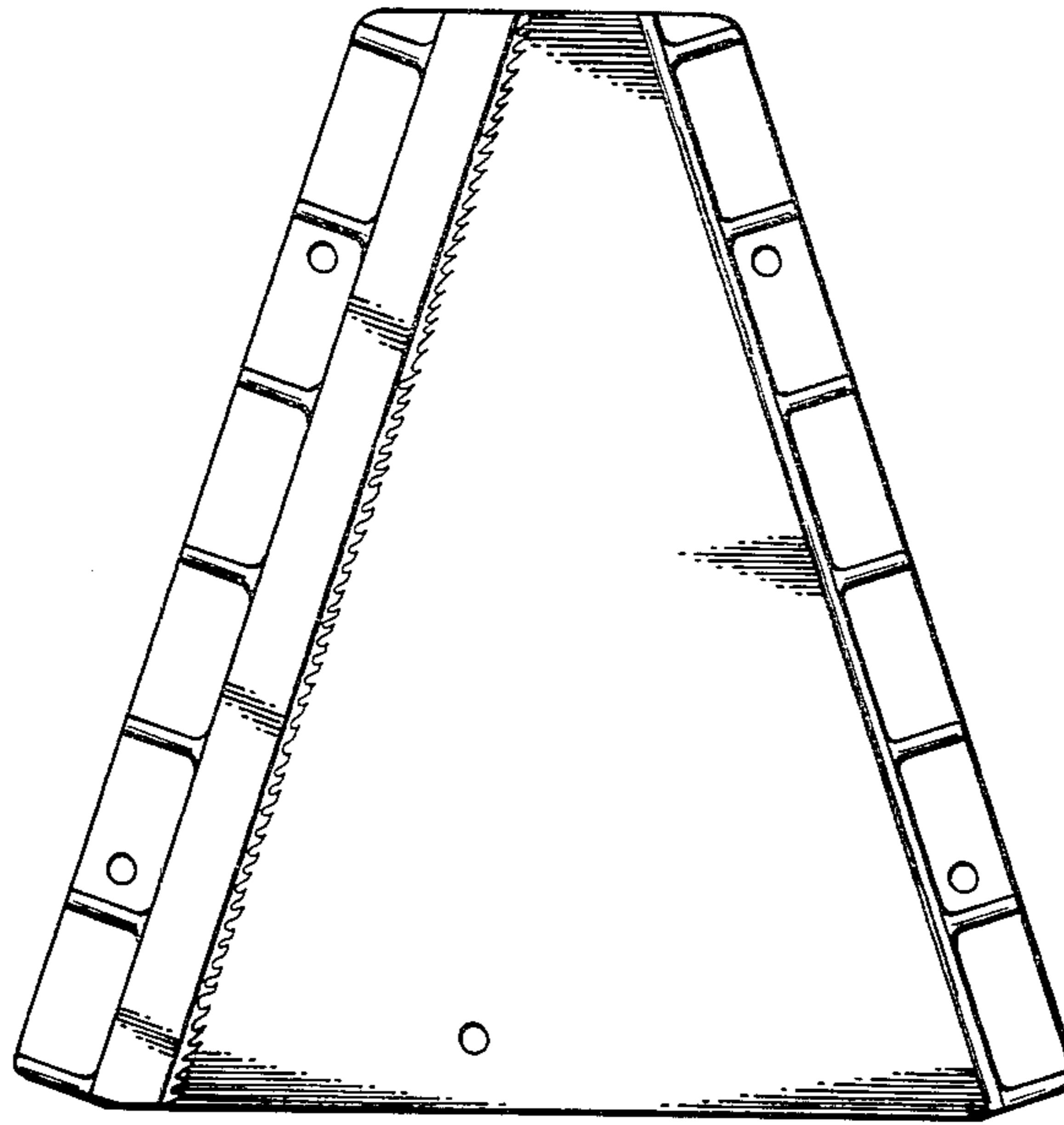

[57] CLAIM

The design for a device for removing a cap from a jar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a jar cap remover showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an end elevation view thereof from the end with the narrow opening;
FIG. 4 is an elevation seen from the end opposite; and,
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof.



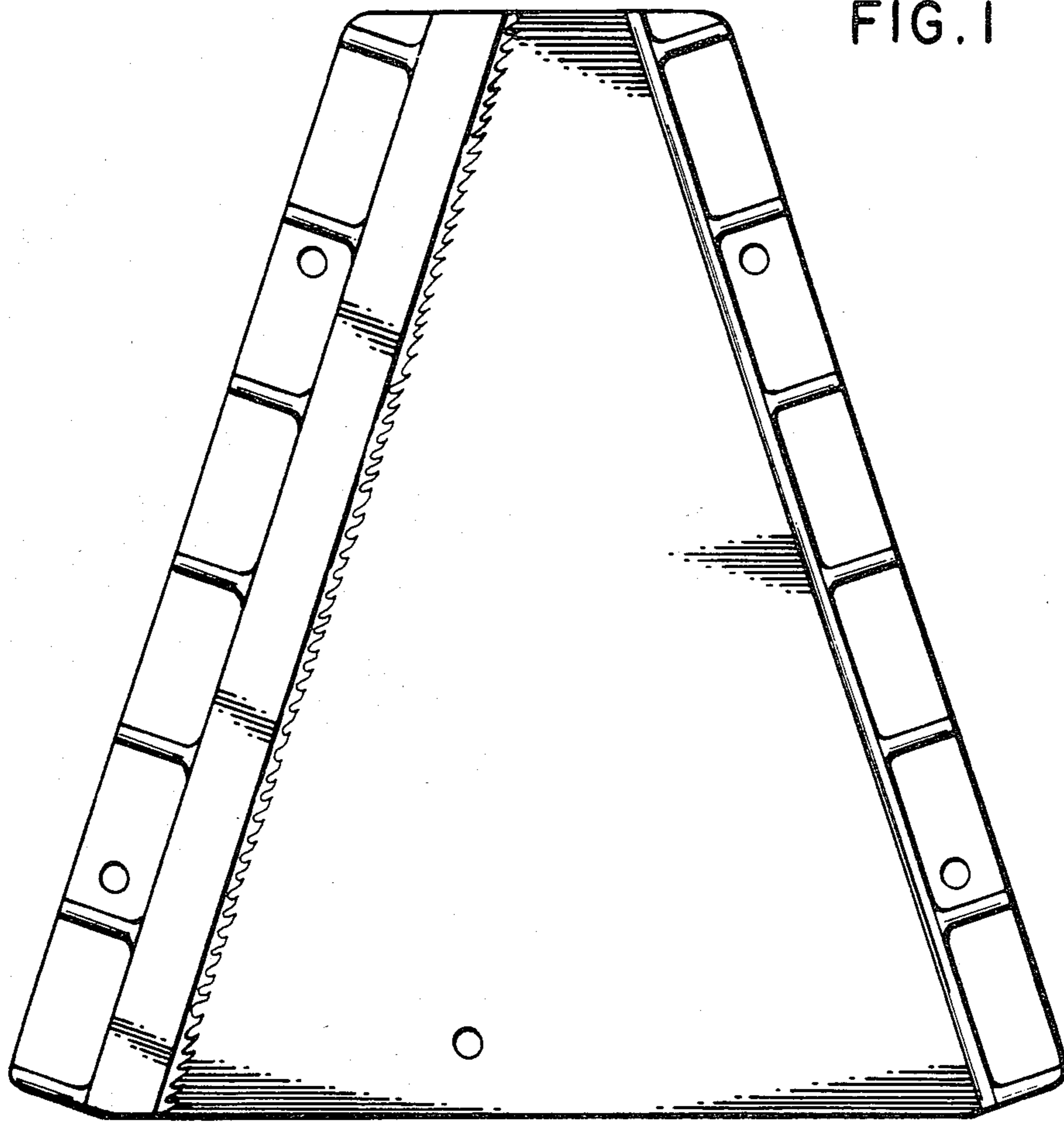

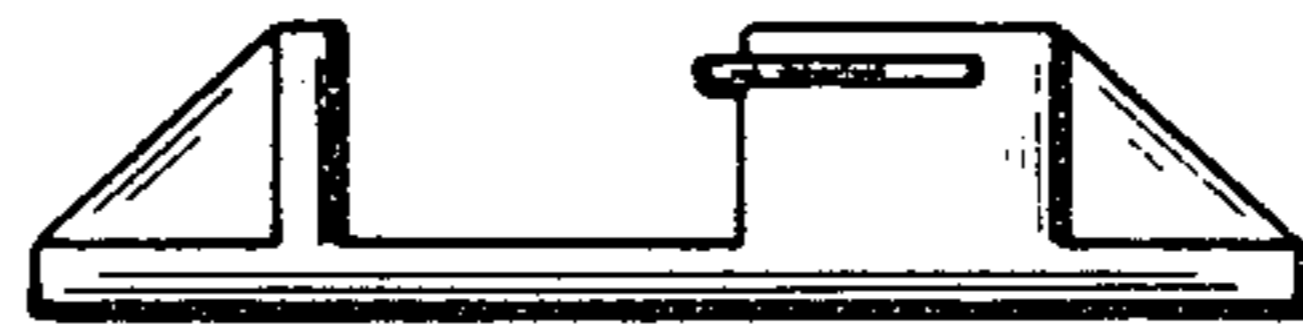

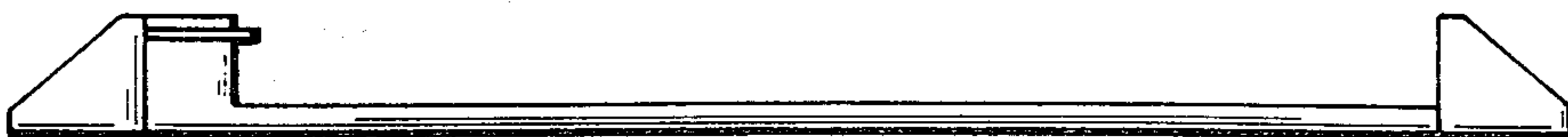

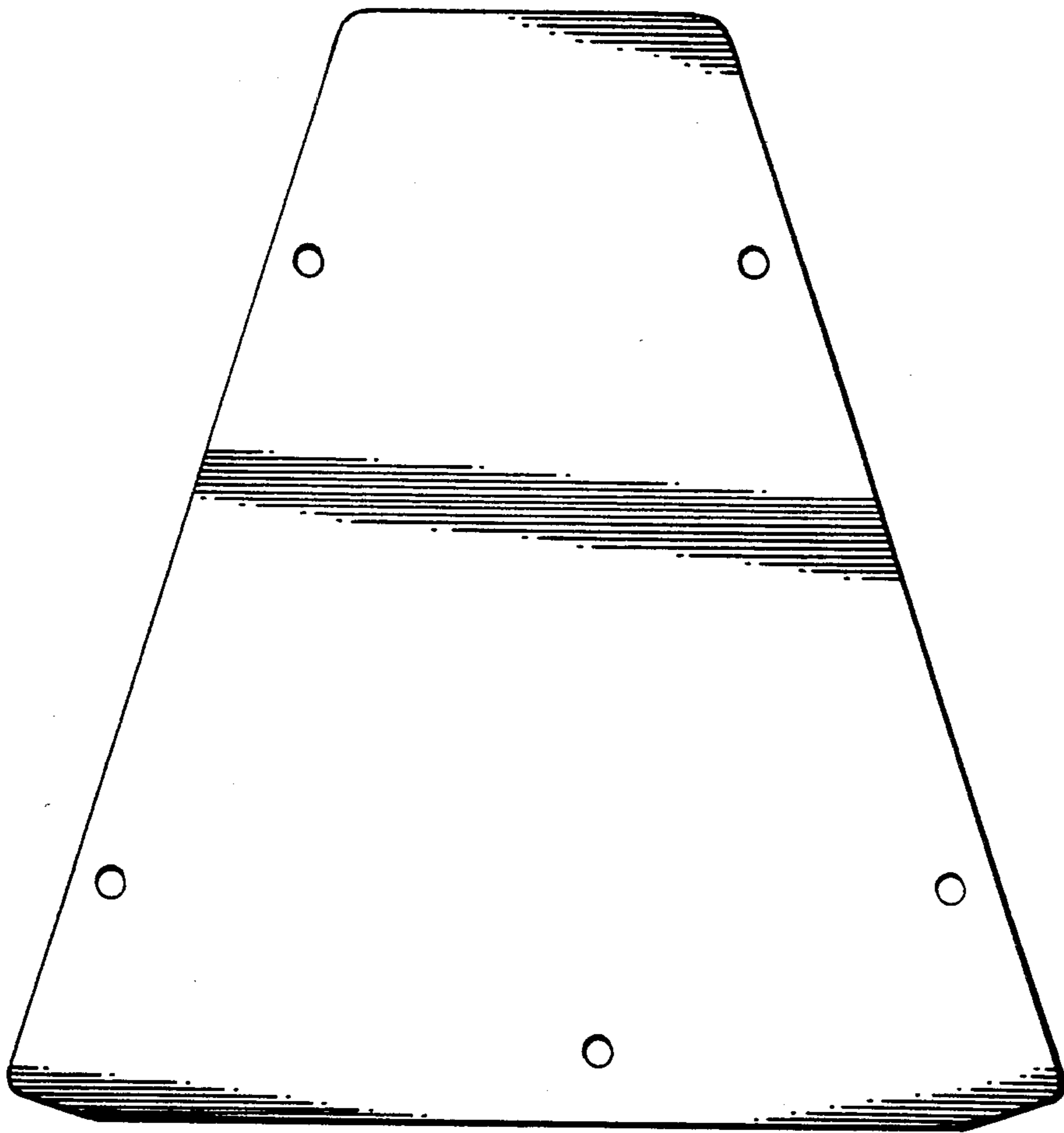
