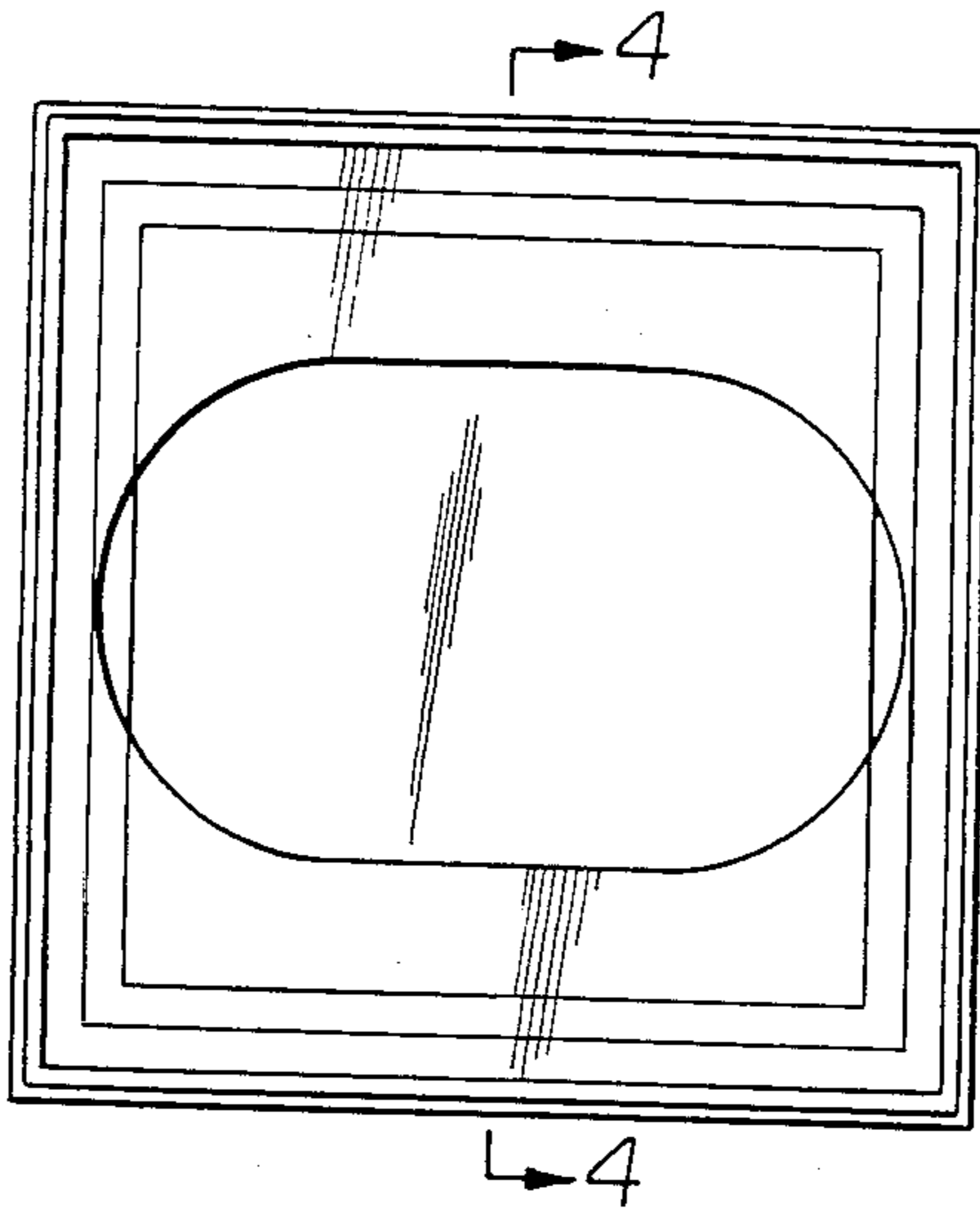

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a telescoping dispenser for cotton balls or the like.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a telescoping dispenser for cotton balls or the like embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 4 is a sectional view along line 4—4 of FIG. 1 with cotton balls being shown in broken lines to show environmental use only.



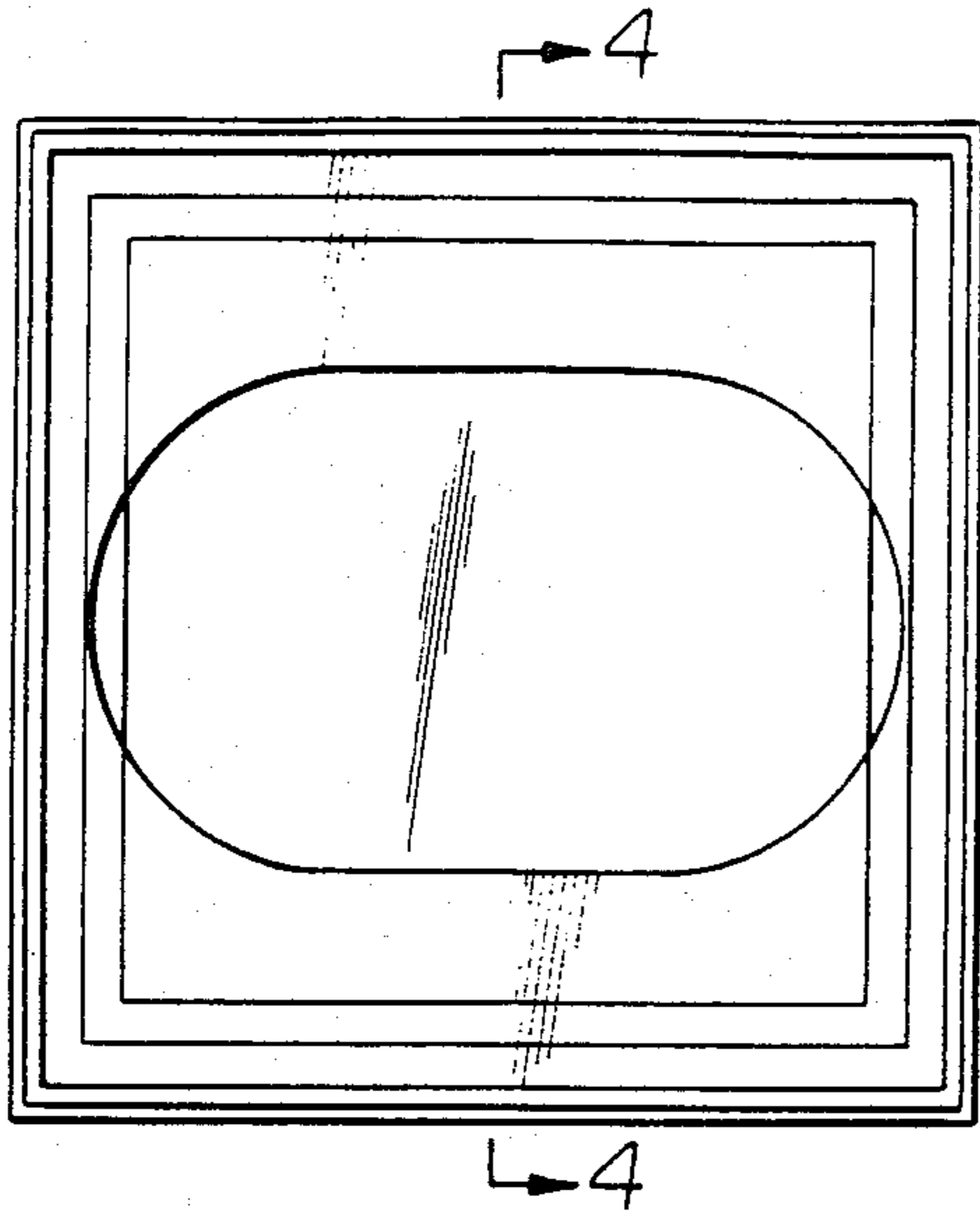

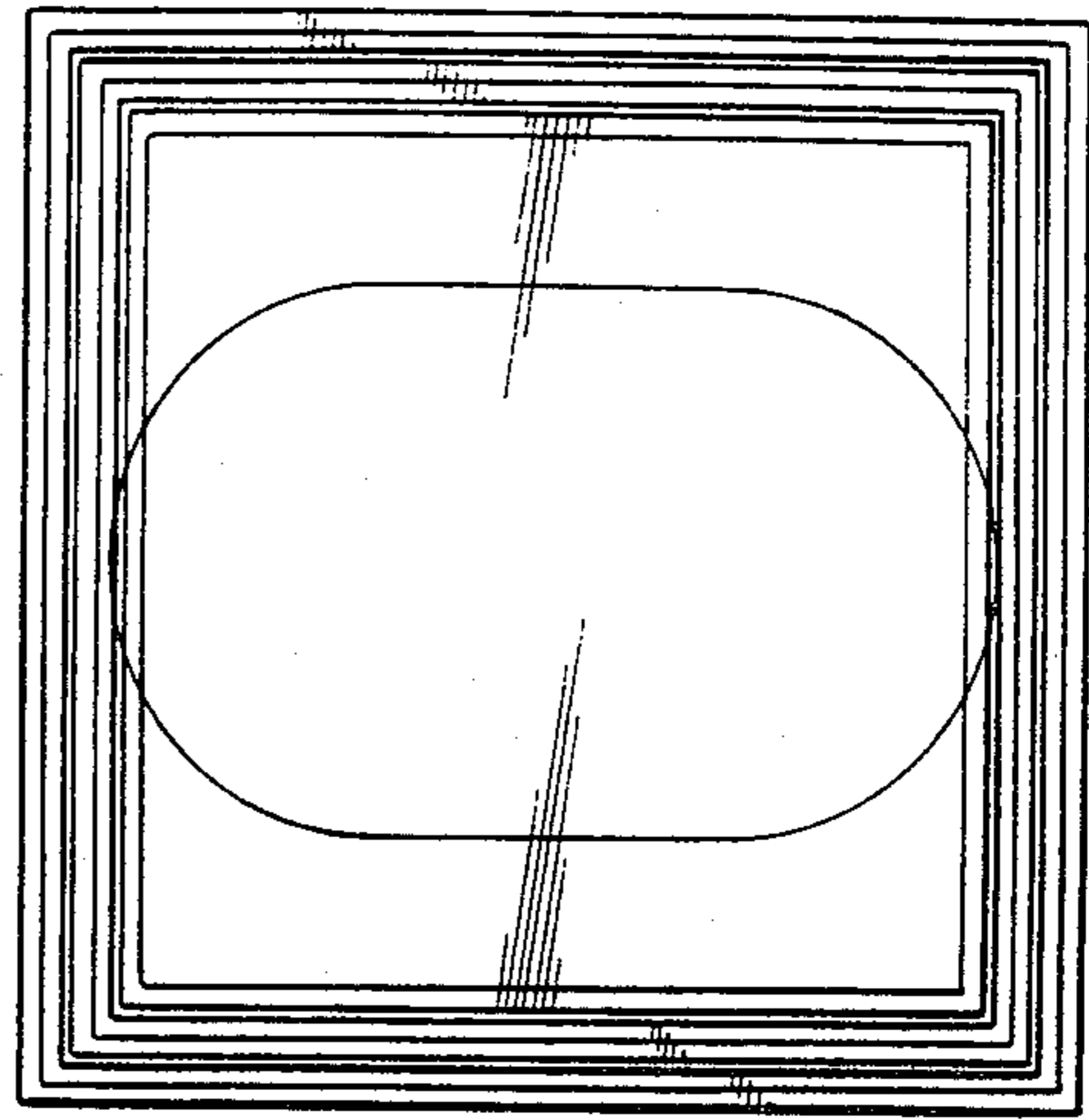

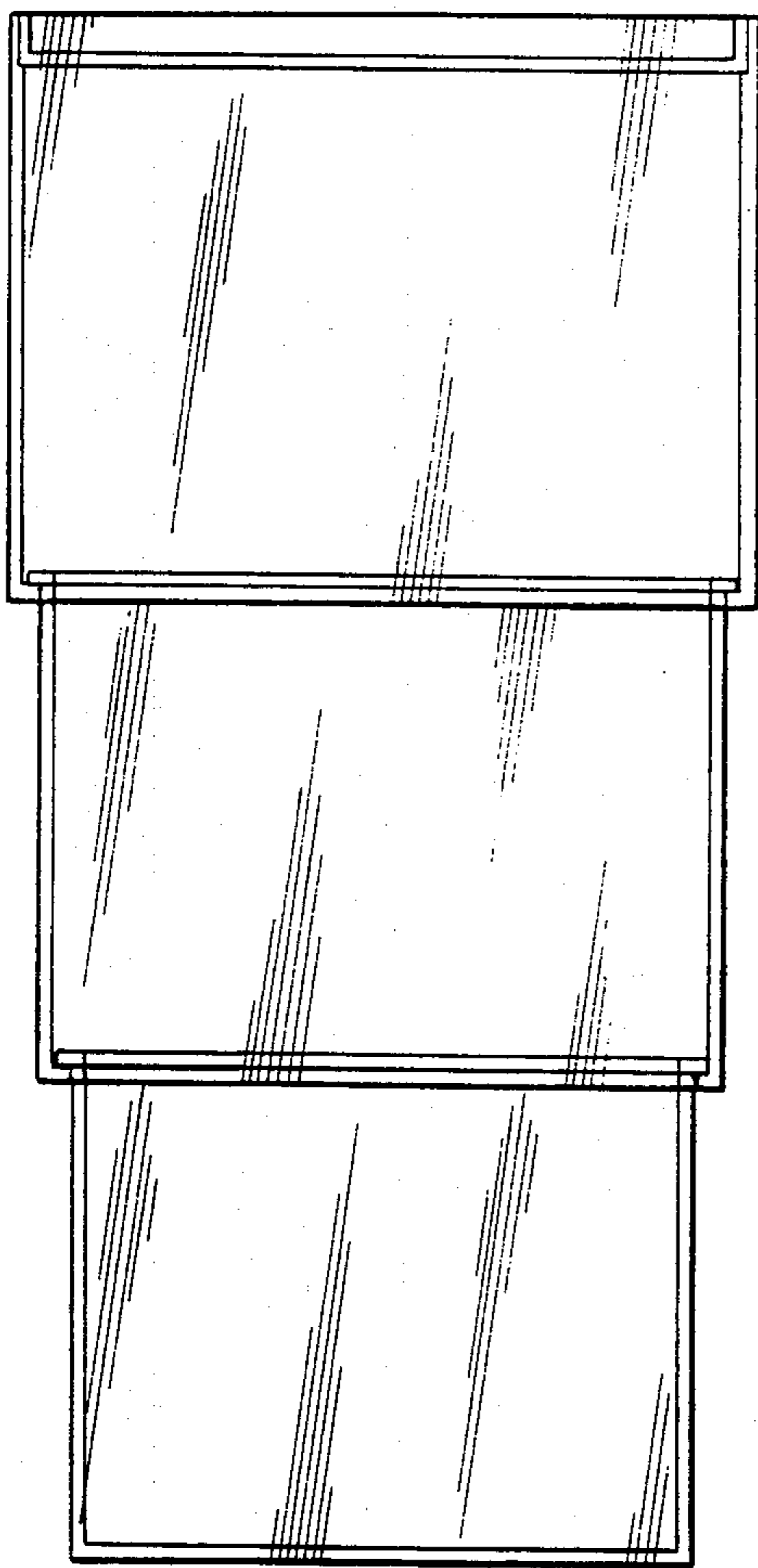

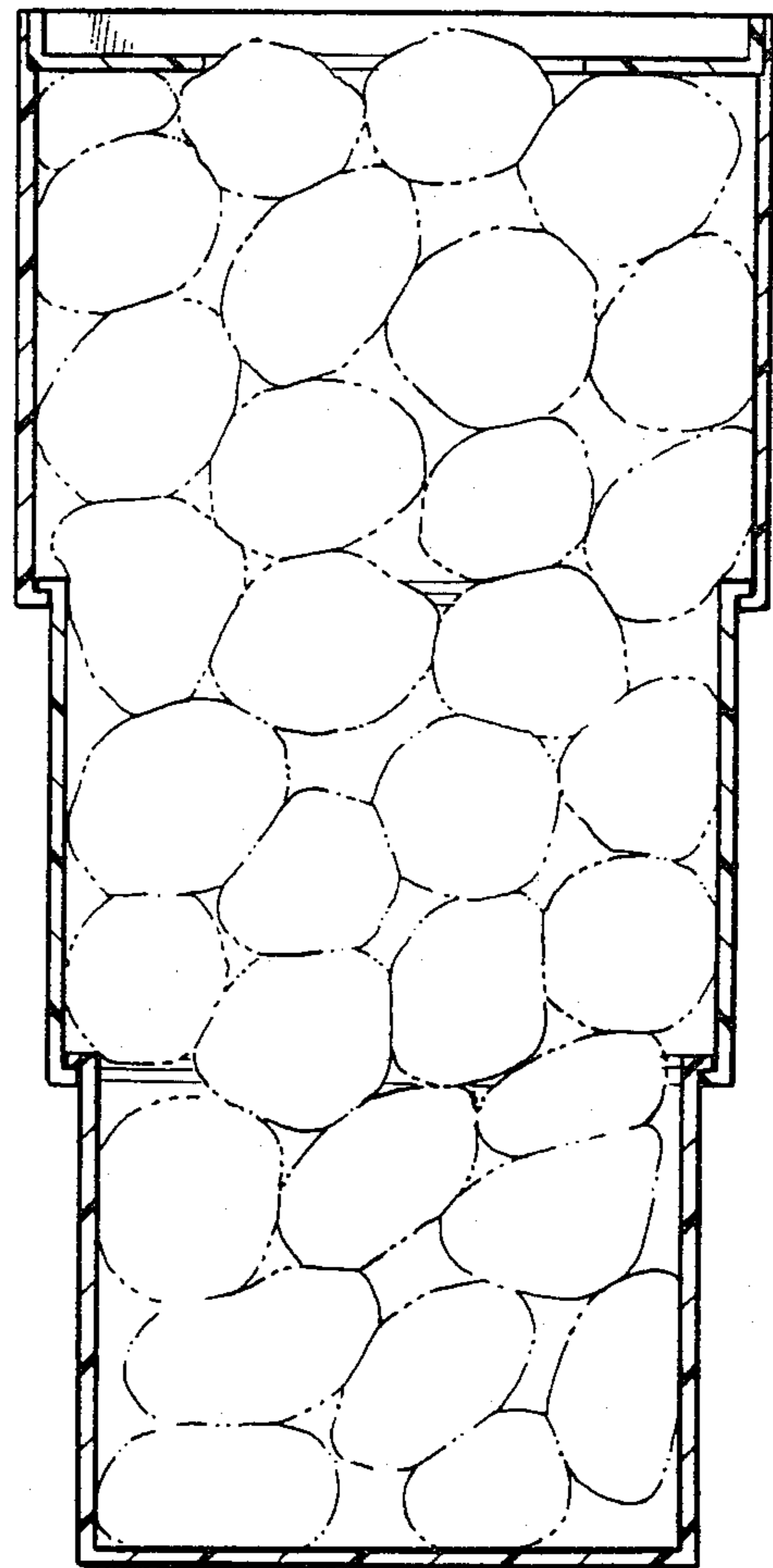
