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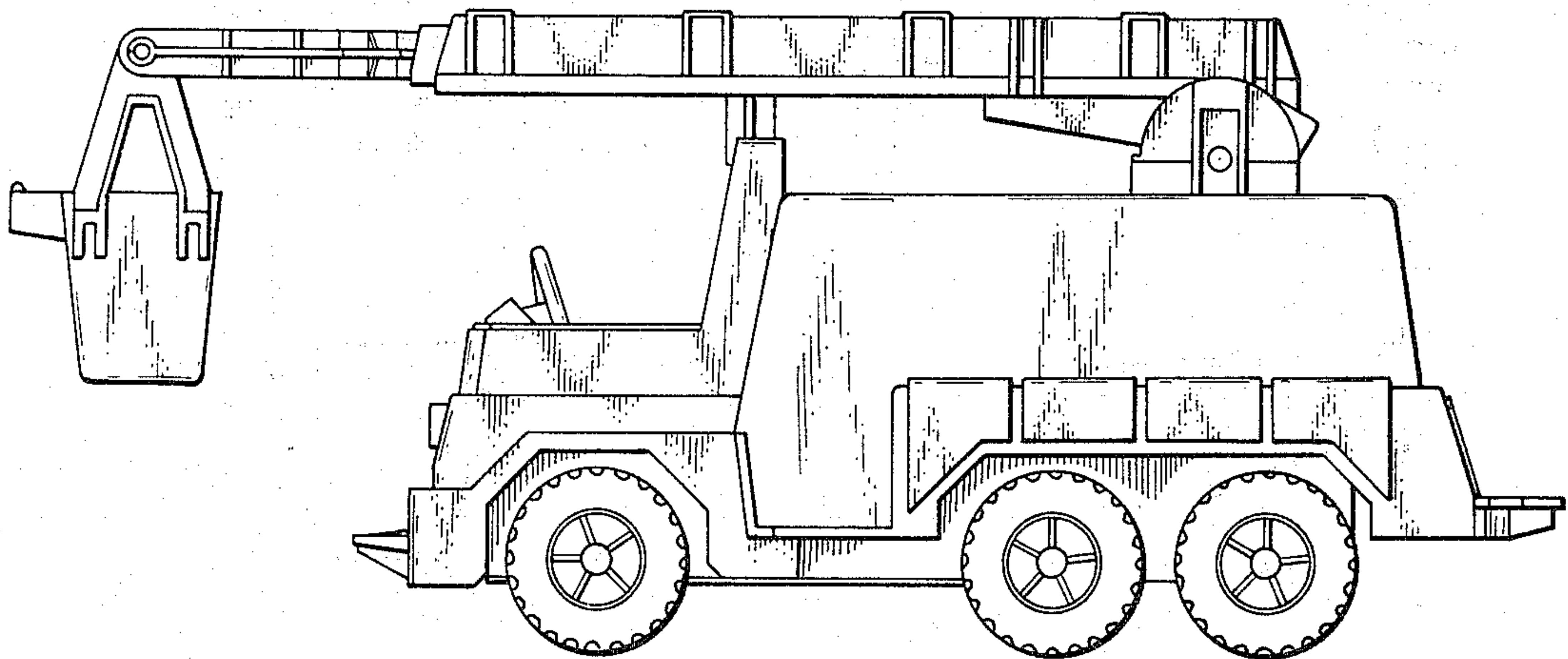

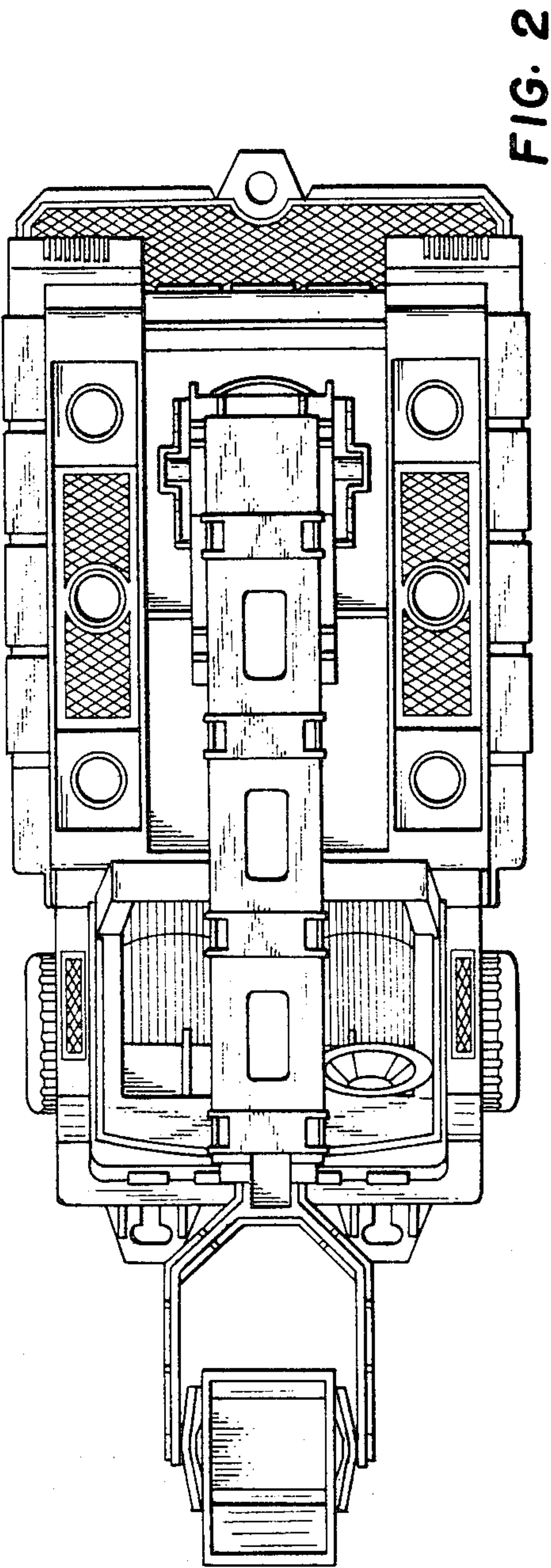
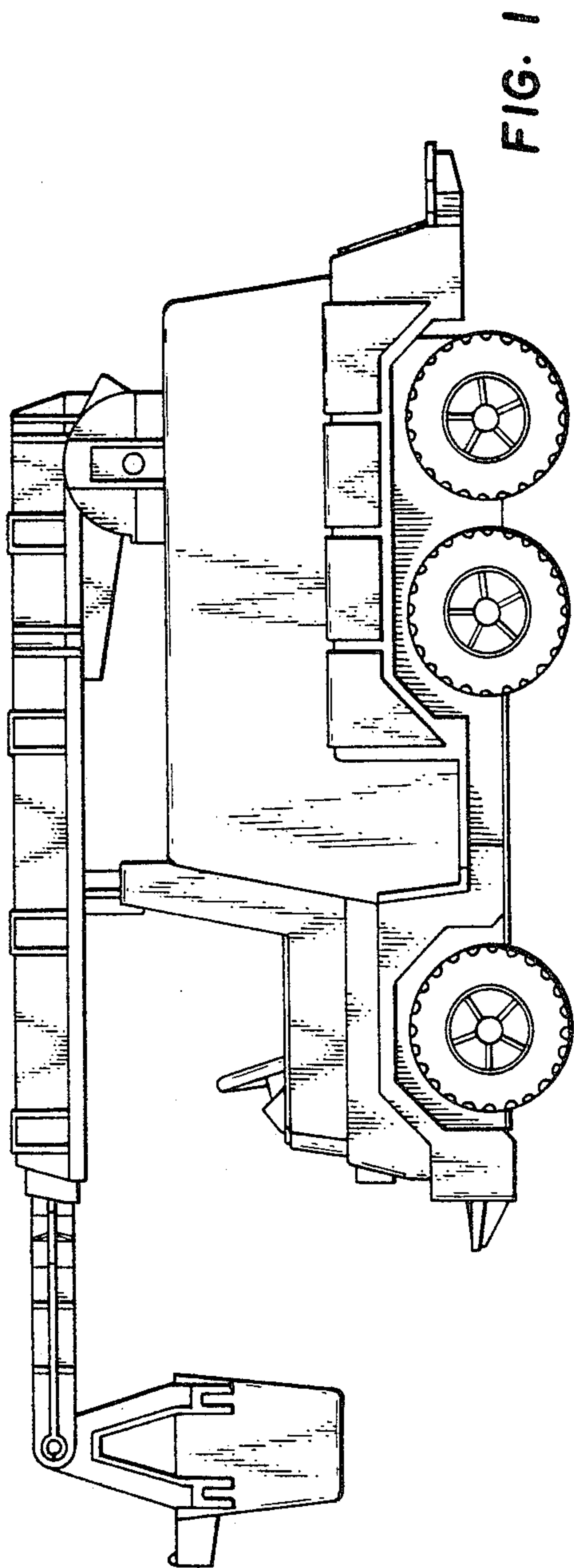
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toy utility truck, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-side elevational view of a toy utility truck showing my new design, the right side being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.





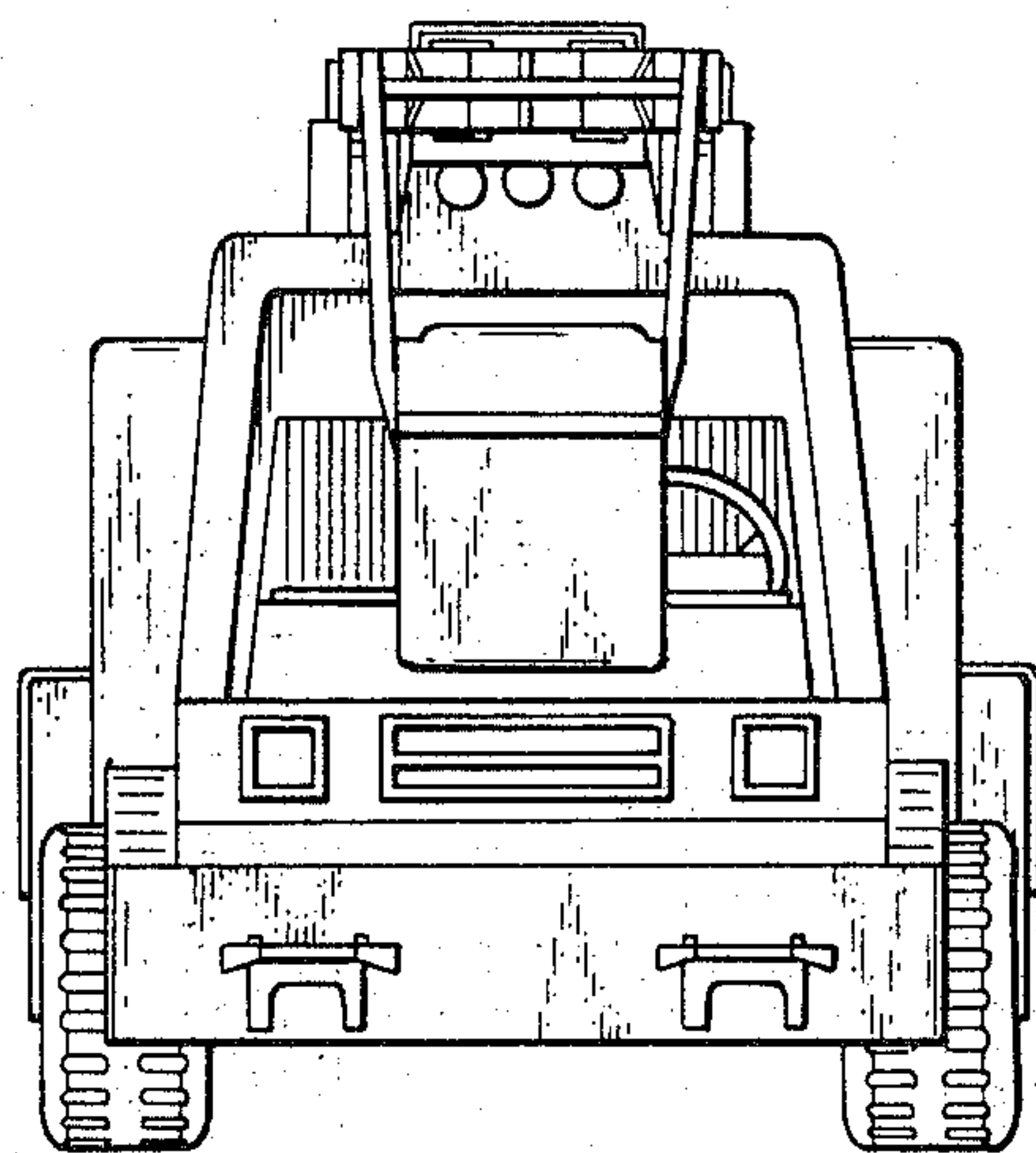

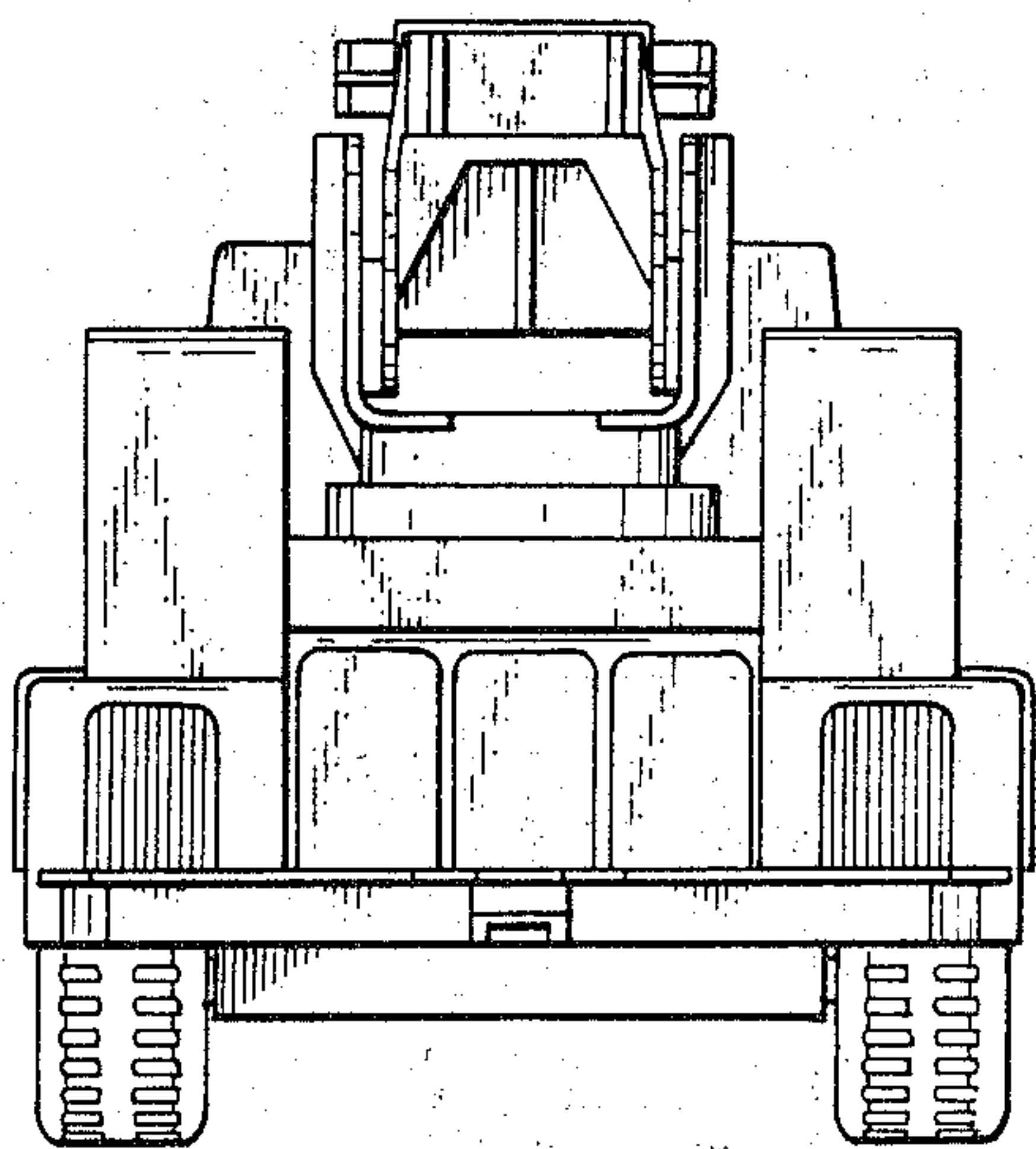

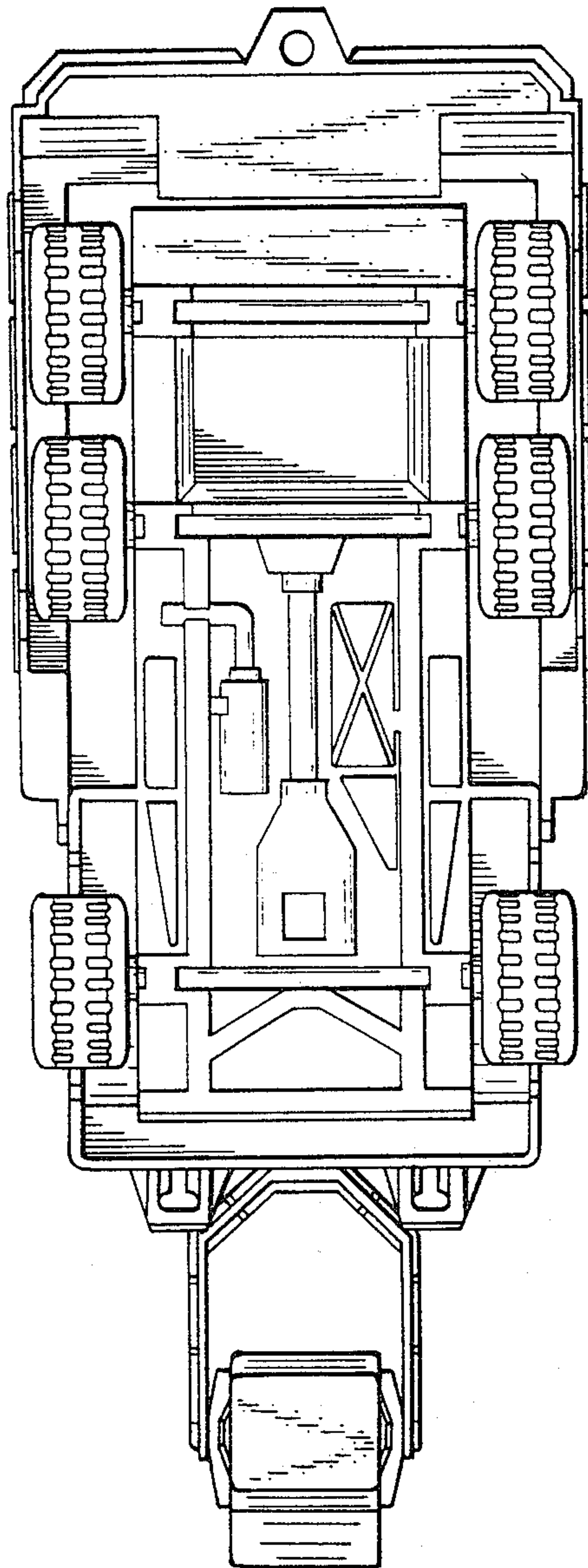
