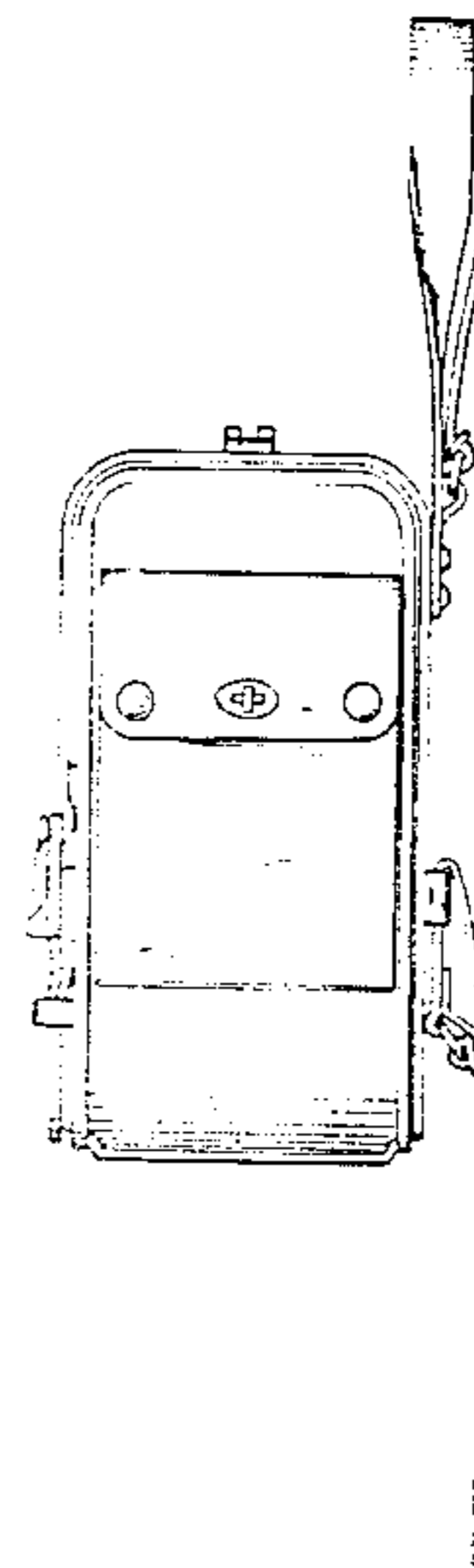
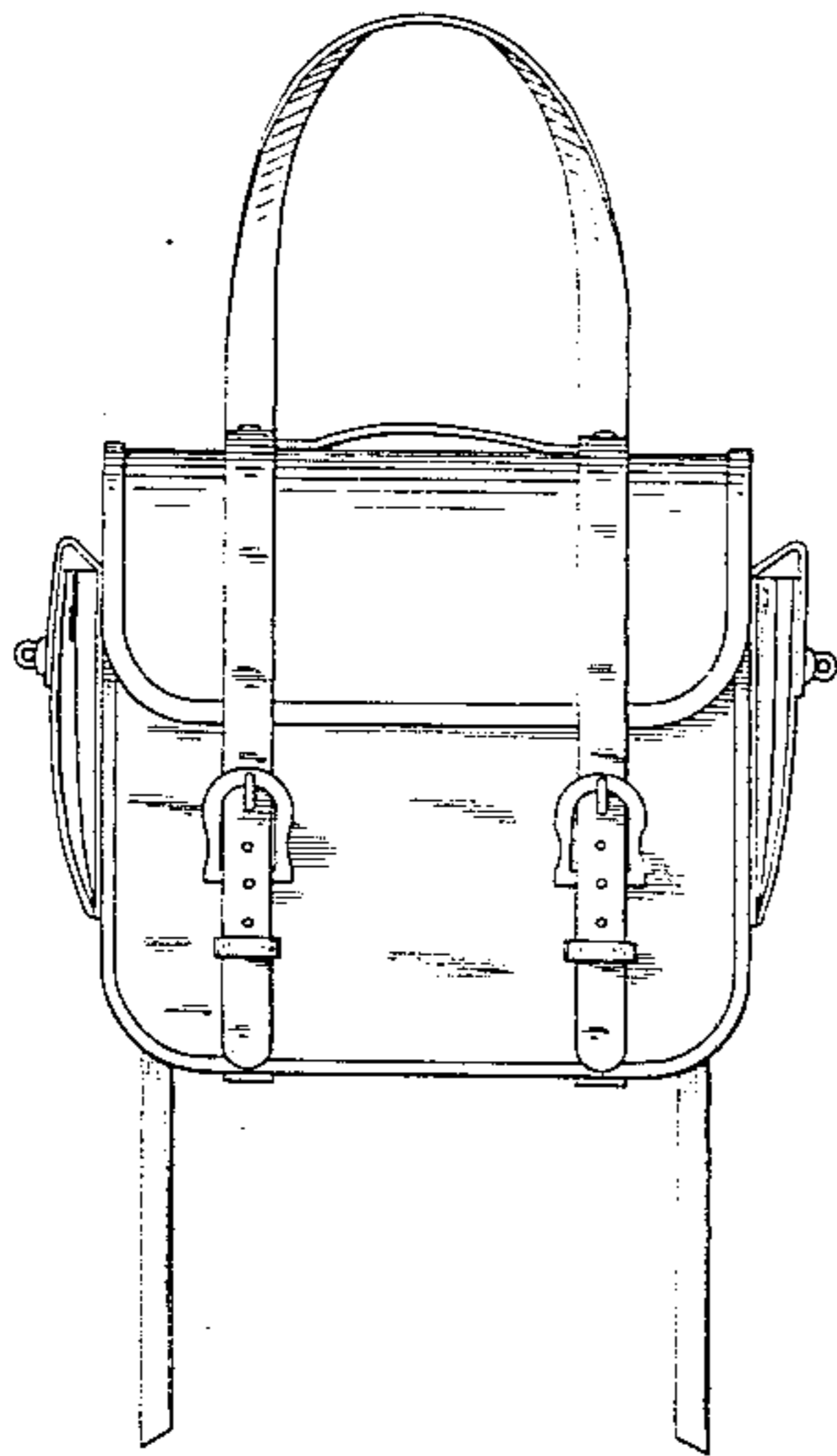

The ornamental design for a motorcycle saddlebag, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a motorcycle saddlebag, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof taken from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevation view thereof taken from the left of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



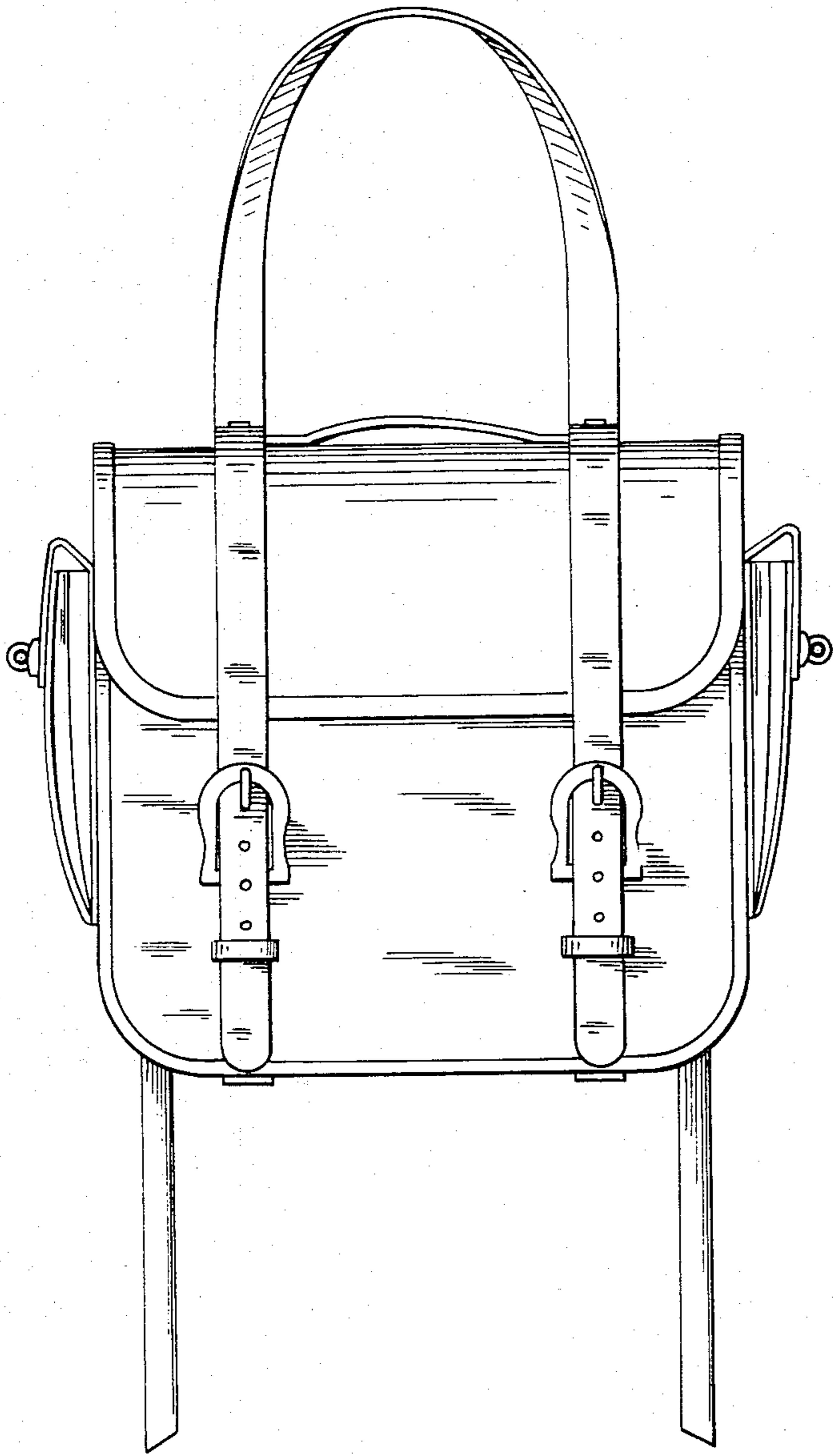

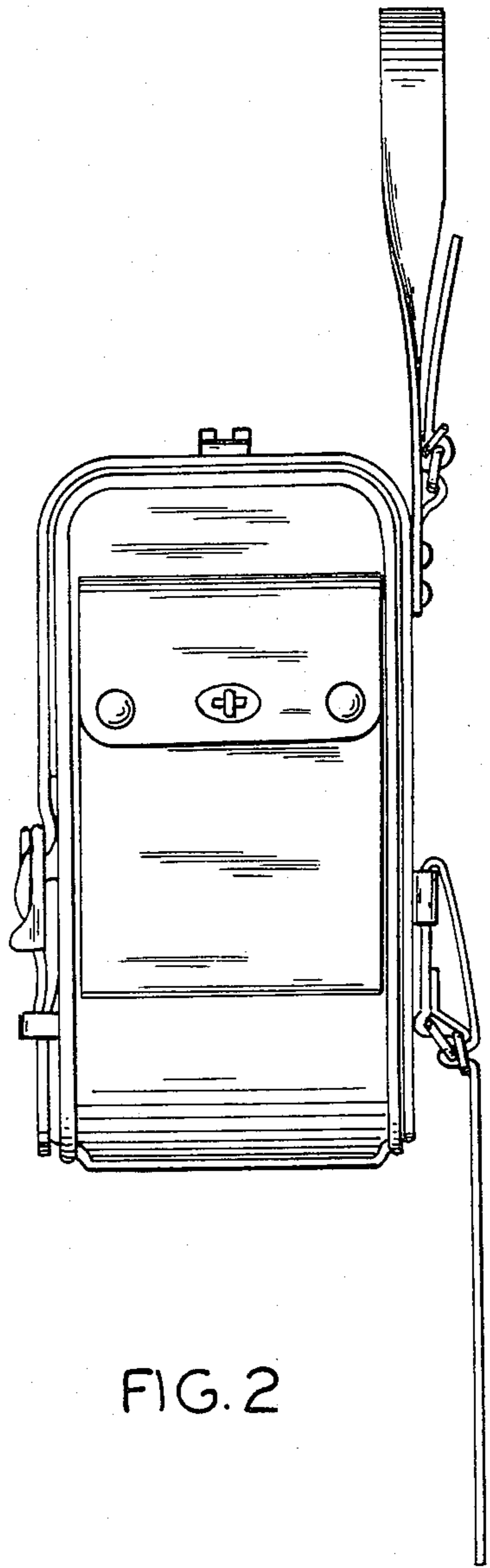

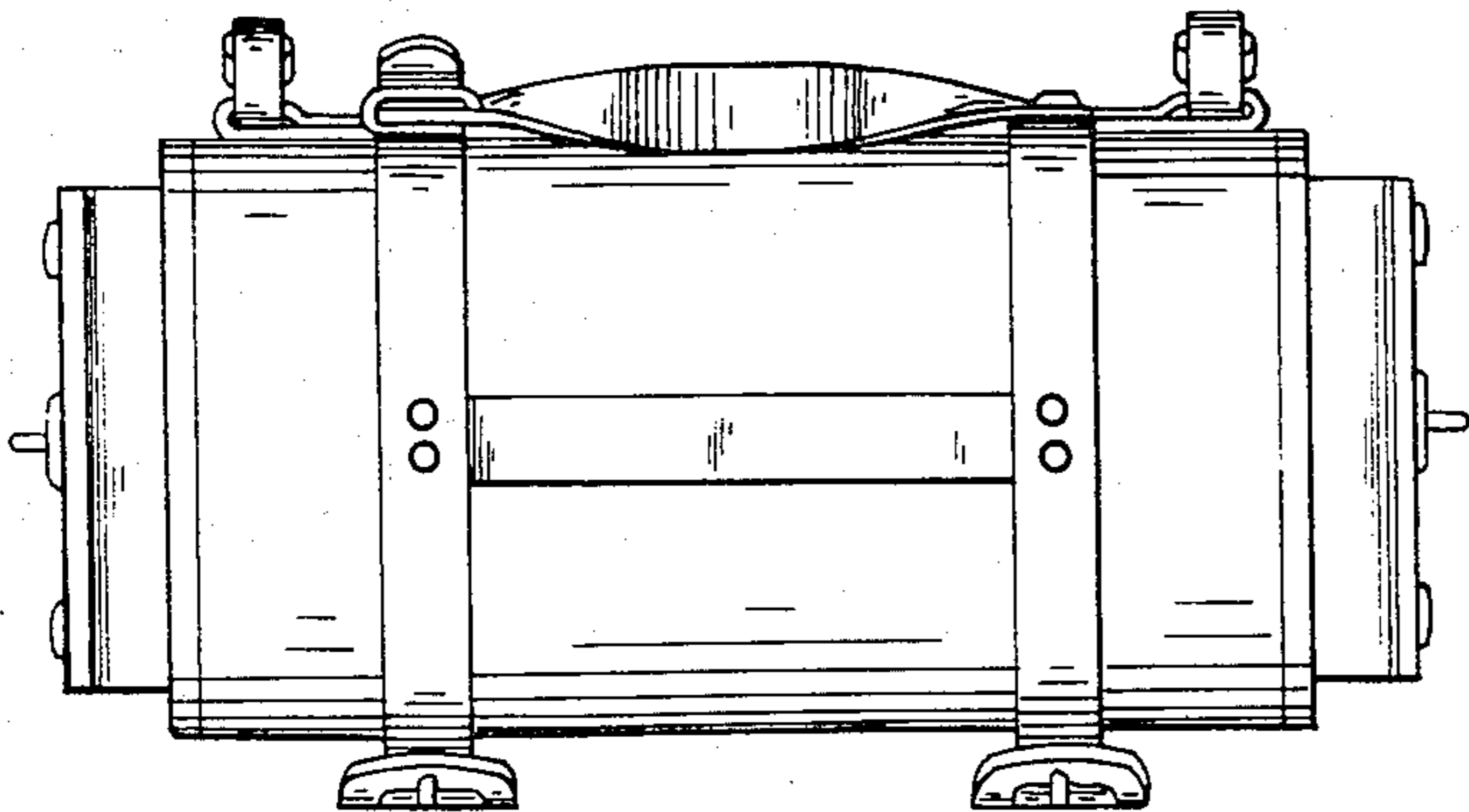

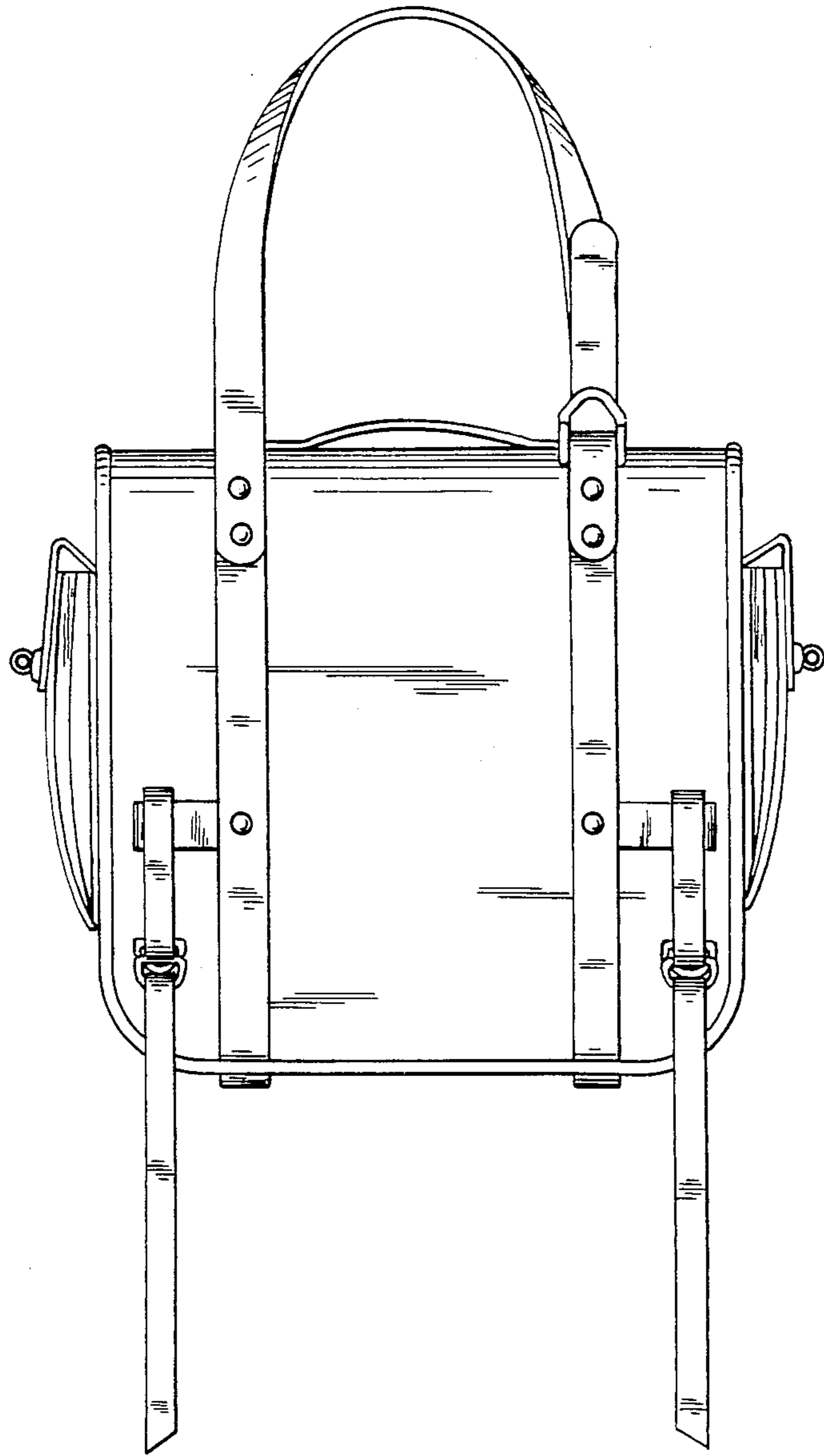

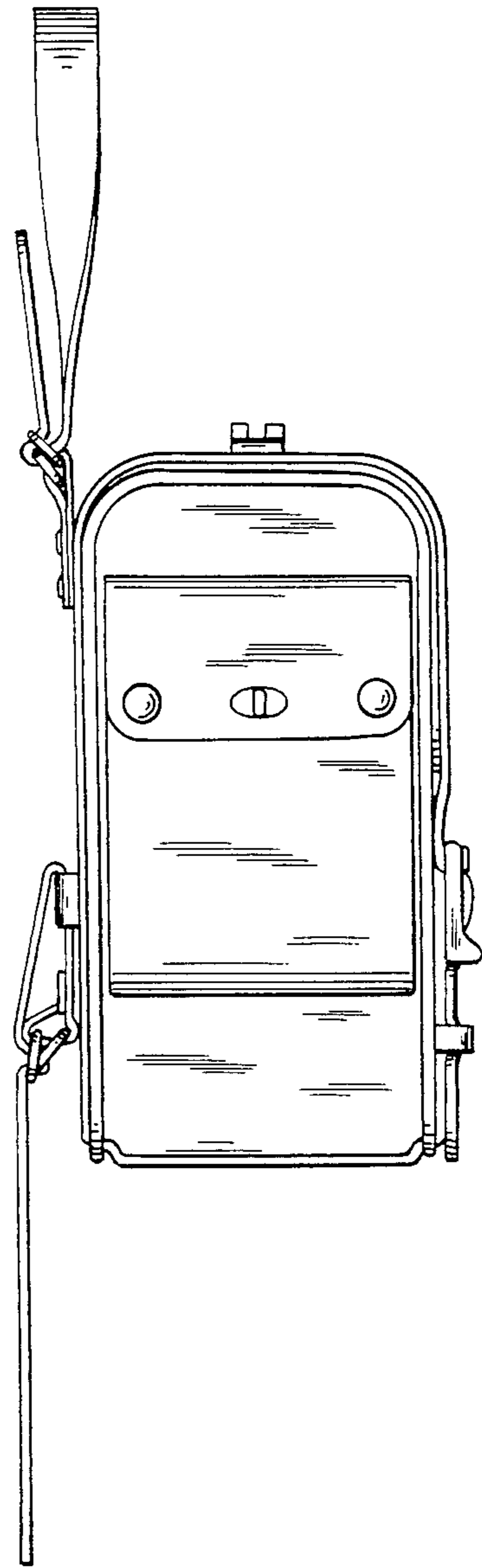

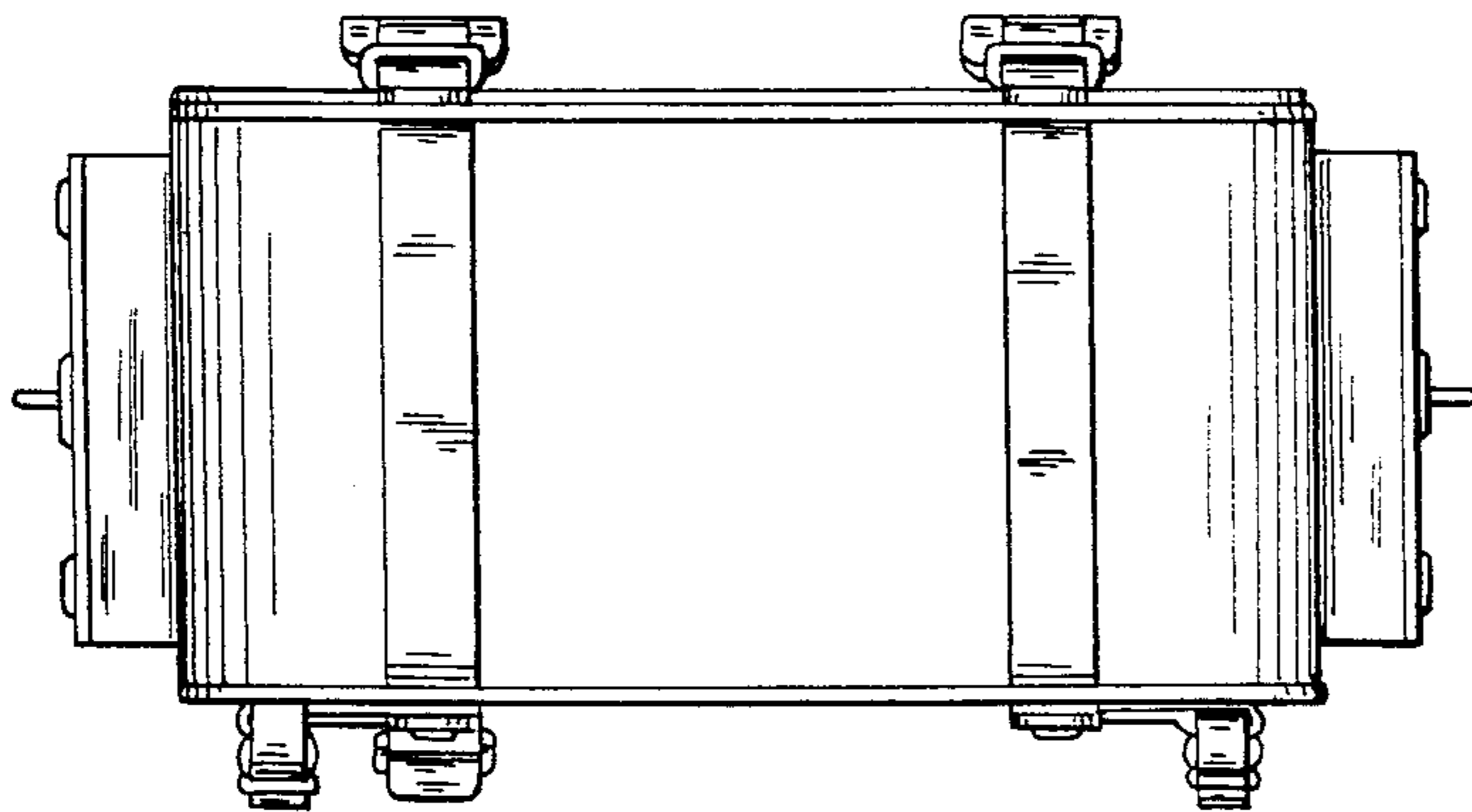
