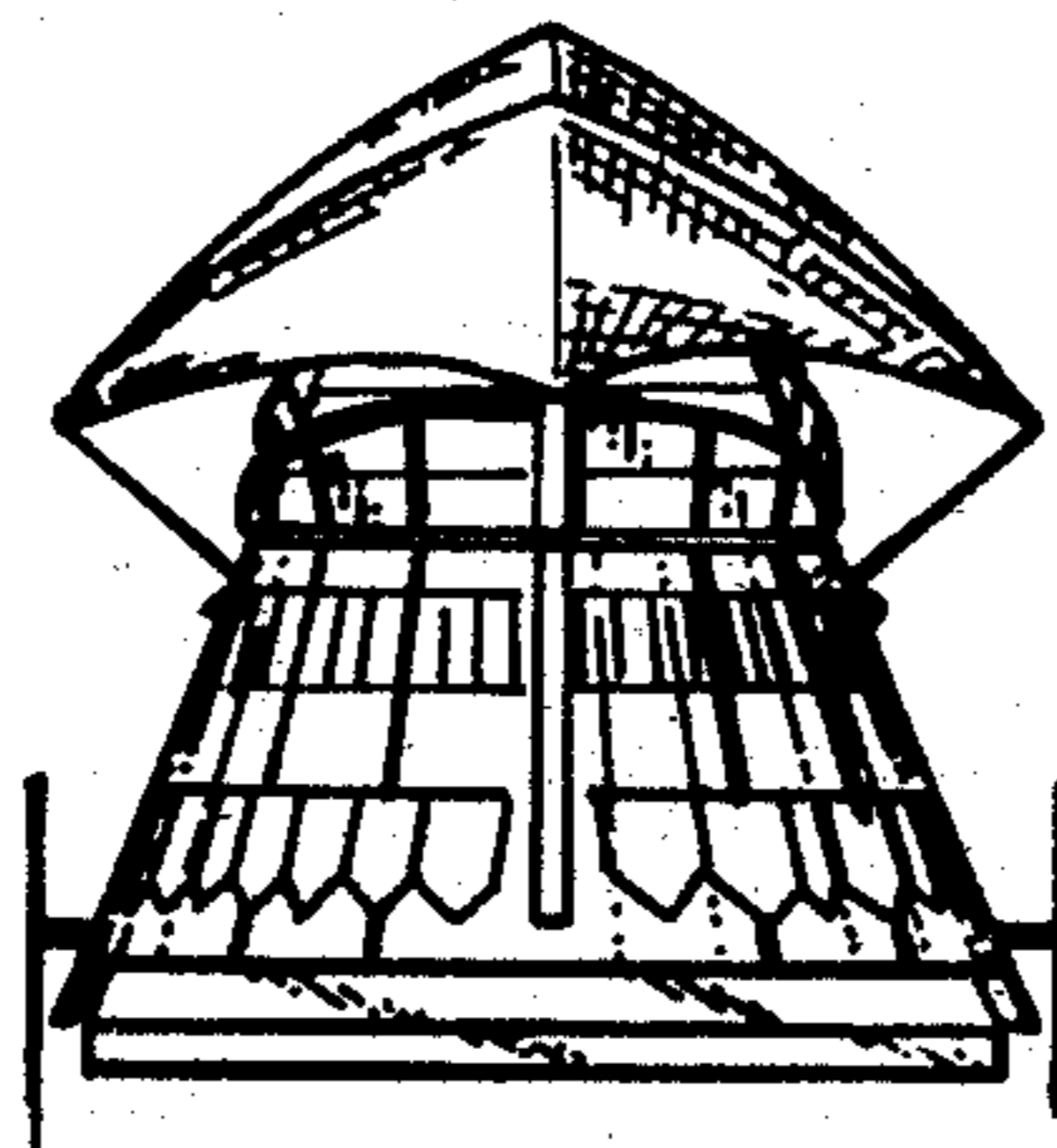

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toy vehicle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



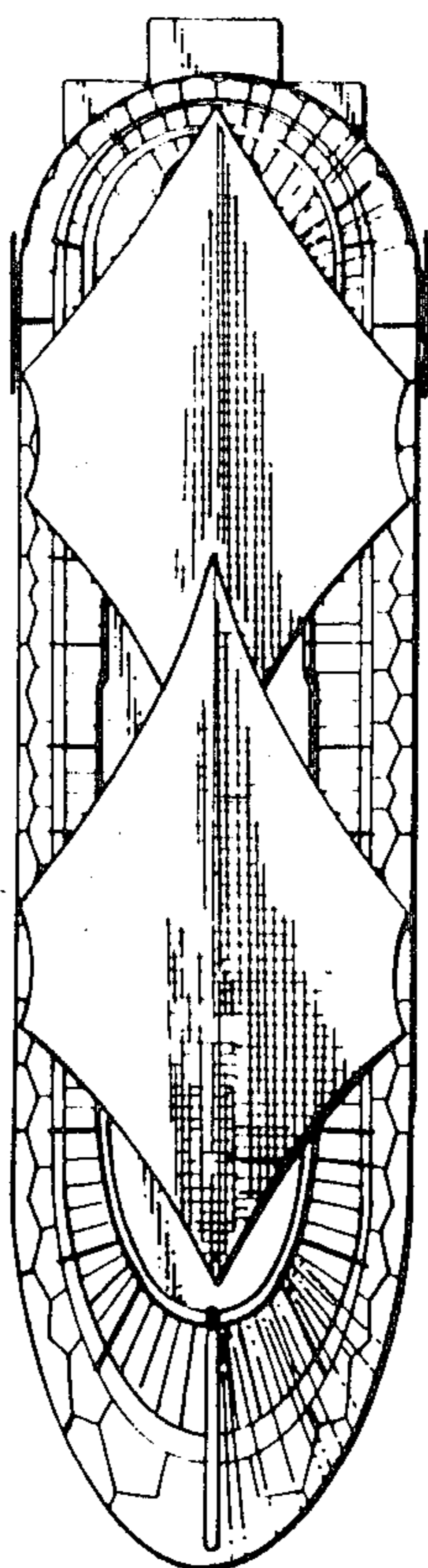

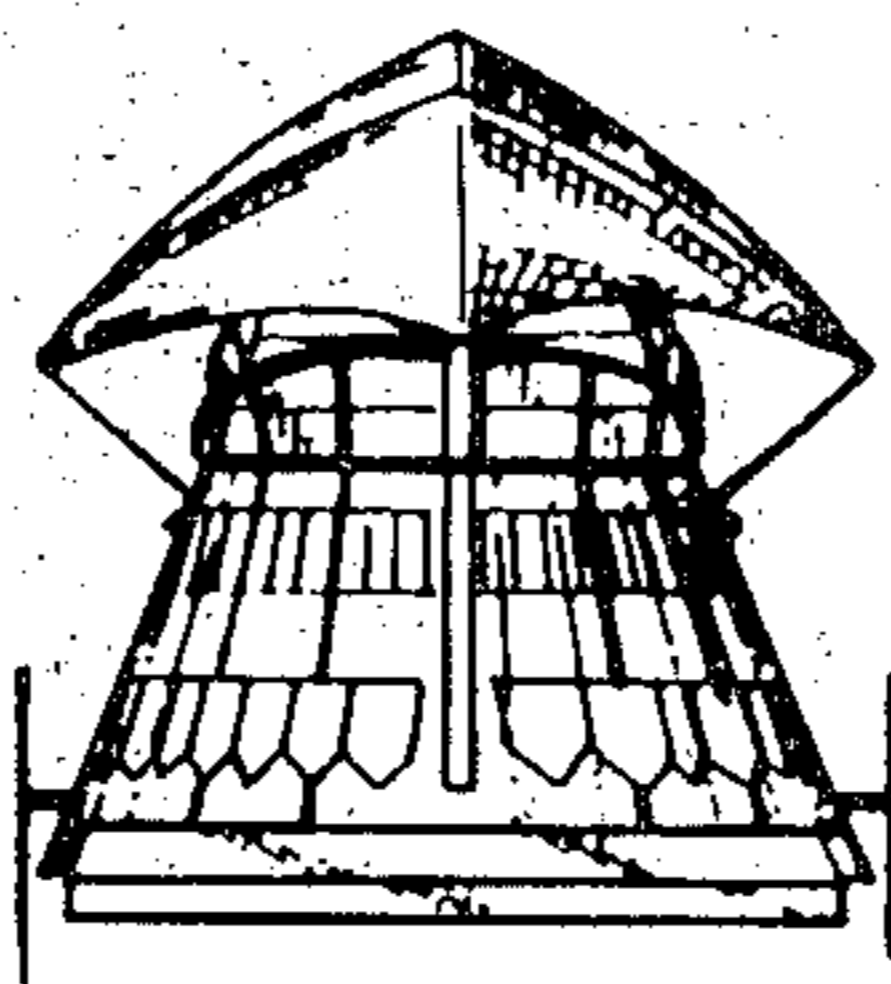

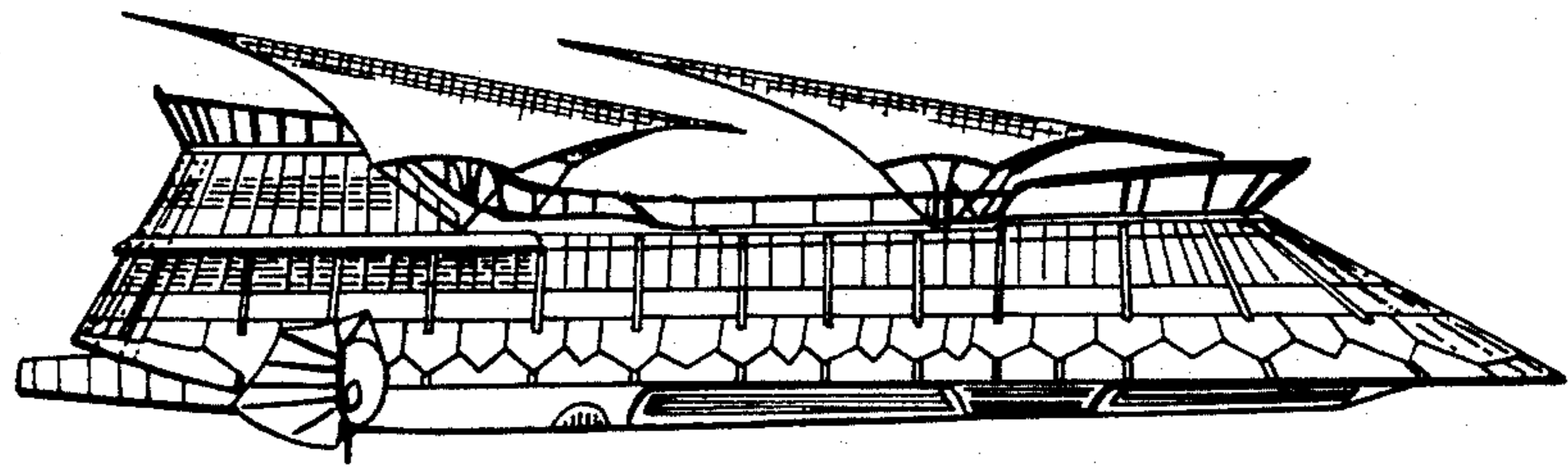

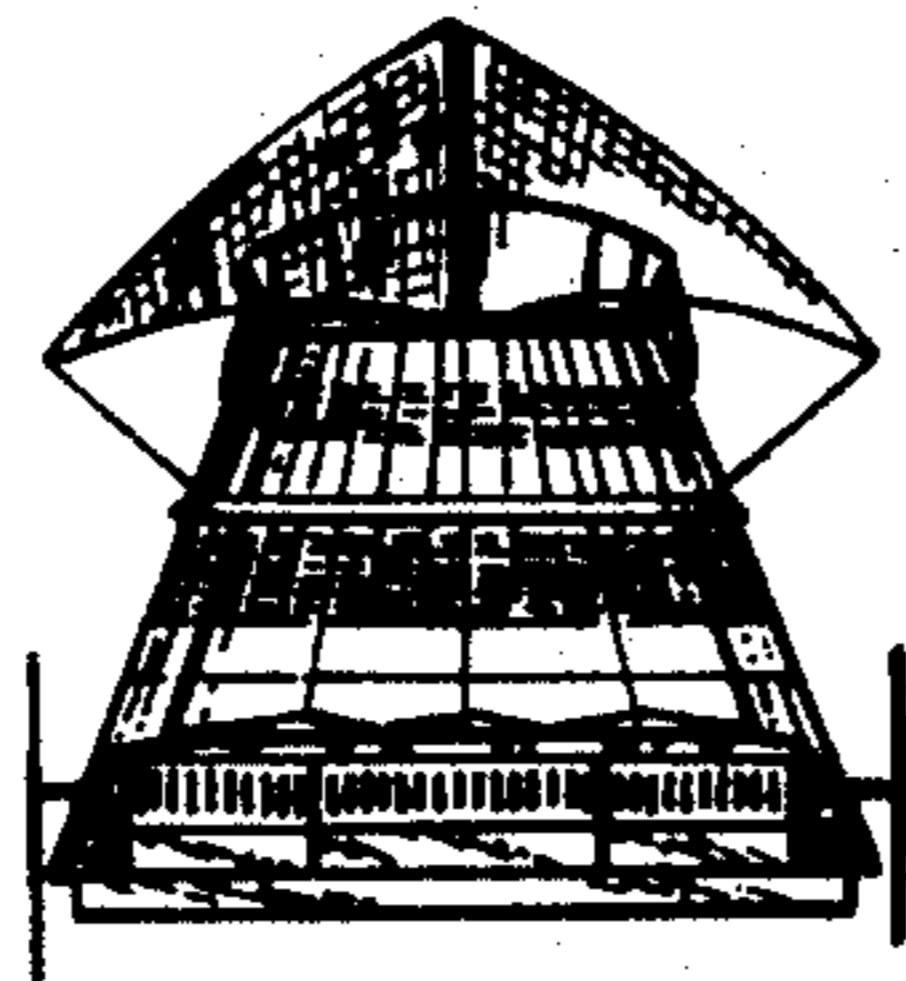

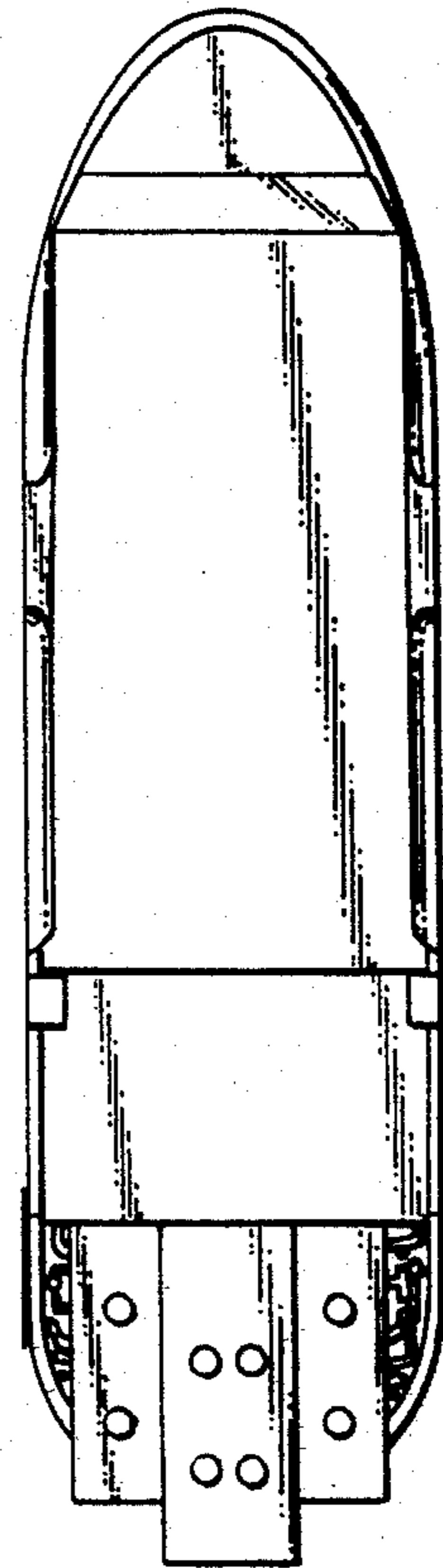
