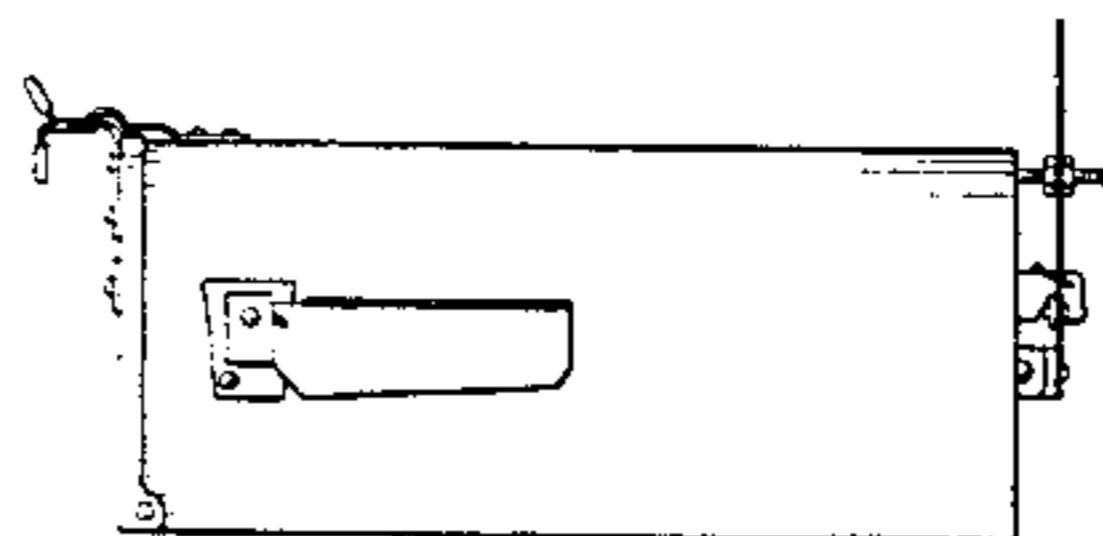
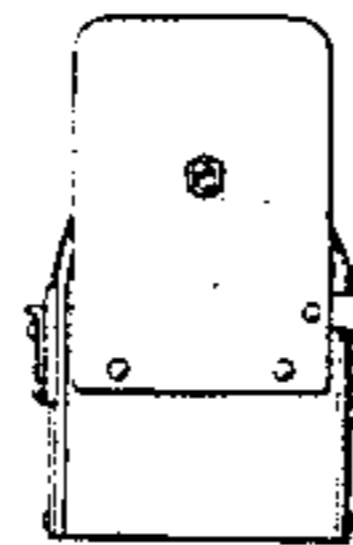
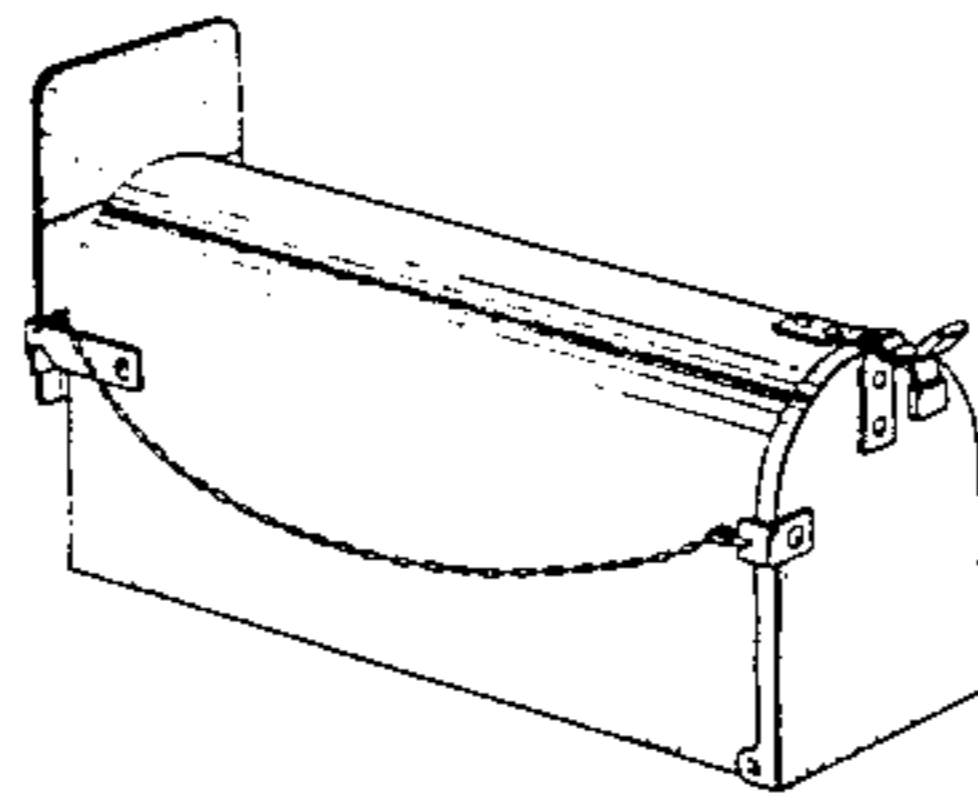

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined mailbox and signal, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a combined mailbox and signal showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevation thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevation thereof; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof with the signal shown in a released position. The undisclosed bottom portion is plane and unornamented.



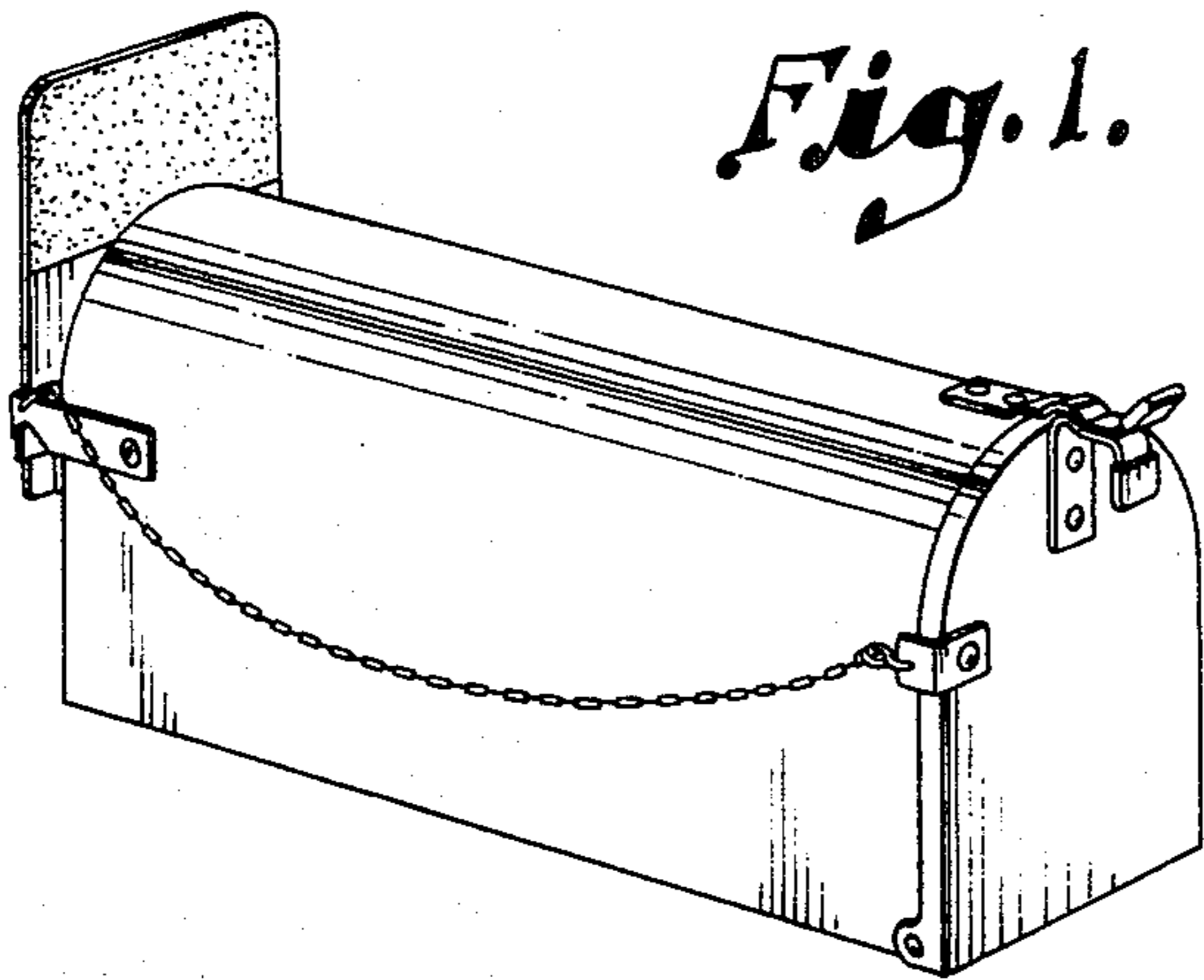

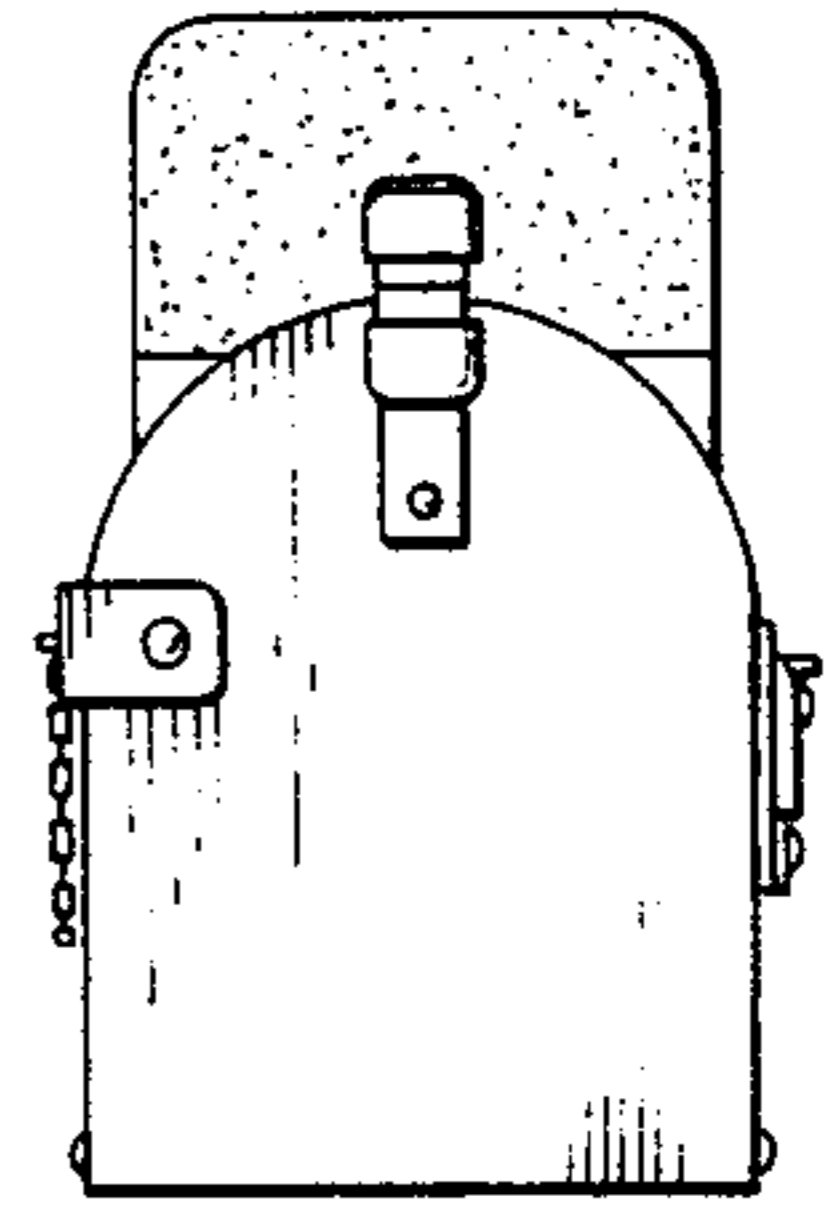

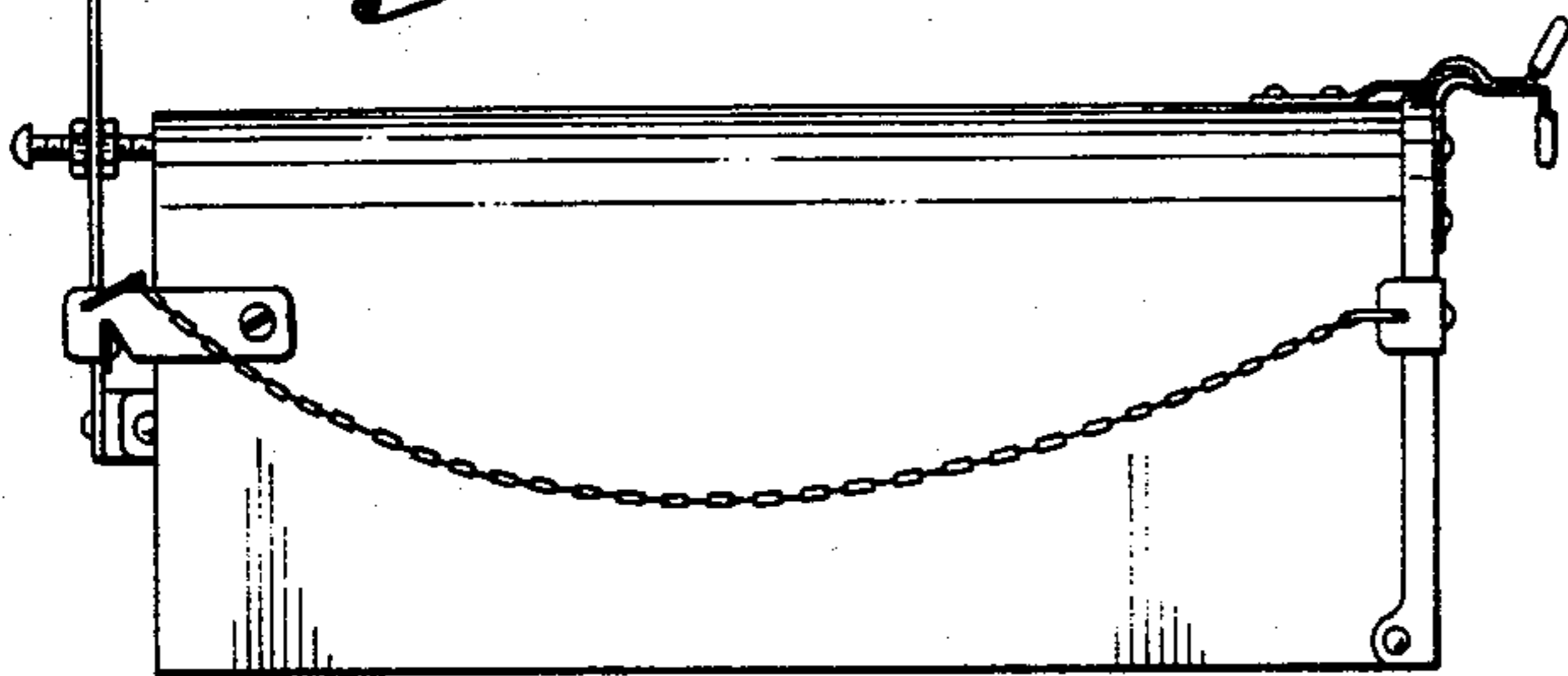

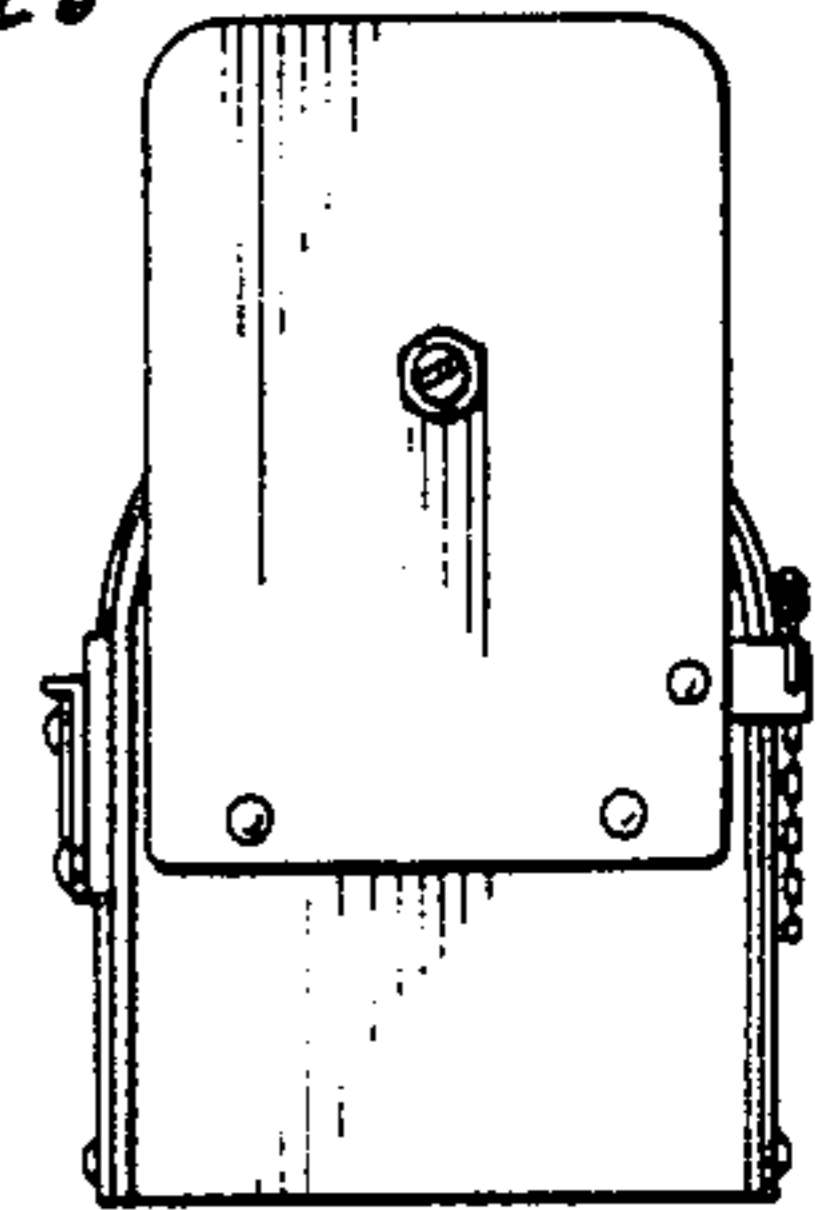

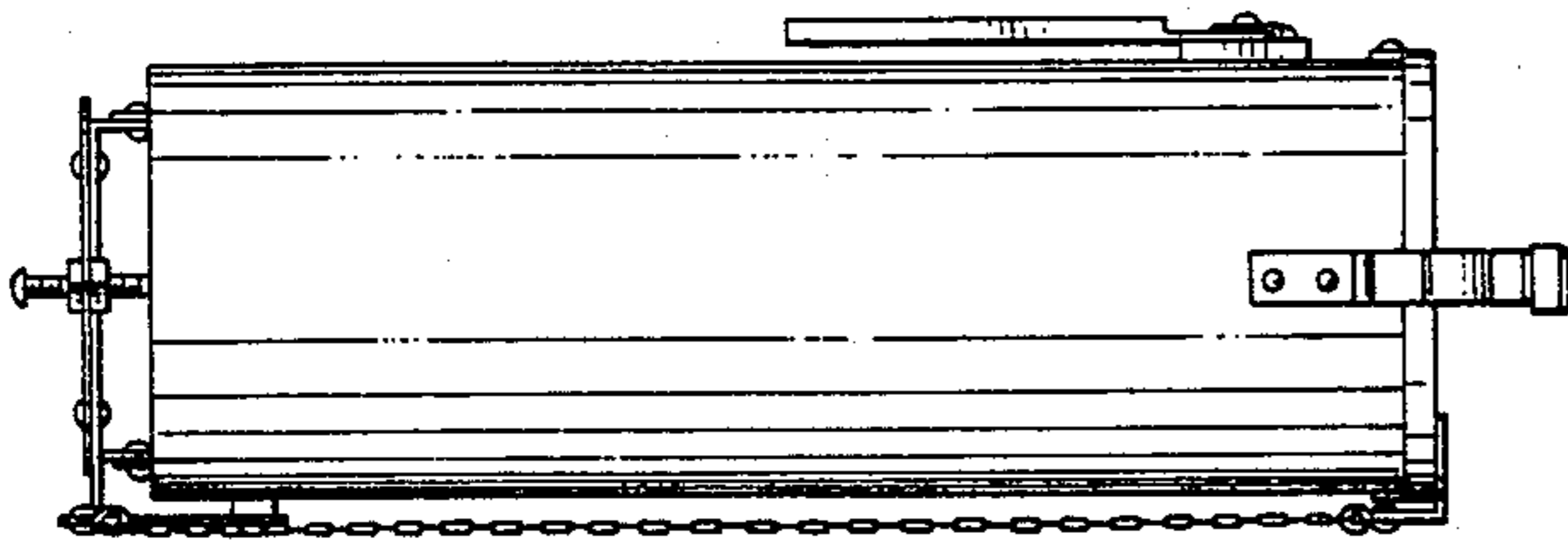

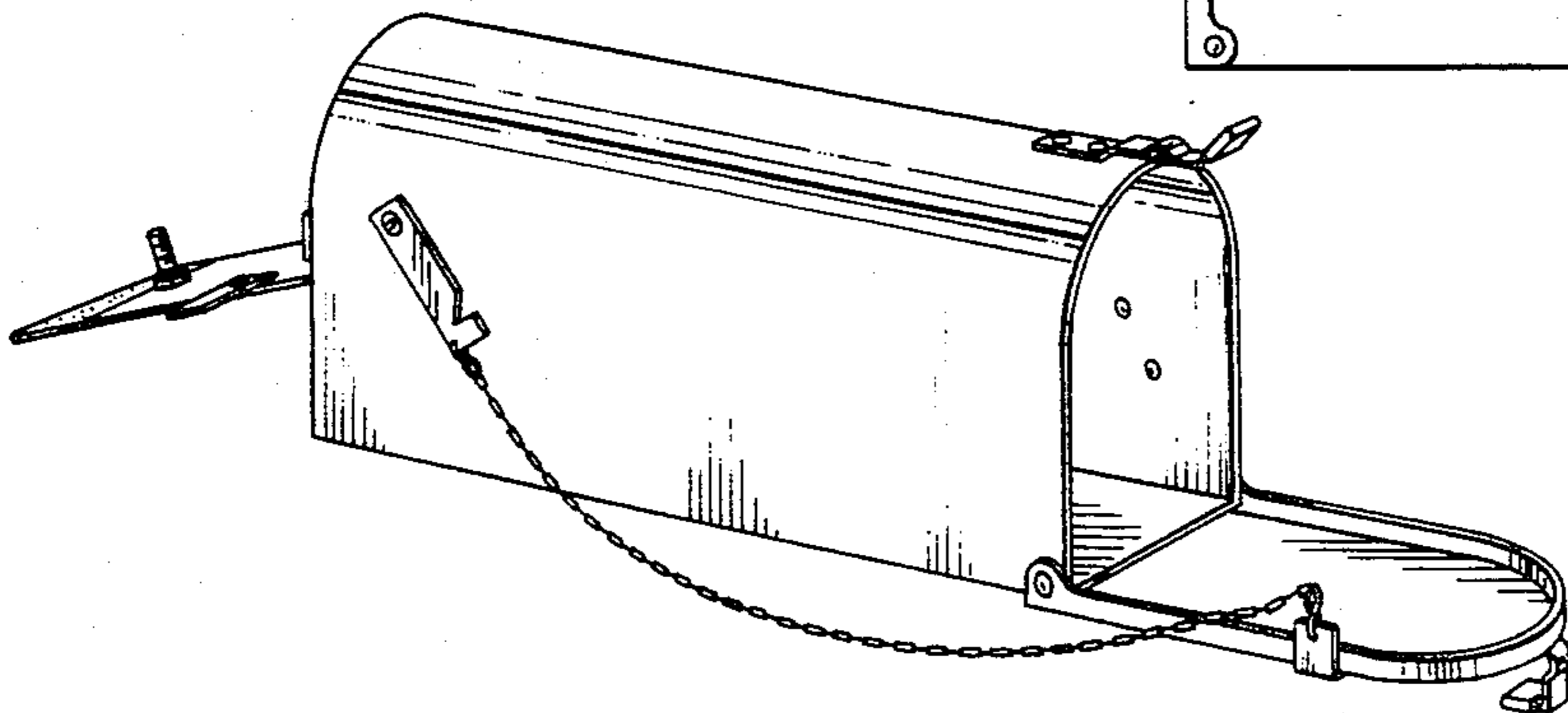
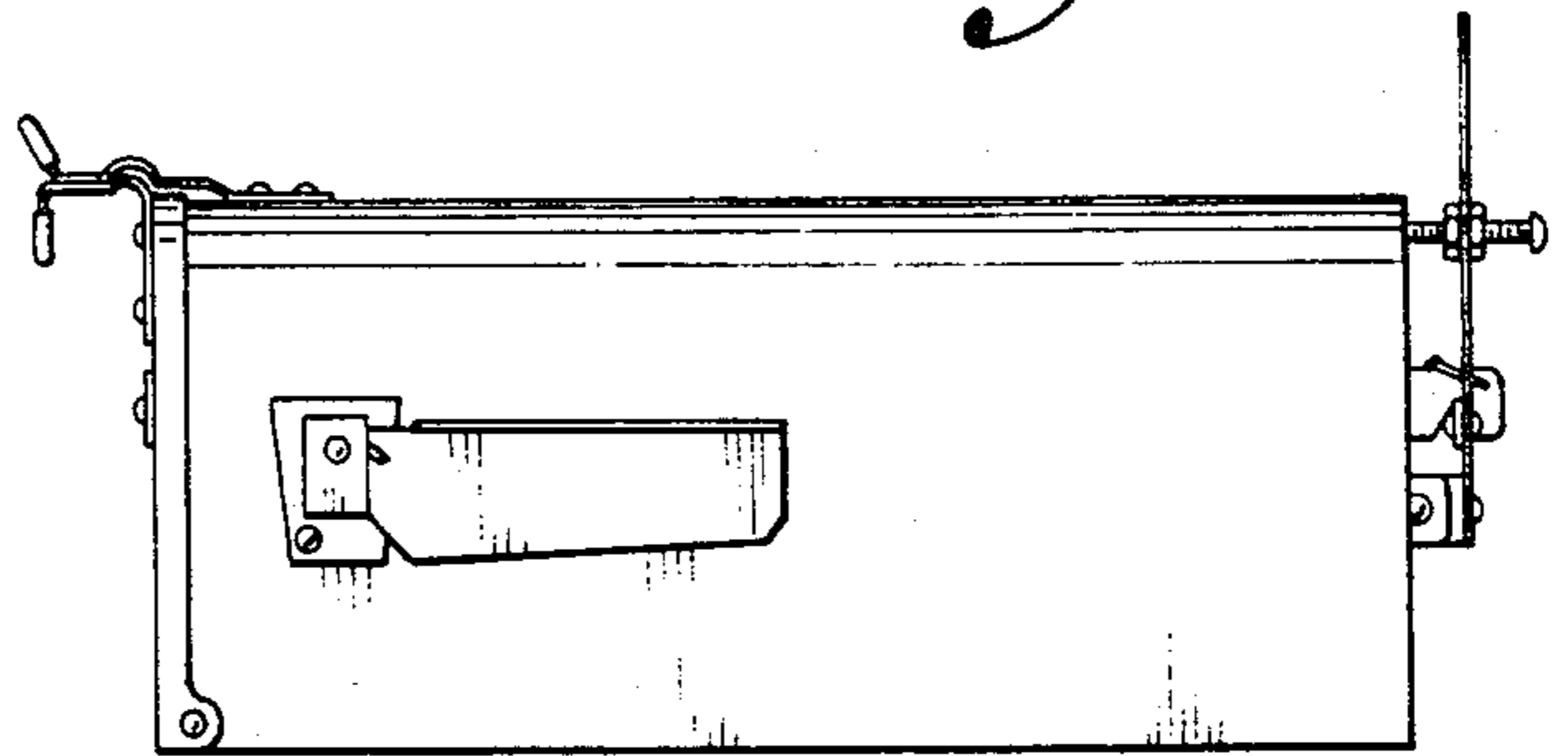
