FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

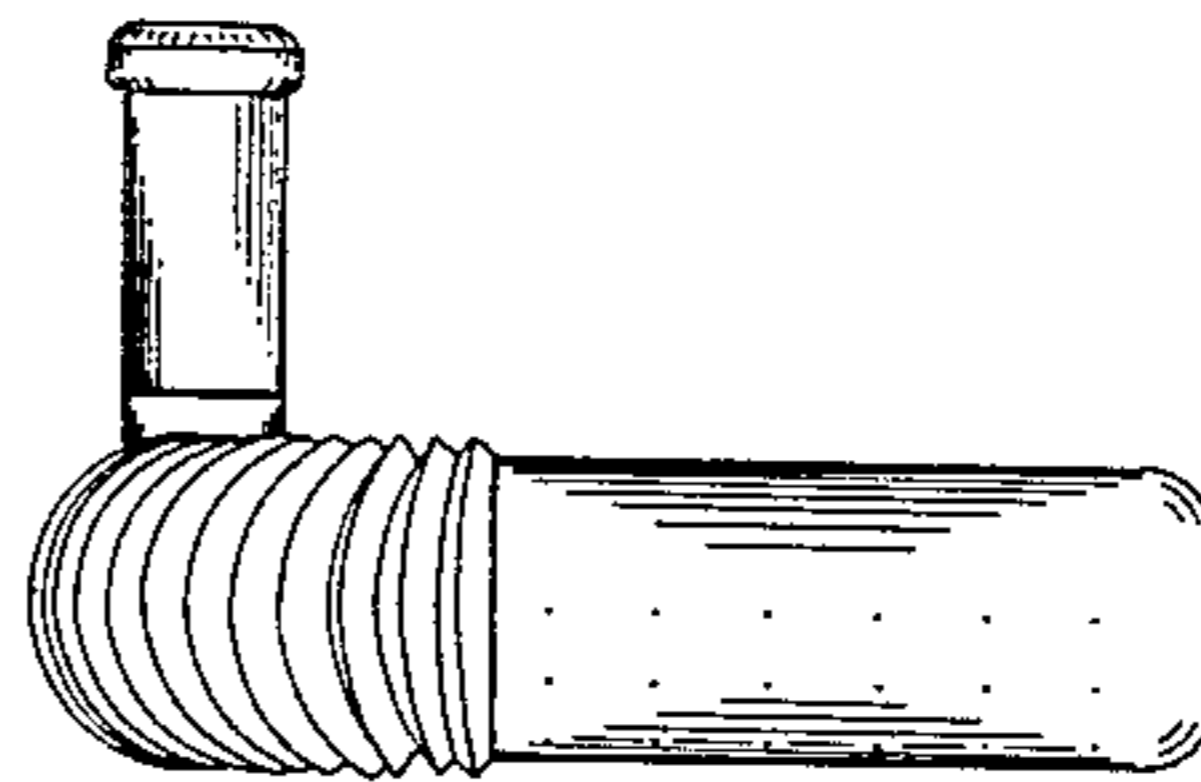
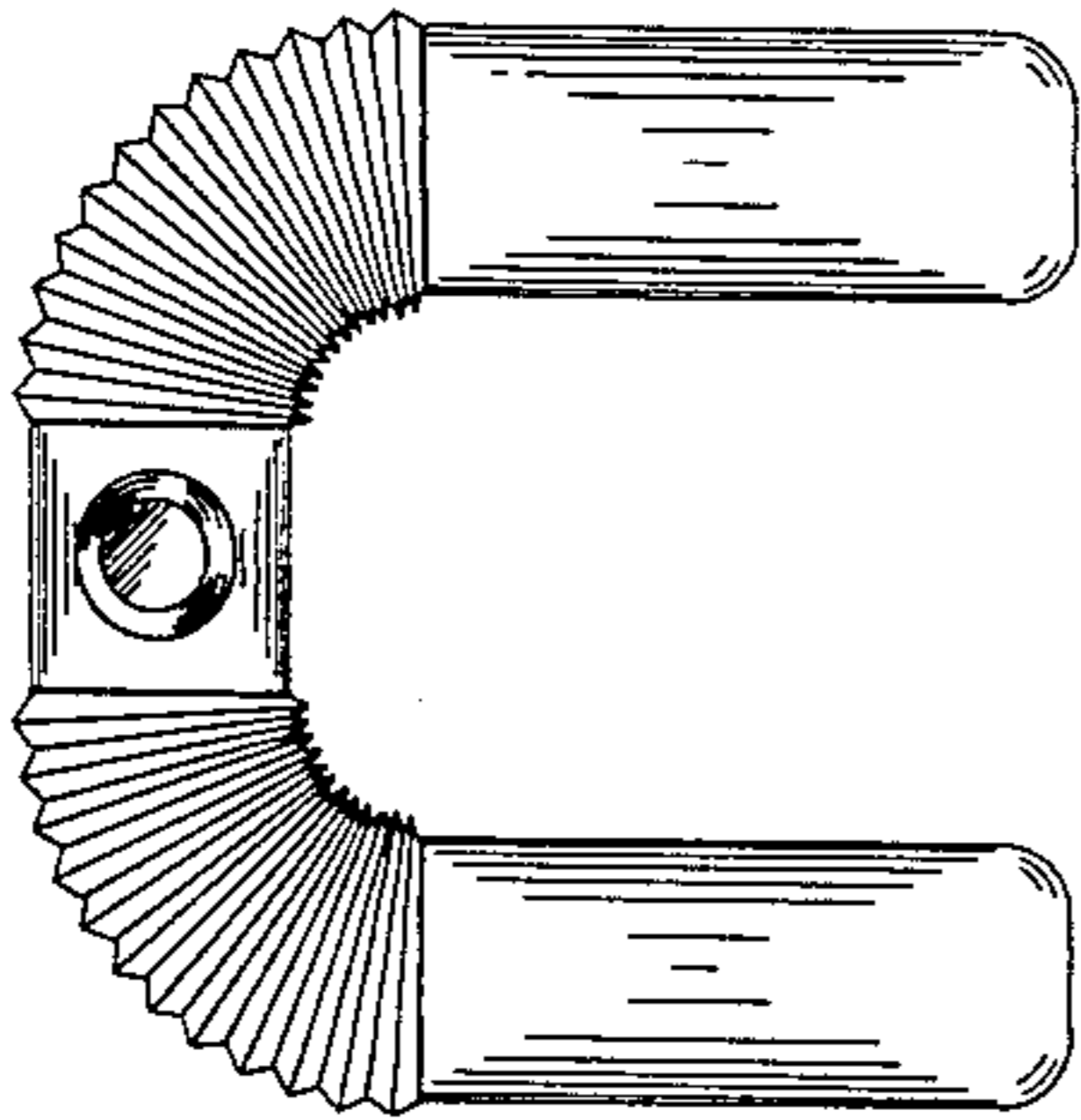
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown; and

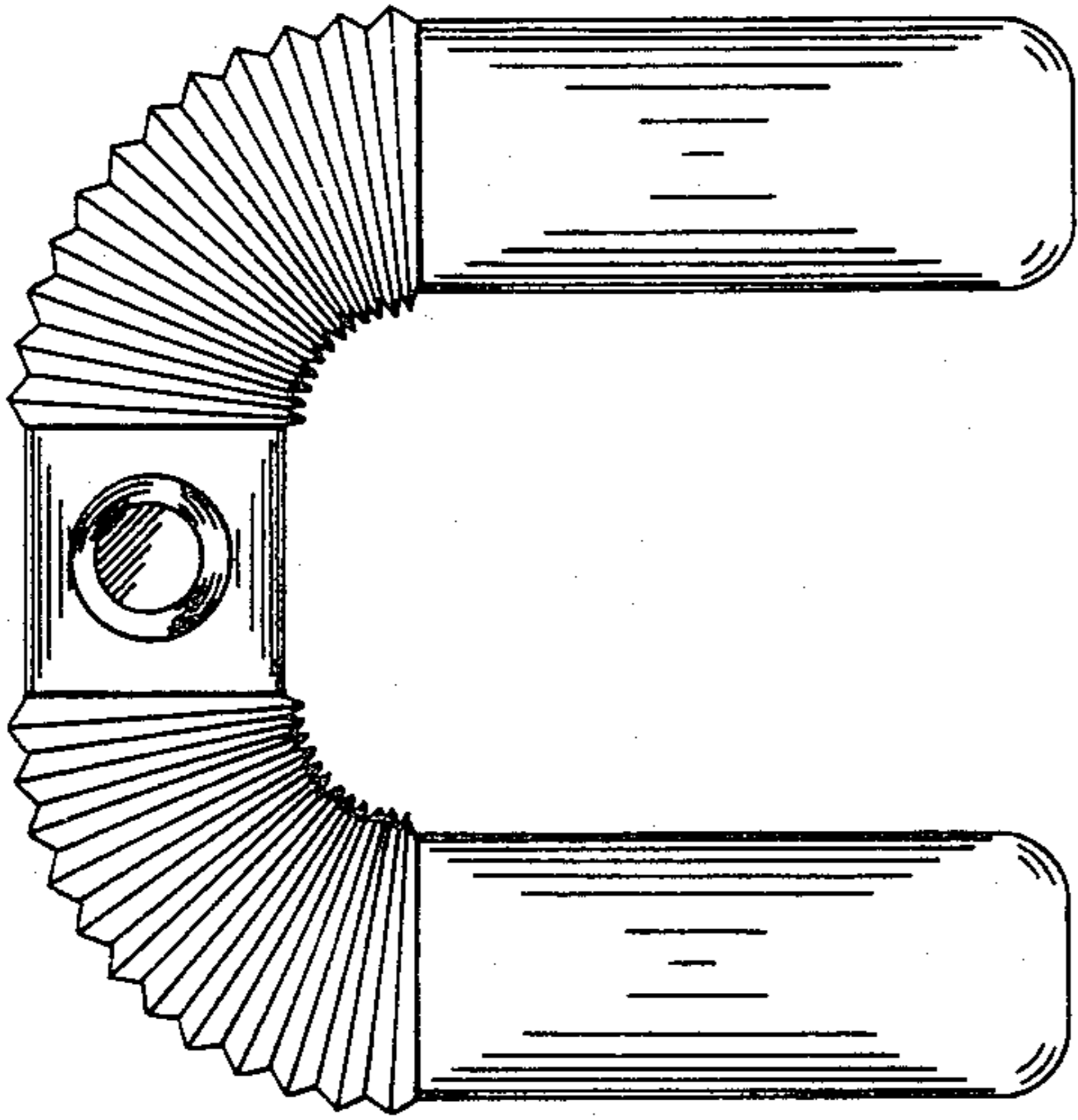

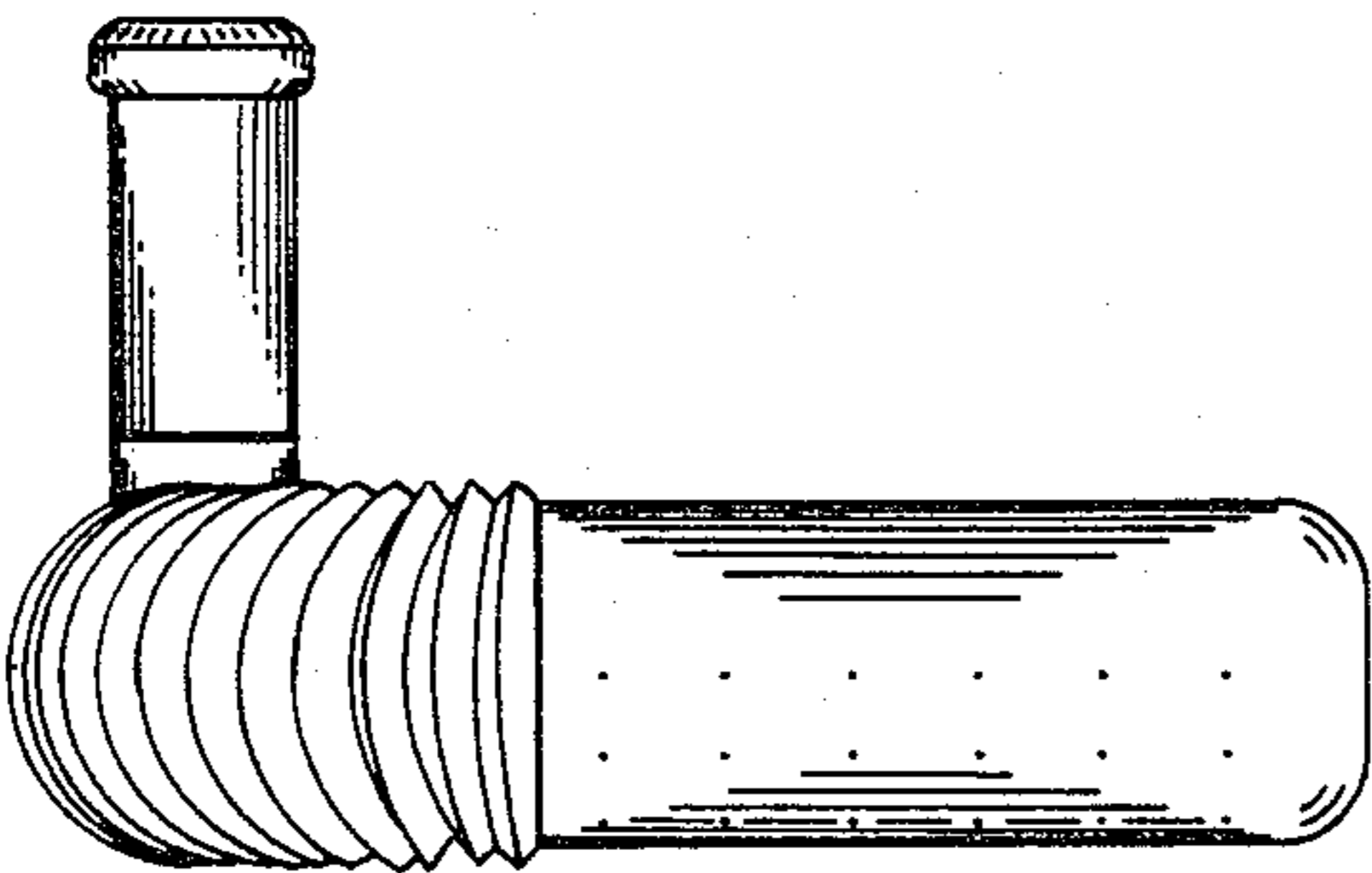

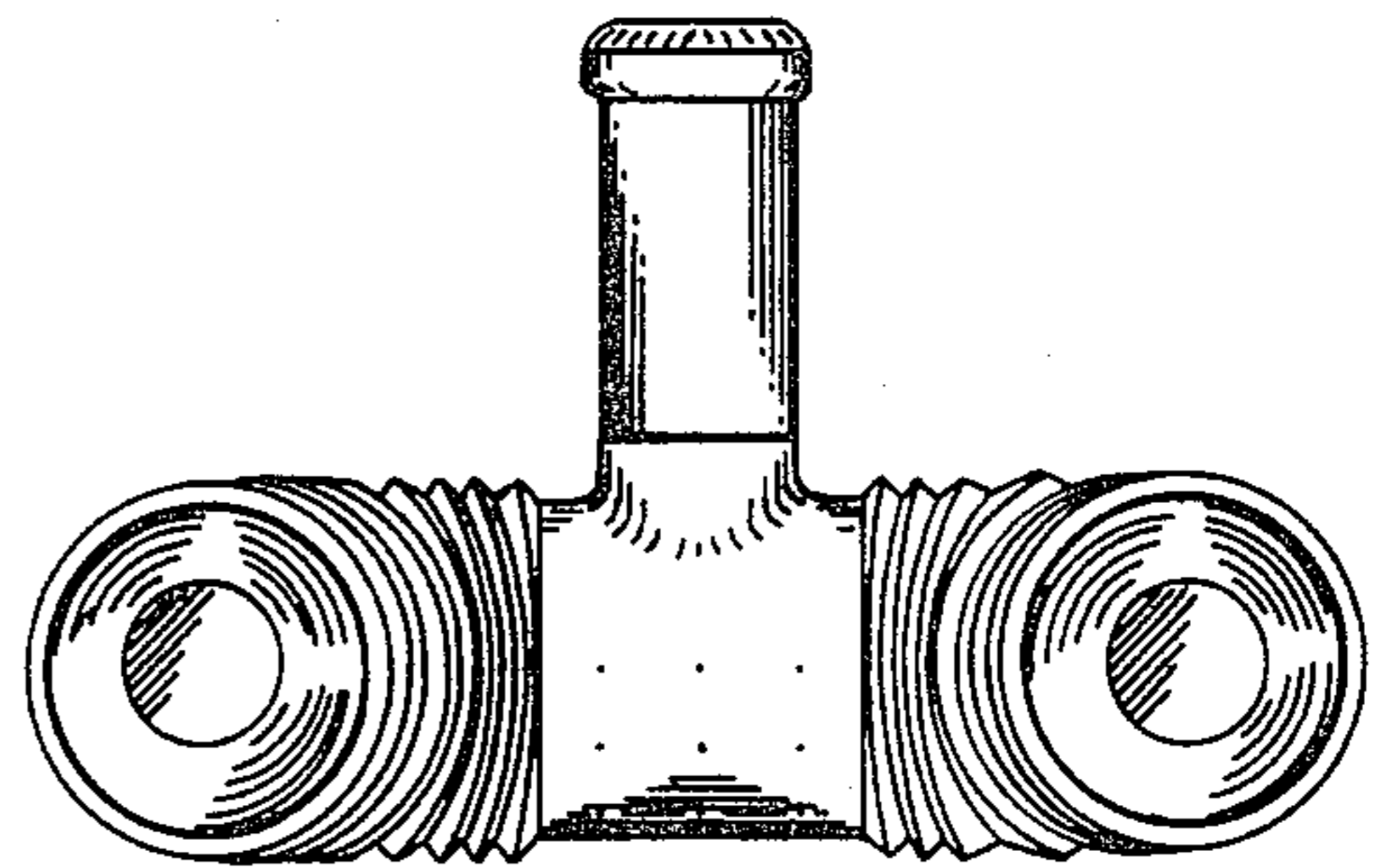

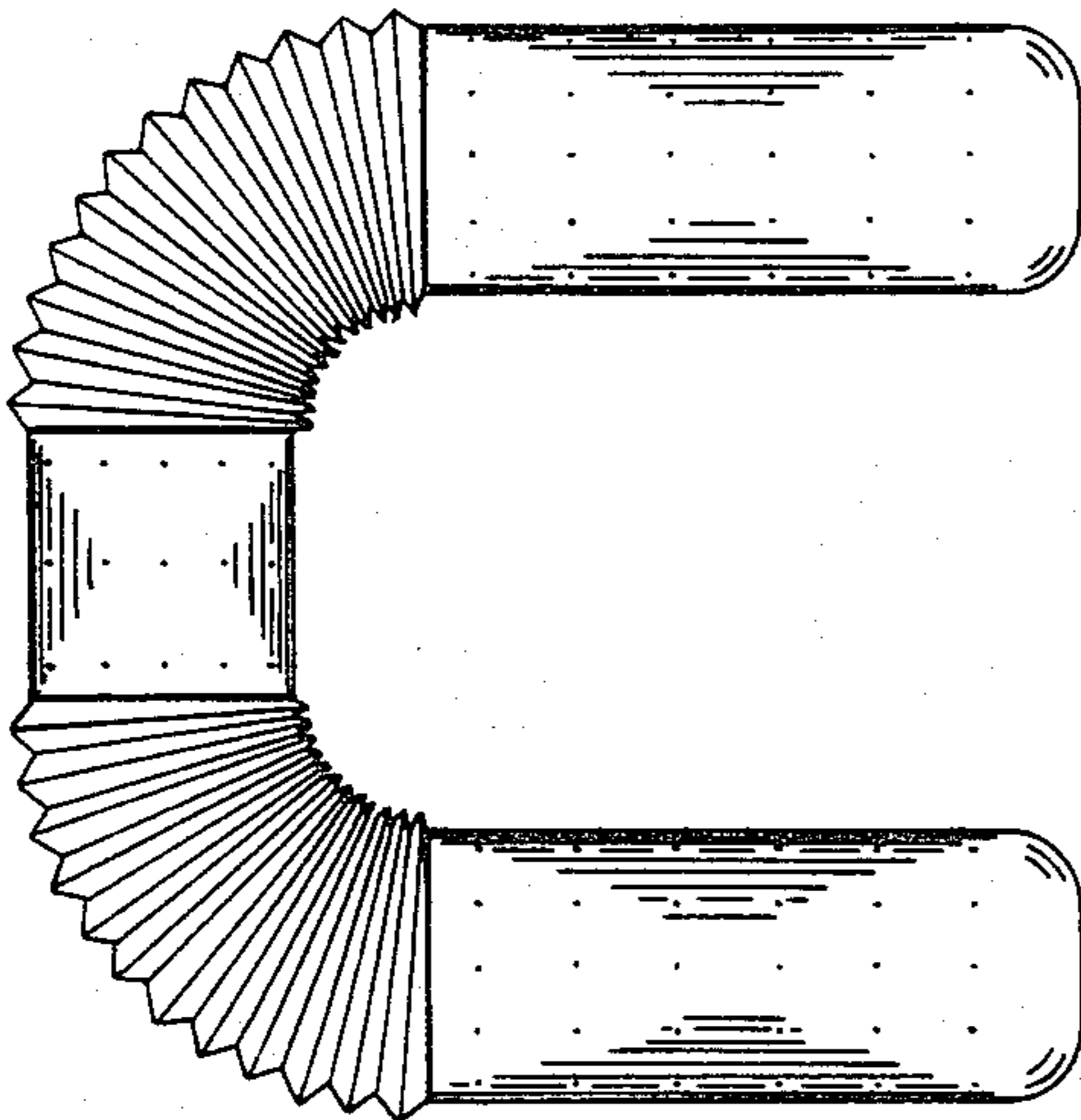
