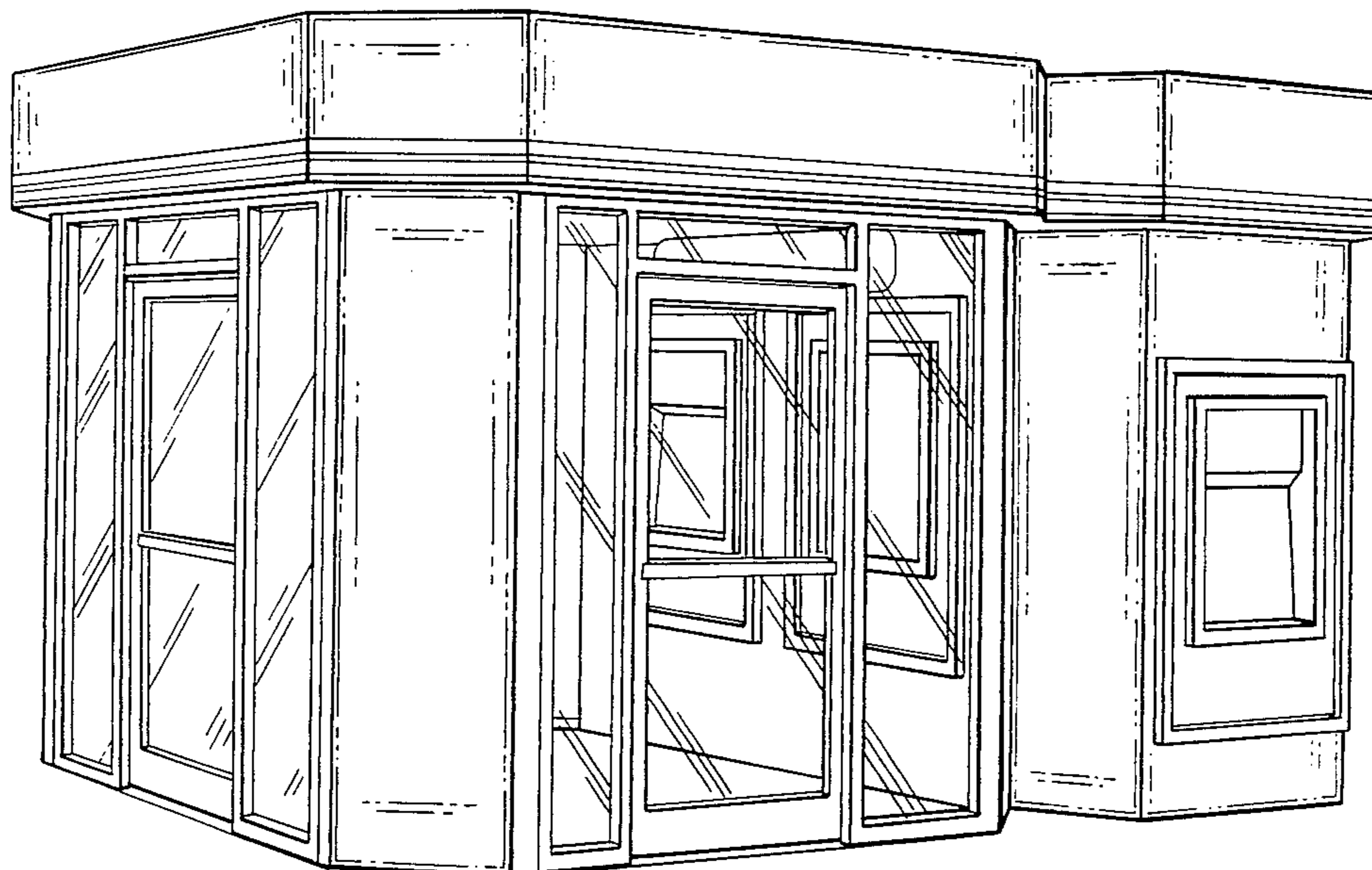

The ornamental design for an automatic teller machine island enclosure, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an automatic teller machine island enclosure showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



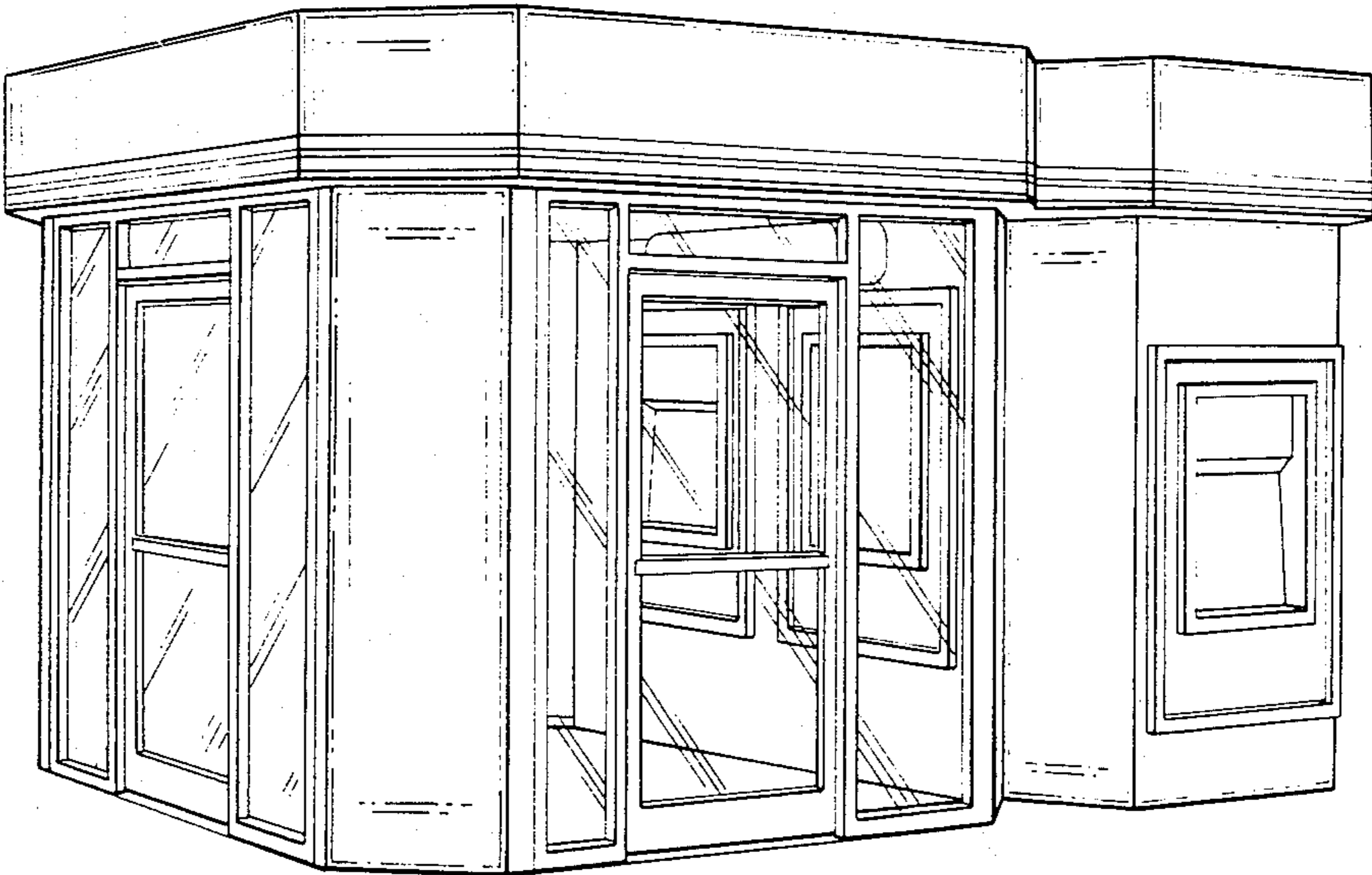

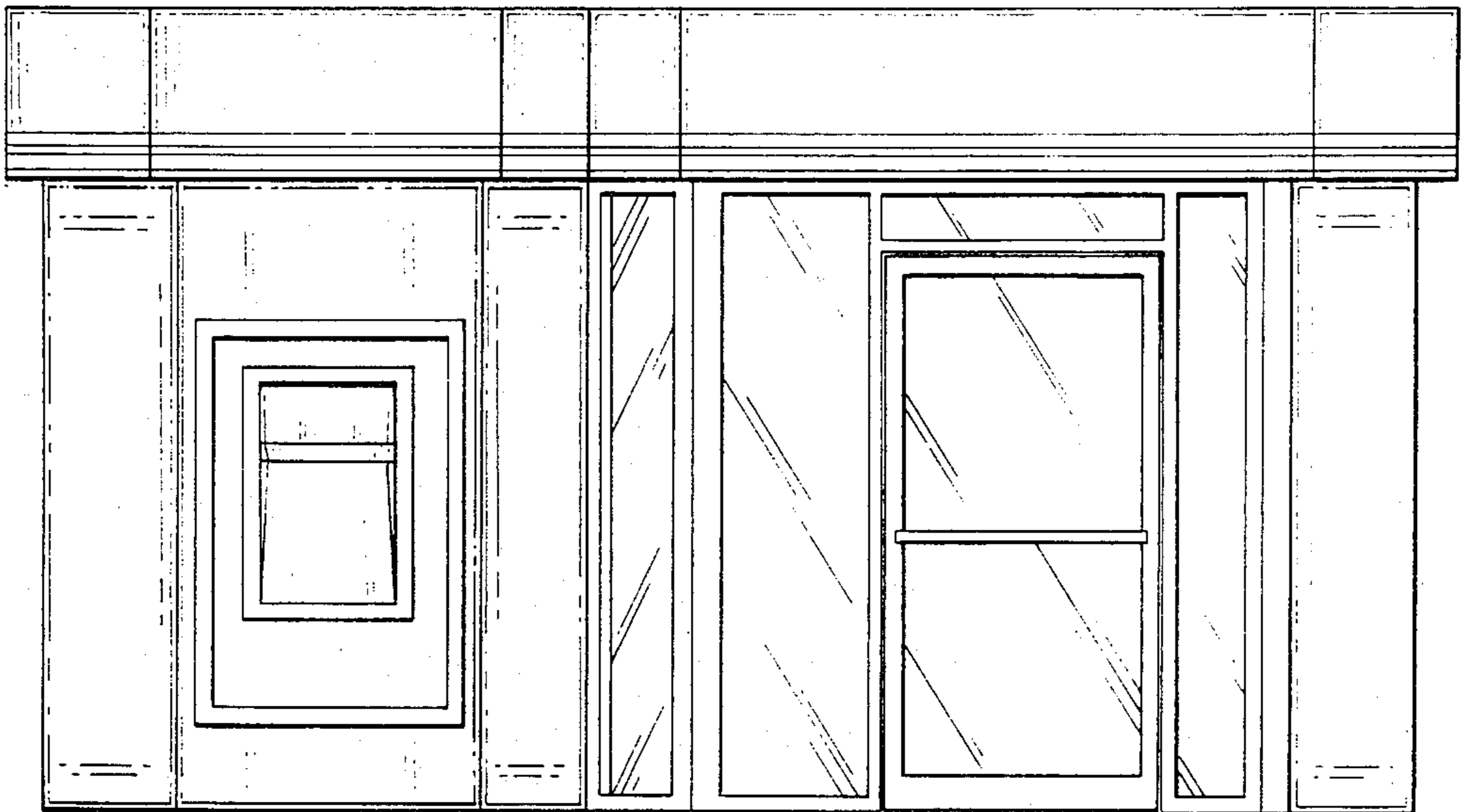

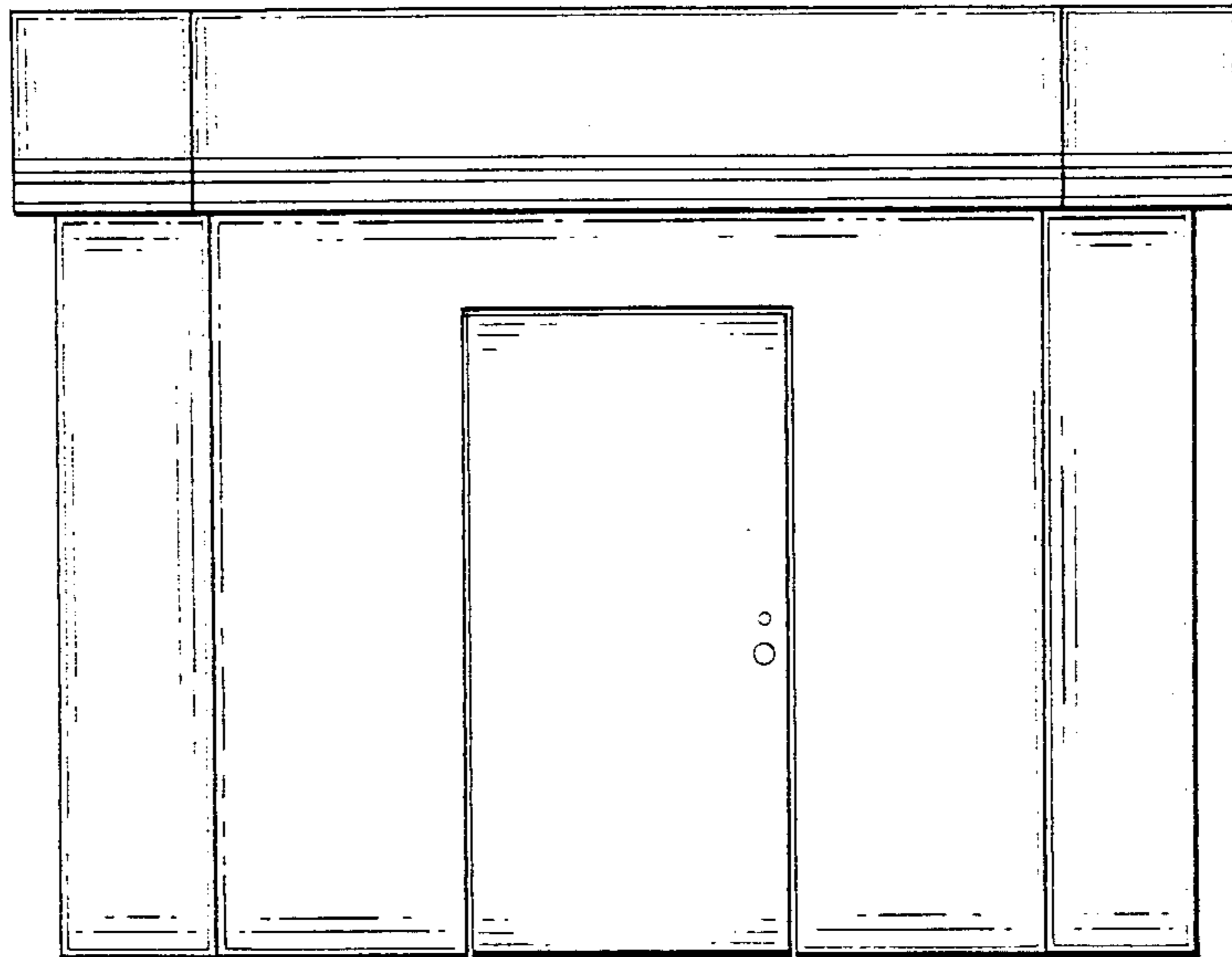

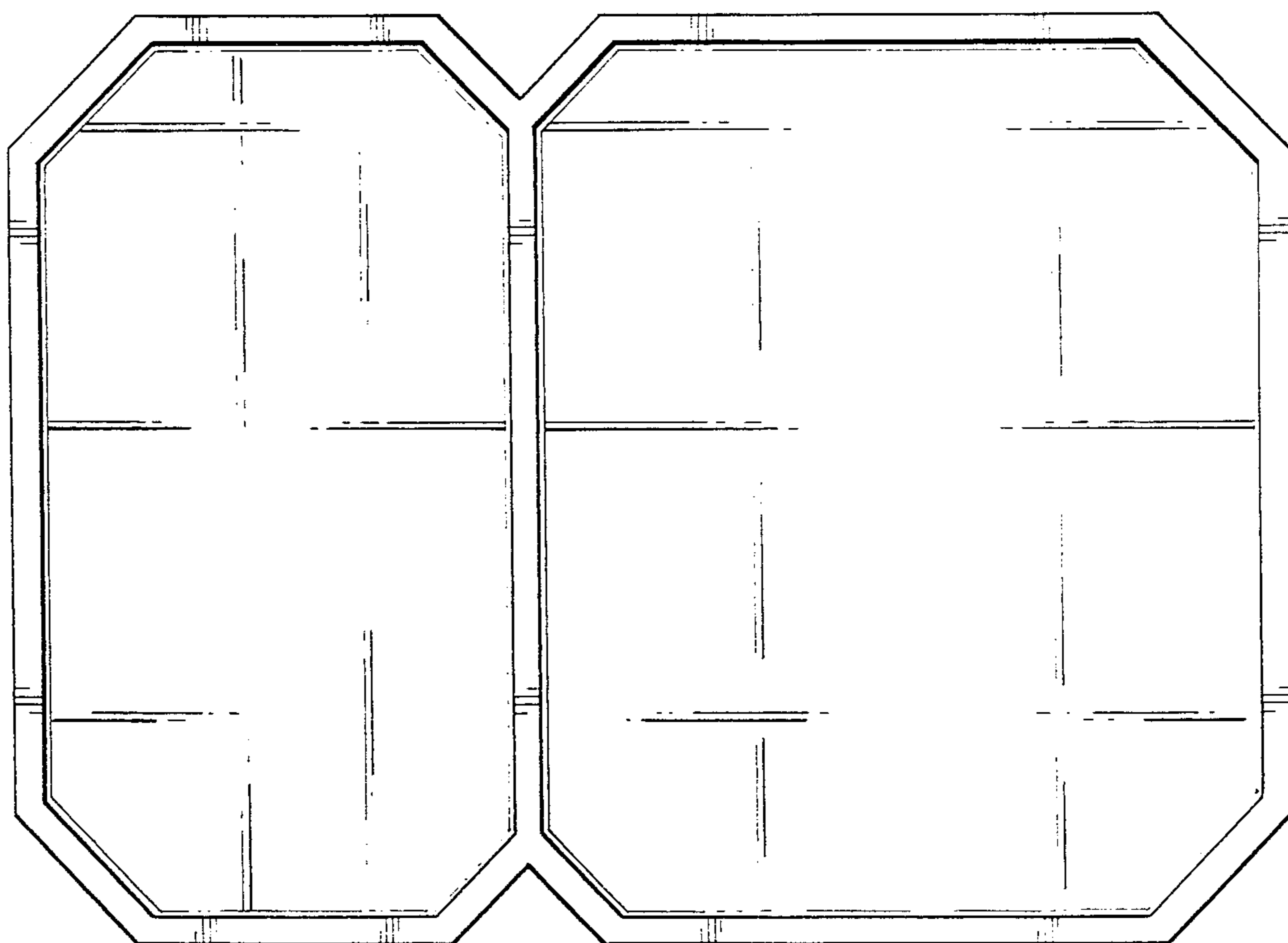
