FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof in the open position.

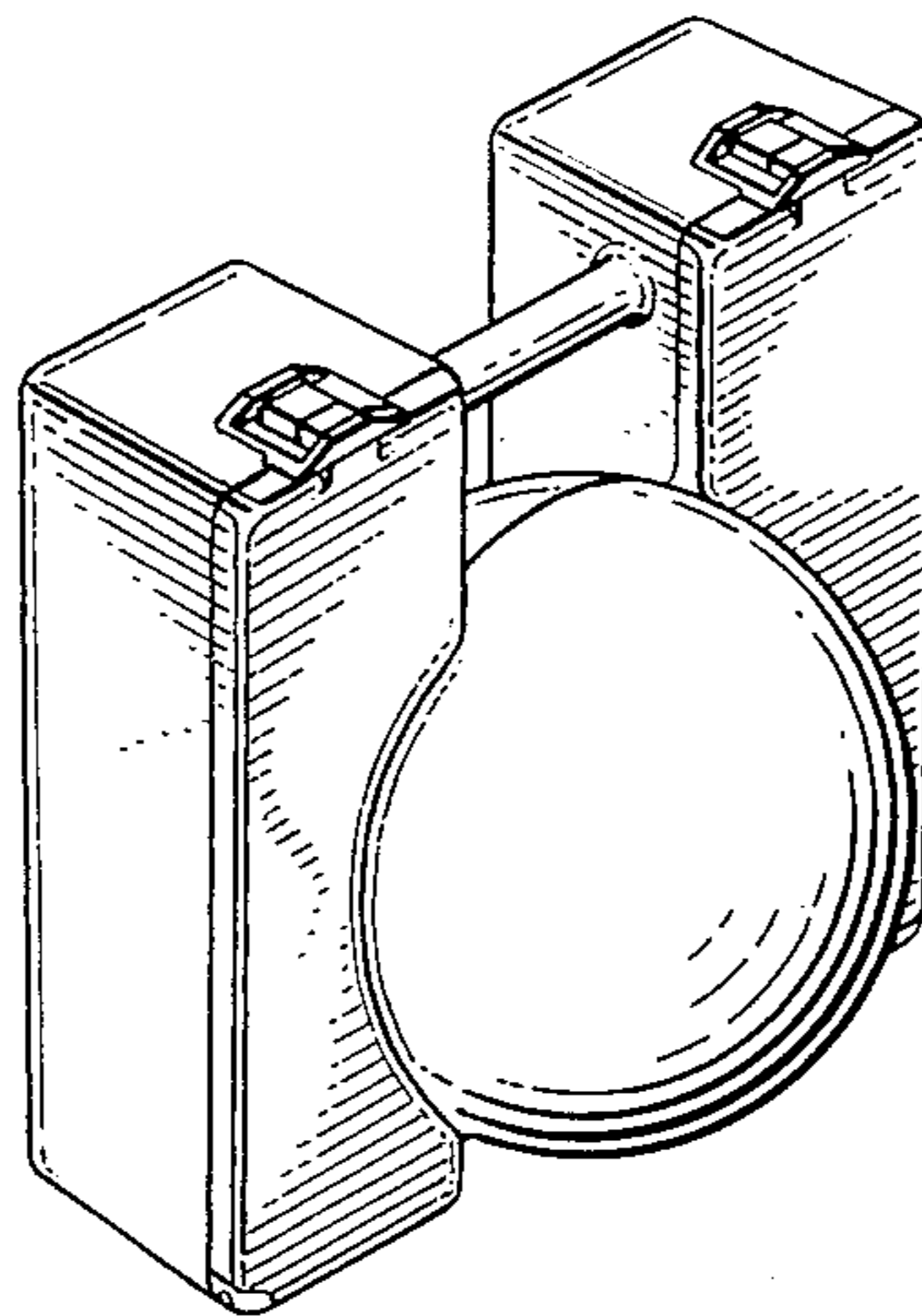

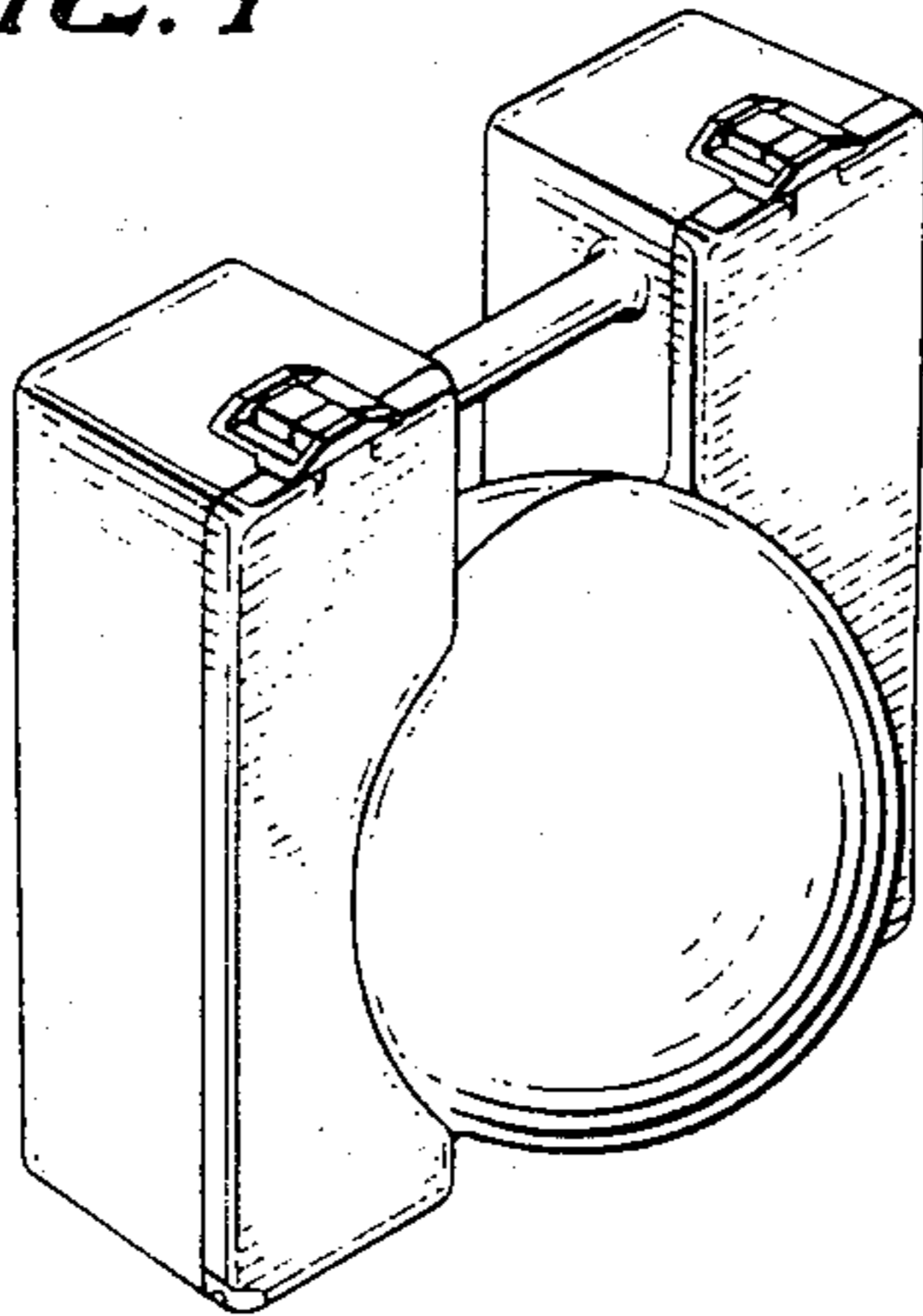

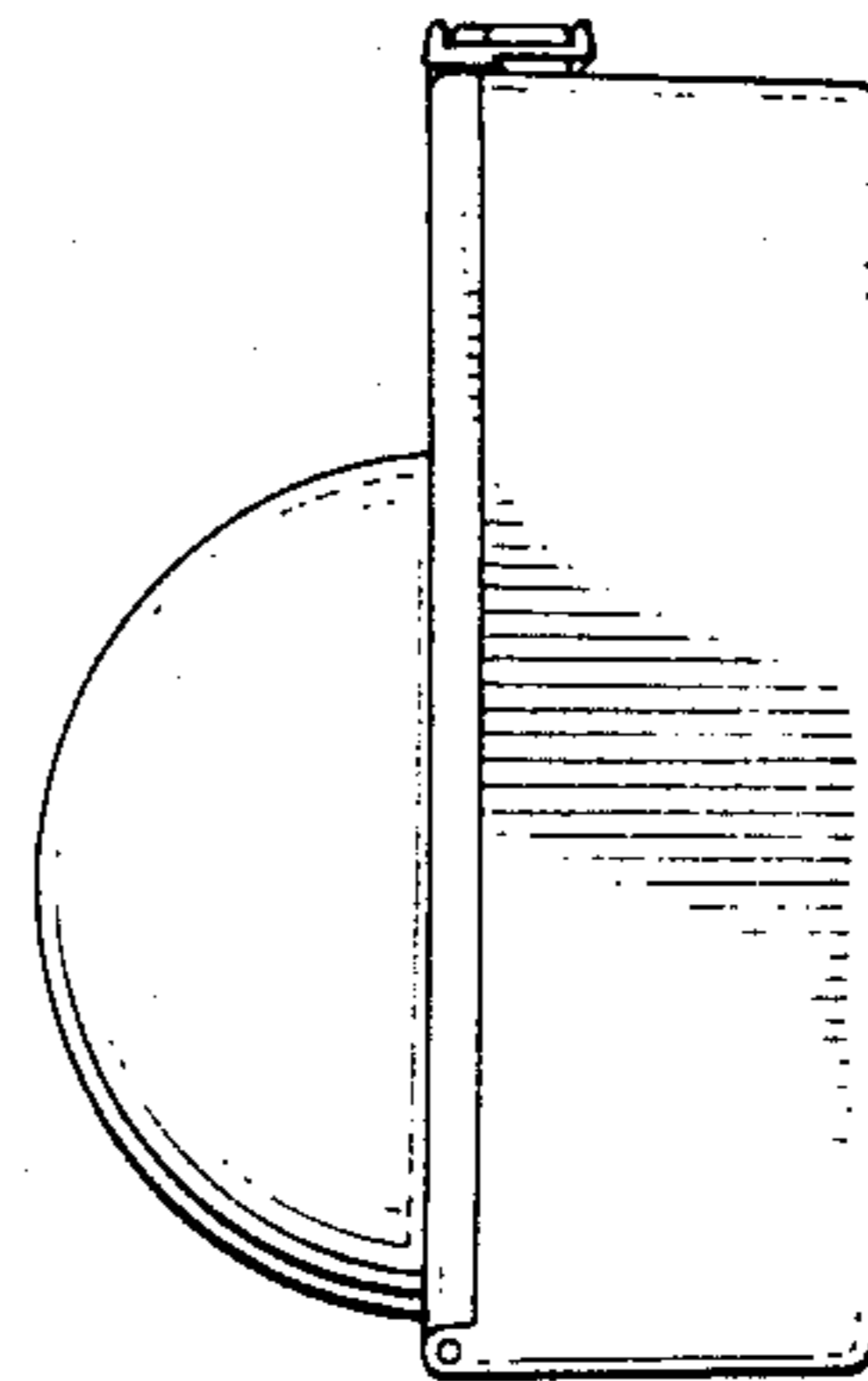

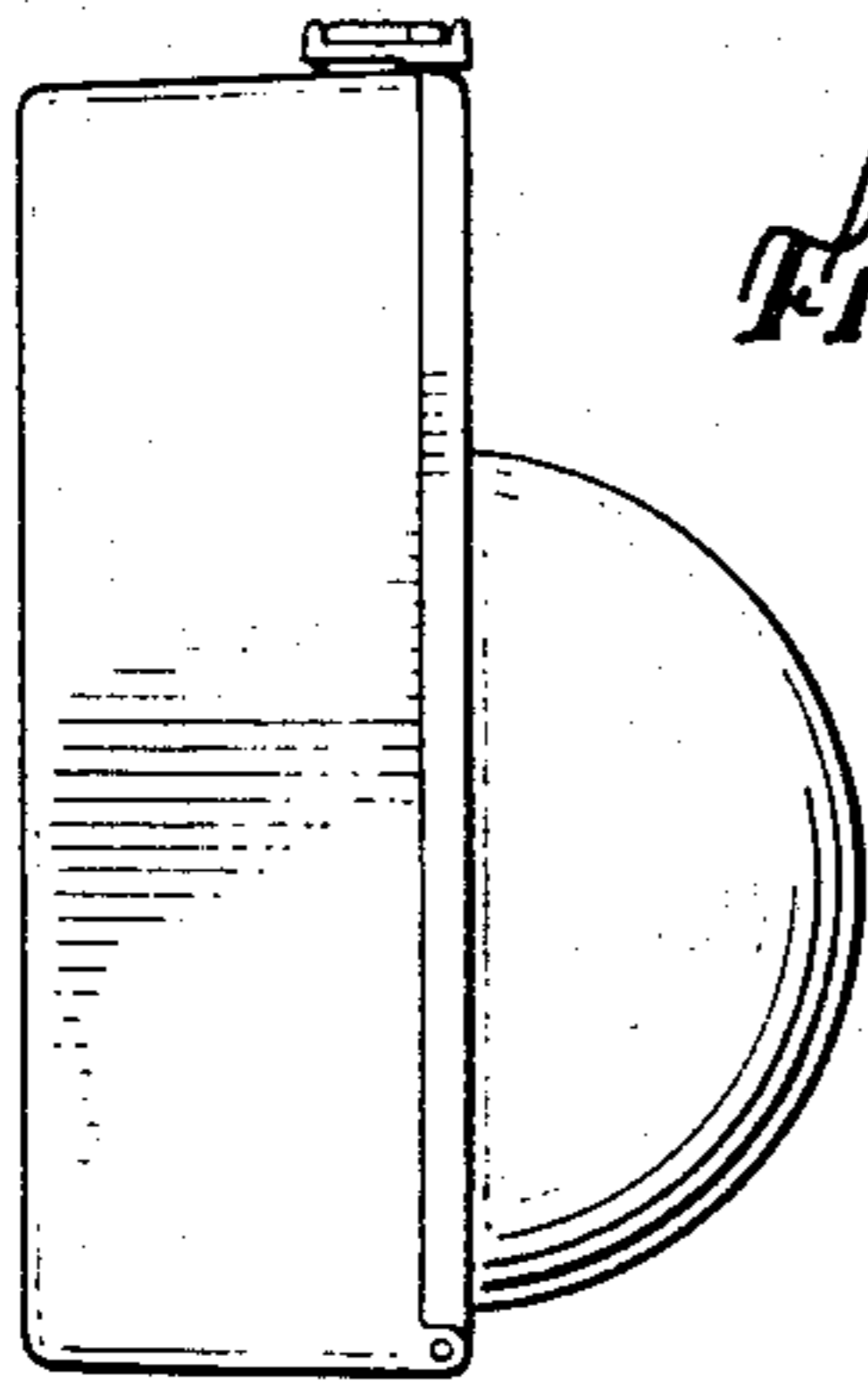
