The ornamental design for a toy vehicle, substantially as shown and described.

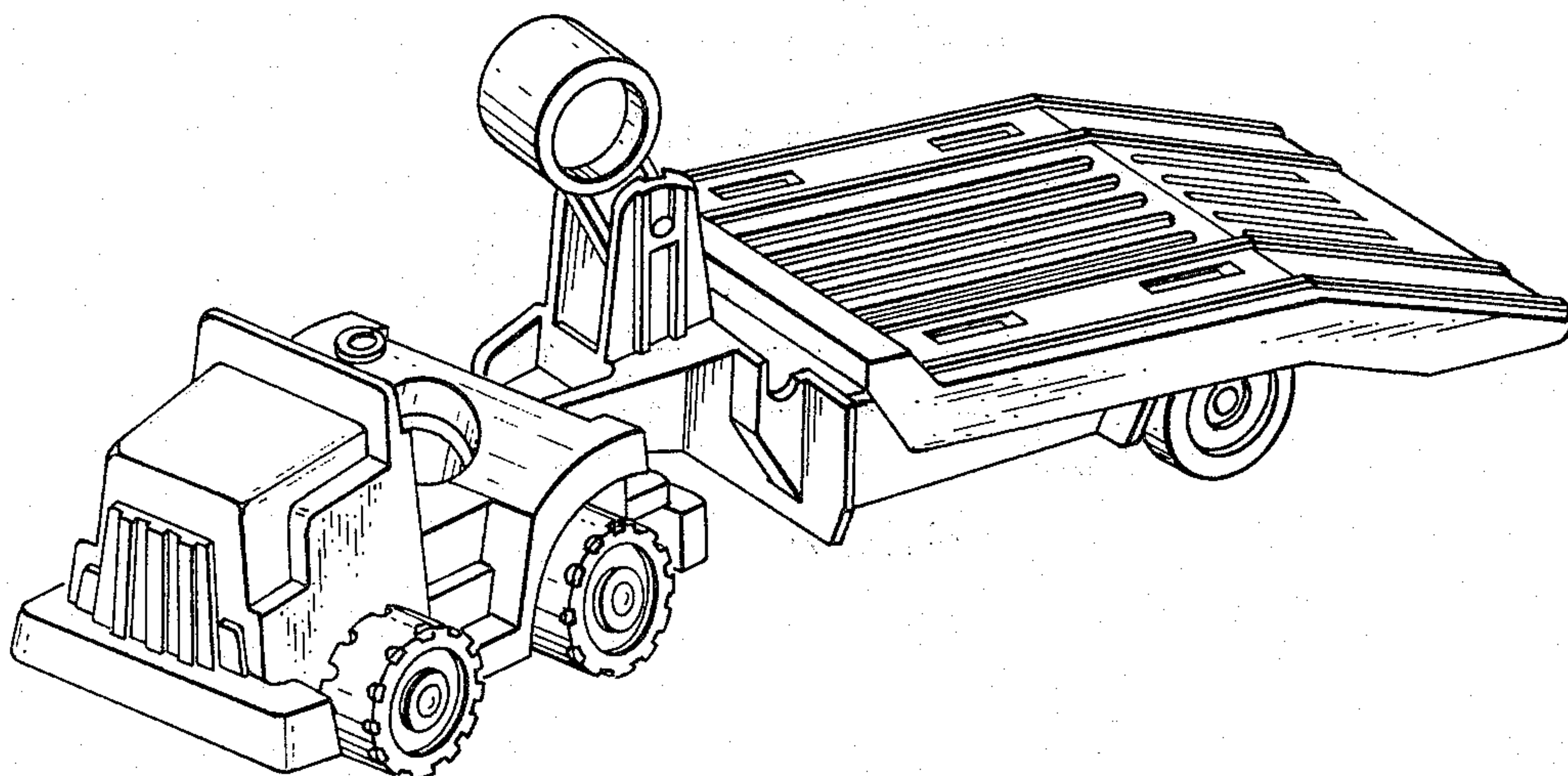
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top left perspective view of a toy vehicle showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



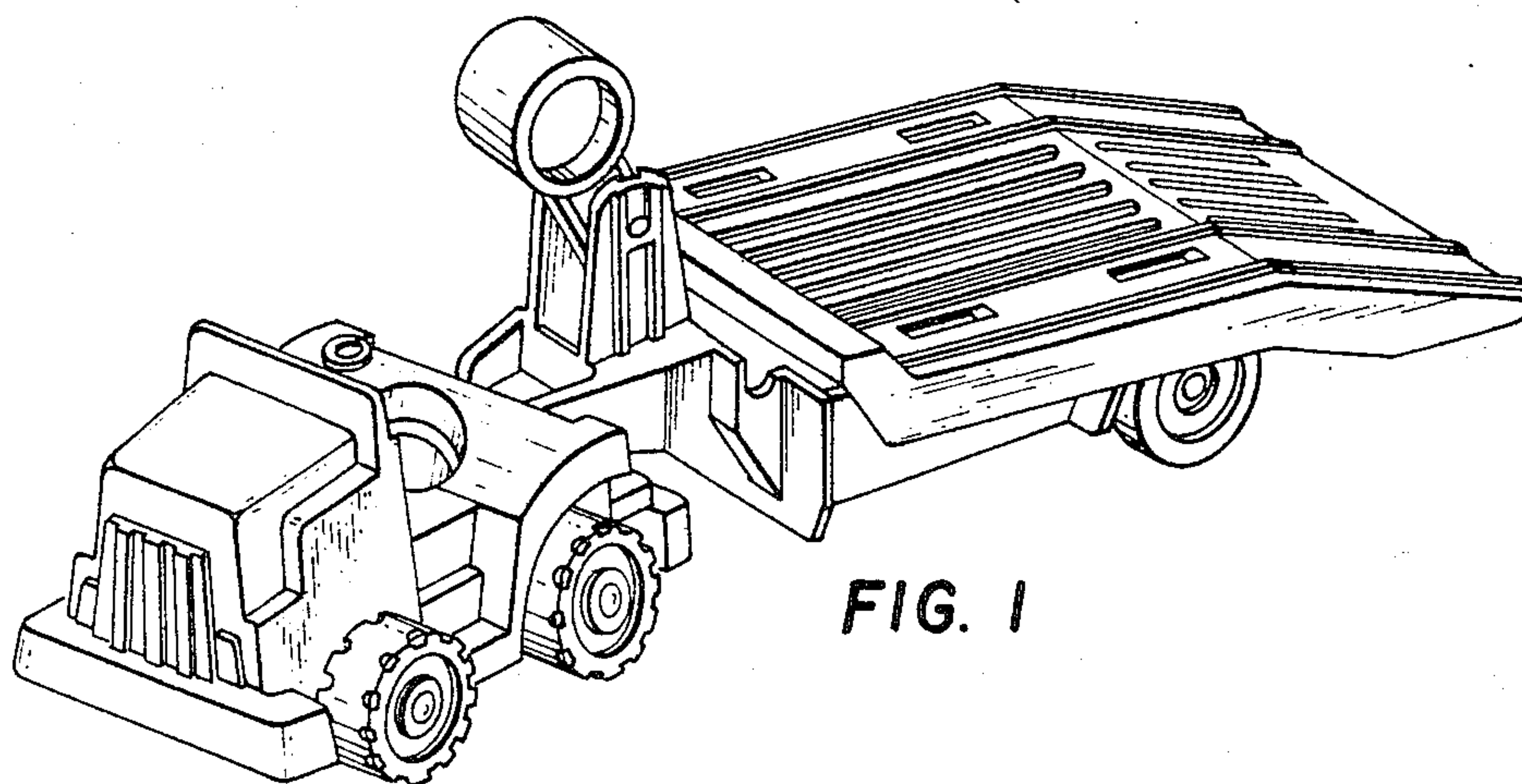

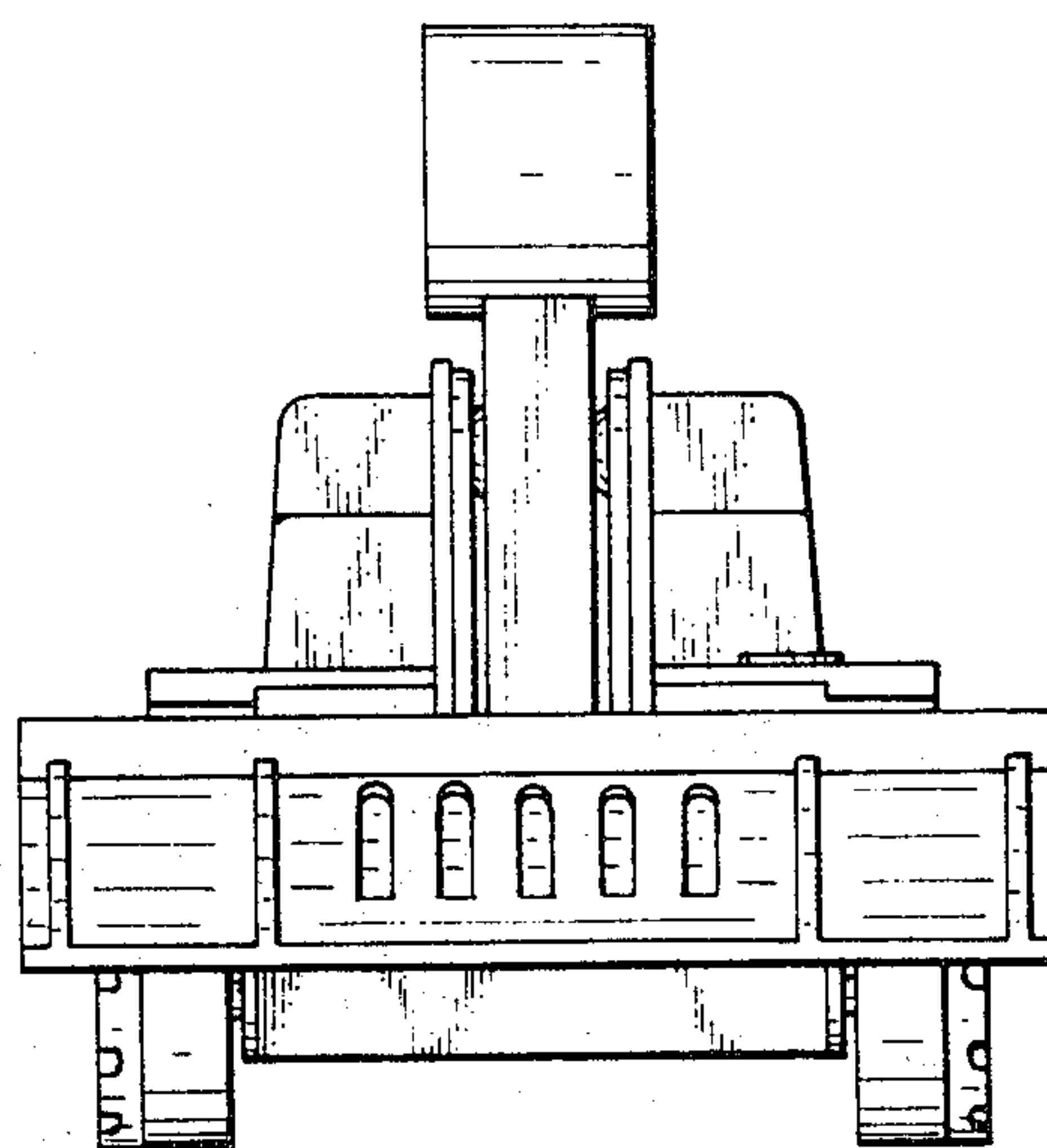

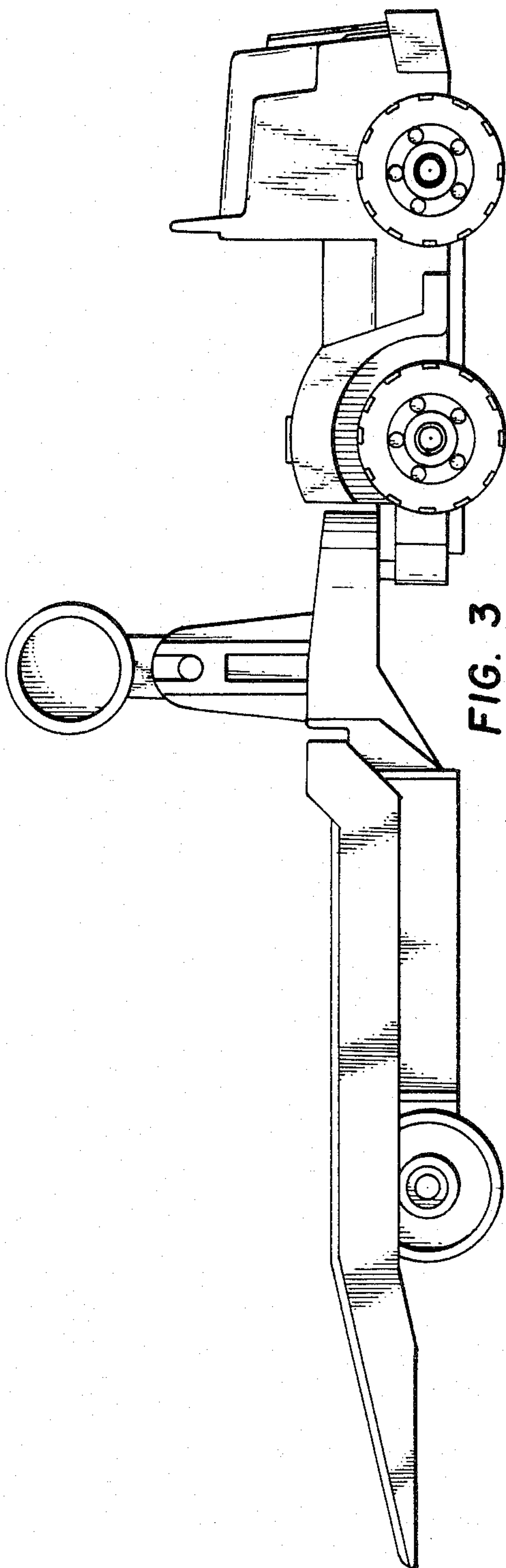

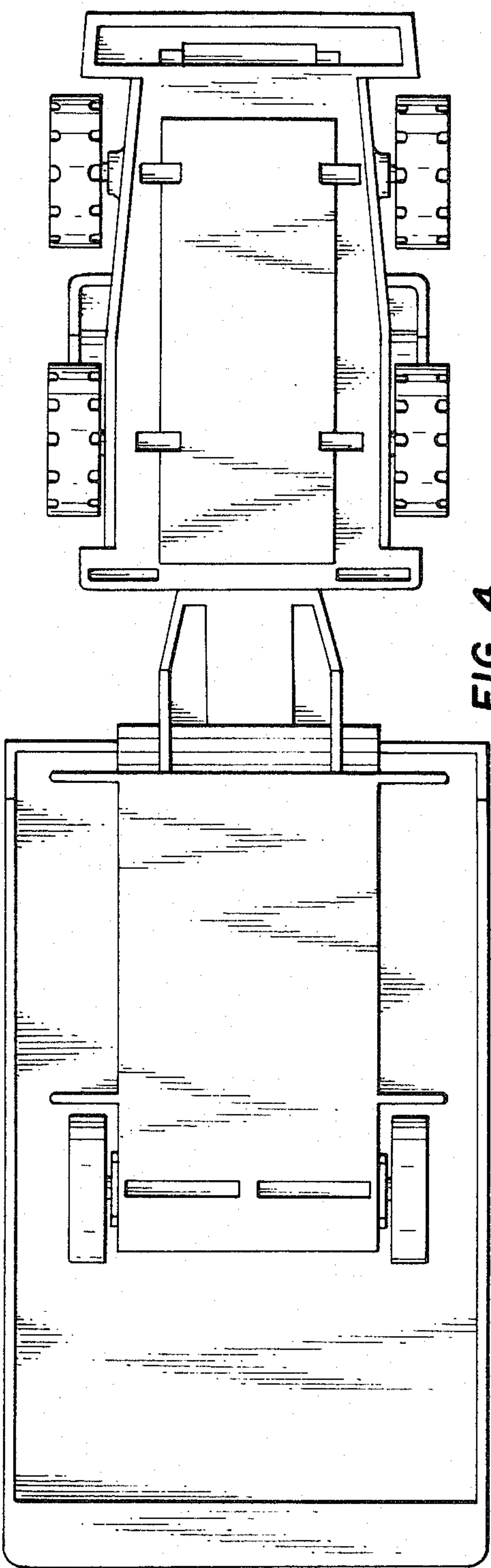
