[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lower body protector, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a lower body protector showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear, bottom and right side perspective view;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 5 is a view like FIG. 1 of a modified form of the lower body protector wherein the bottom thigh pads are eliminated;

FIG. 6 is a view like FIG. 2 thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

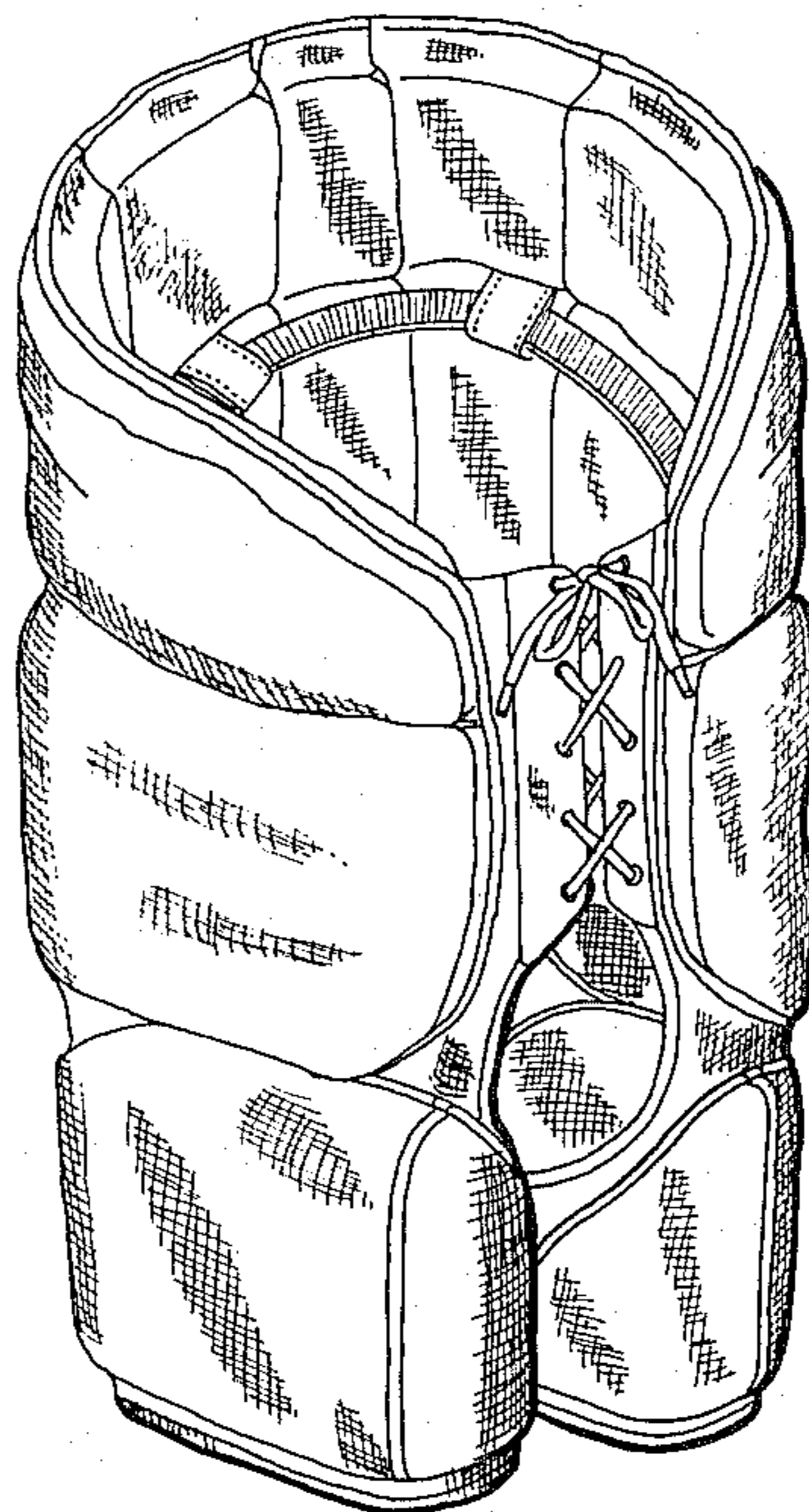

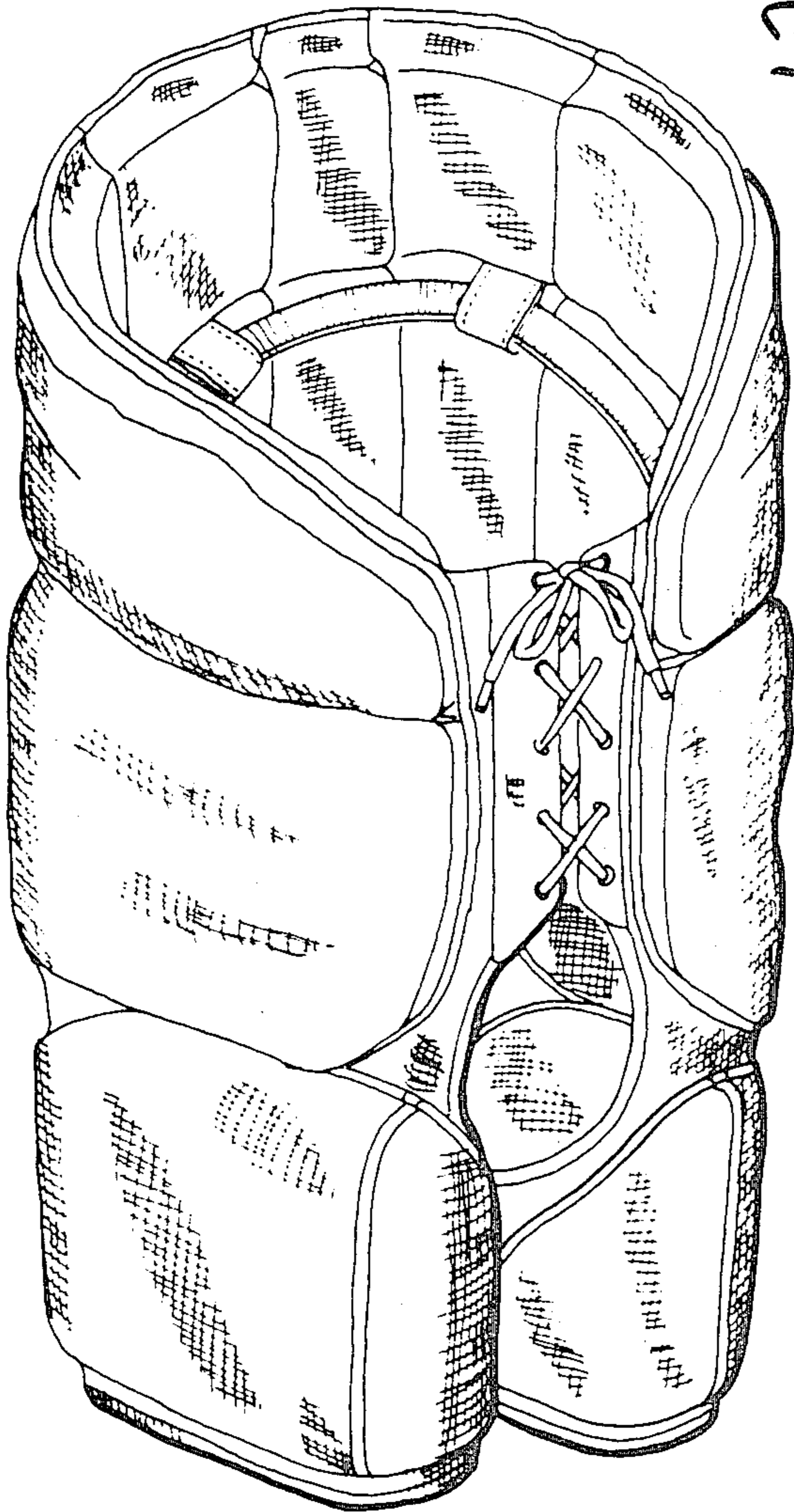

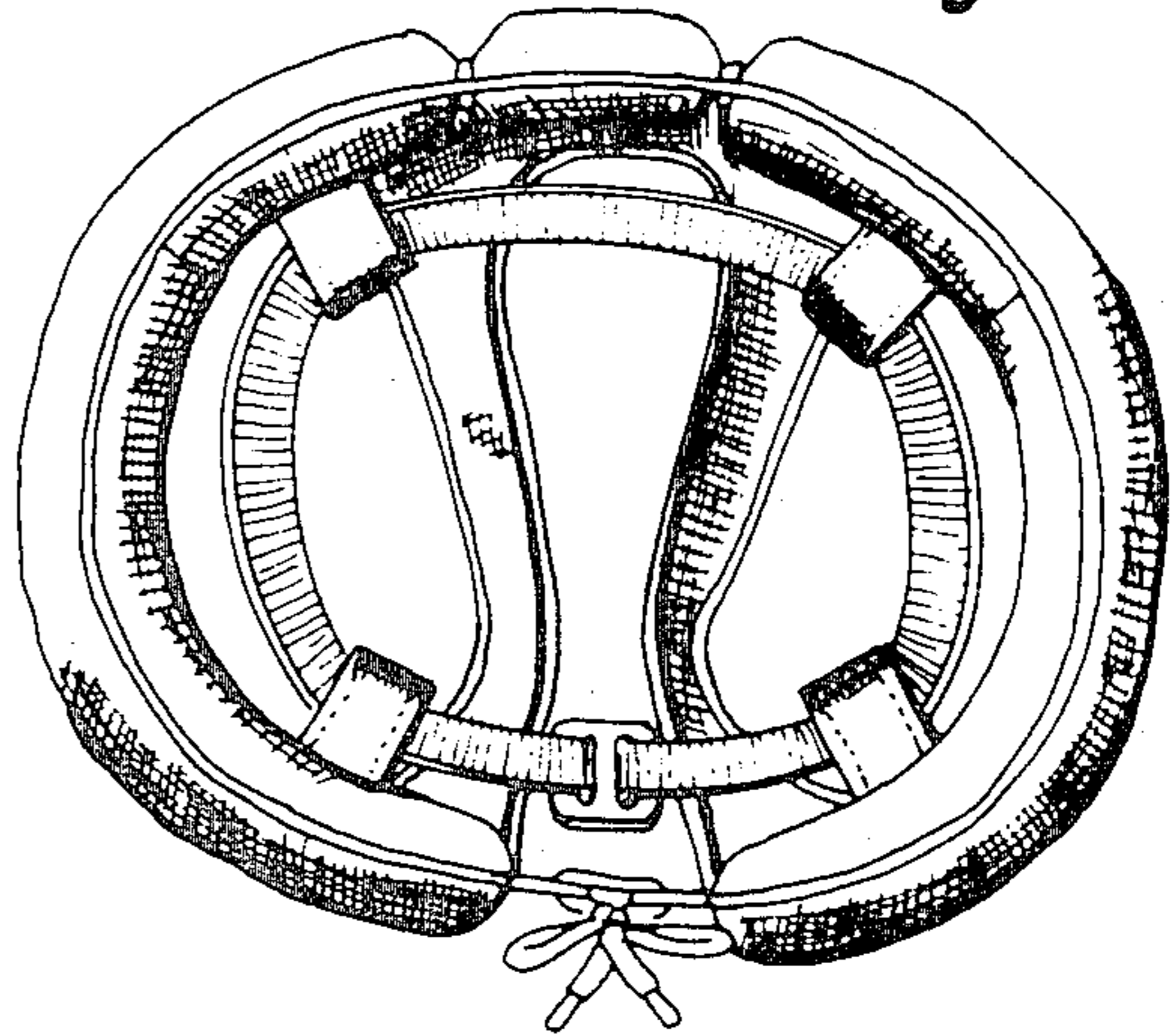

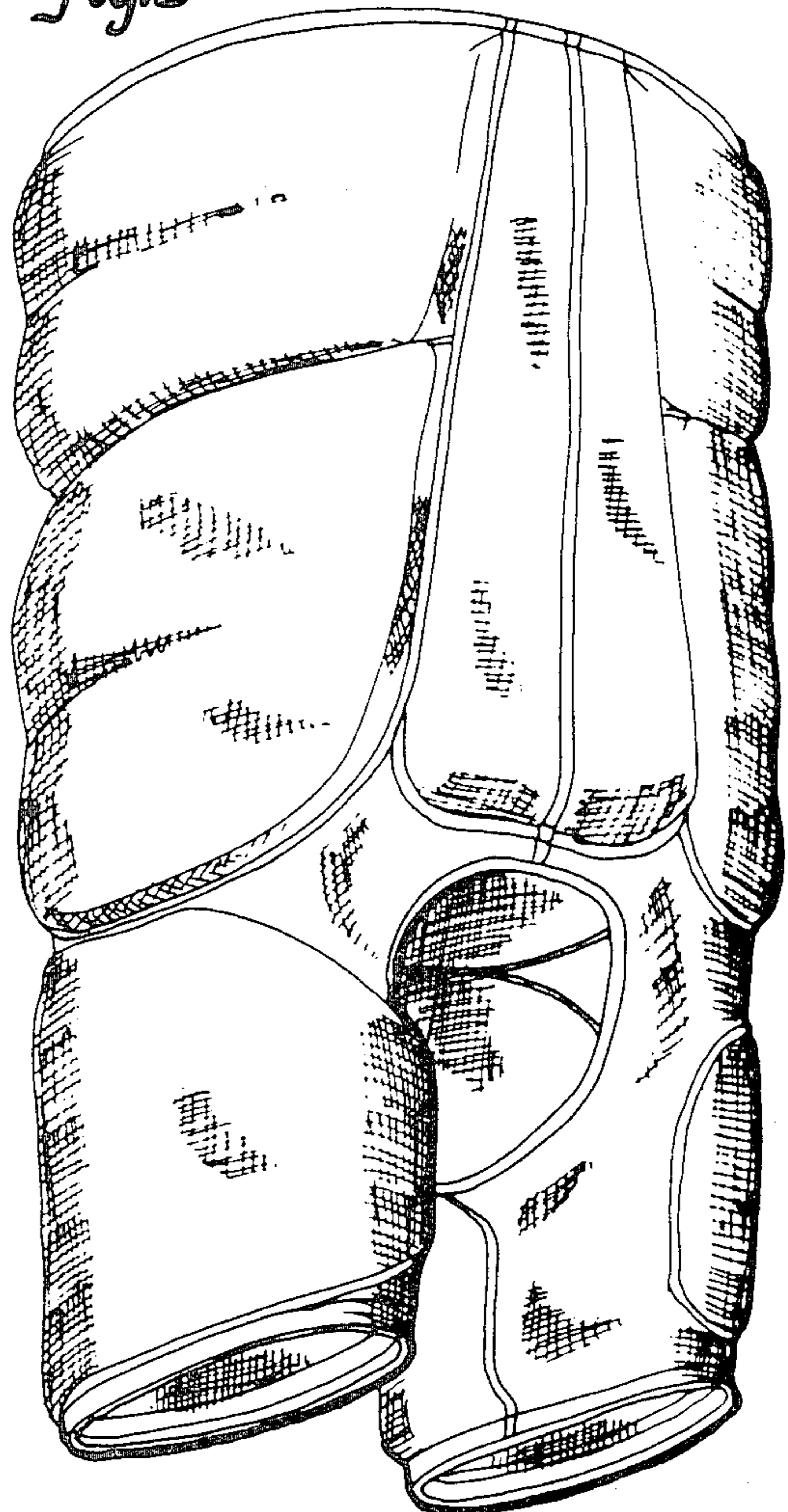

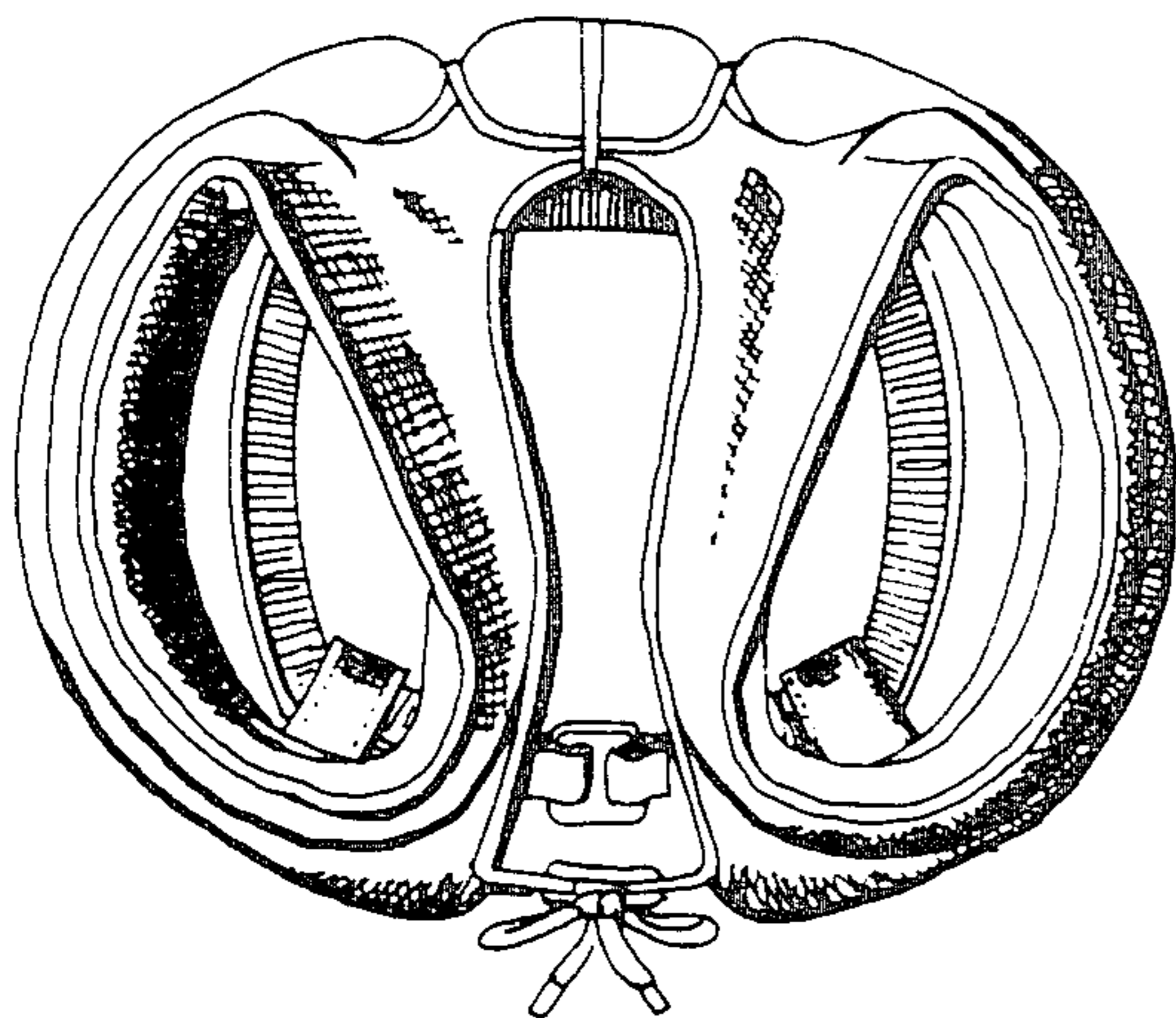

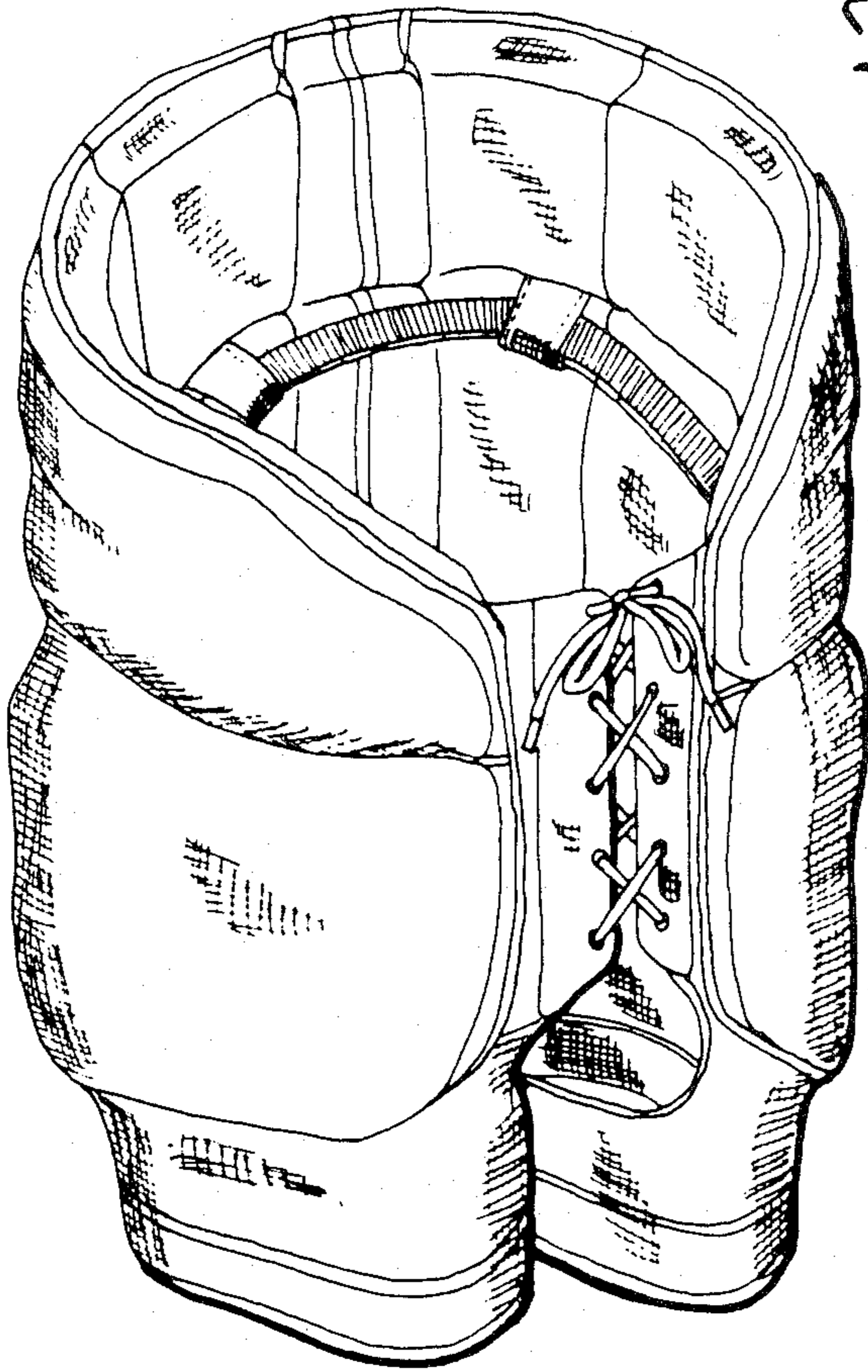

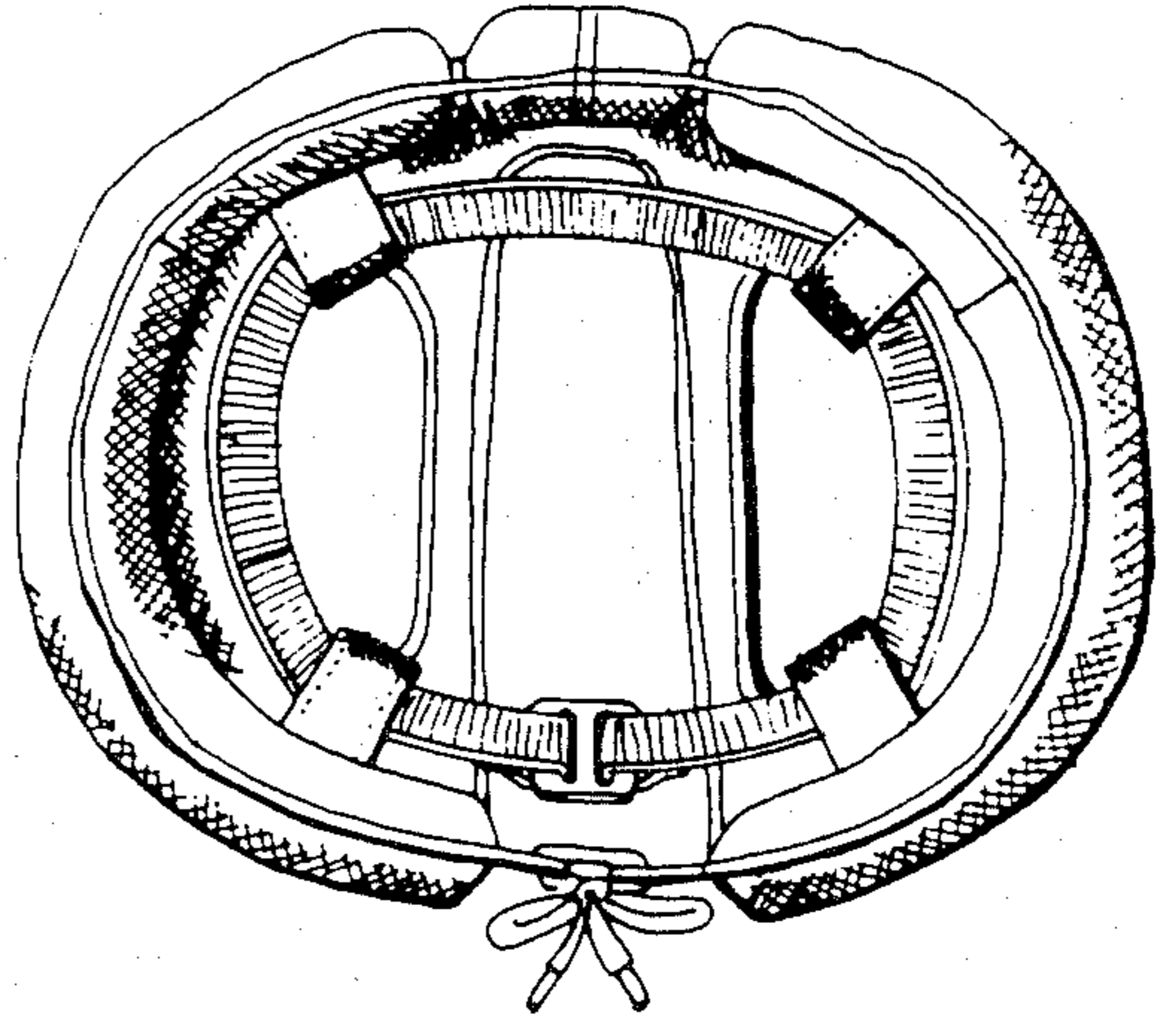

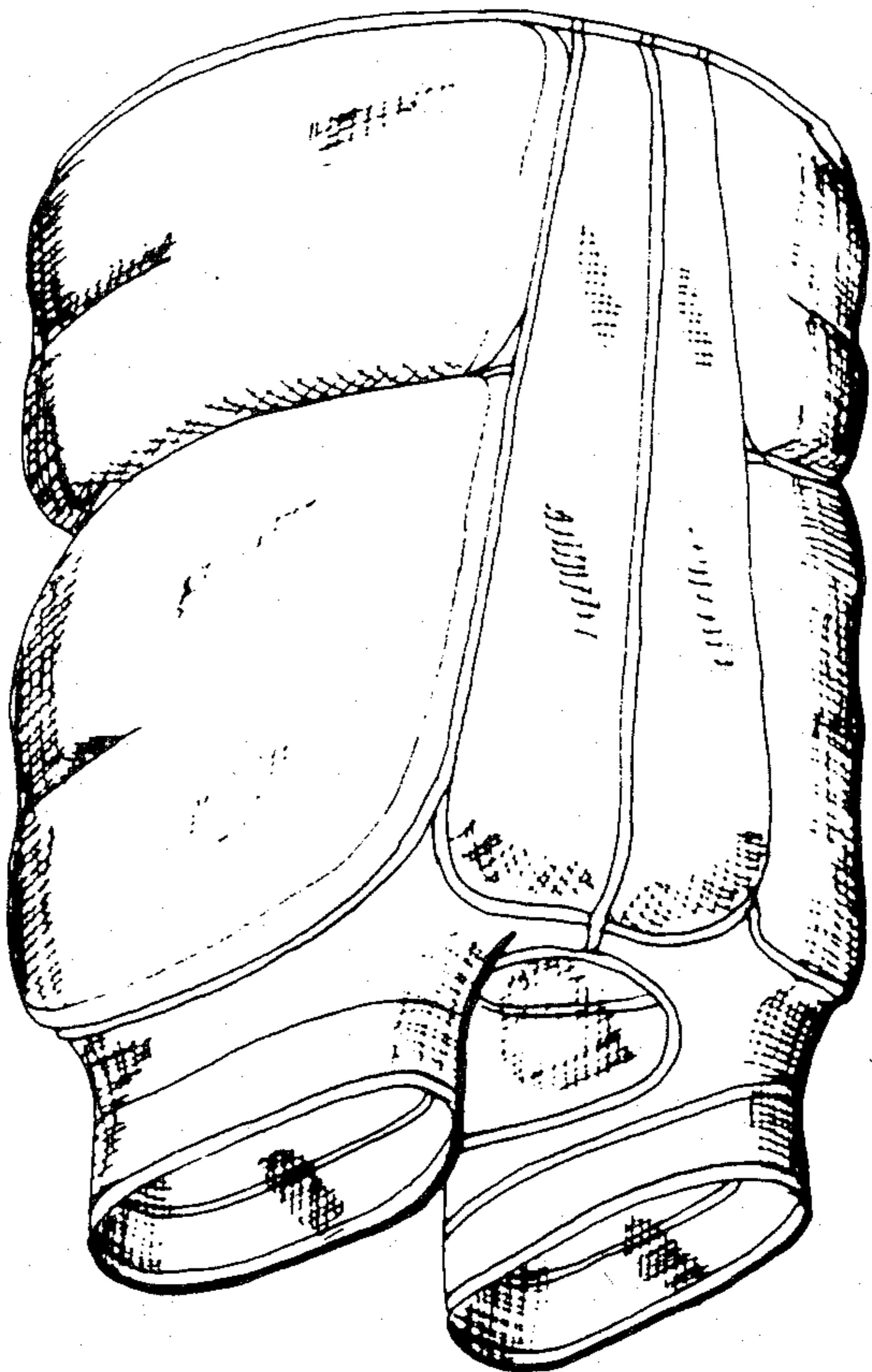
