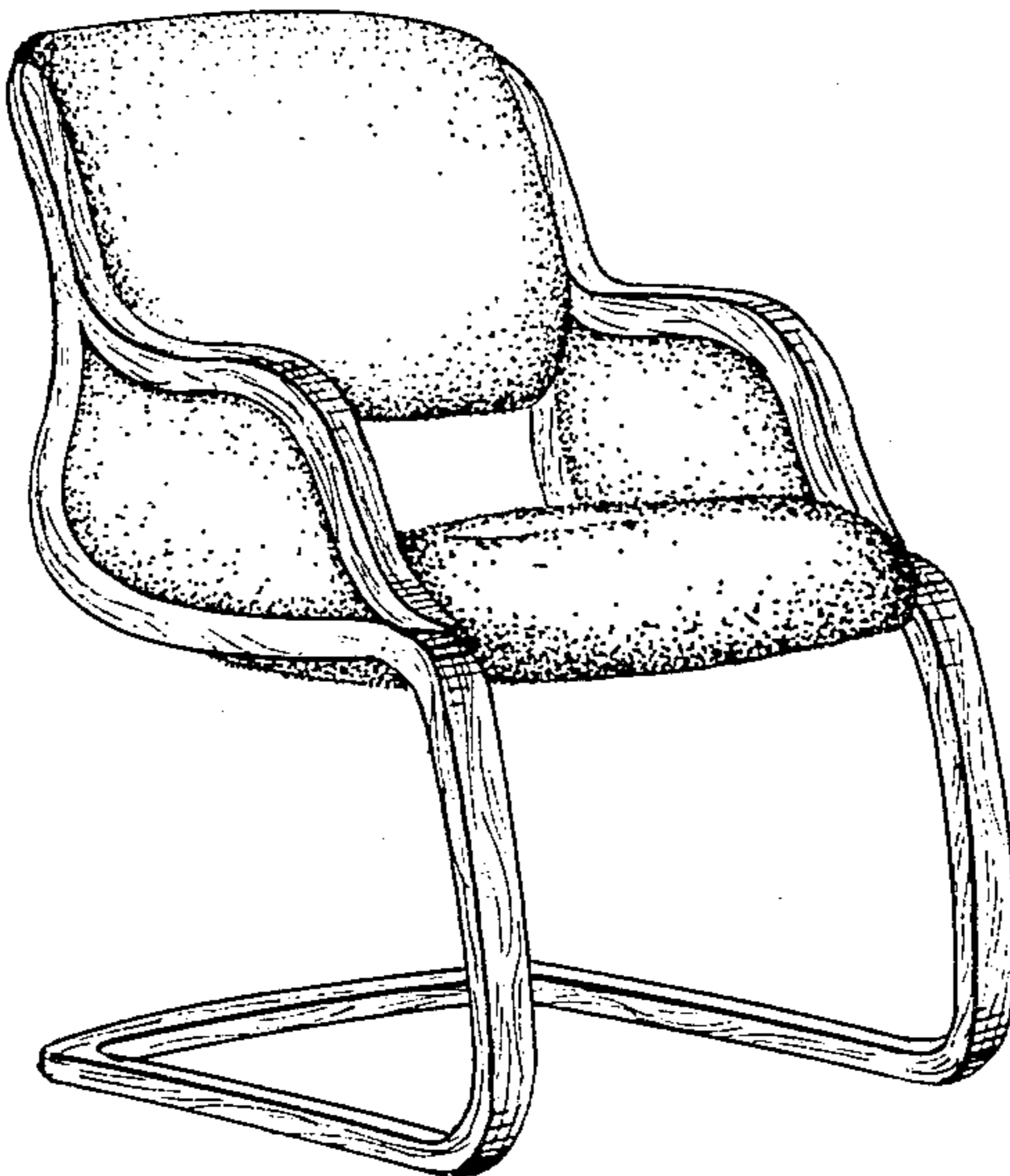
The ornamental design for the sled based arm chair with closed arm, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sled based arm chair with closed arm embodying my design.

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the design.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the design, taken from the right-hand side thereof, wherein the left-hand side is substantially identical.



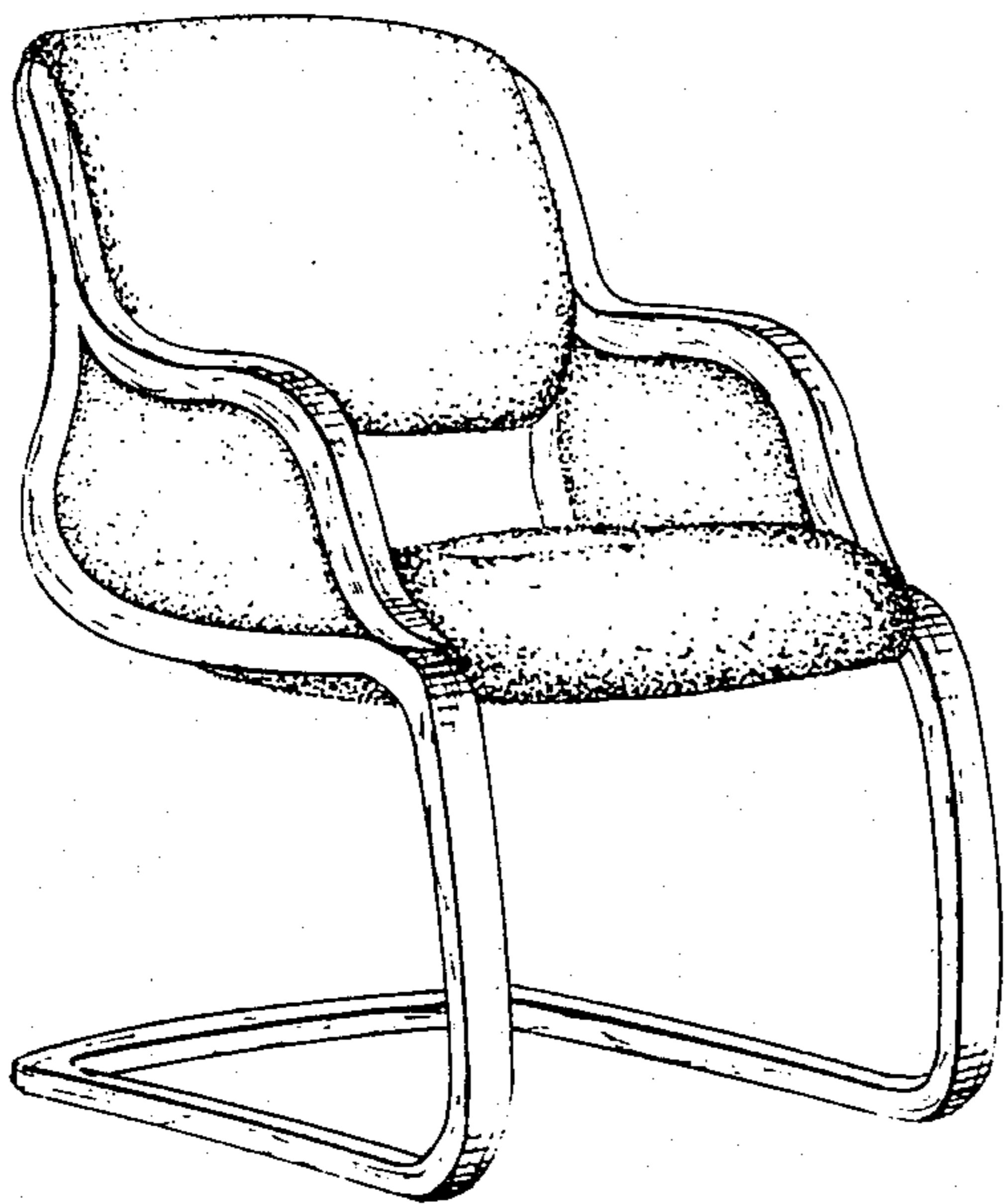

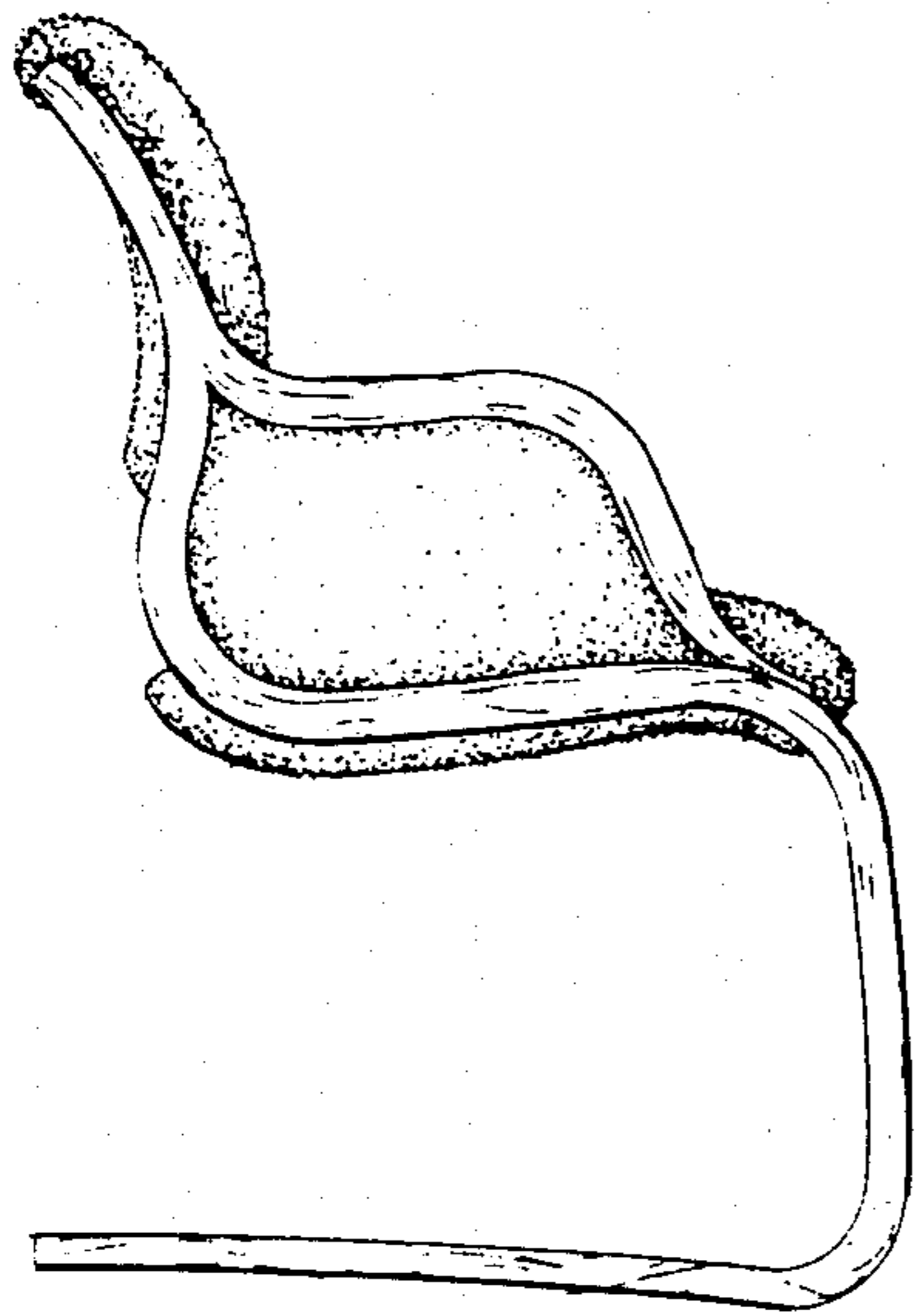

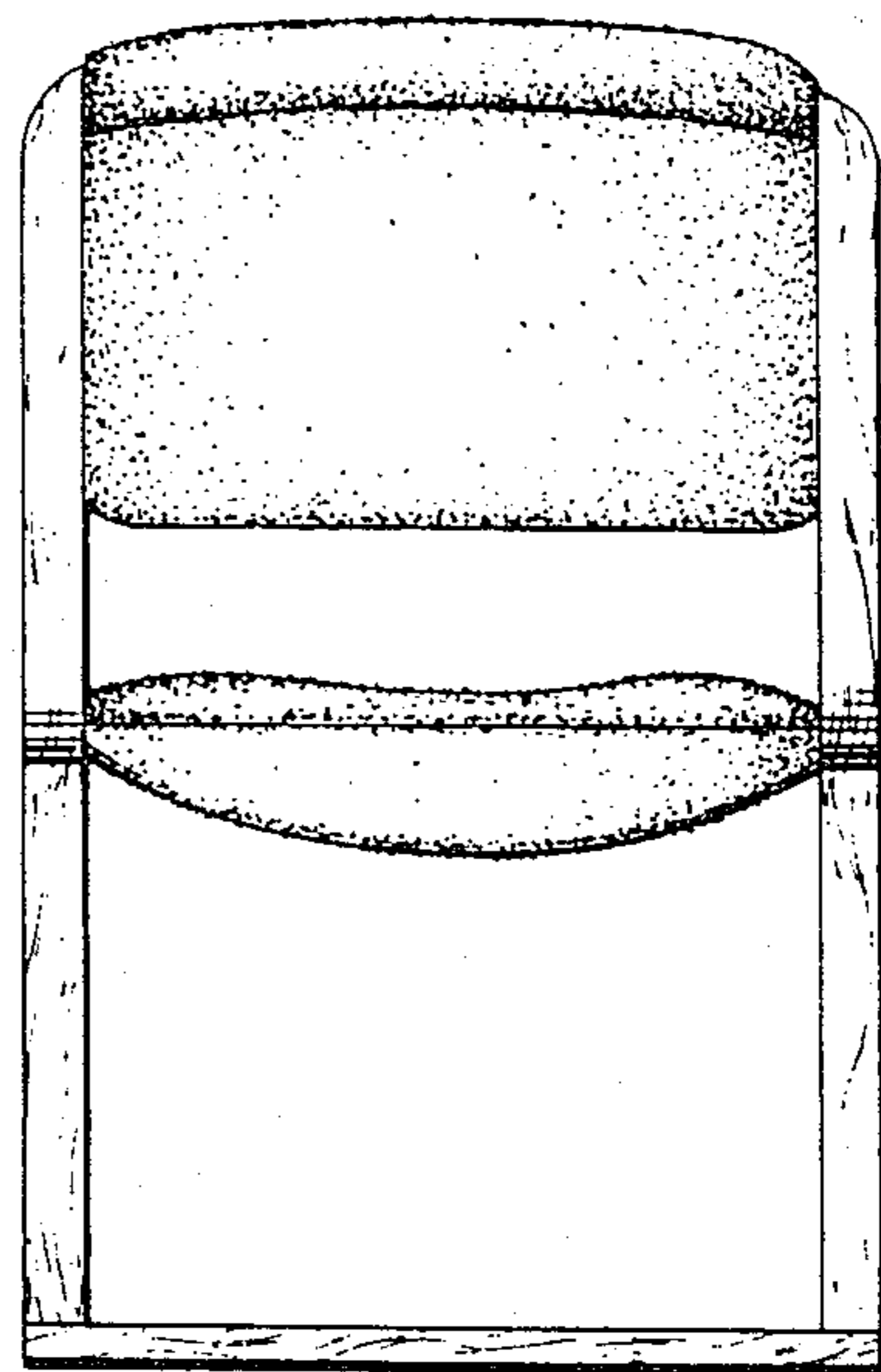

--The characteristic feature of this design resides in the configuration of the chair frame and side arms wherein the upper portion of the back support portion of the frame has substantially the same cross-sectional area as both the lower portion of the back support and the chair arm, and further wherein the forward portion of the side arm has a reduced cross-sectional area curving forwardly to rest on the chair frame, and further wherein upholstery is provided in the area between the side arm and seat support.--
