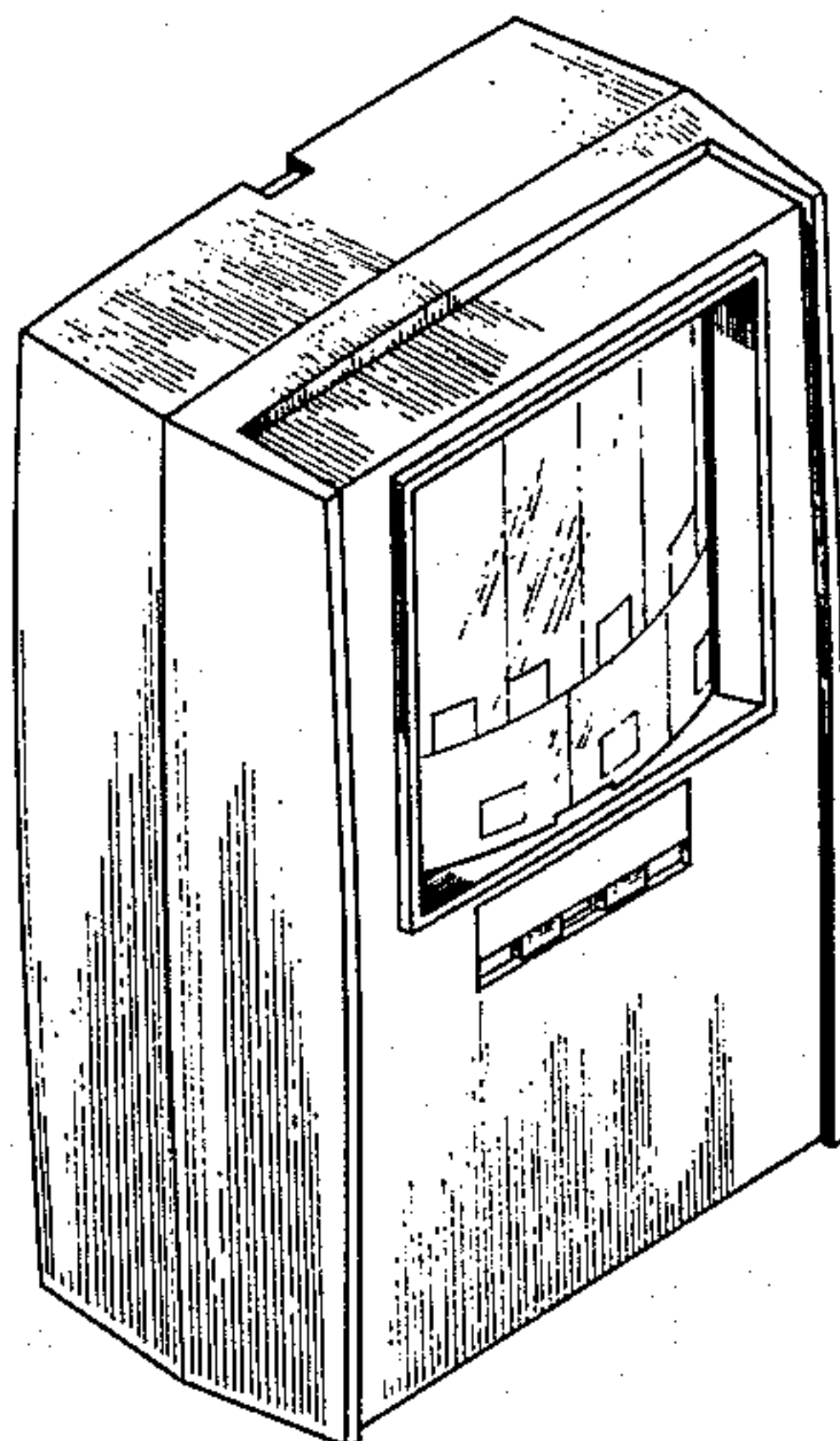

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.



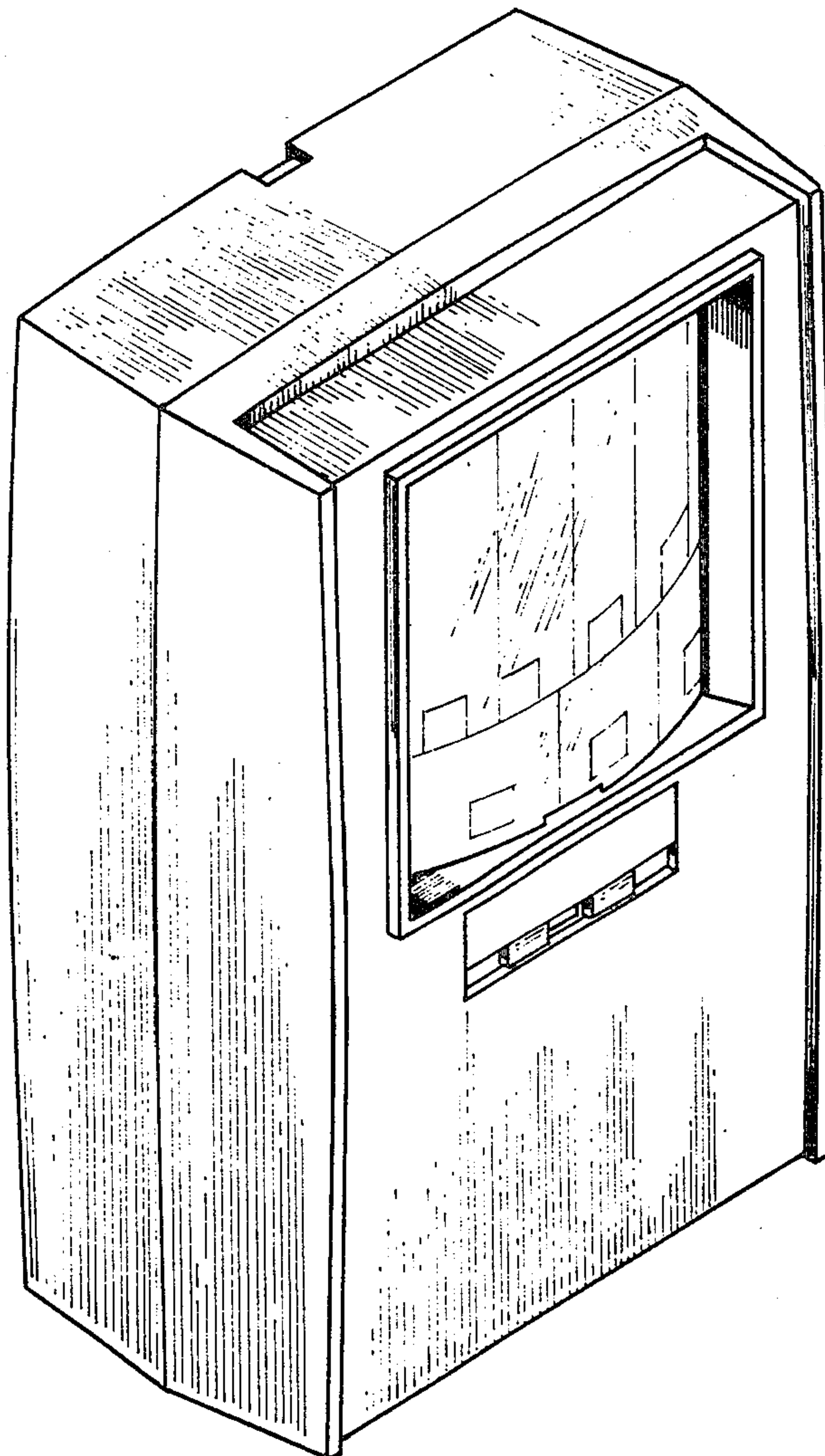

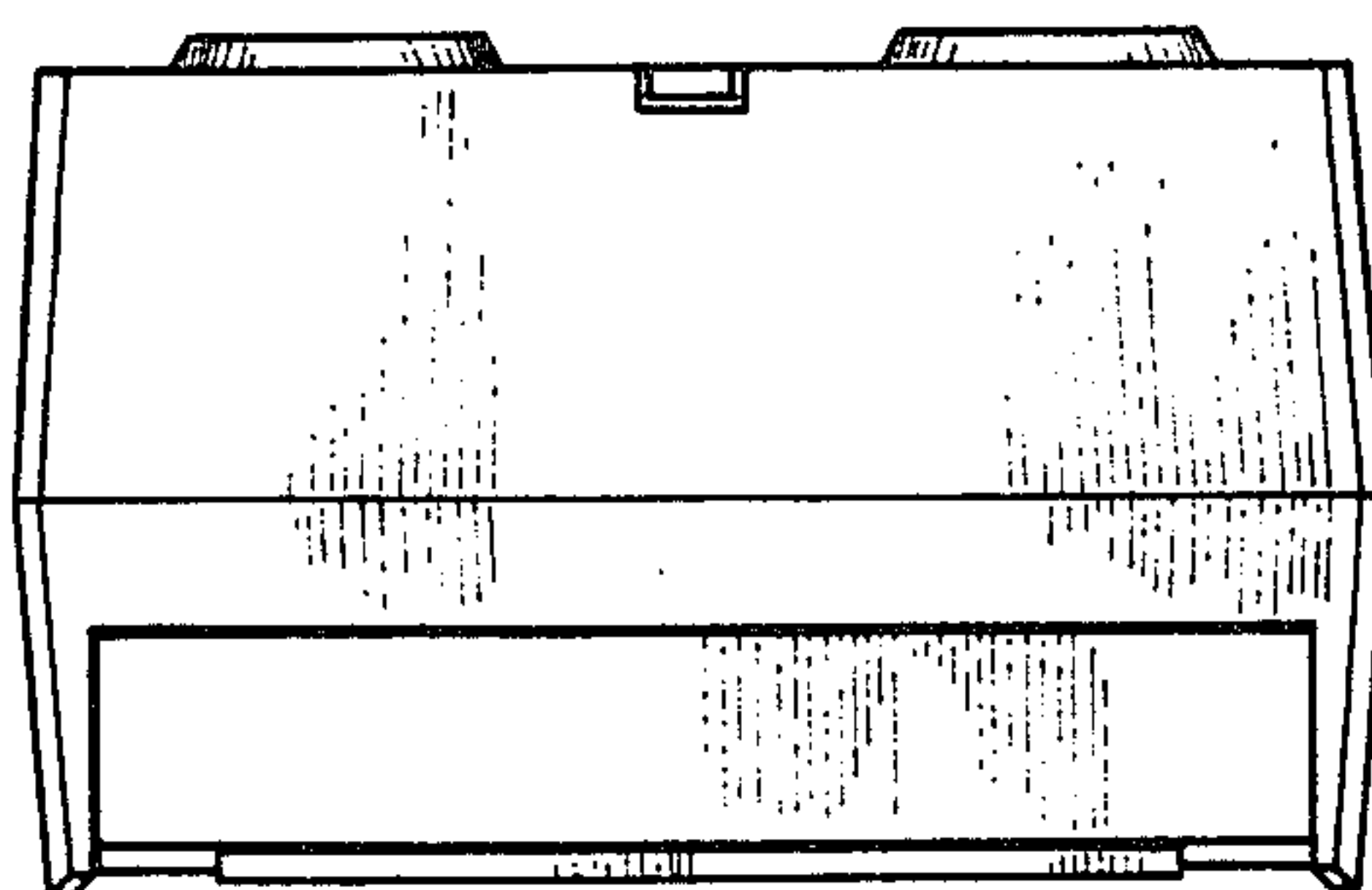

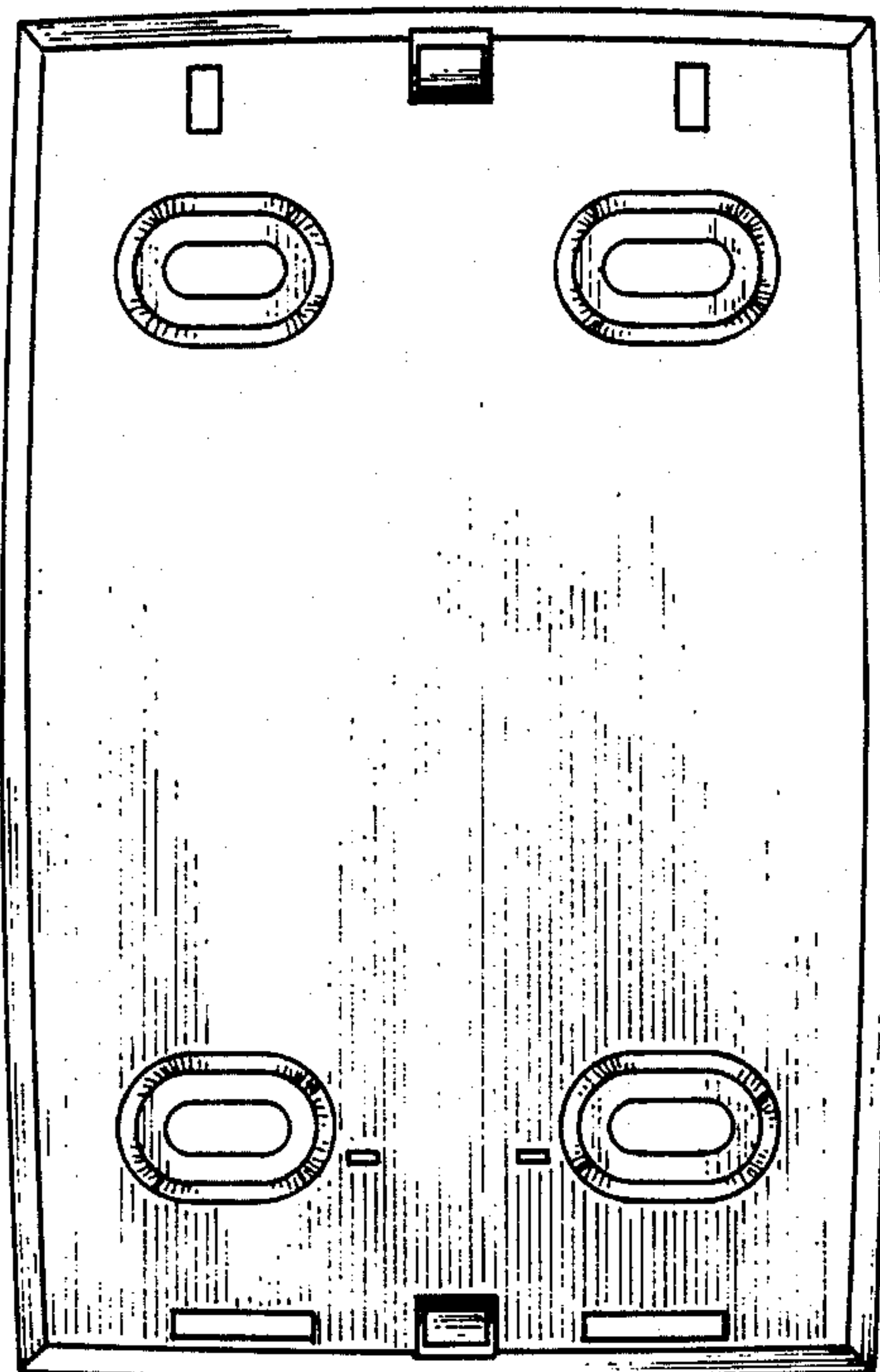

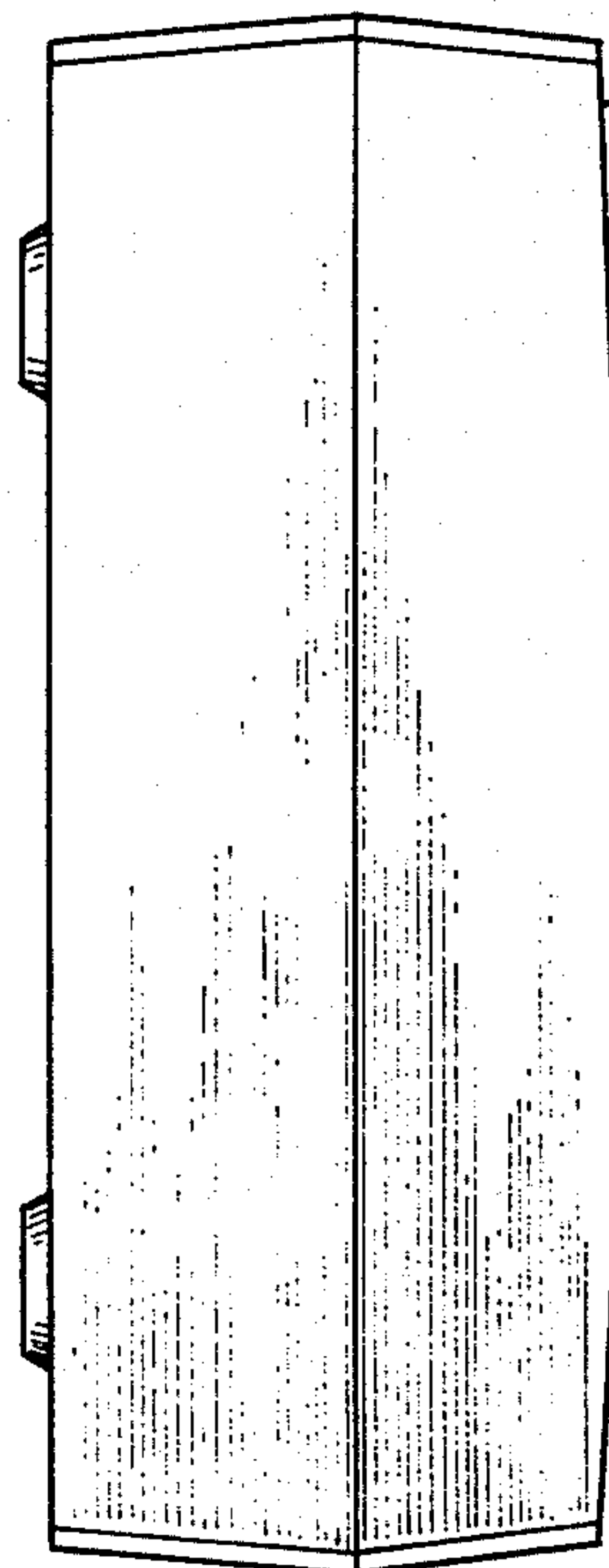

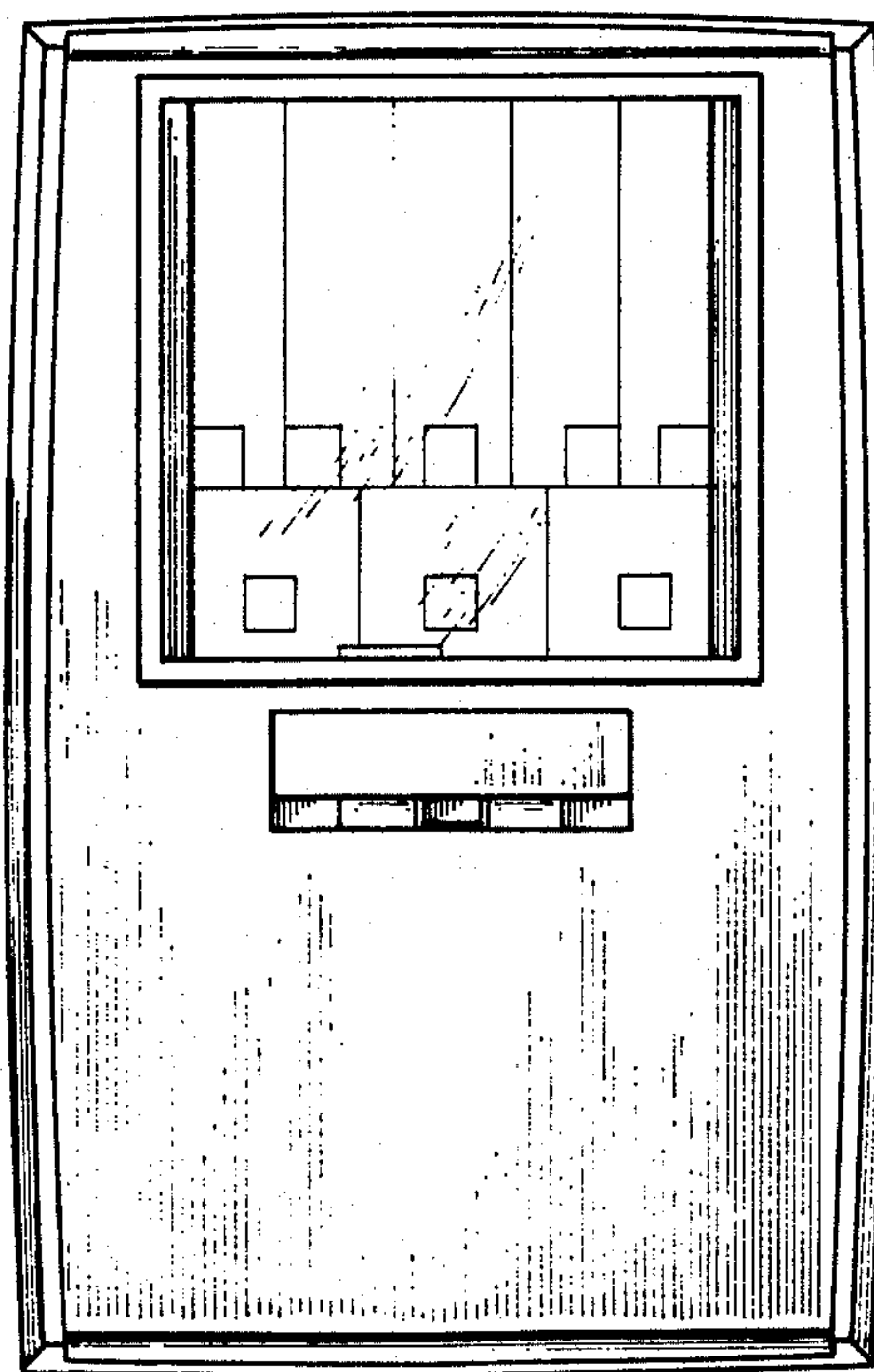
