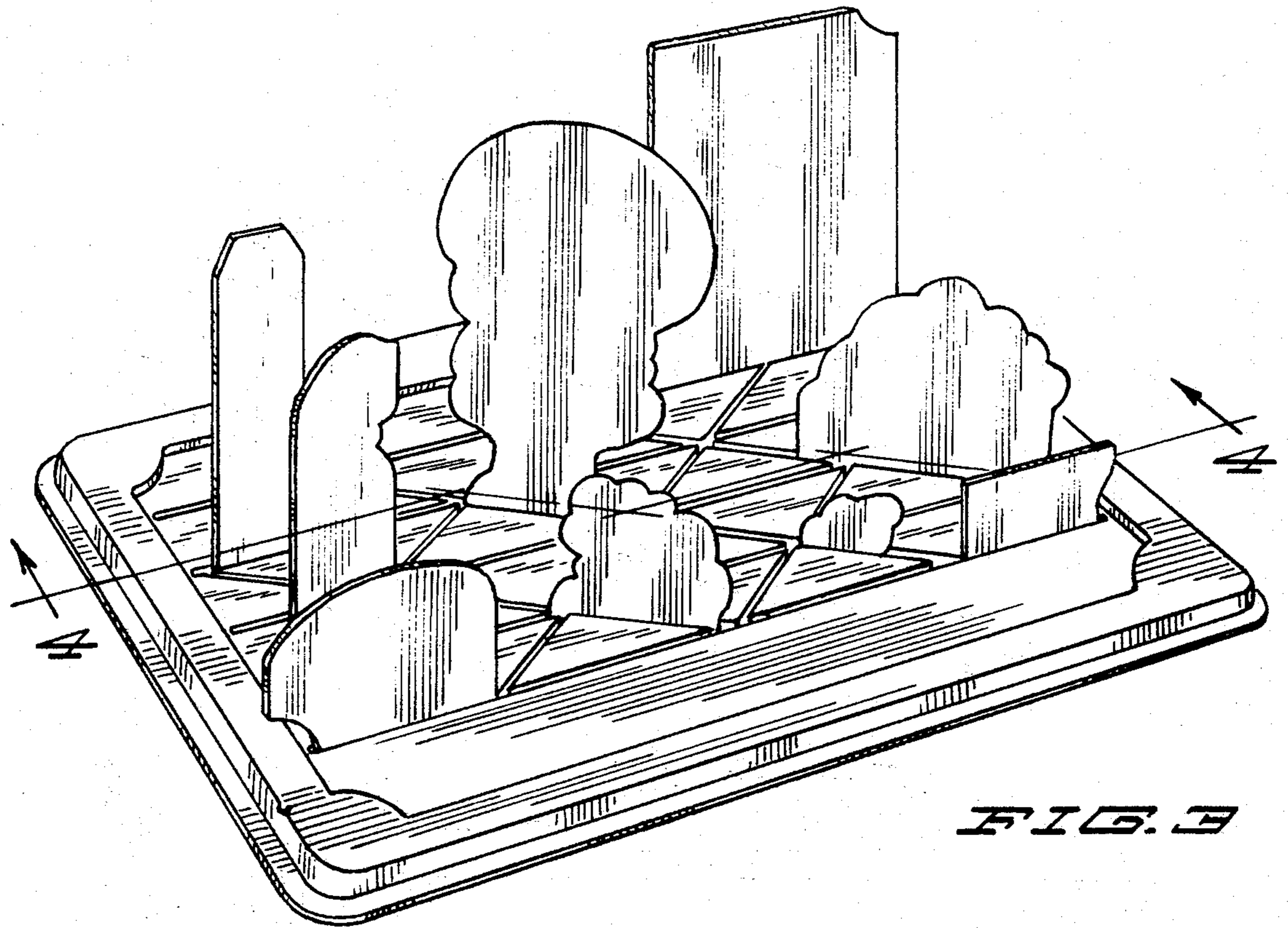

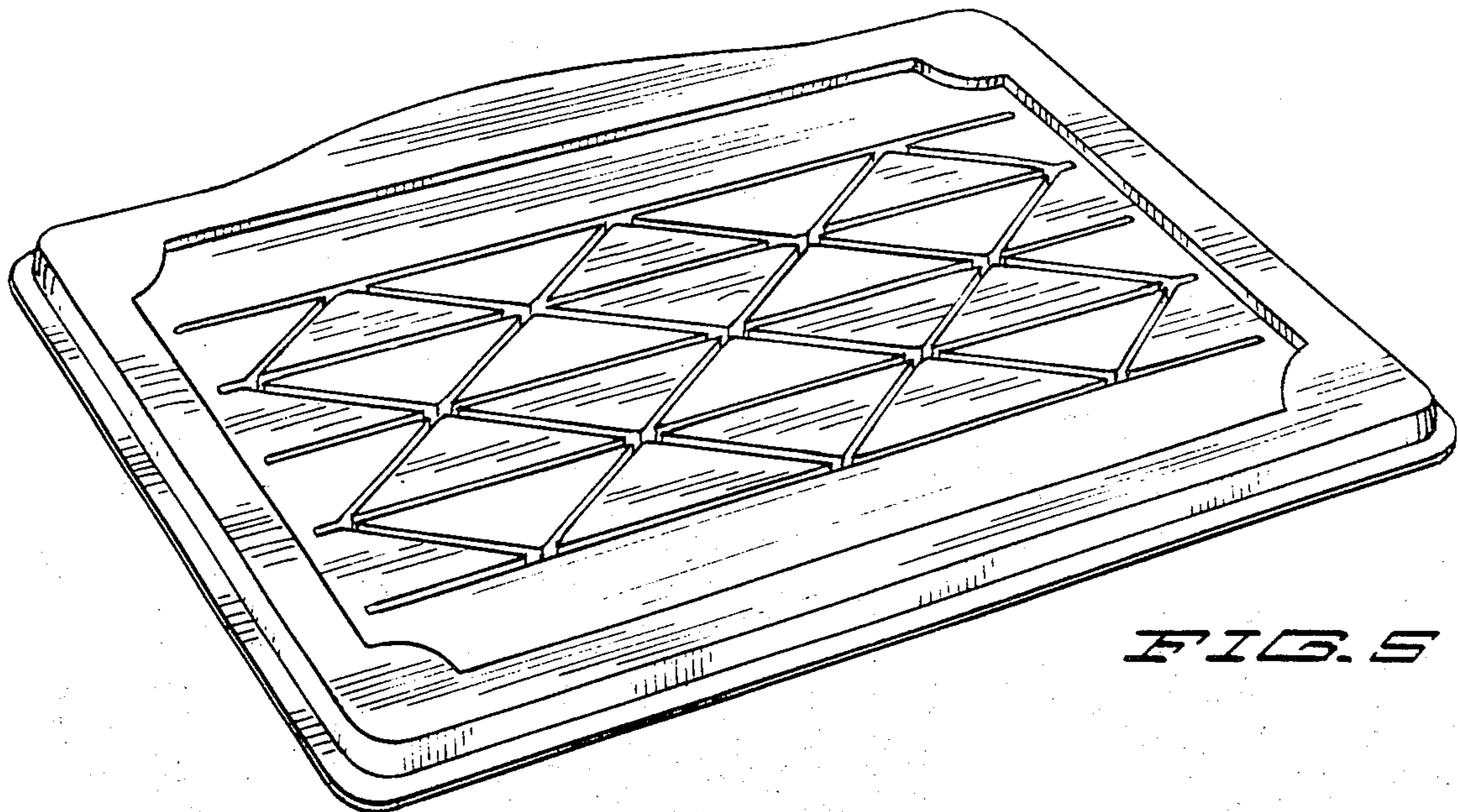

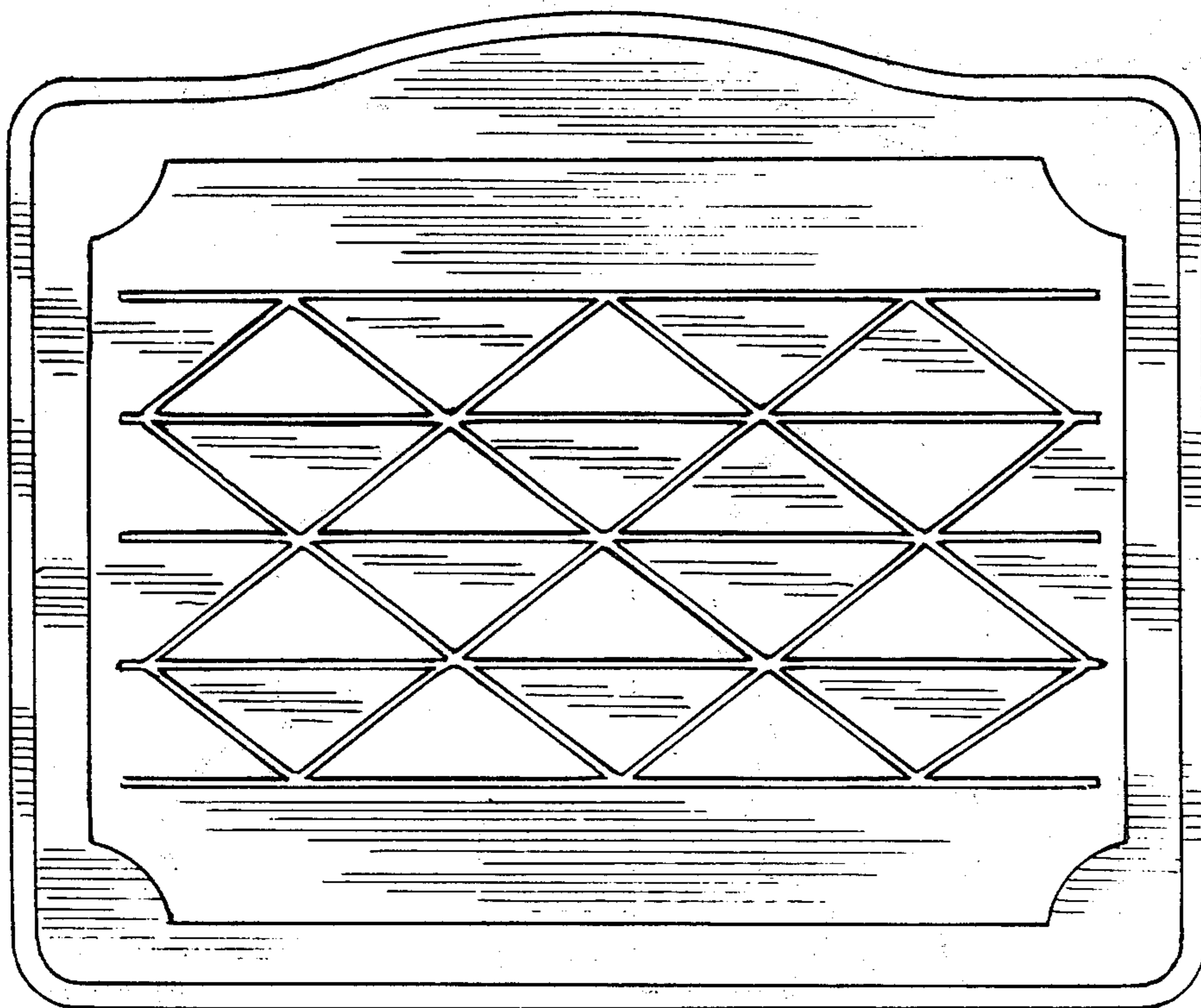
