 FIG. 5 is a sectional view thereof taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 4 on an enlarged scale.

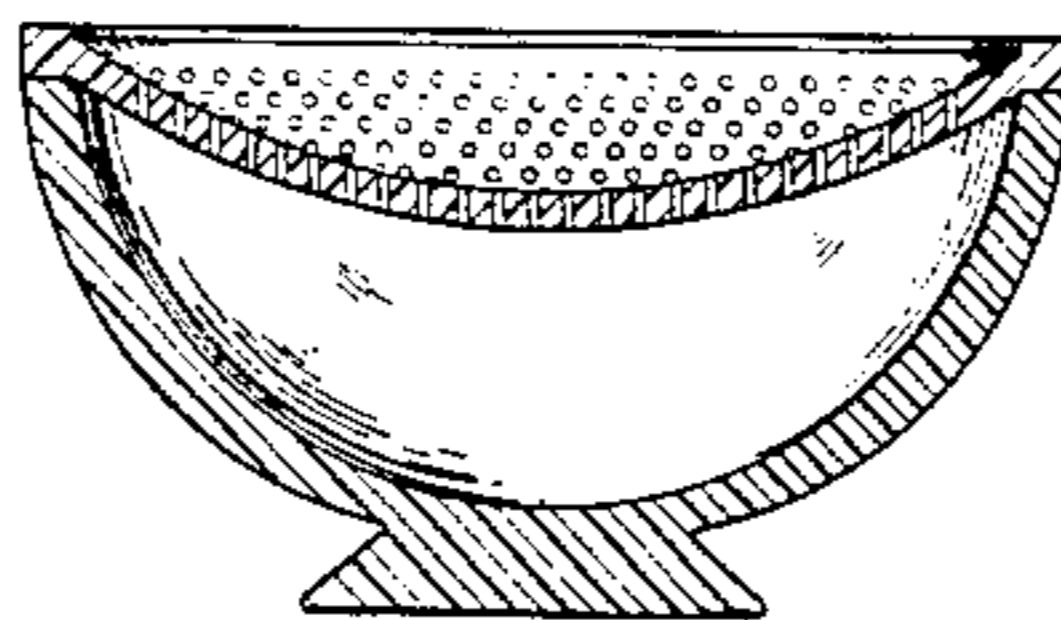
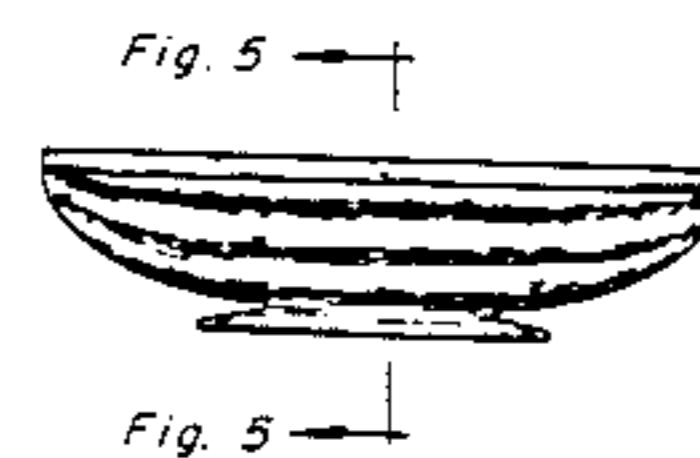
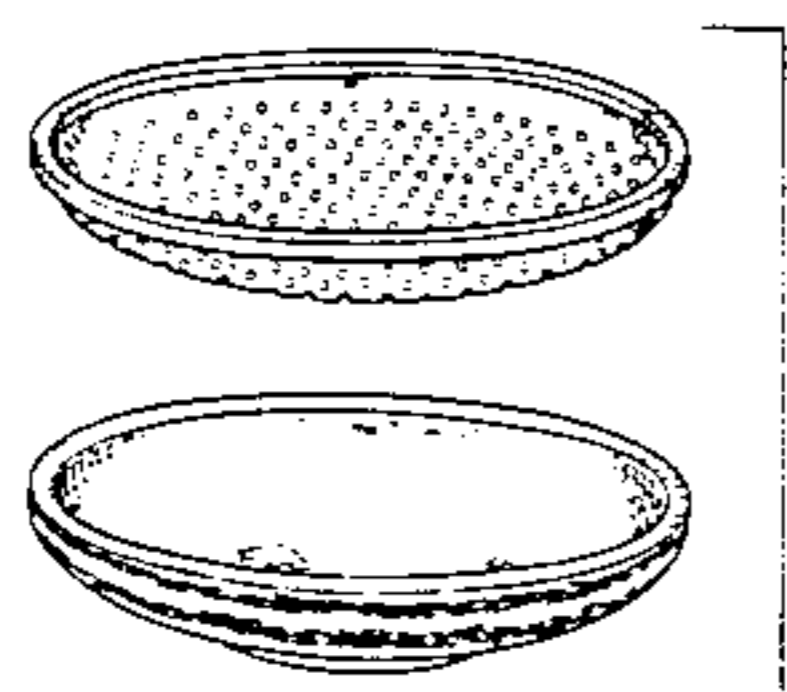

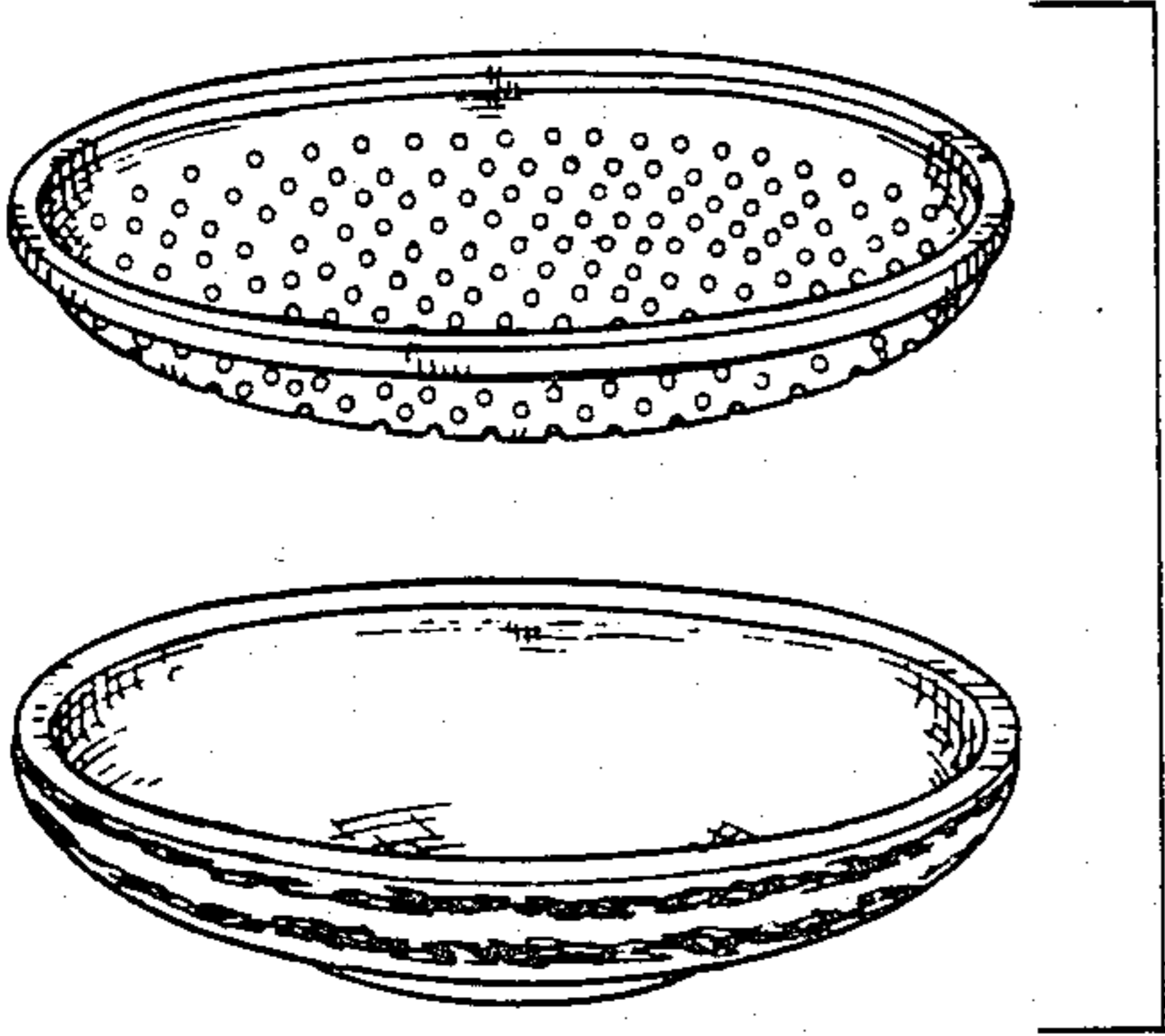

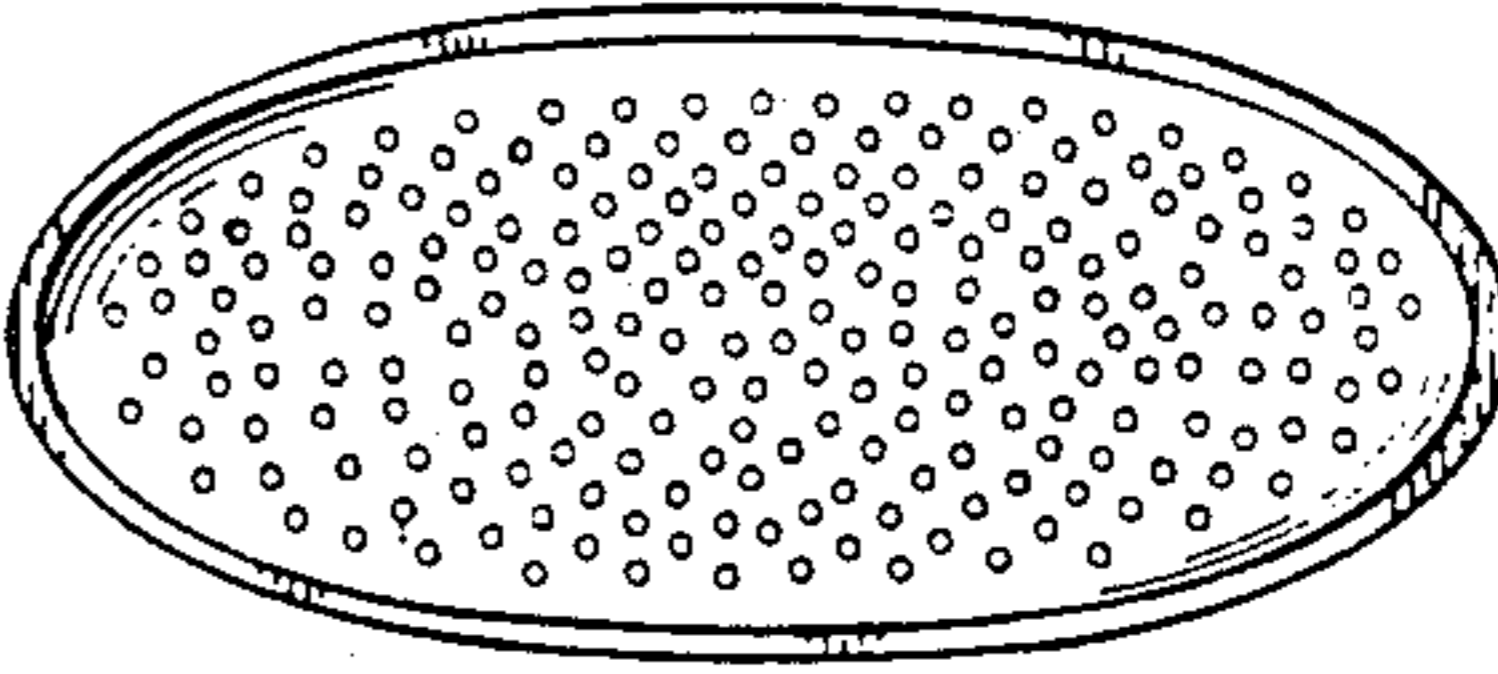

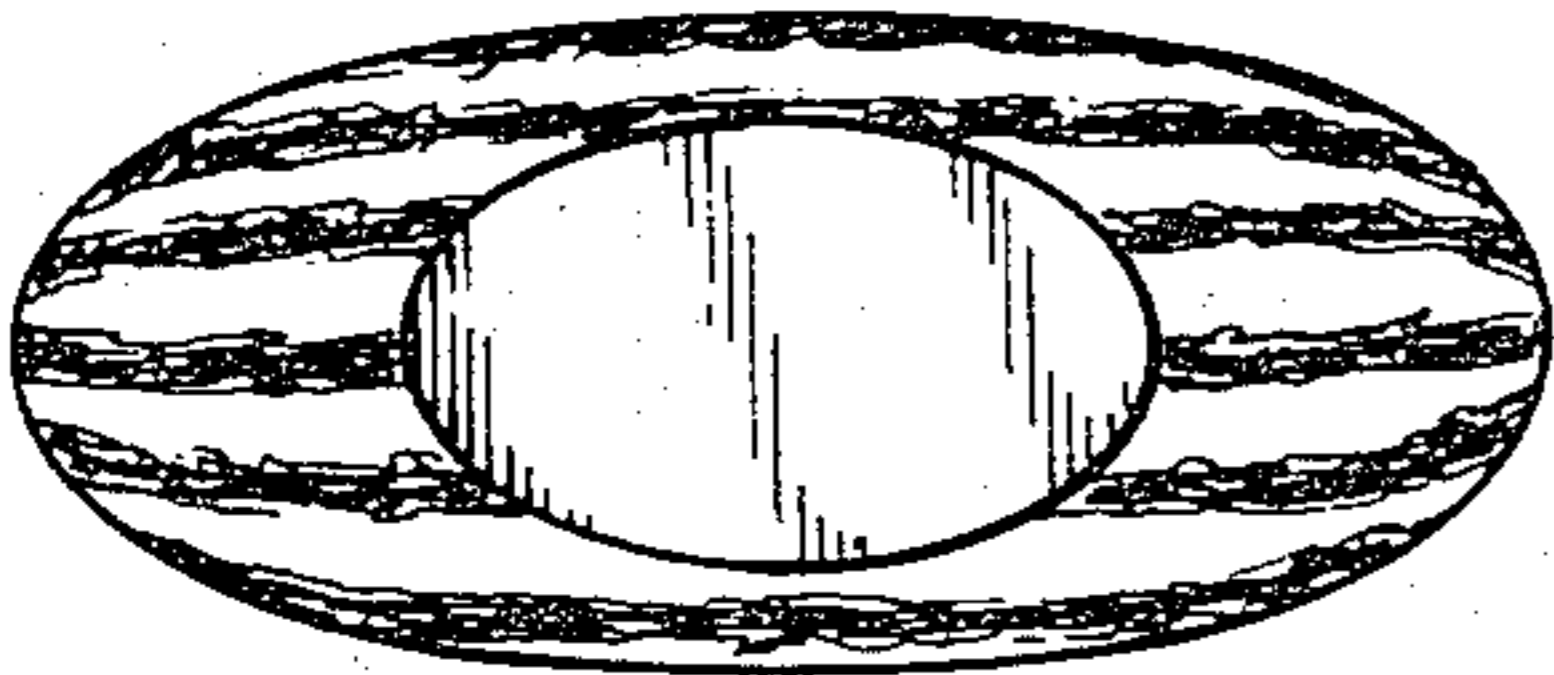

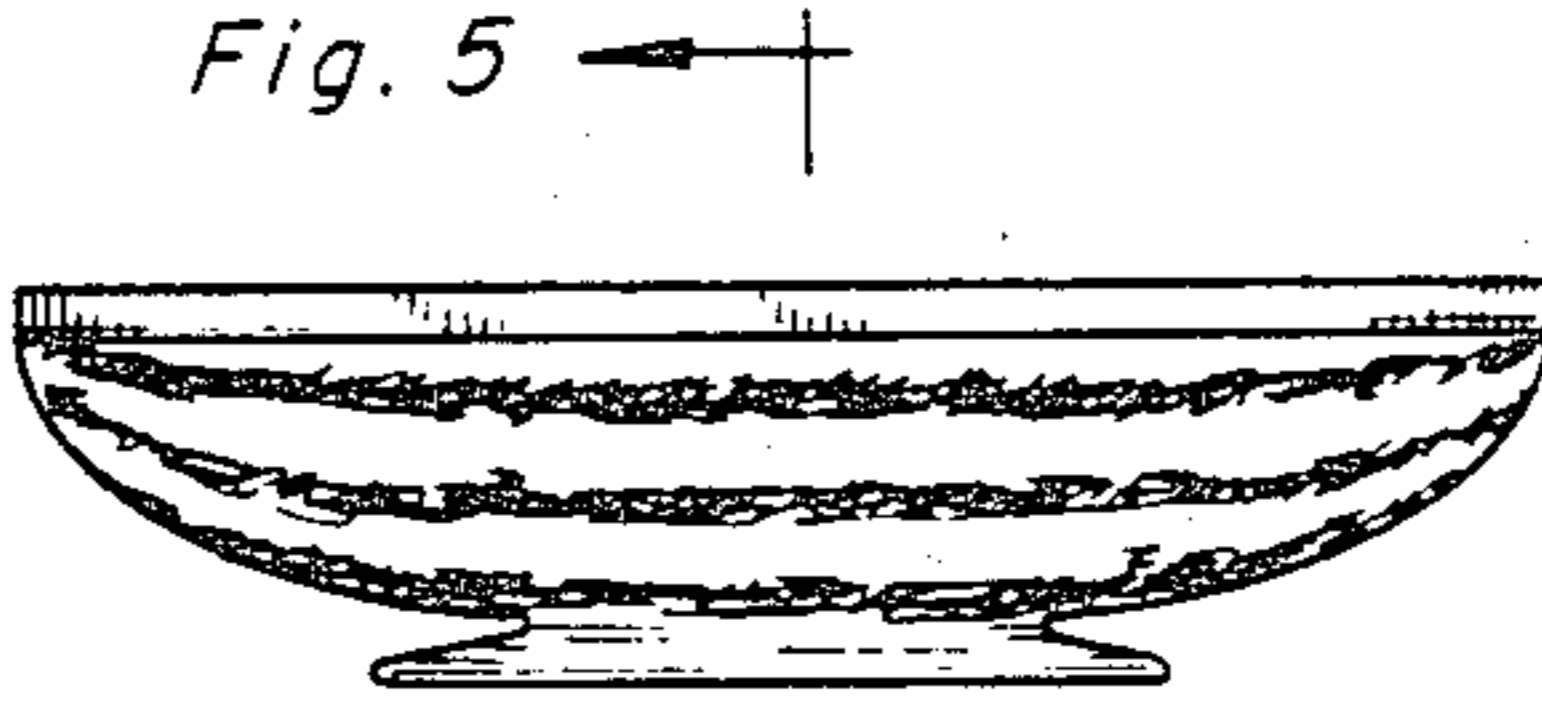
