FIG. 2 is a side elevational view looking directly into a tyne;

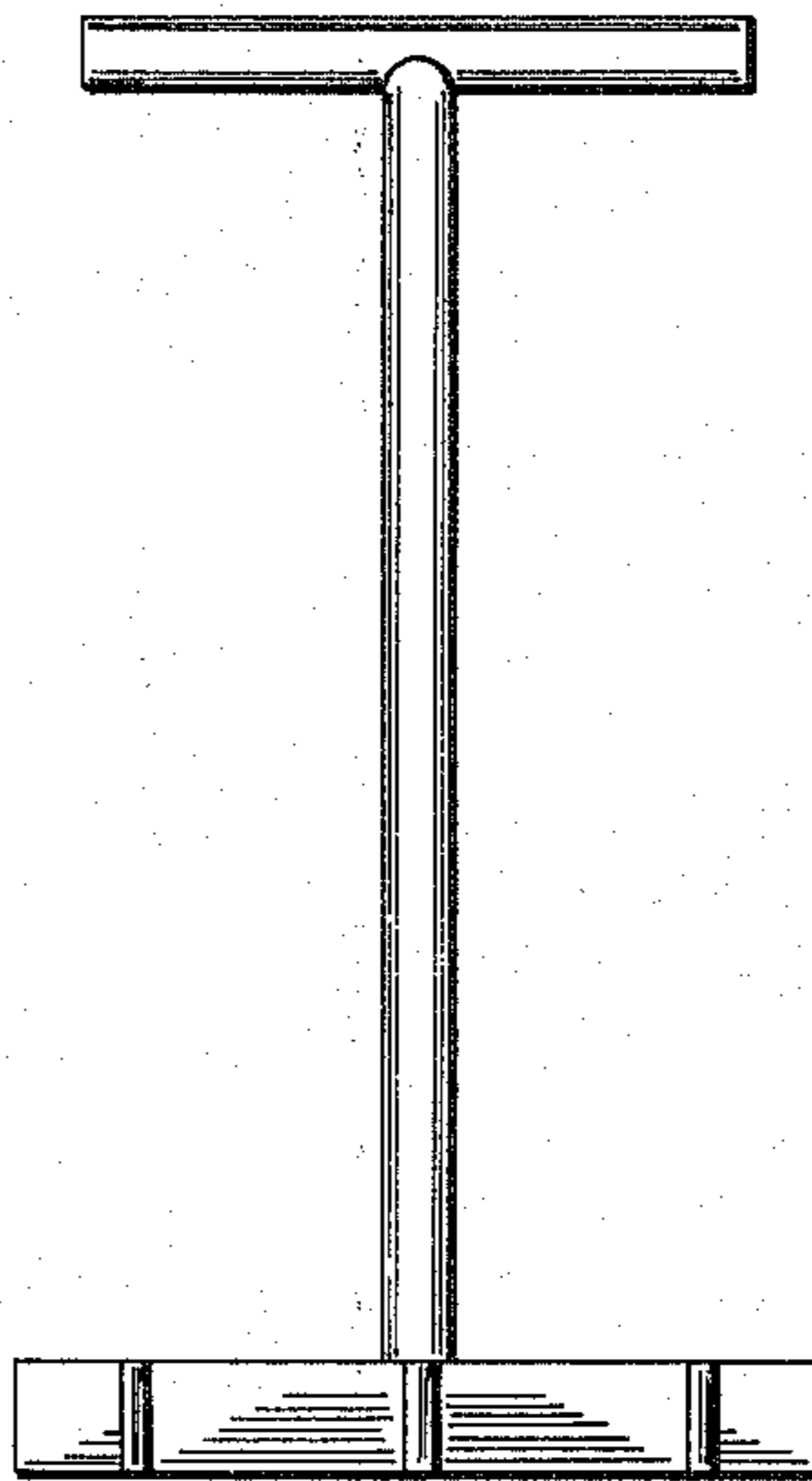
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view which has been rotated about 22.5° from the view of FIG. 2; and,

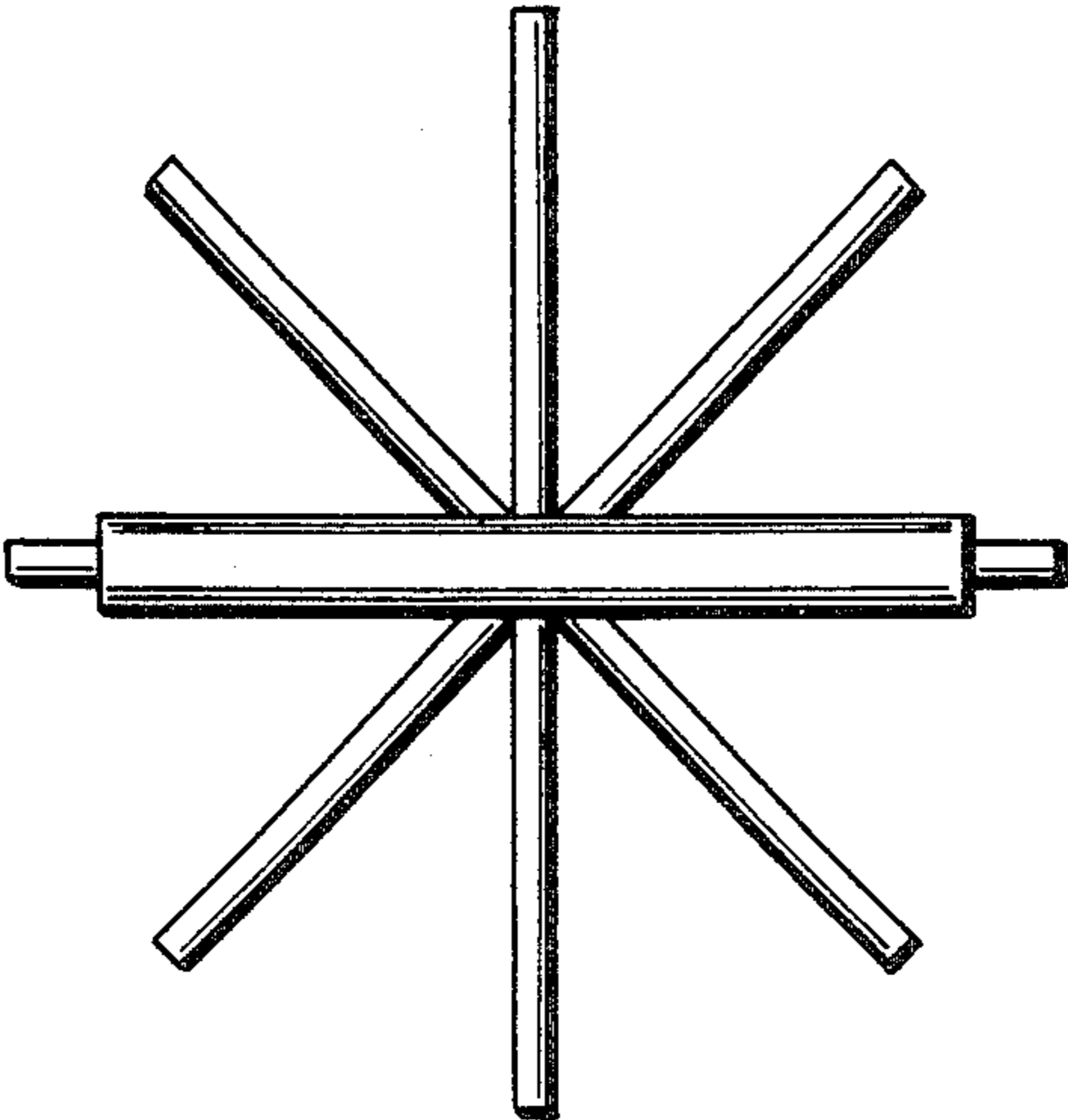

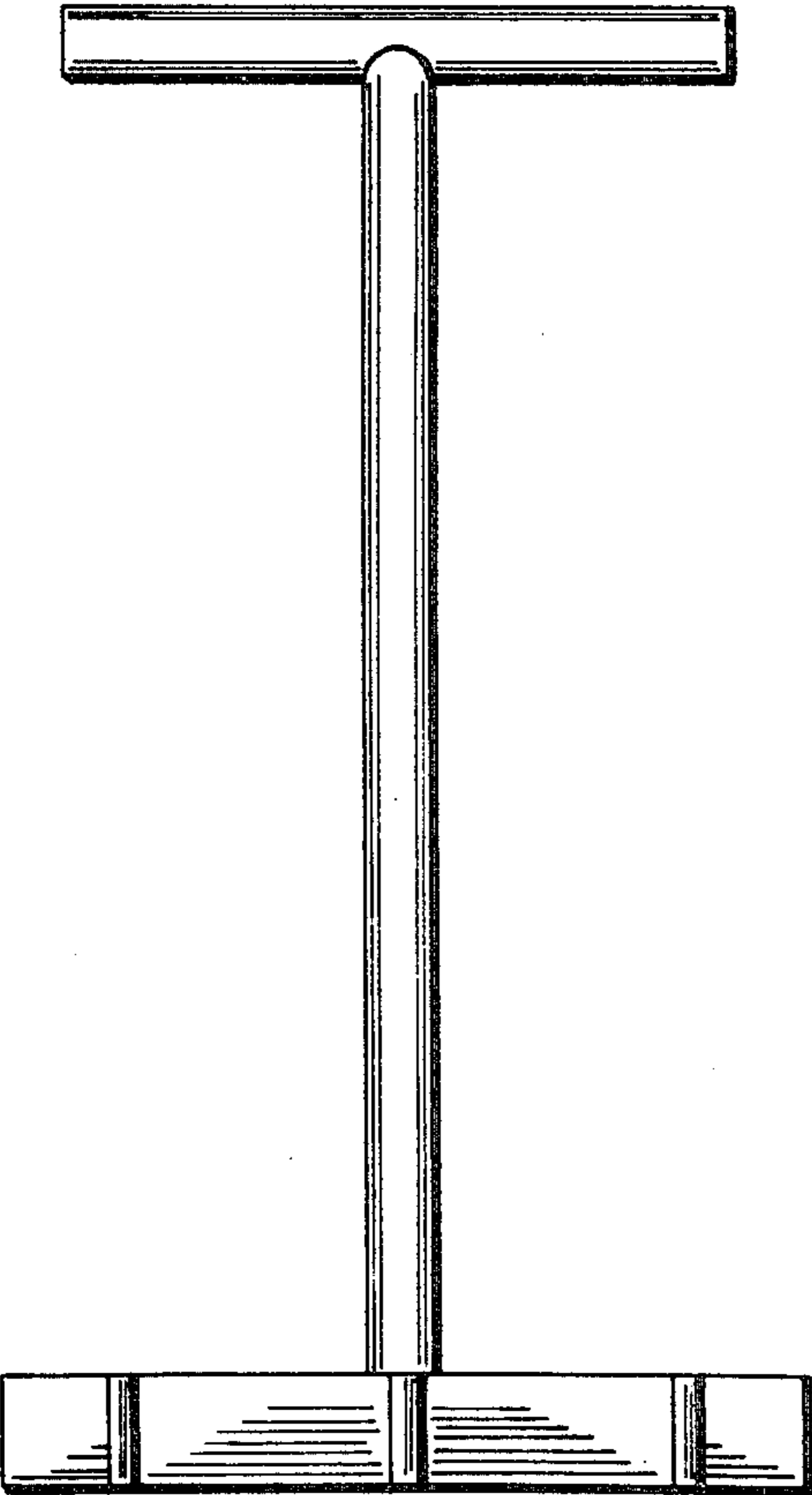

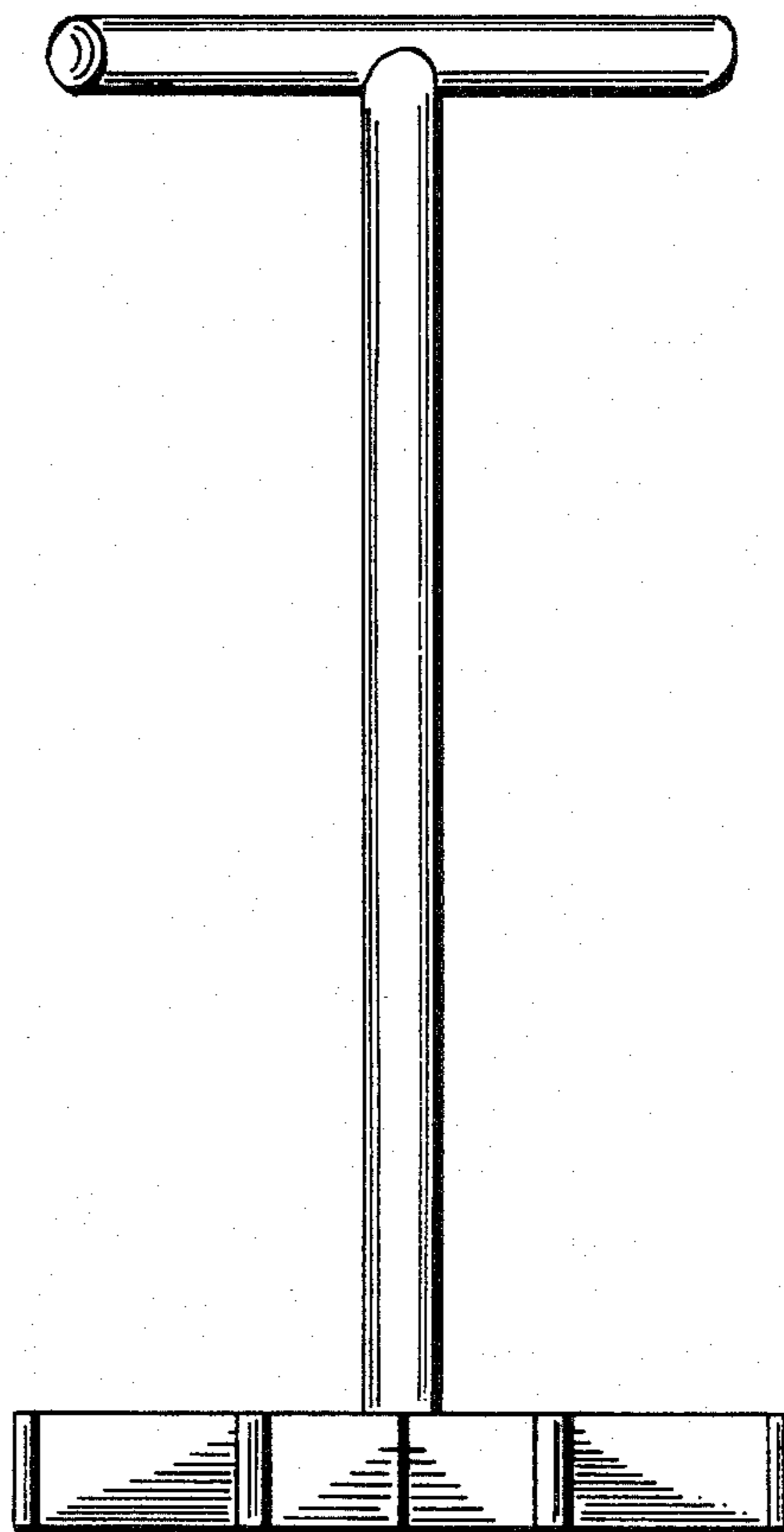

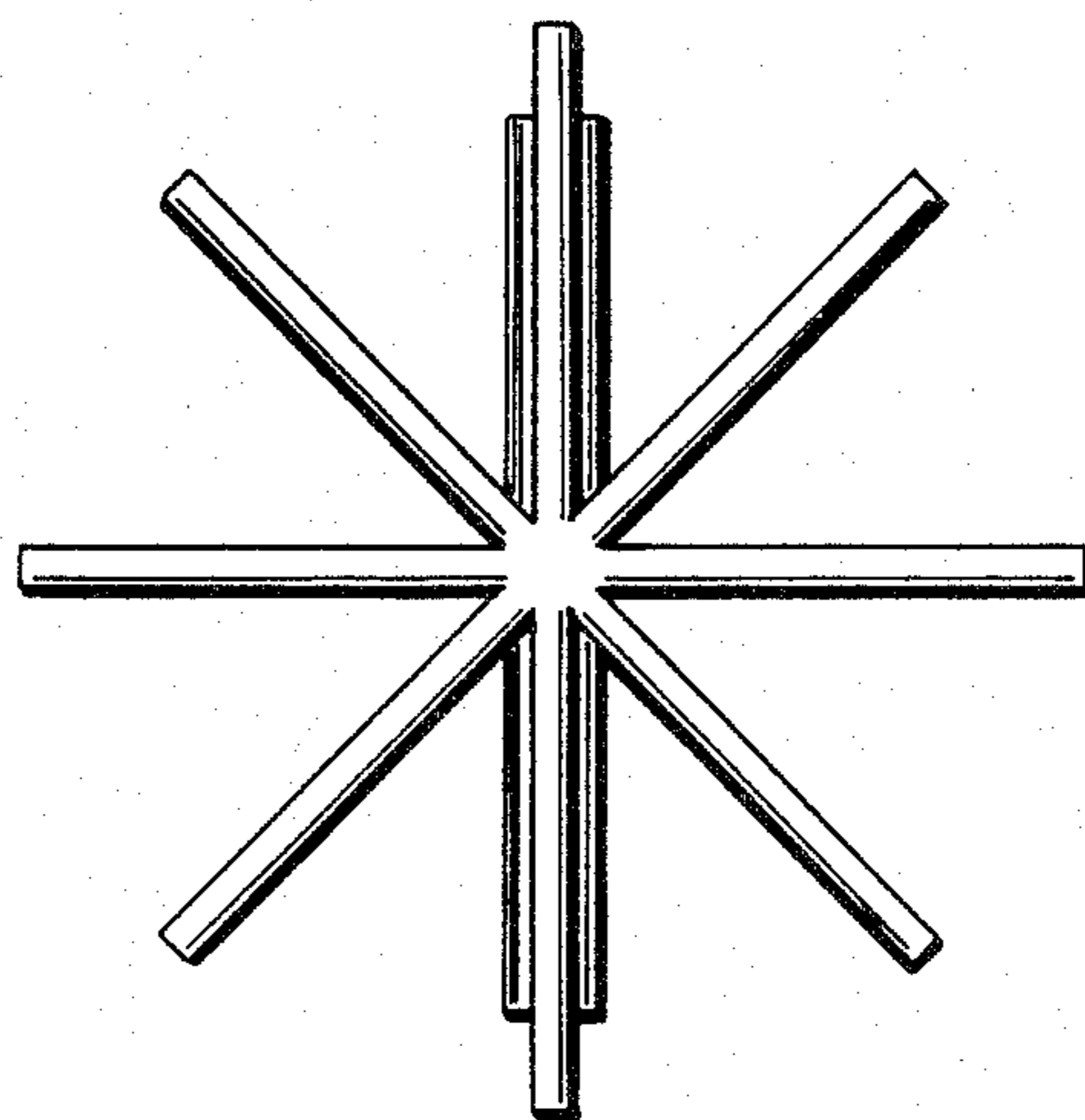
