DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a saddle rack showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a modified form of the saddle rack shown in FIG. 1;

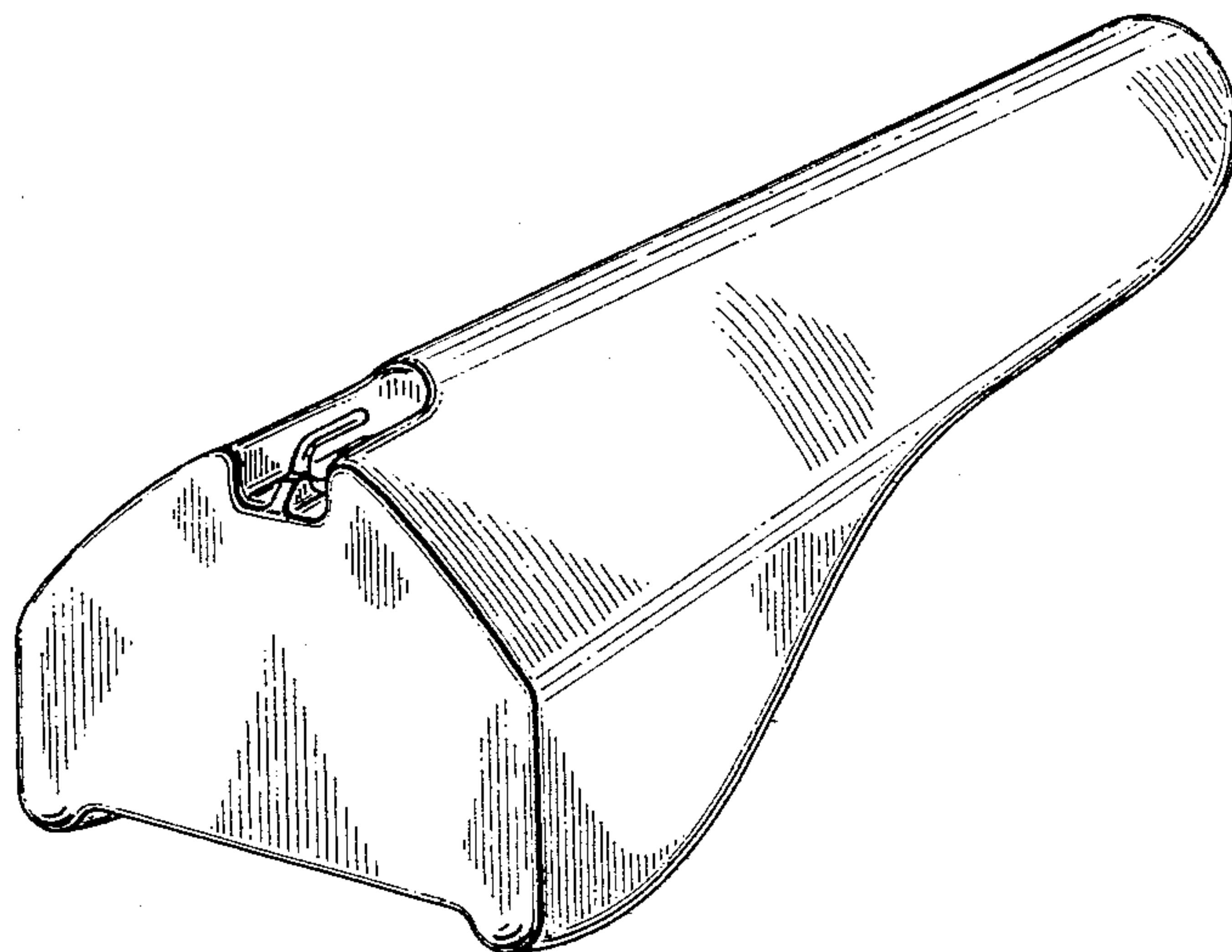
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7.



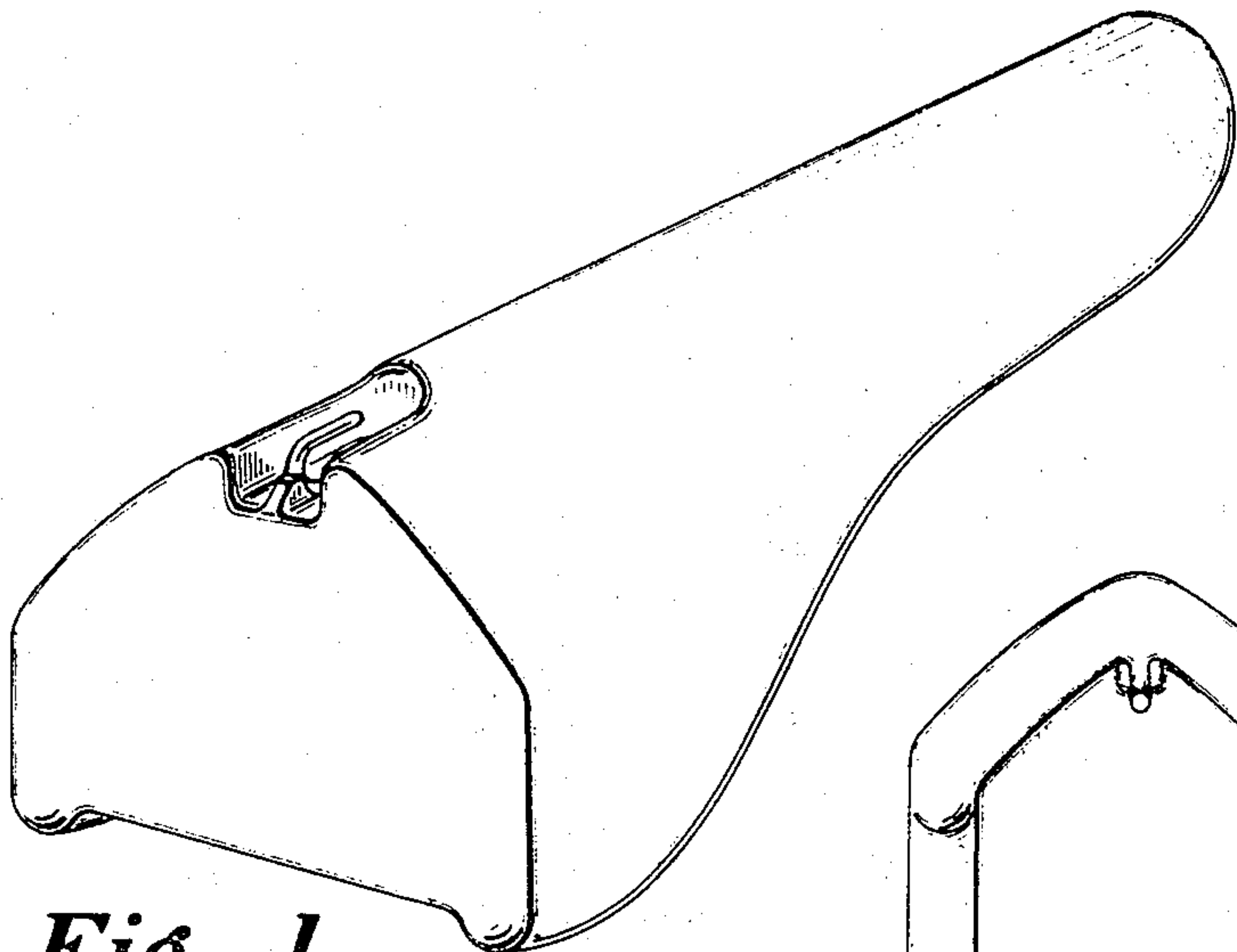

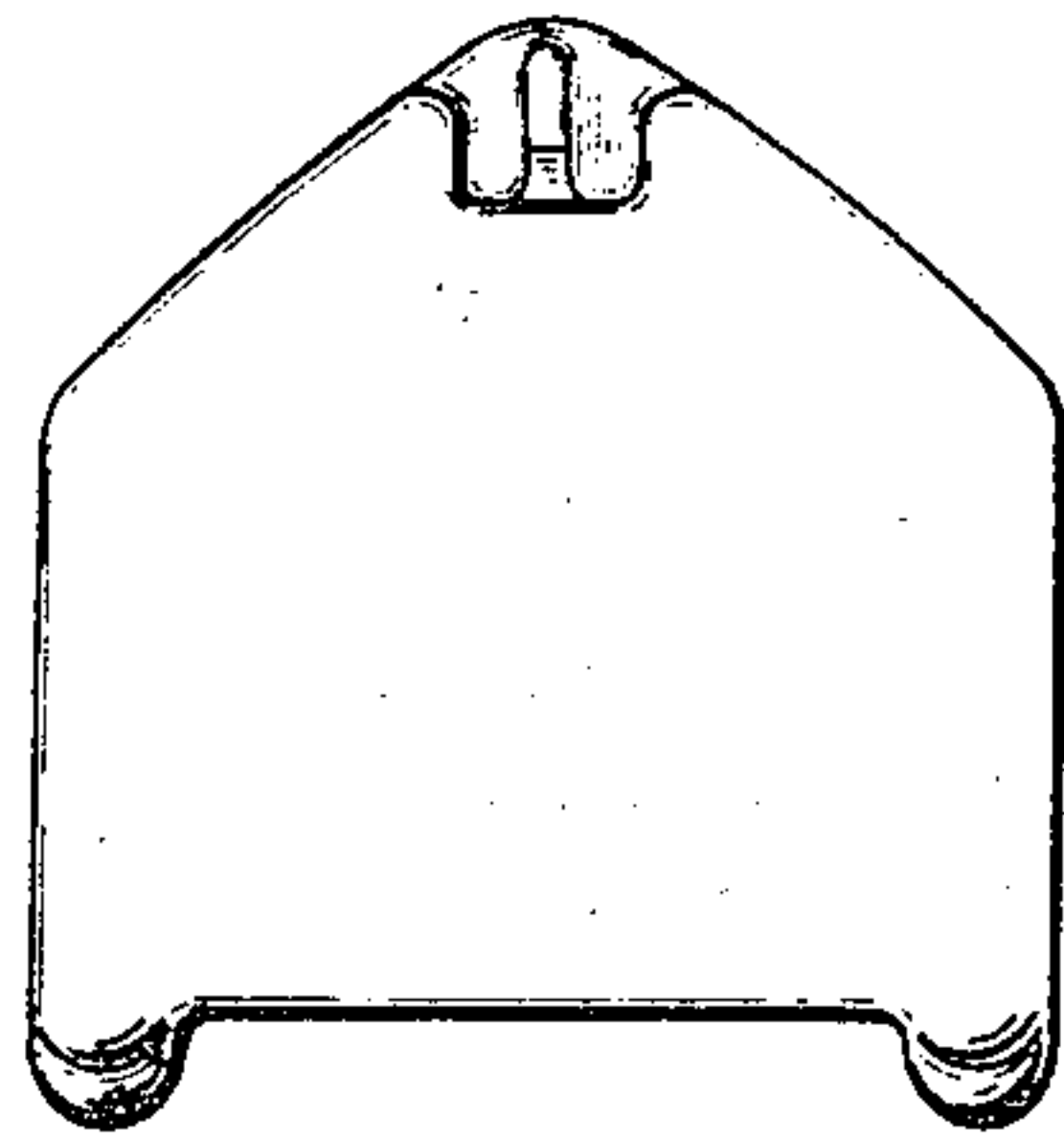

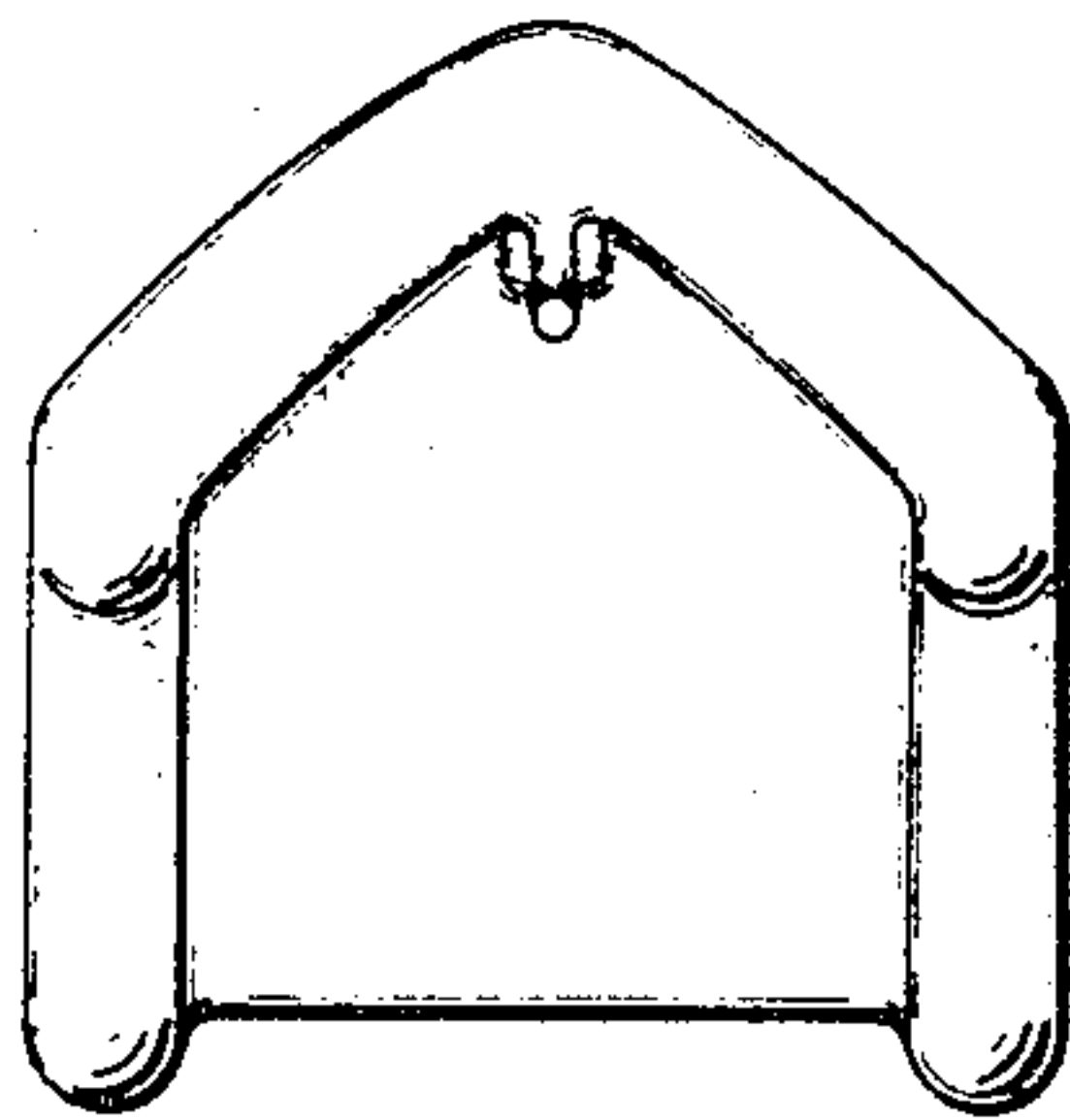

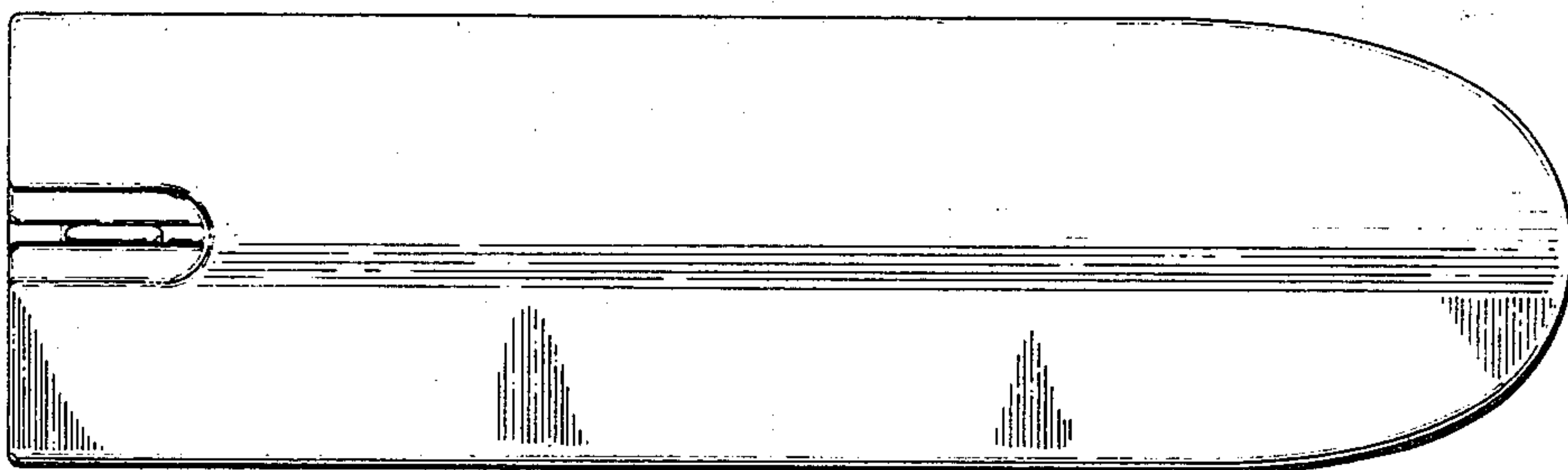

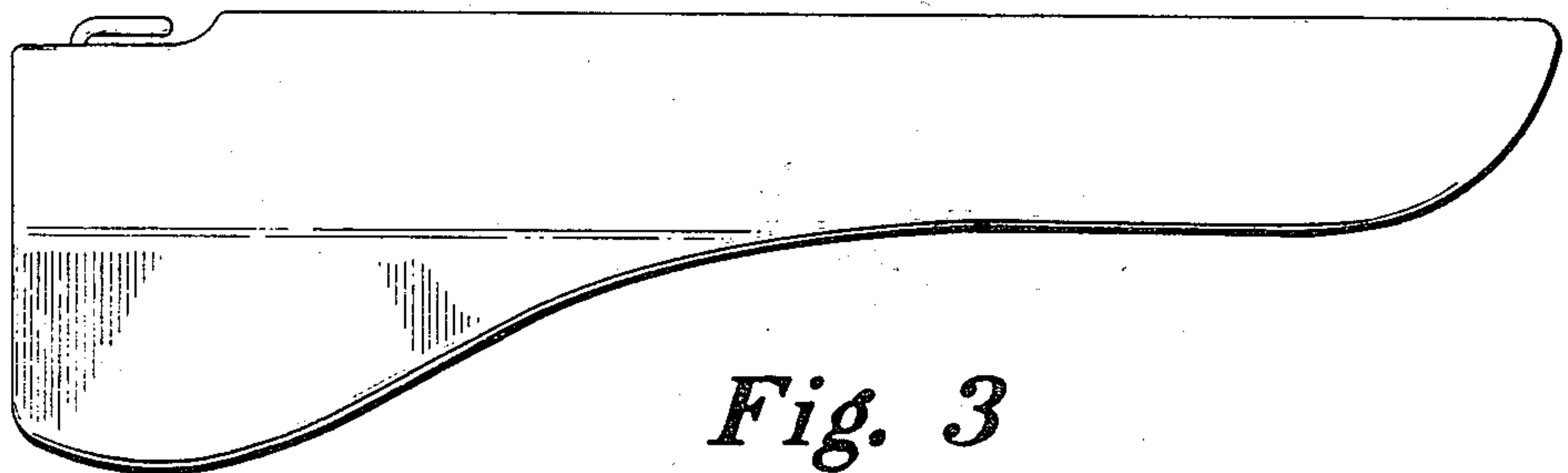

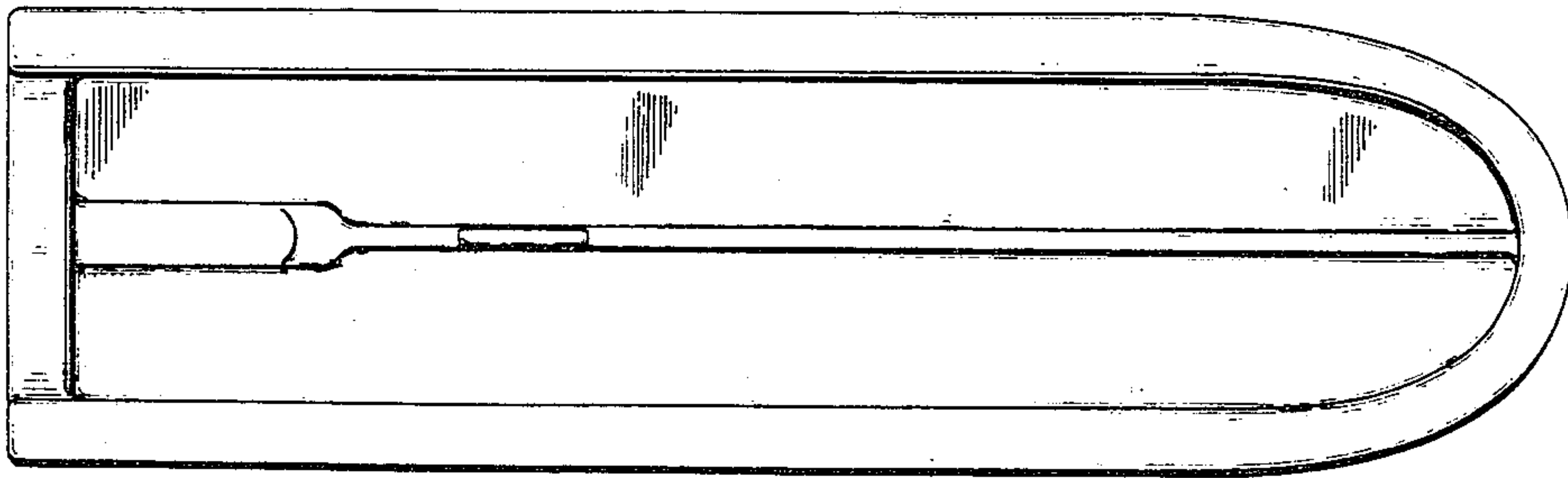

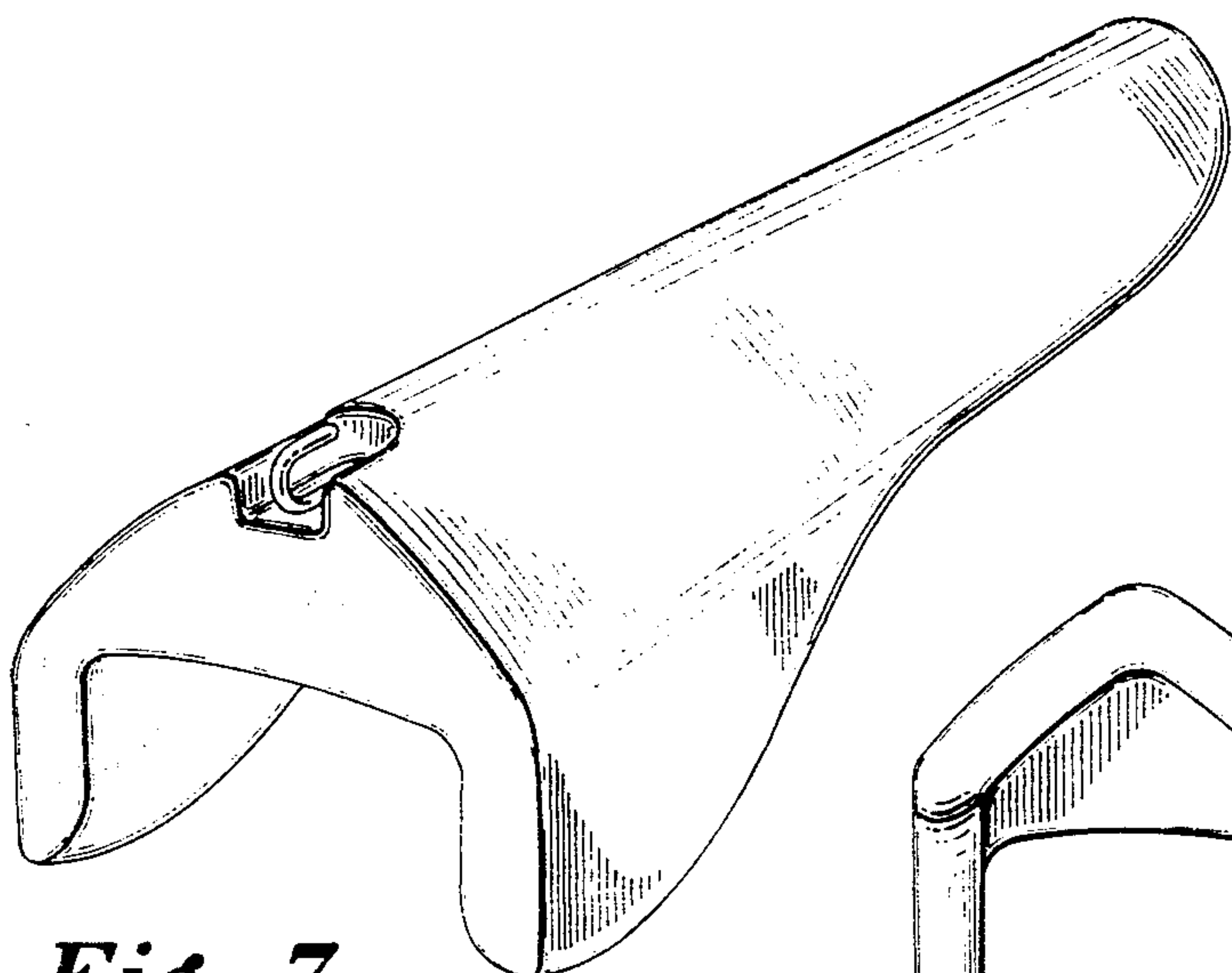

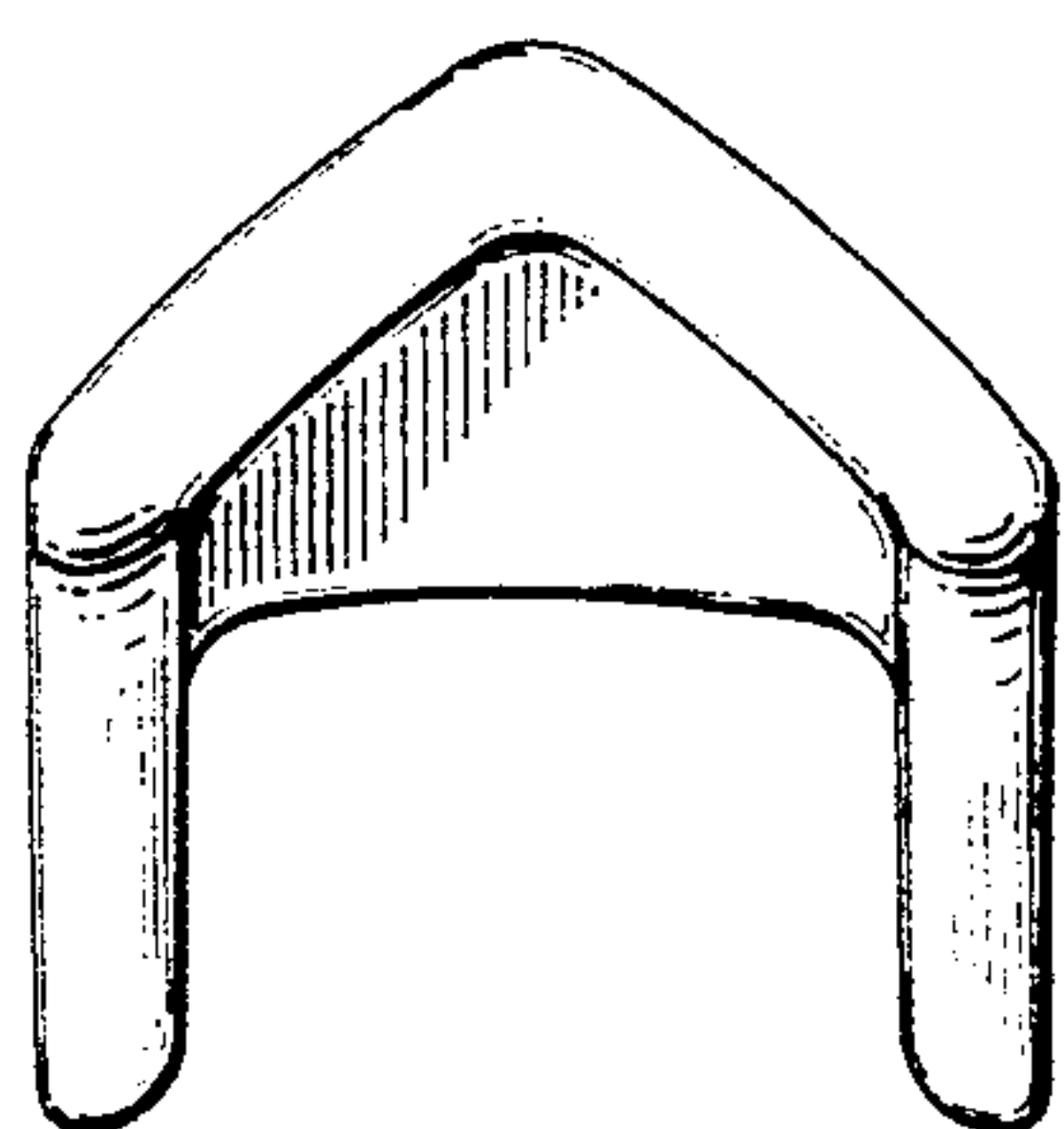

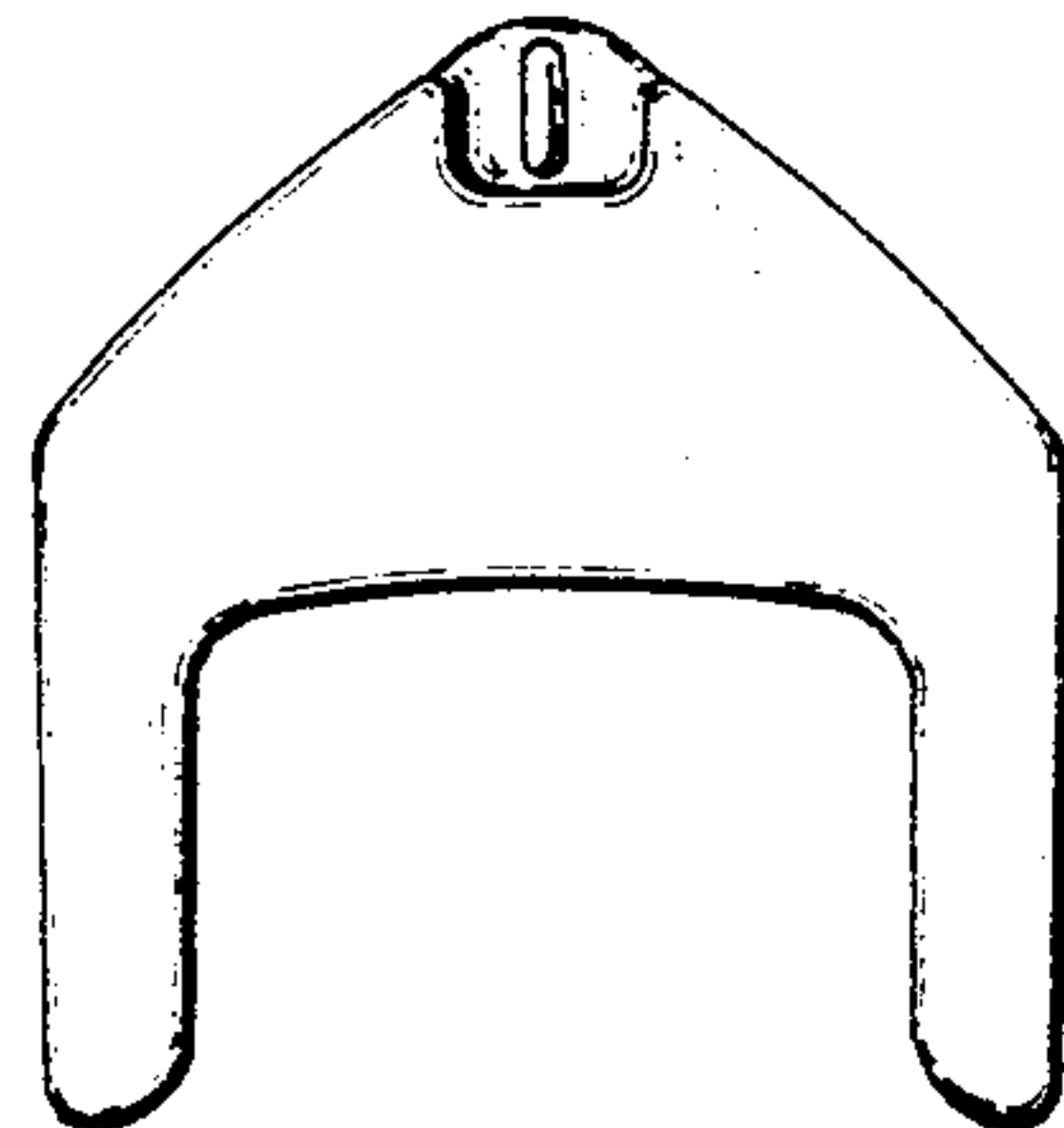

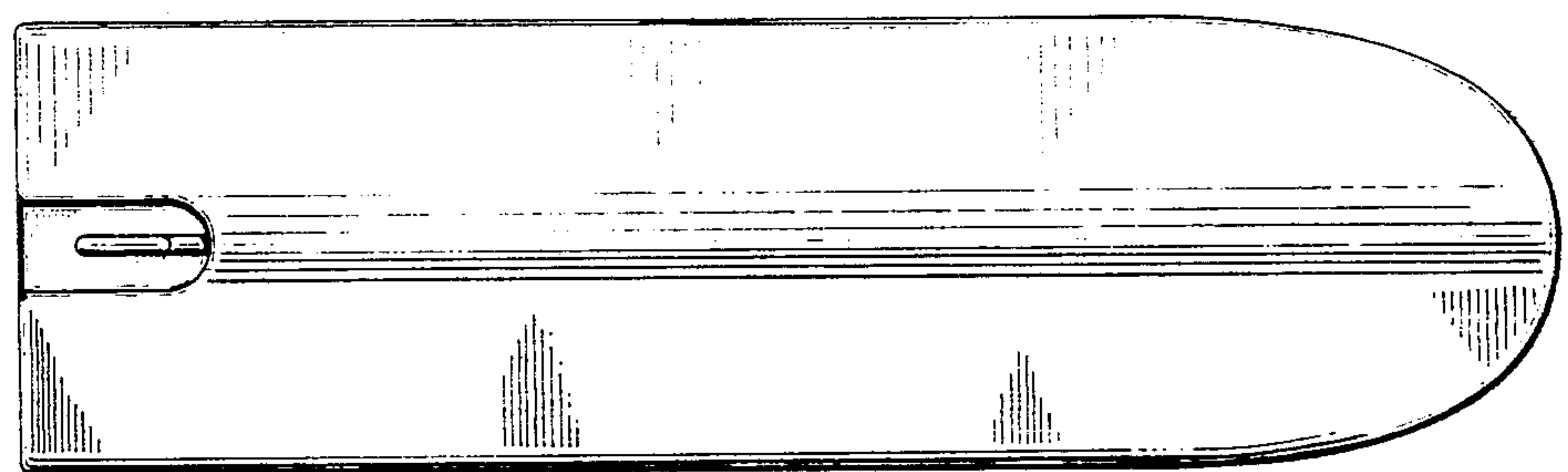

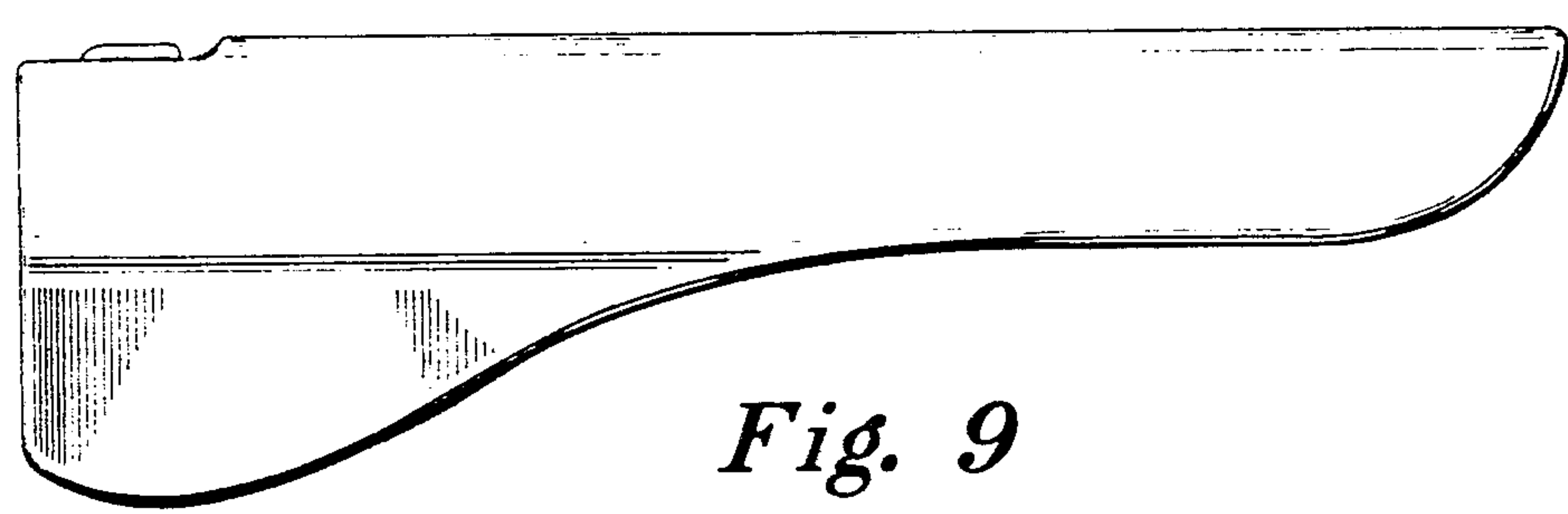

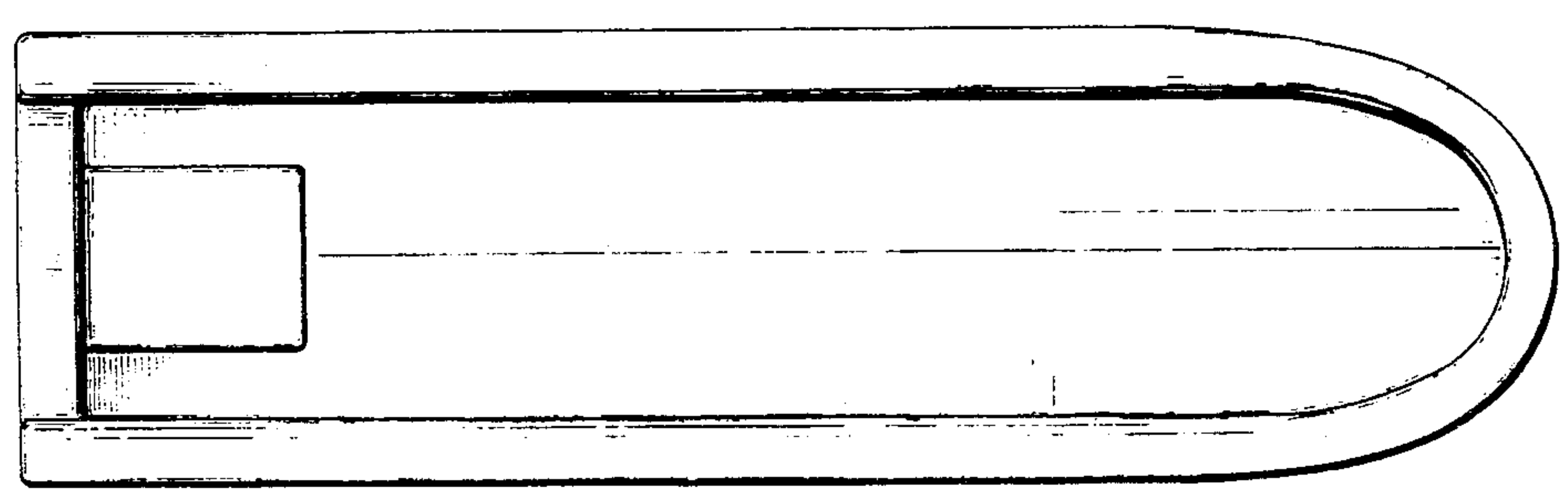
