[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an automobile fender skirt ornament, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and front perspective view of an automobile fender skirt ornament showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

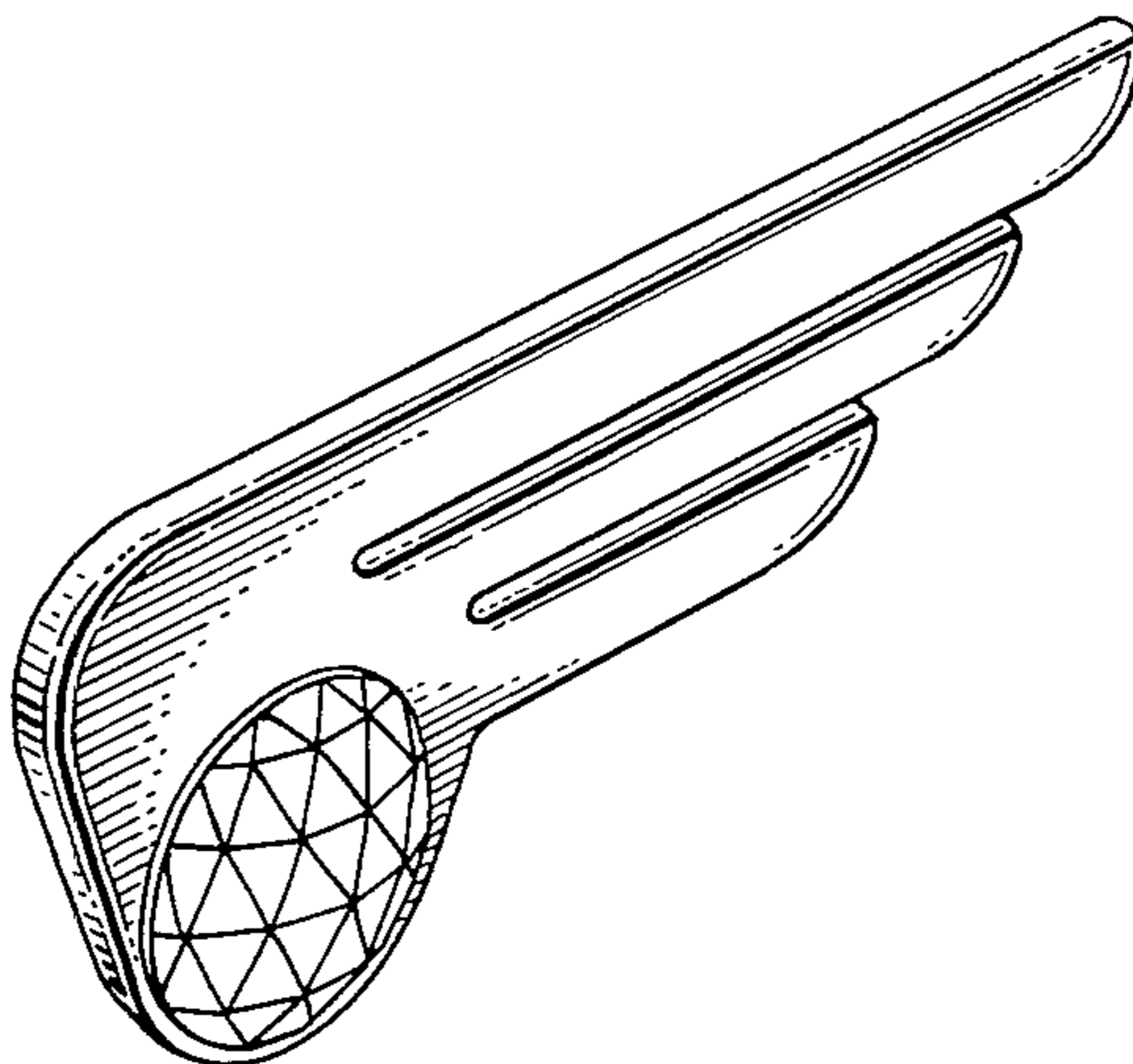

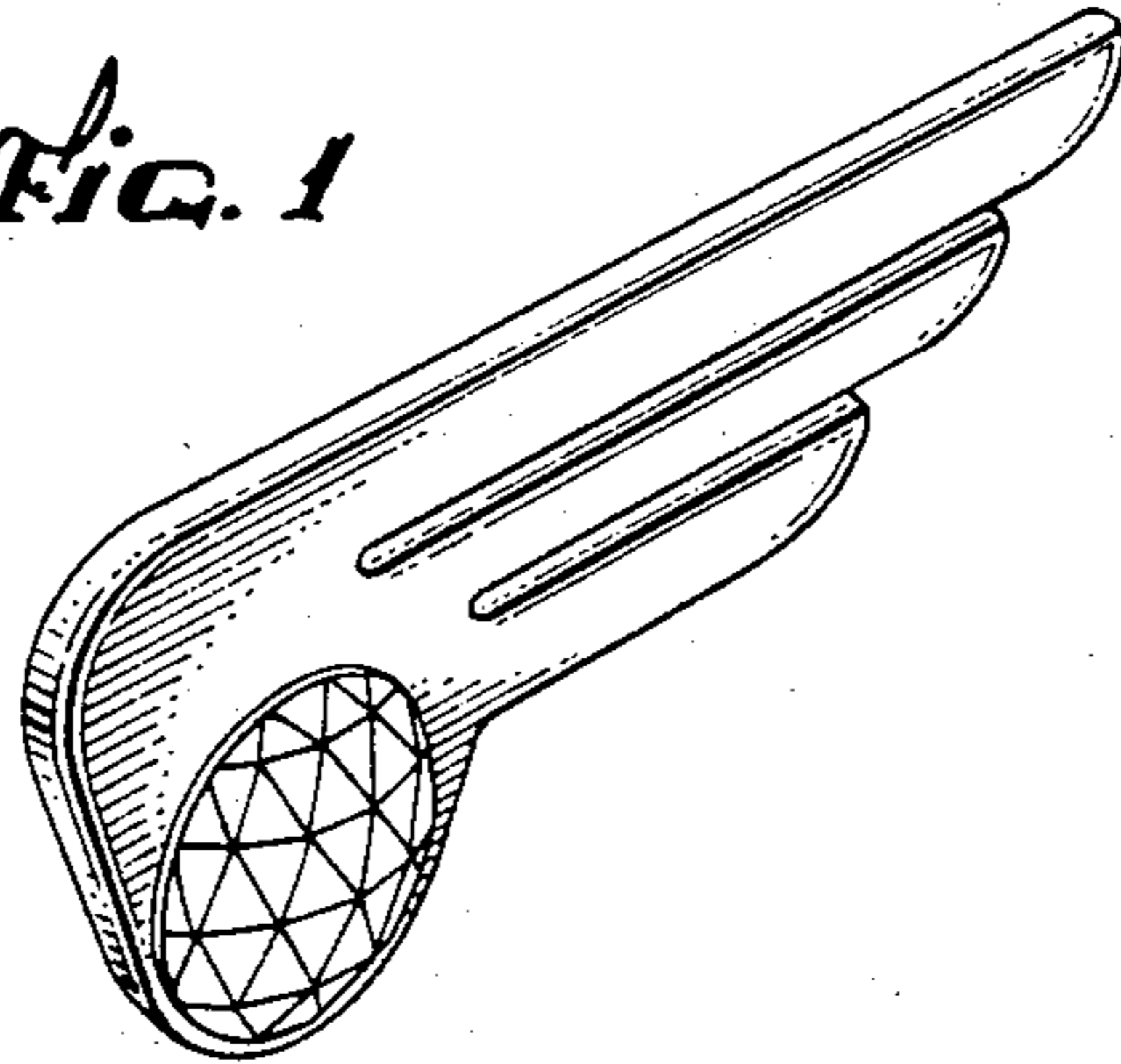

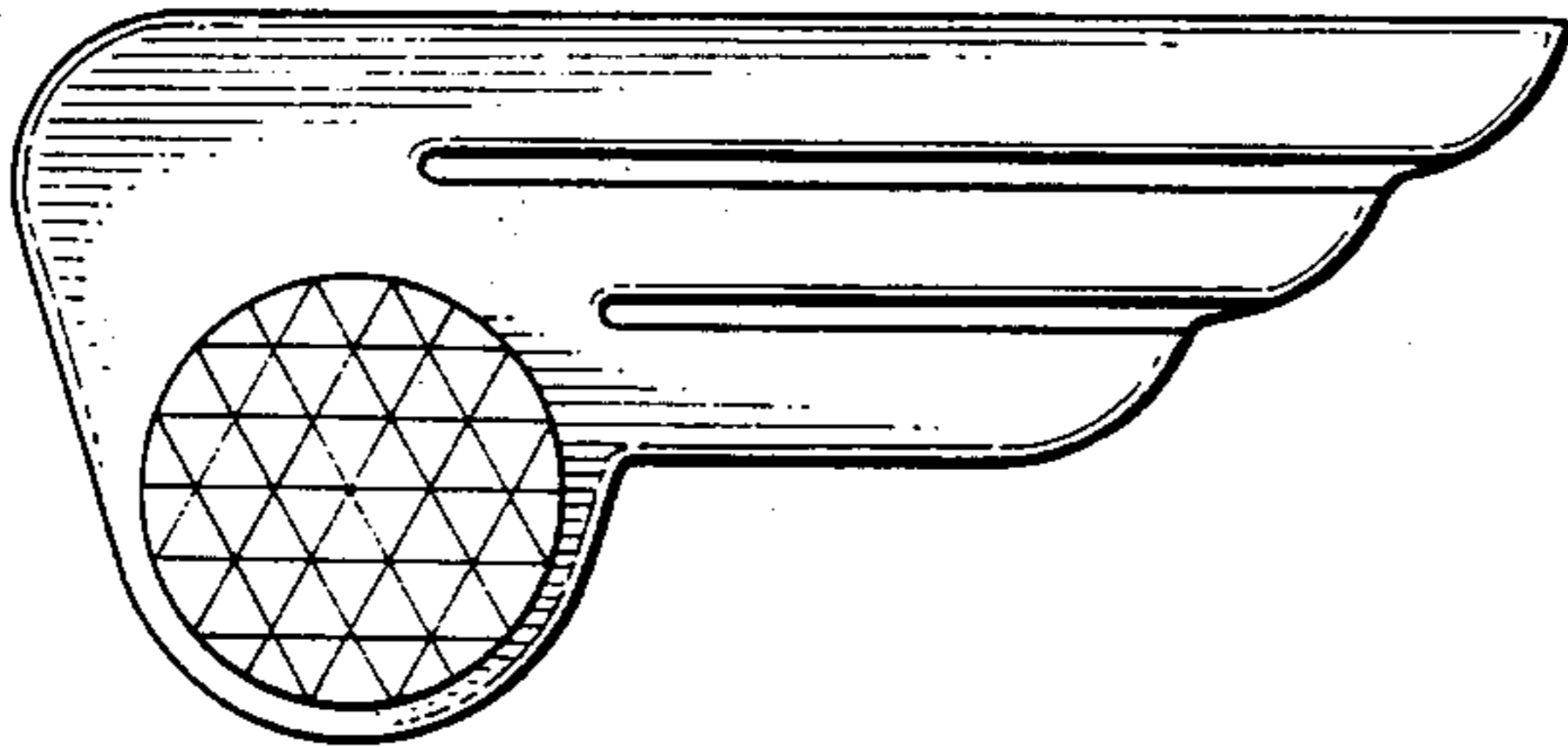

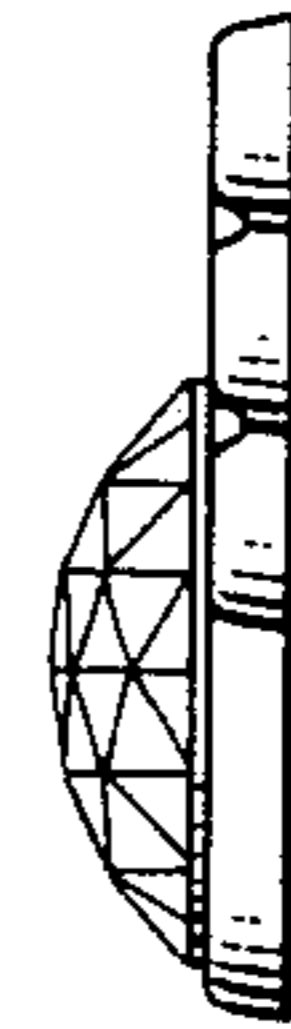

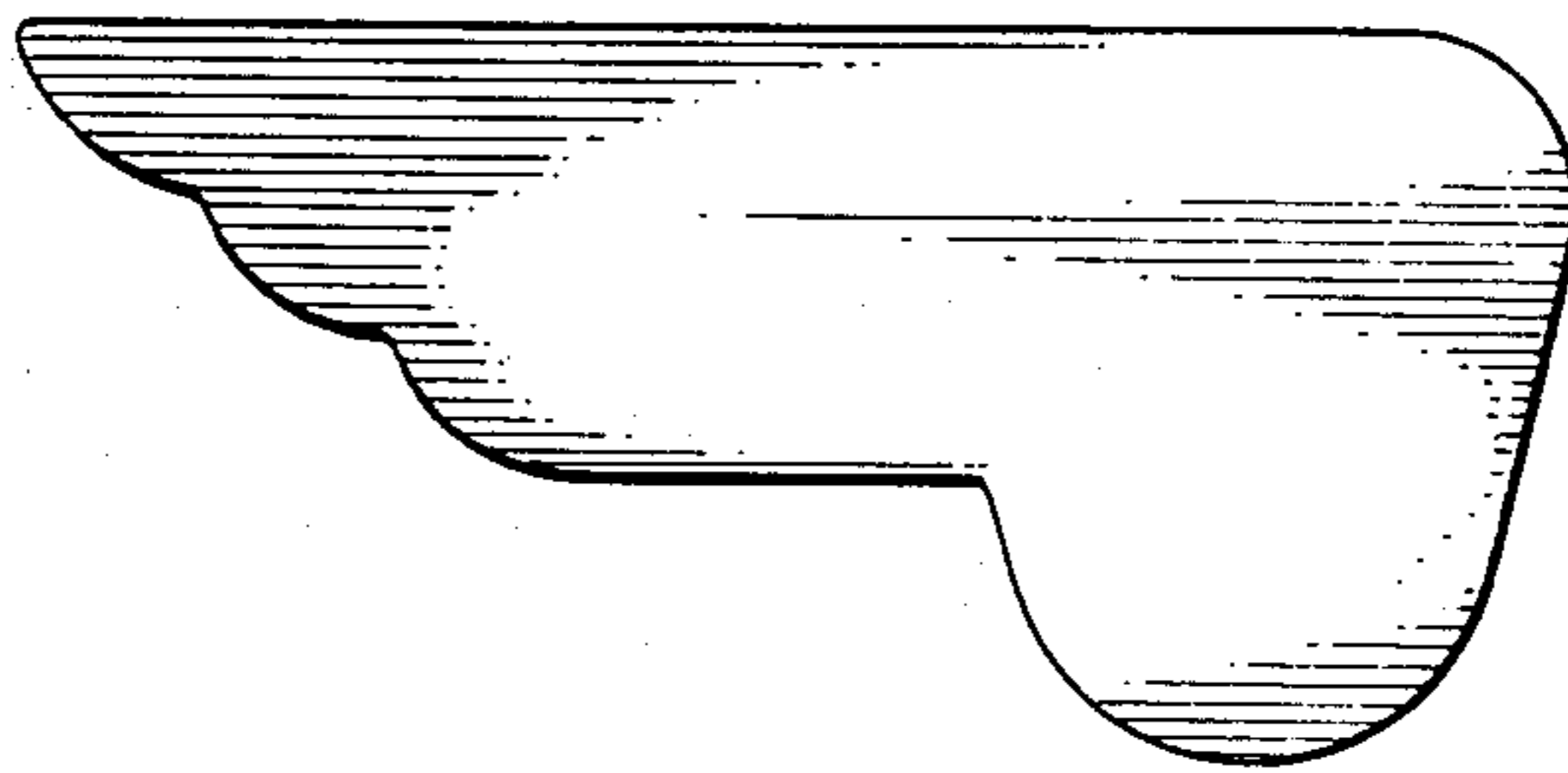

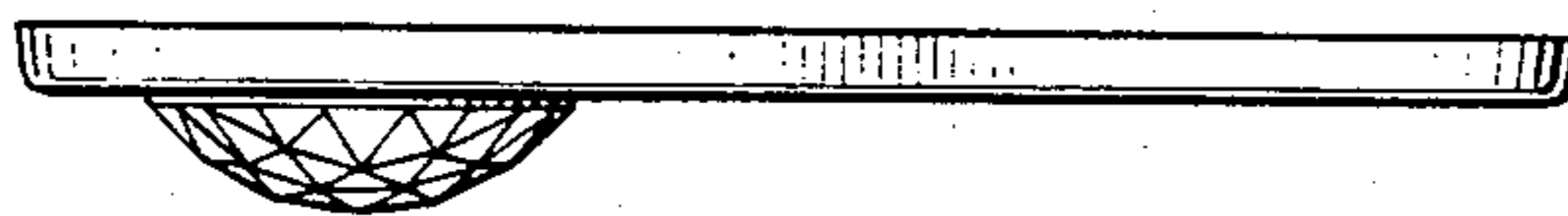
