DESCRIPTION

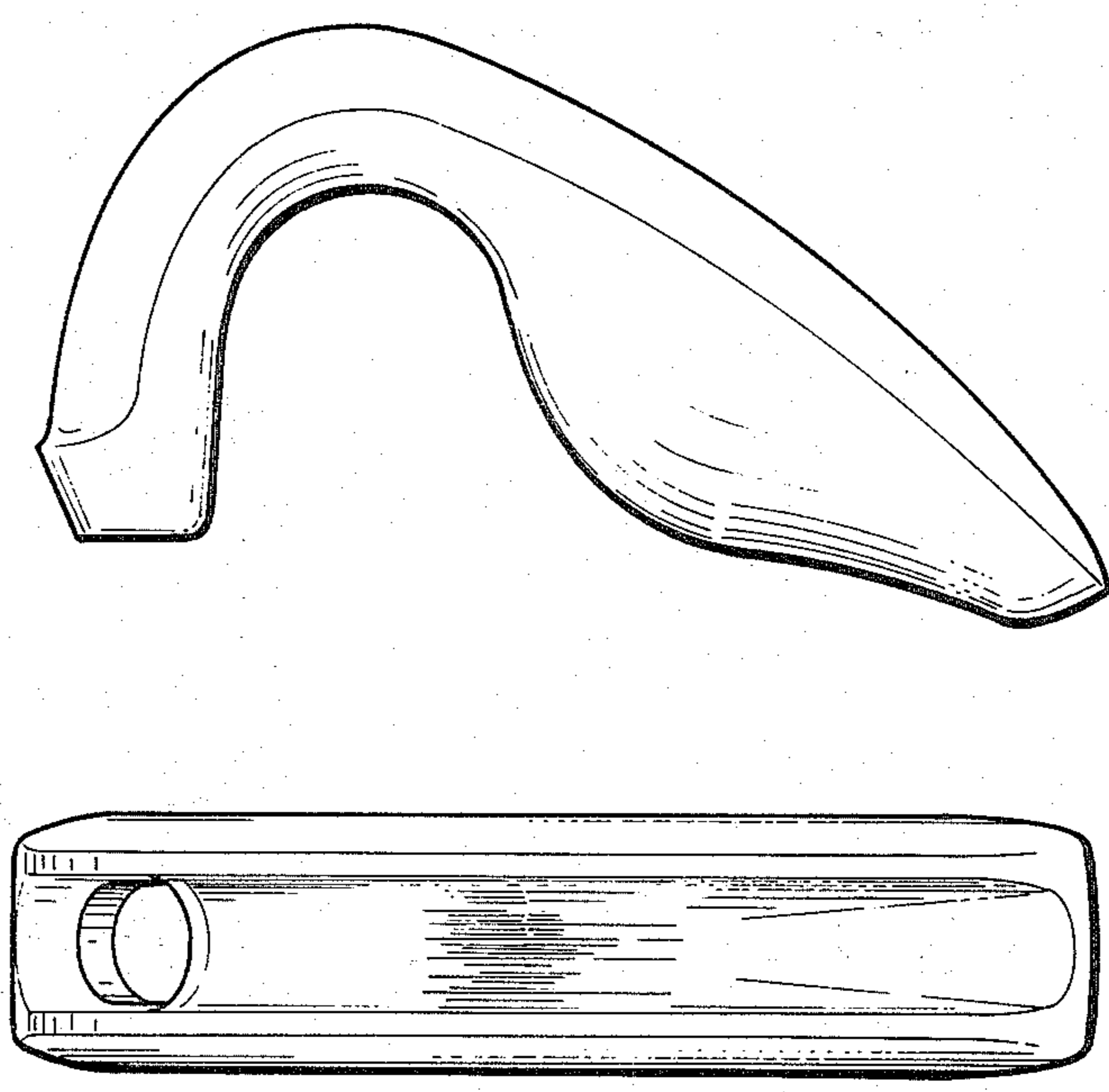
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a coathanger handle showing my new design the side opposite being a mirror image thereof;

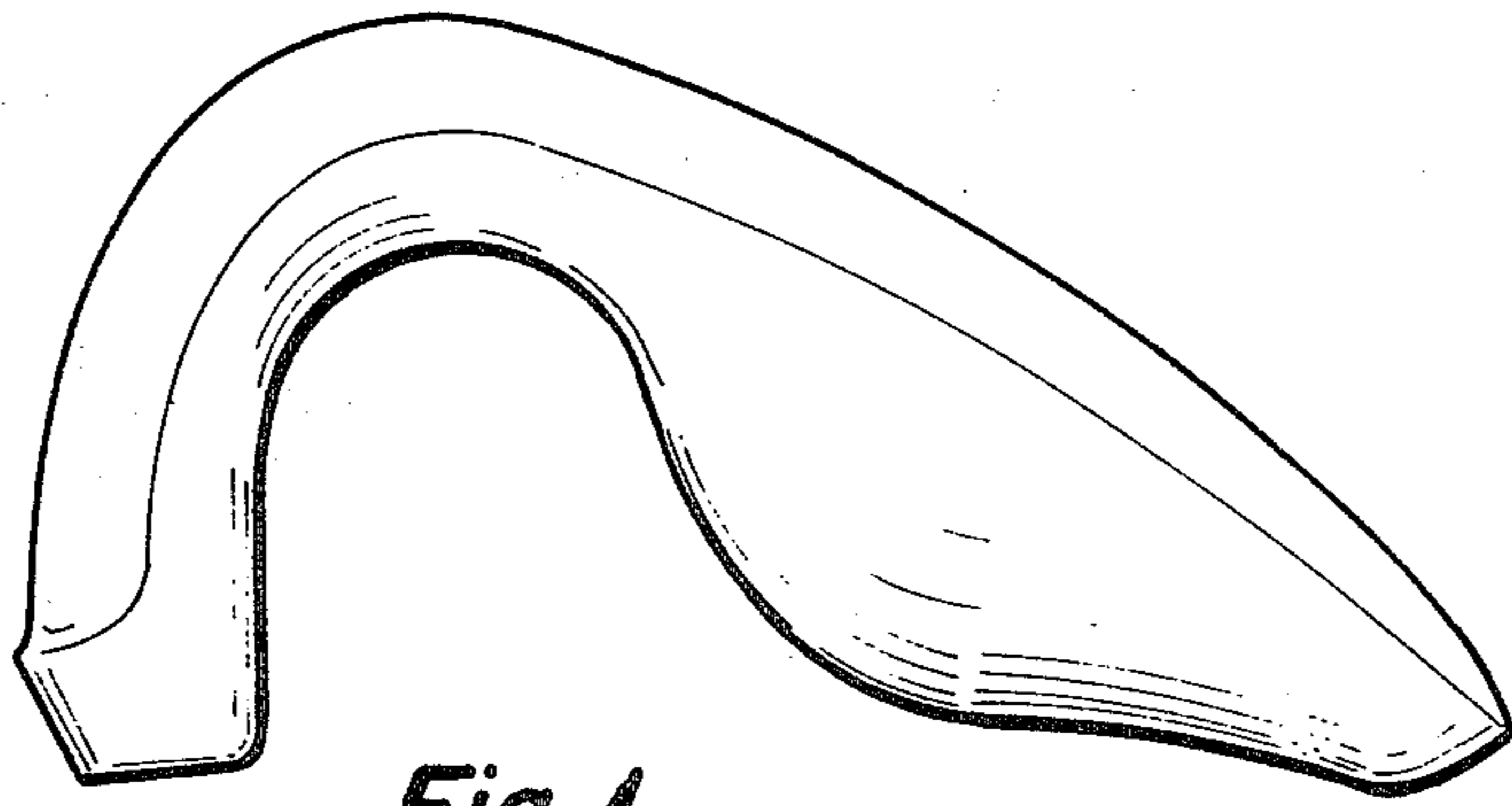
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view;

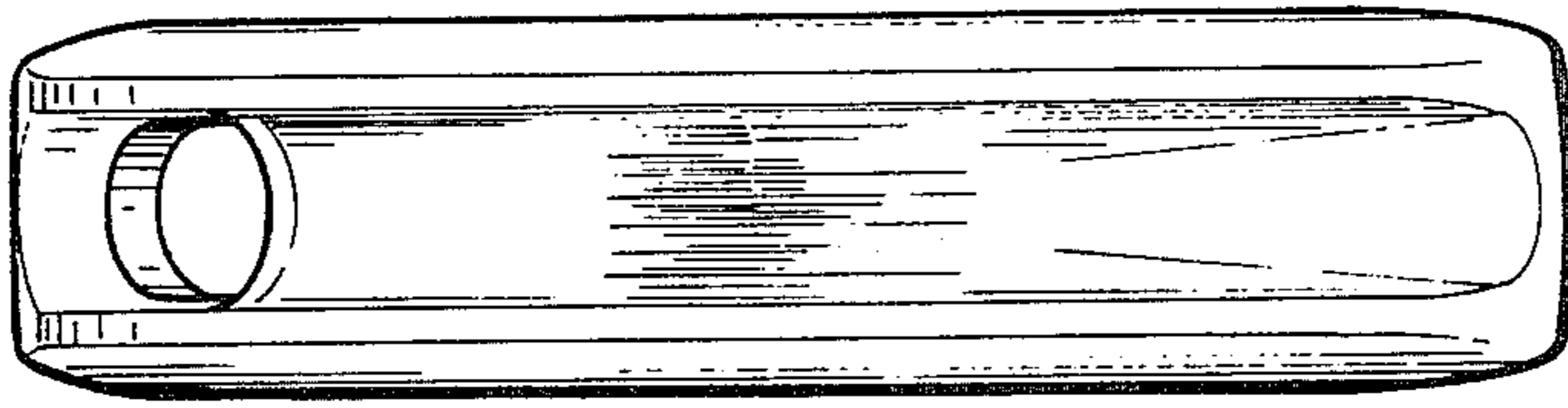
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1.

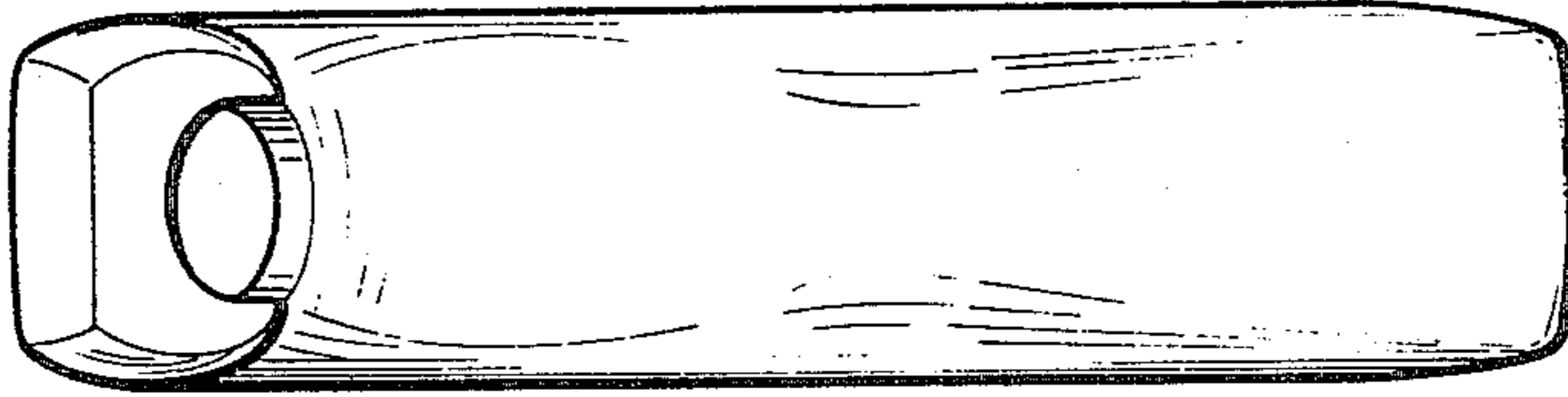




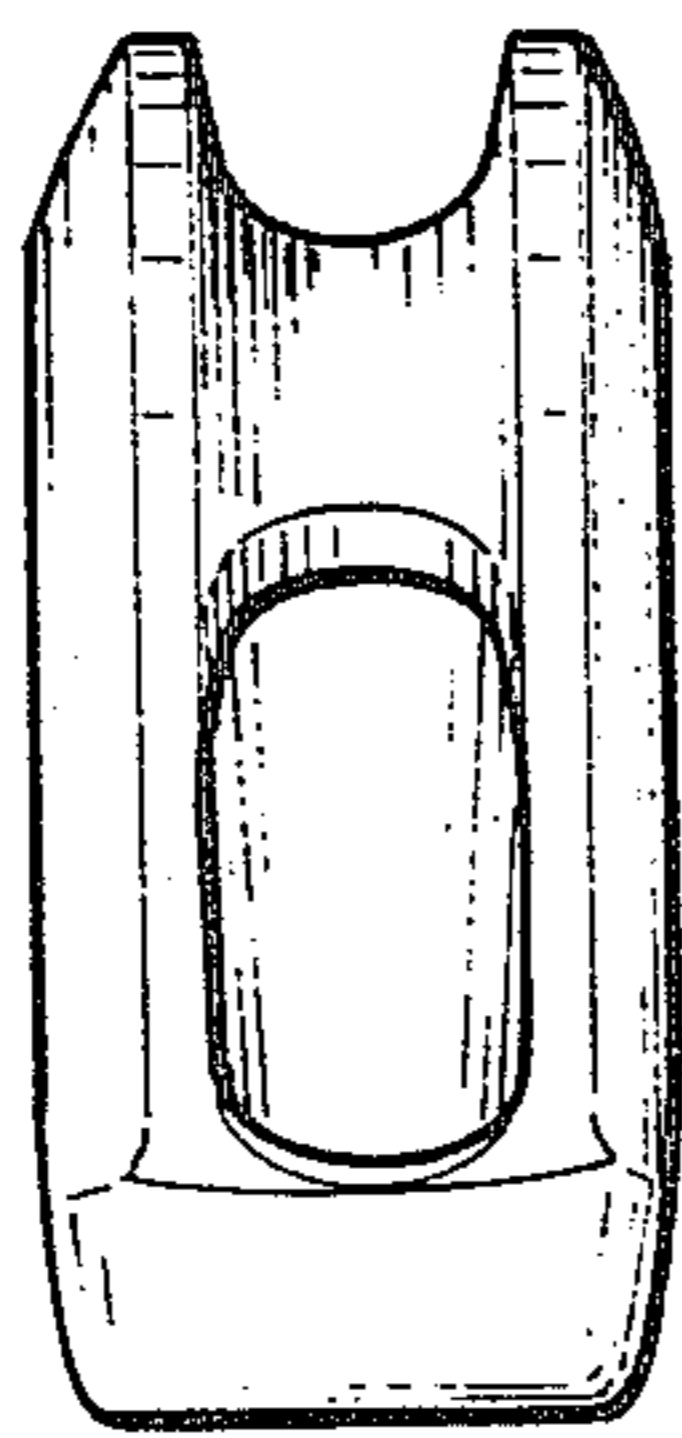

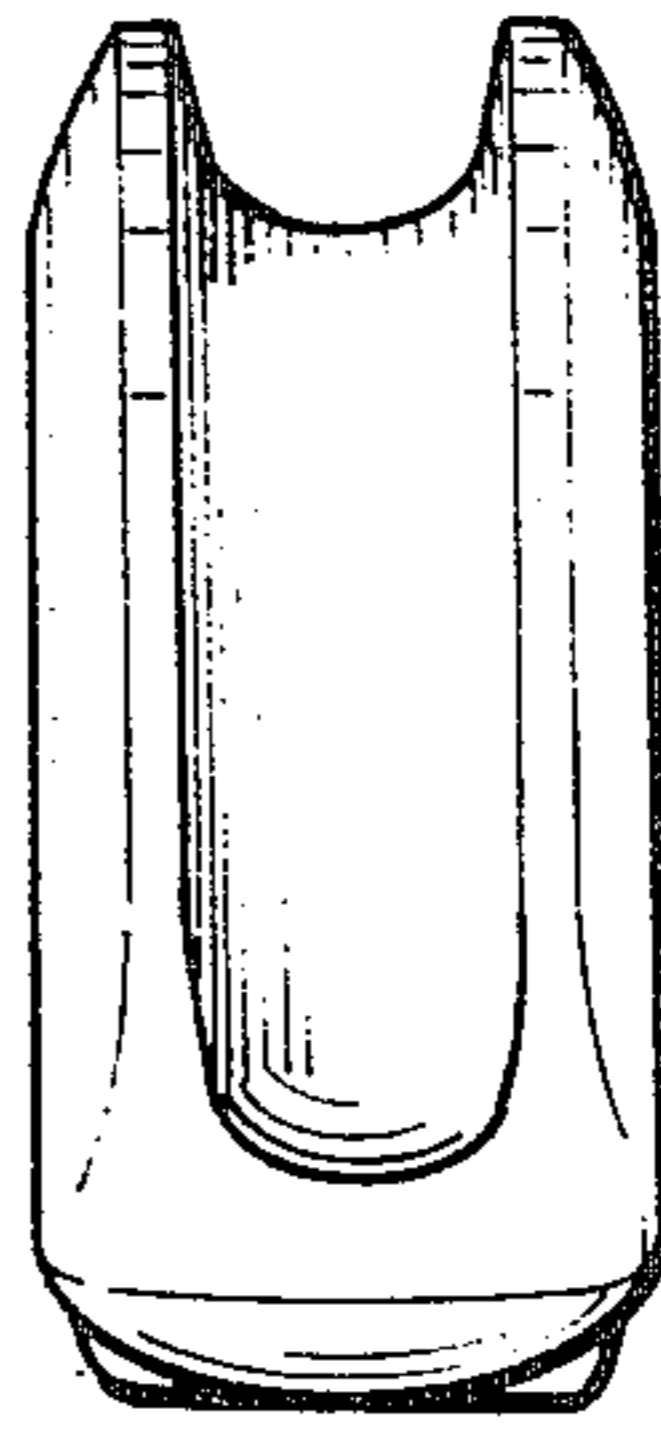
