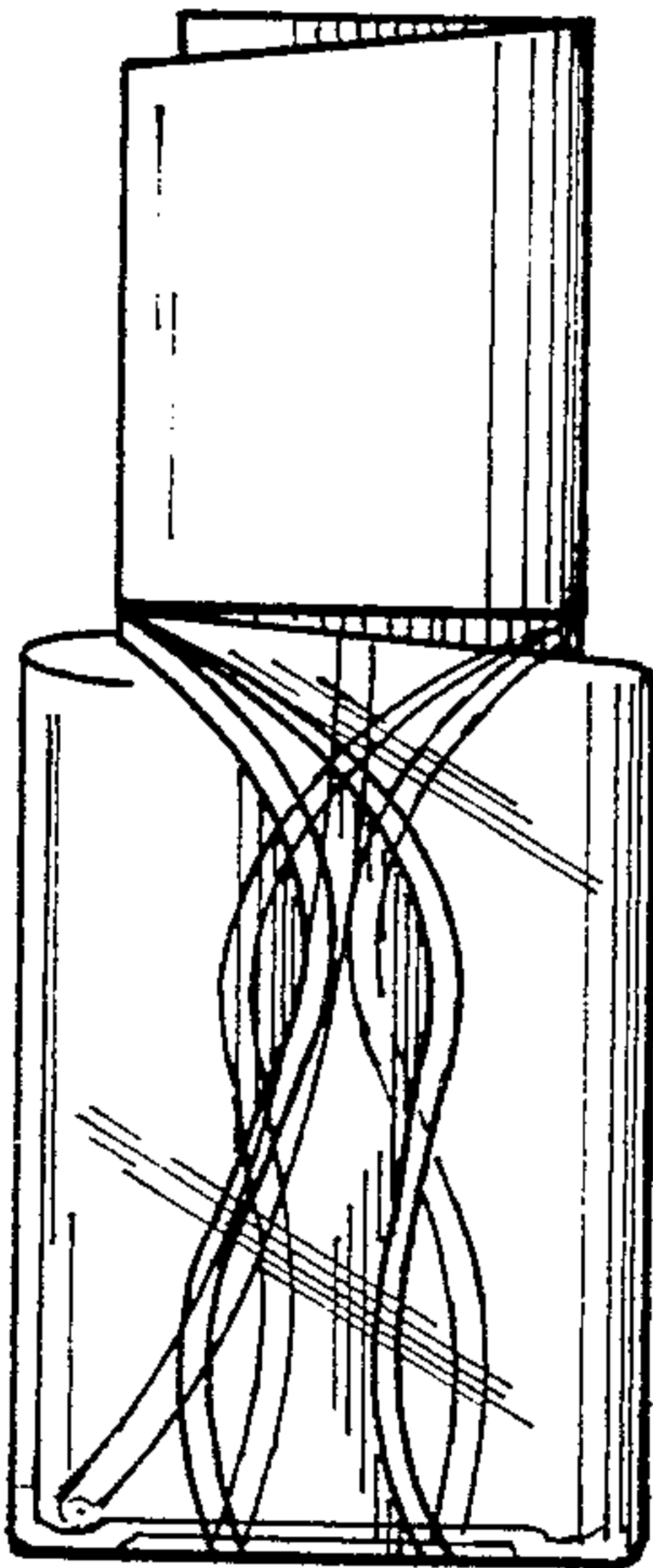

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined bottle and cap,
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded side elevational view of a com-
bined bottle and cap, looking from the left side, showing
my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the reverse
side being the obverse of the front side;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, looking from
the right side;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



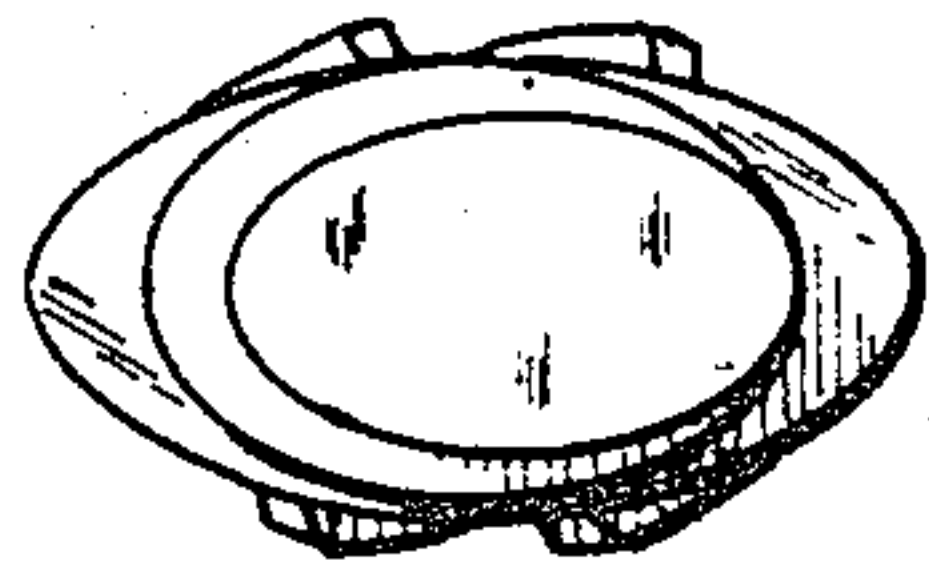

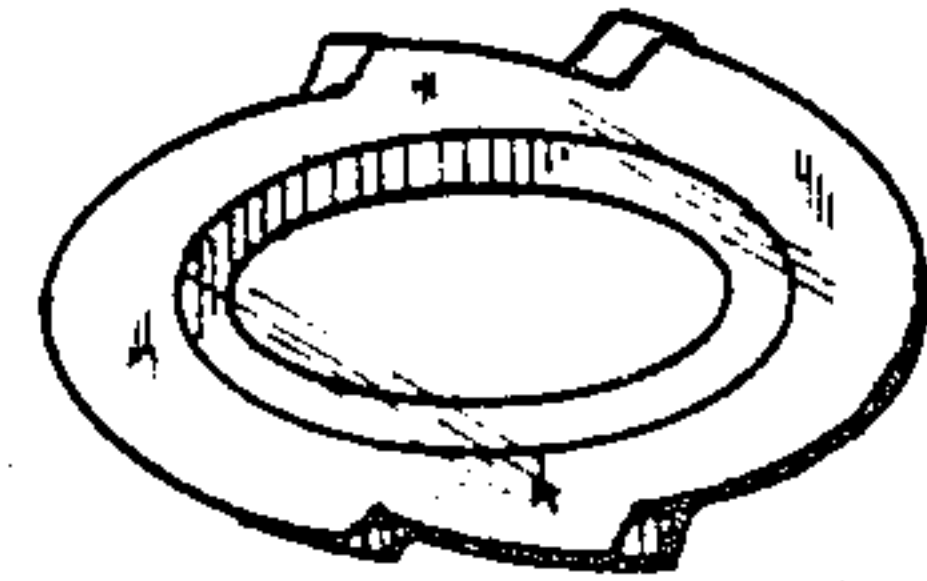

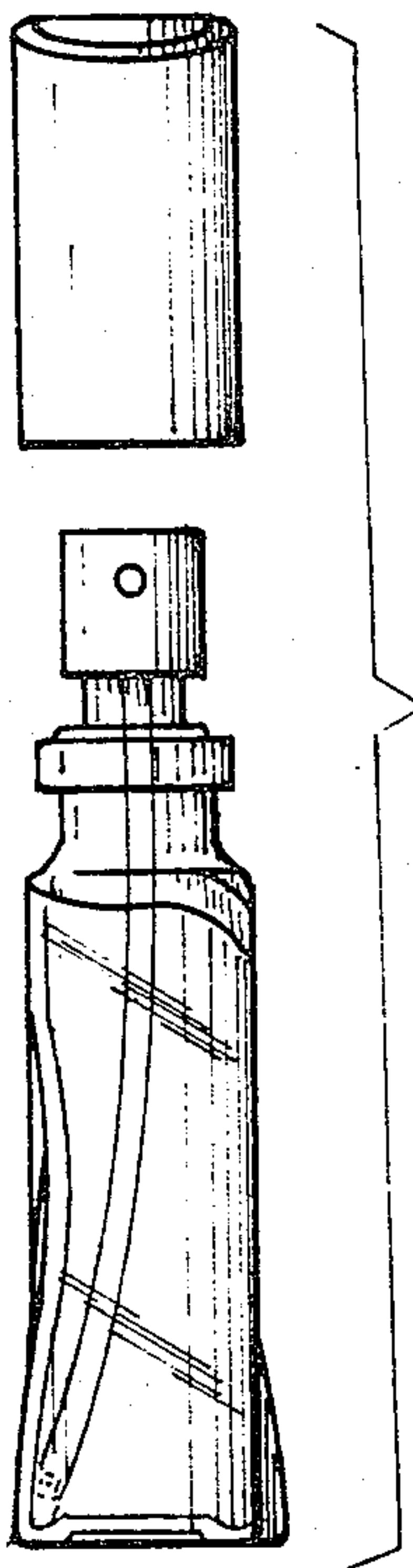

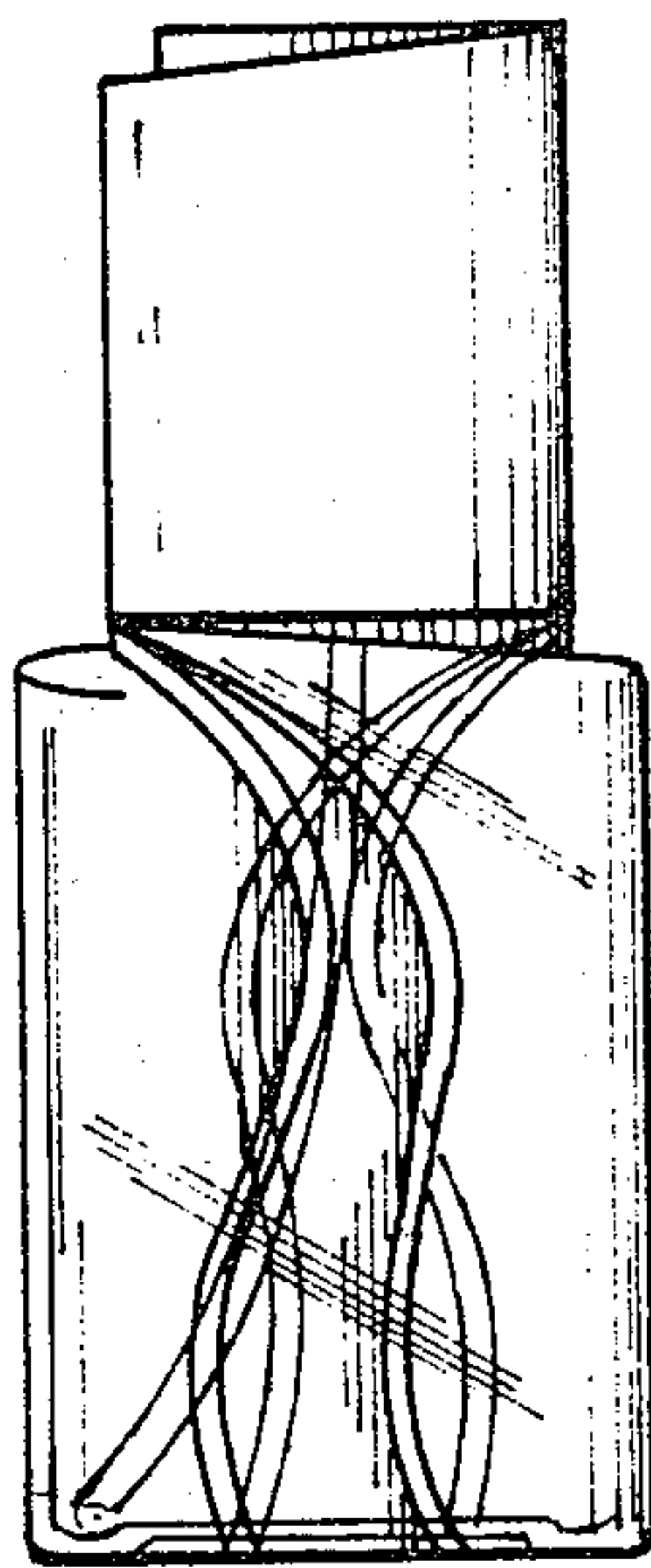

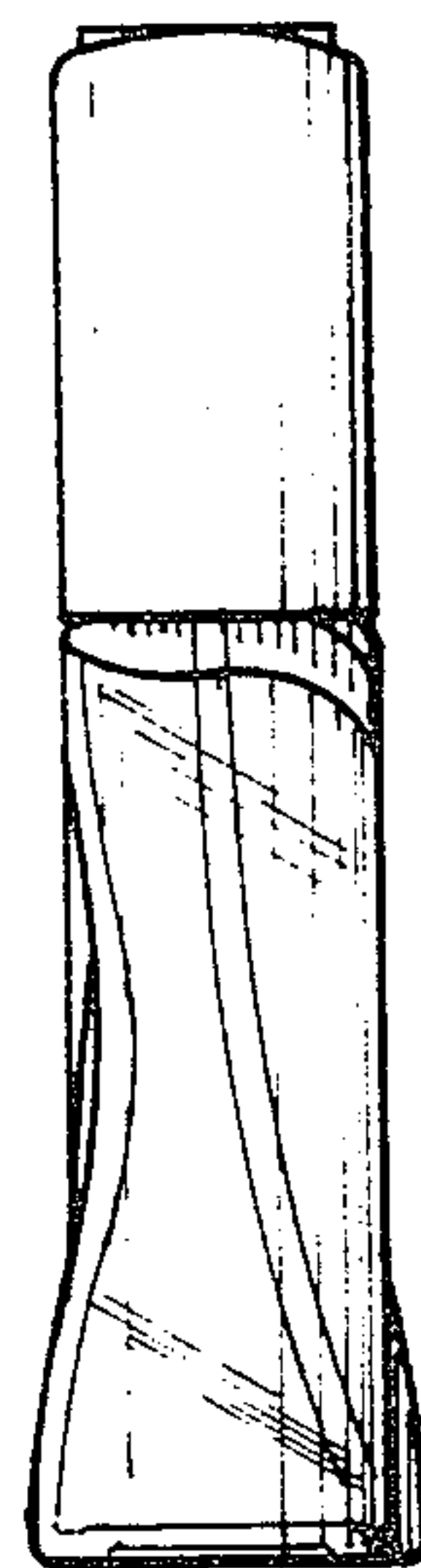
