The ornamental design for display notebook, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a display notebook showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a view of the top edge of my design;
 FIG. 3 is a view of the right side edge of my design;
 FIG. 4 is a view of the back edge or binder side of my notebook;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of my design with the notebook in its opened mode;
 FIG. 6 is a section of the notebook taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 7 is a bottom edge elevation view of the notebook in its open mode as shown in FIG. 5;
 FIG. 8 is a section taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 9 is a section taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 10 is a section taken along line 10—10 of FIG. 5;

 FIG. 11 is a section taken along line 11—11 of FIG. 5.

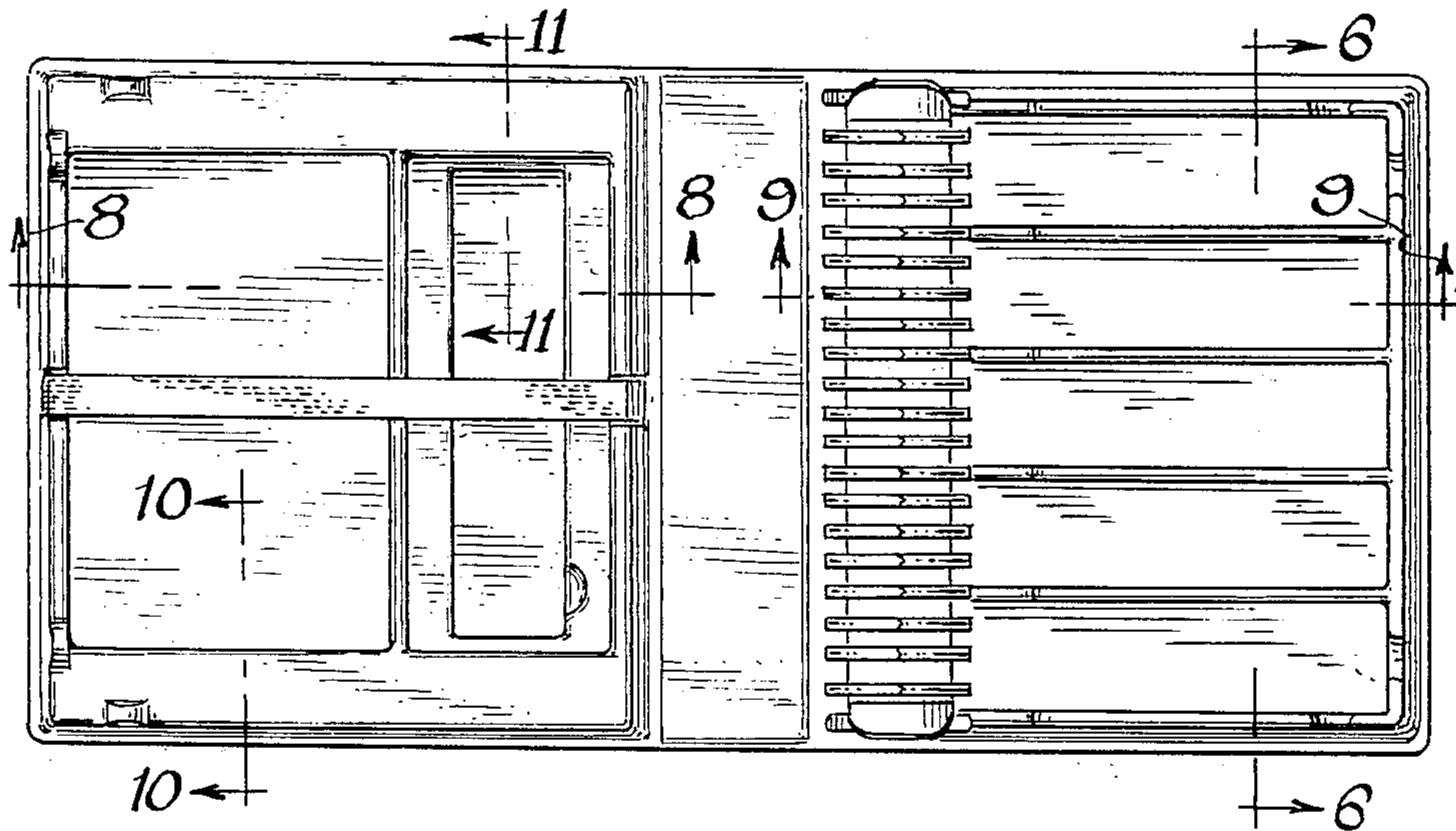

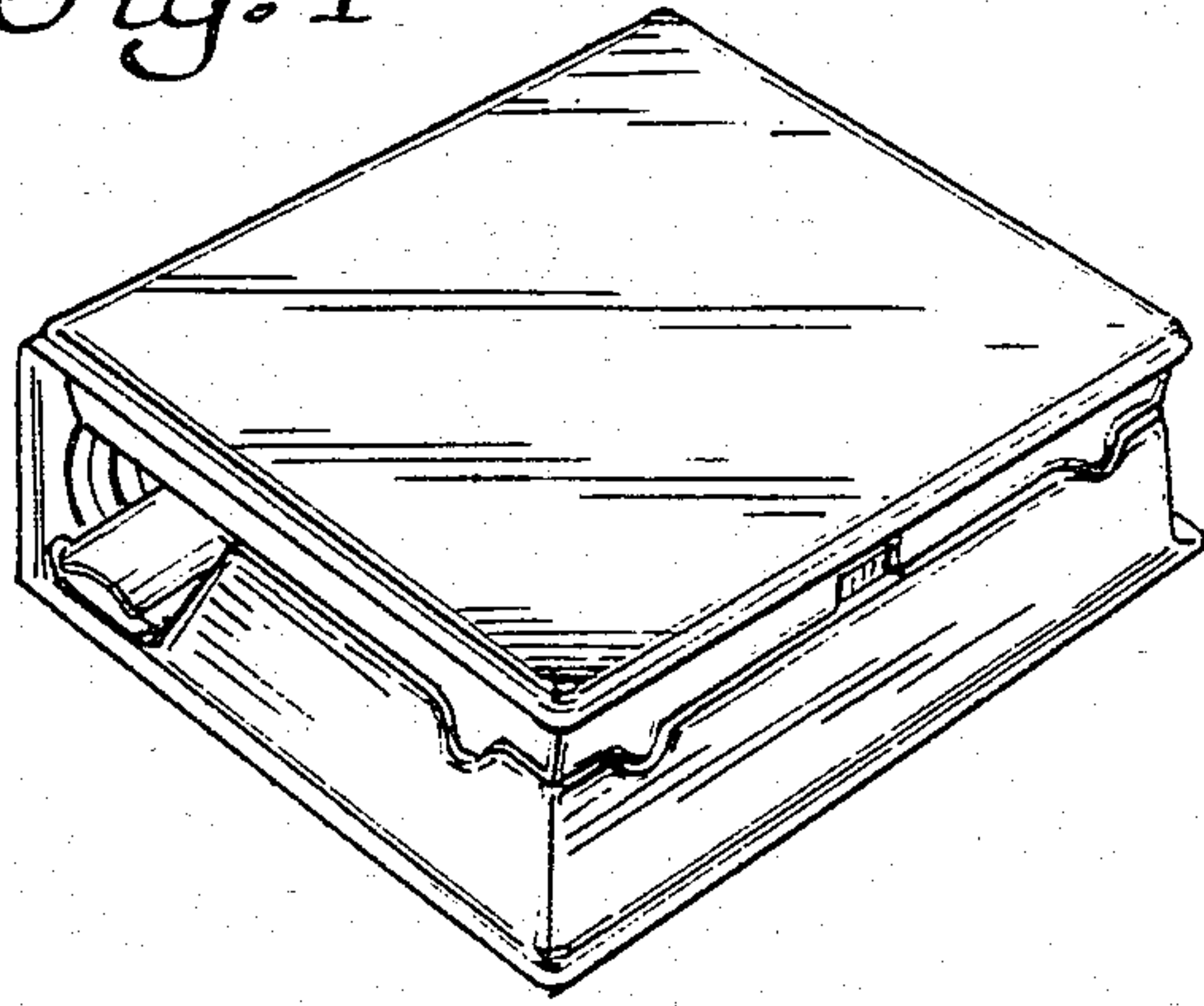

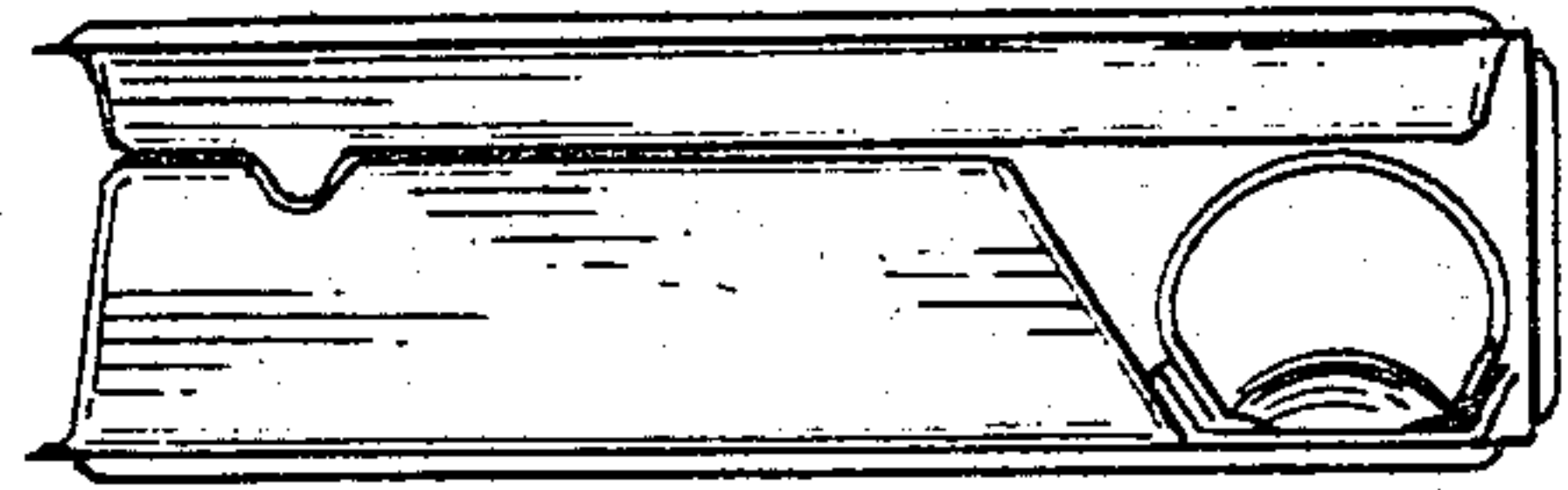

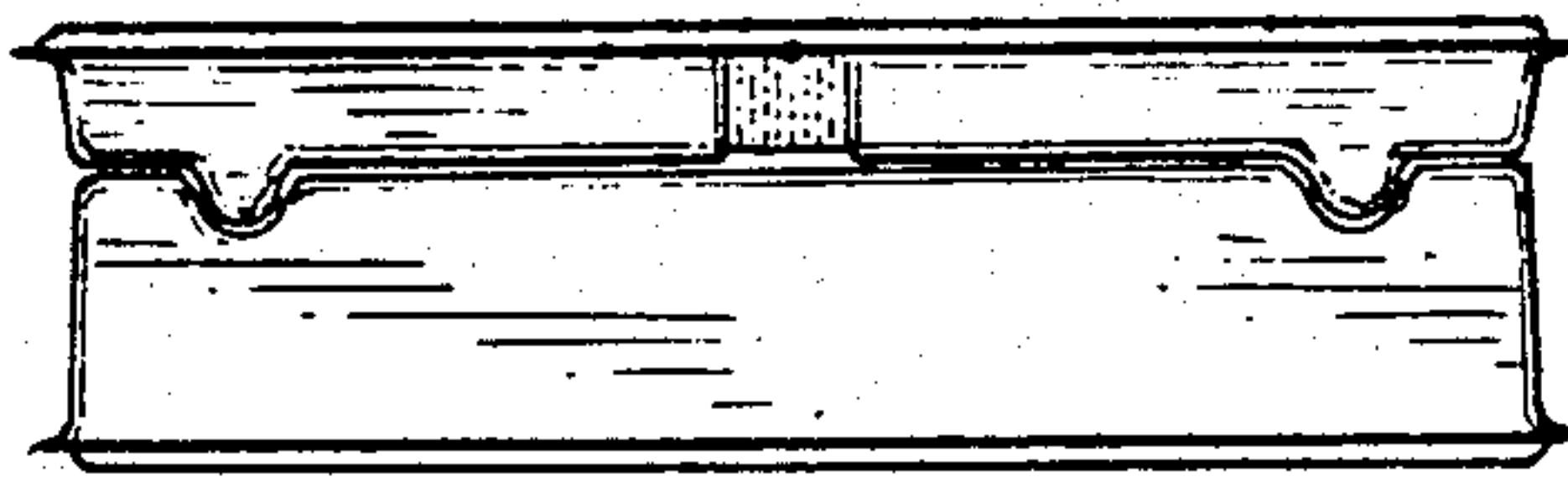

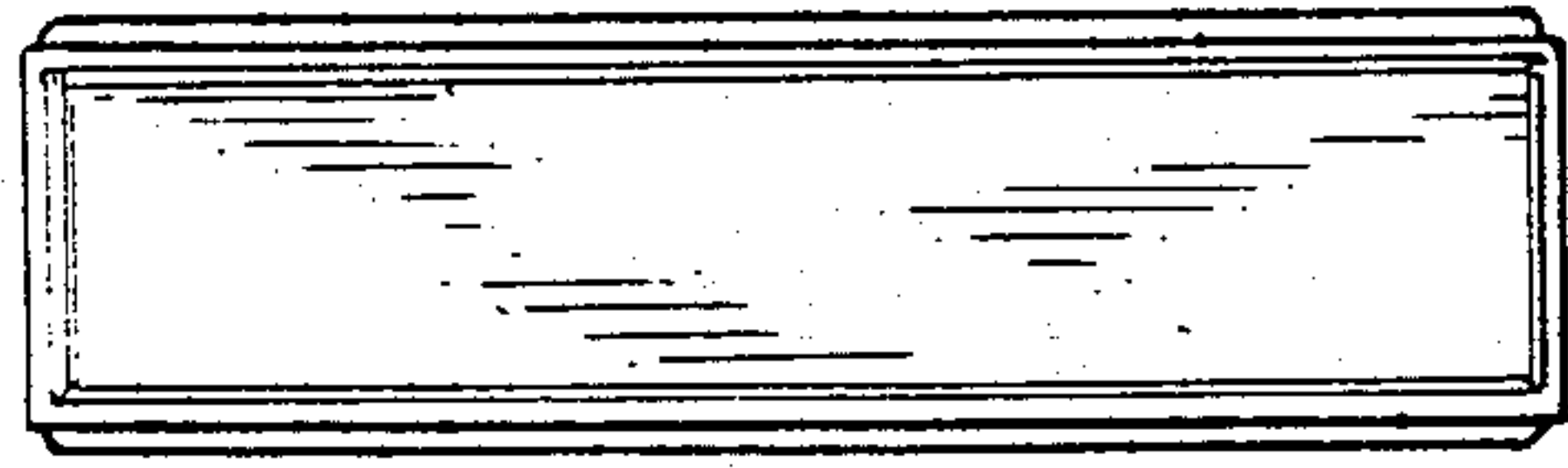

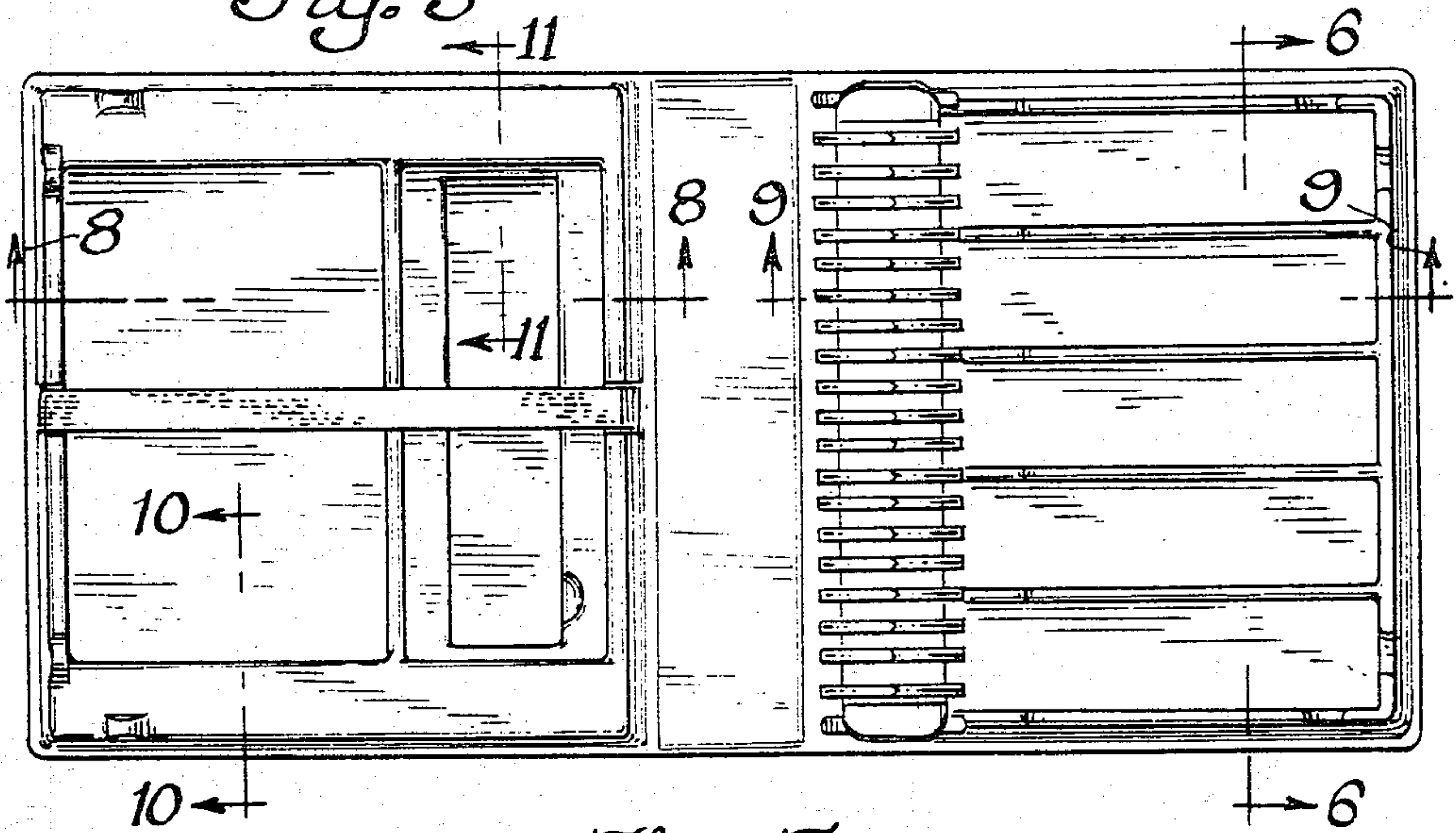

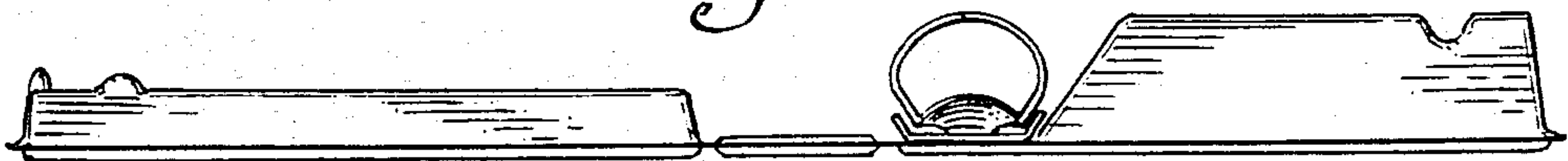

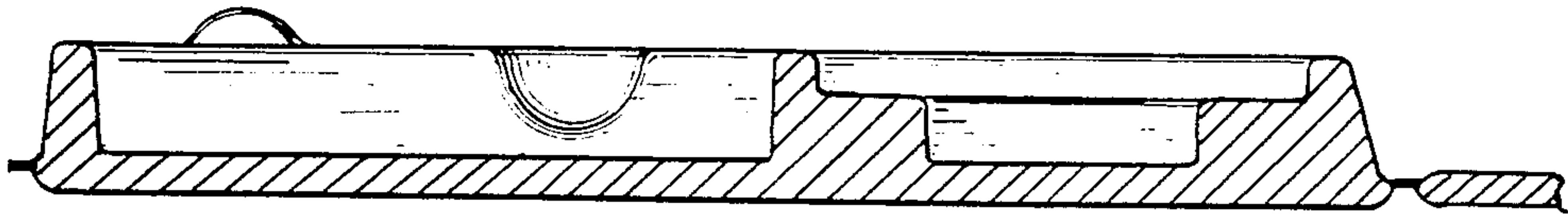

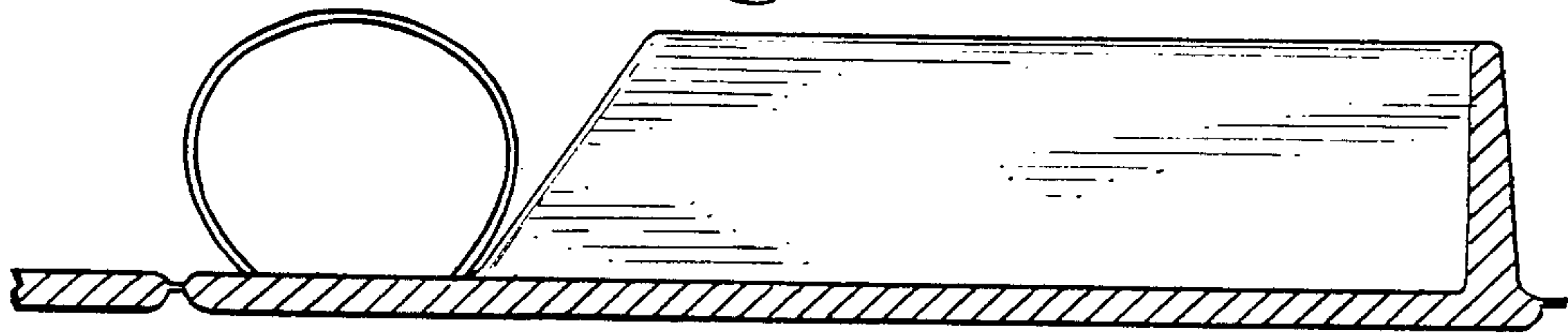

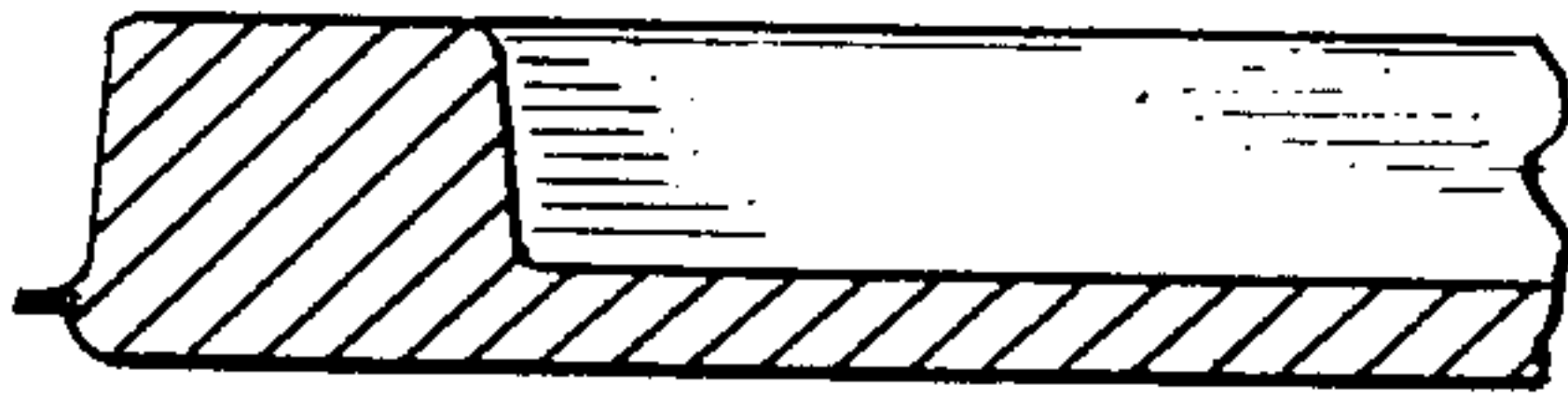

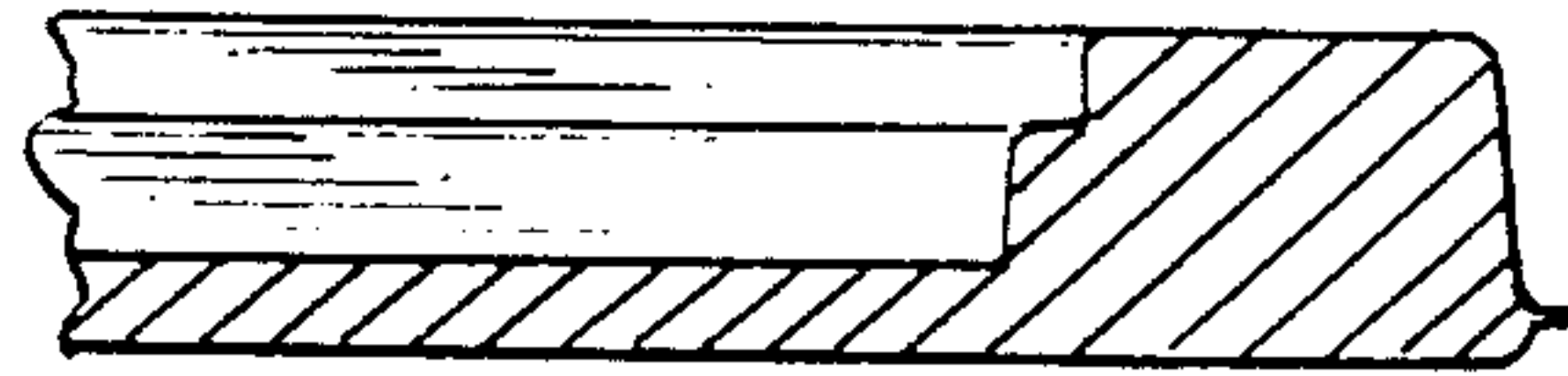
