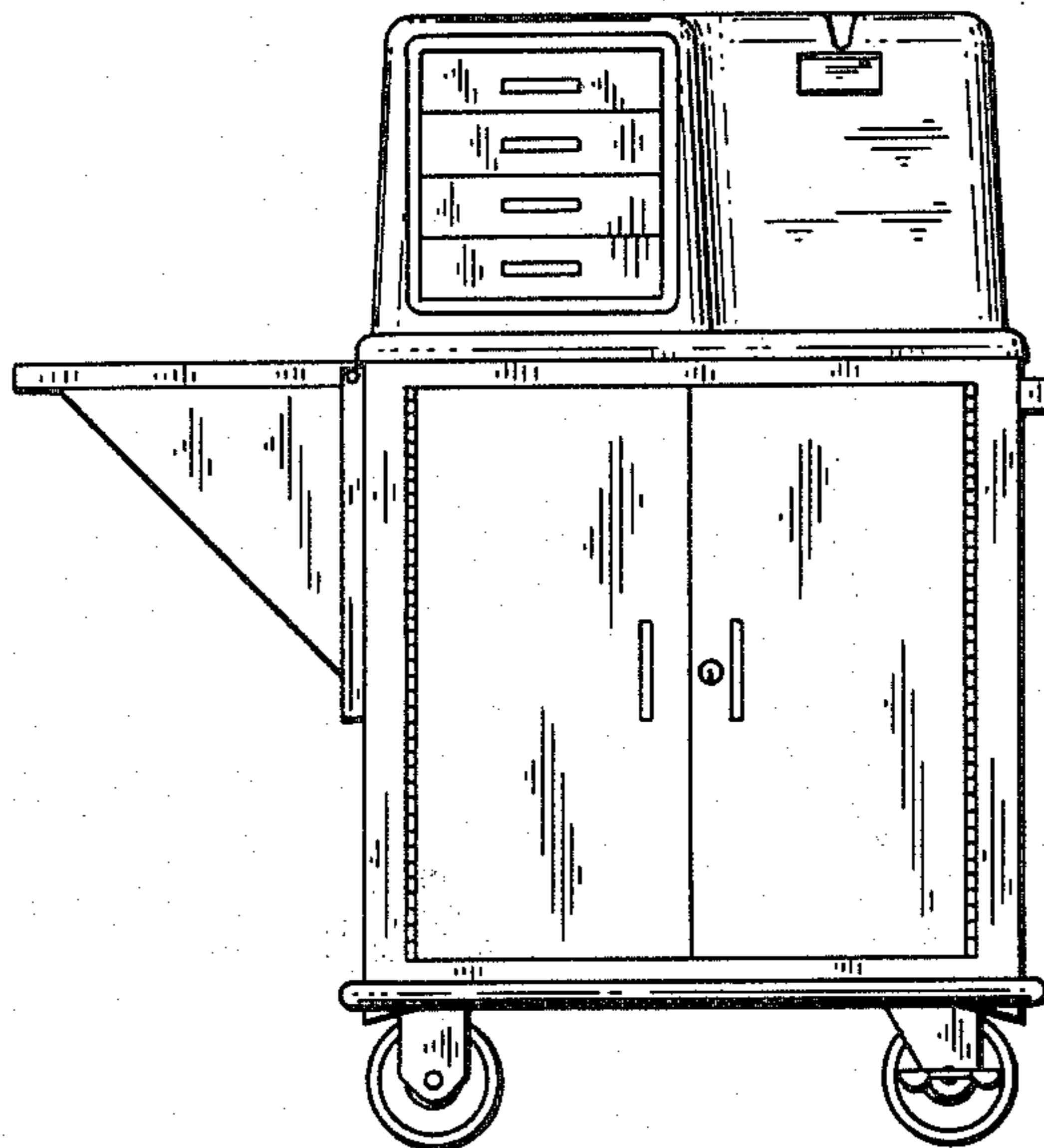

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

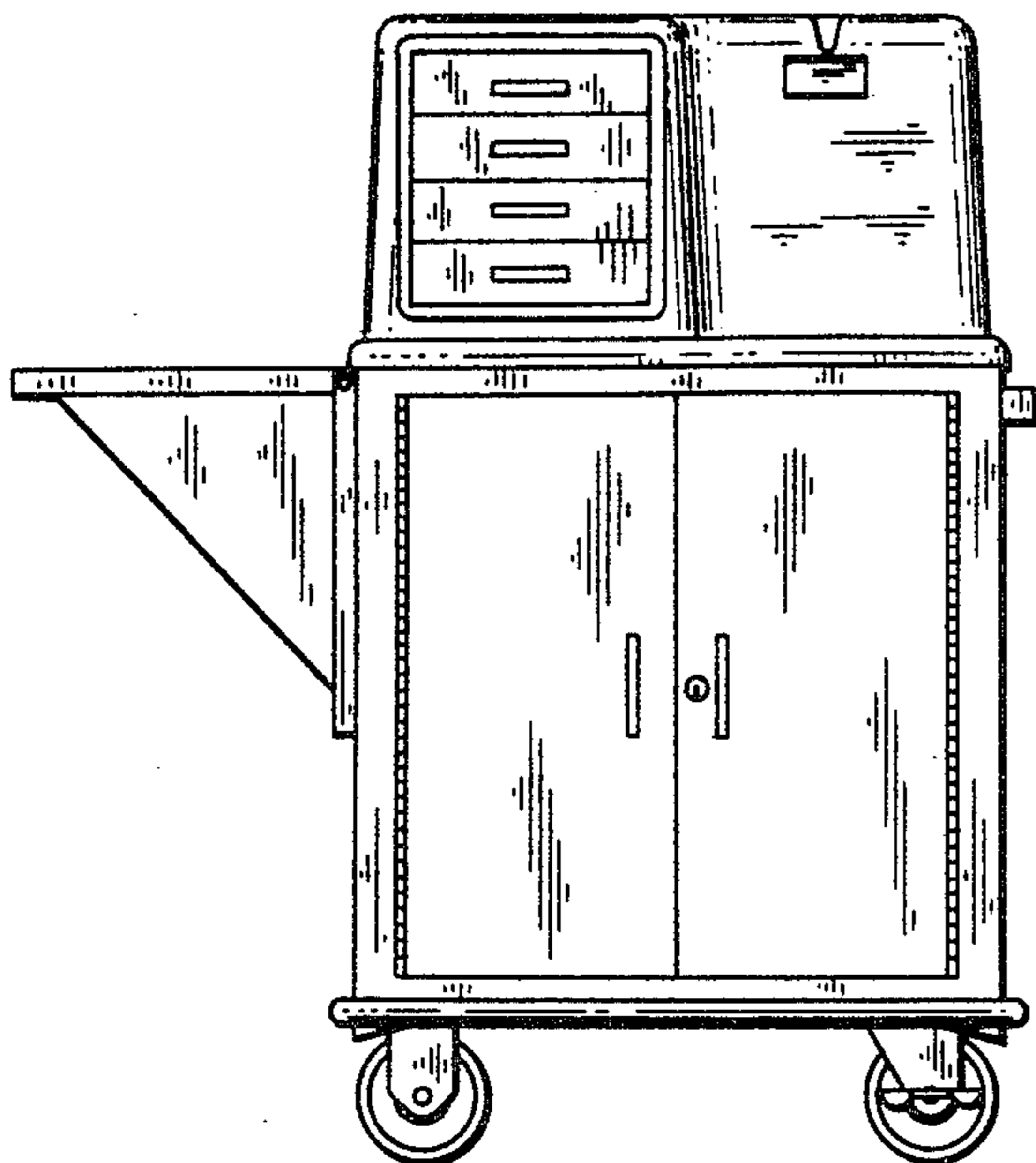

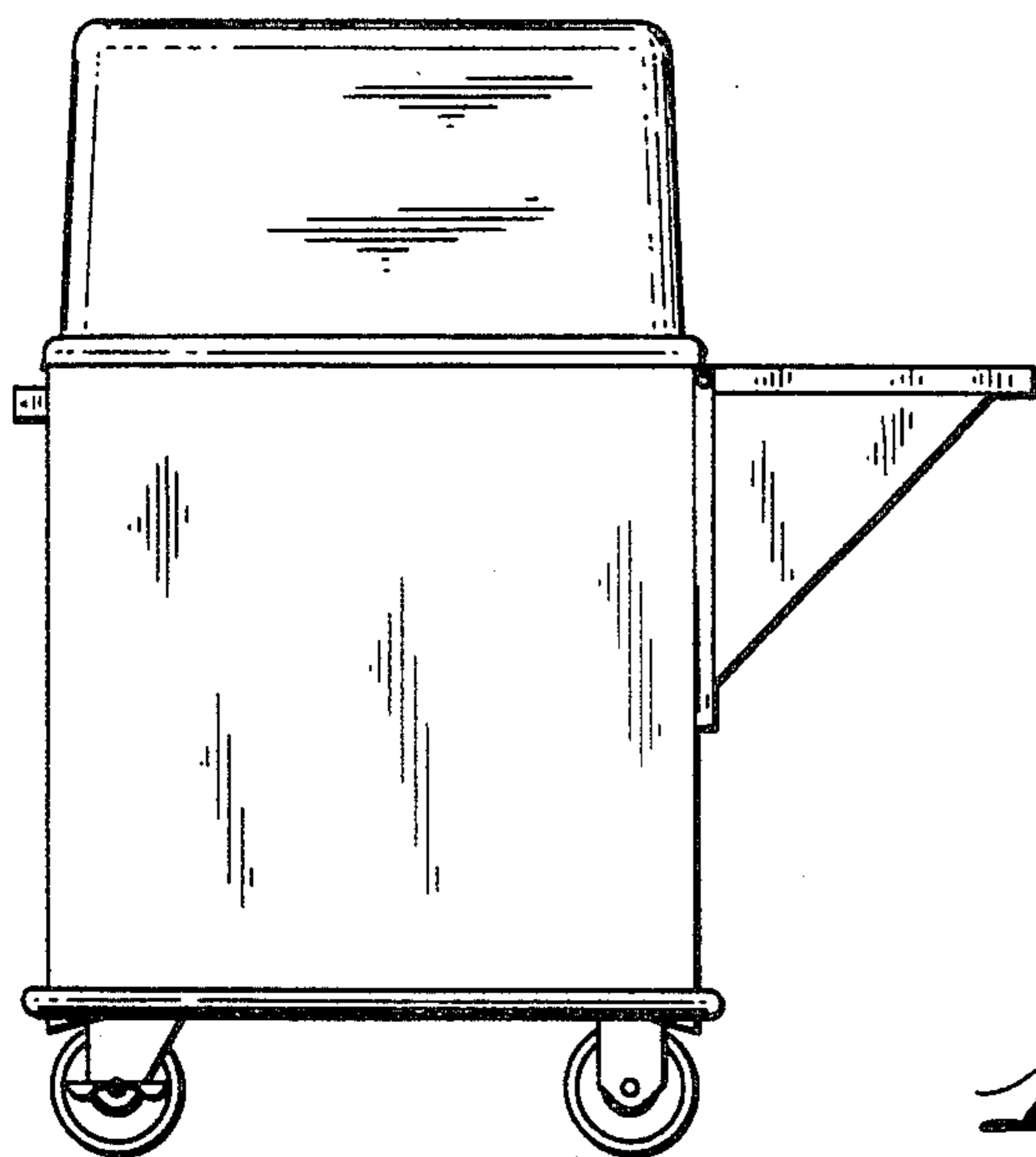
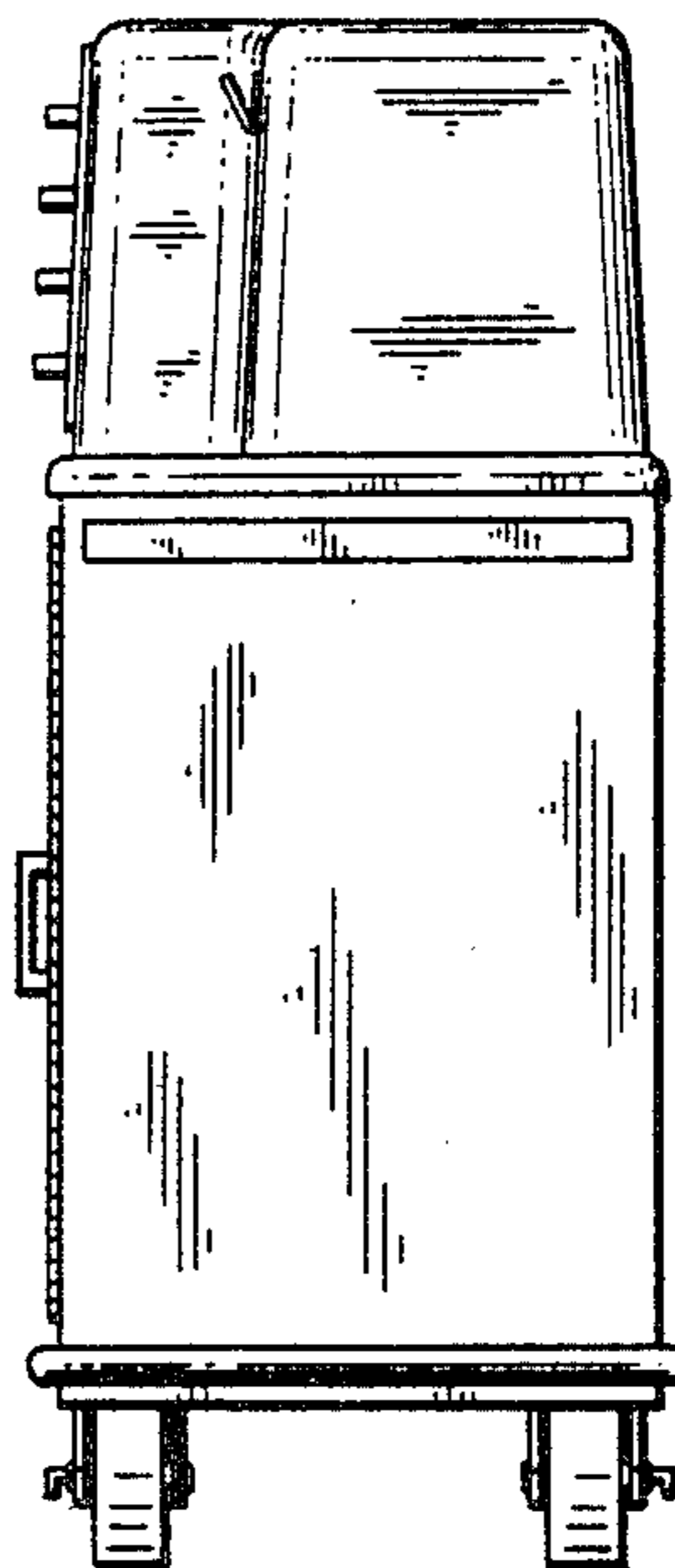

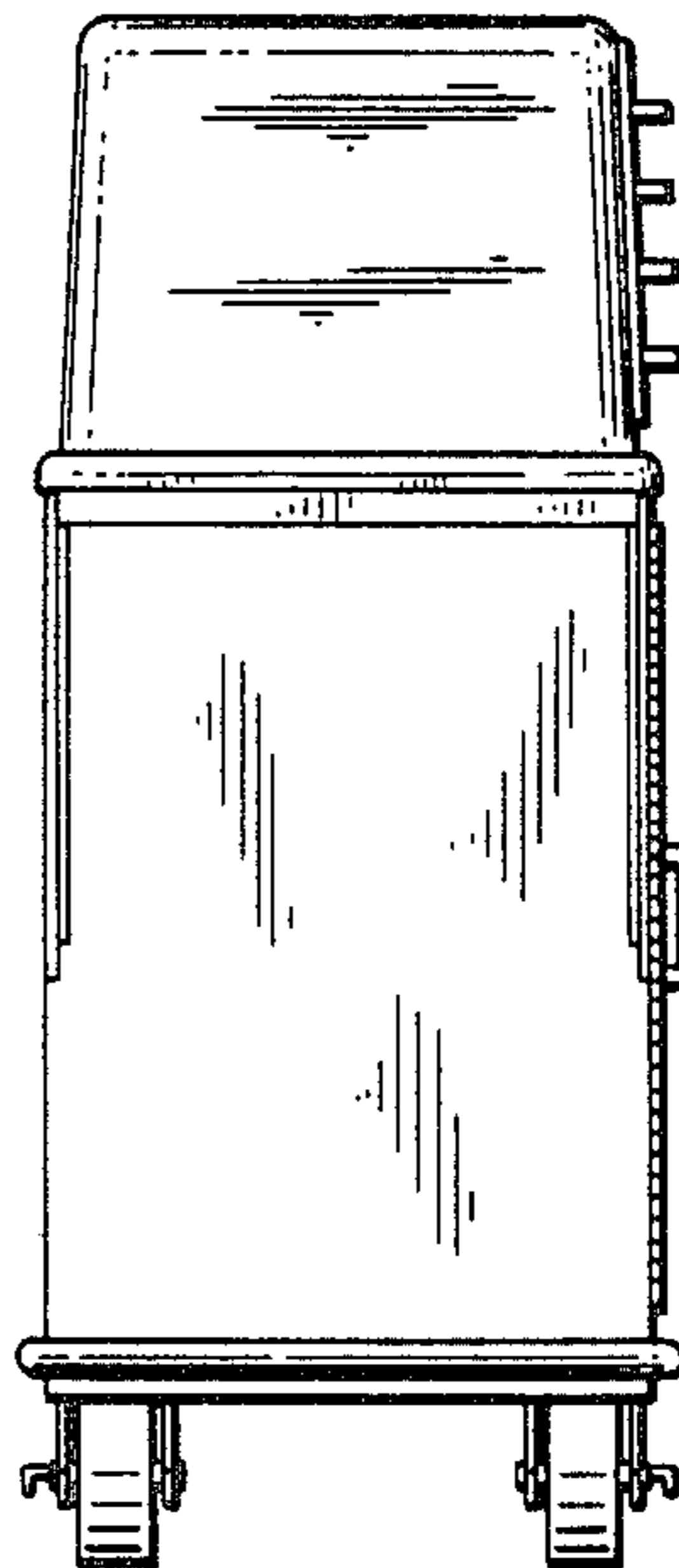
