DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a road wheel tire show-
ing my new design it being understood that the tread
pattern is repeated uniformly throughout the circumfer-
ence of the tire and the opposite side is the same as that
shown;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a longitudinal sectional view thereof taken
along line 4—4 in FIG. 3.

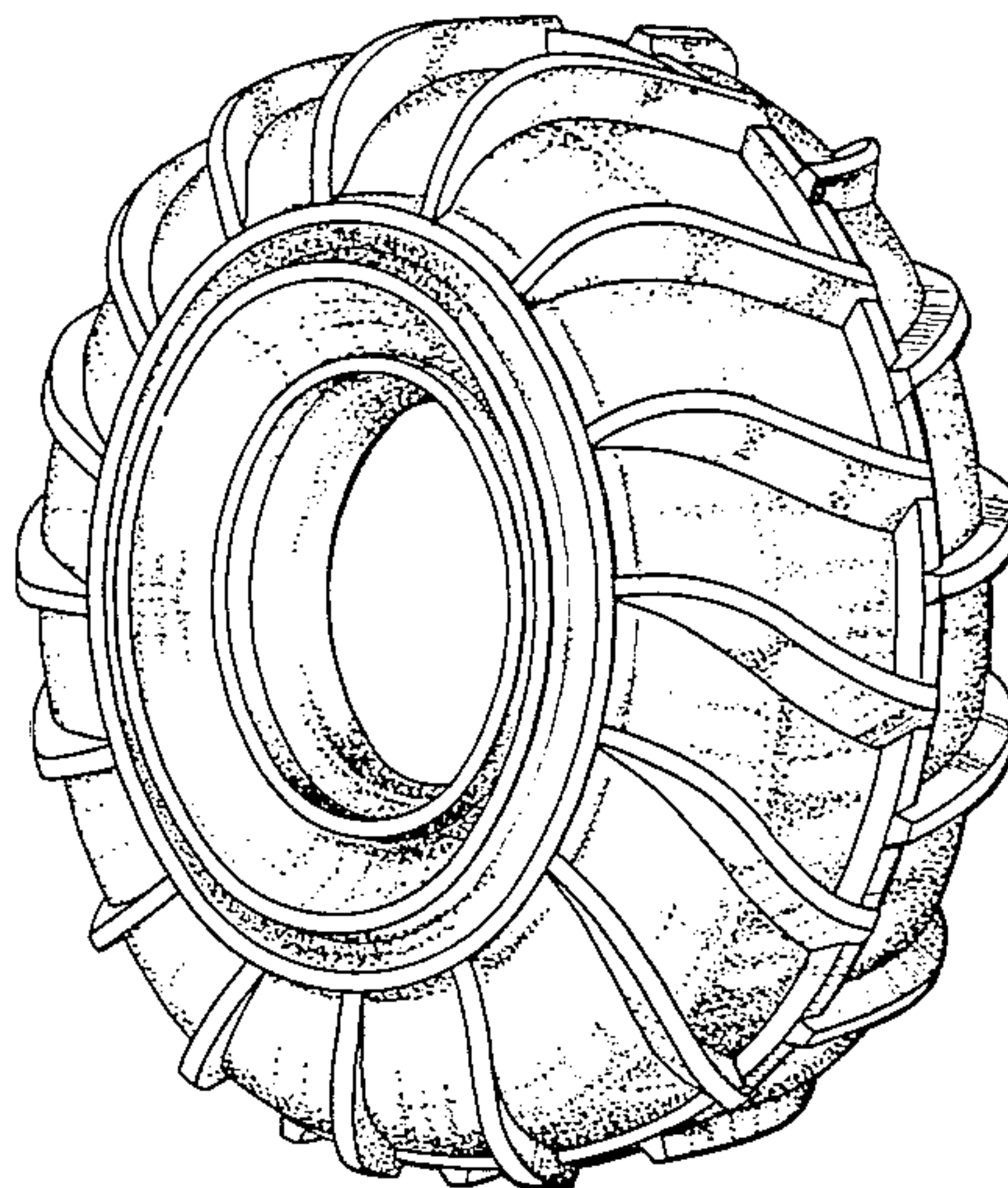

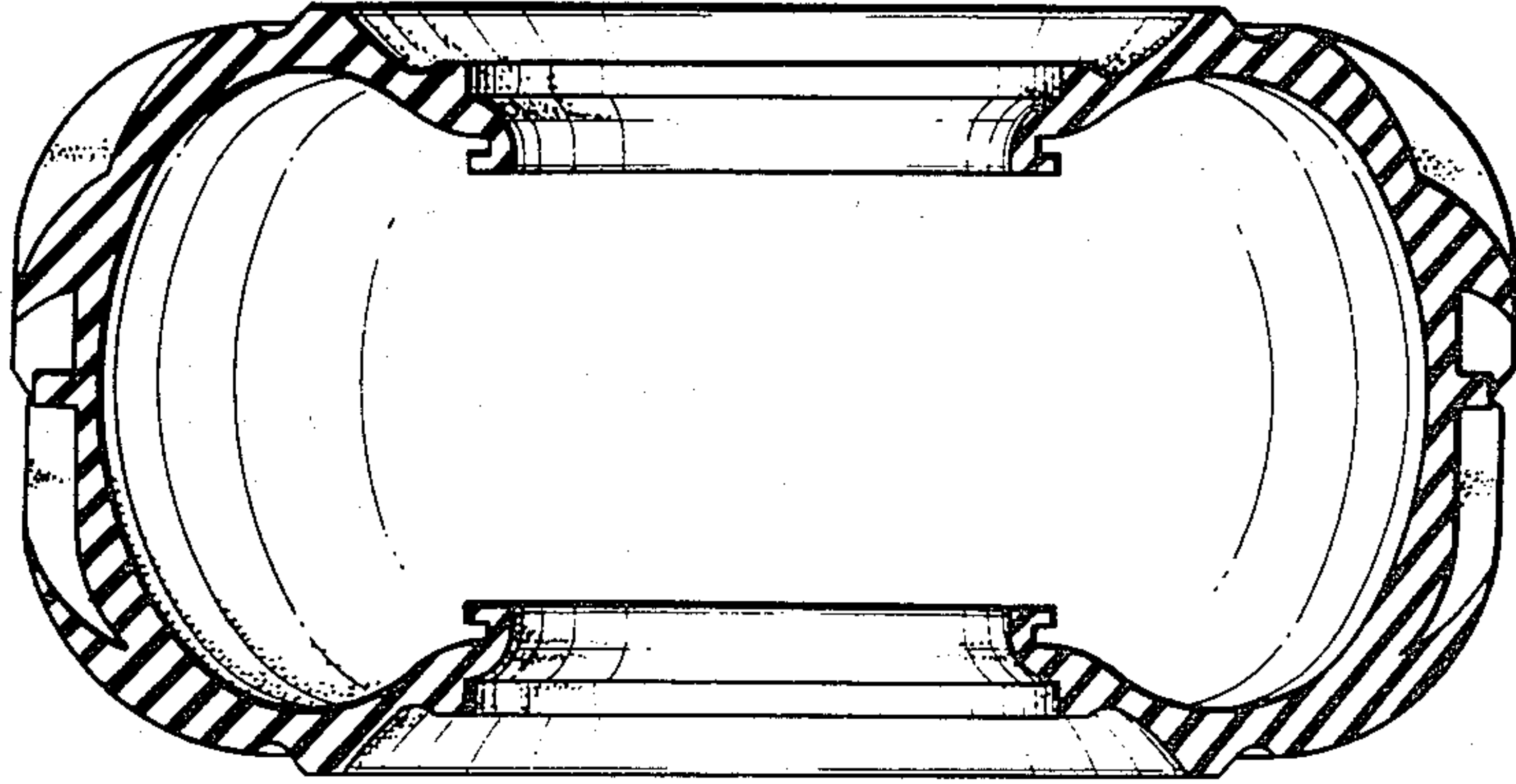

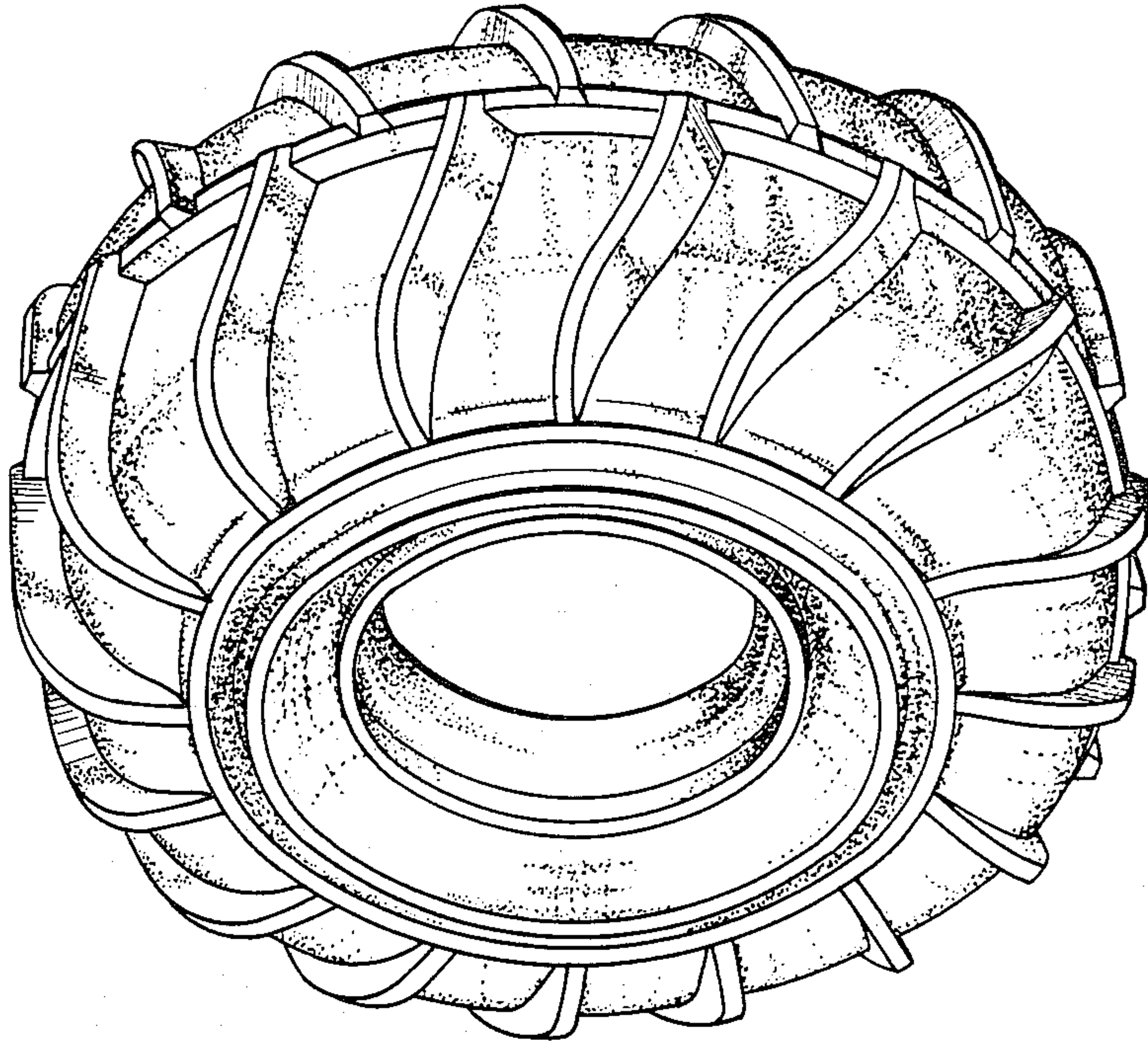

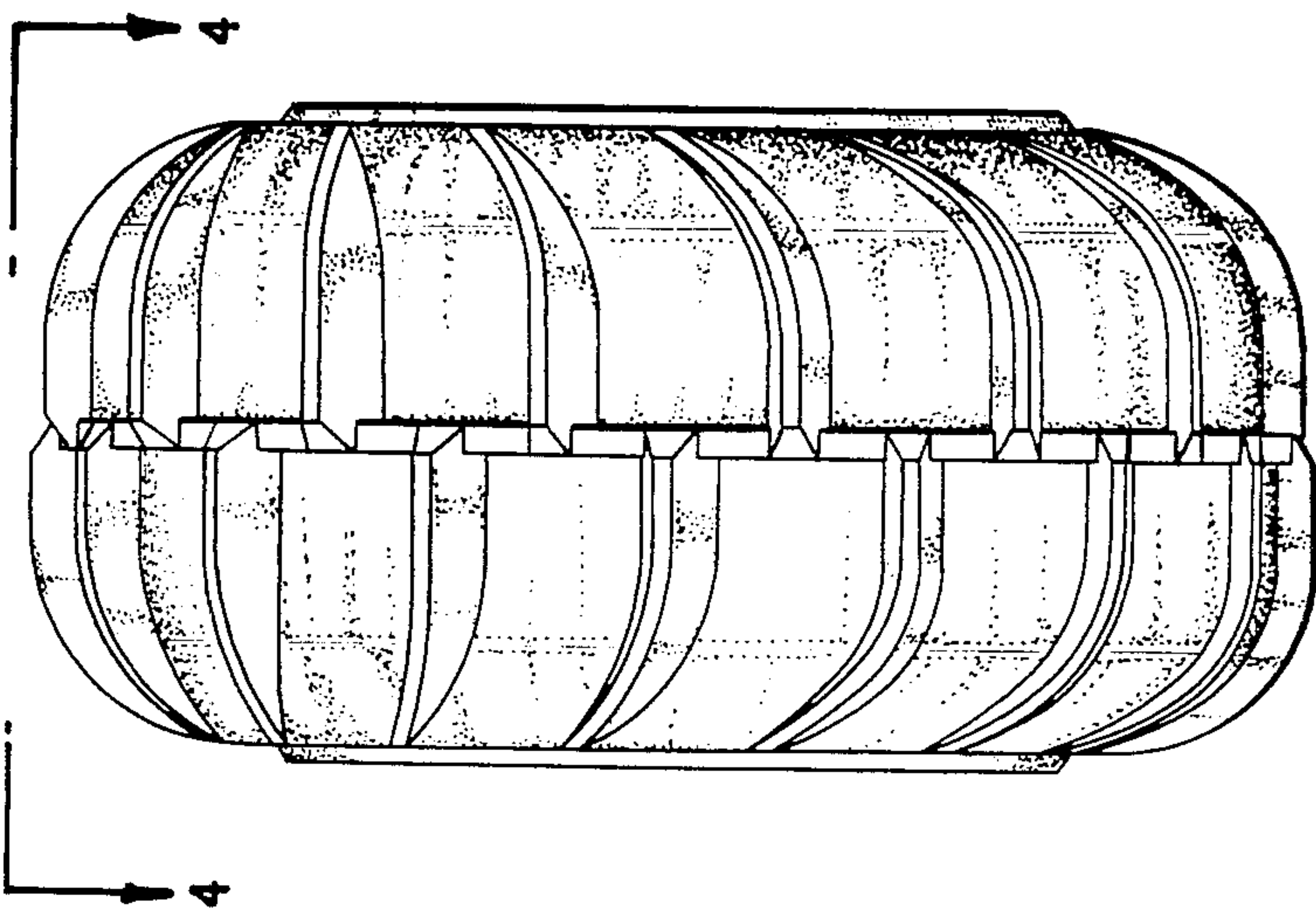
