FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2.

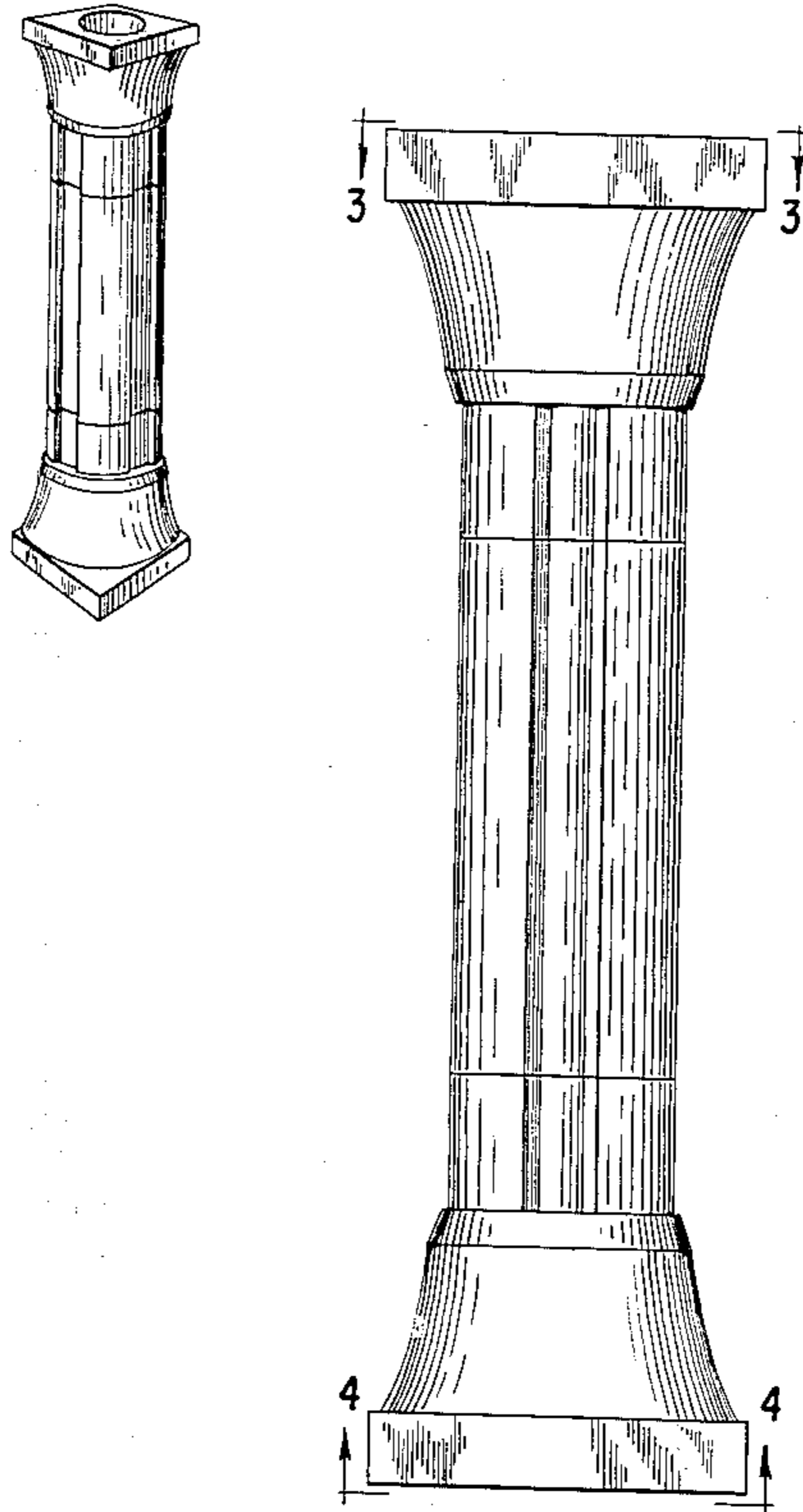

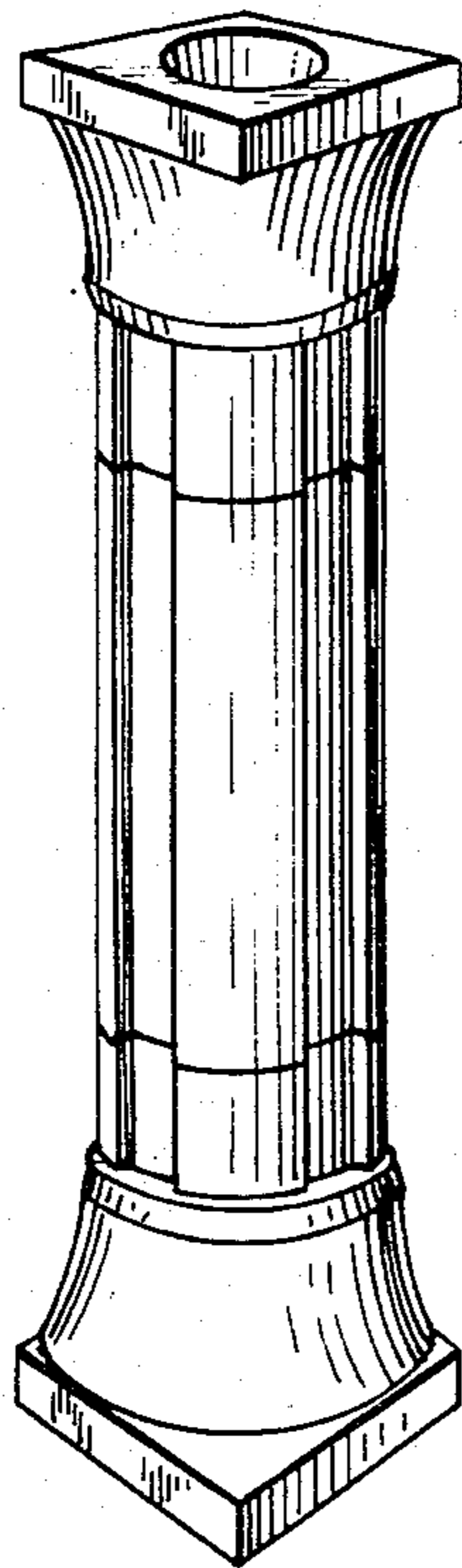

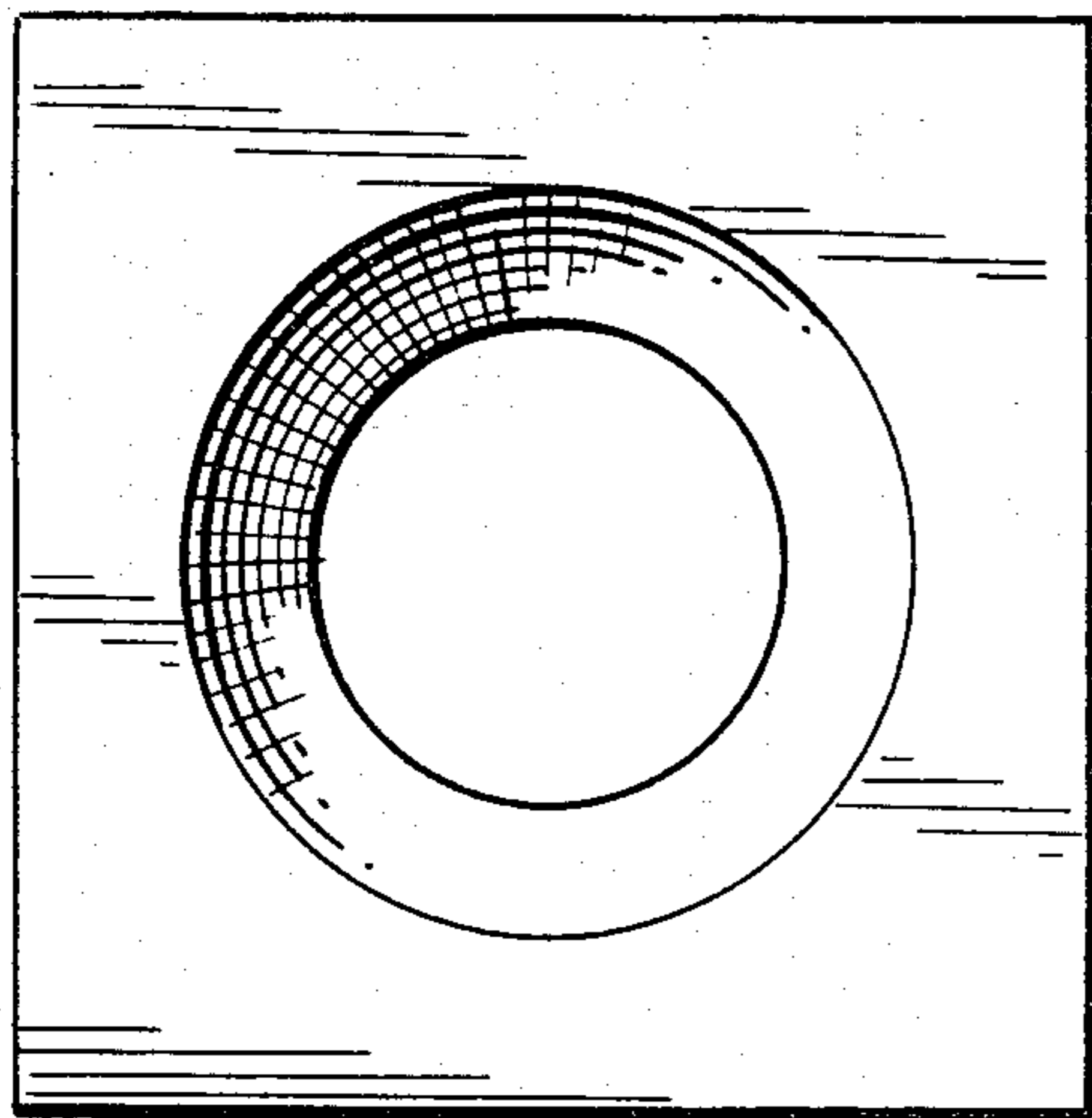

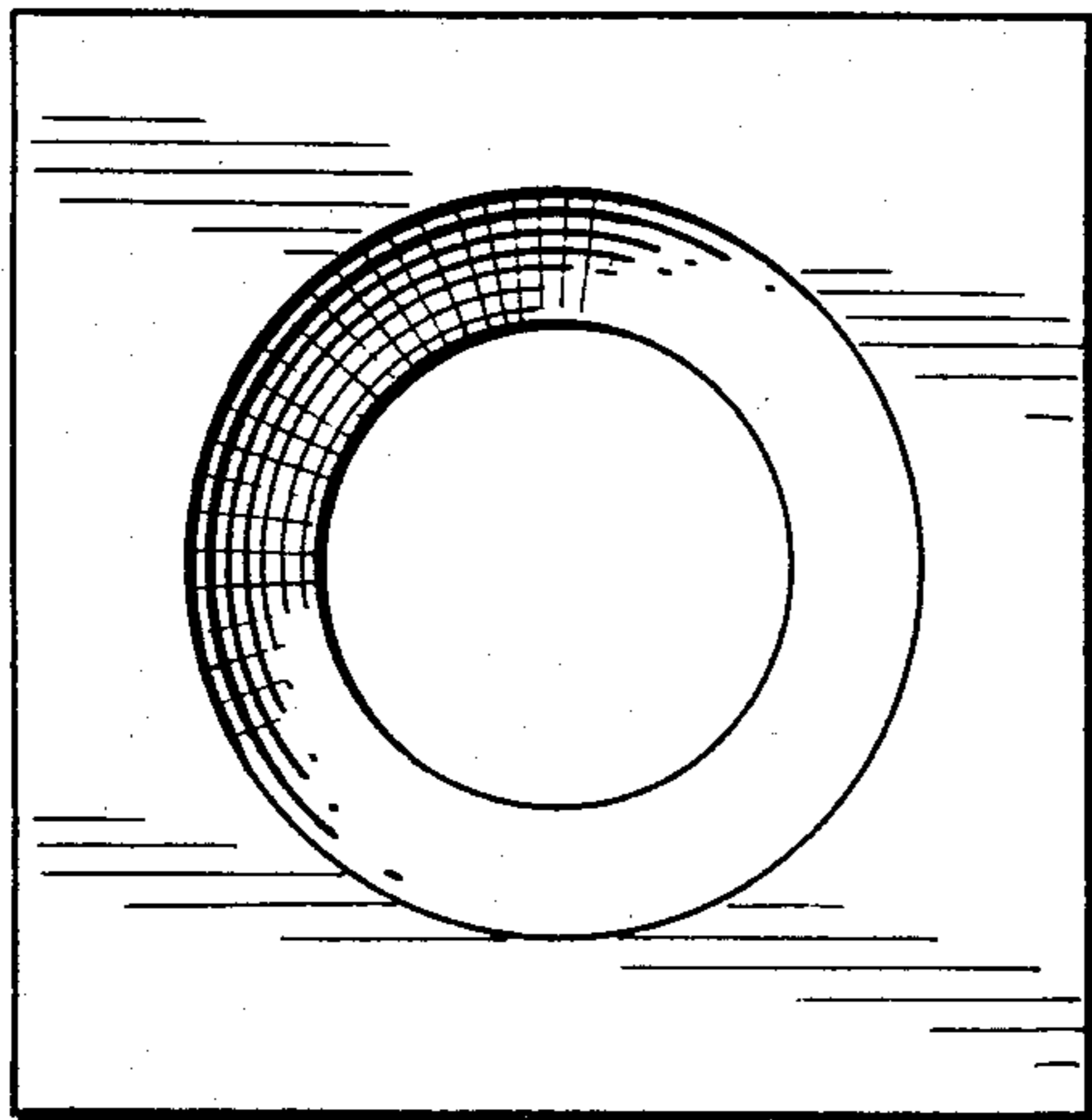
