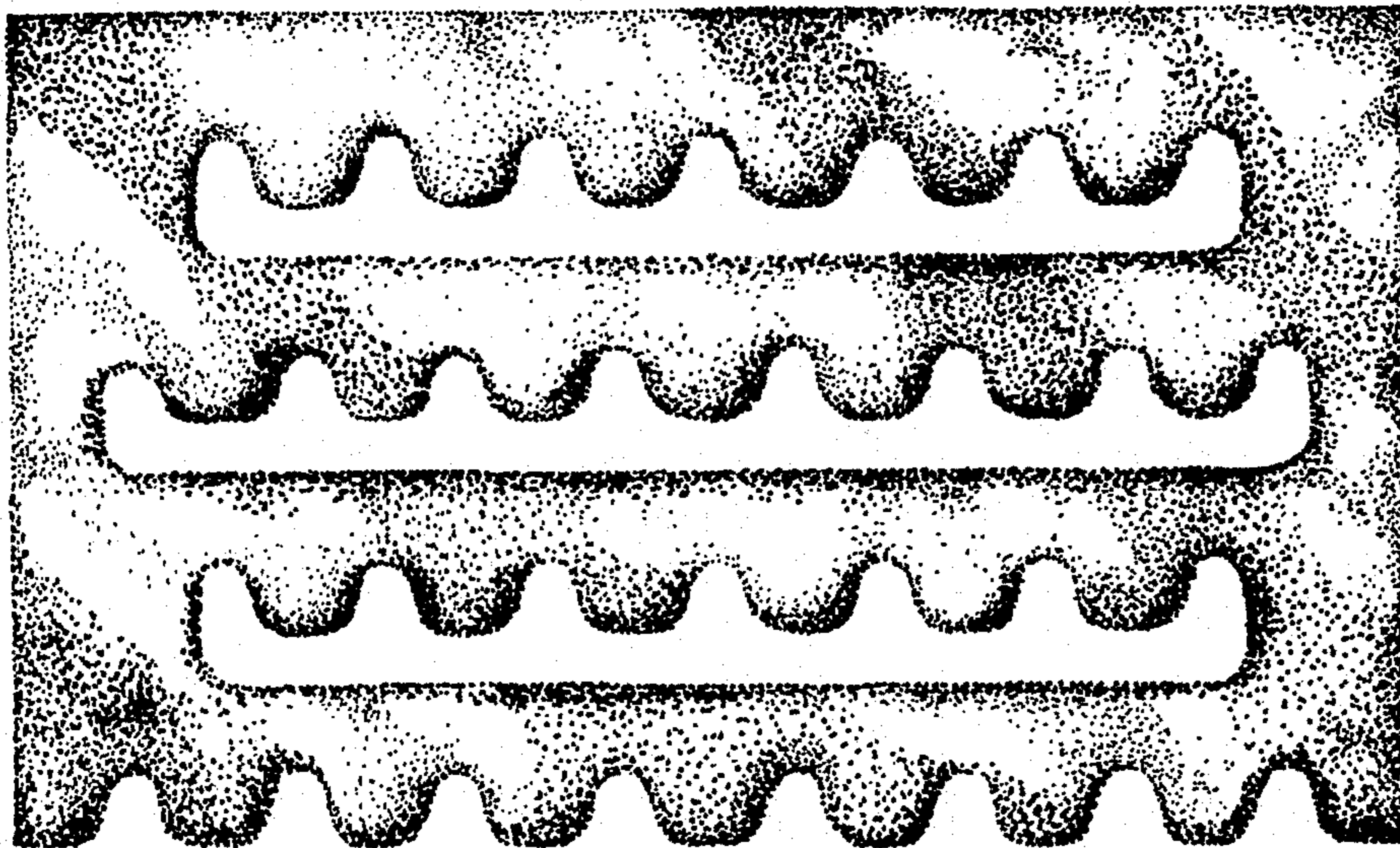

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an interior shelf for a security safe, gun cabinet, vault or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of the shelf;
FIG. 2 is an elevational front view of the shelf;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the left side of the shelf;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the right side of the shelf;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the shelf; and
FIG. 6 is an elevational back view of the shelf.



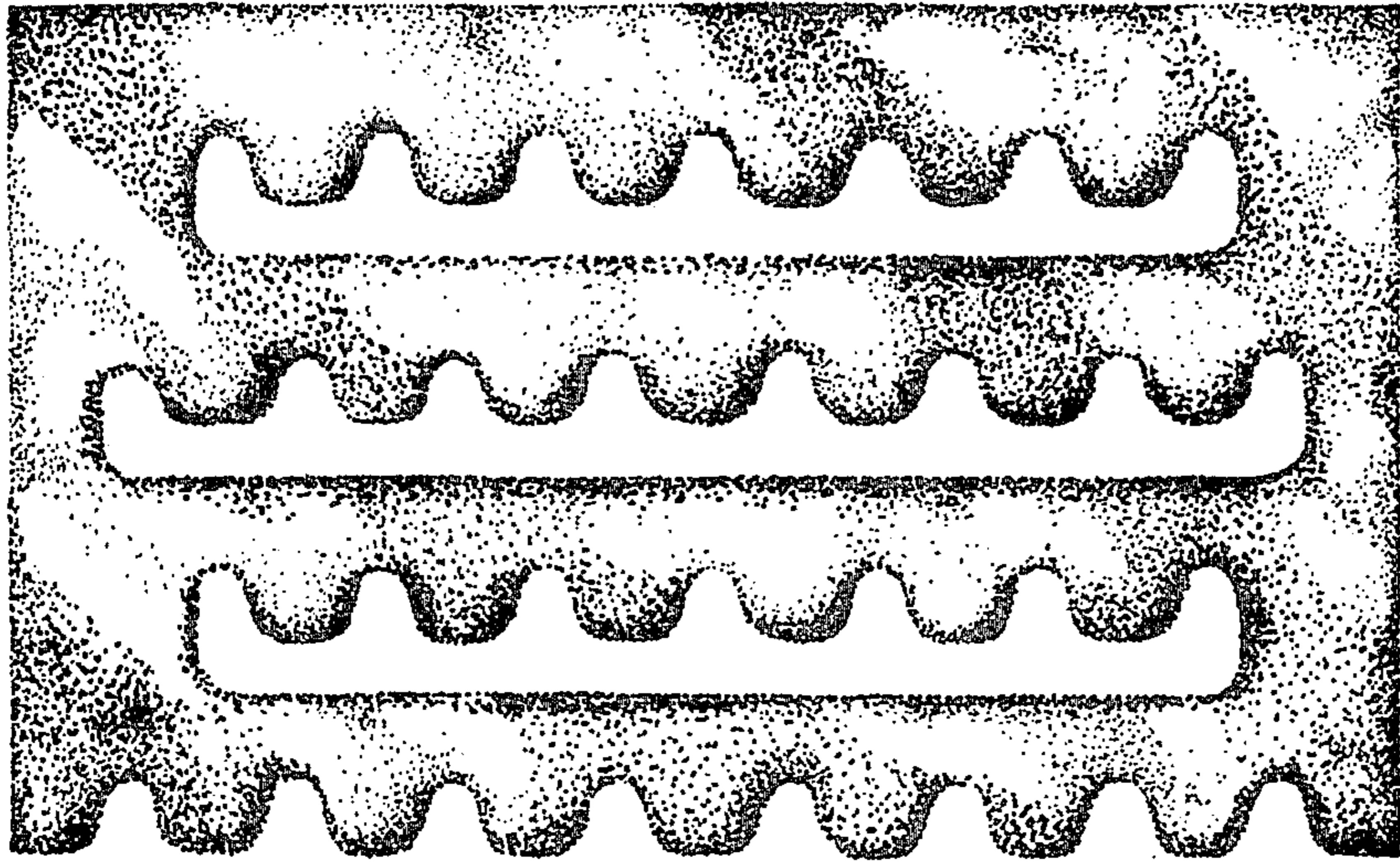

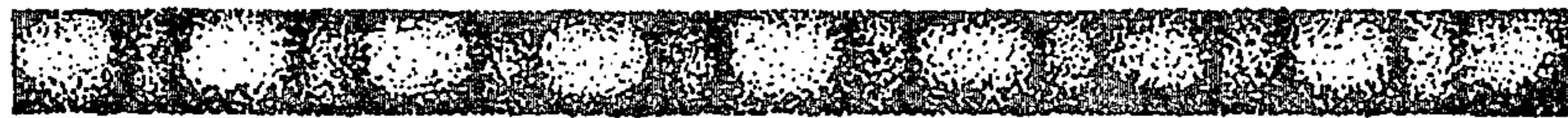

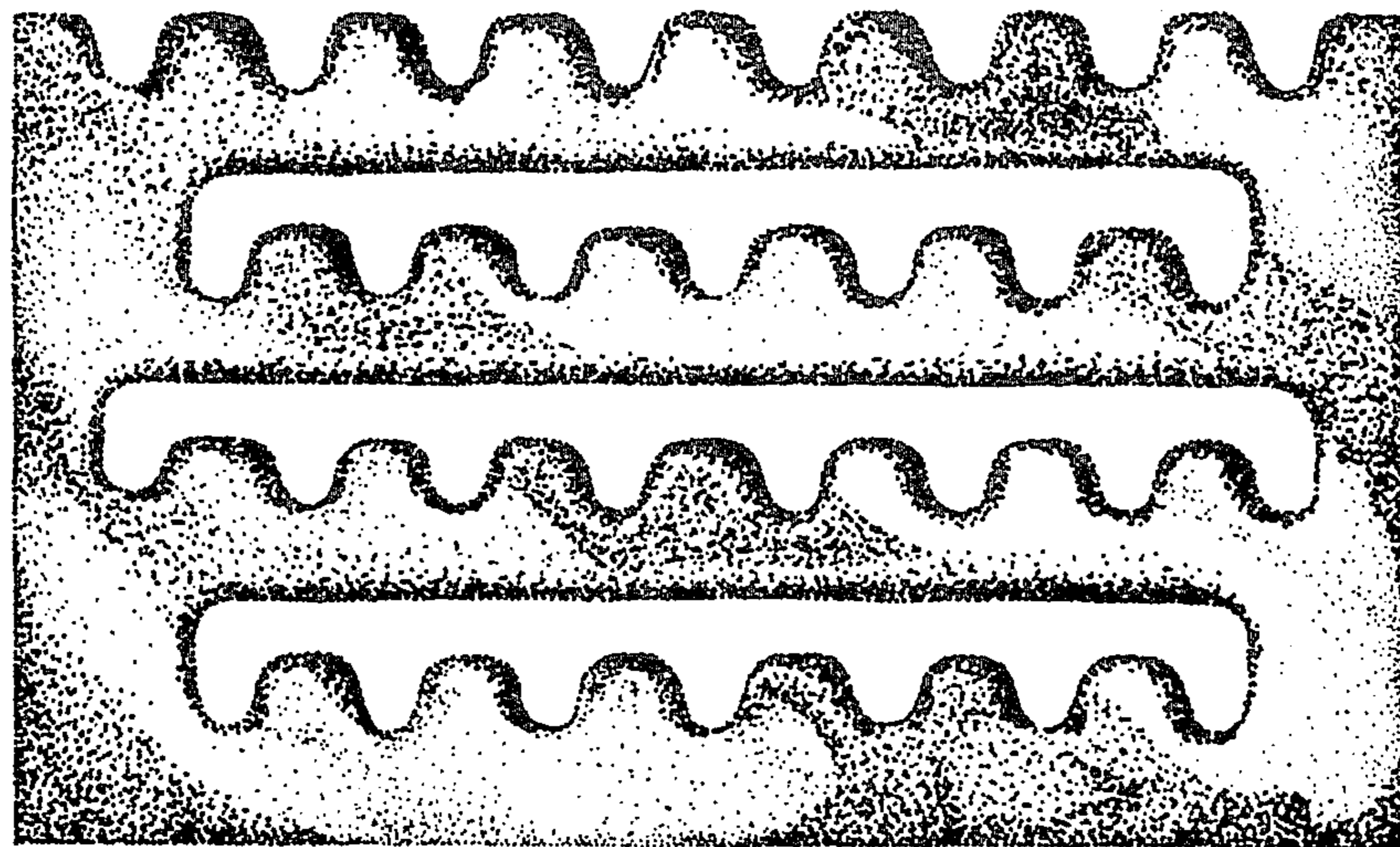
