## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cart for handling biological tissue showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view taken from the right hand side of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;  
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view opposite to that shown in FIG. 2; and  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

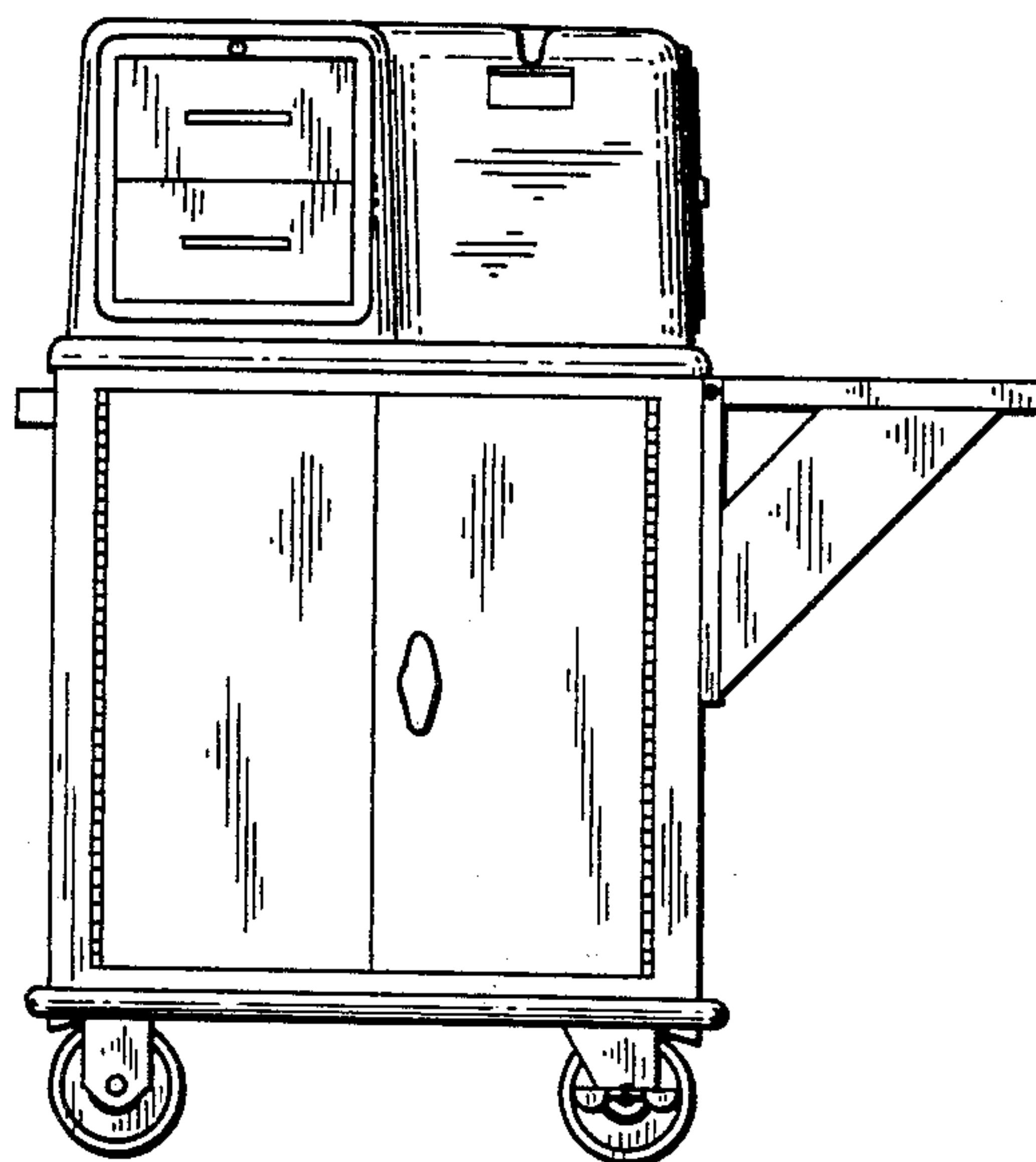

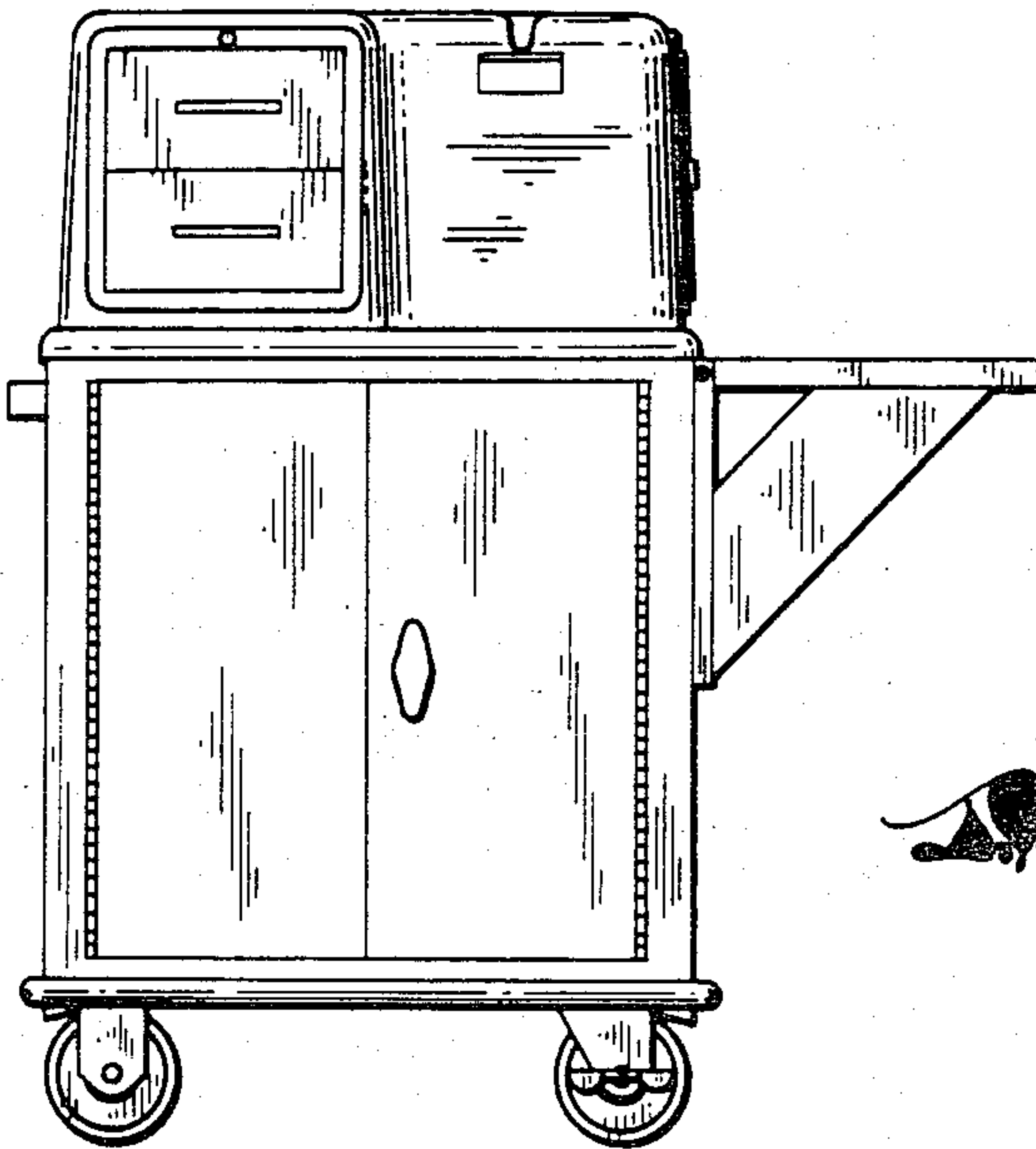

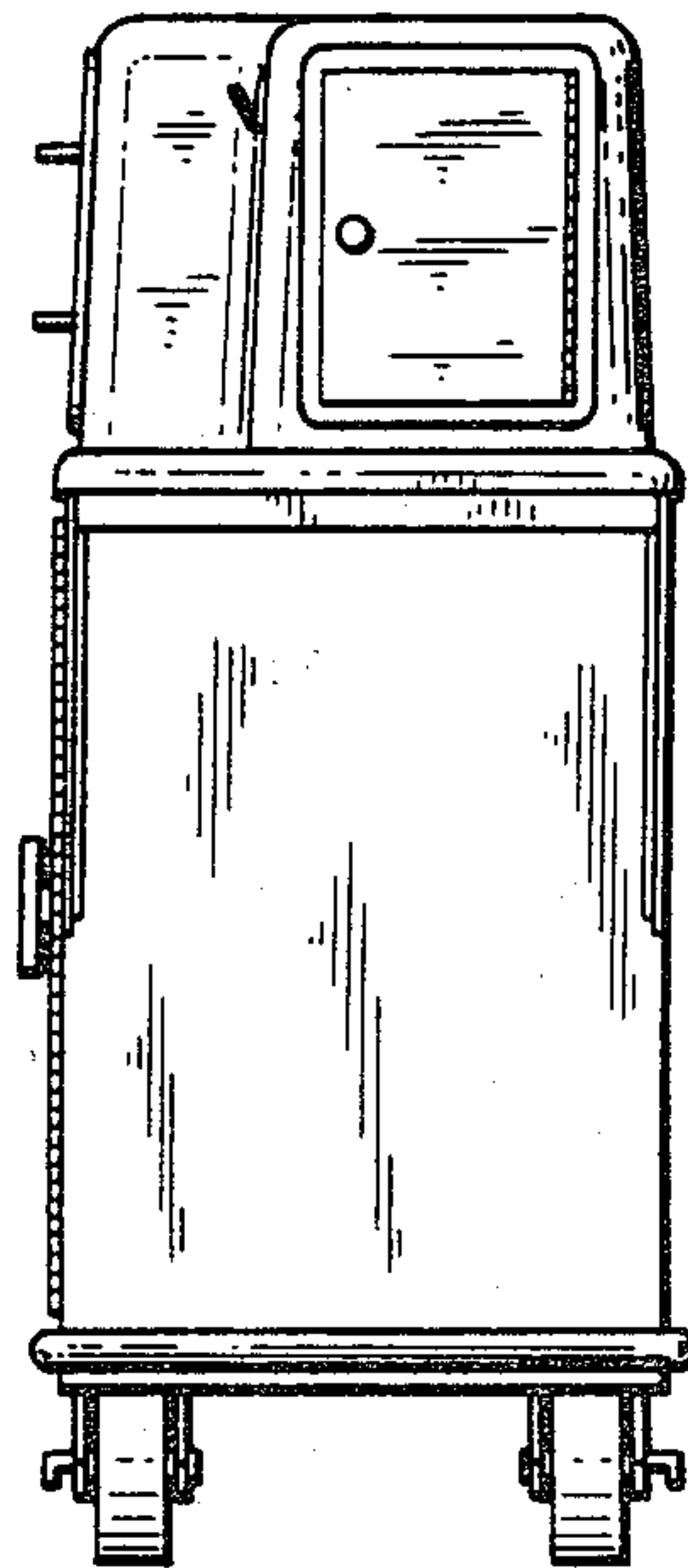

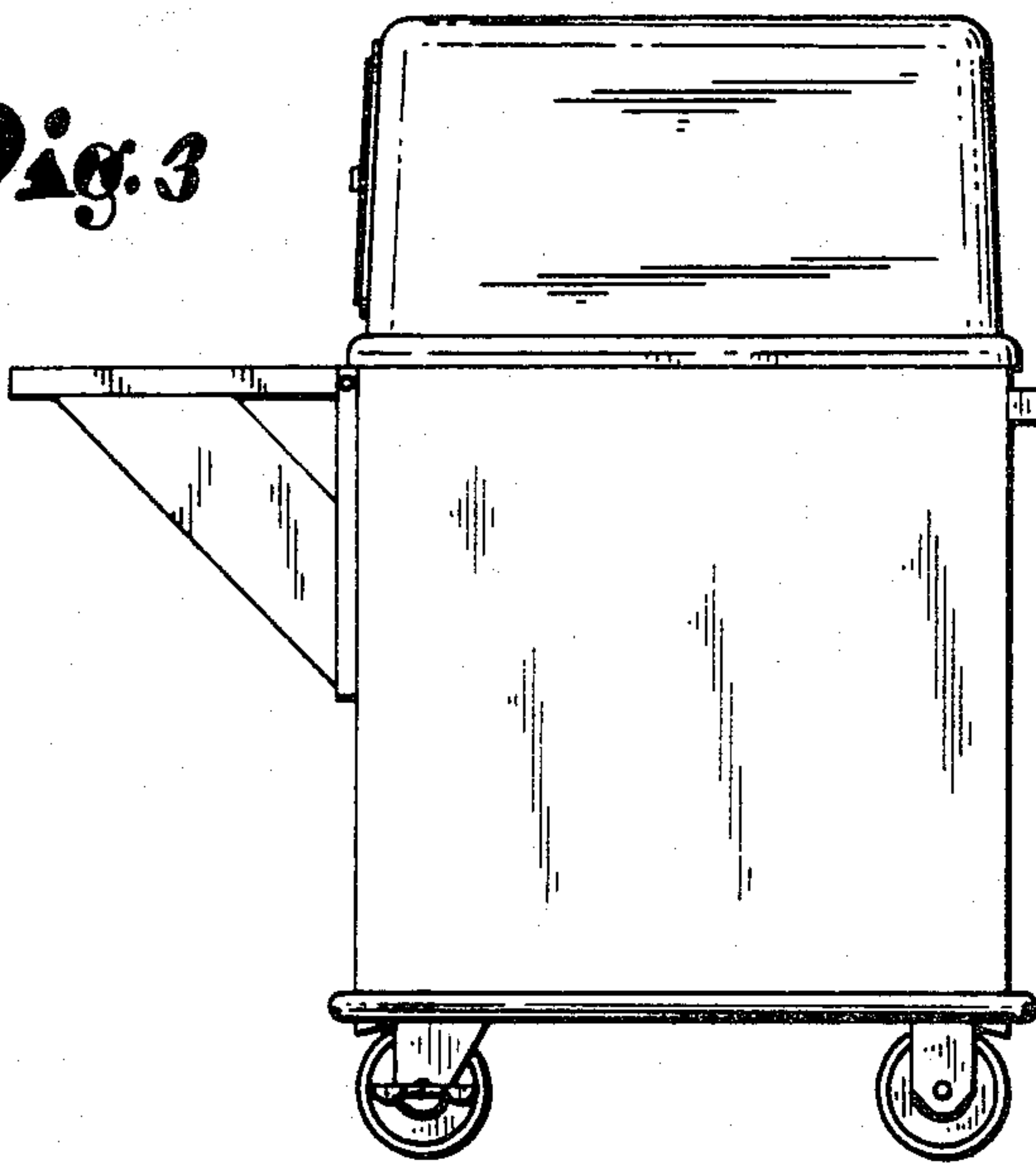

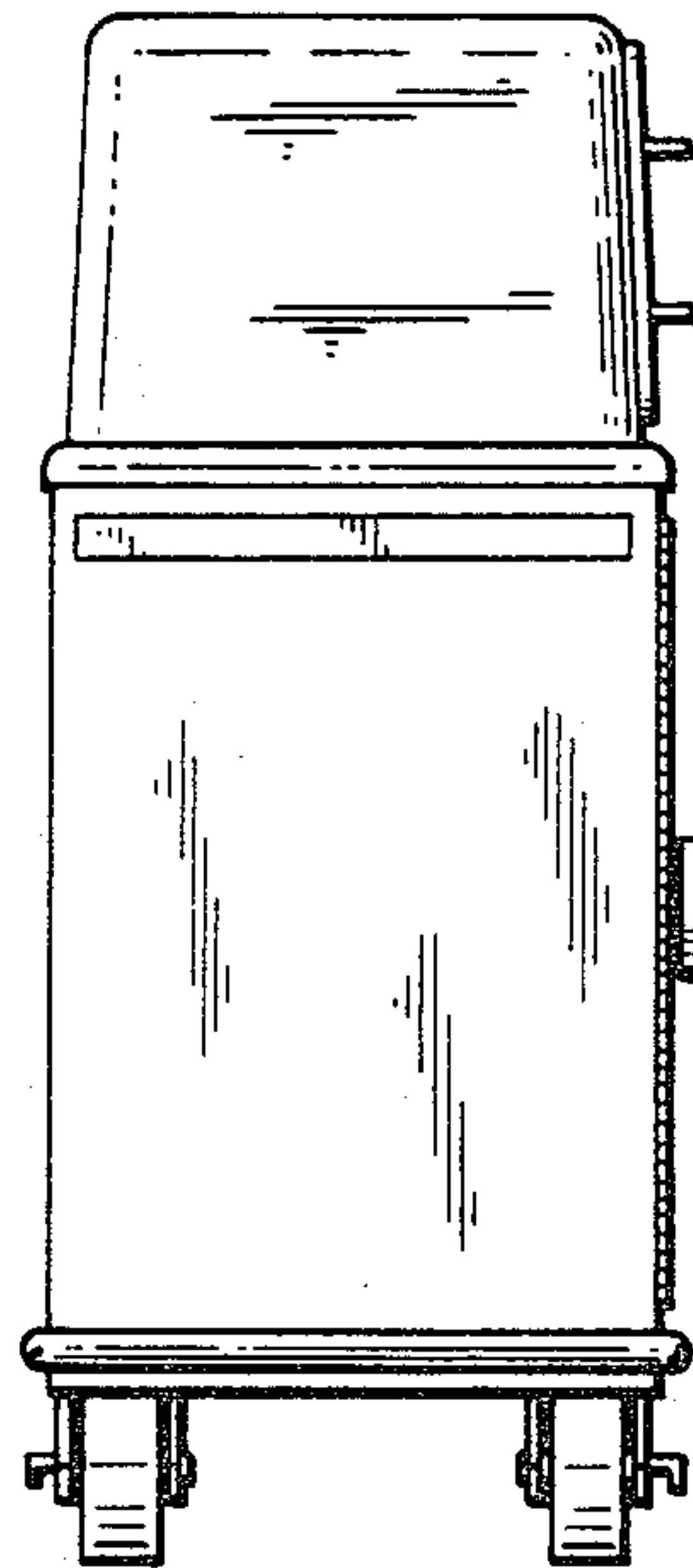
