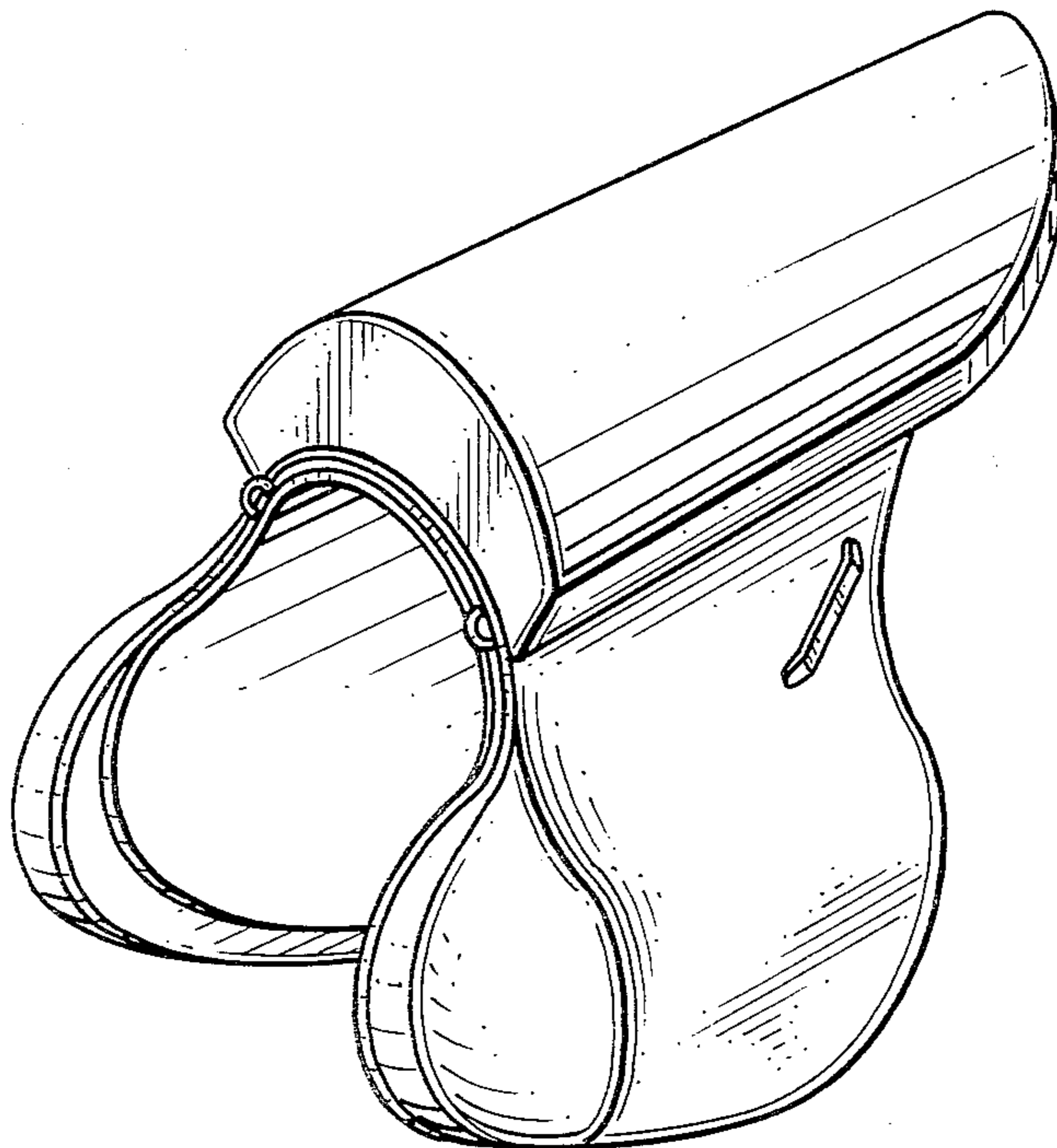

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a riding saddle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a riding saddle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 4; and
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a modified form of the riding saddle shown in FIG. 1.



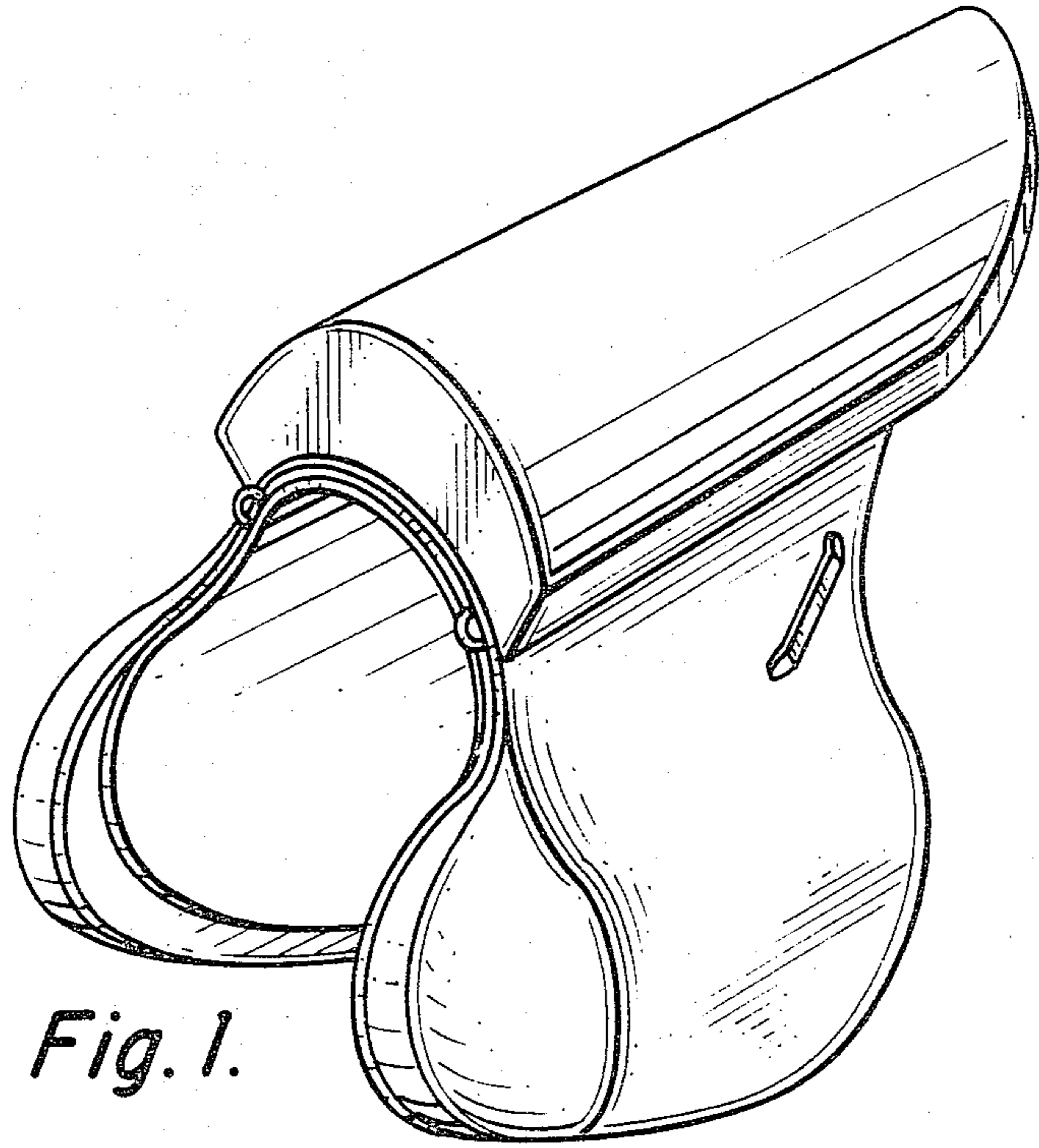

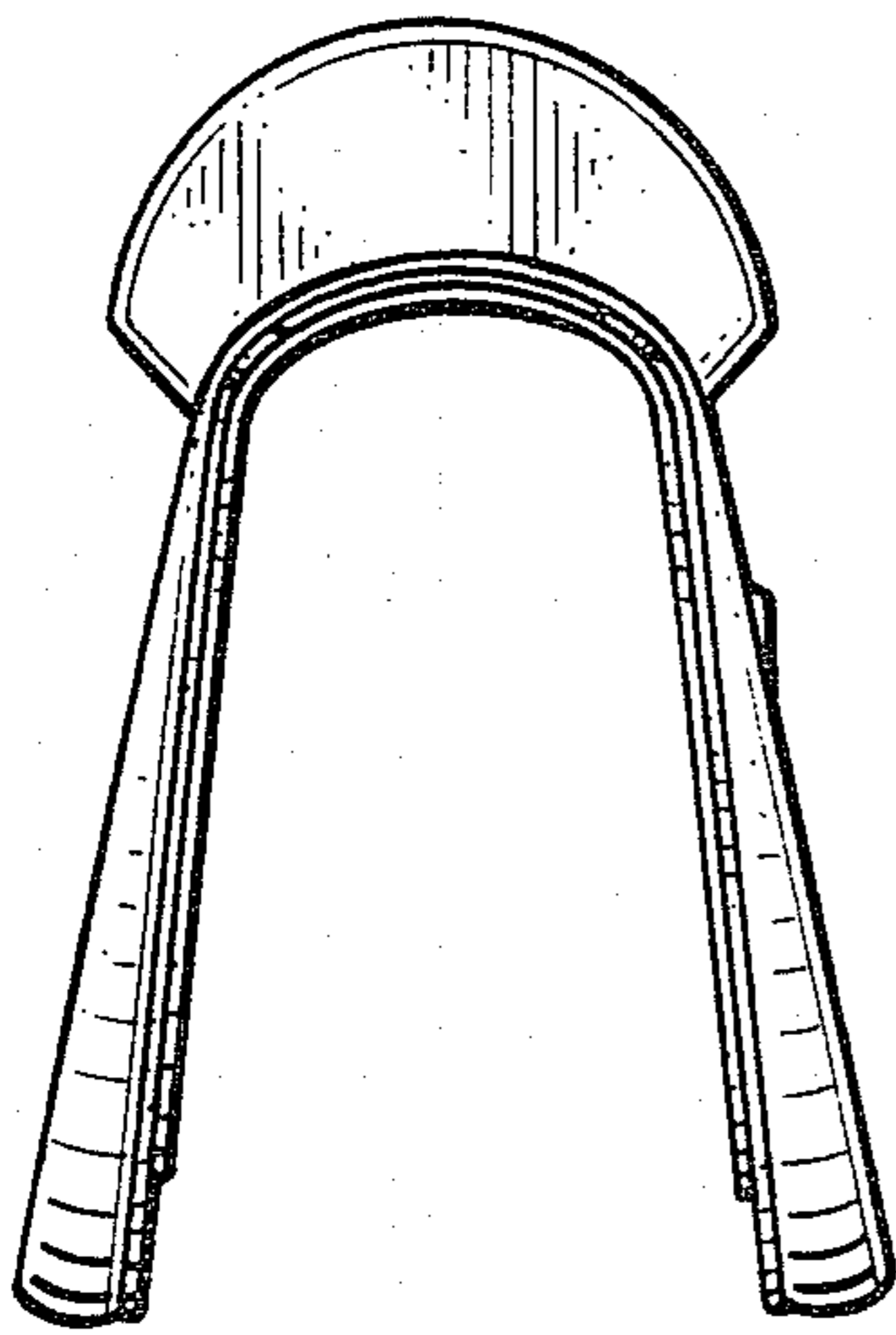

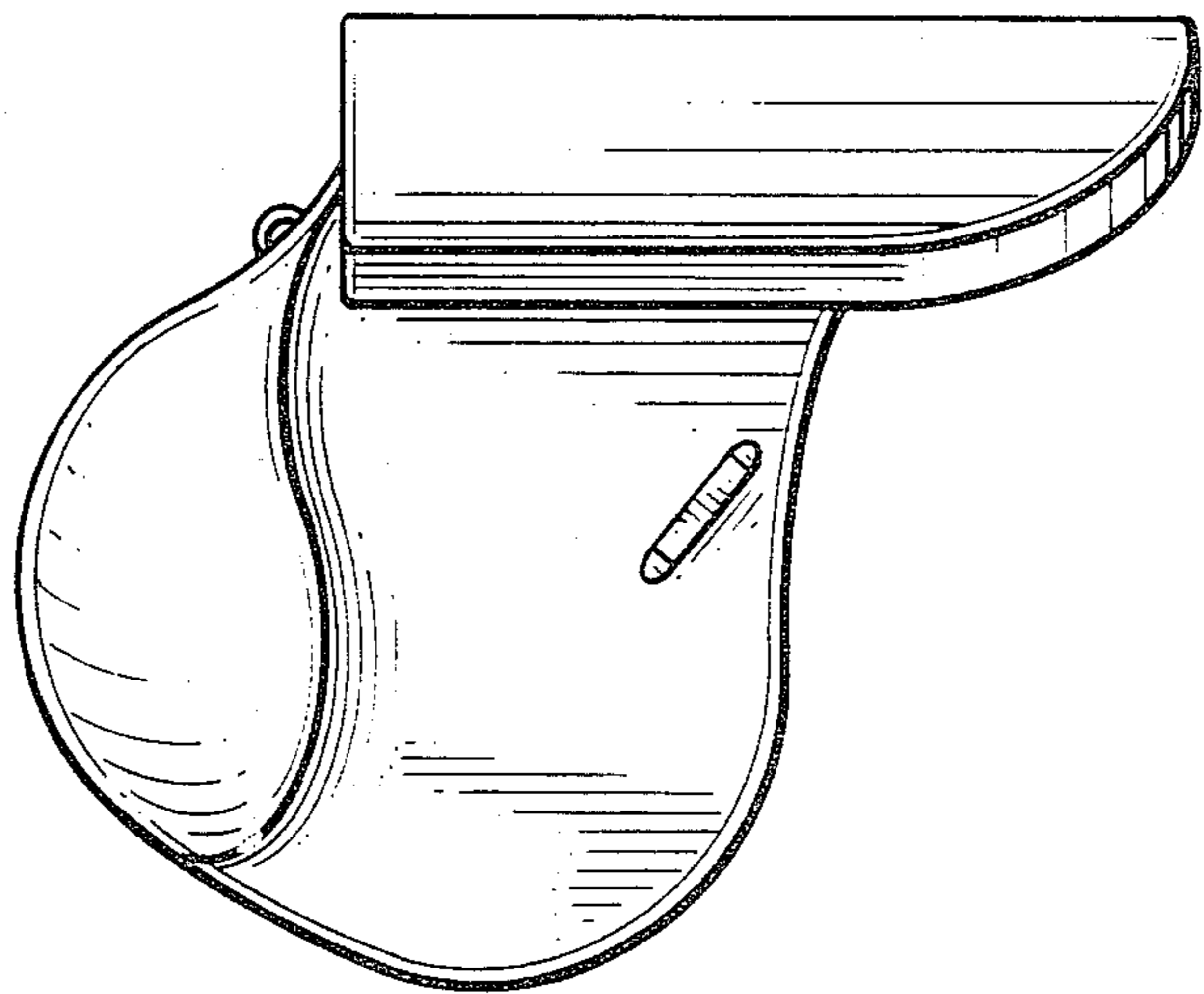

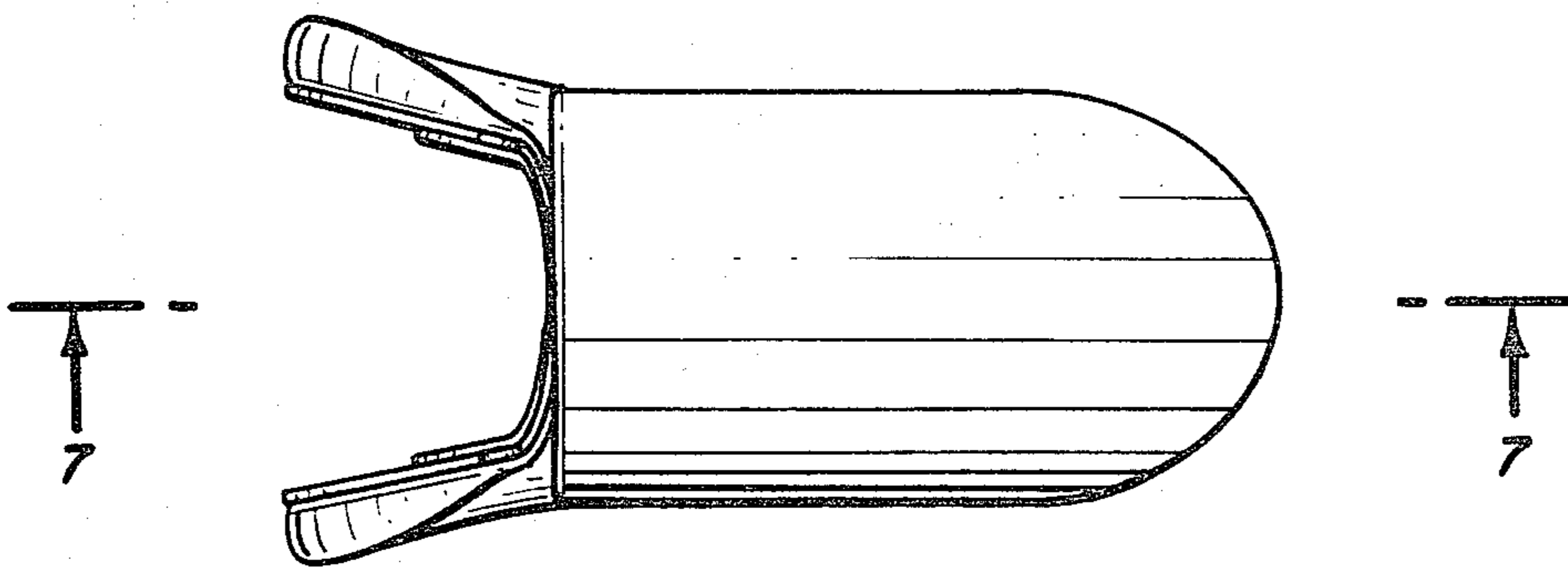

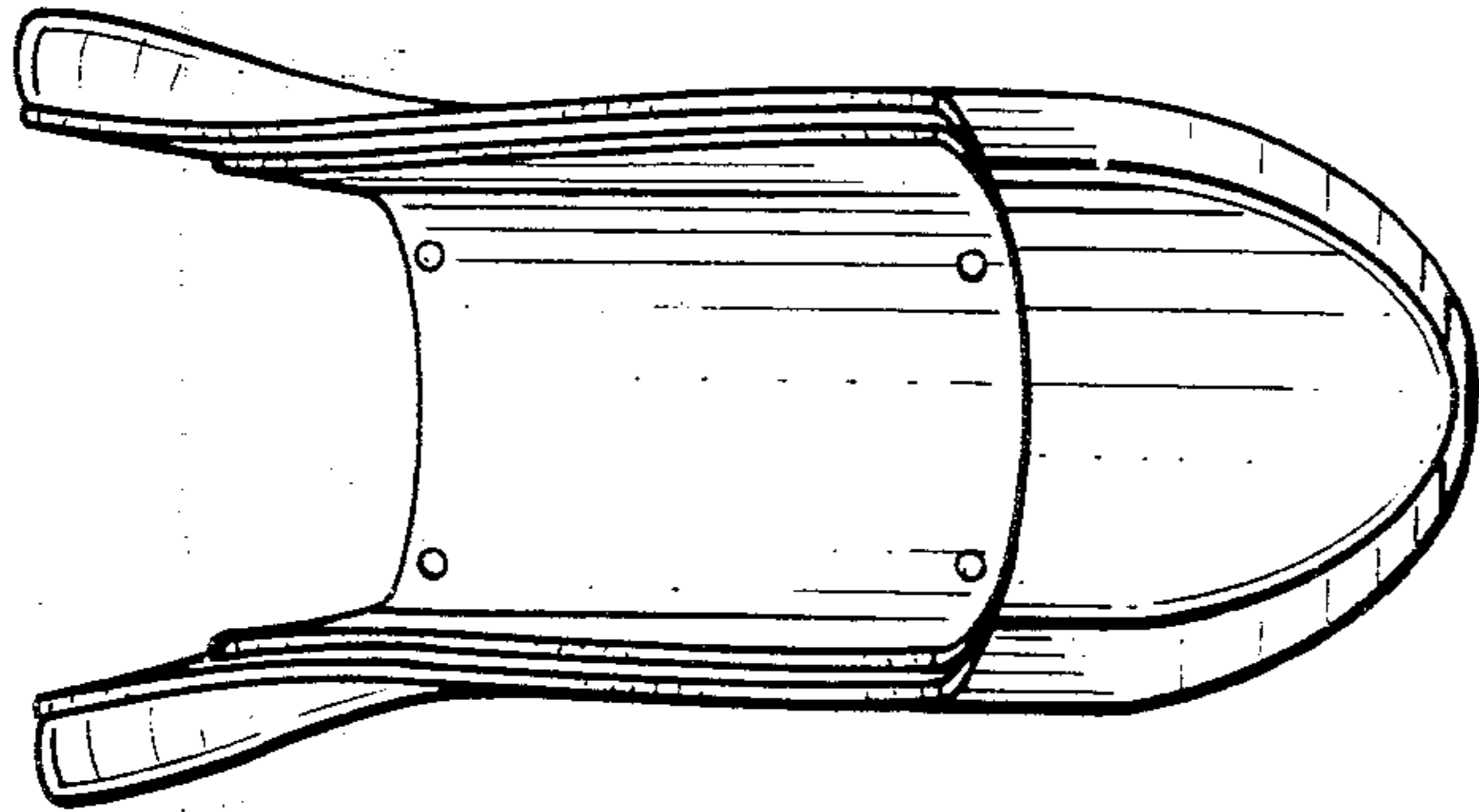

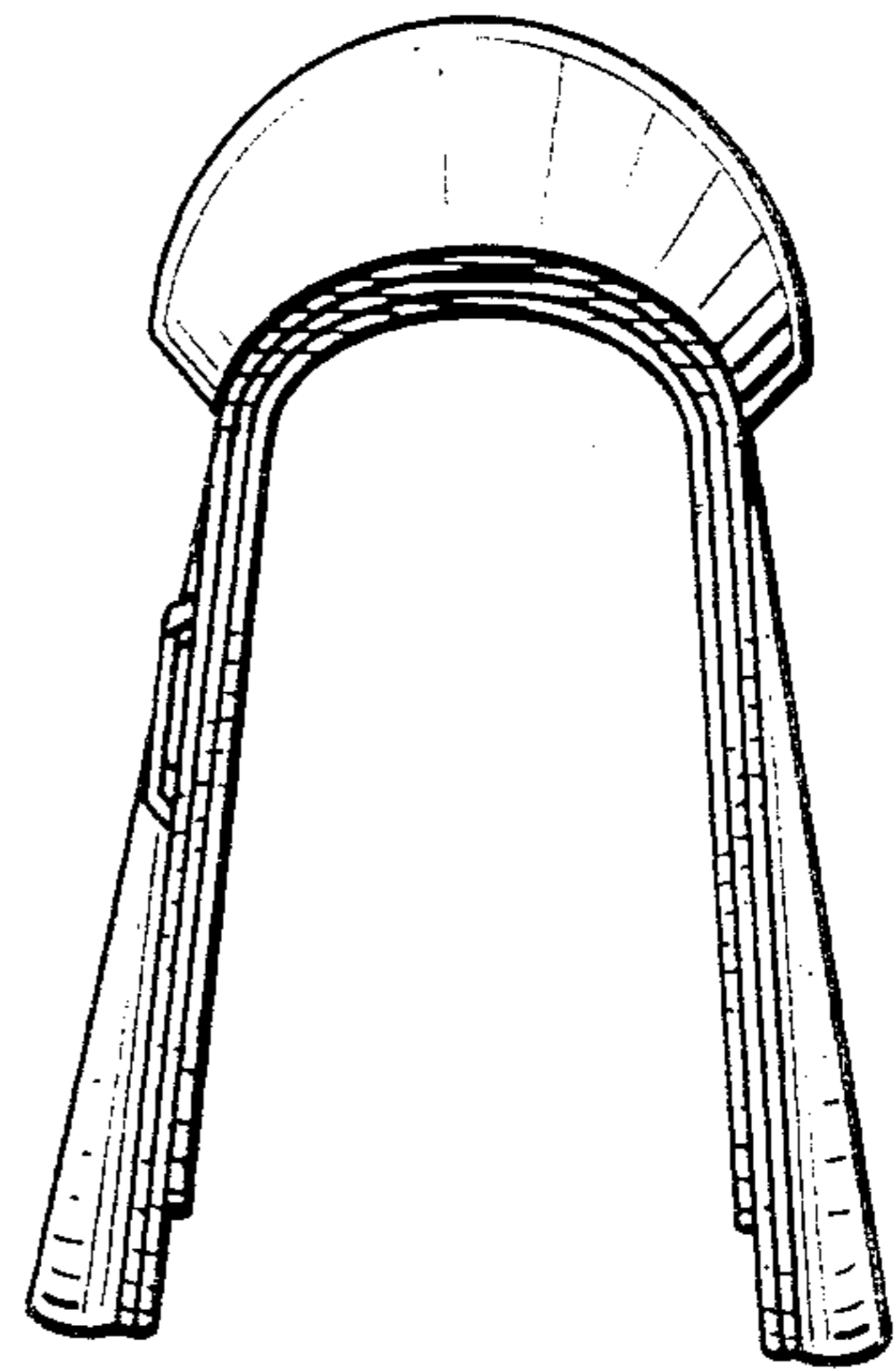

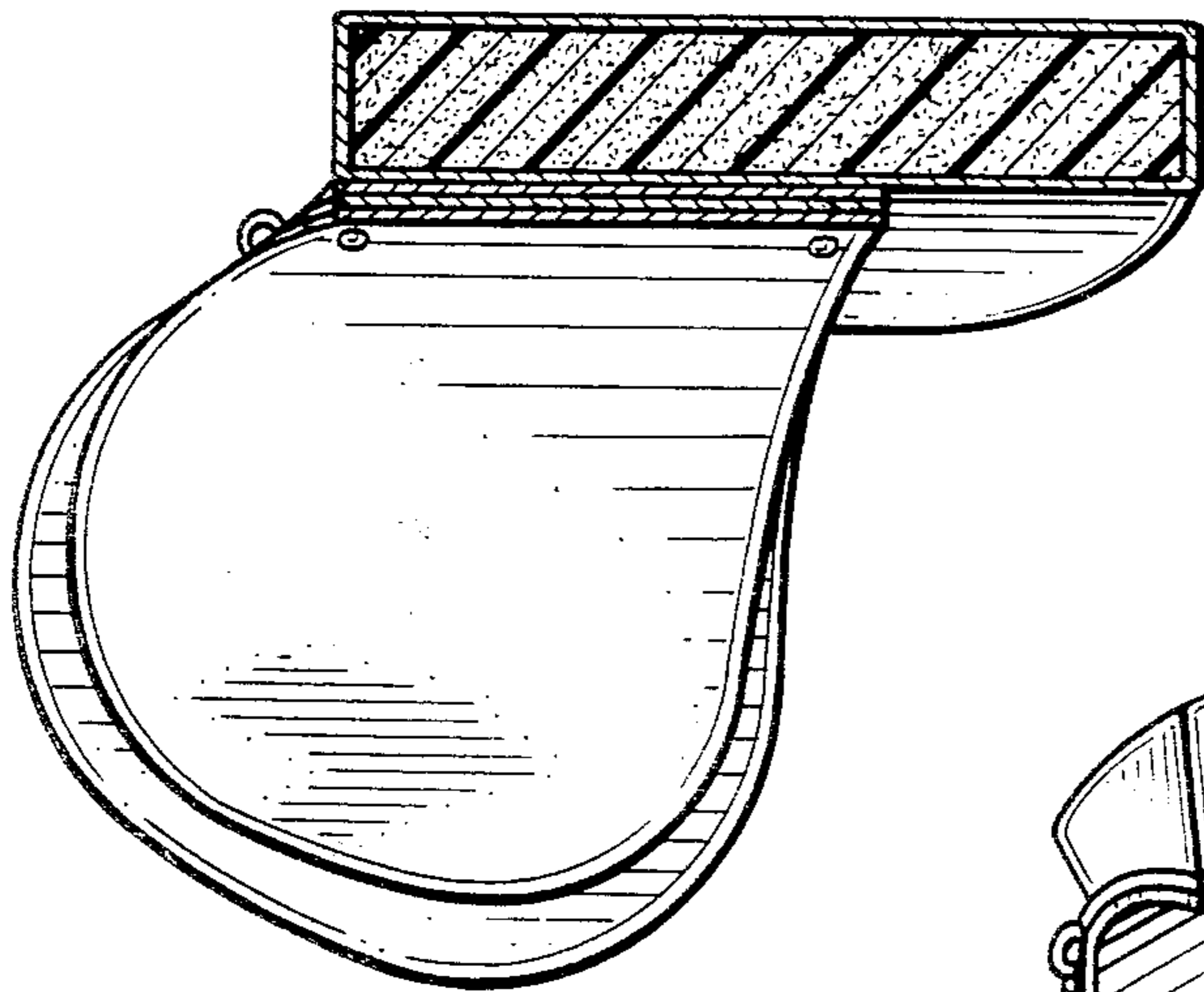

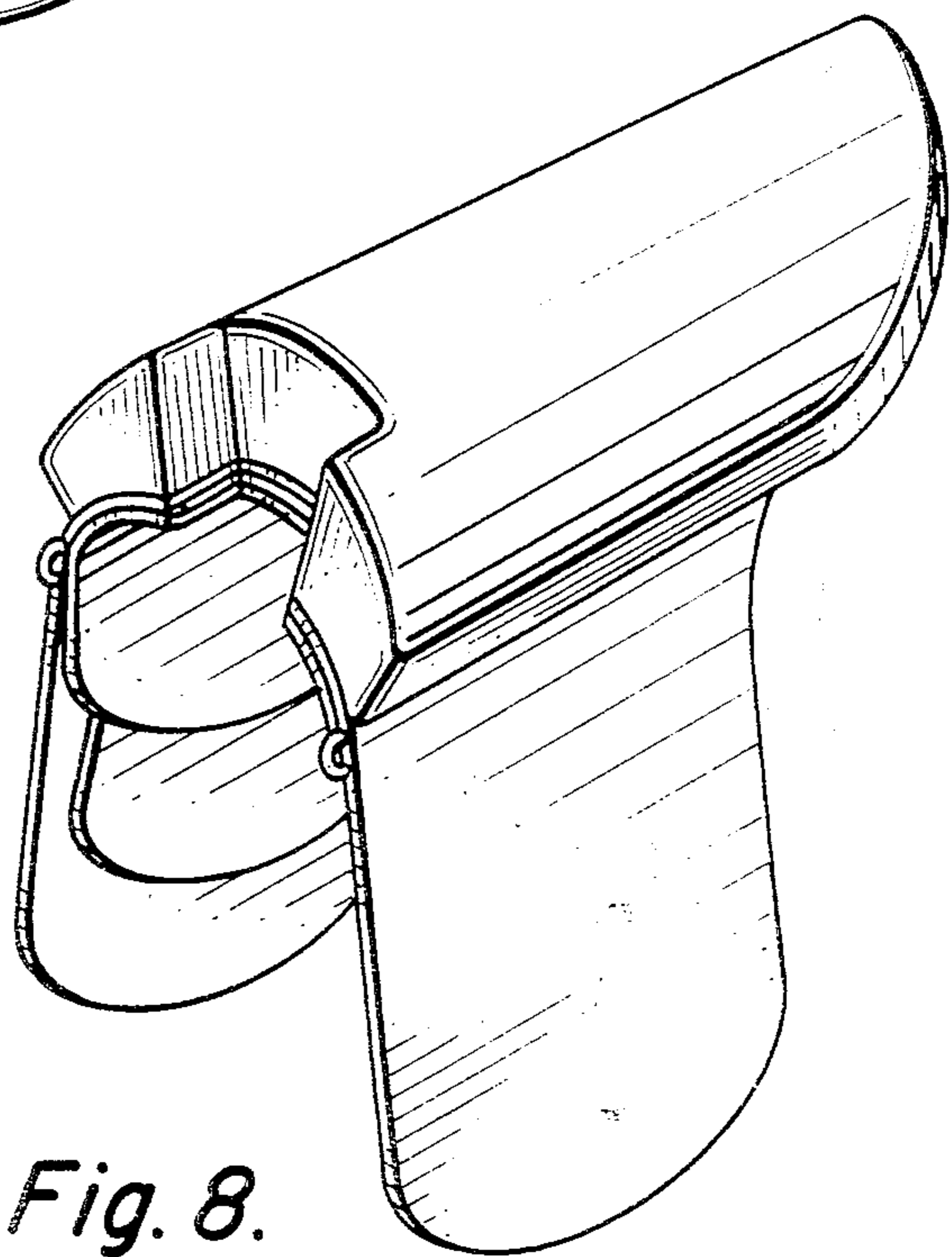
