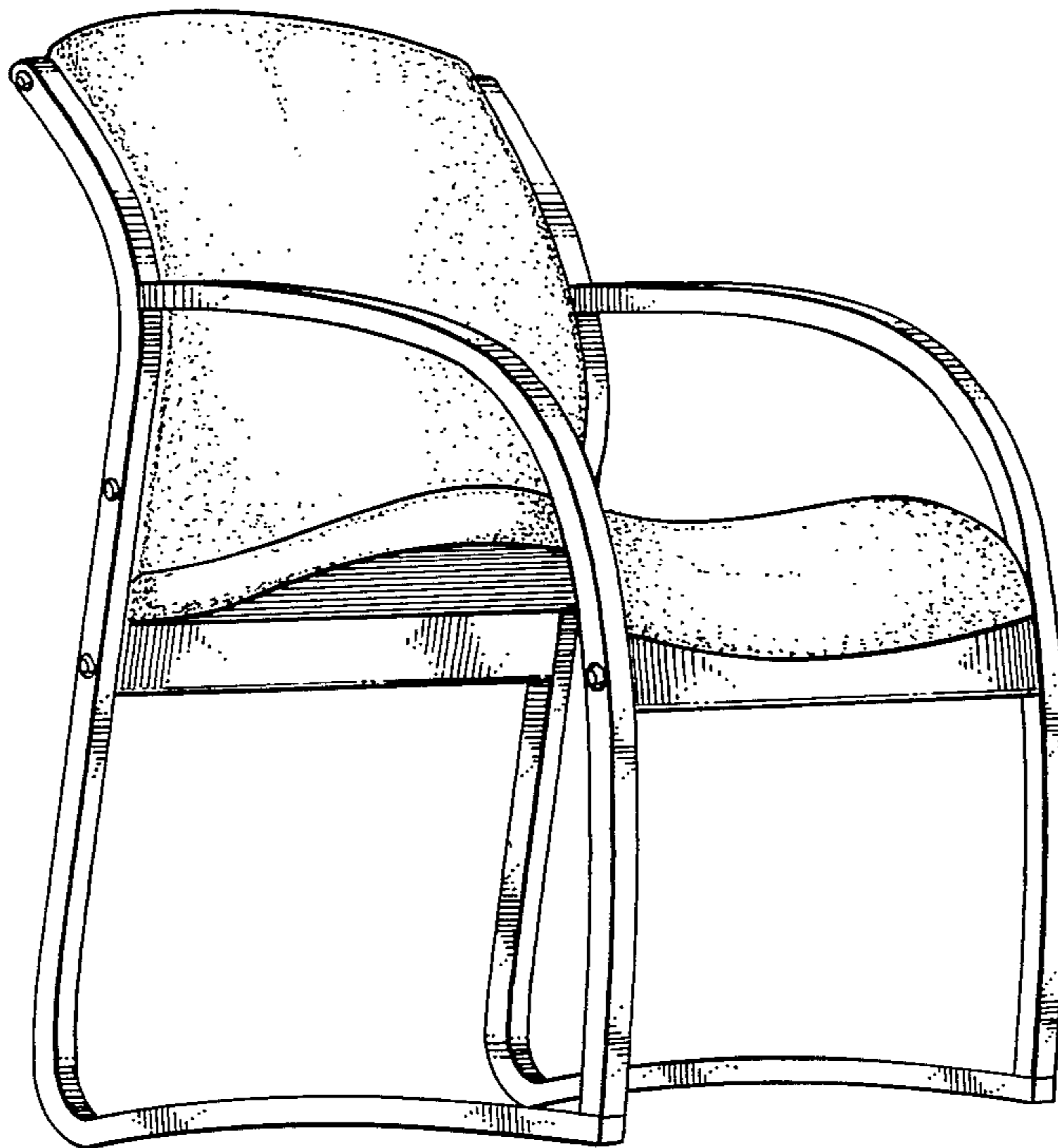

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my design;

FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view thereof.



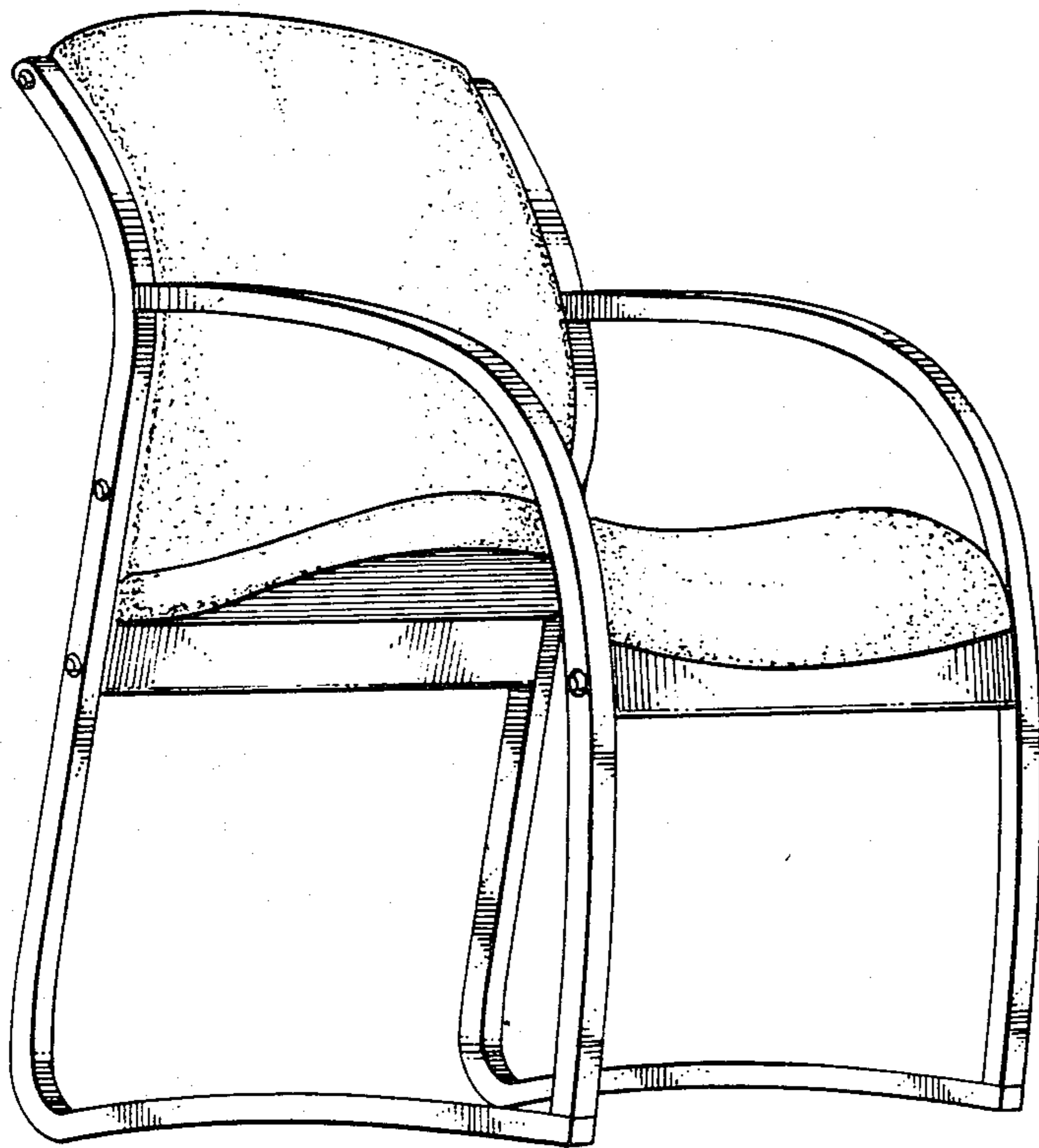

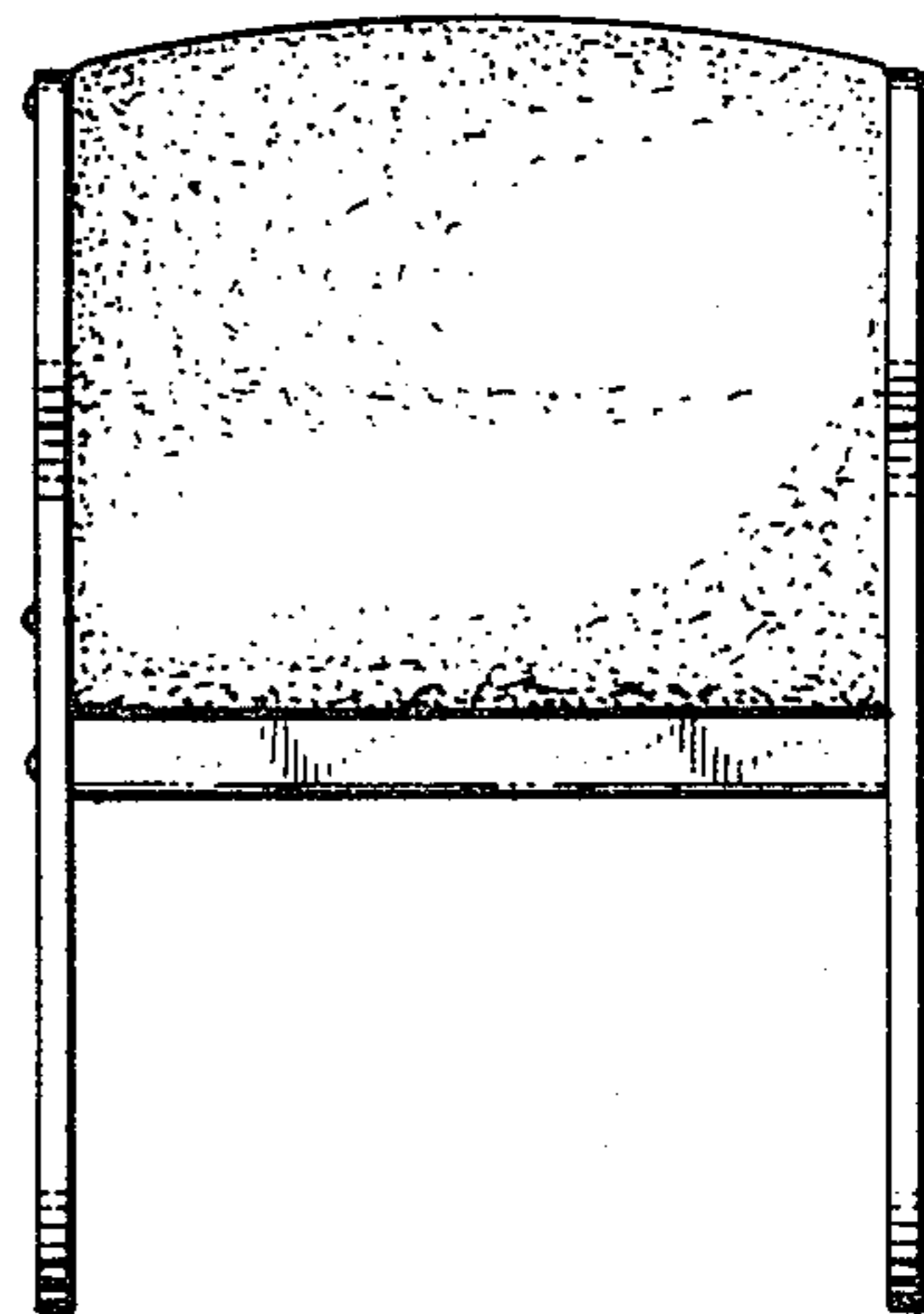

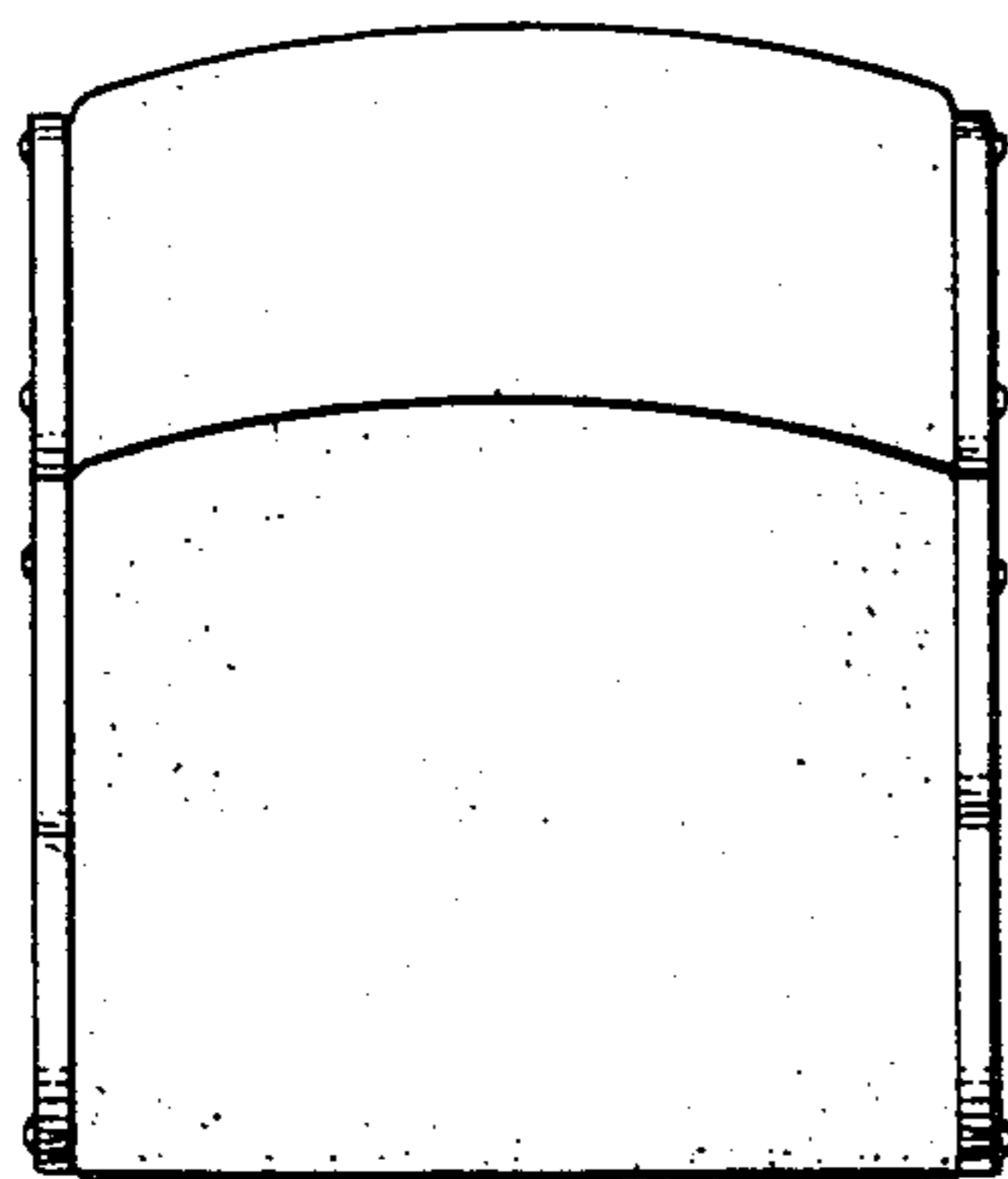

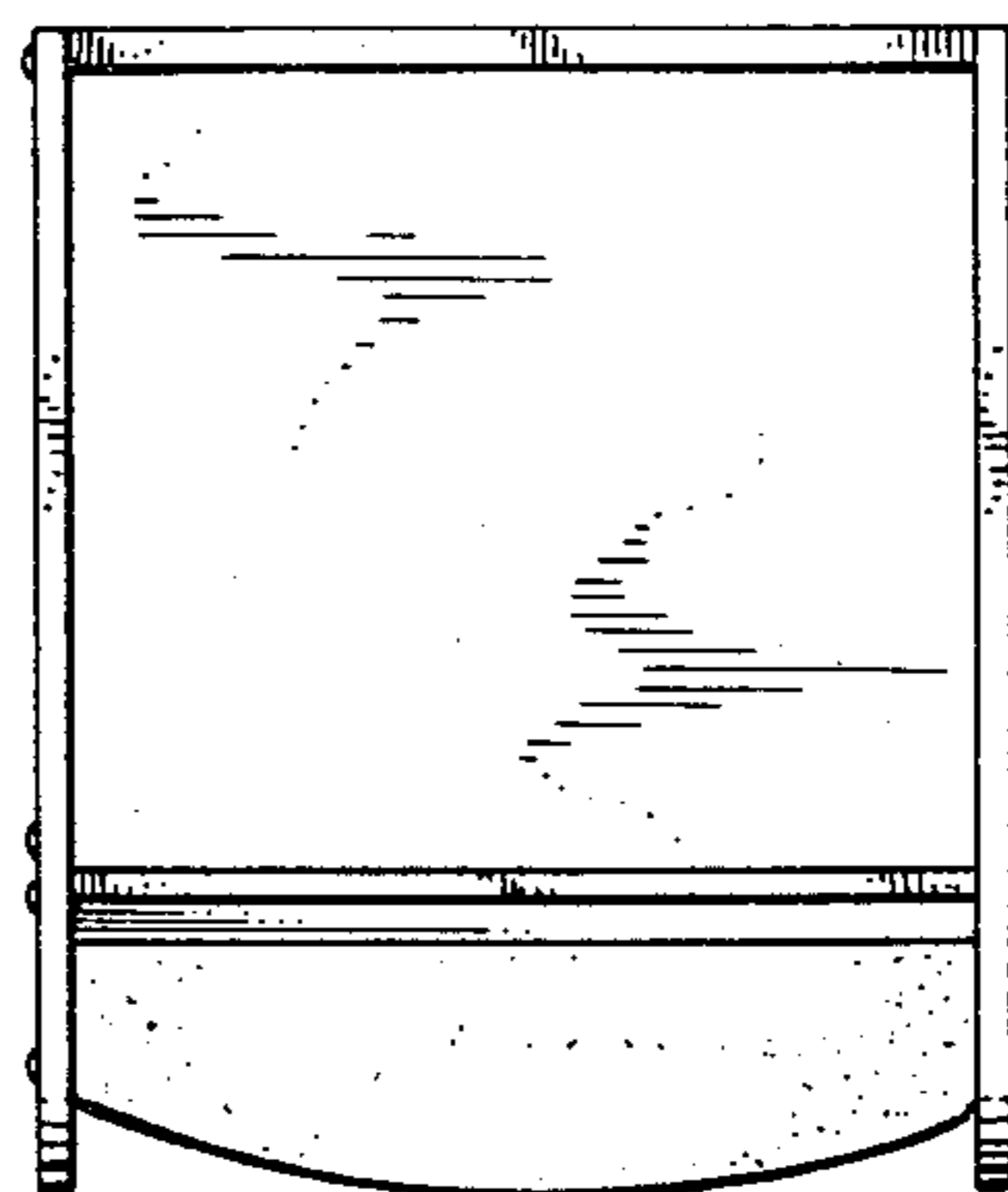

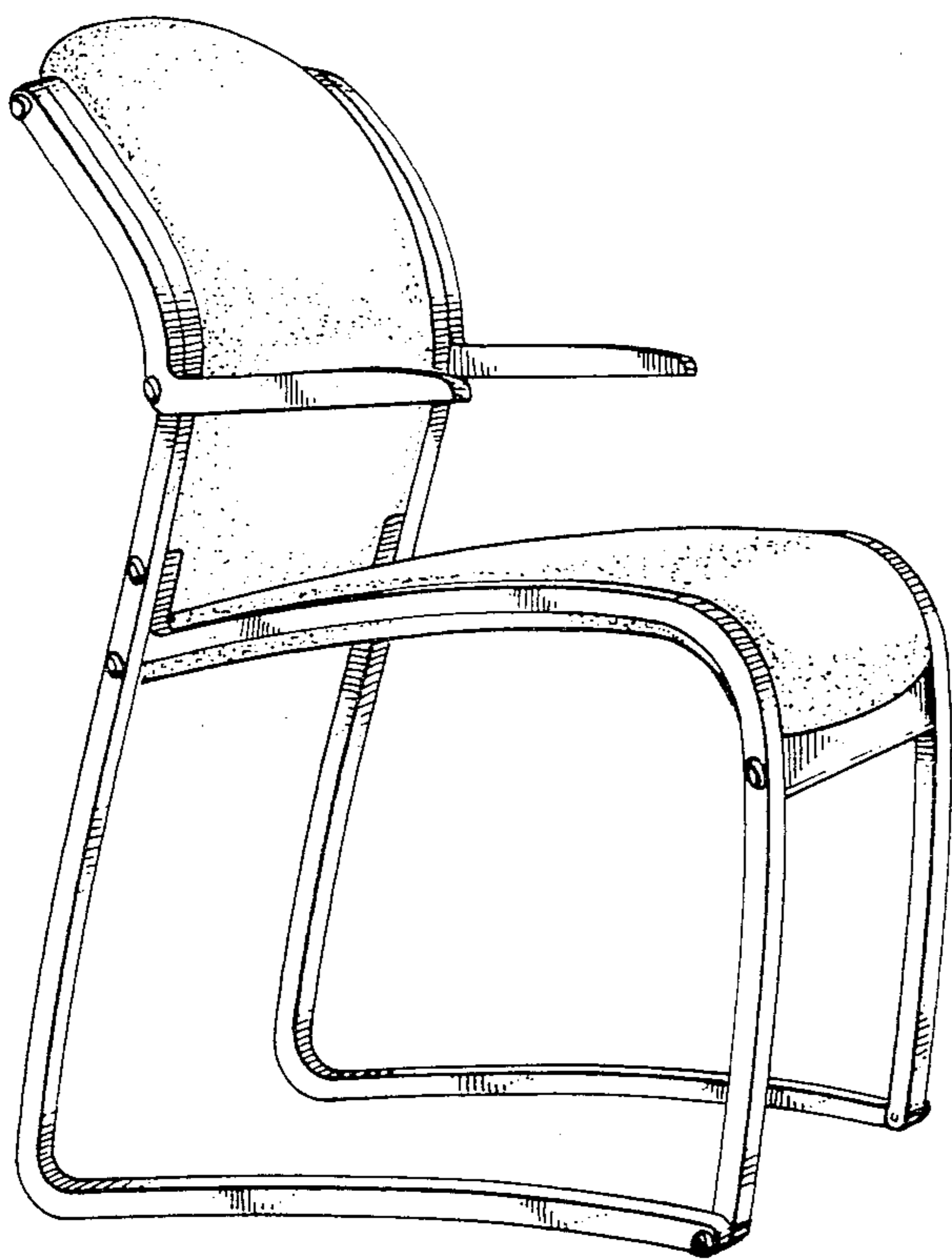

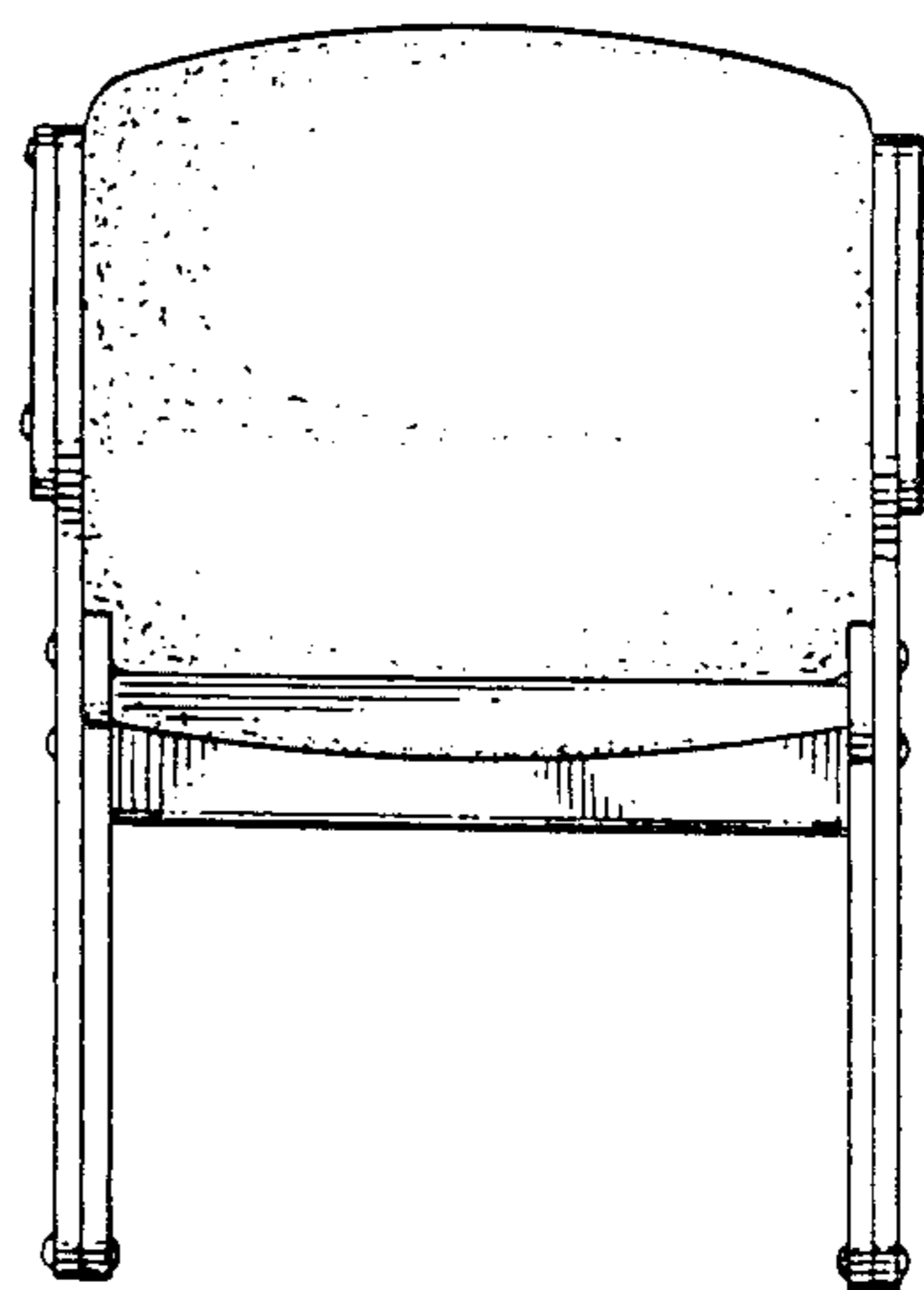

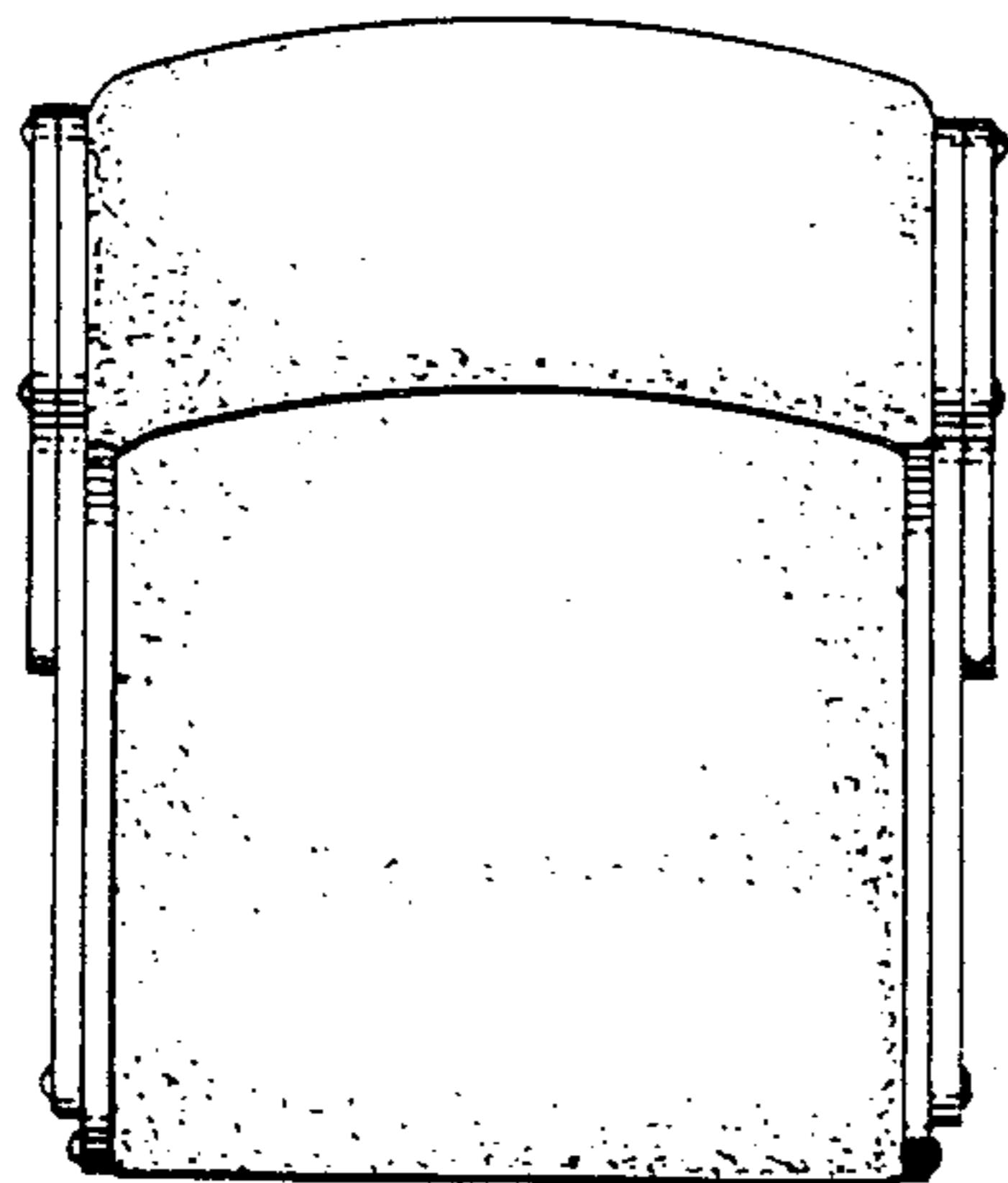

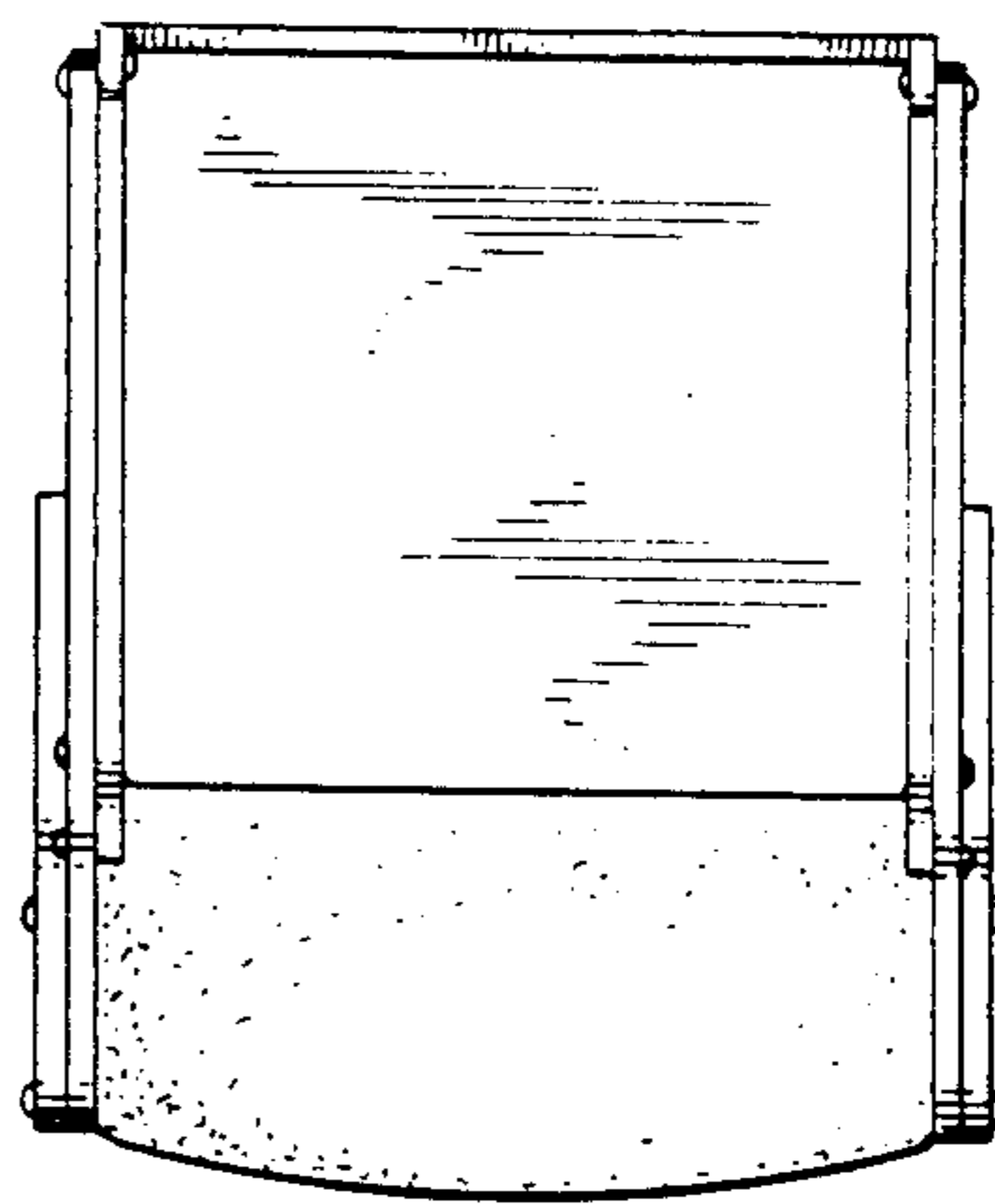

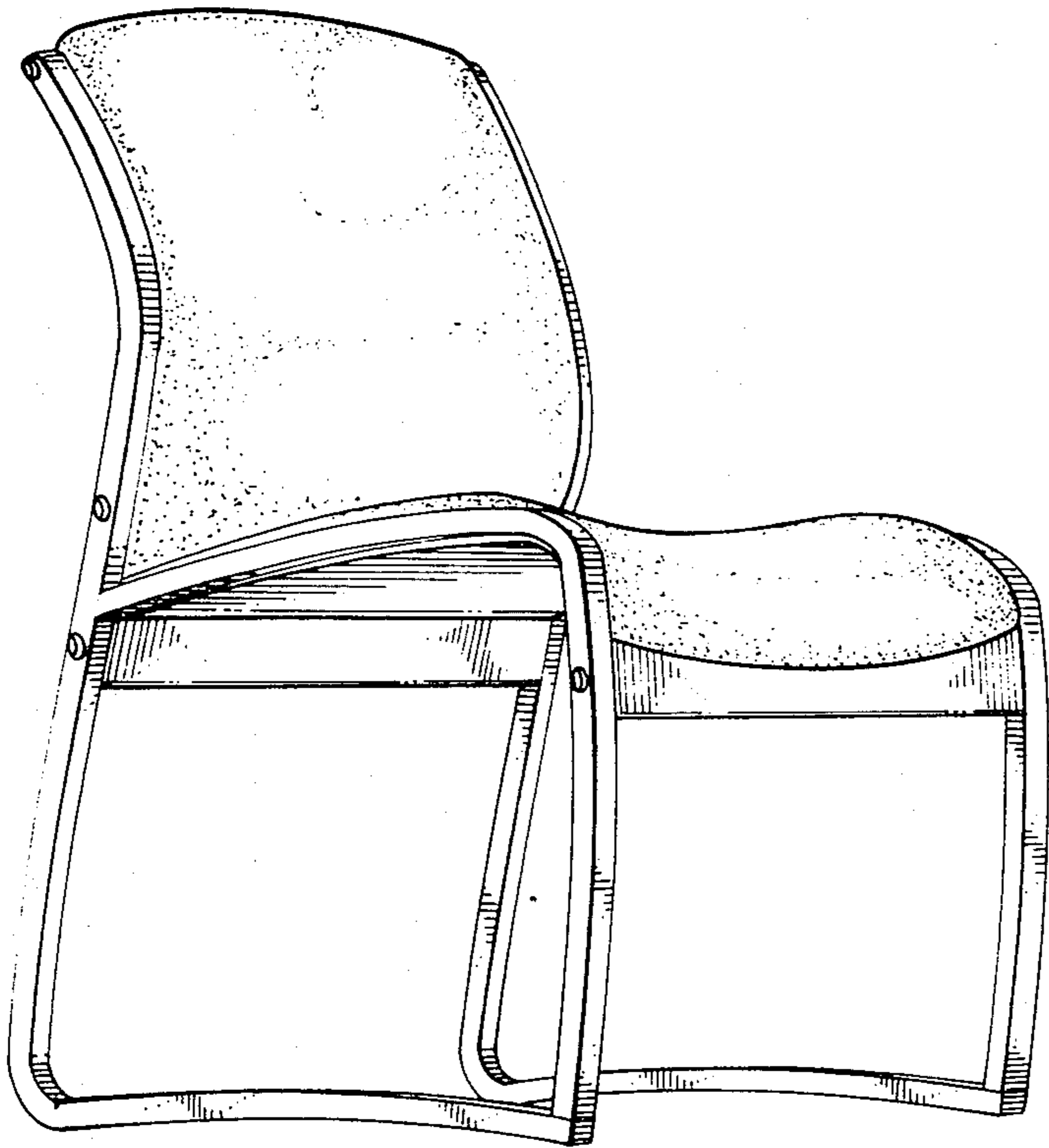

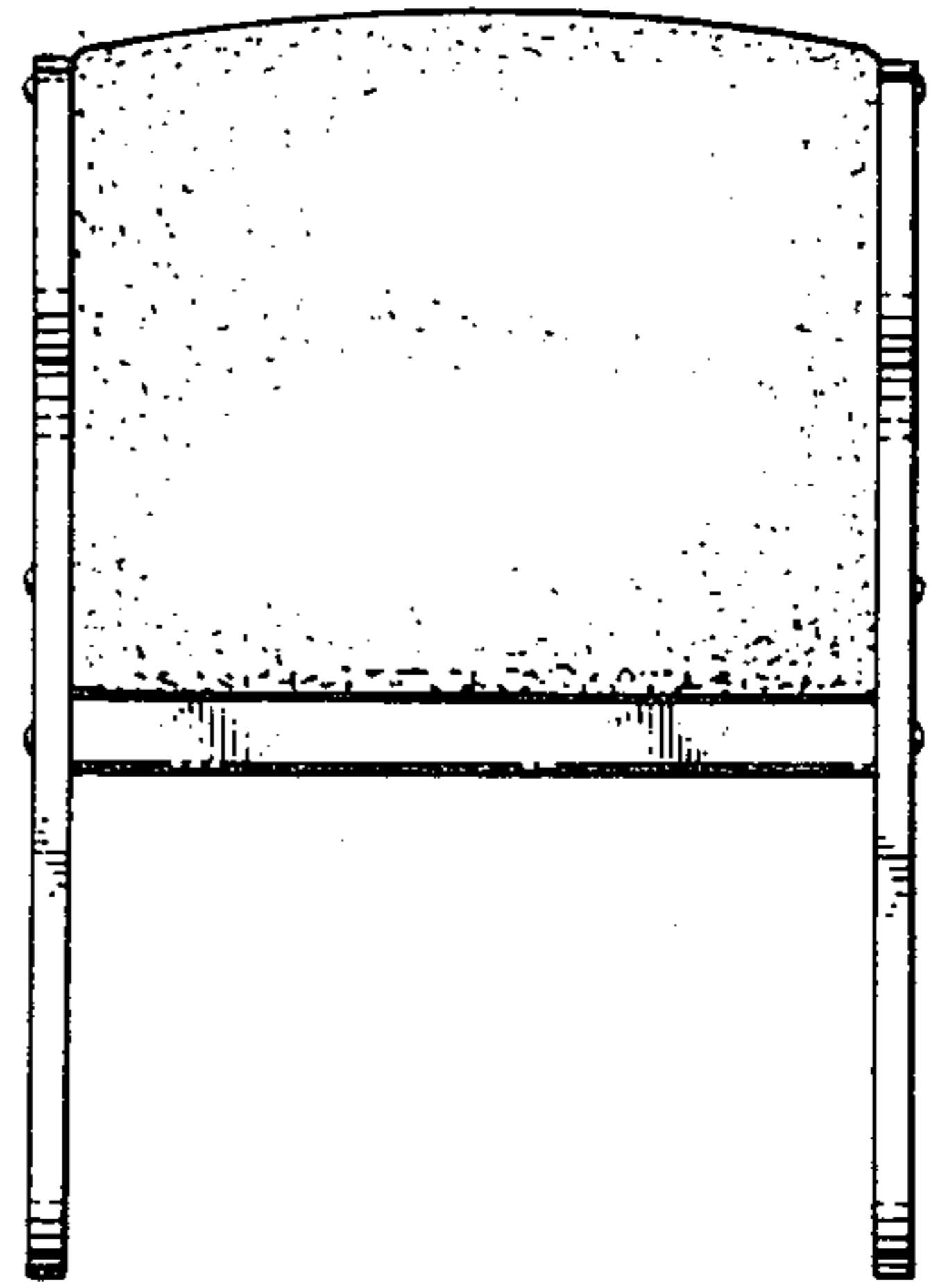

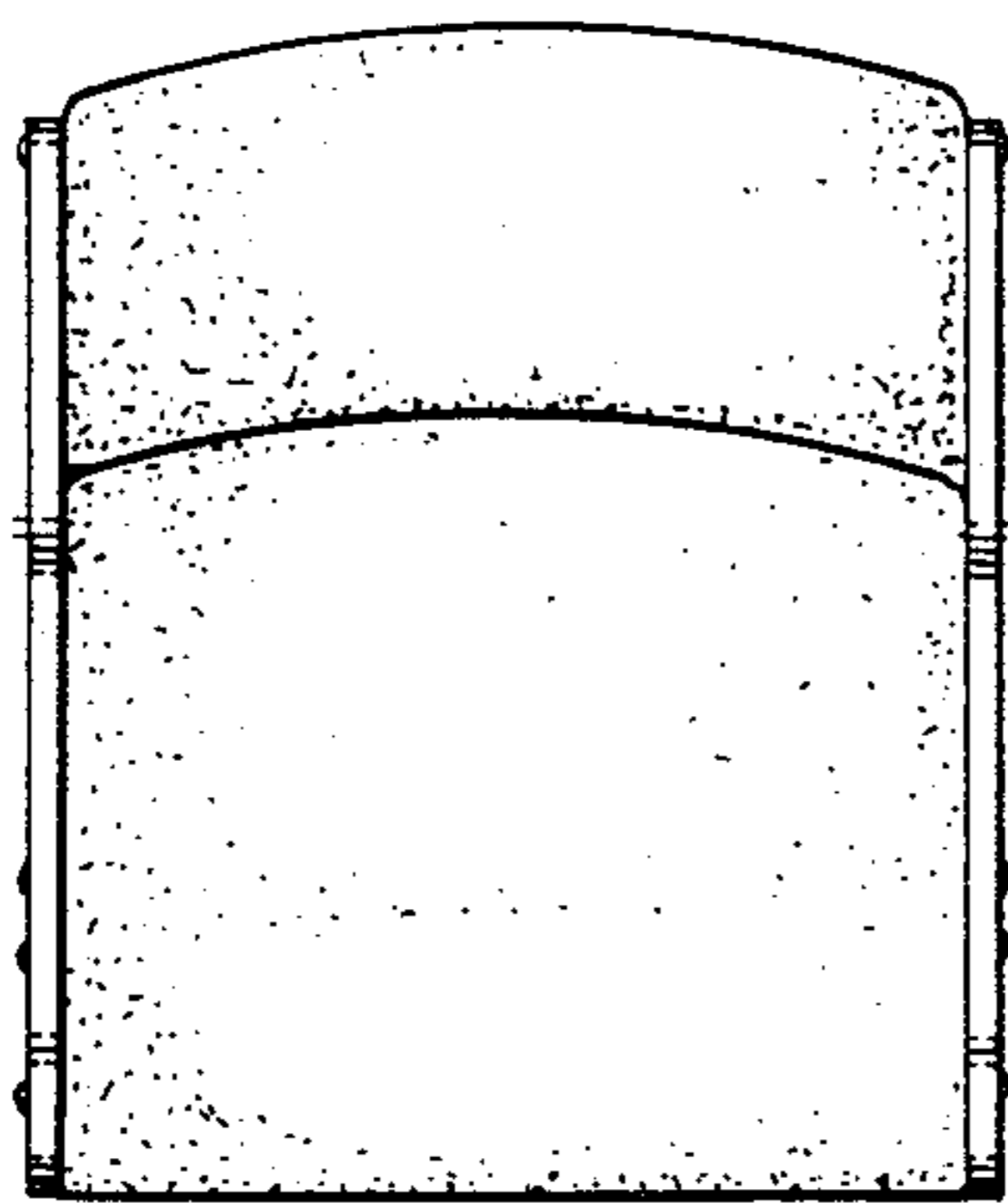

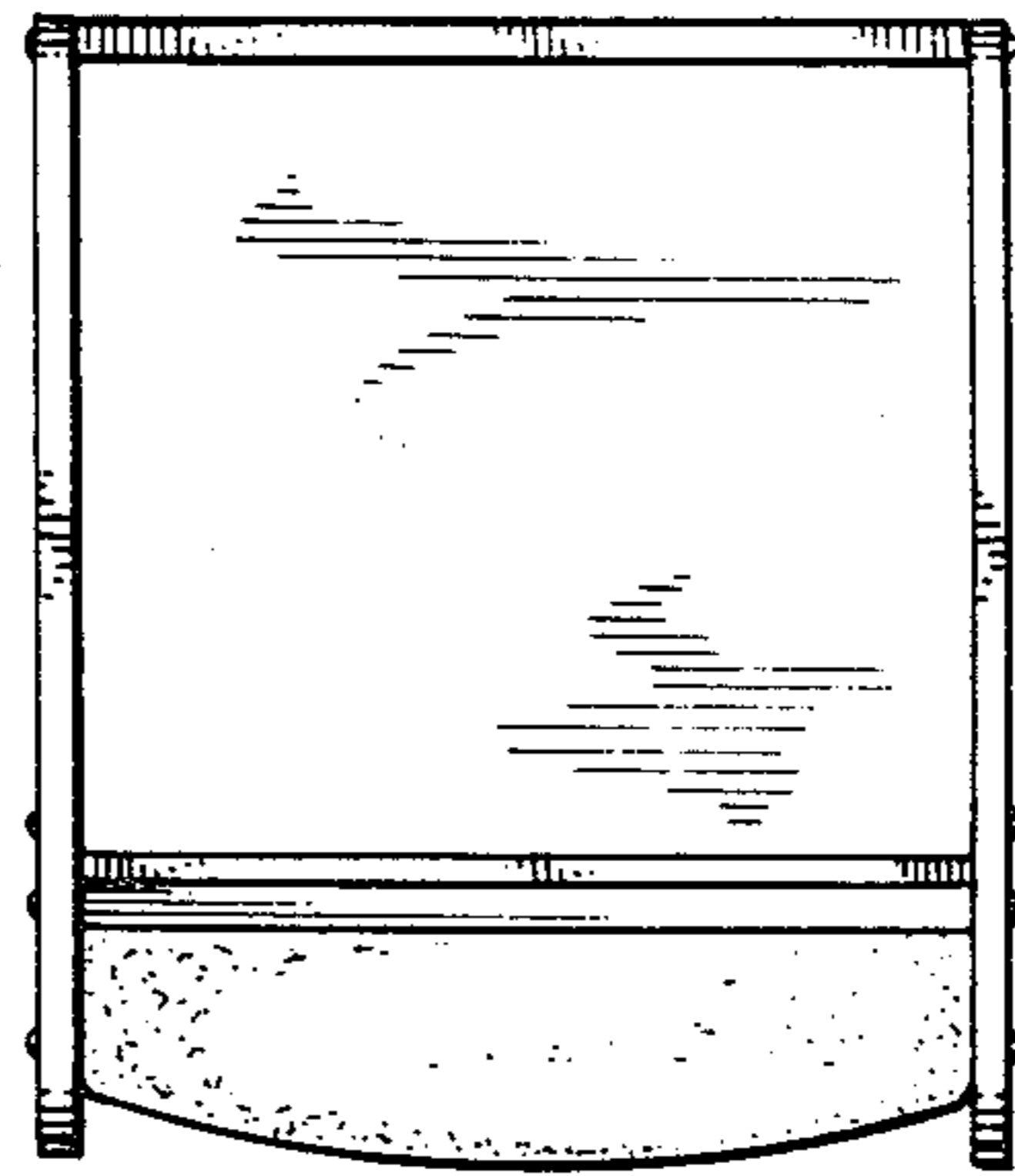

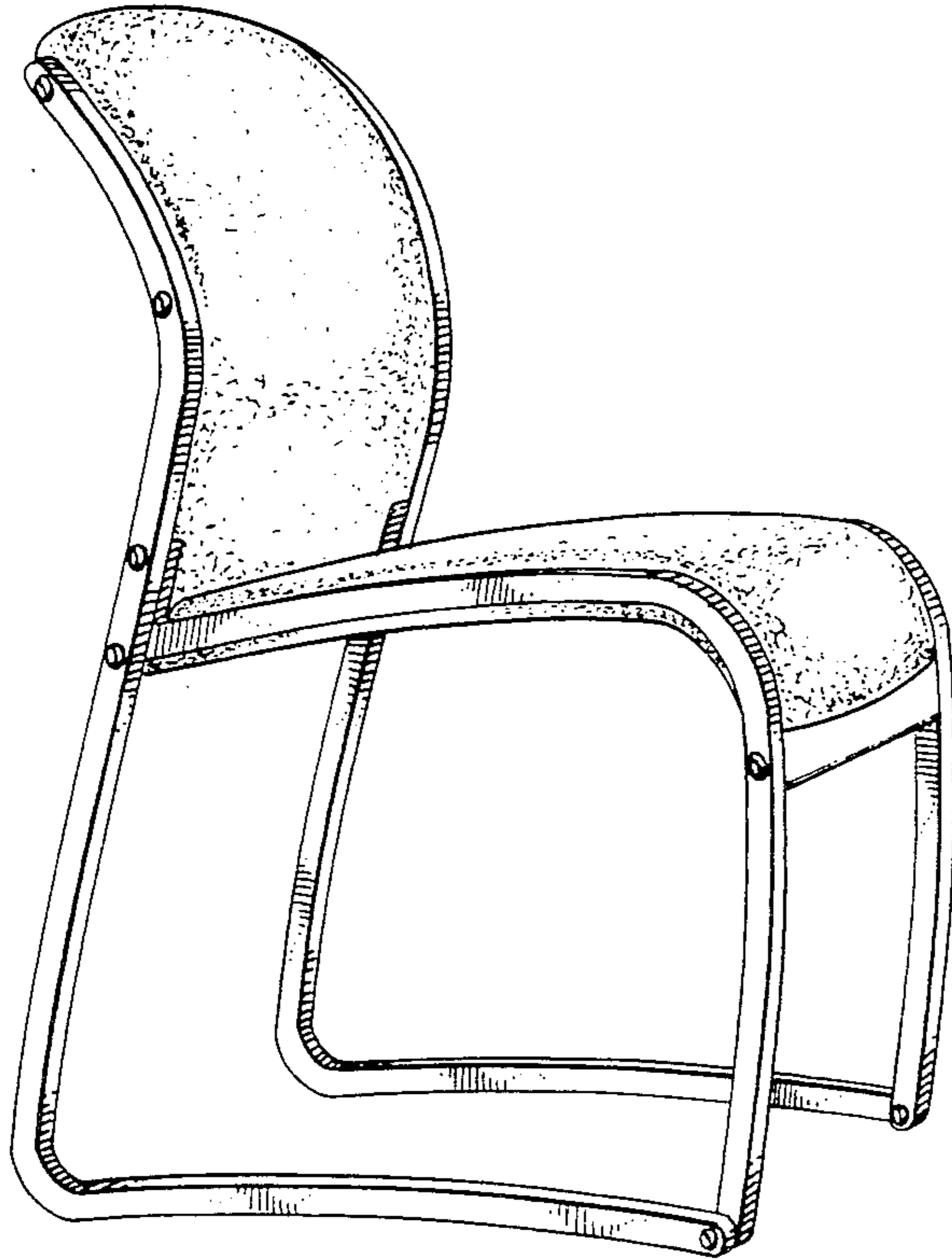

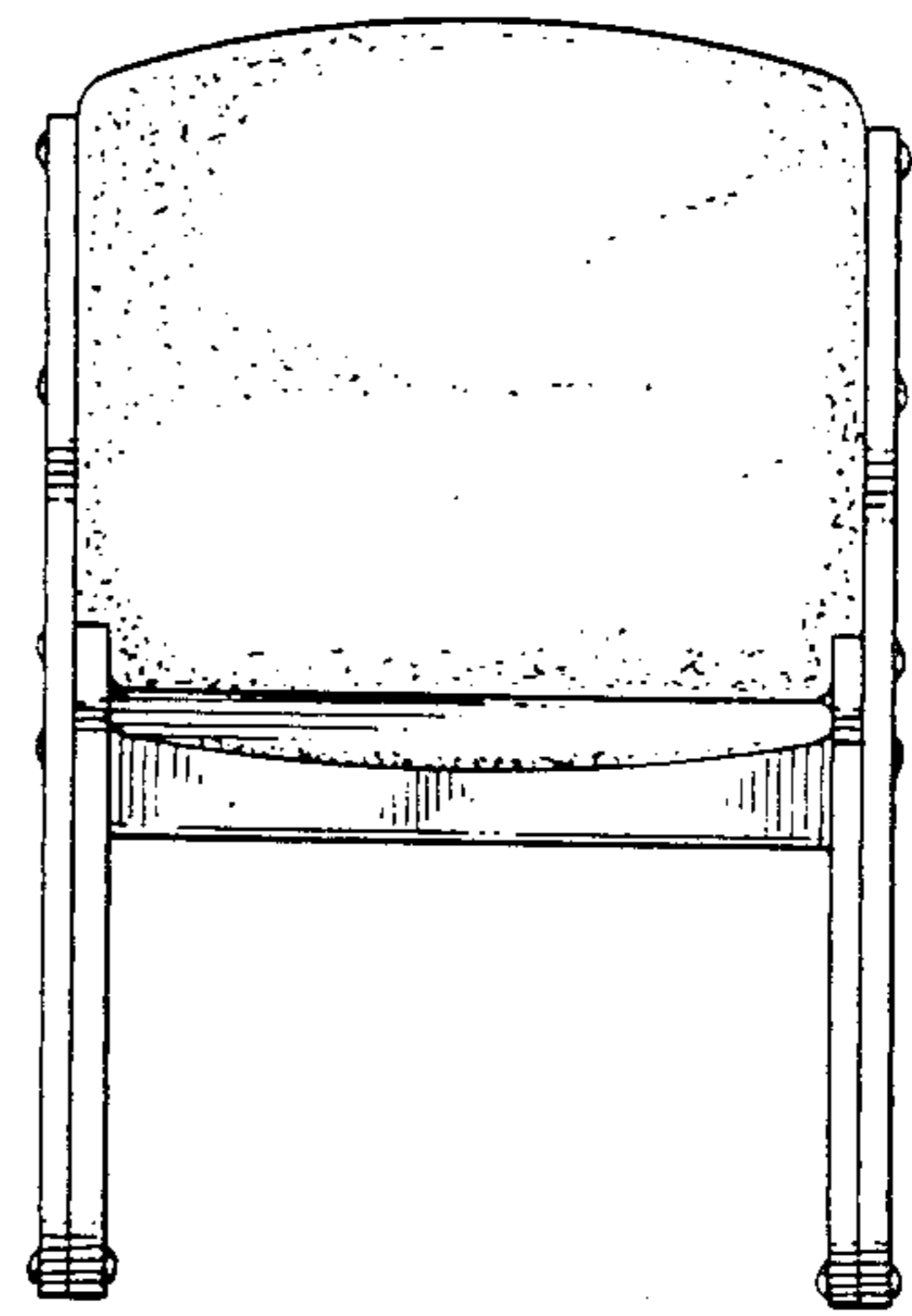

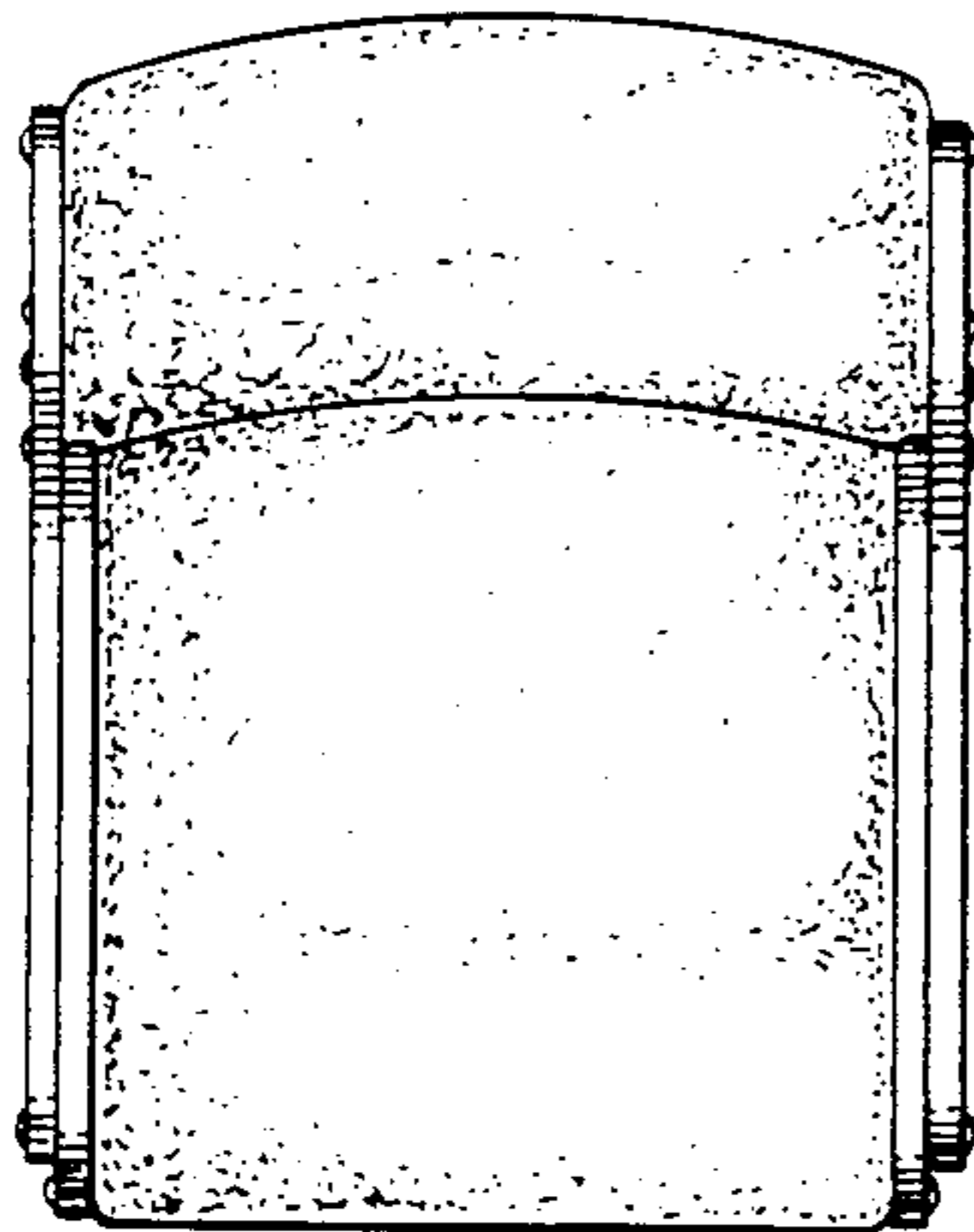

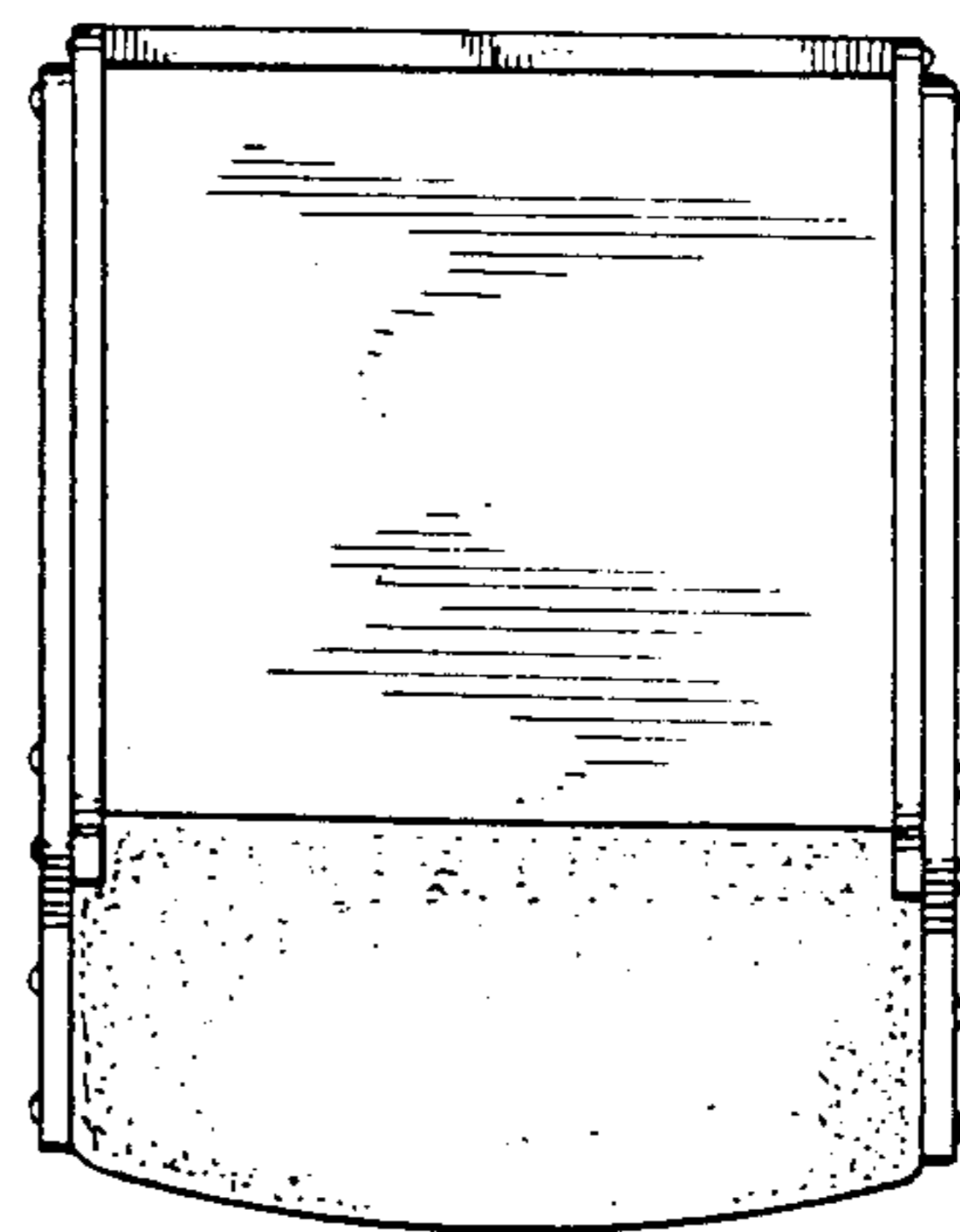
