DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a heel portion of
a combined heel-sole unit showing my new design, the
right side being a mirror image thereof, the broken-line
showings being for illustrative purposes only and form-
ing no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
