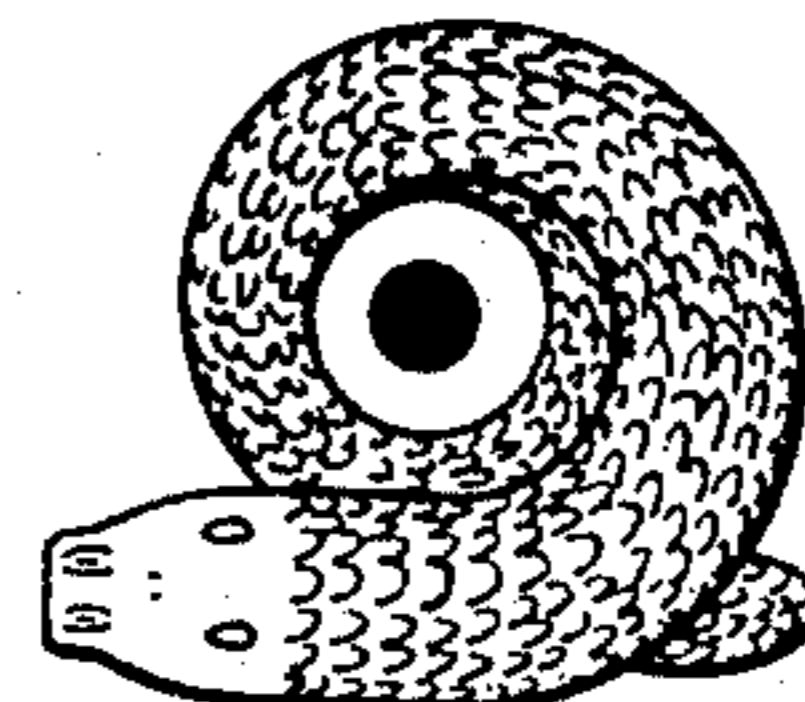
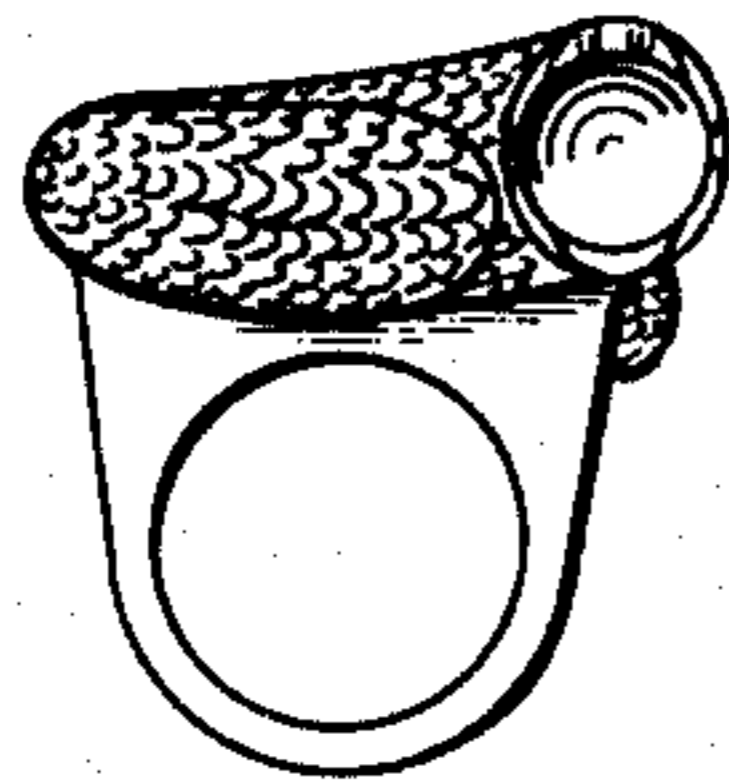

FIG. 1 is a top view of a combined ring and article holder showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view, the broken line showing of a writing implement being illustrative of environment only.



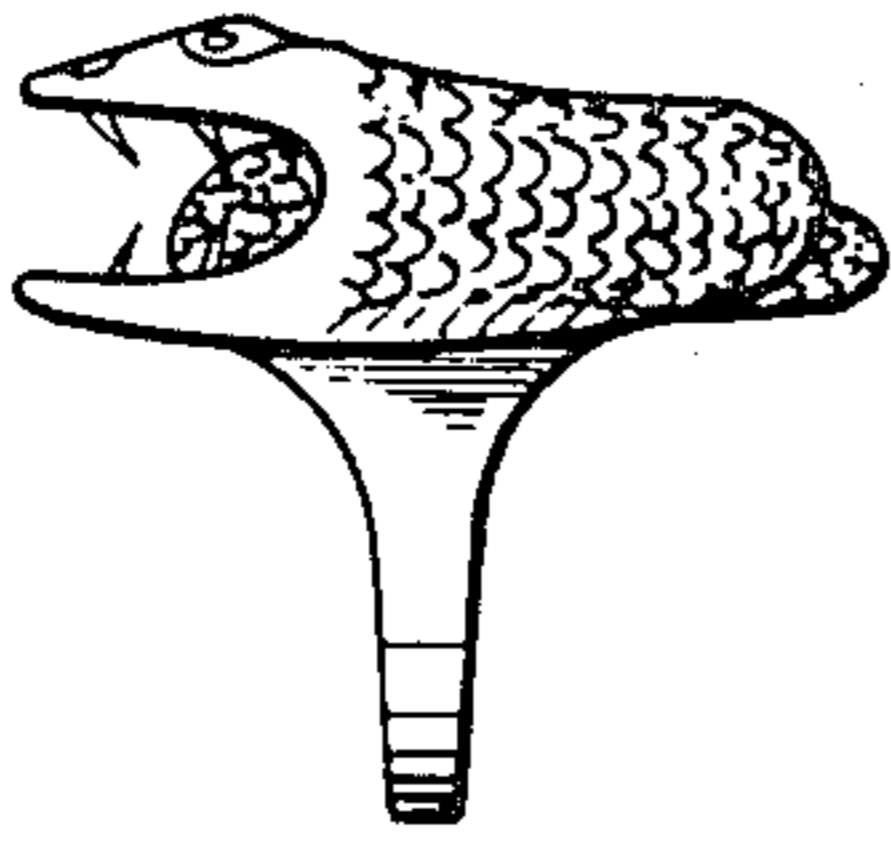

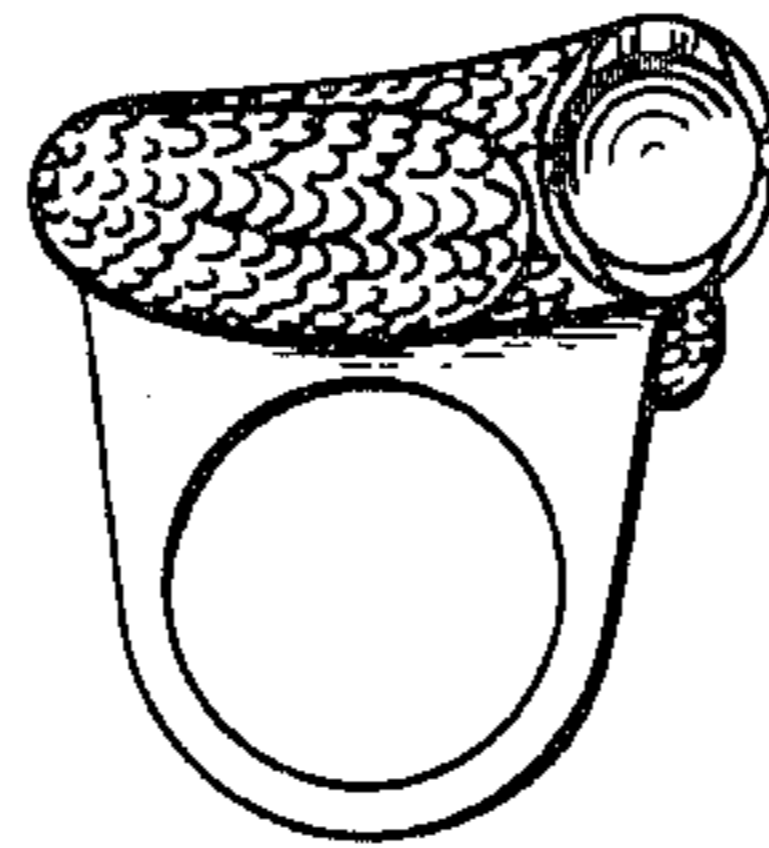

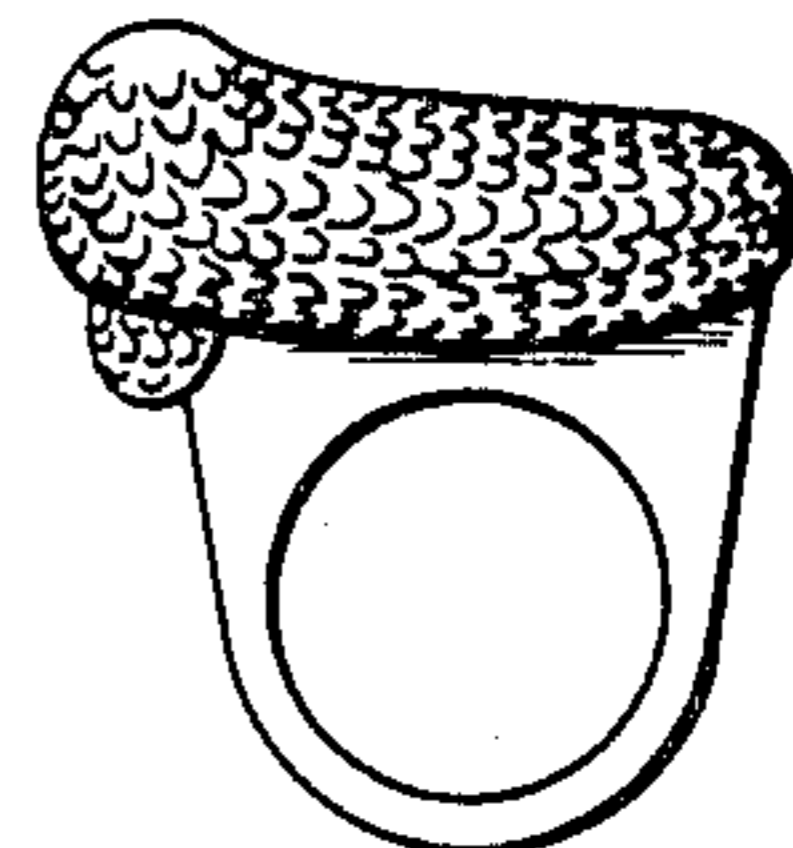

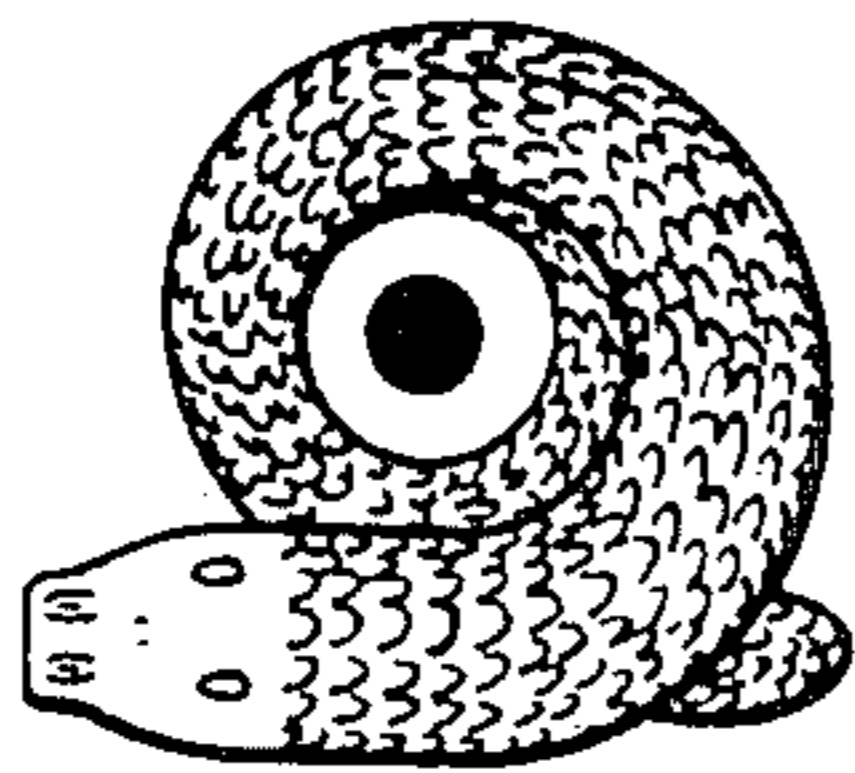

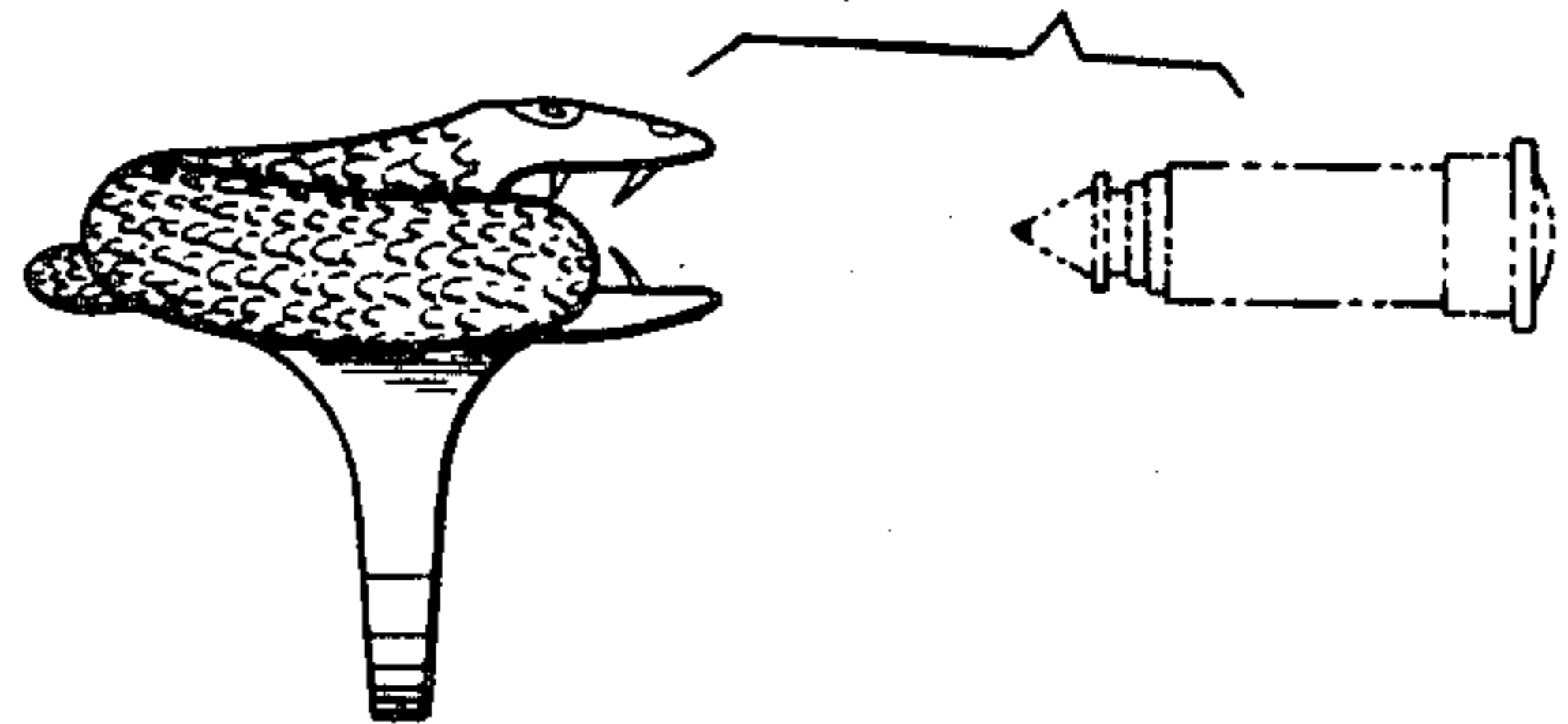
