[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wood-splitting axe, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wood-splitting axe, showing our new design, the view looking from the blade end of the axe,

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, looking from the opposite end of the axe,

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof,

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, and

FIG. 5 is an enlarged sectional view corresponding to the line 5—5 of FIG. 4.

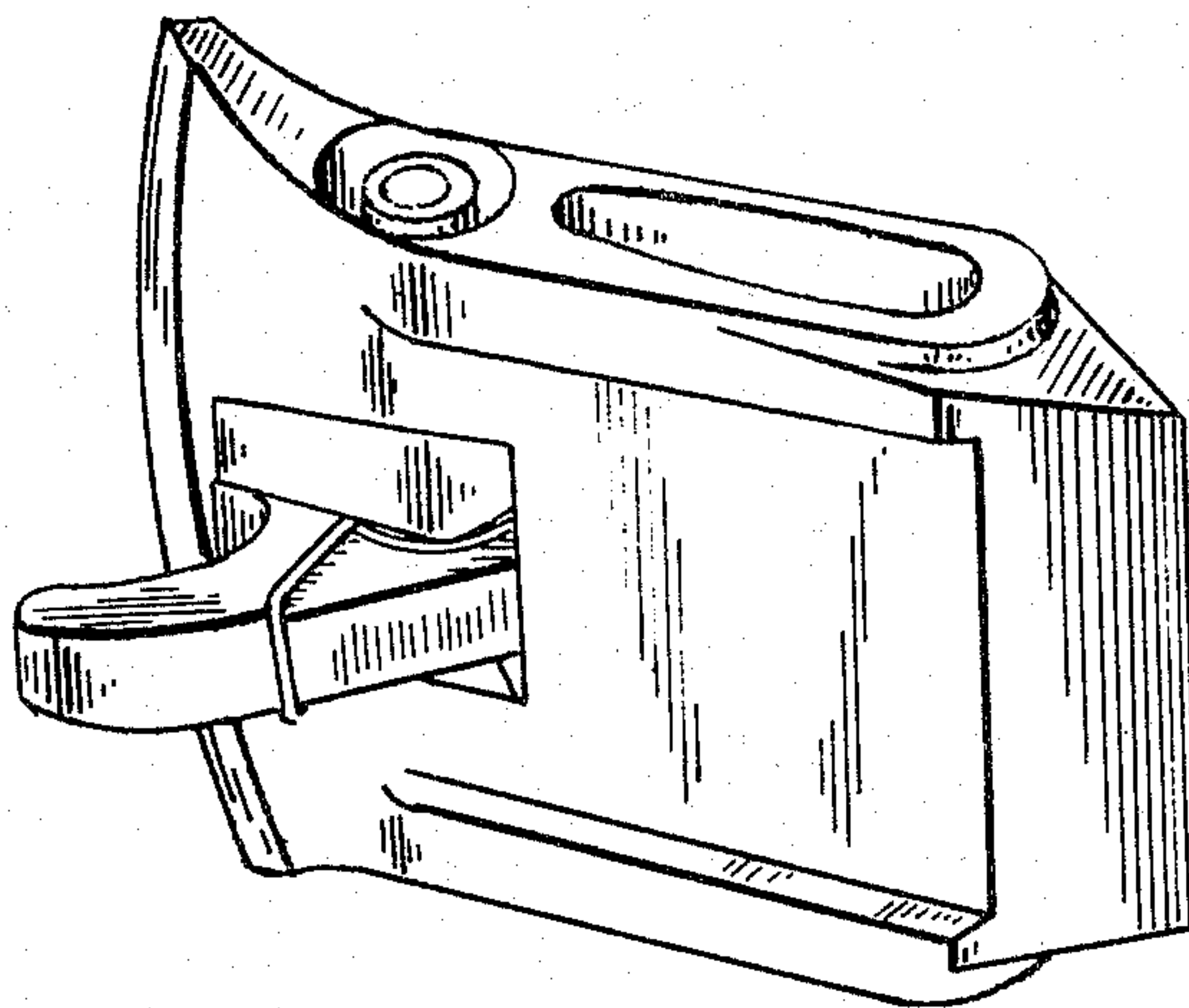

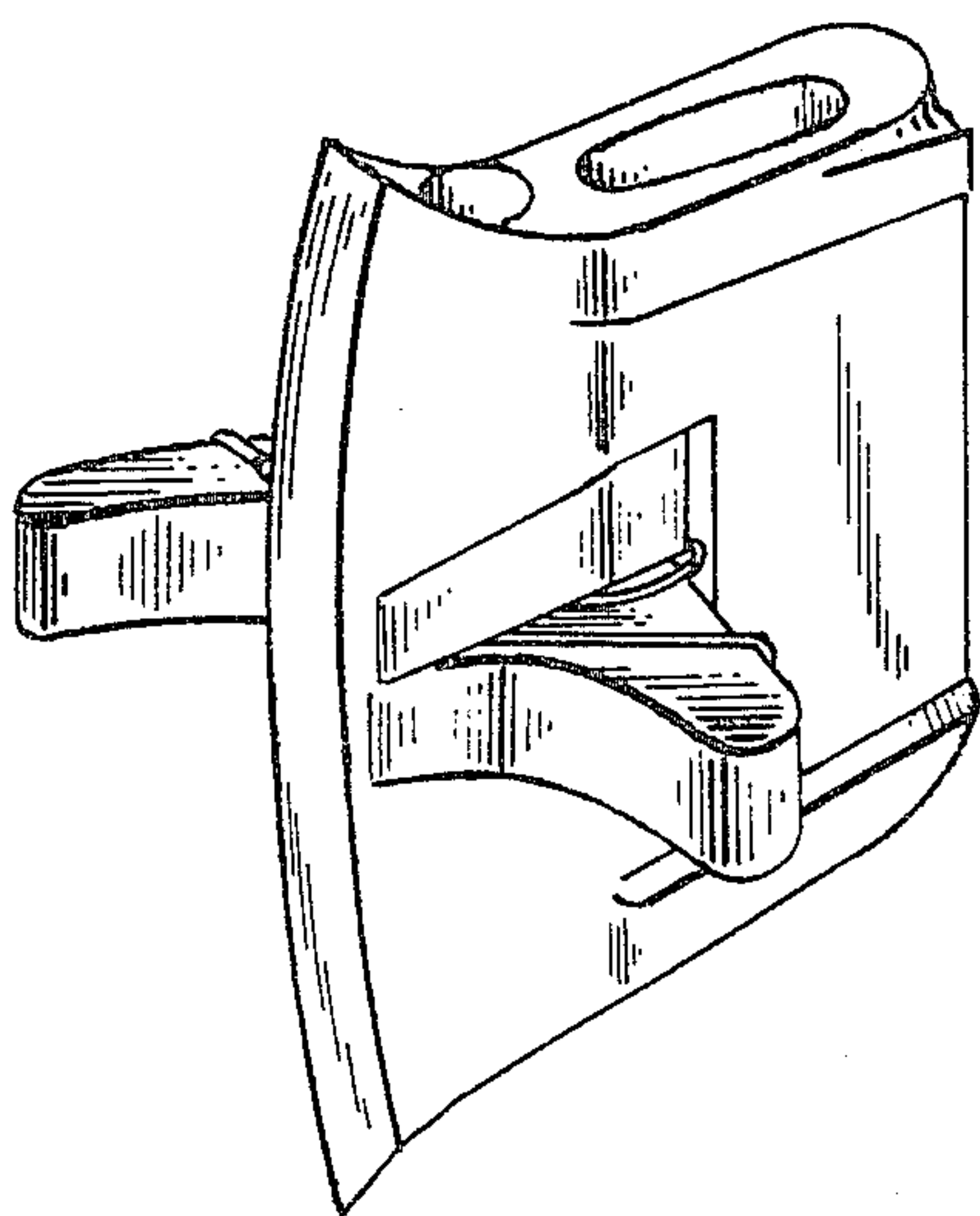

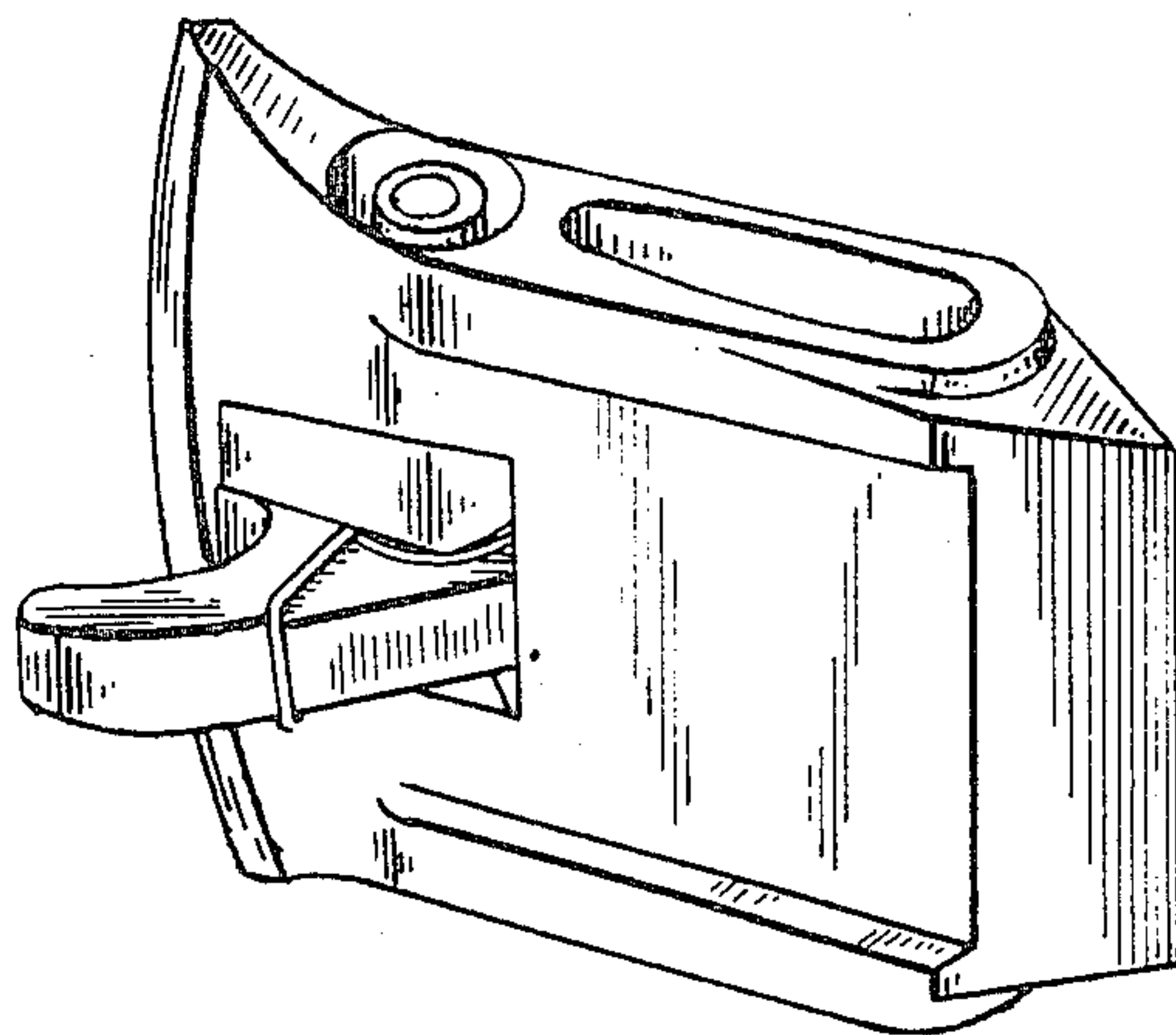

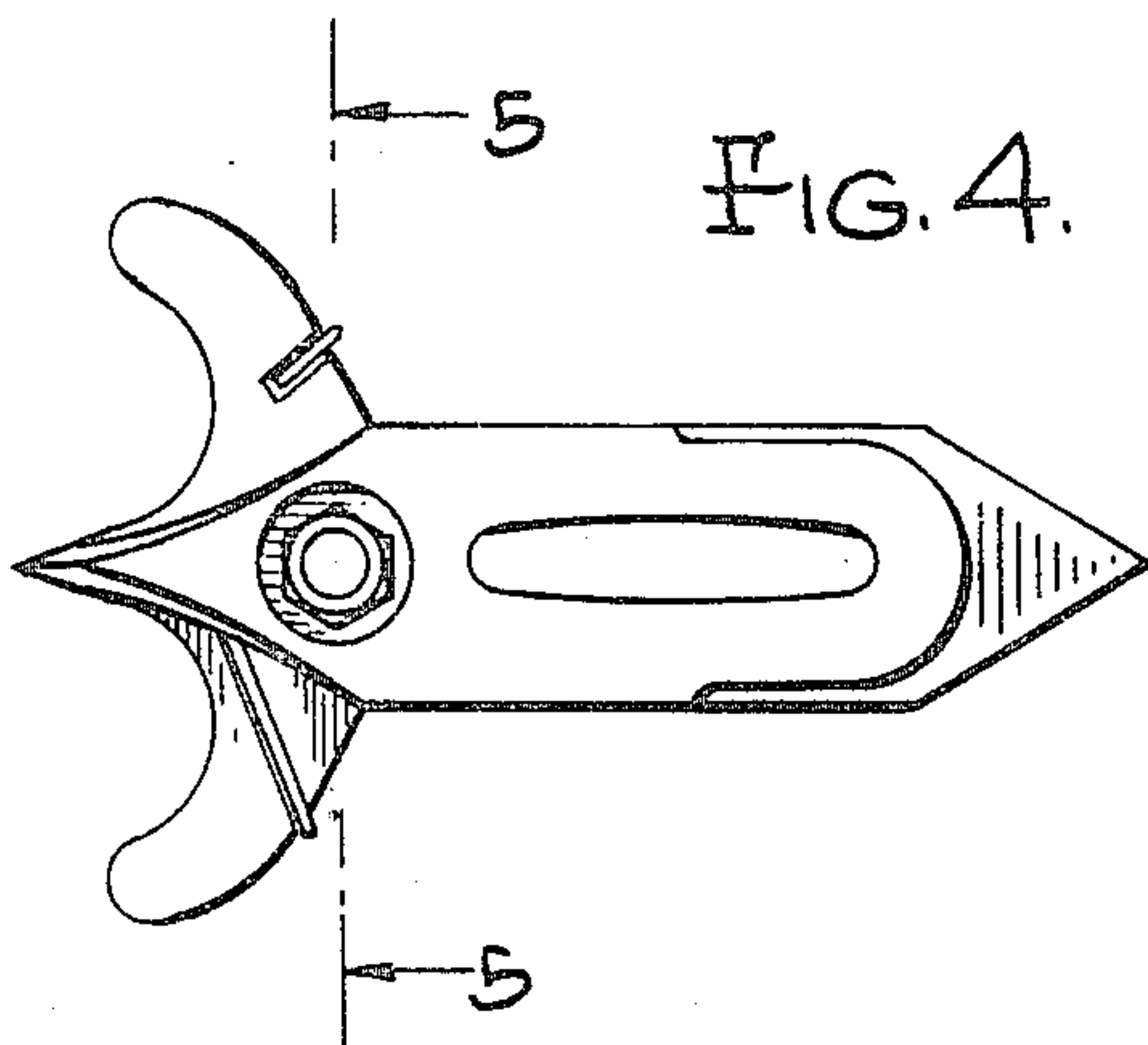

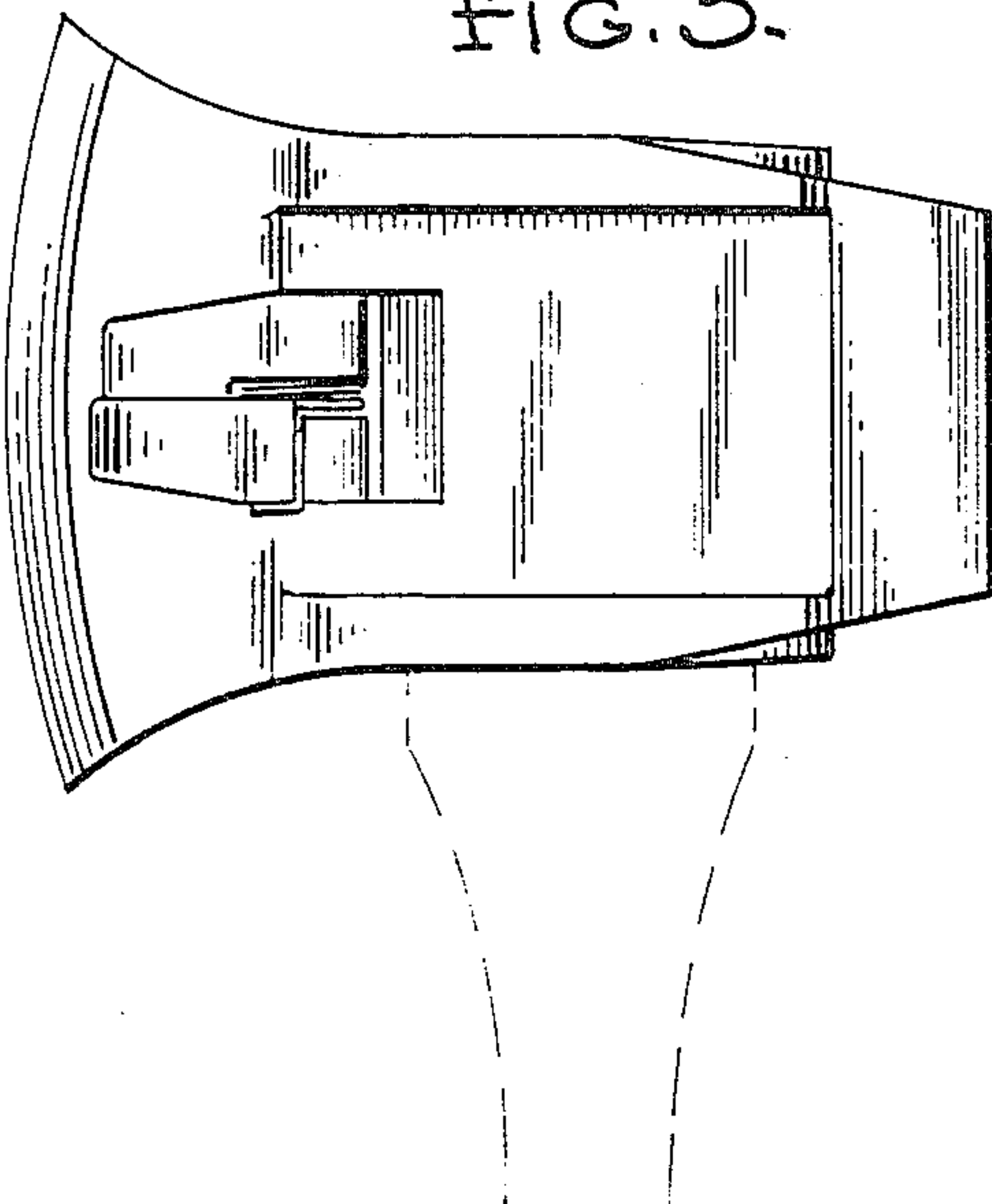
