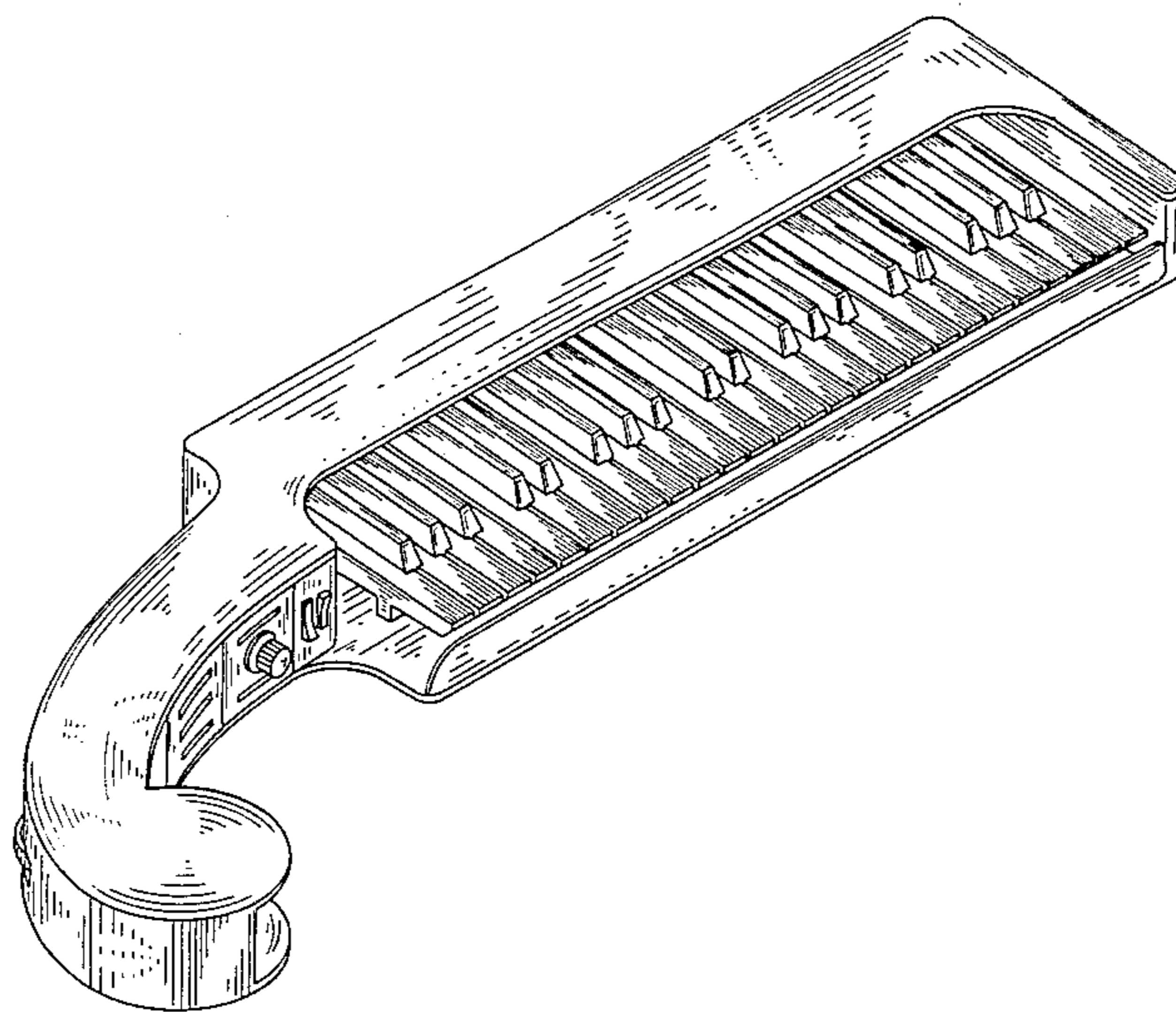

The ornamental design for a portable musical synthesizer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a portable musical synthesizer showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.



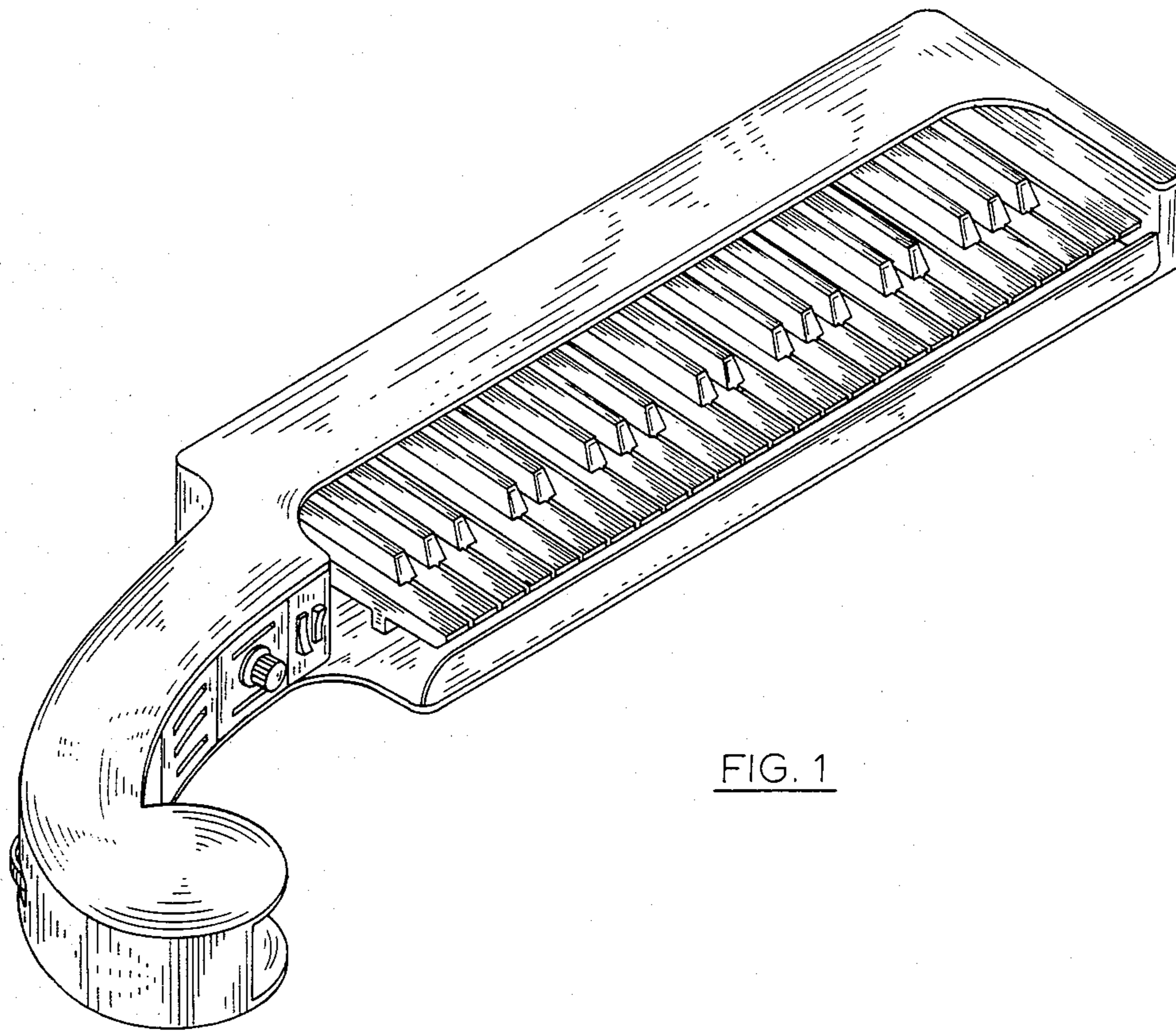

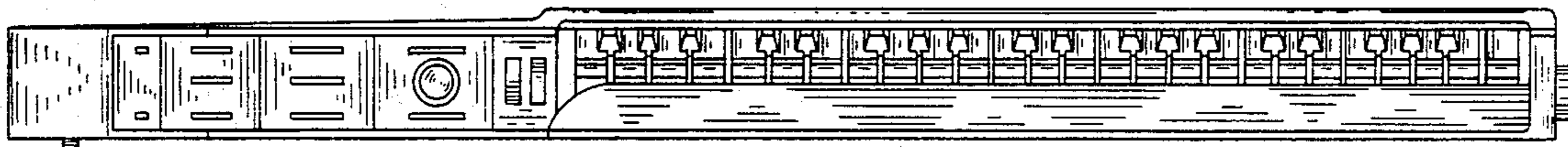

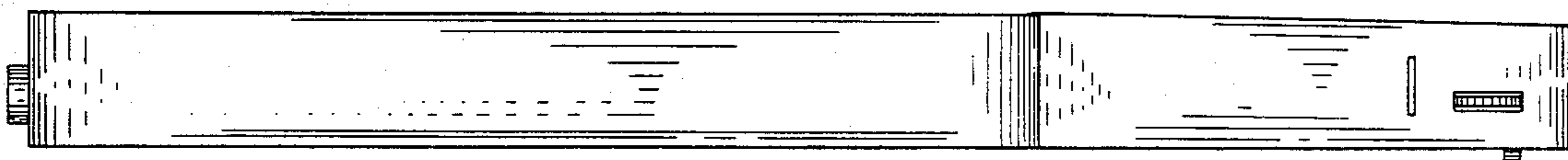

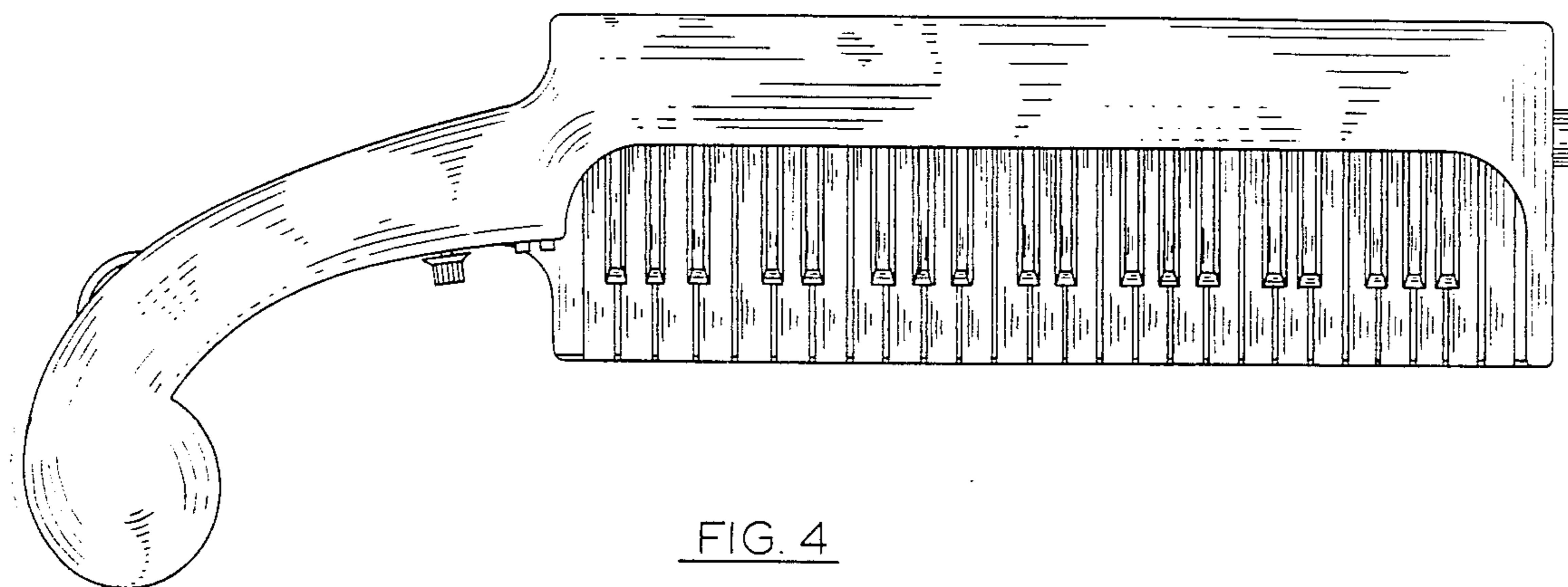

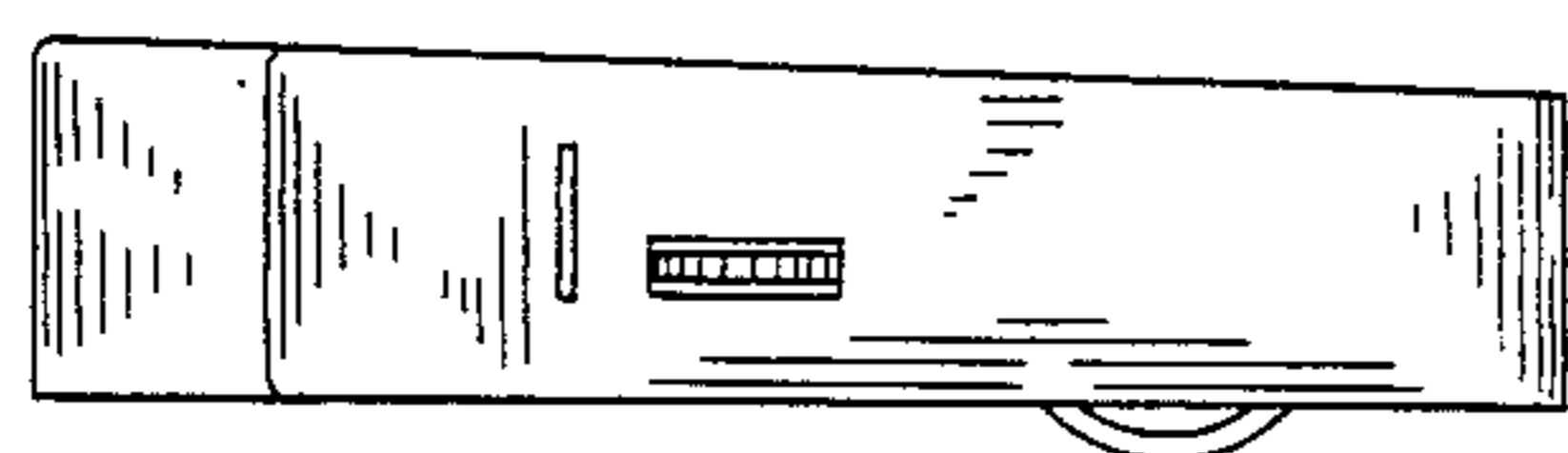

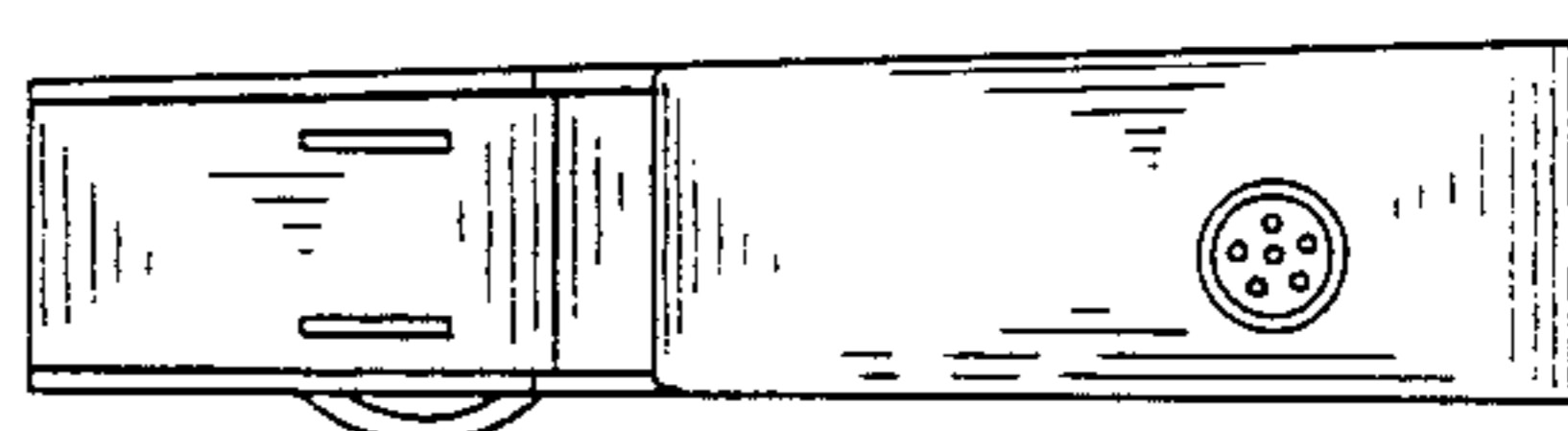

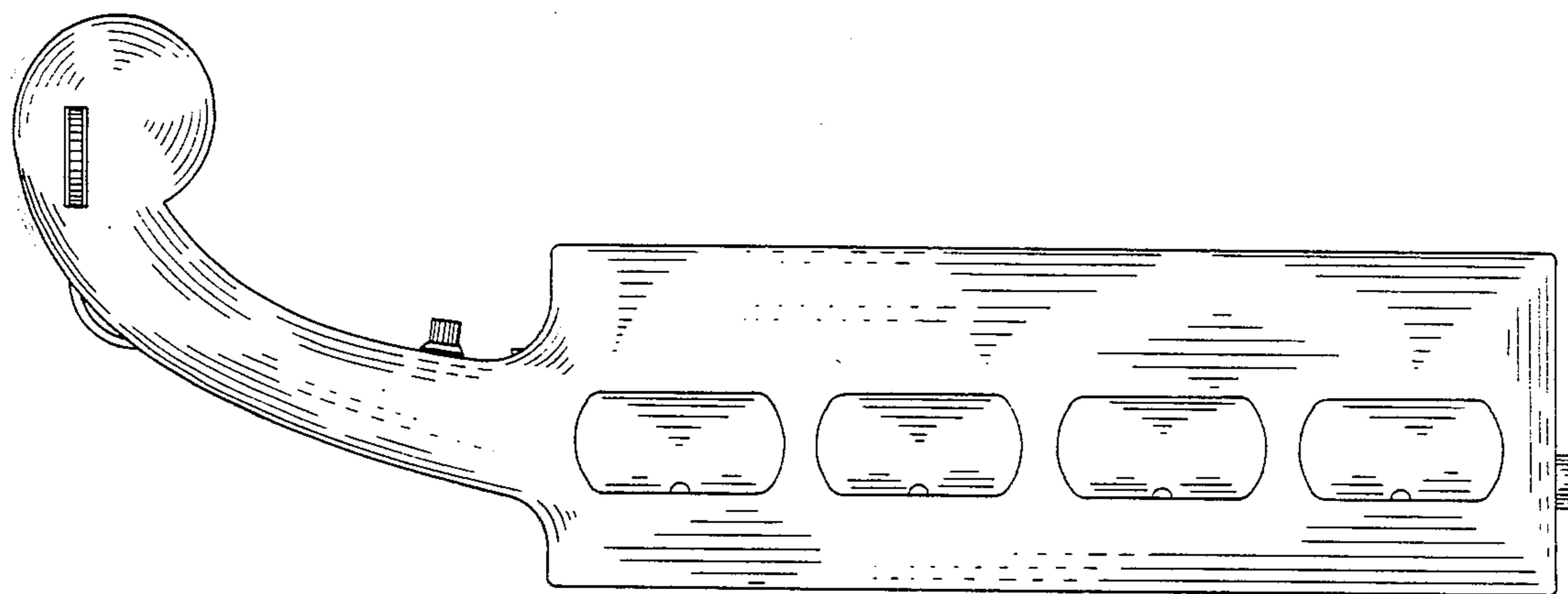
