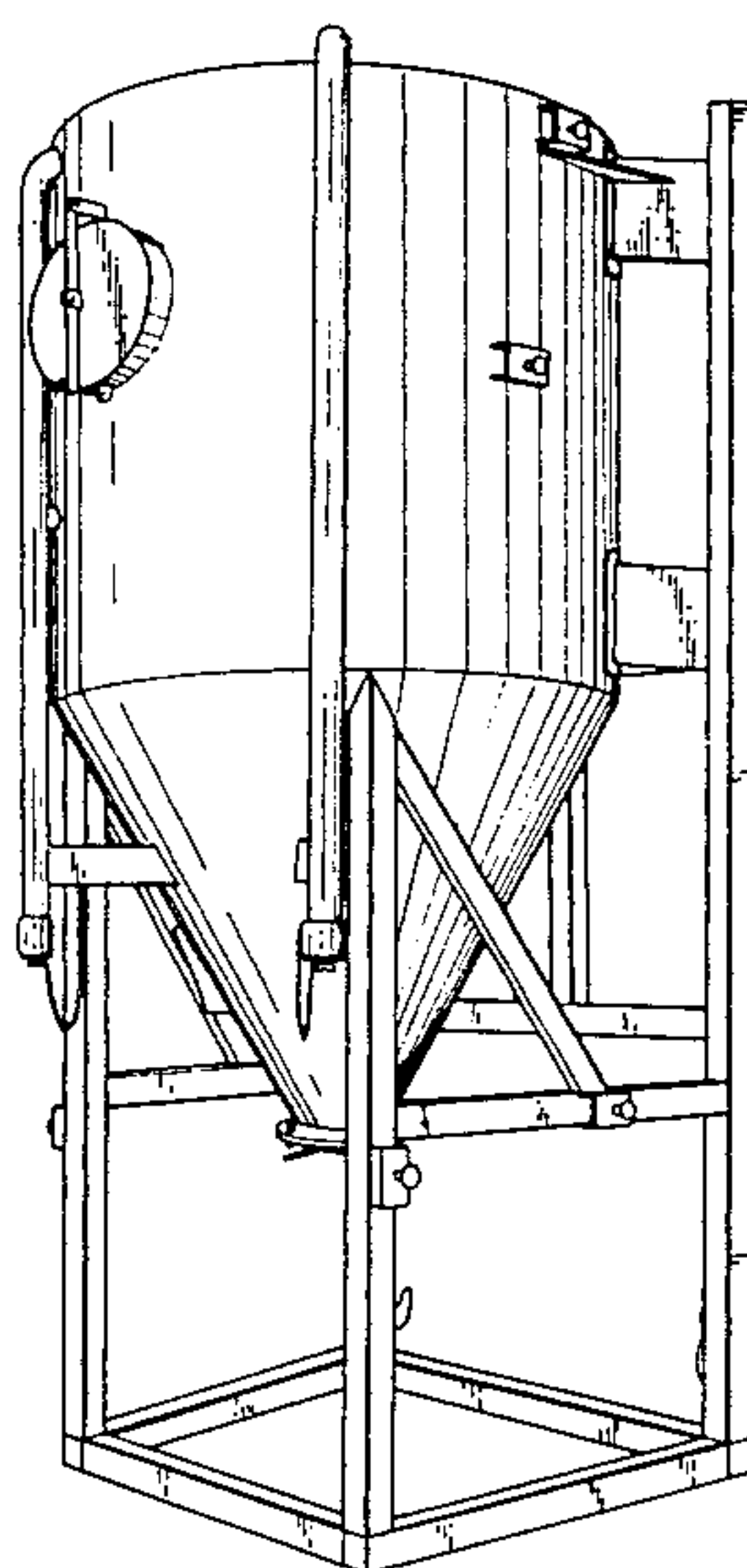
The ornamental design for a transportable bulk container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a transportable bulk container showing our design as viewed from the front when standing upright.

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of our design as viewed from the rear when standing upright.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the top side of our design as viewed when the container is lying down.



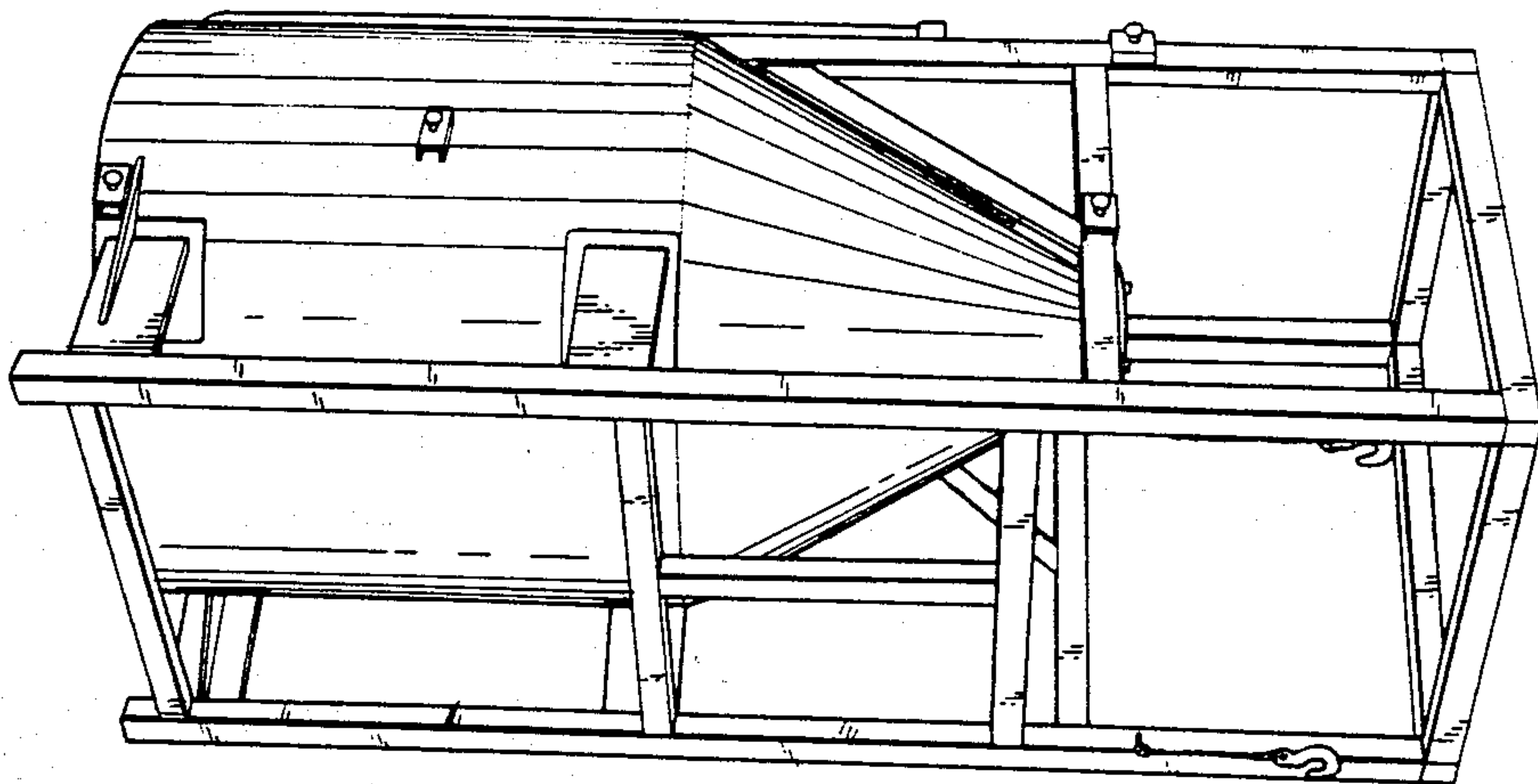

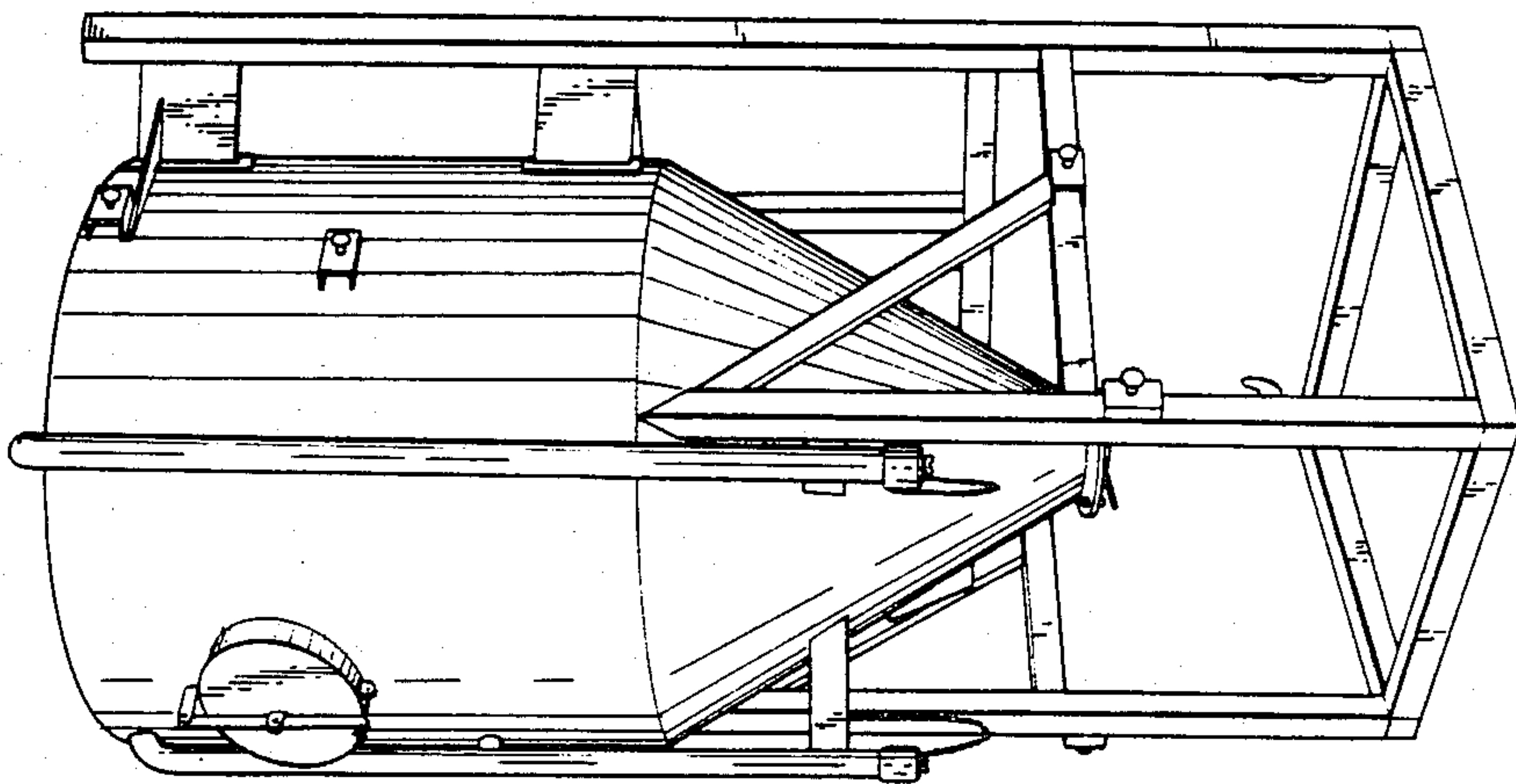

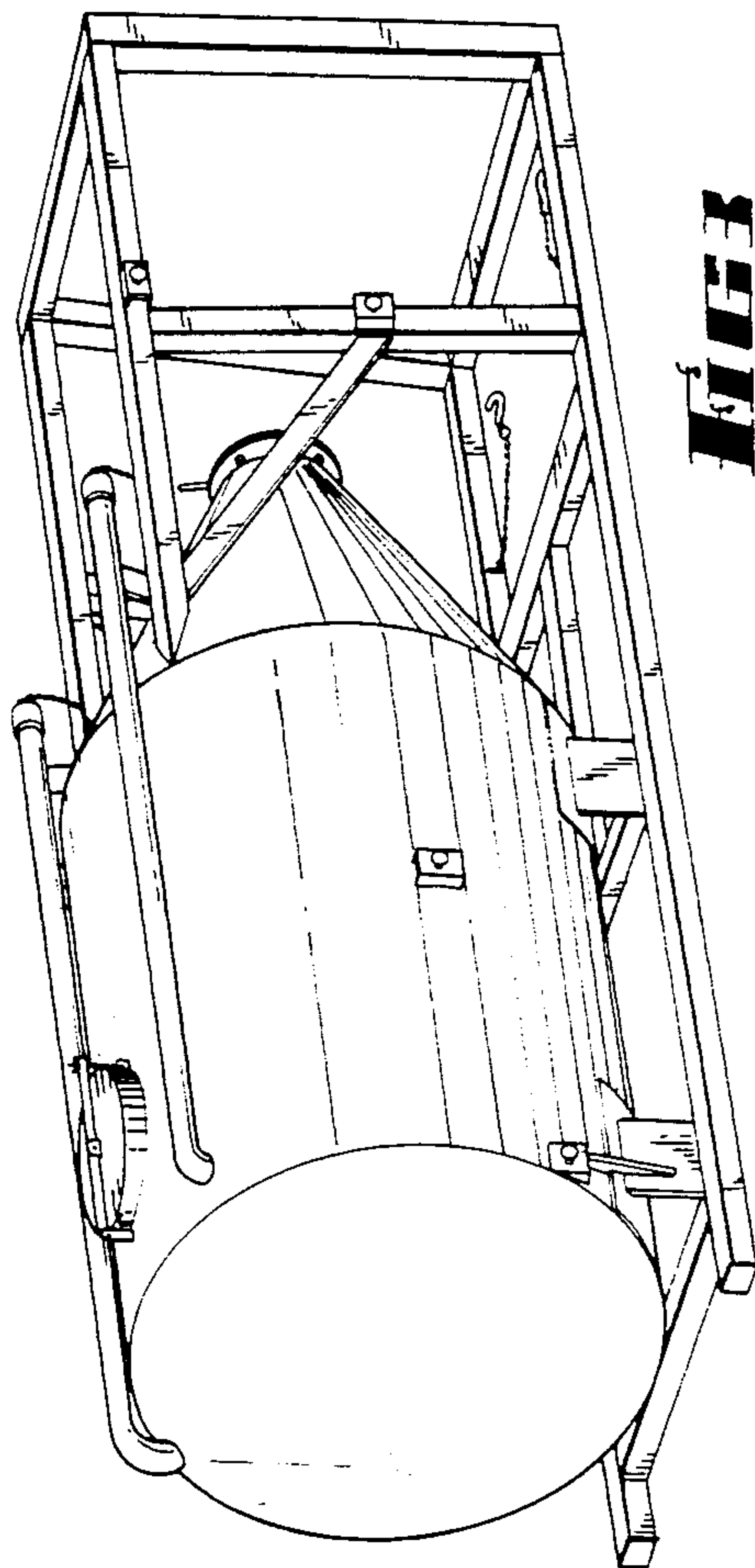
