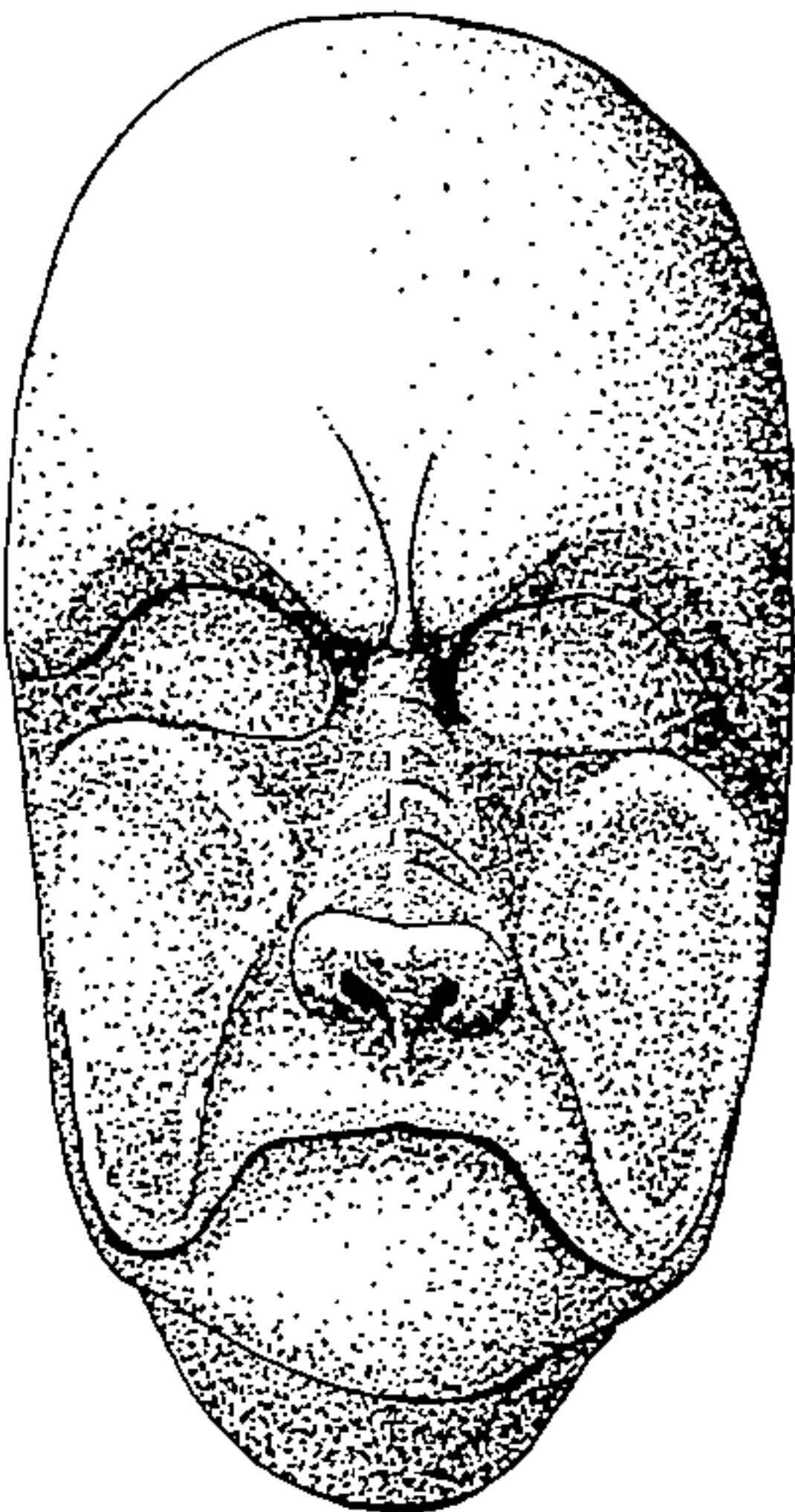

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a facial appliance for  
makeup, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the facial appliance  
for makeup showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the left side  
of FIG. 1 and a view taken from the right side of FIG.  
1 would be the same in appearance as FIG. 2;  
FIG. 3 is a rear view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top view of FIG. 1.





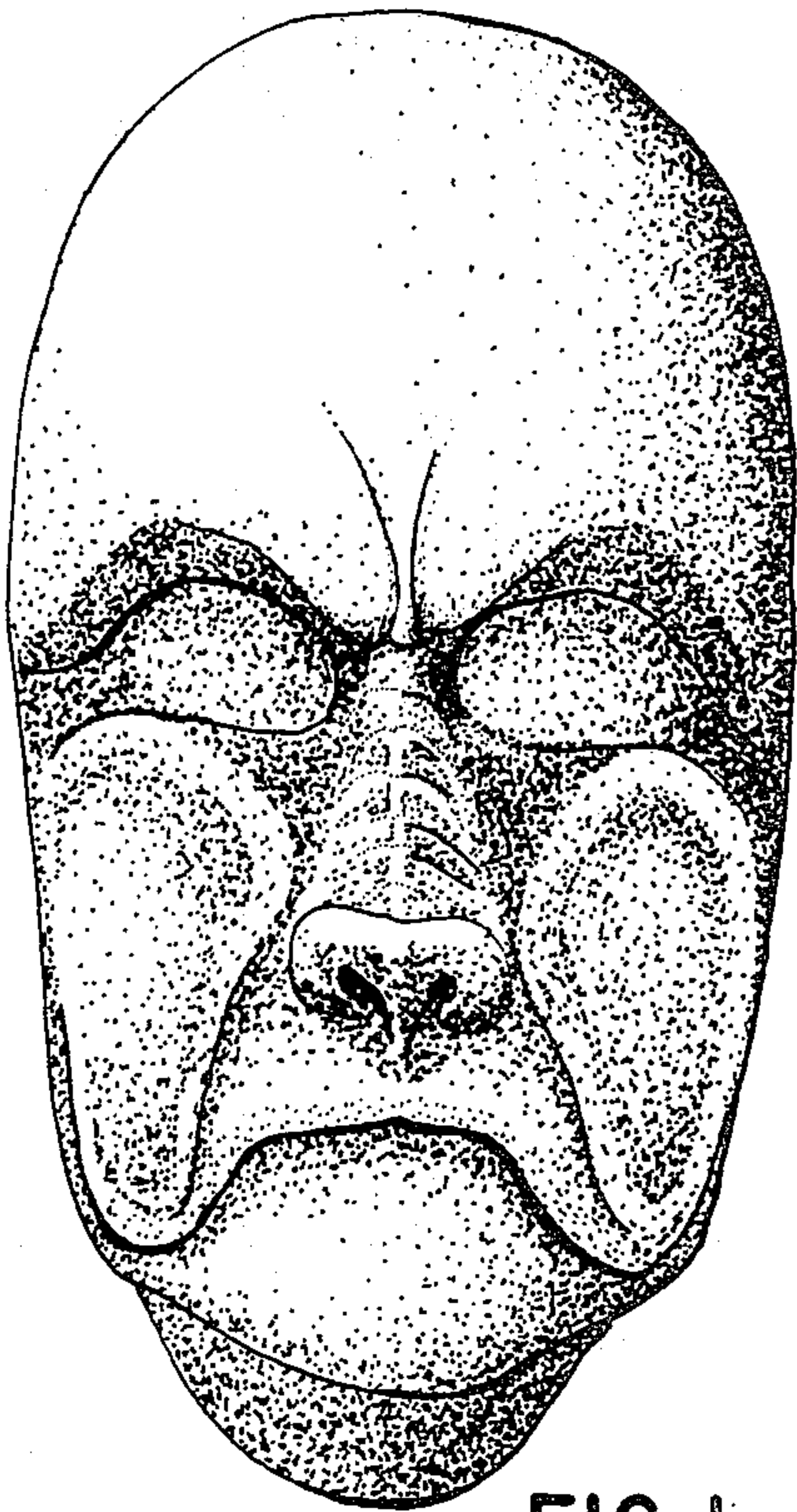

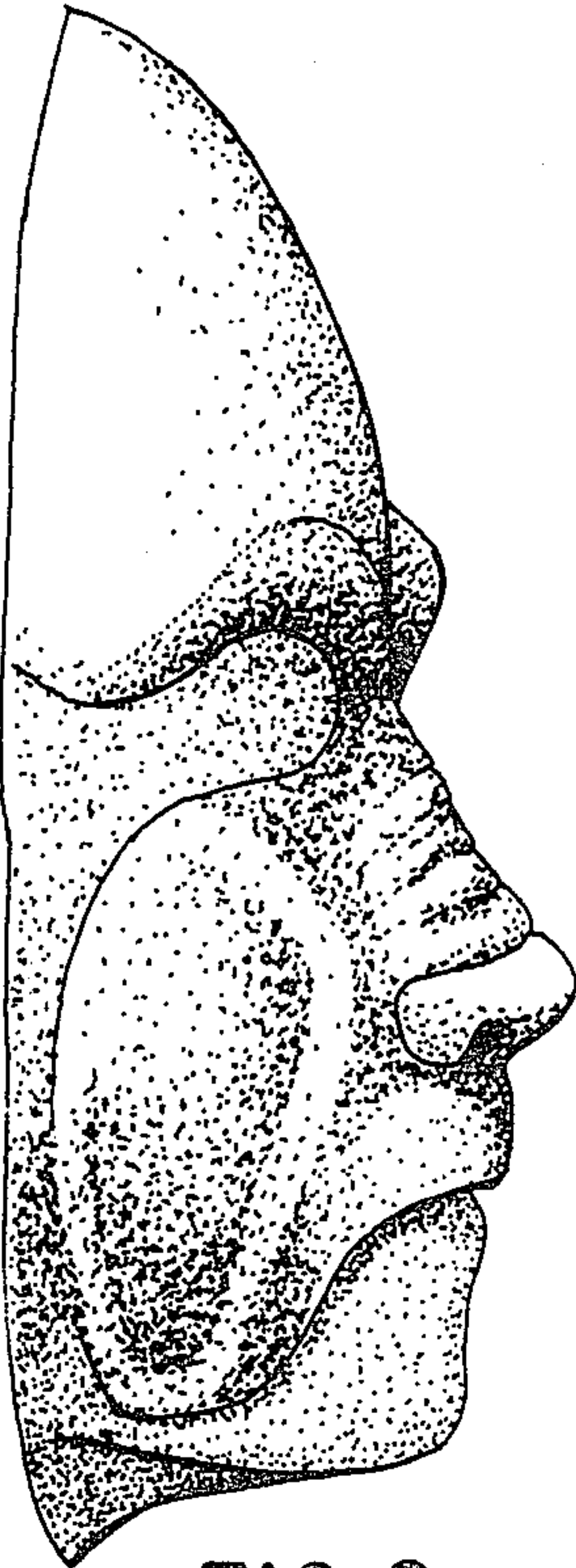

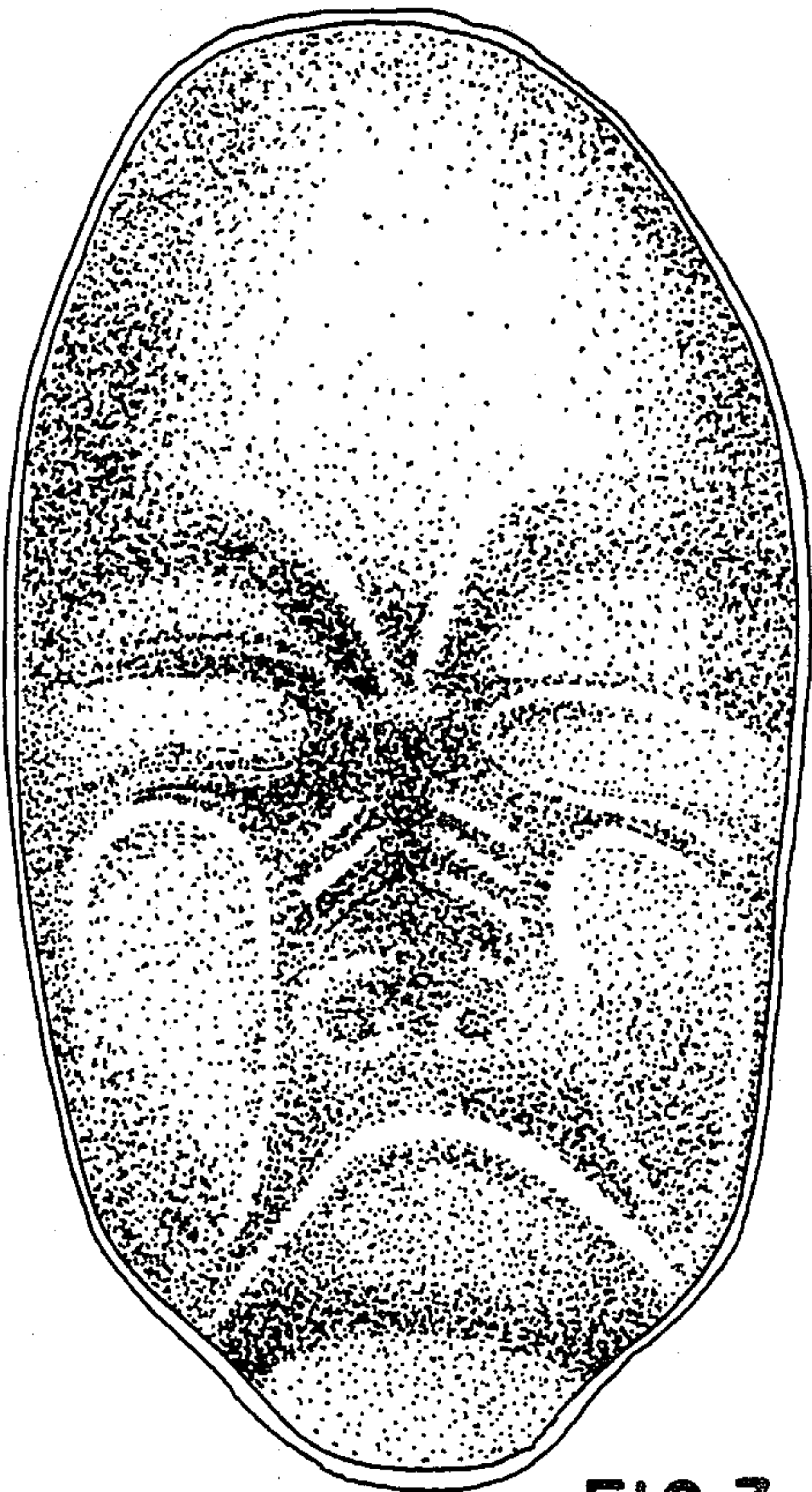

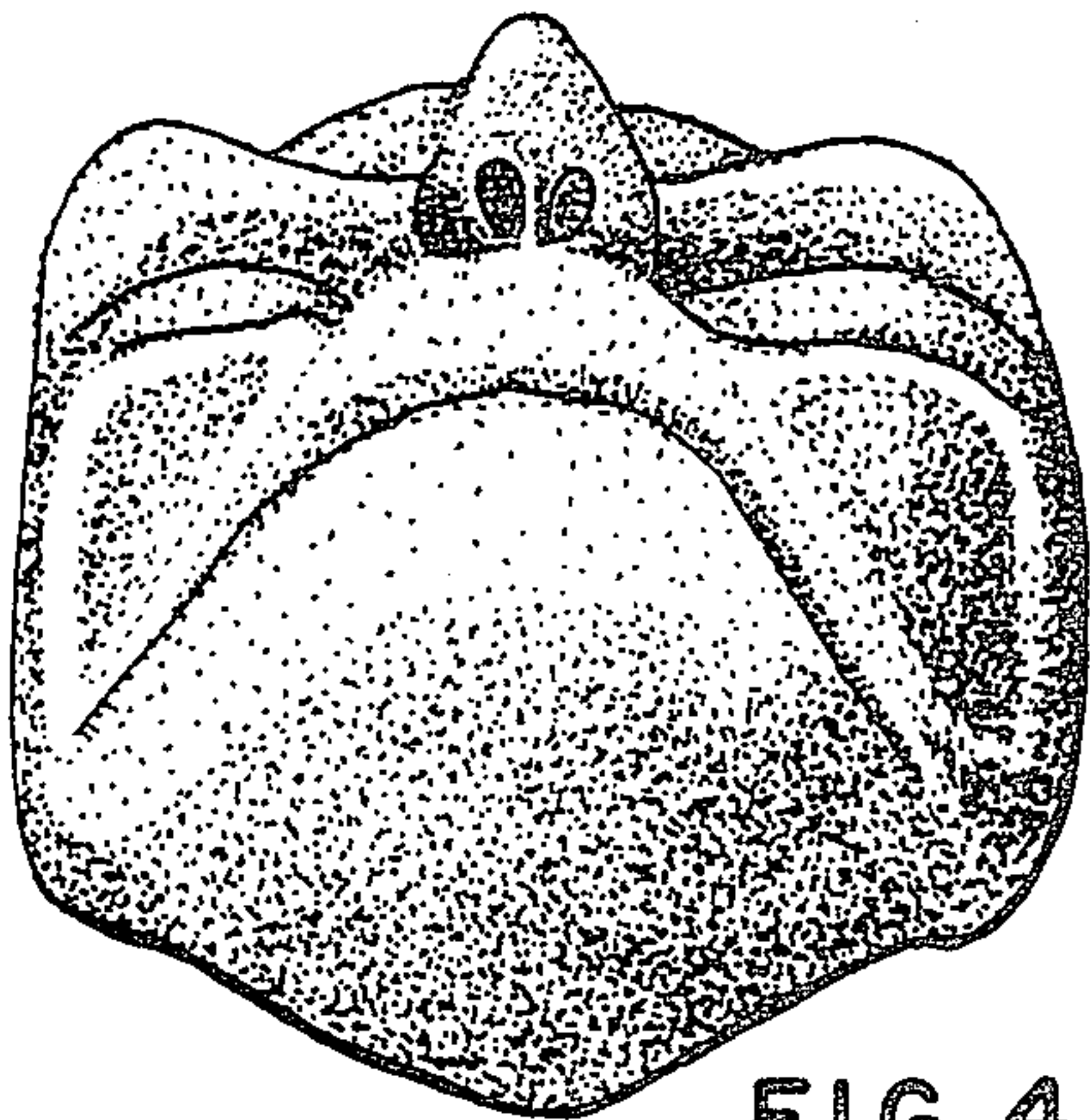

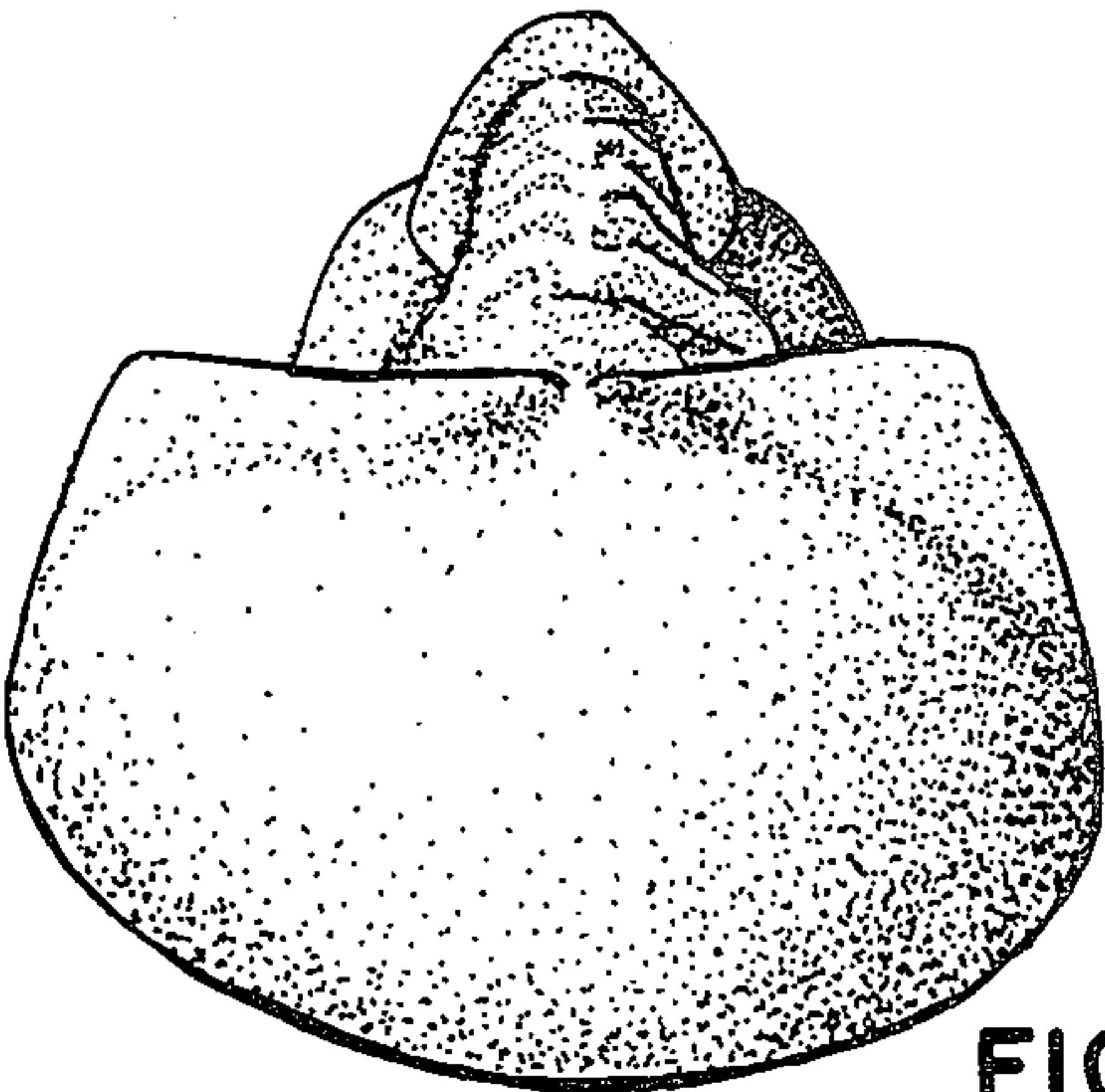
