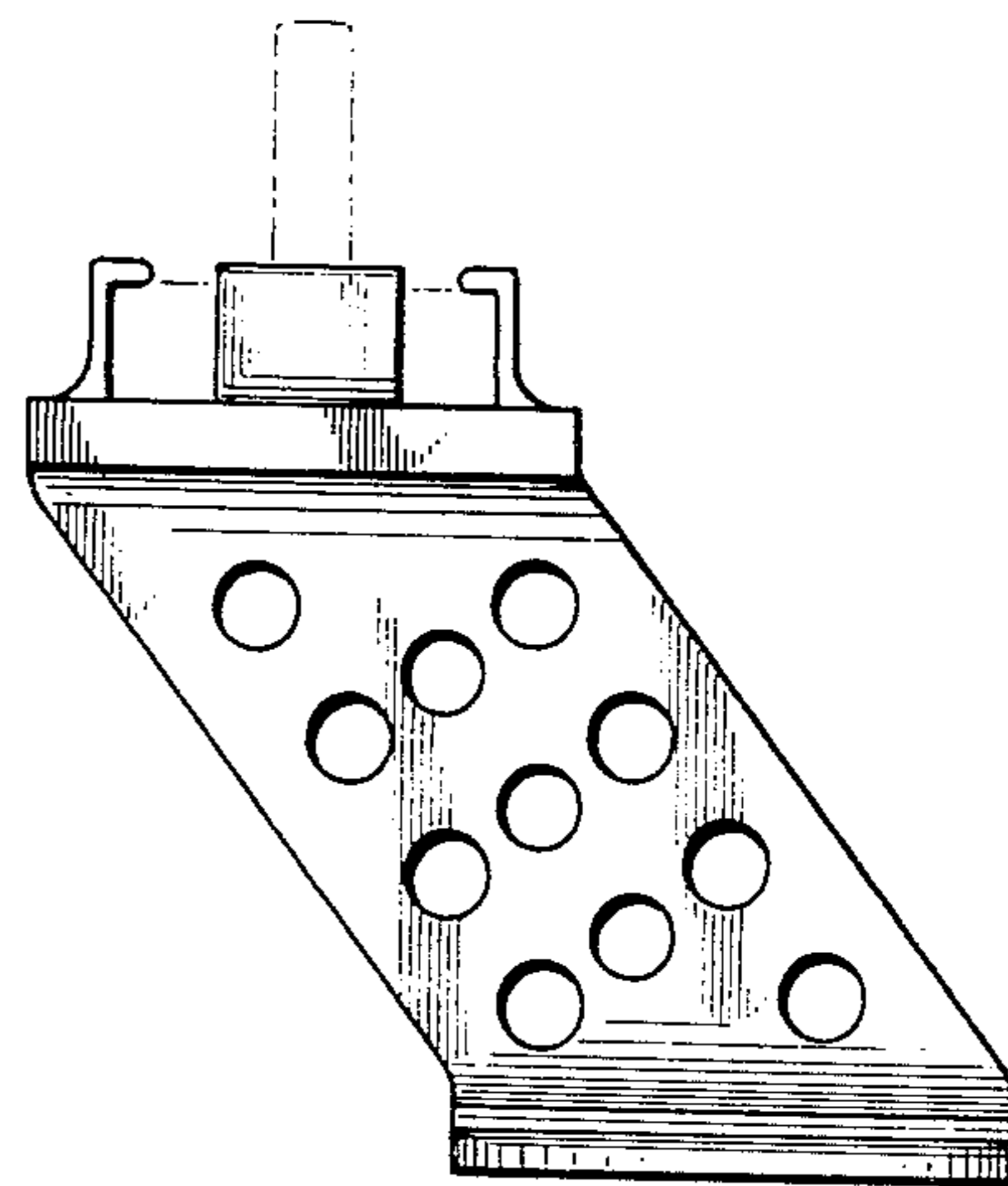
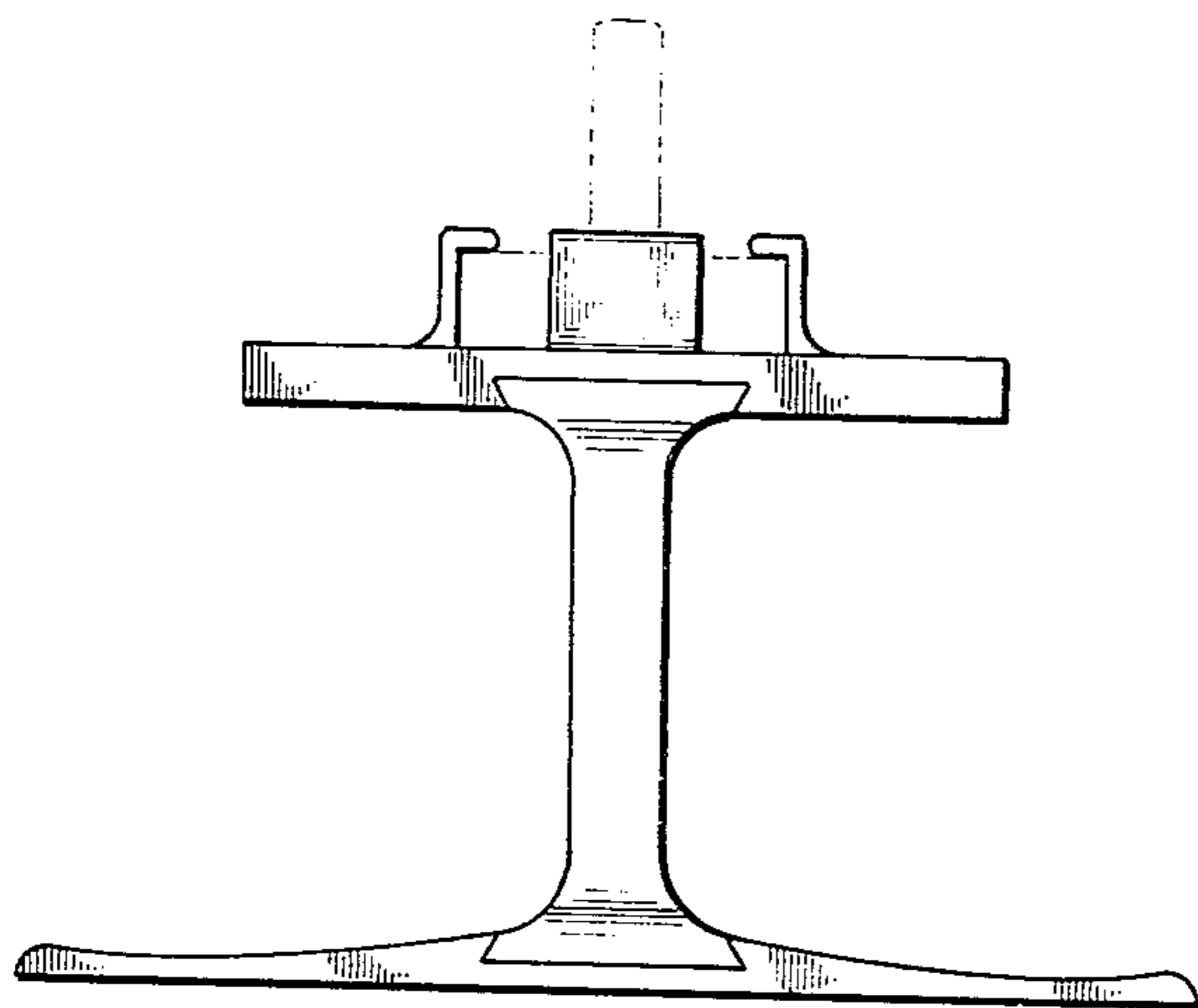

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stand for a home video controller, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a stand for a home video controller showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The broken line showing of a controller in FIGS. 1-3 is for illustrative purposes only.



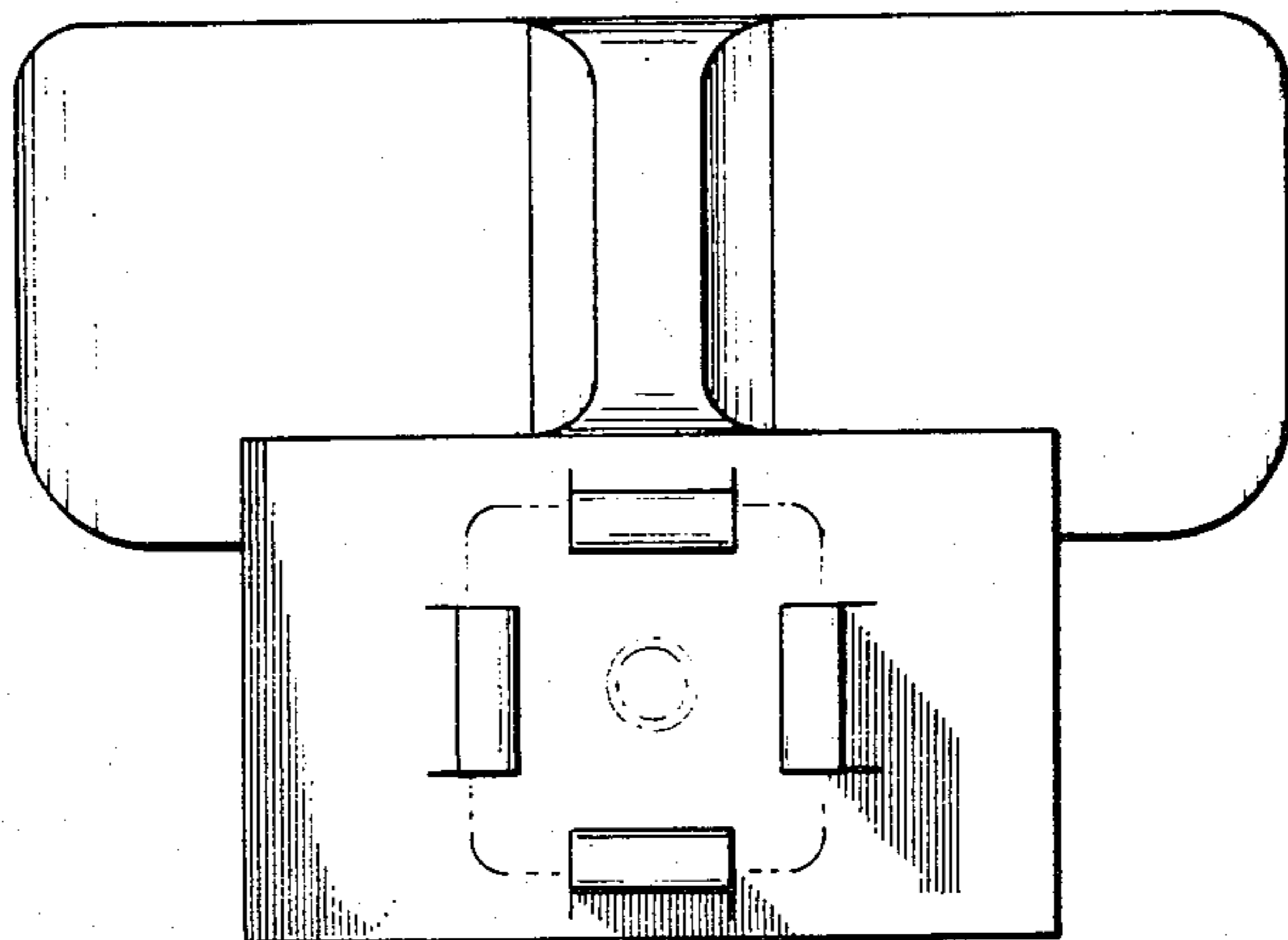

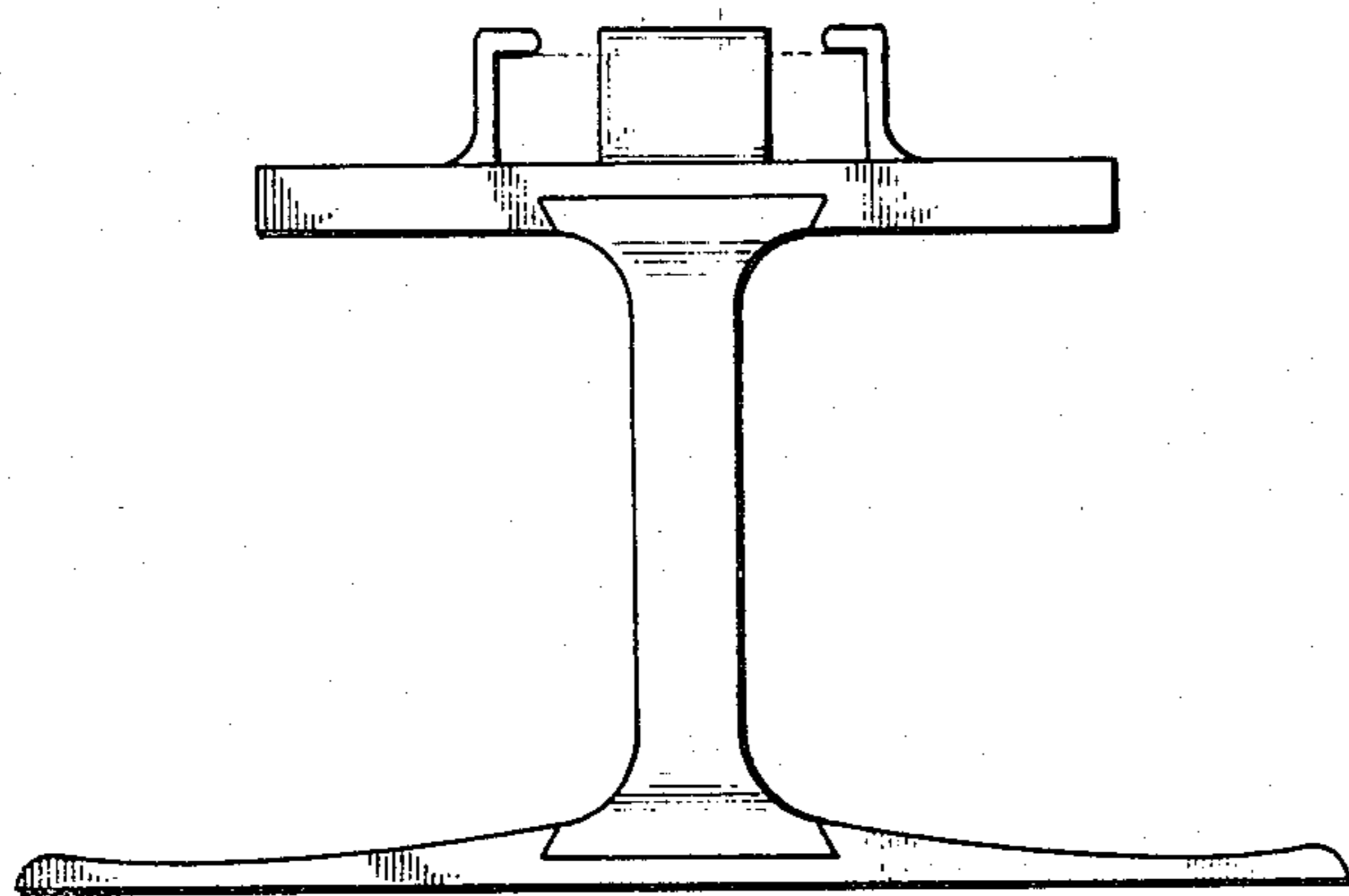

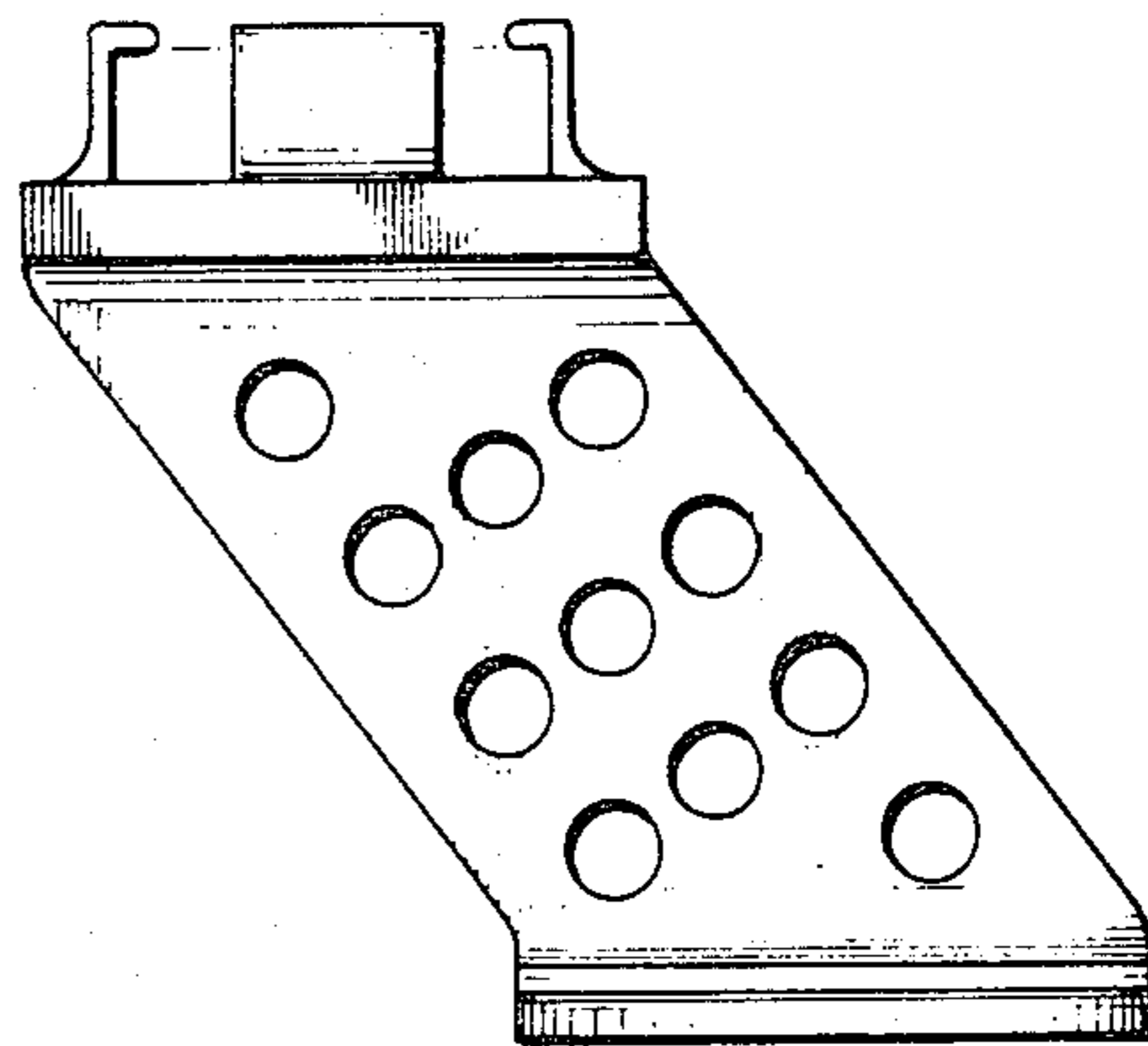

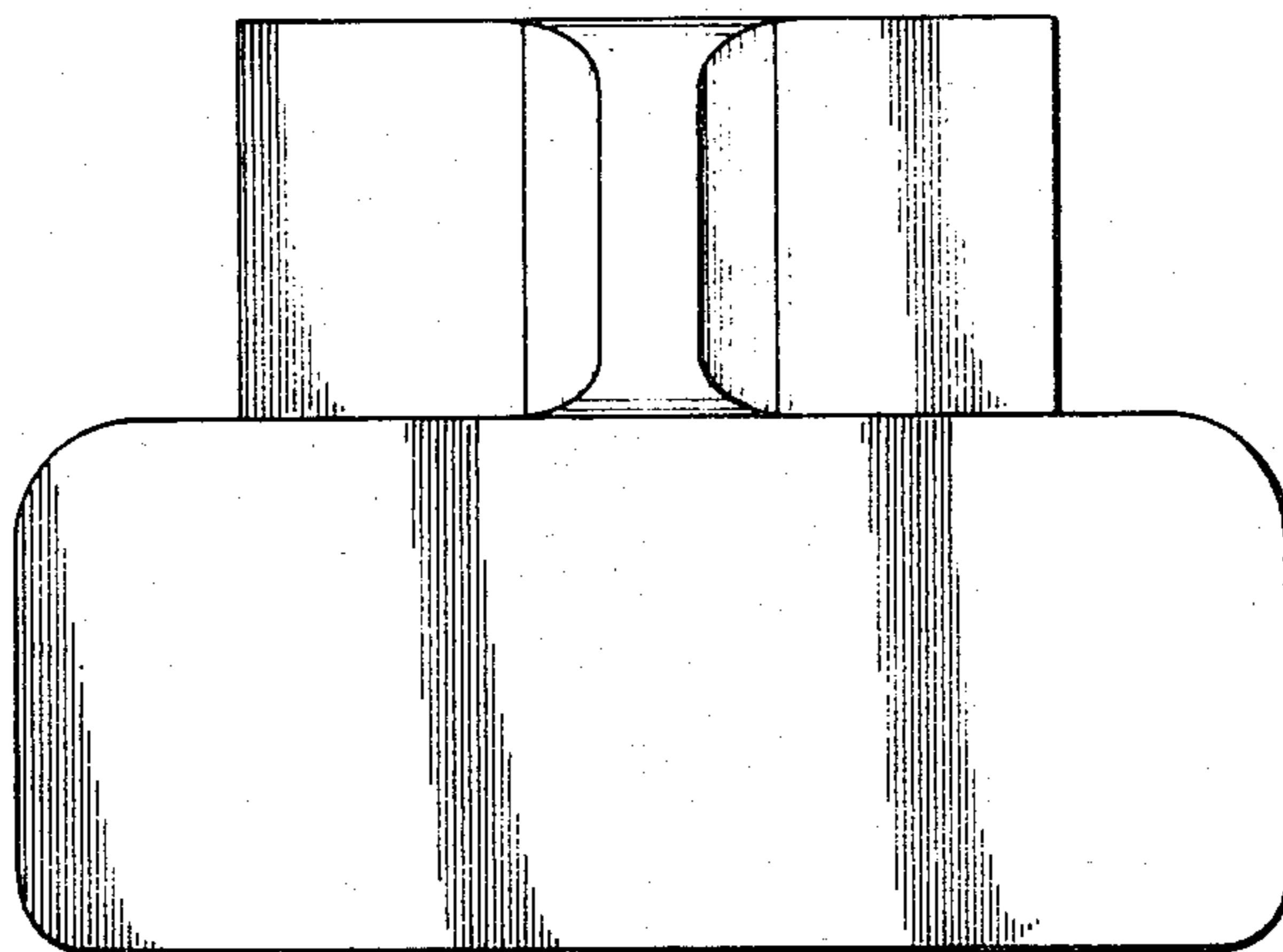
