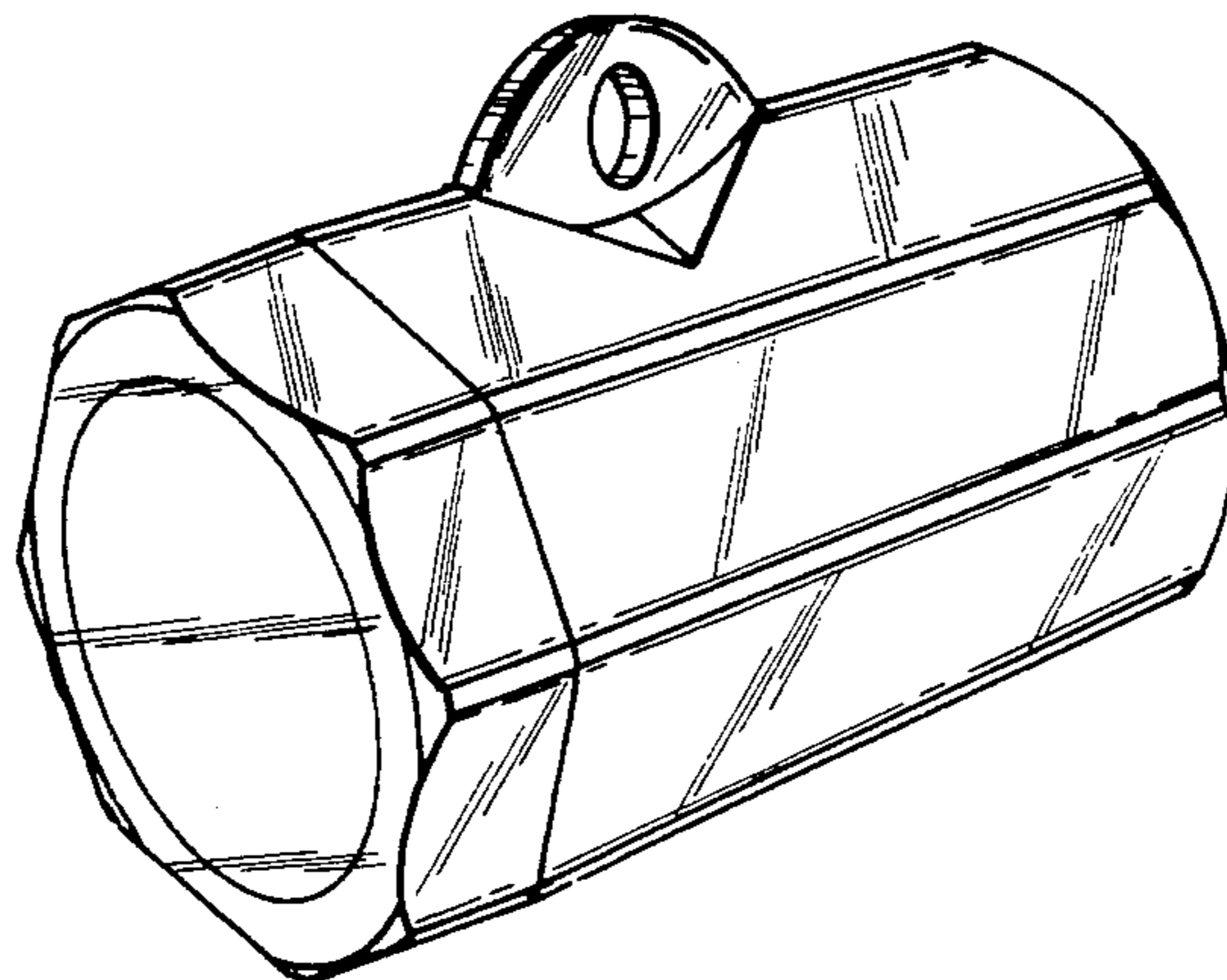

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective of a pendant medical microfilm reader showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1.



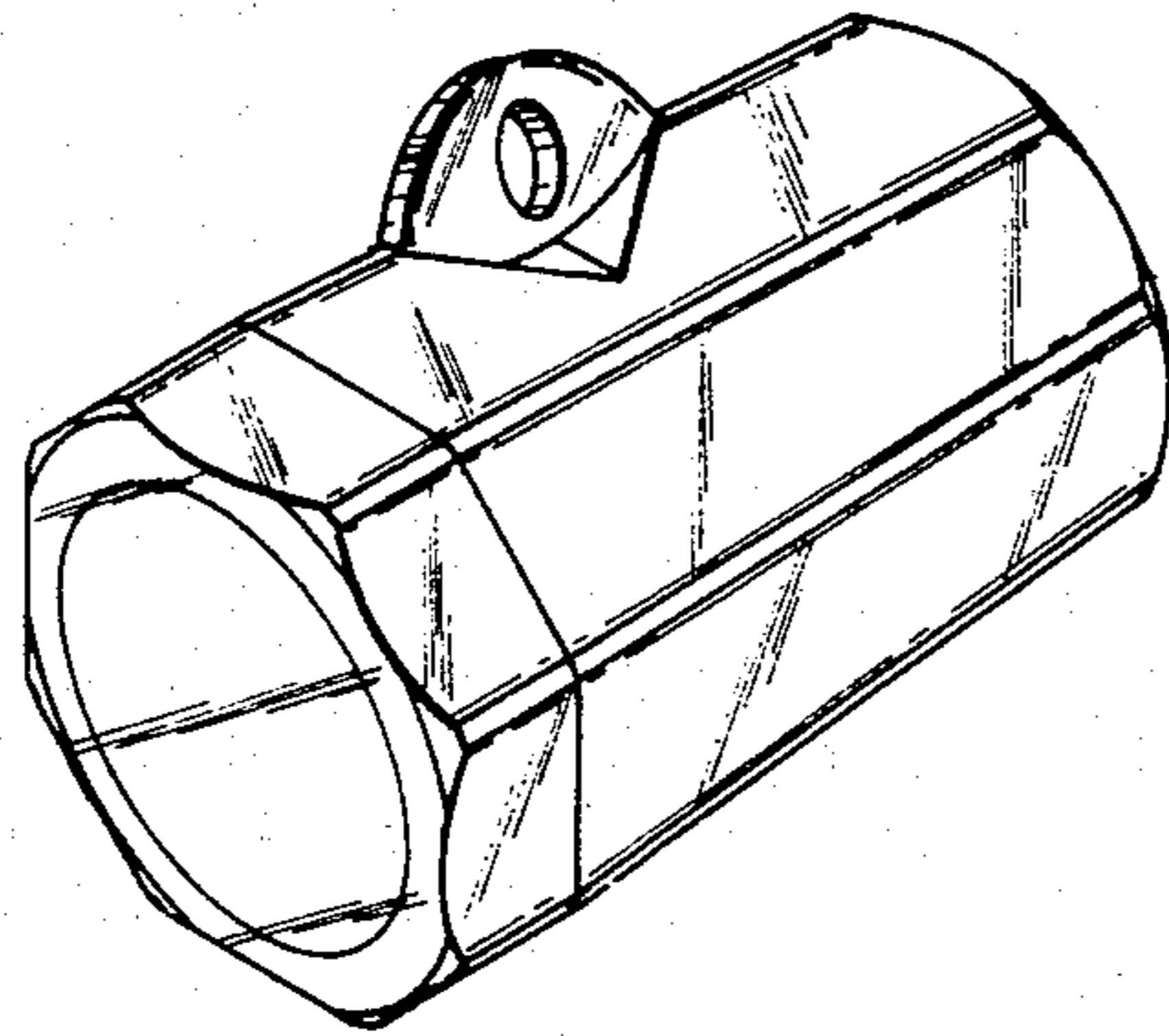

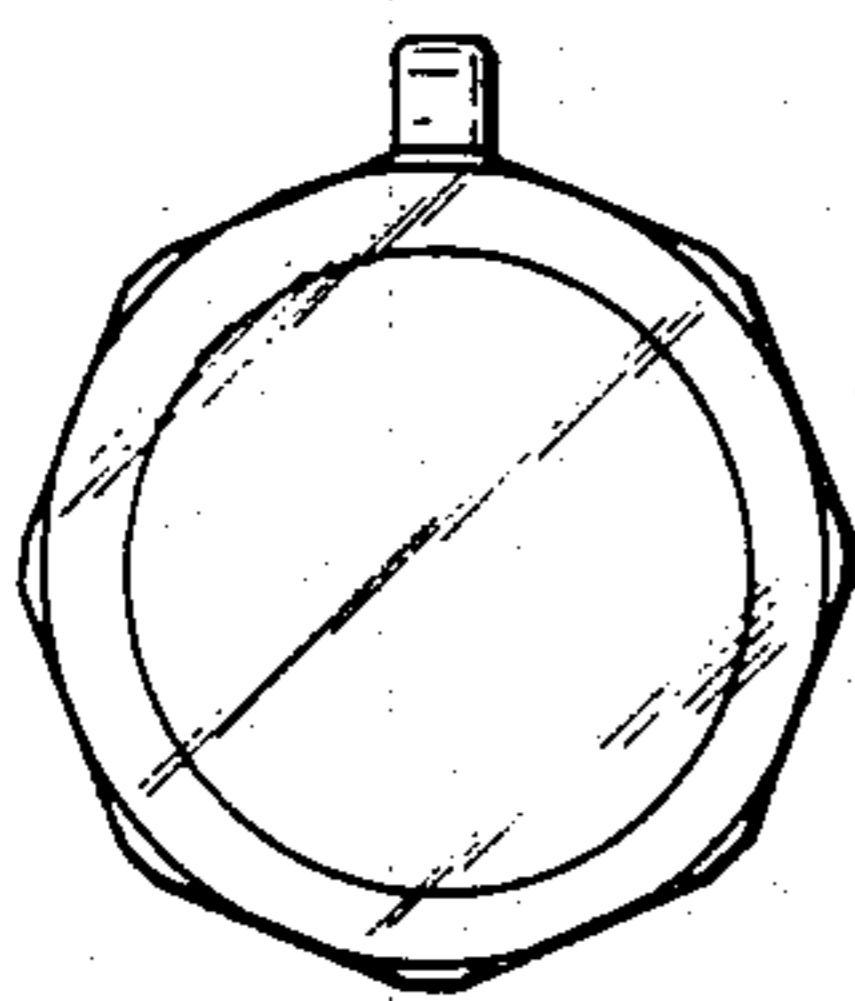

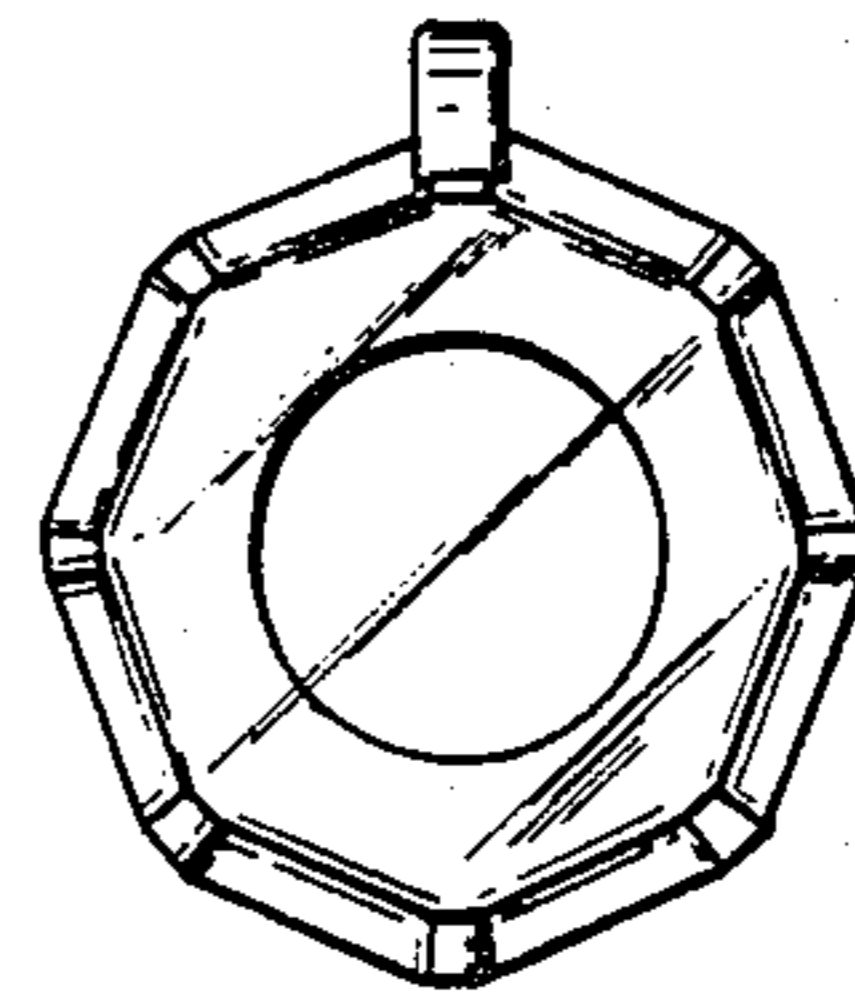

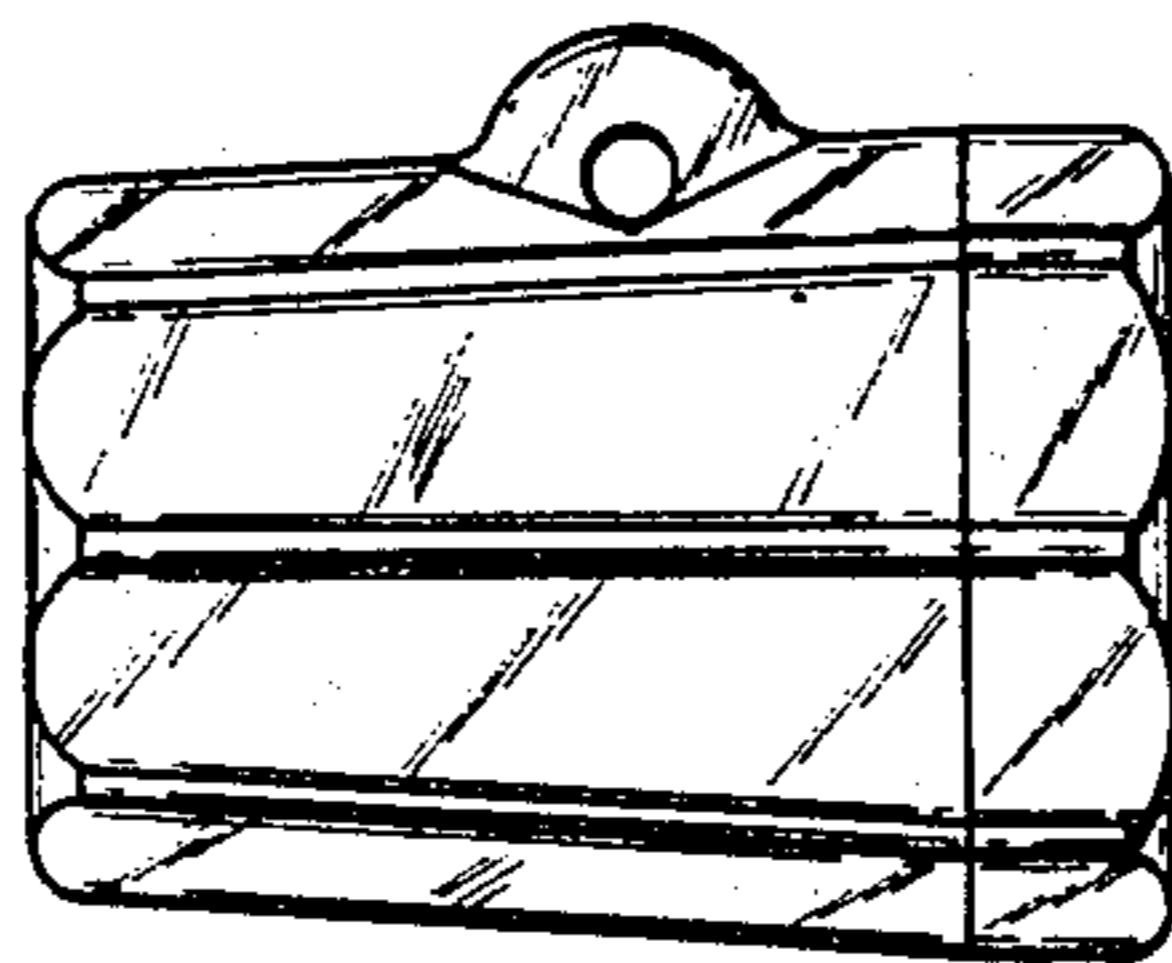

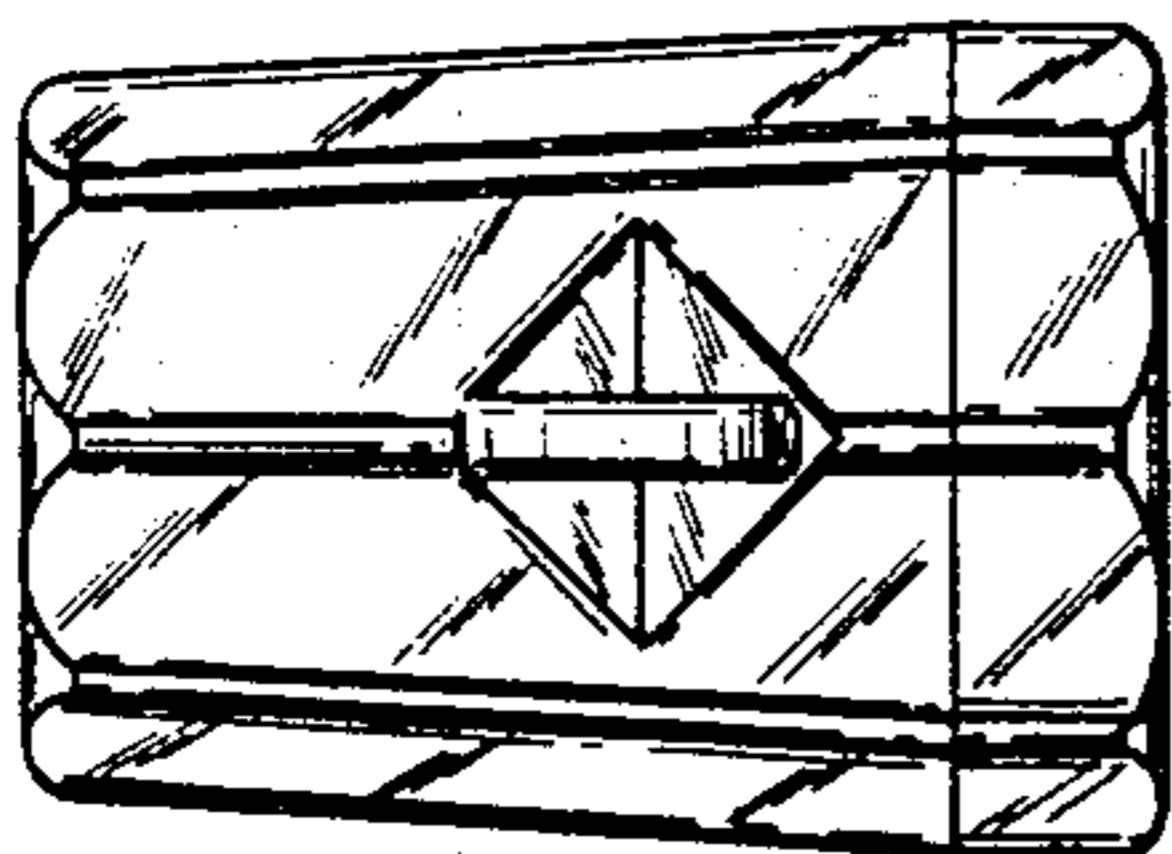

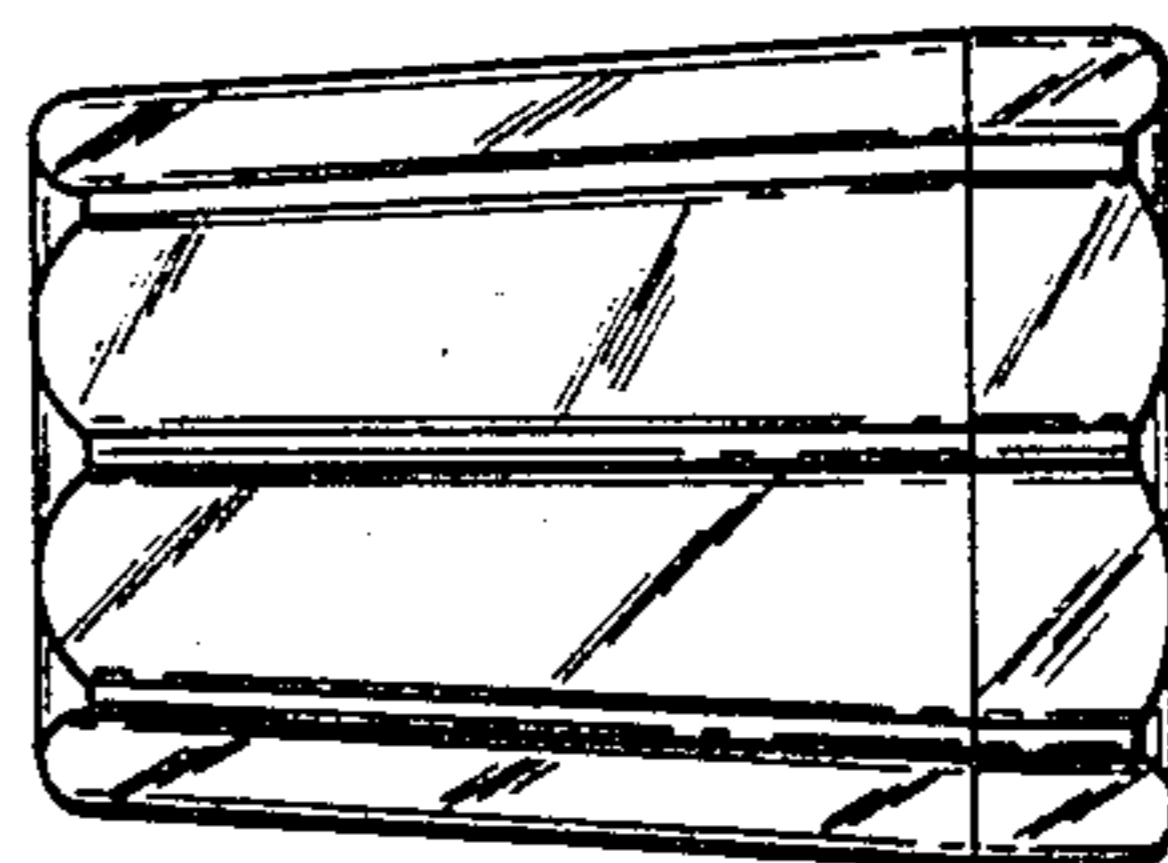
