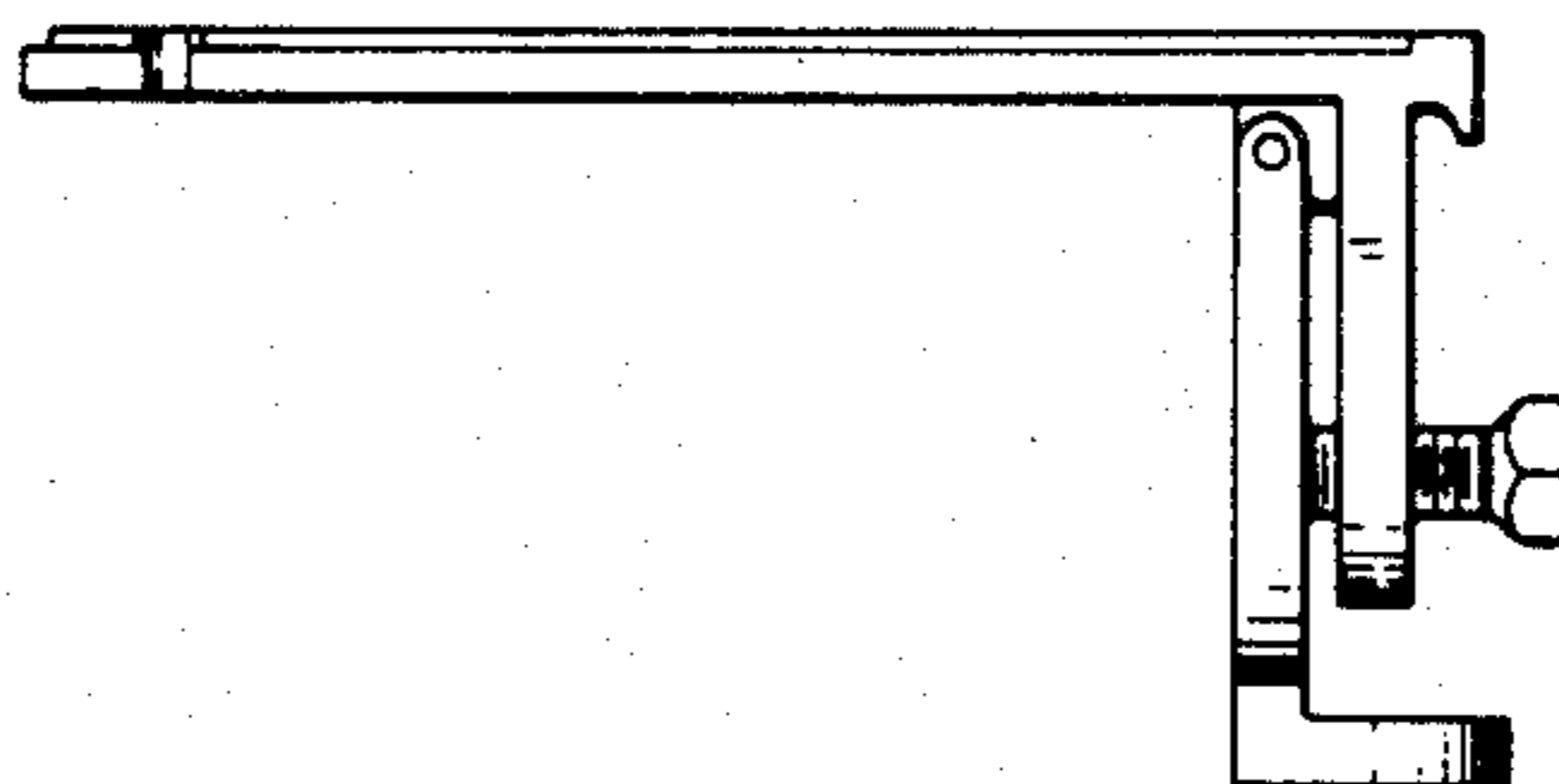
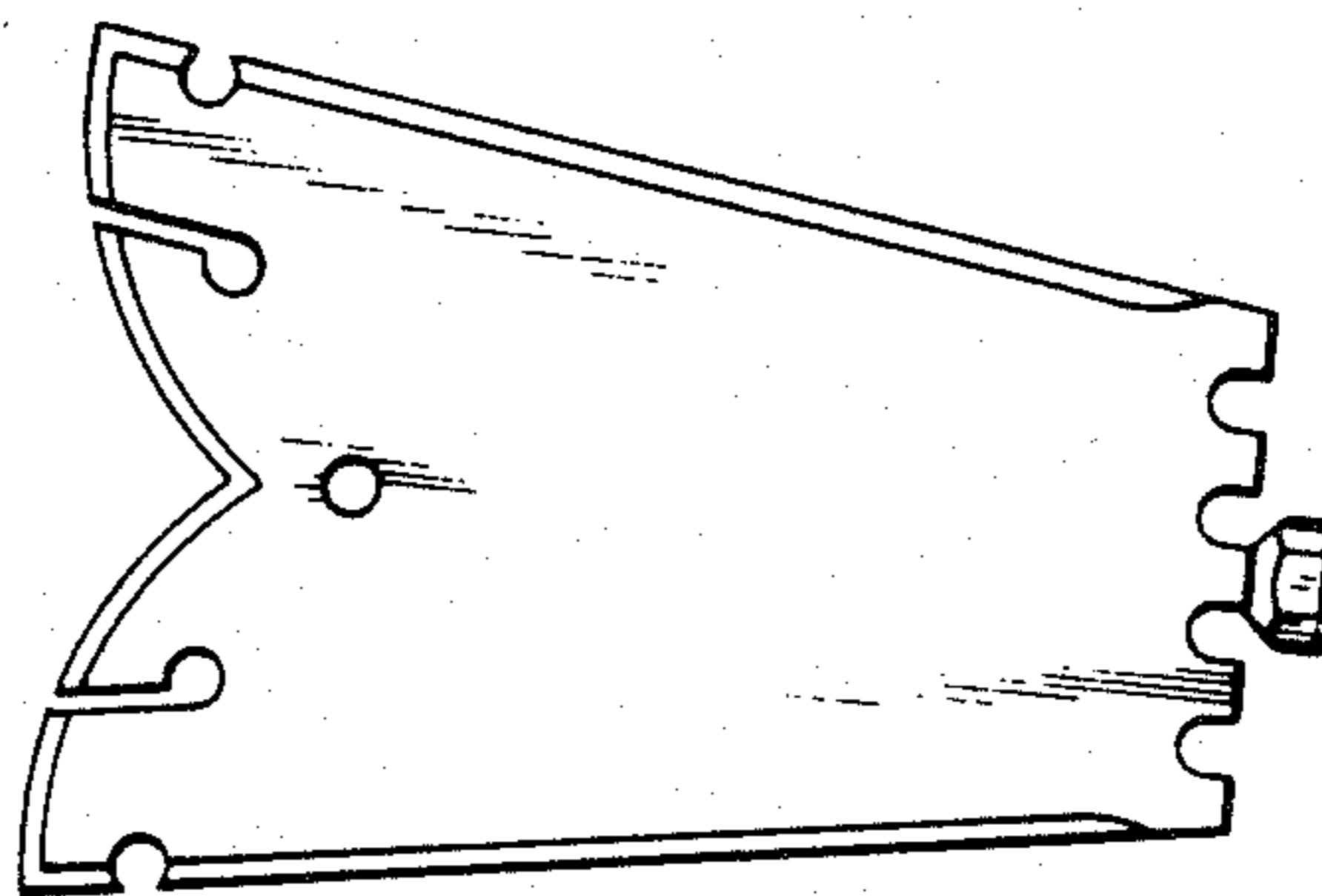

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tail piece for a banjo, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tail piece for a banjo showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



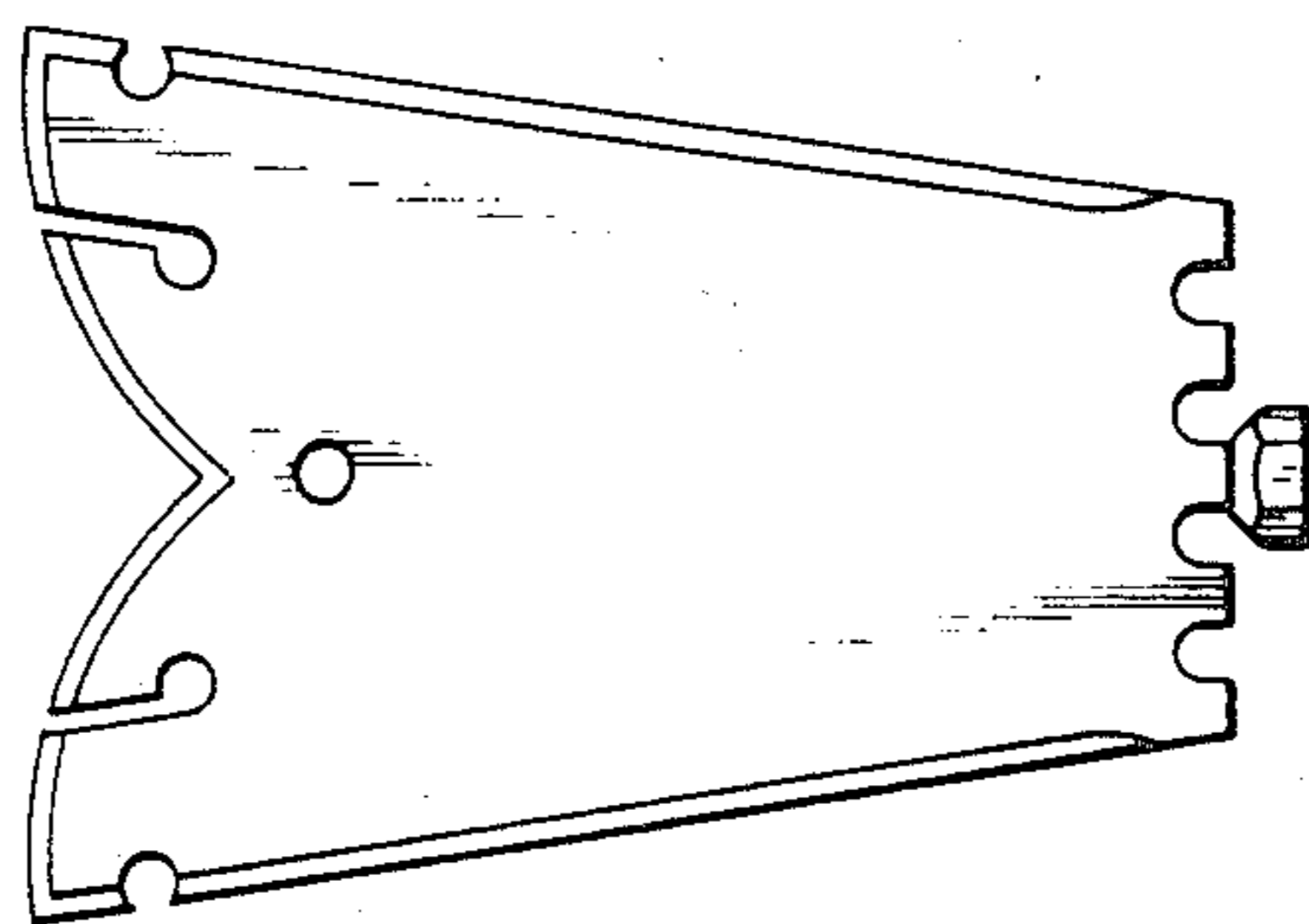

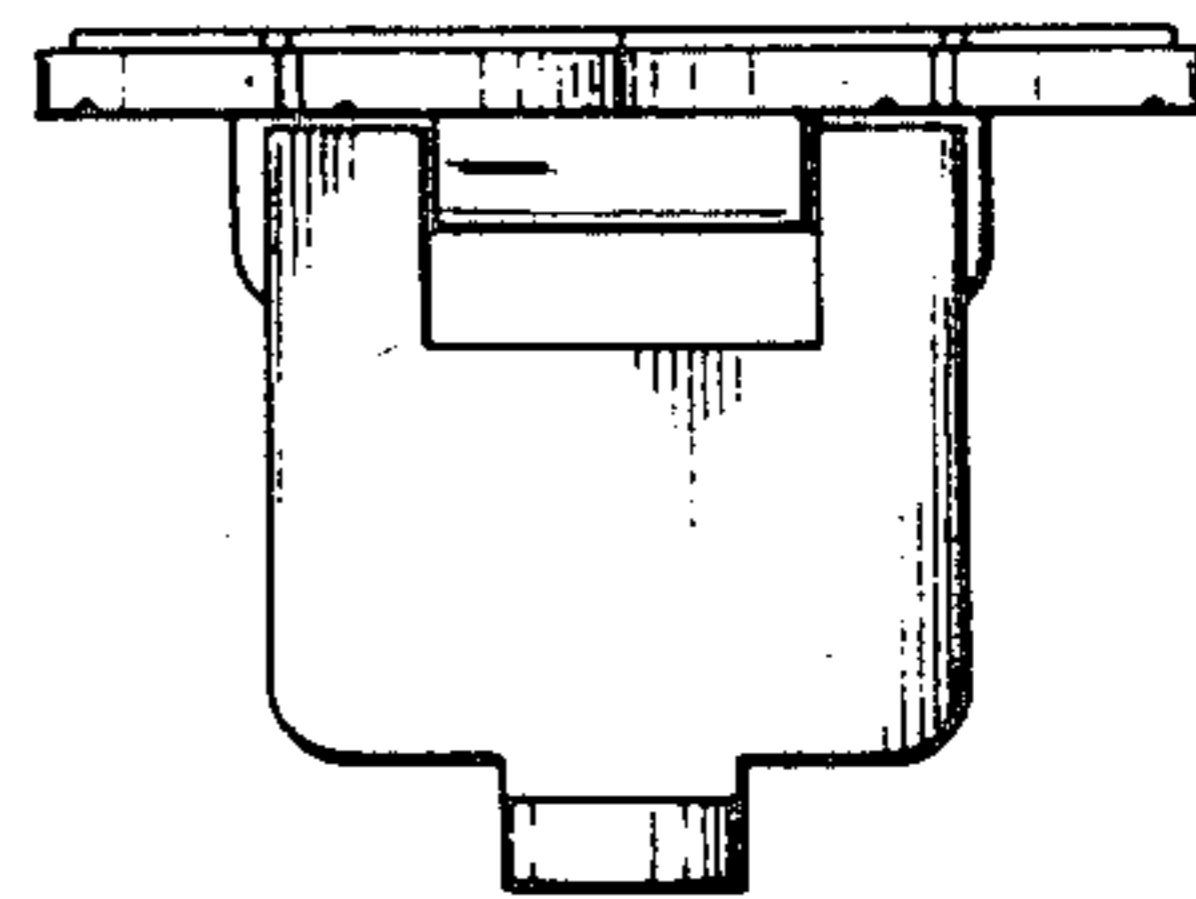

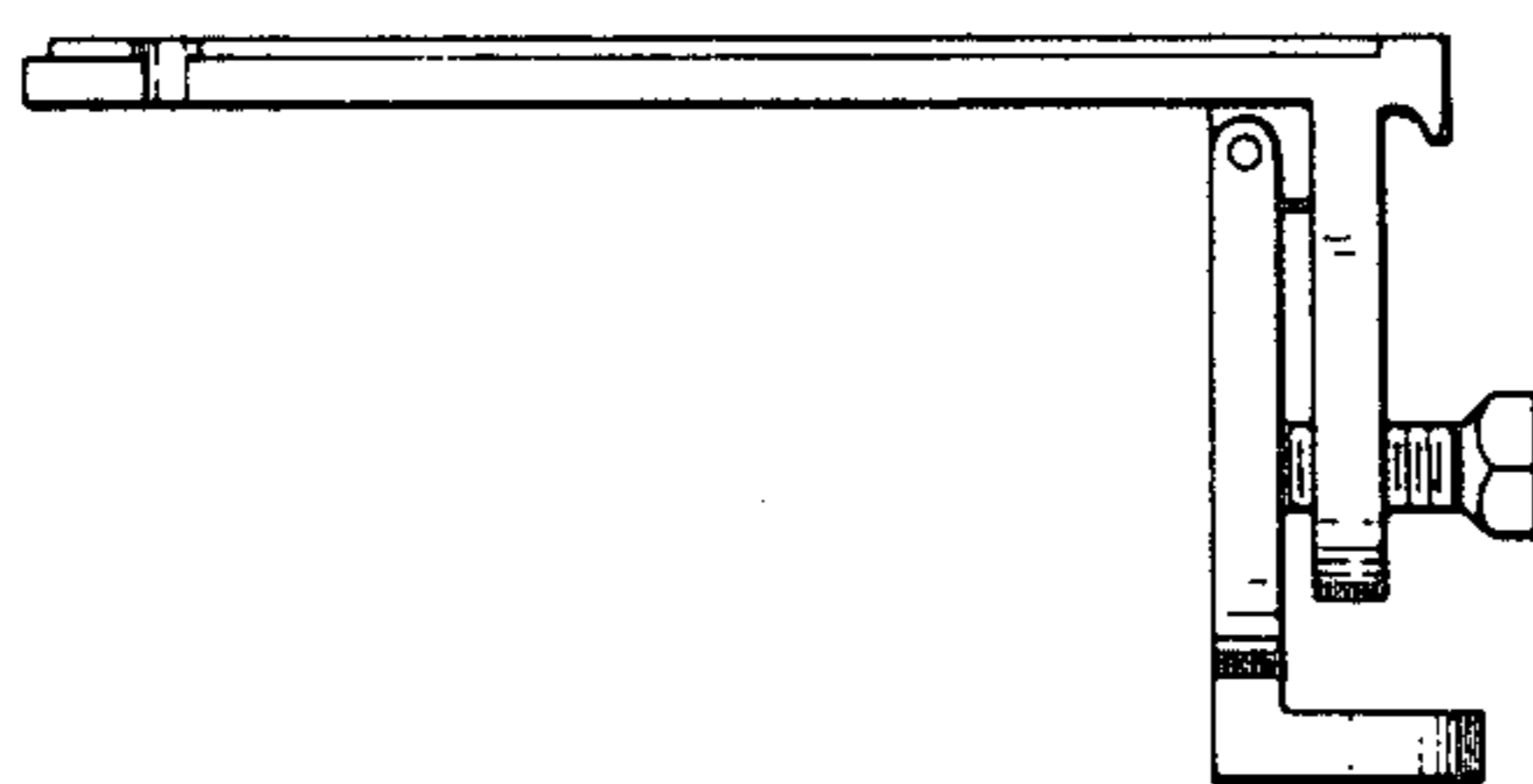

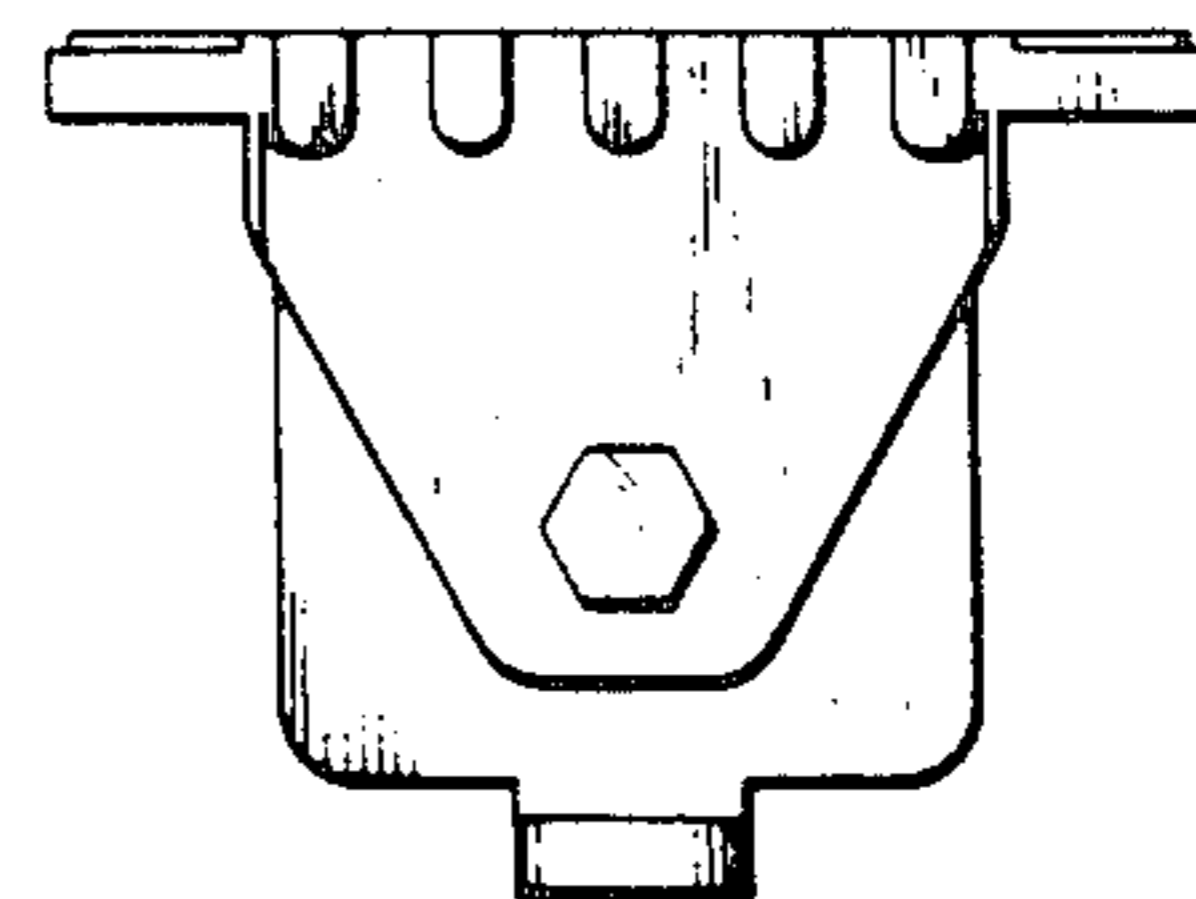

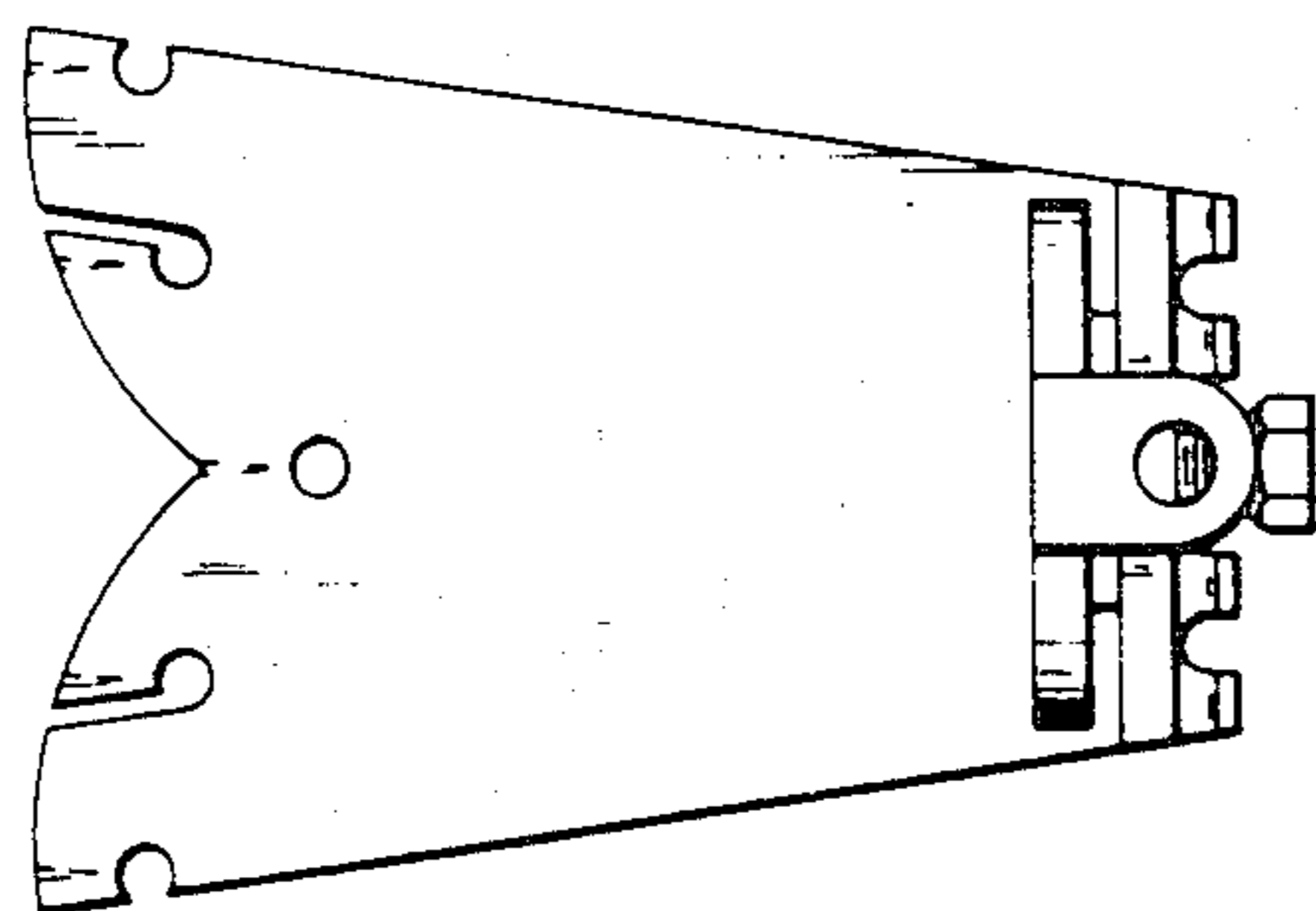
