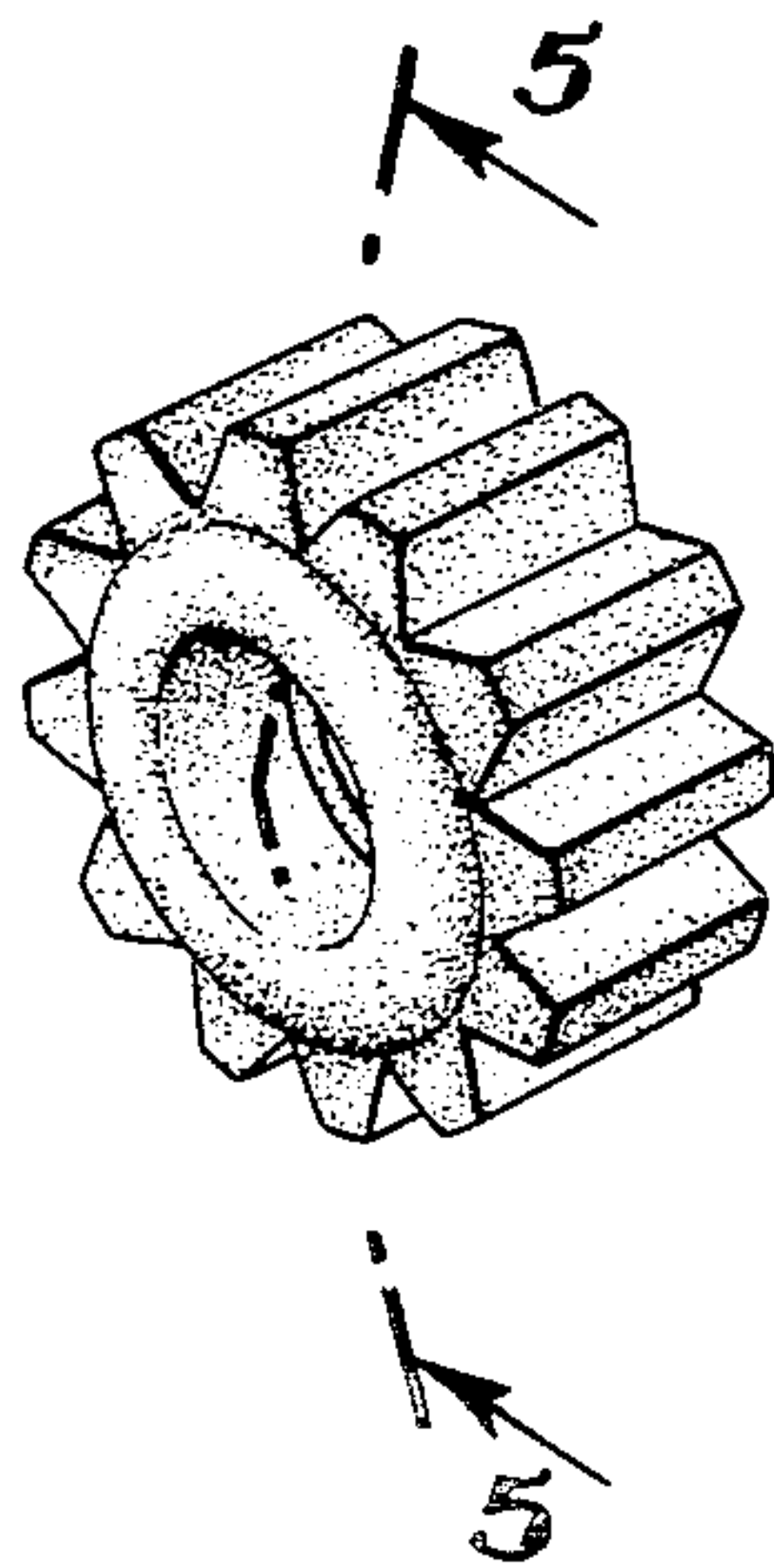

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tire for toy vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tire for toy vehicle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational and side elevational views being identical;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 1.



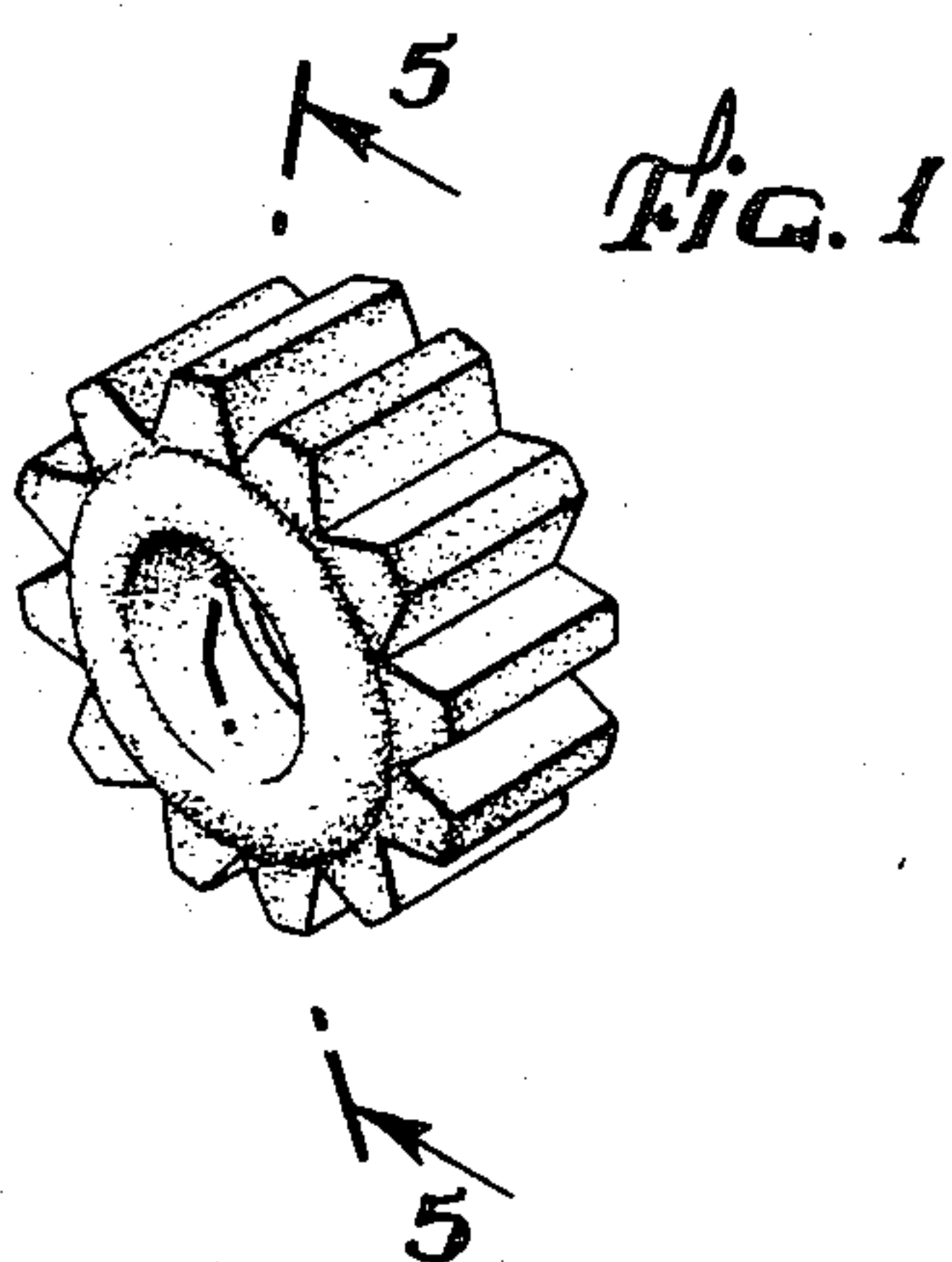

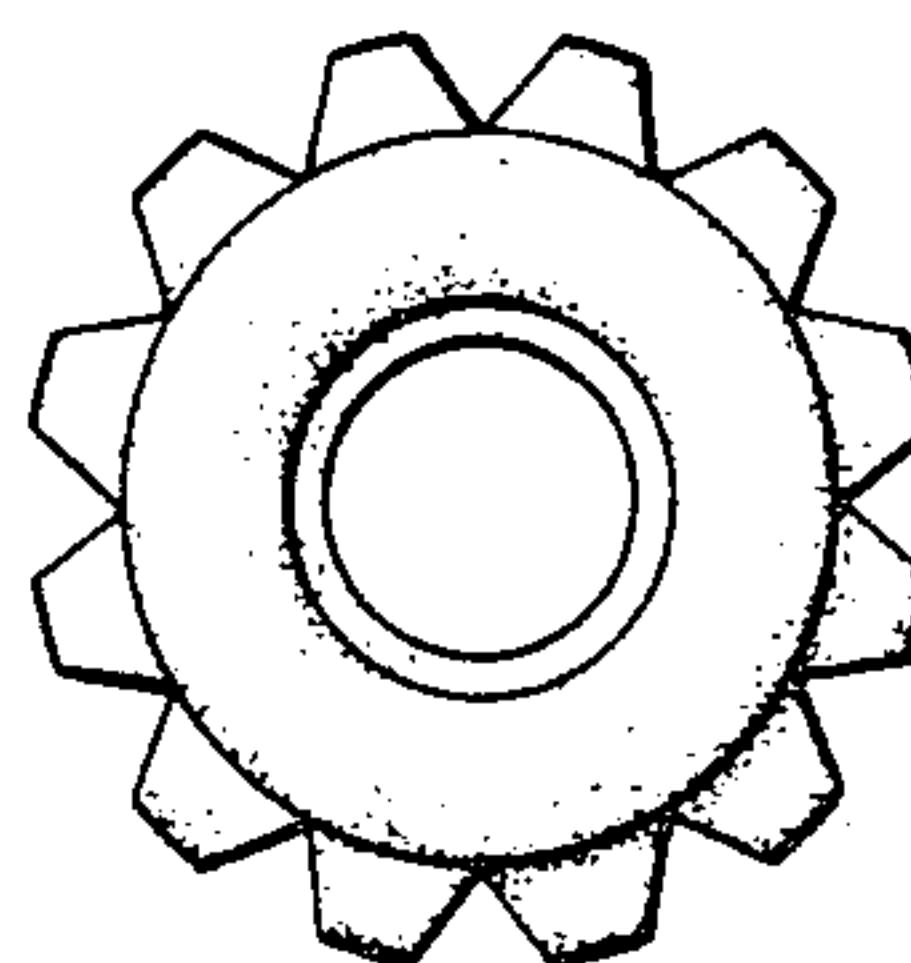

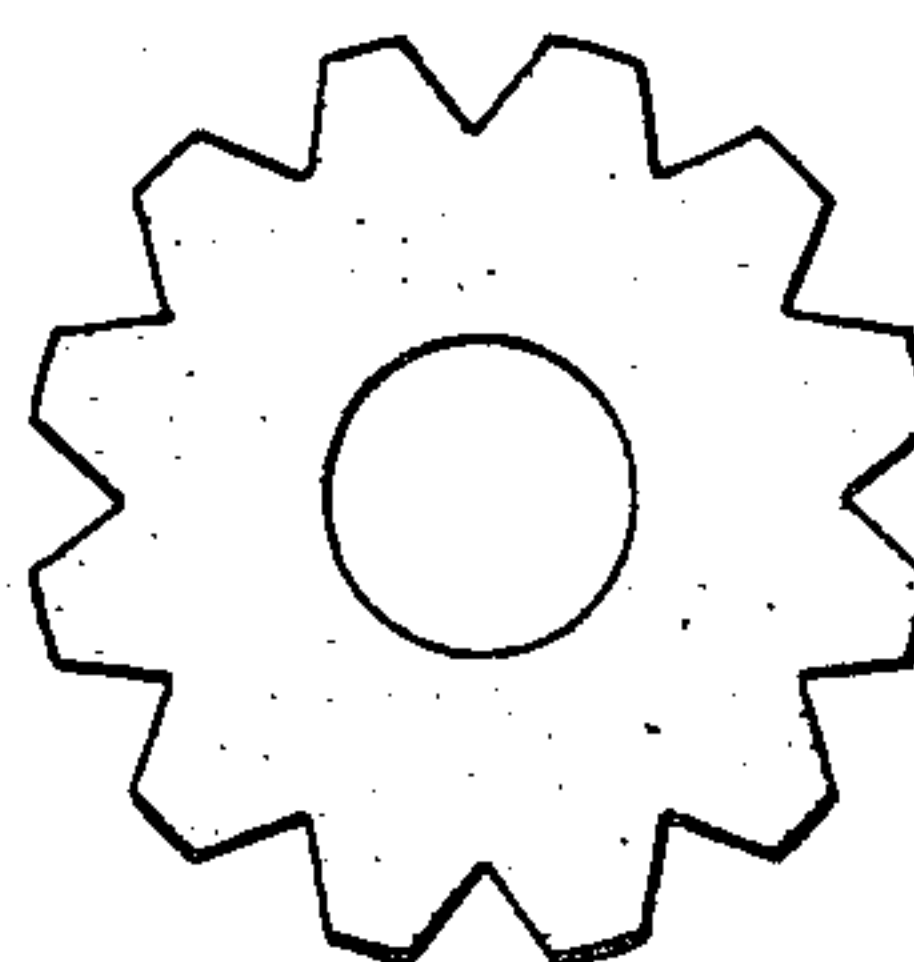
