[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a zodiacal cusp medallion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a zodiacal cusp medallion showing my new design, the medallion being of conventional thickness and having the back thereof plain.
