FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of an outsole for athletic shoe showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the broken line showing of a shoe being environmental only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and

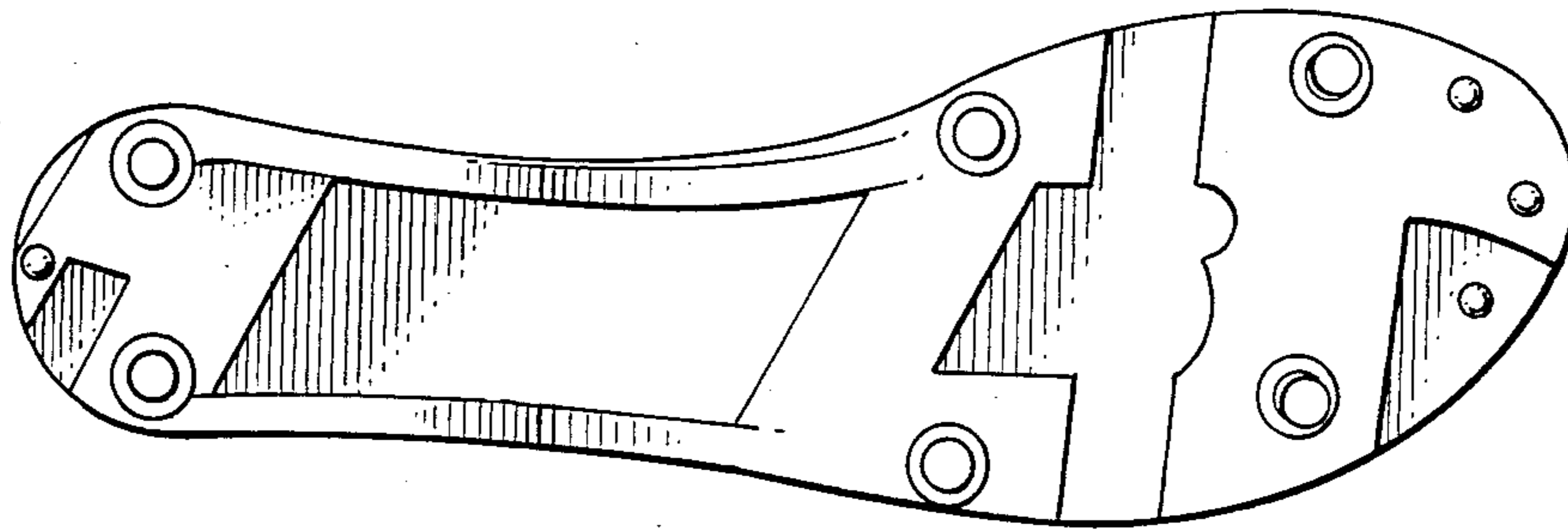

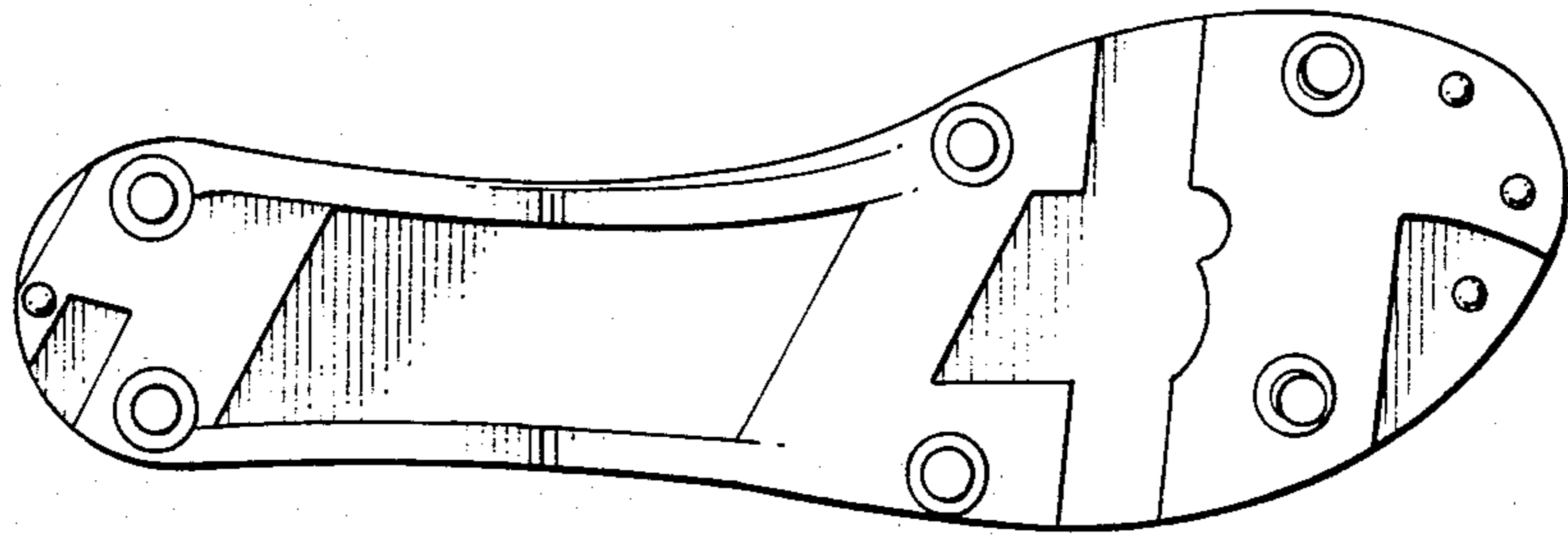

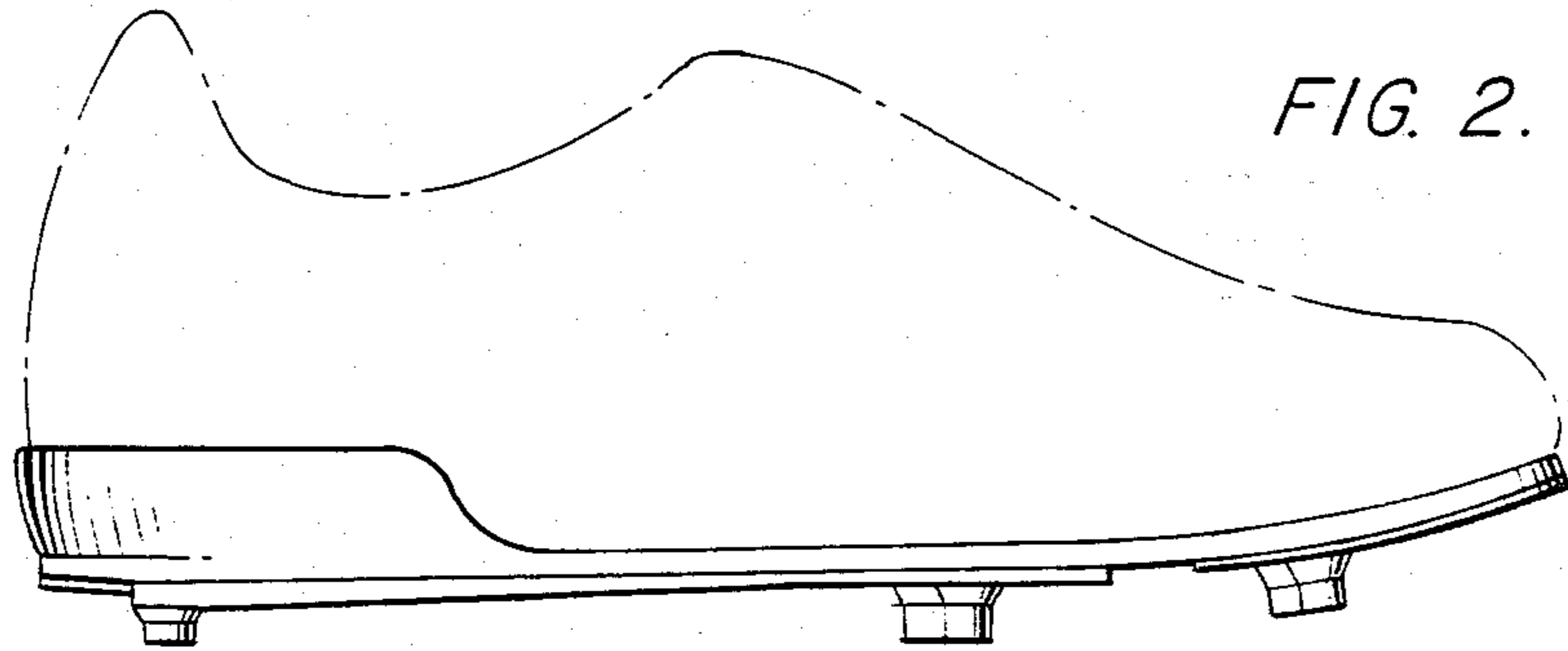

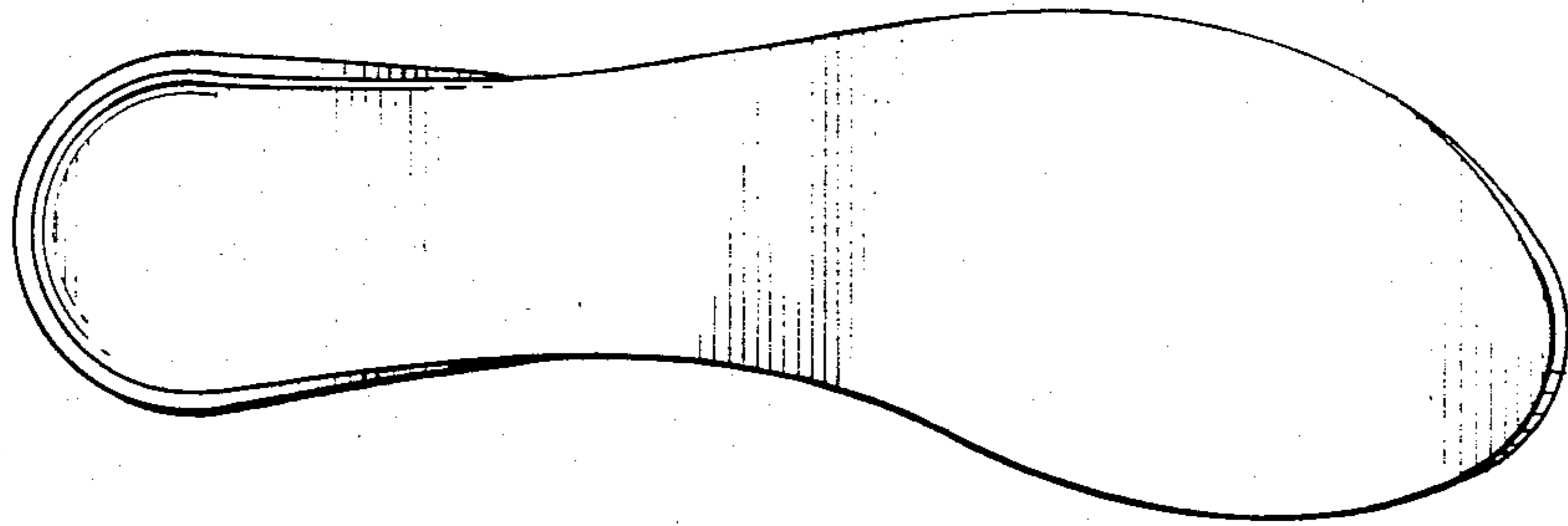

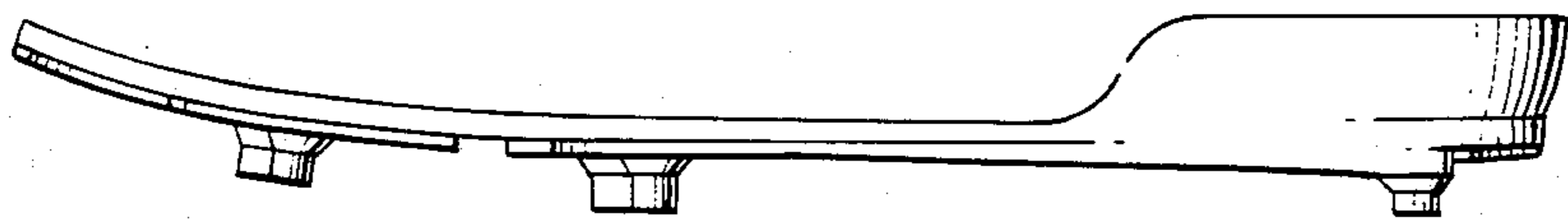

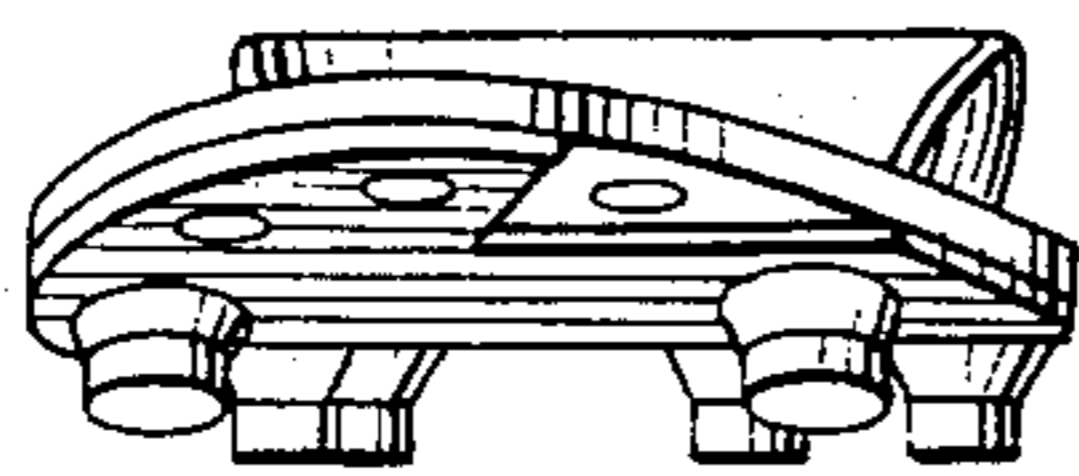
