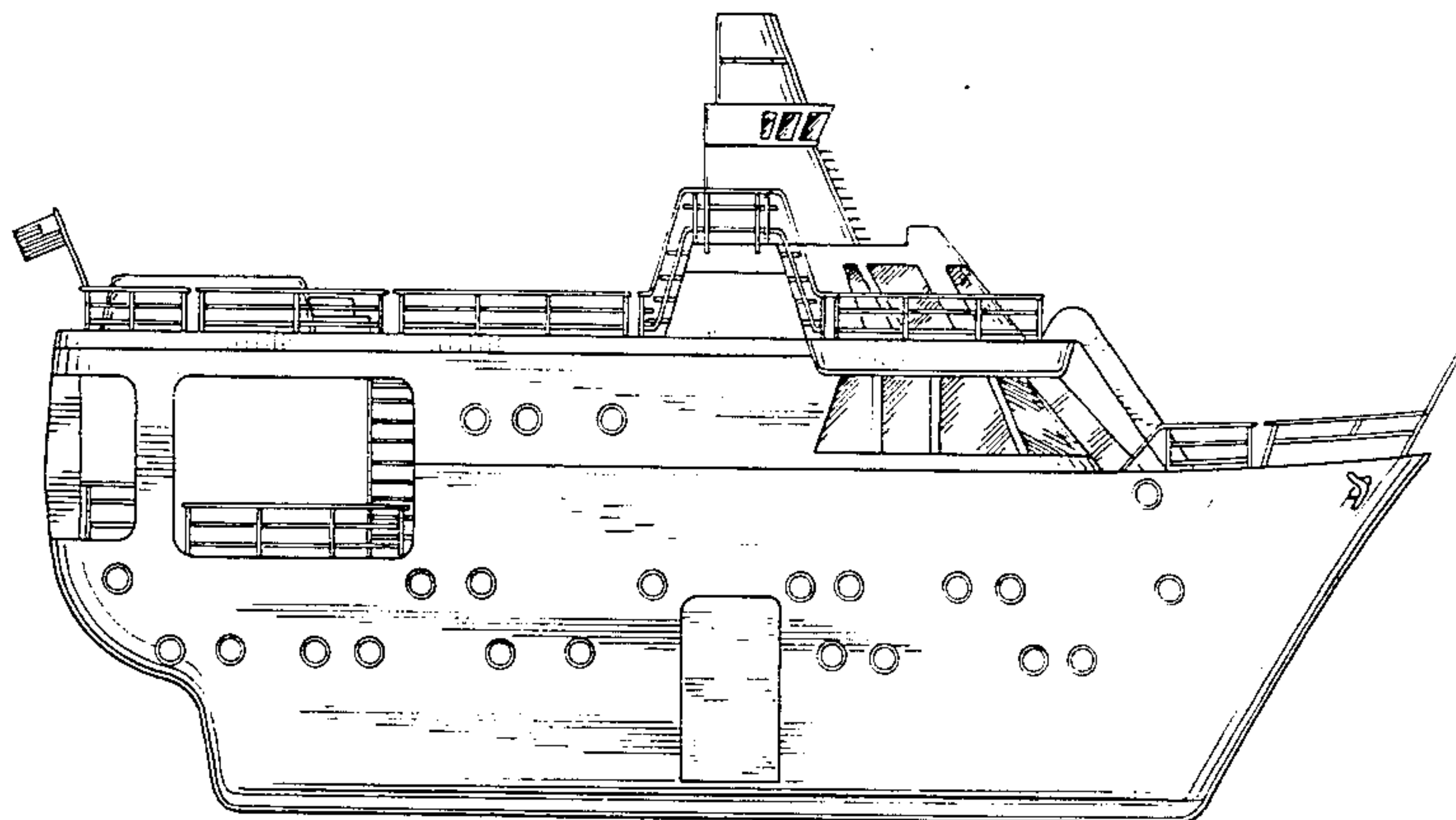

The ornamental design for a toy cruise ship, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a toy cruise ship showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view showing the opposite side of the cruise ship;

 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



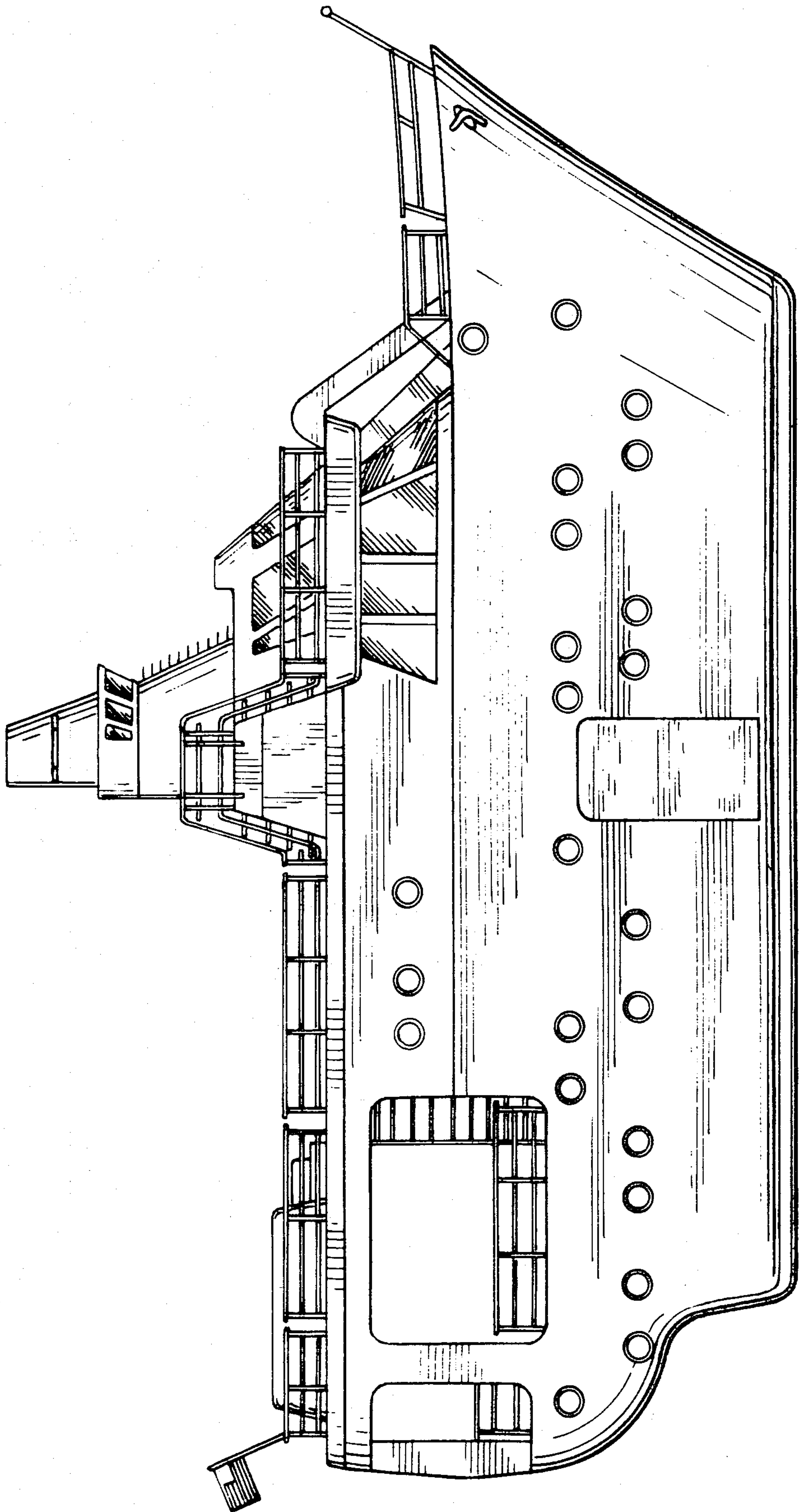

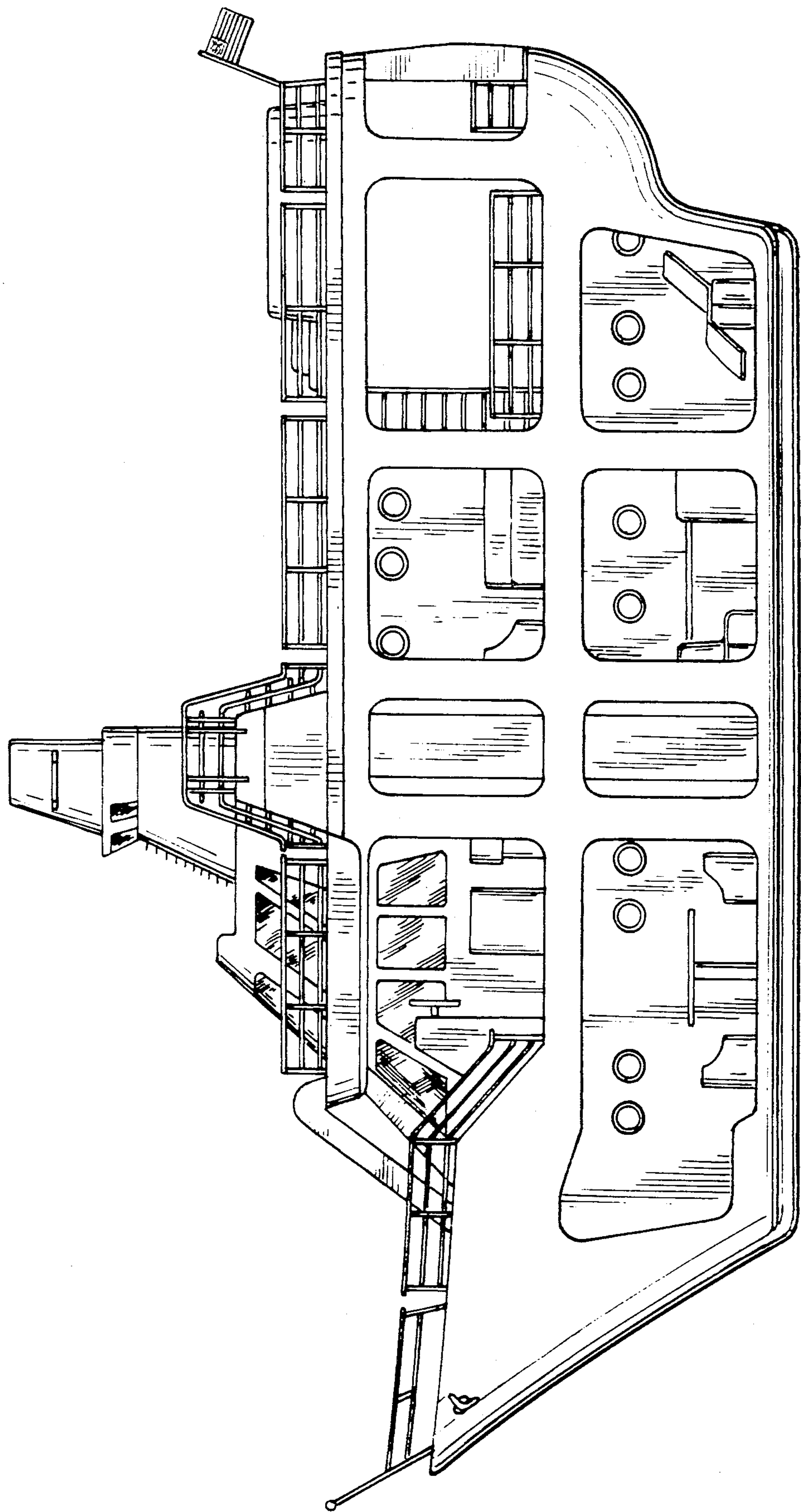

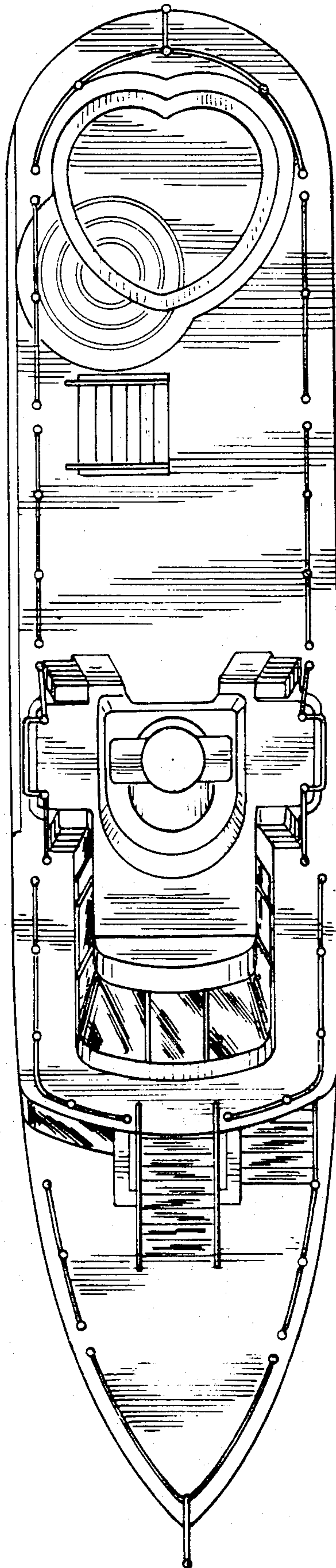

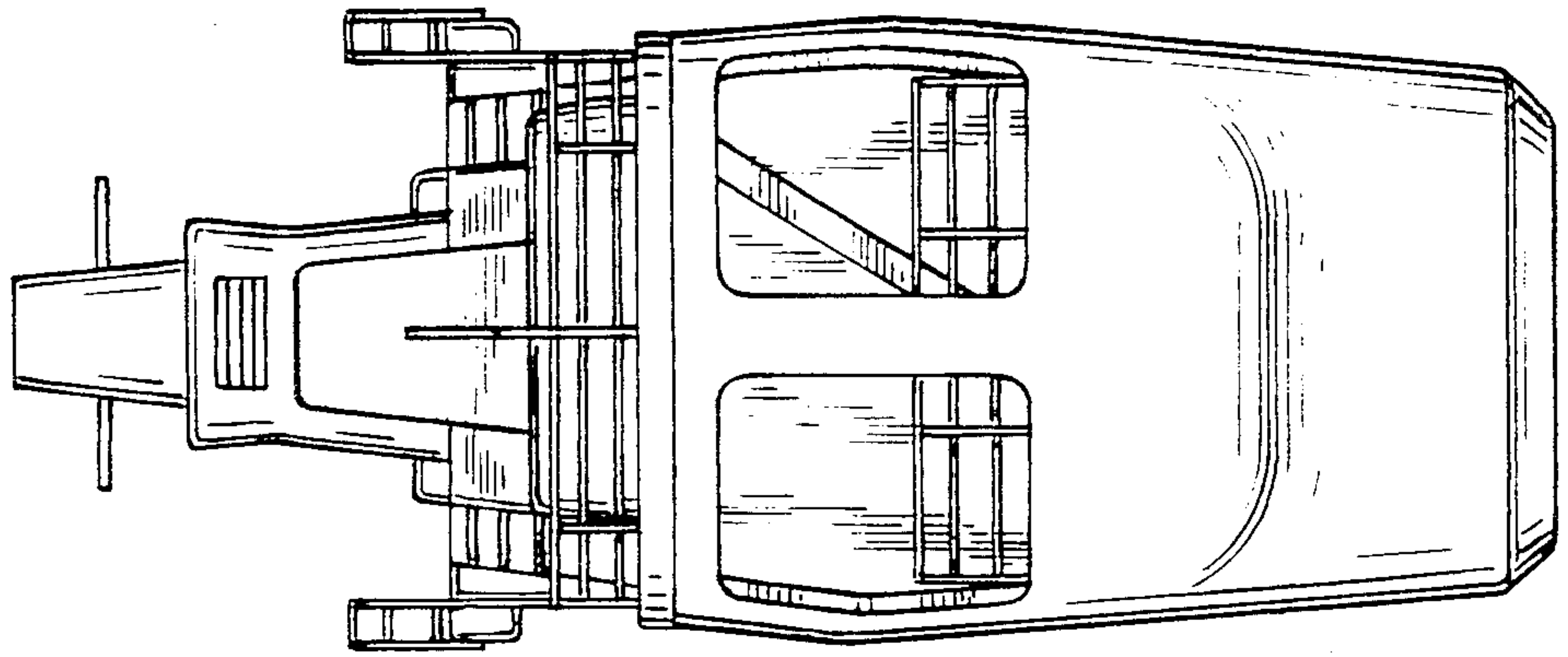

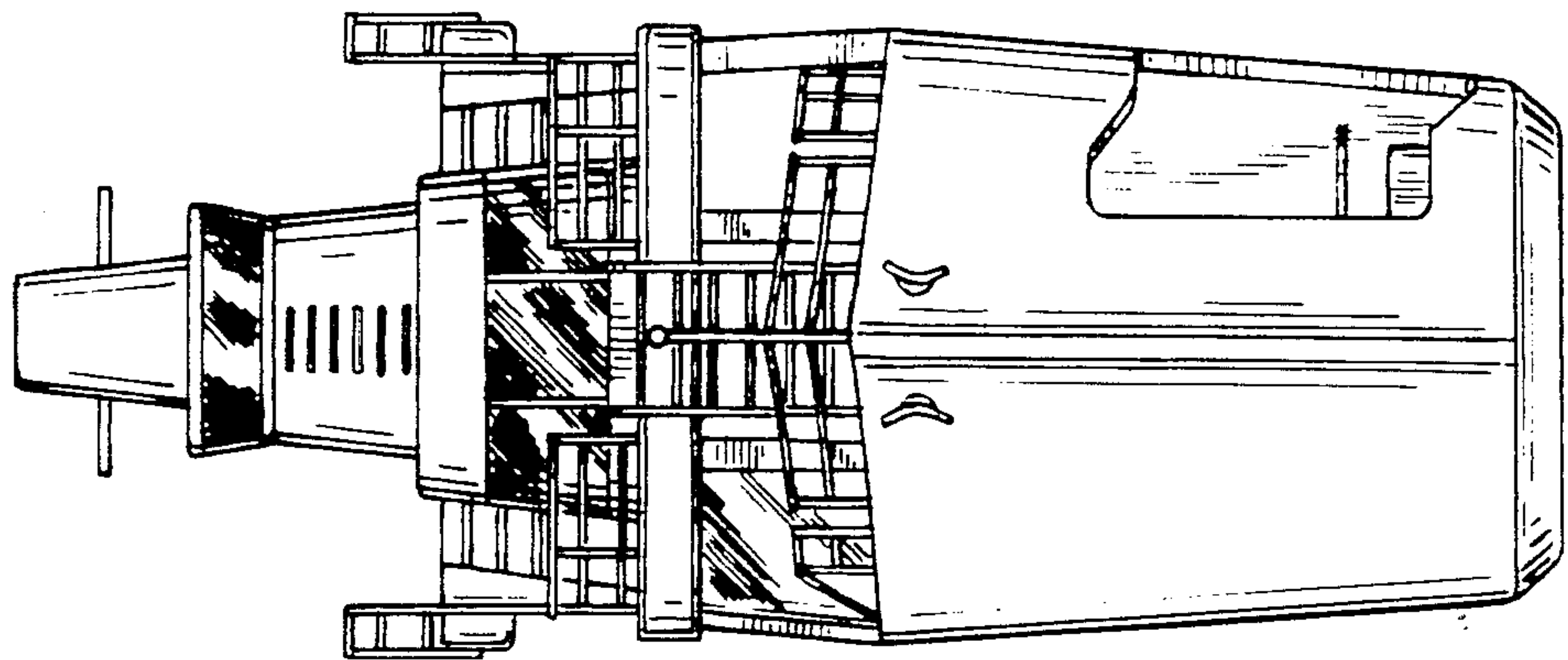
