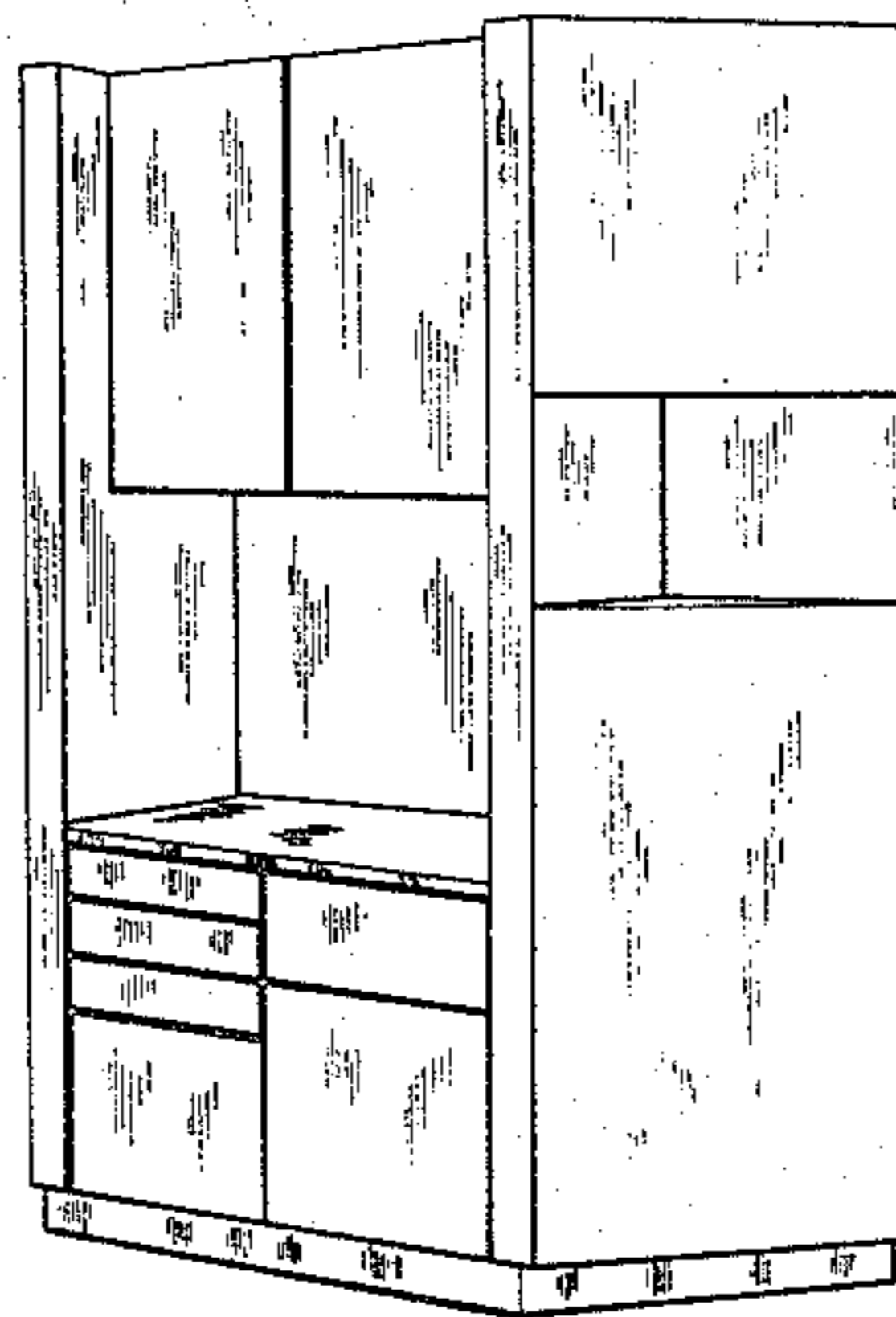

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a dentist service unit showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof. The rear of the unit is substantially flat and unornamented.



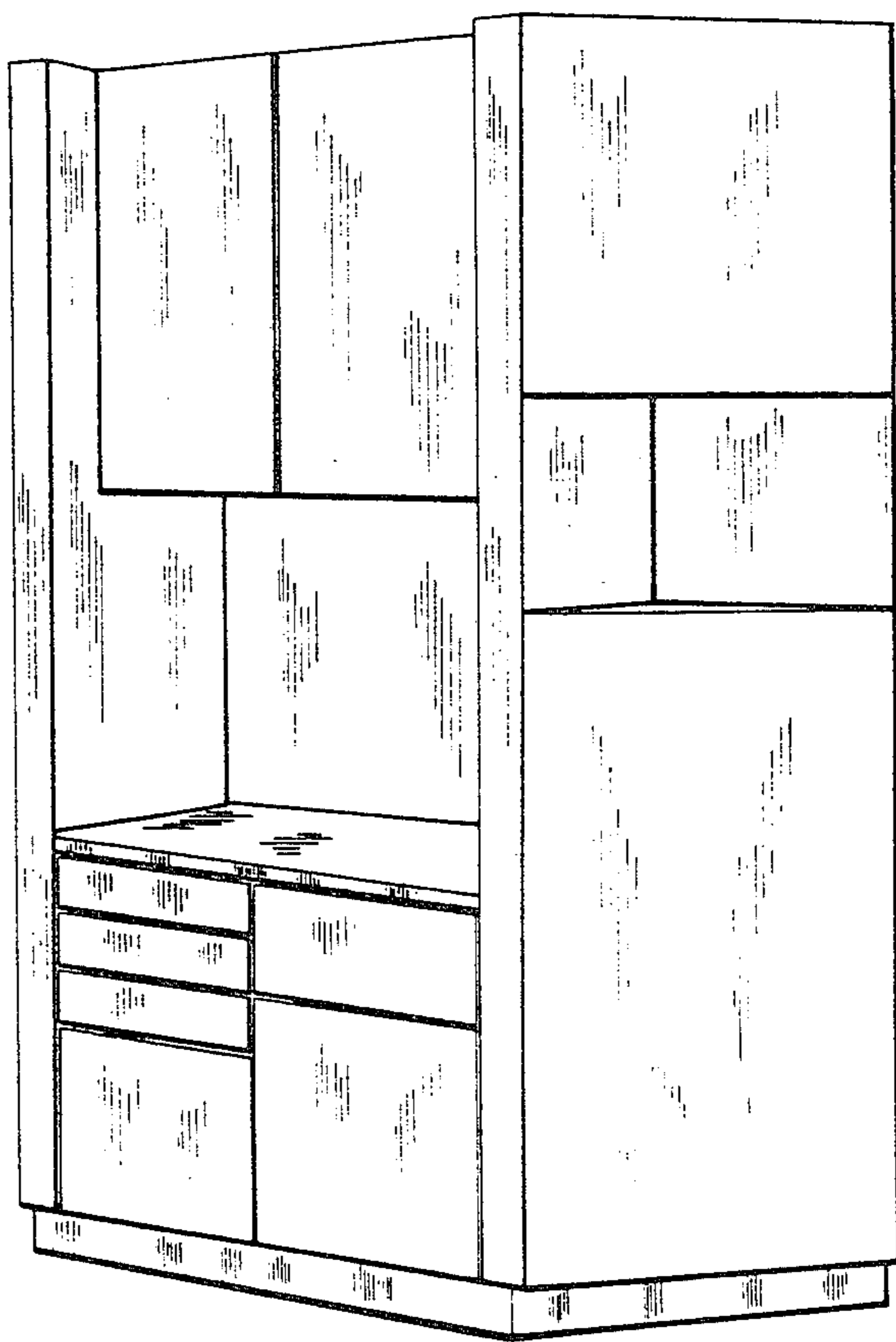

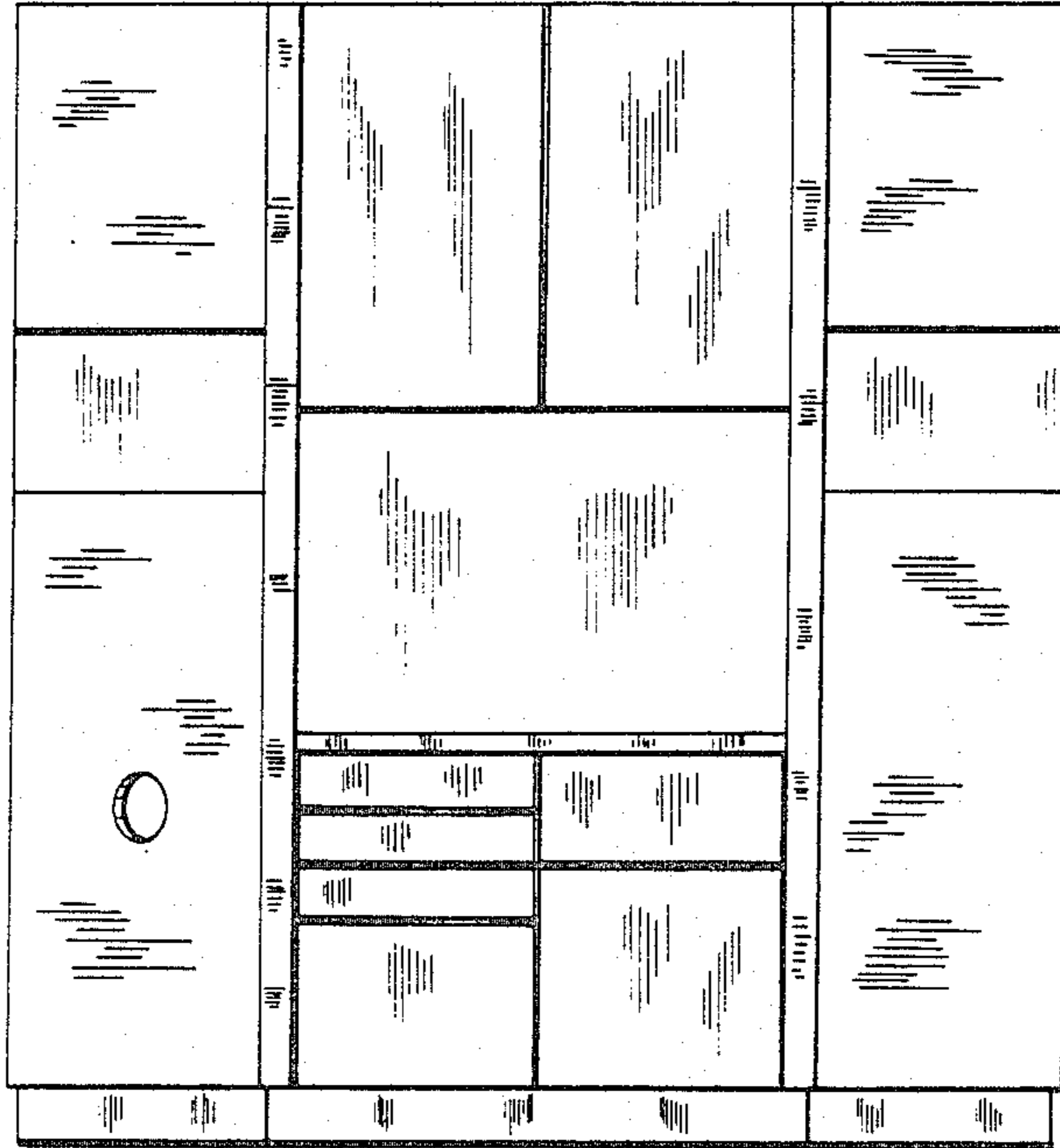

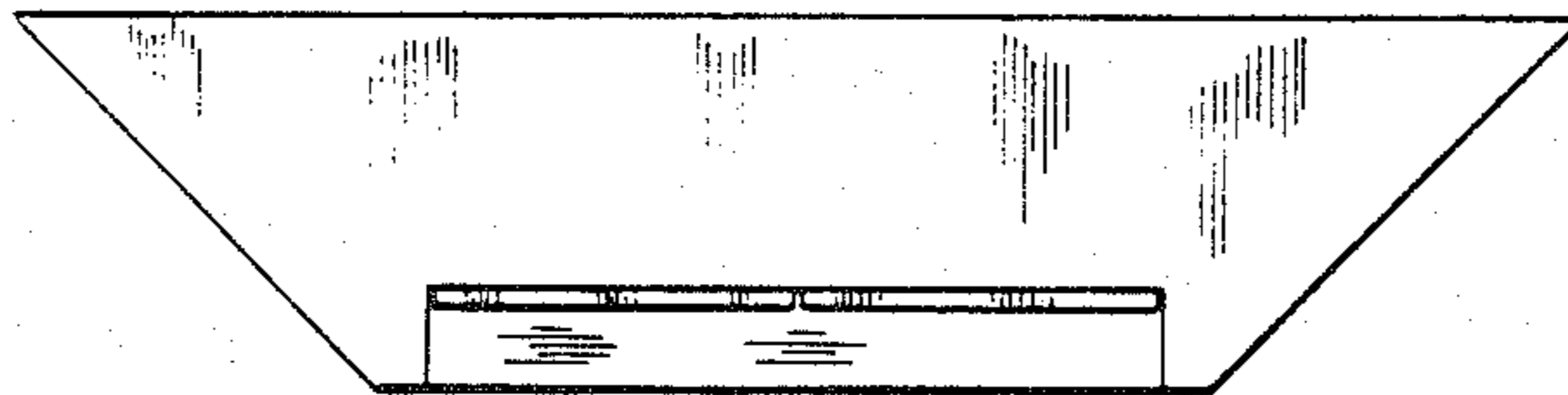
