DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a motorbike brake assembly housing, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view, taken along the line 4—4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an opposite end elevational view, taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is an opposite side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof on a reduced scale.
