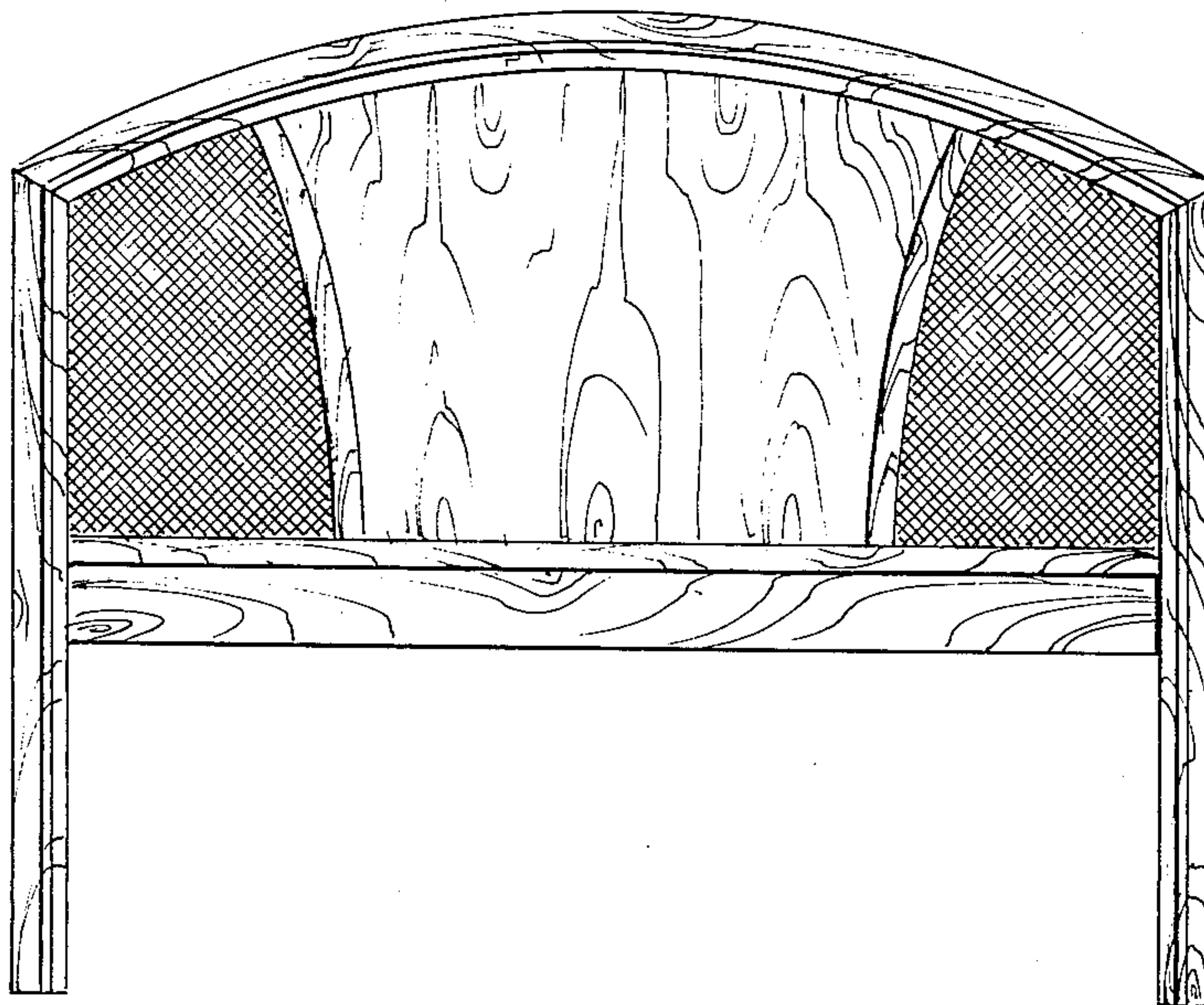

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a headboard showing my new design, the rear being plain; and FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view.



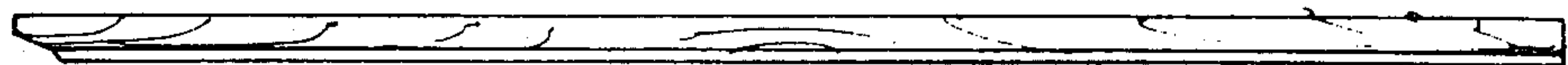

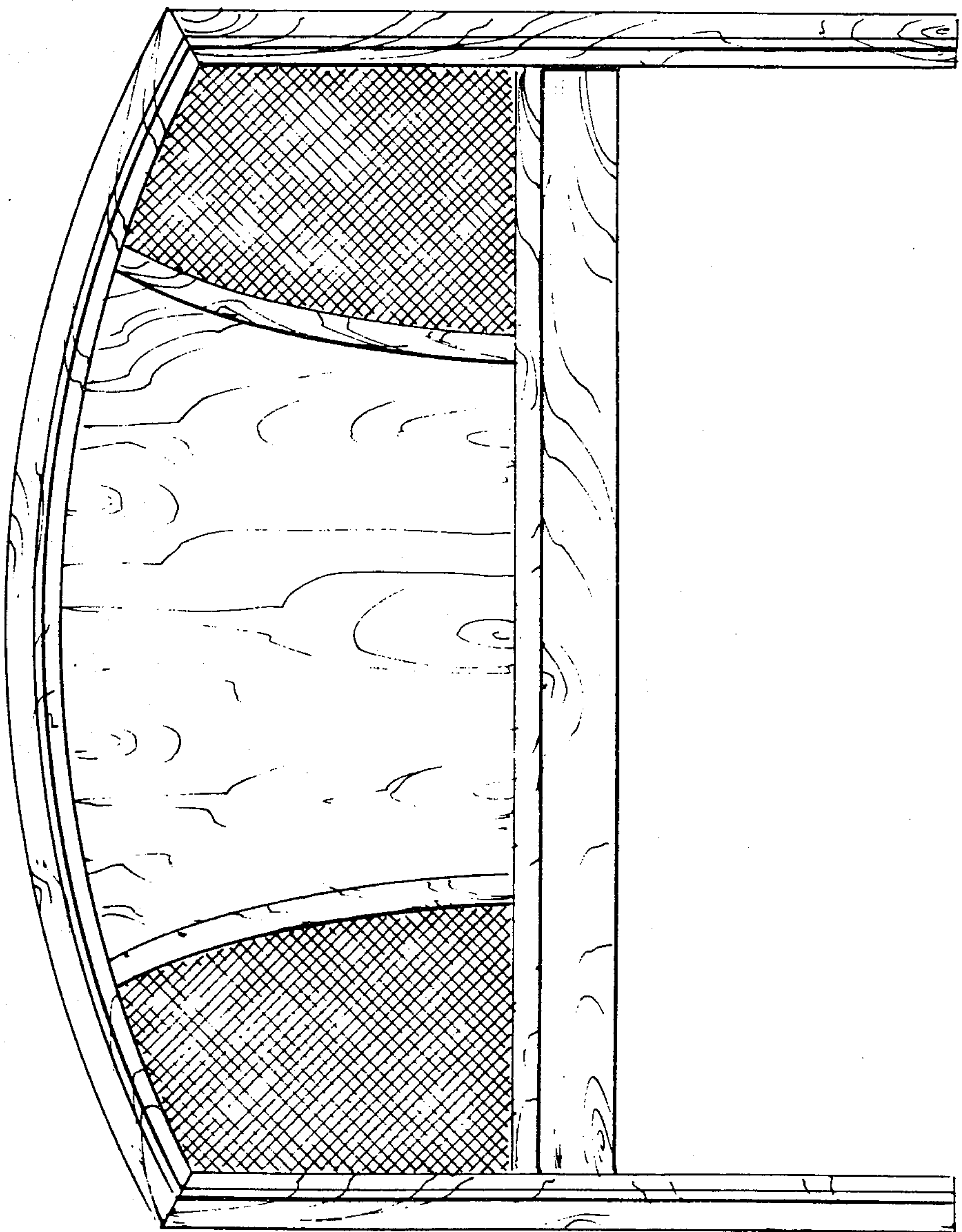
