[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a spoon or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side view thereof, the undisclosed side being substantially identical with the side shown in FIG. 3;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged cross-section taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2.

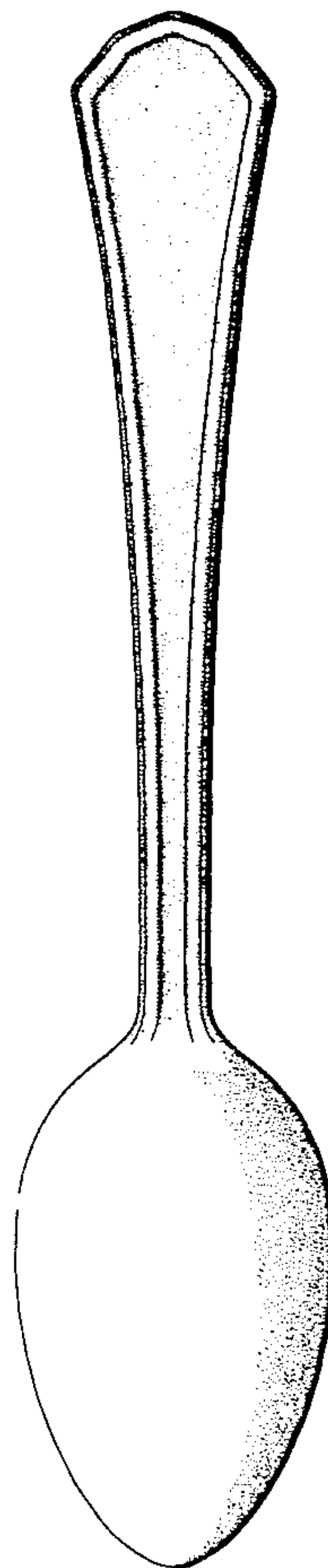
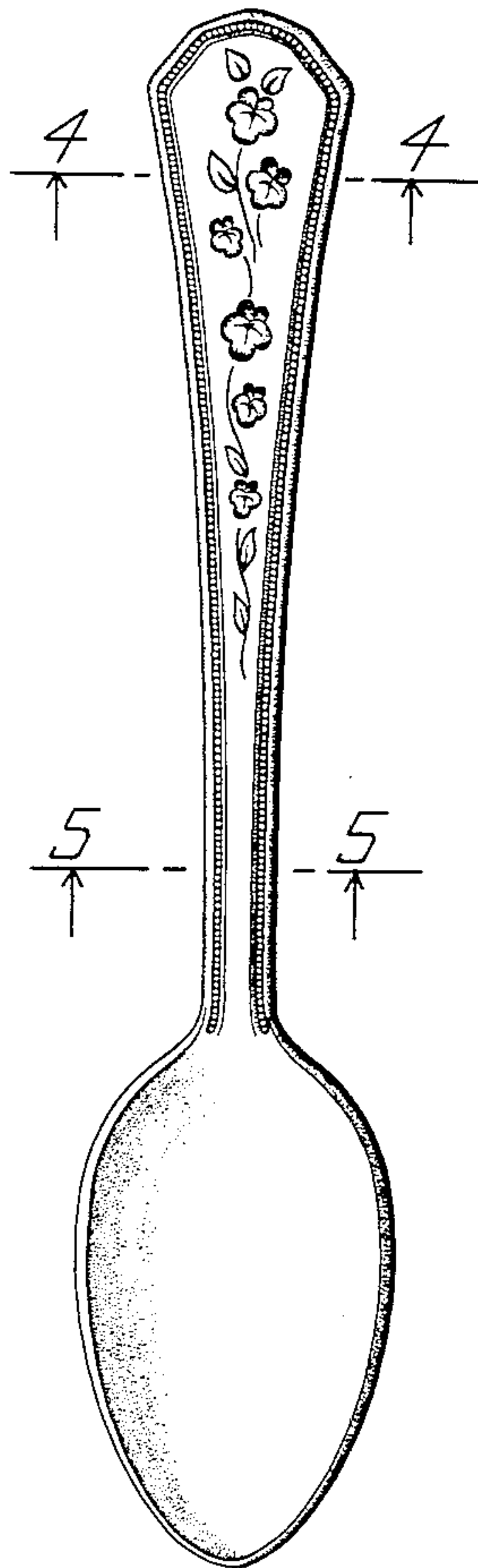

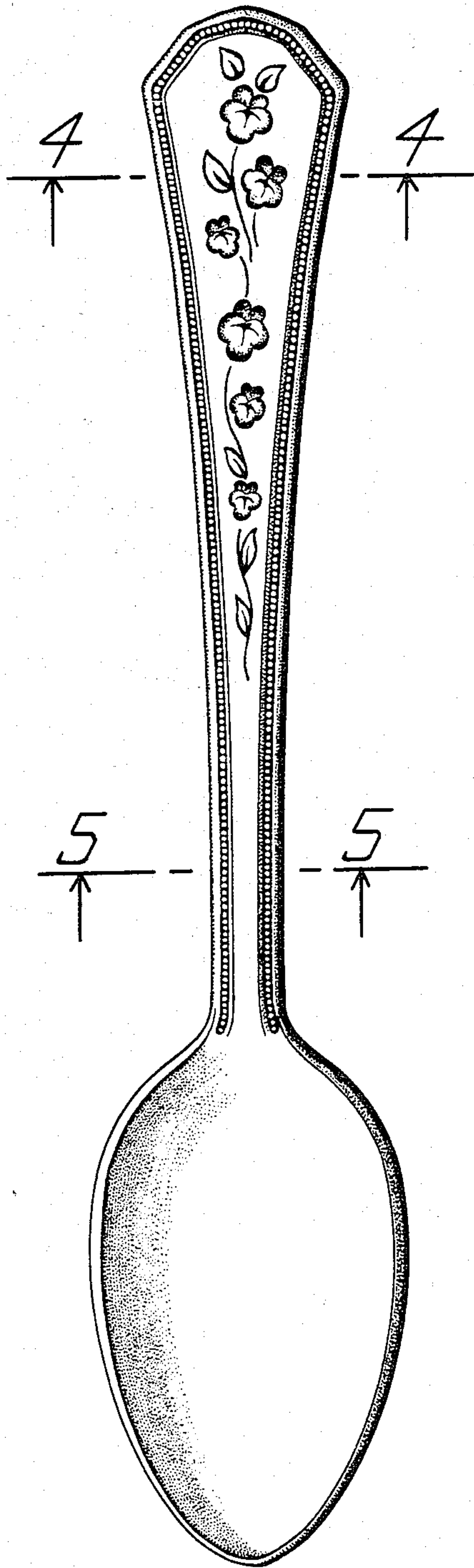

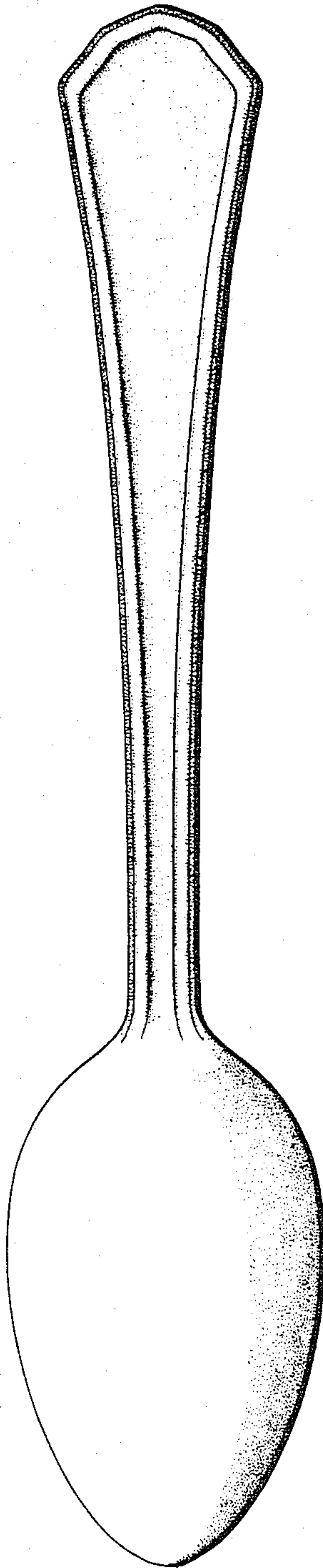

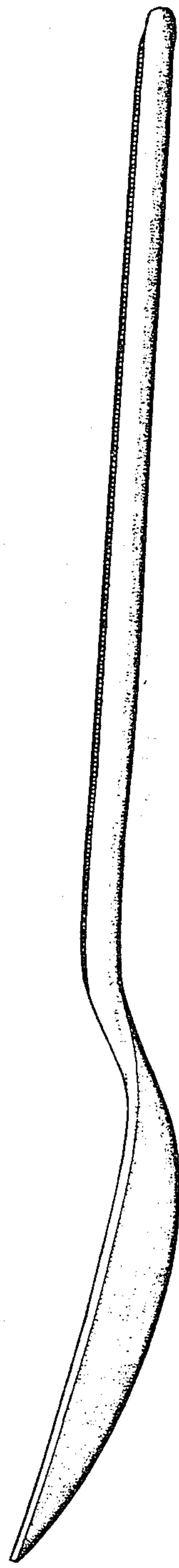
