The ornamental design for a combined sweatband and mirror, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined sweatband and mirror showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

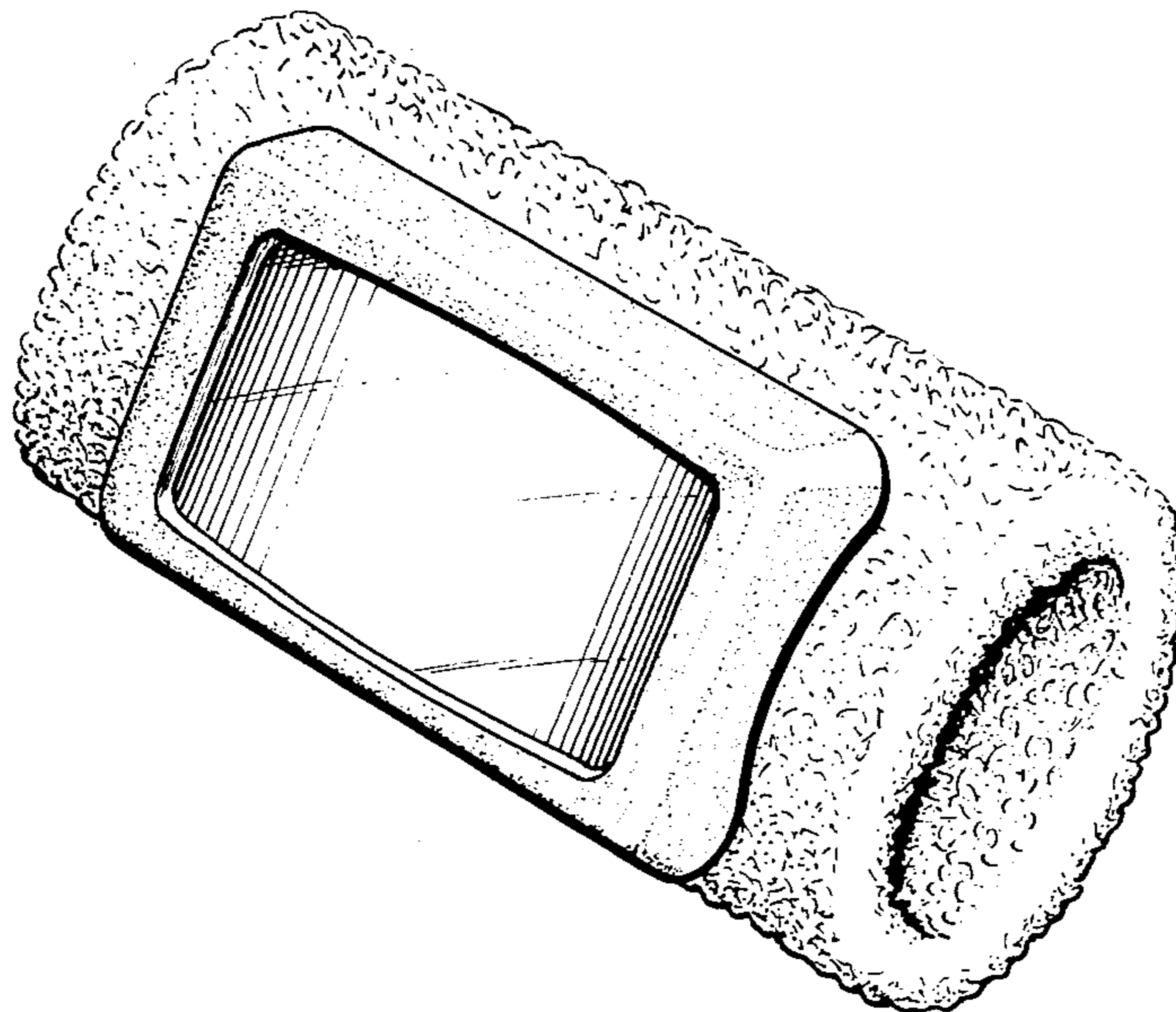

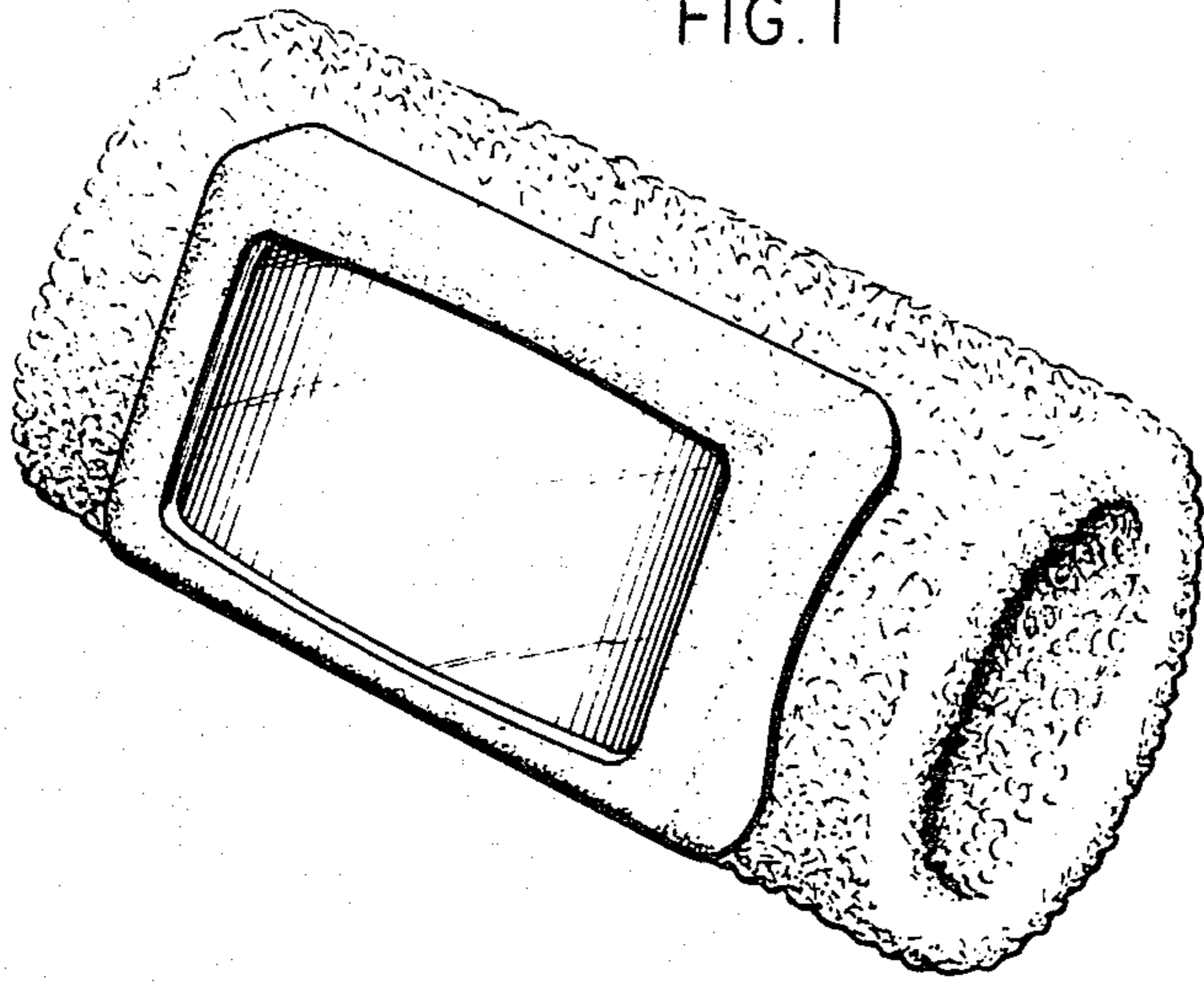

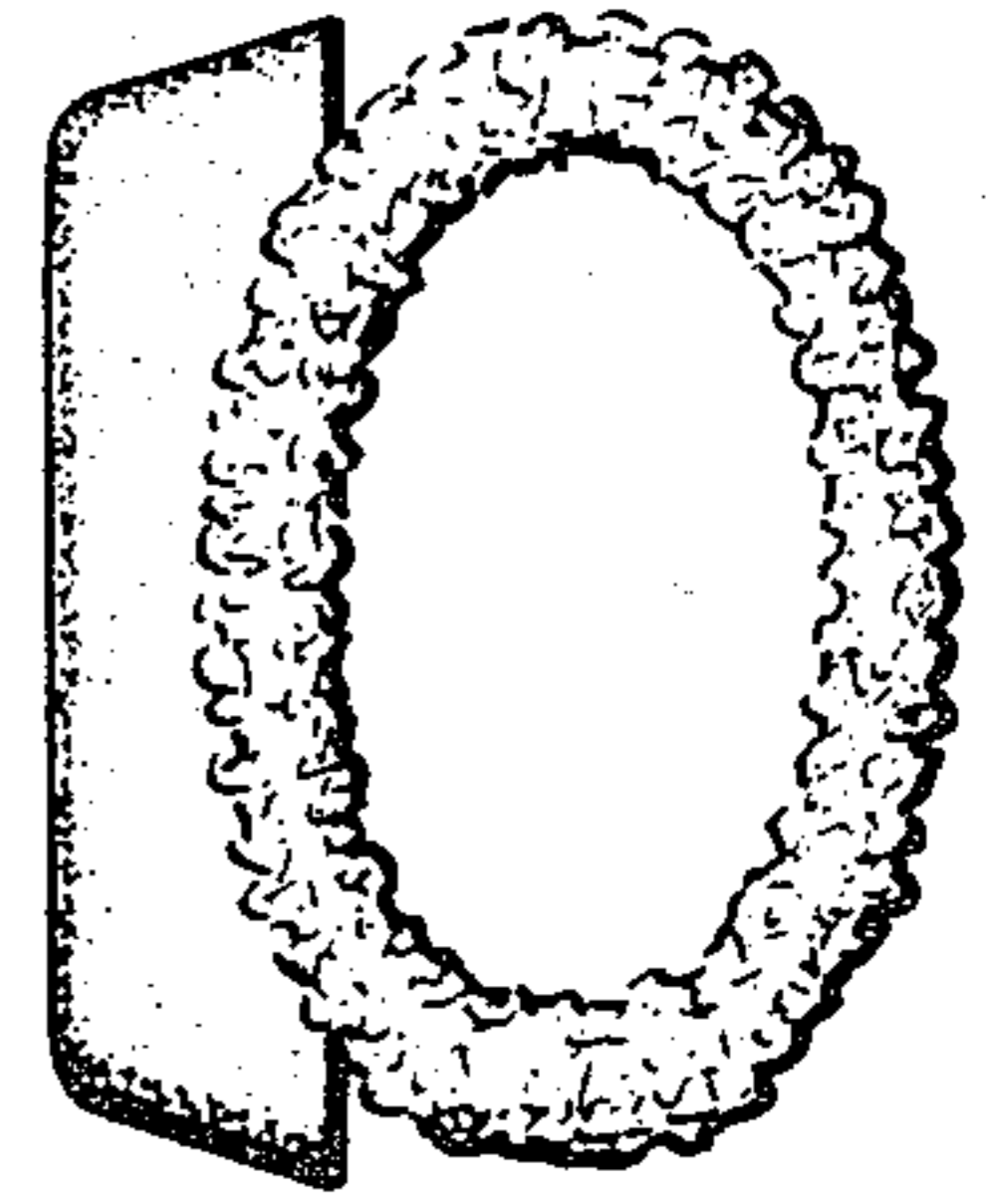

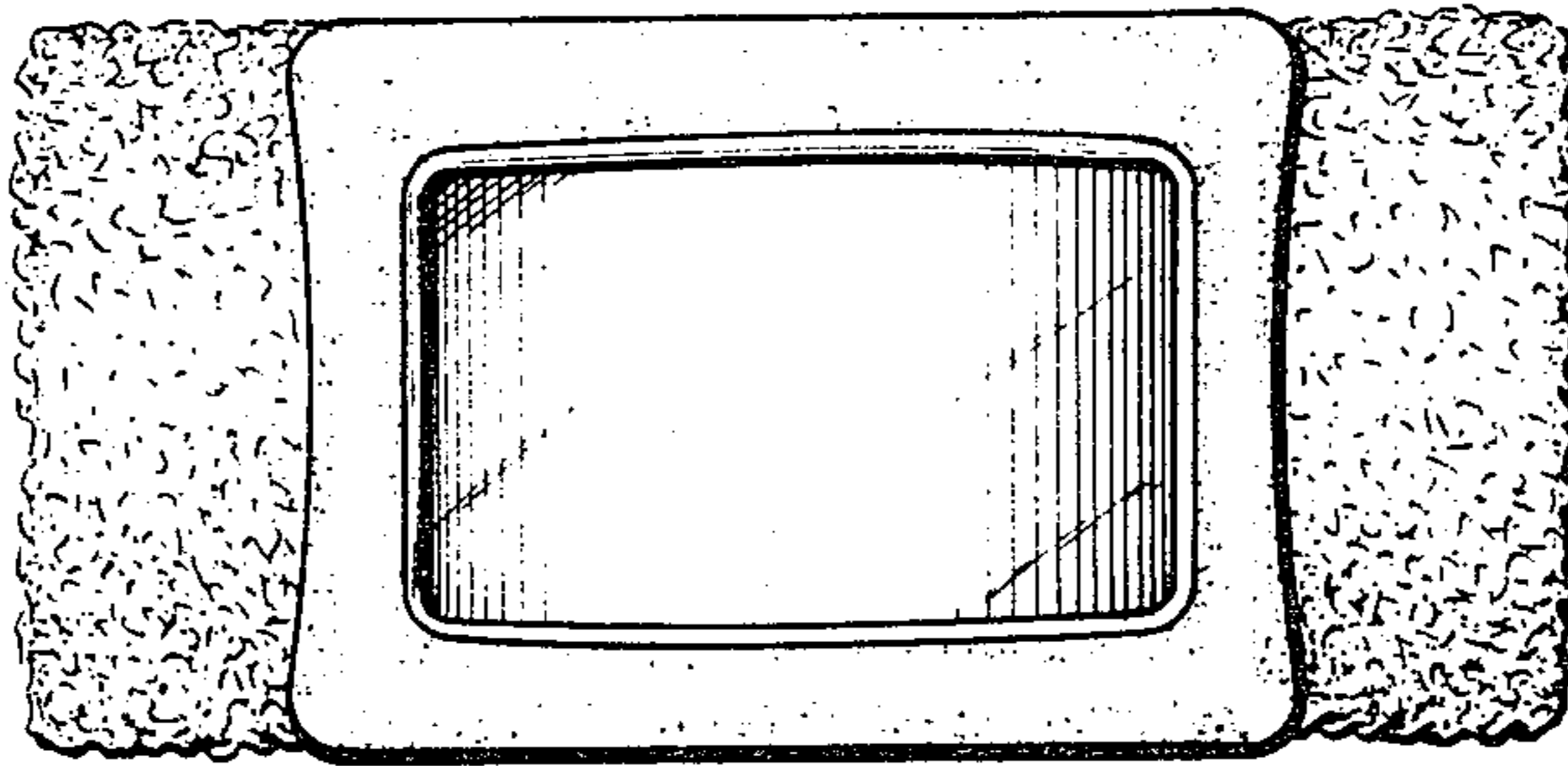
