DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of carry-on luggage showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.

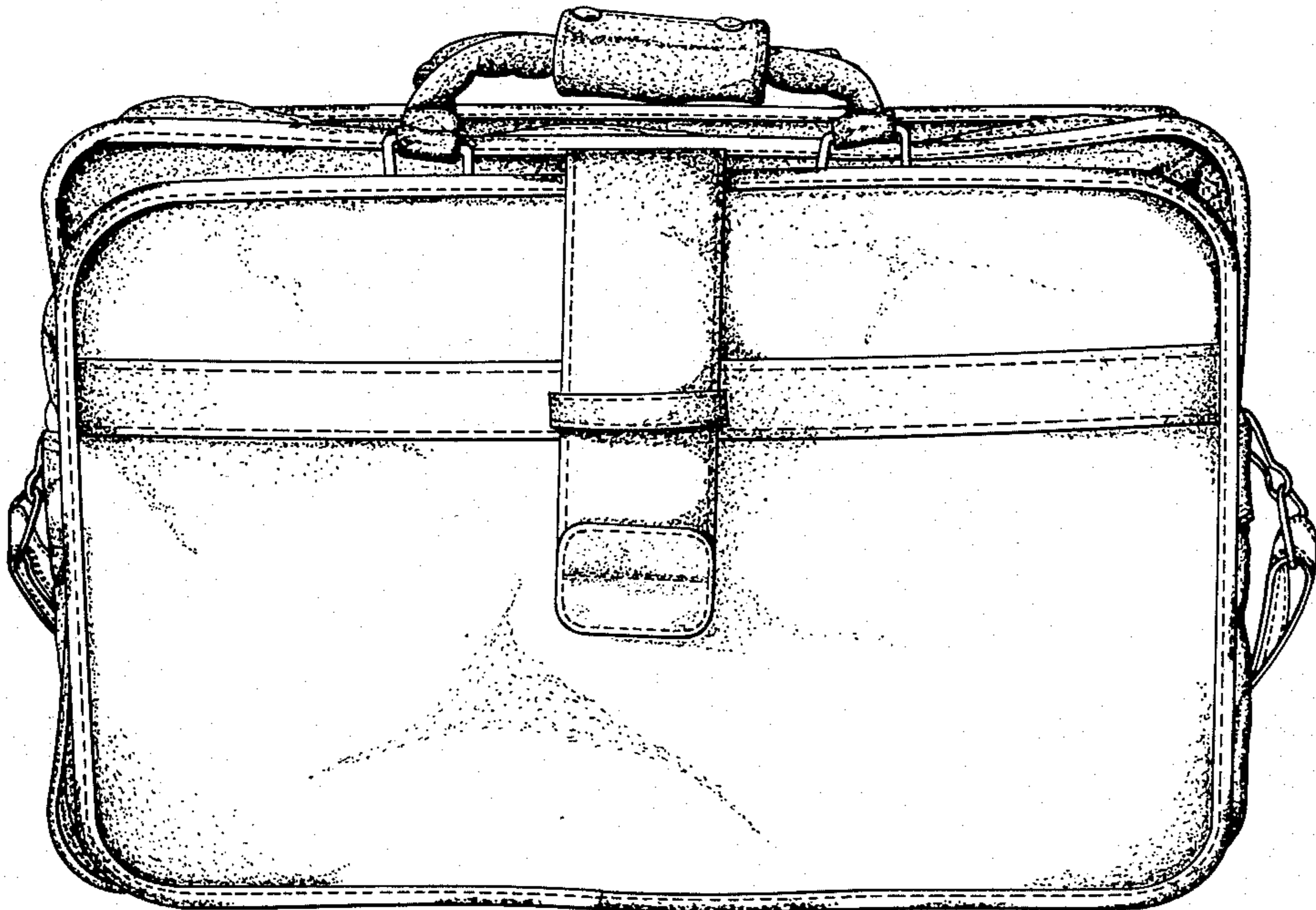

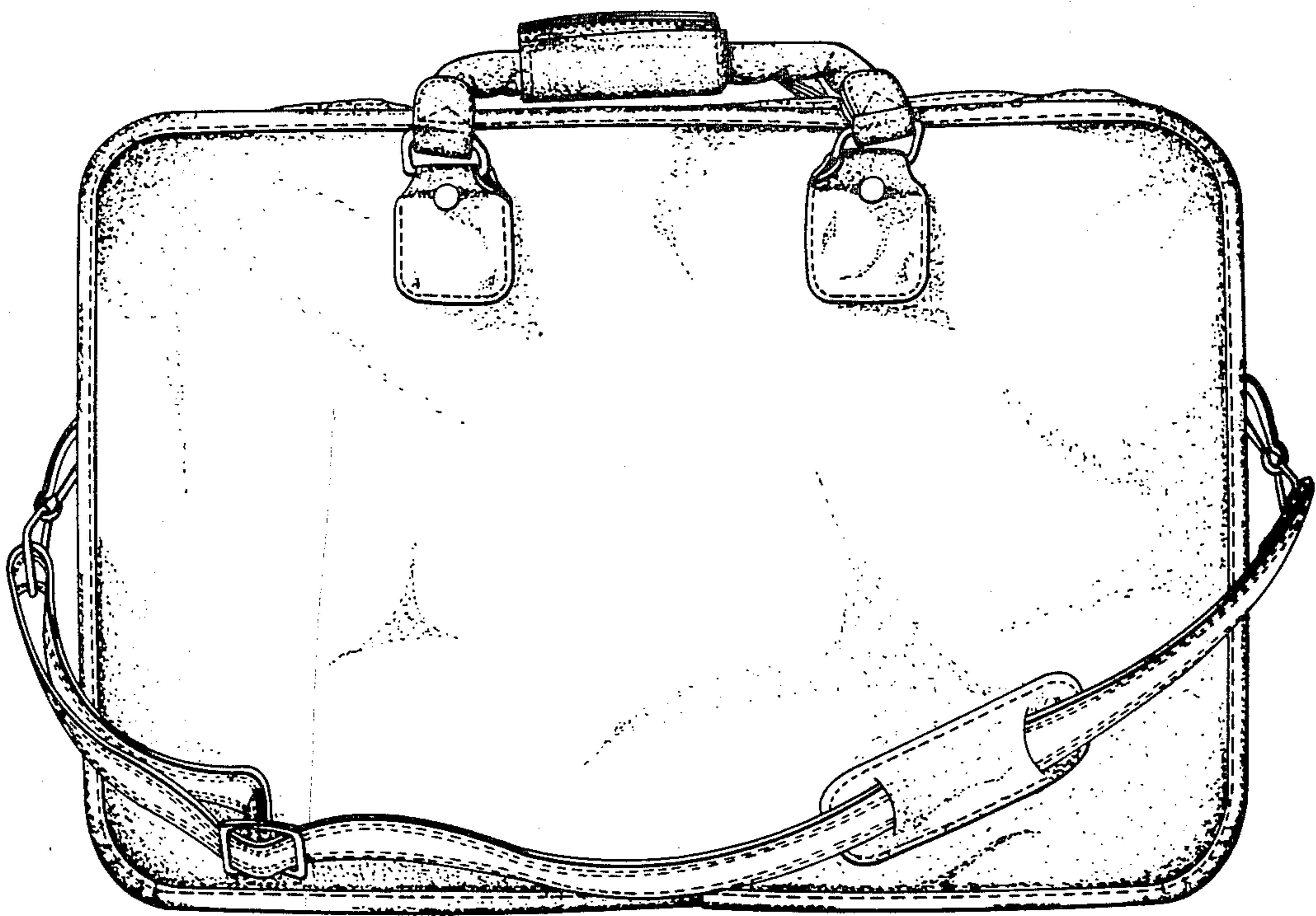
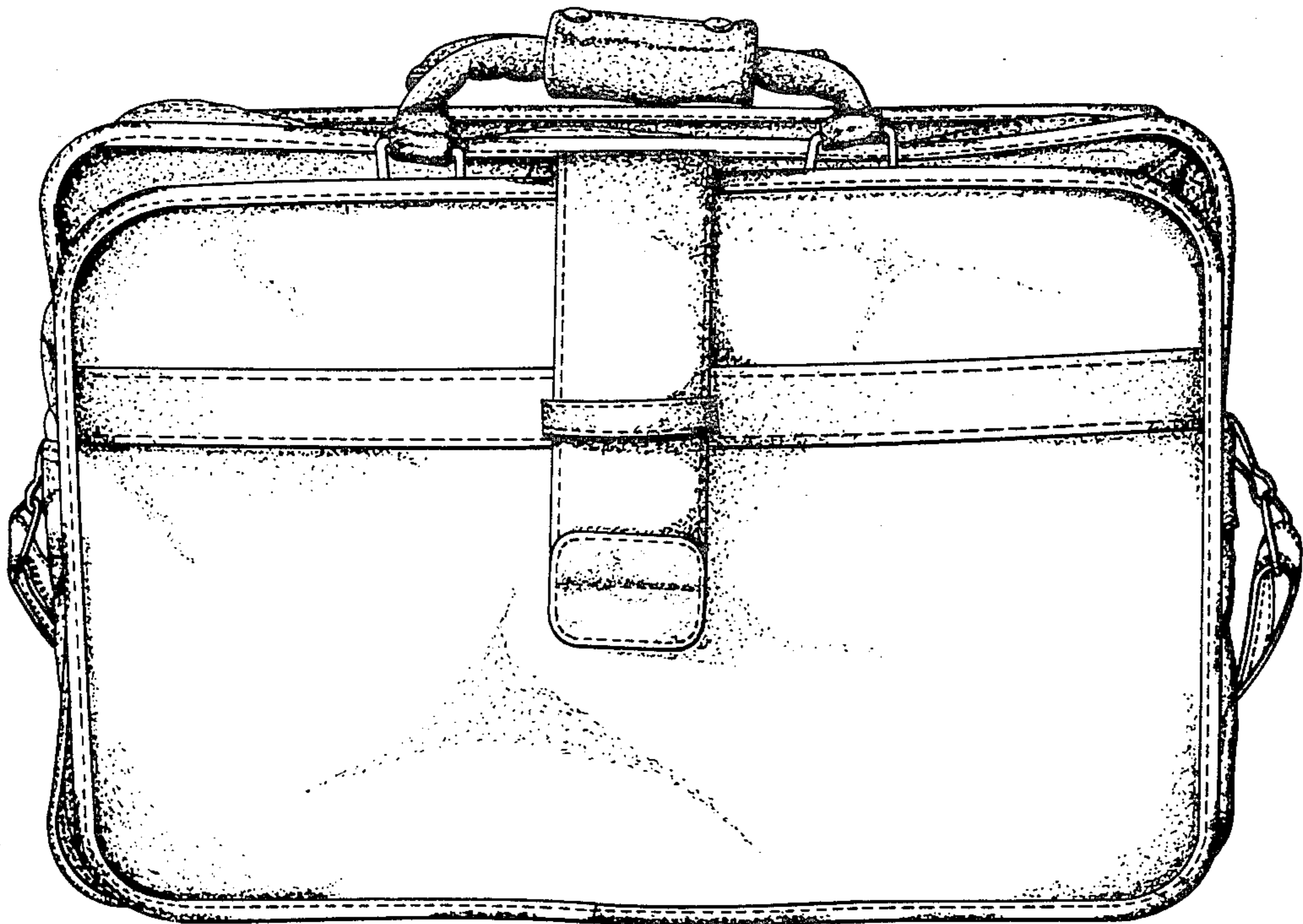

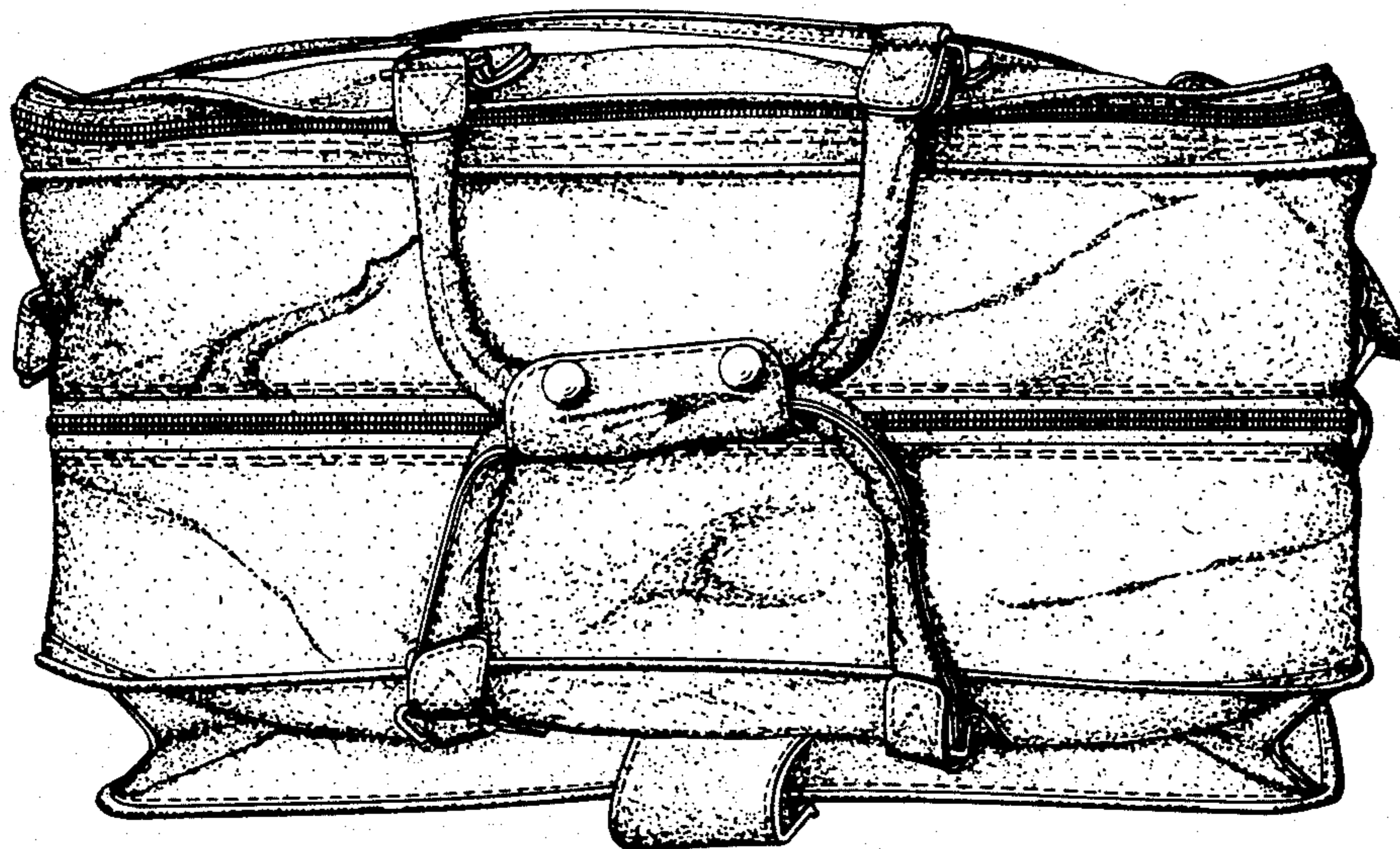

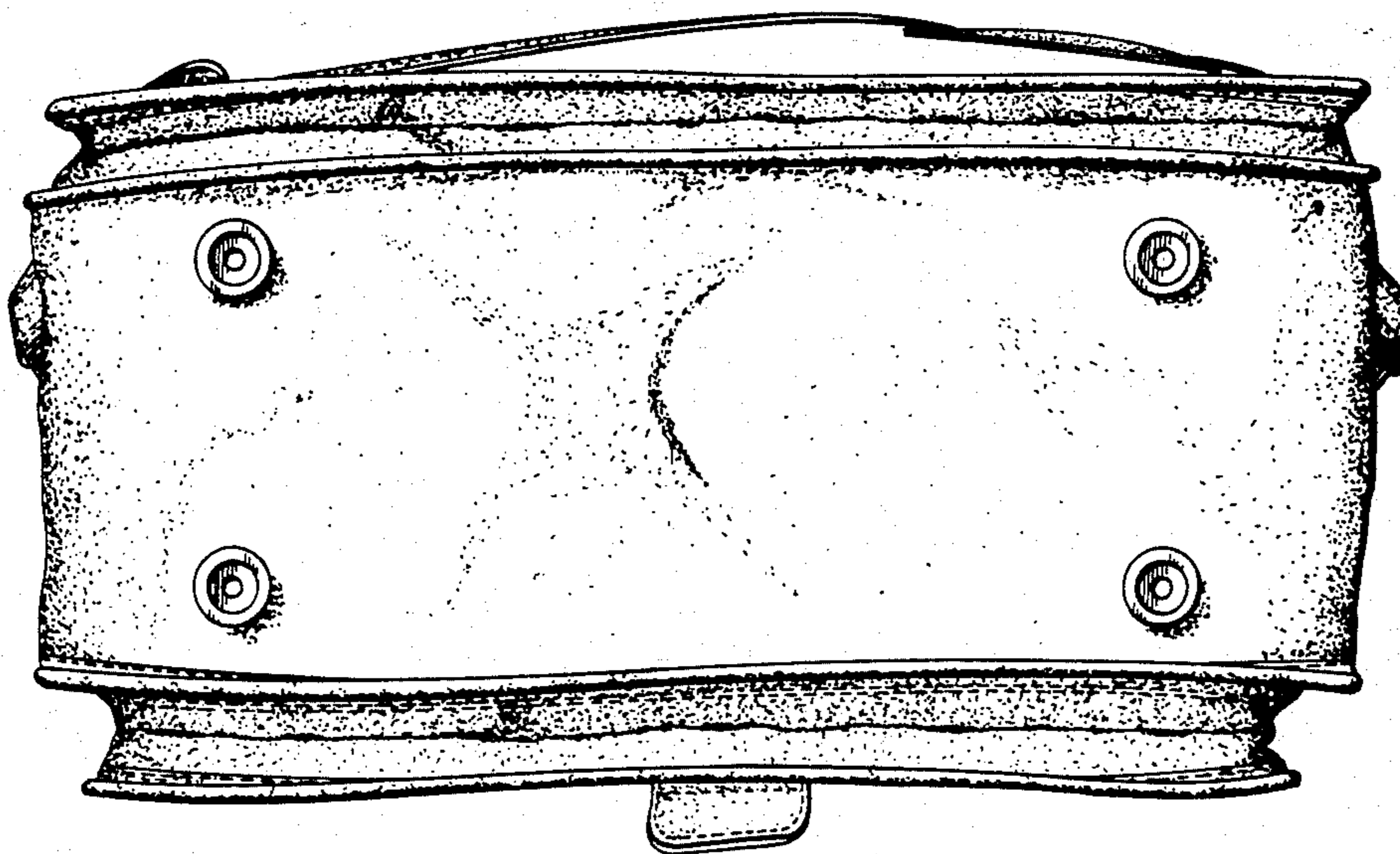

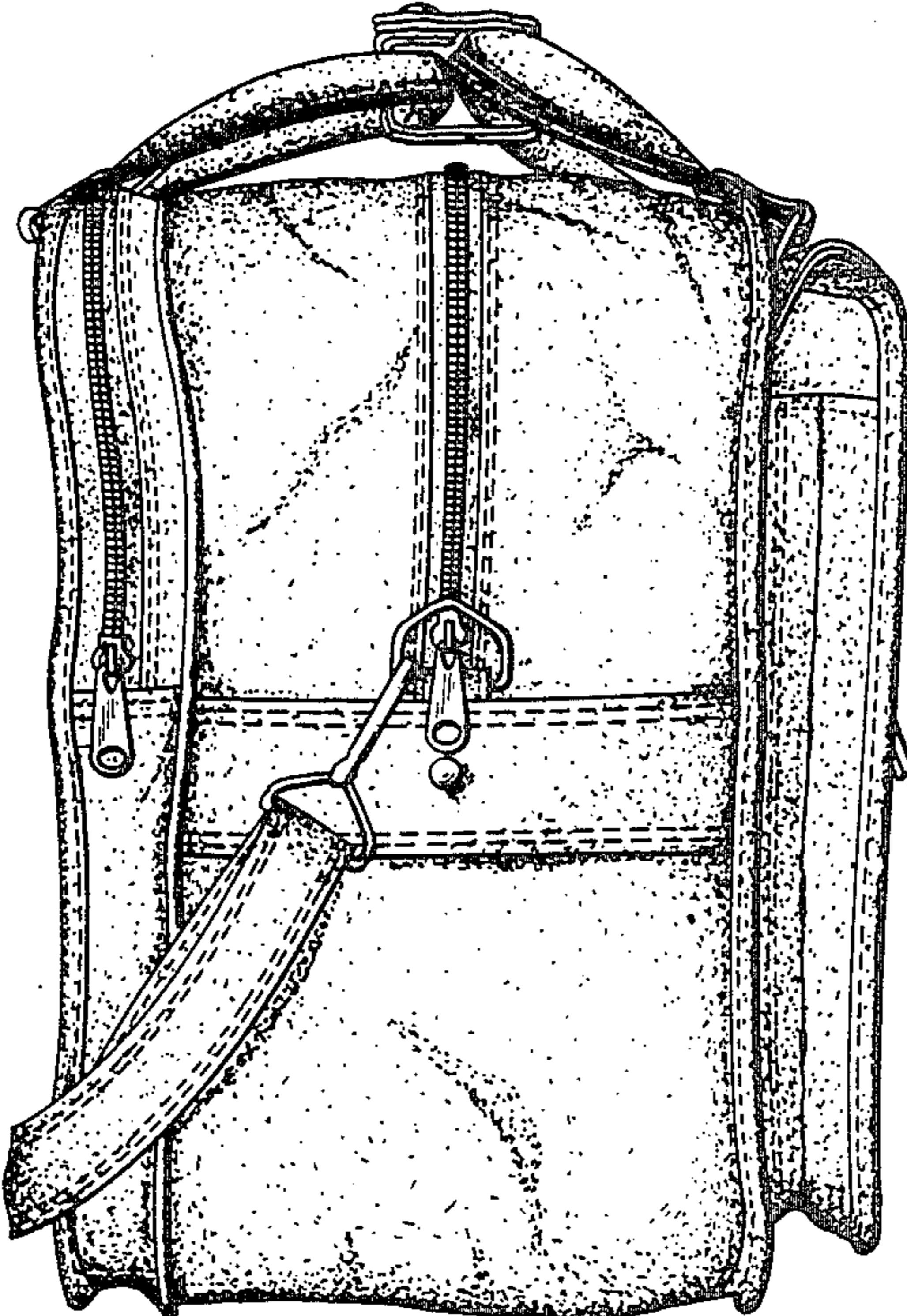
