The ornamental design for a stripes portion of an athletic shoe, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a stripes portion of an athletic shoe showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the athletic shoe body showing our new design;

The right and left sides of the shoe body are completely symmetrical.

The broken line disclosure of the shoe upper and sole is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.





