DESCRIPTION

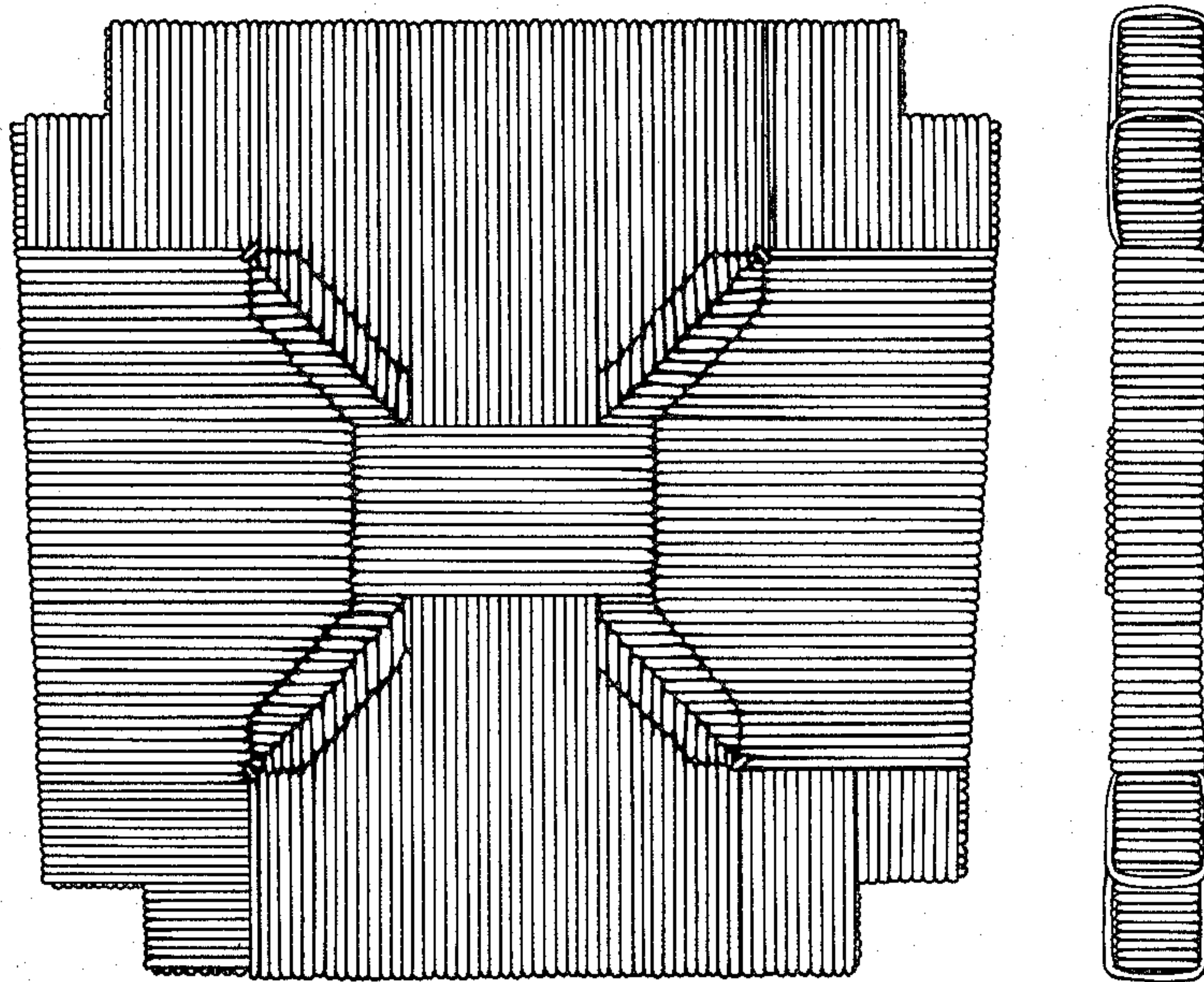
FIG. 1 is top plan view of a woven chair seat showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a right edge view thereof as seen in FIG. 1.



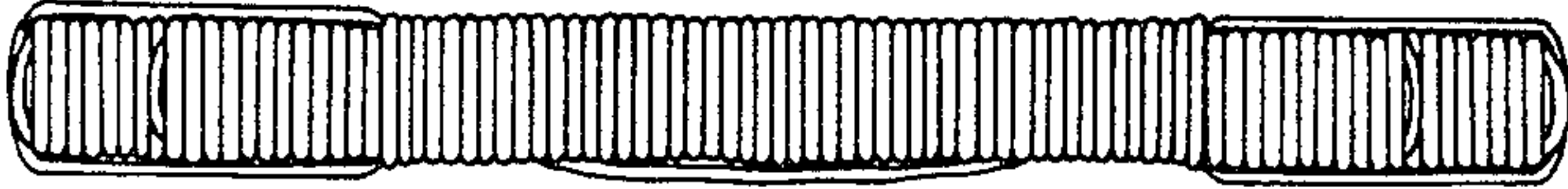

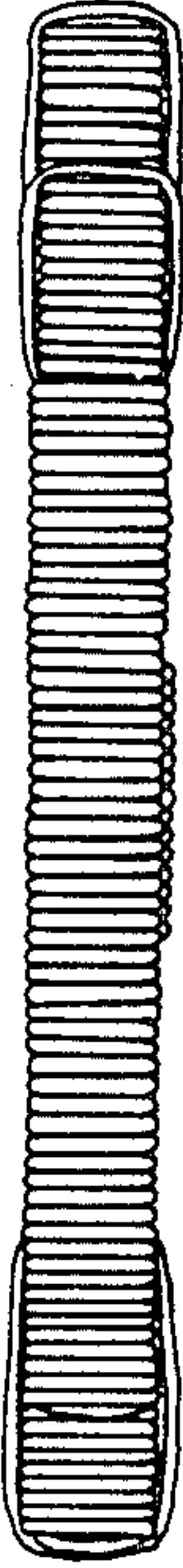

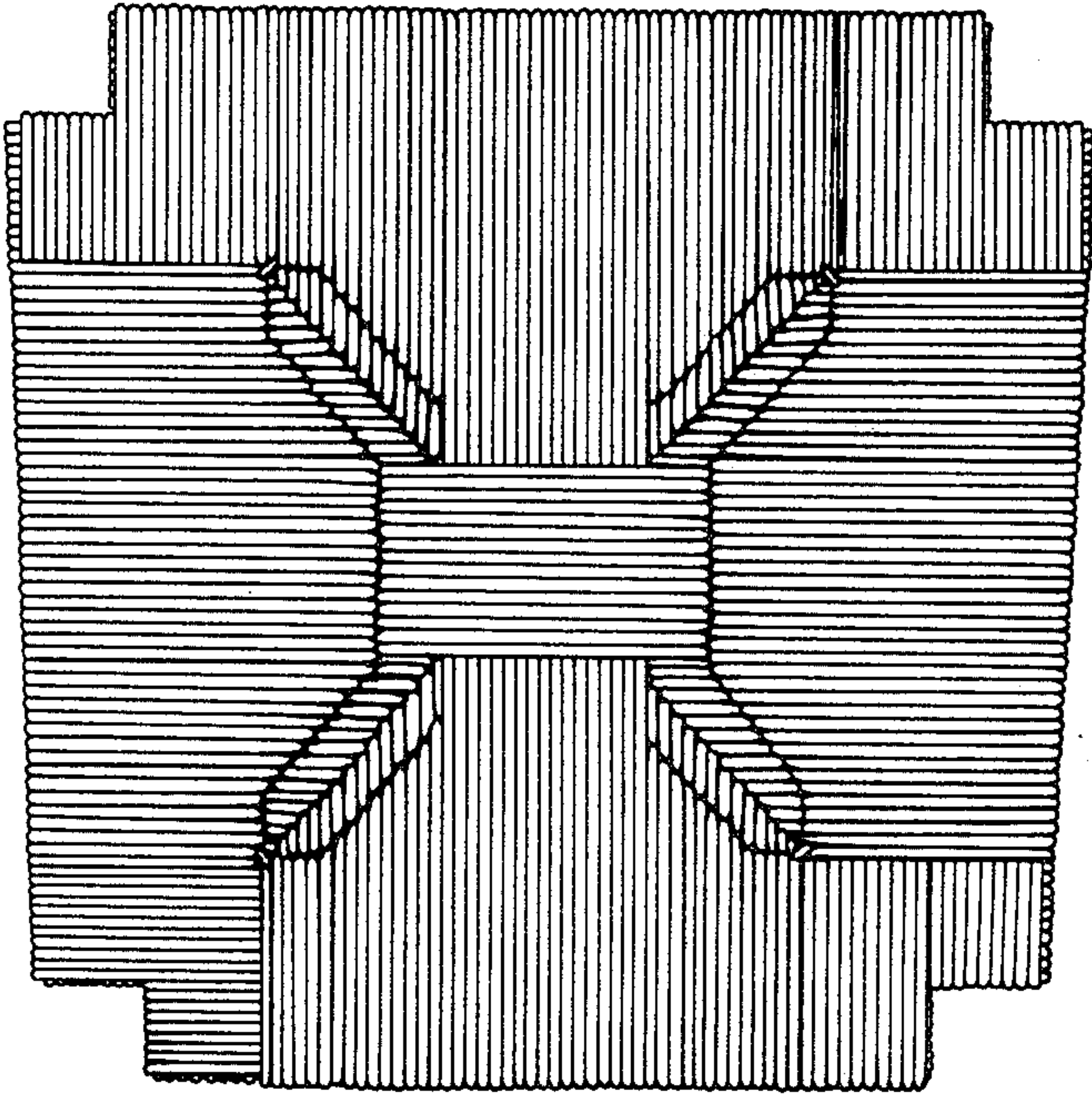
